FIG. 9 is a top plan view thereof;

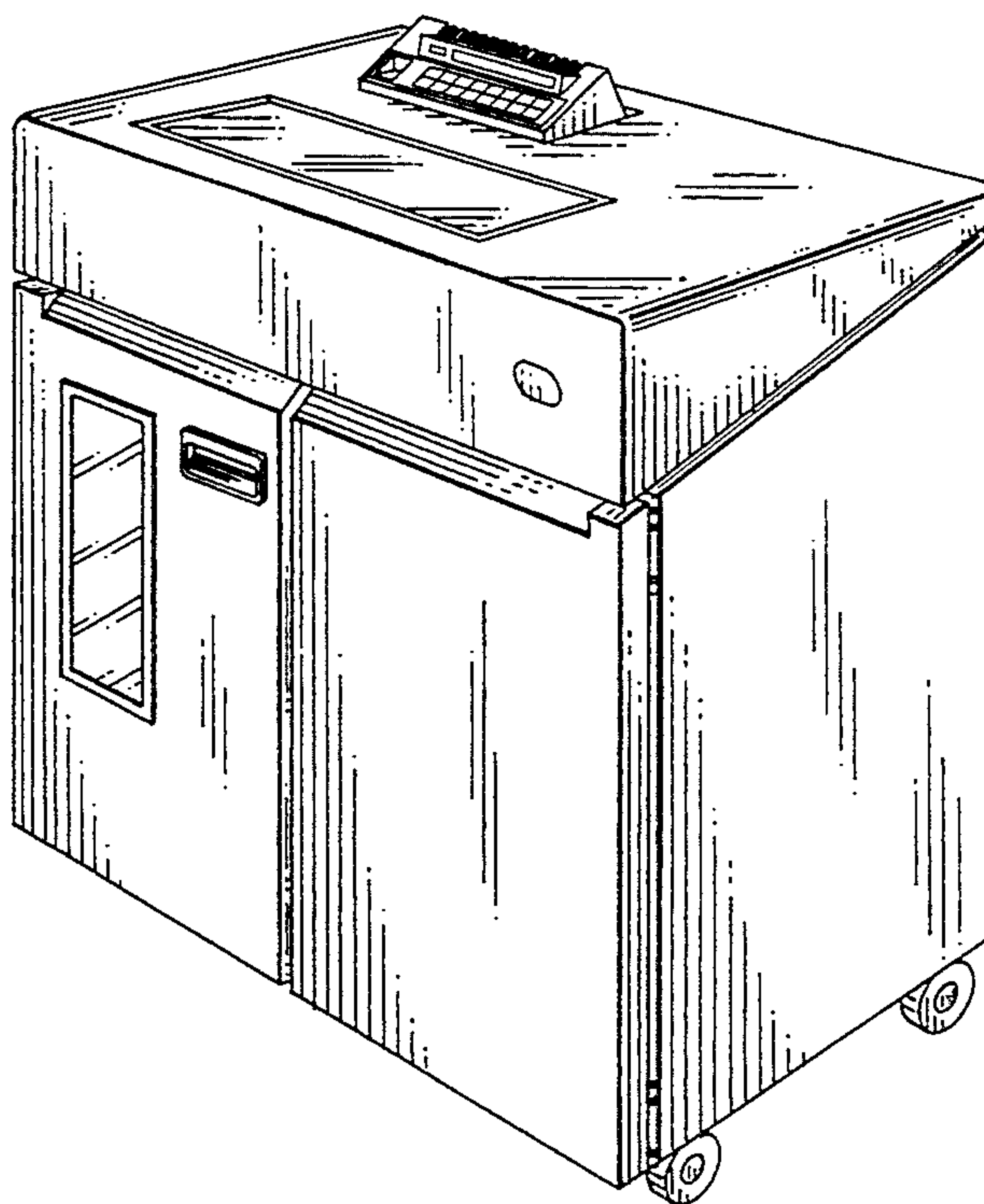
FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view thereof;

rear, FIG. 5, of the first embodiment.



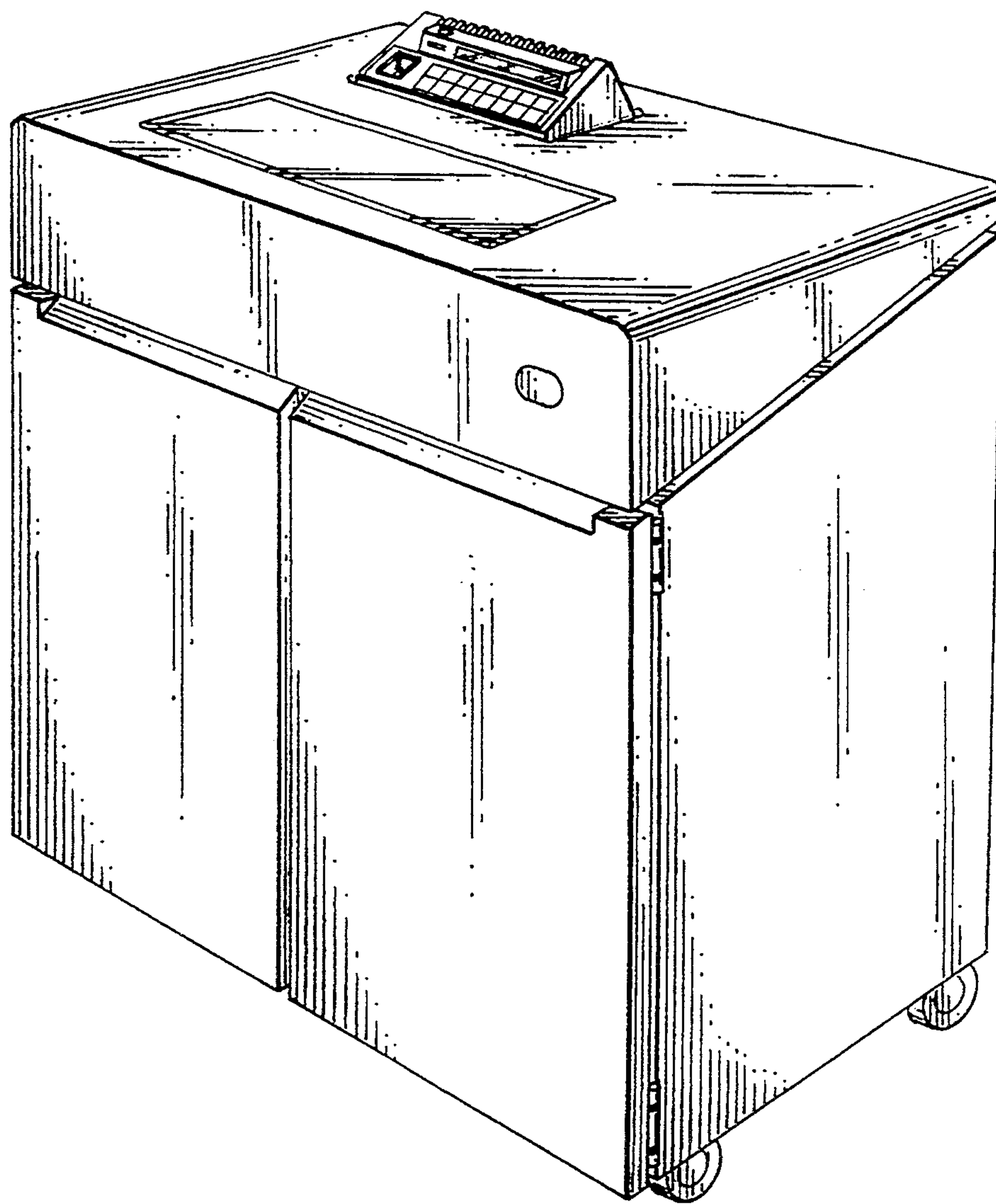

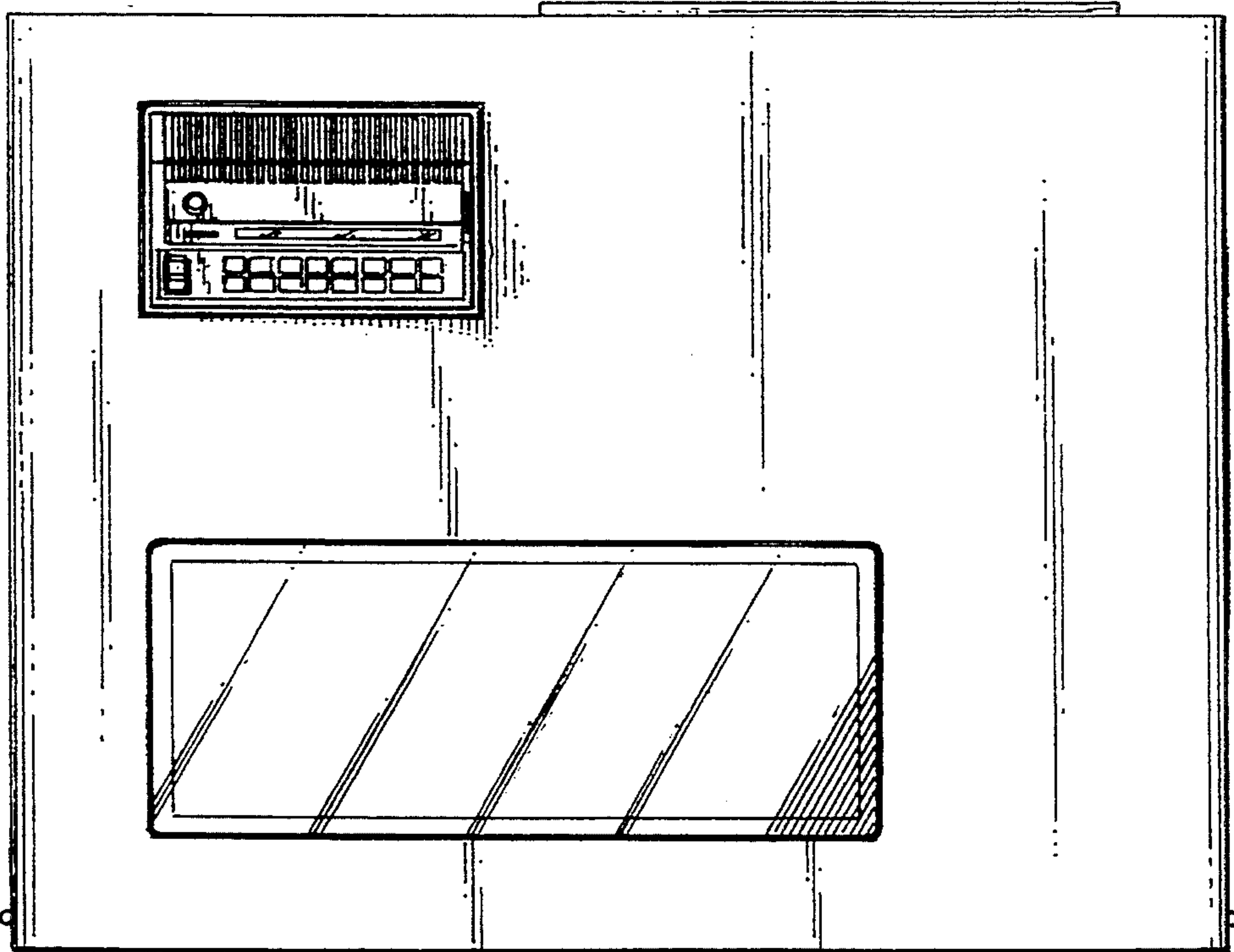

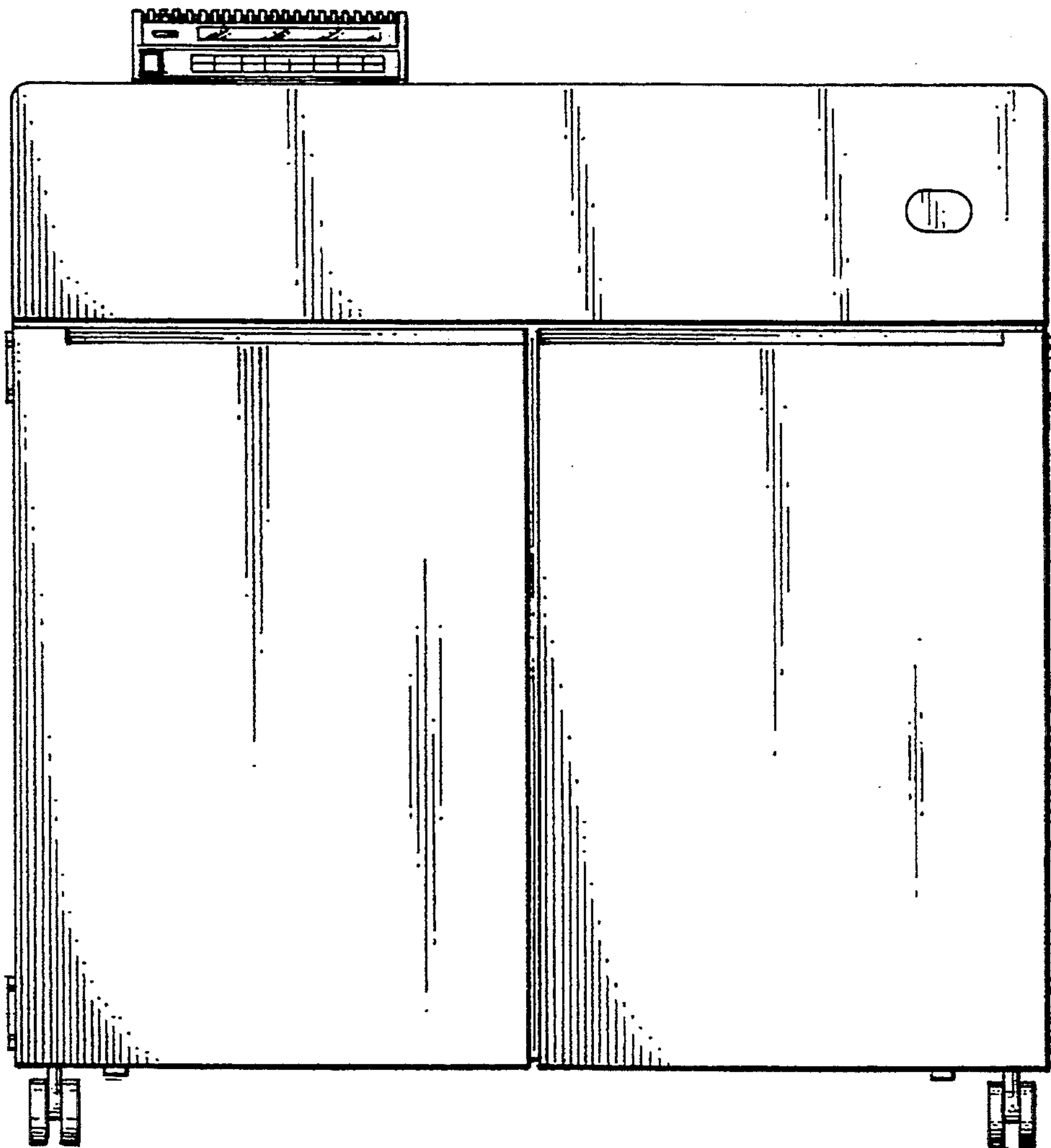

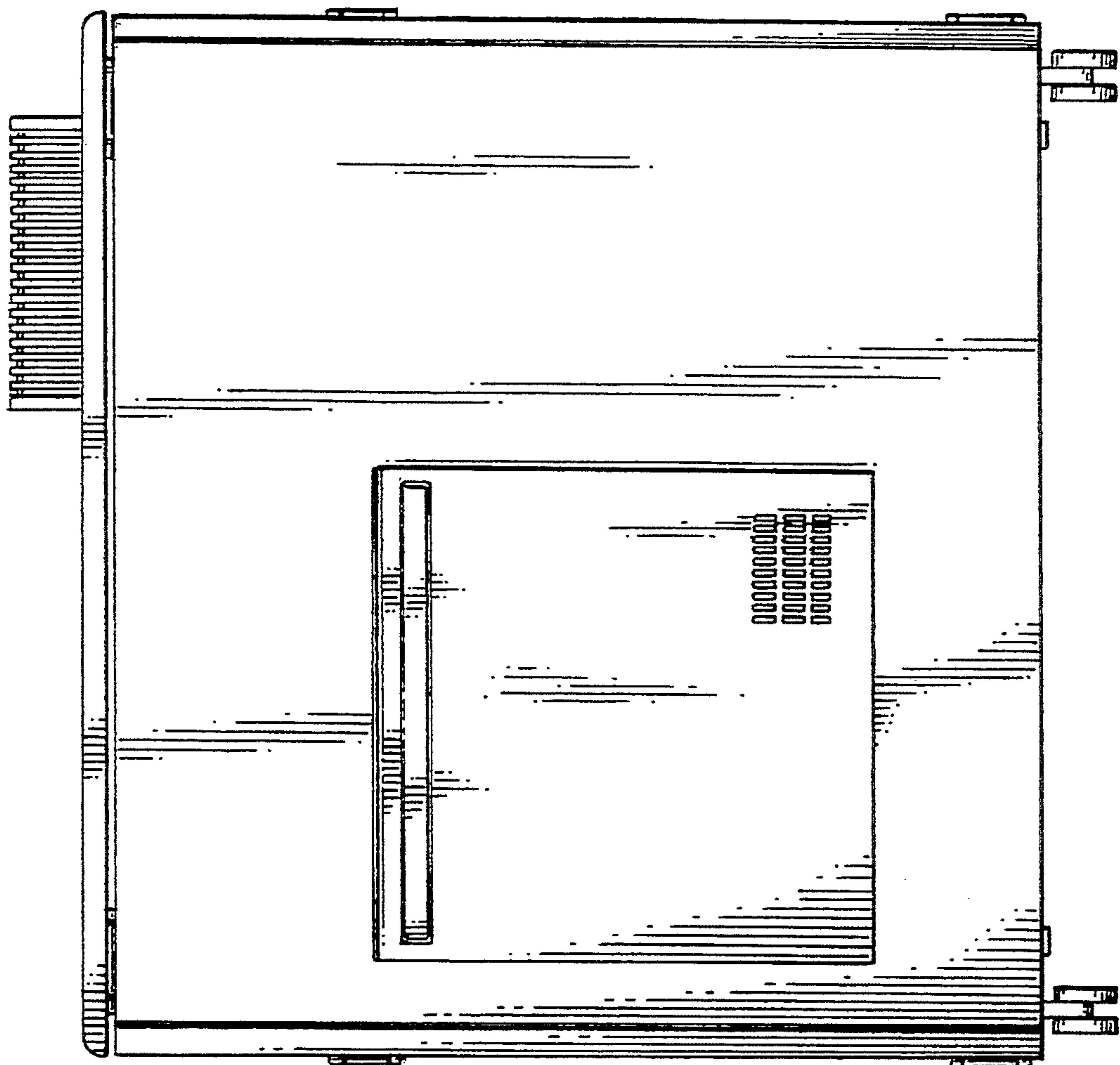

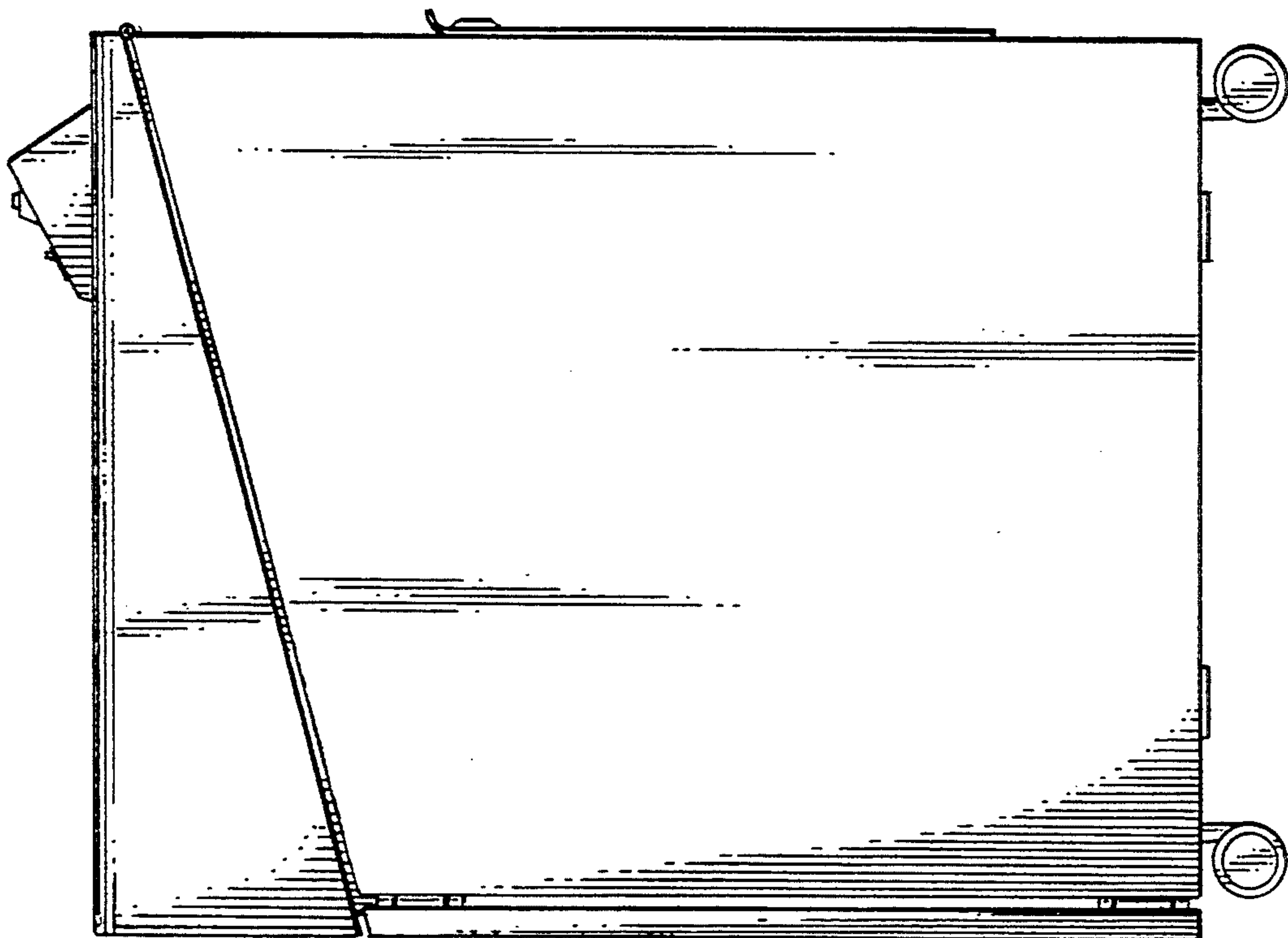

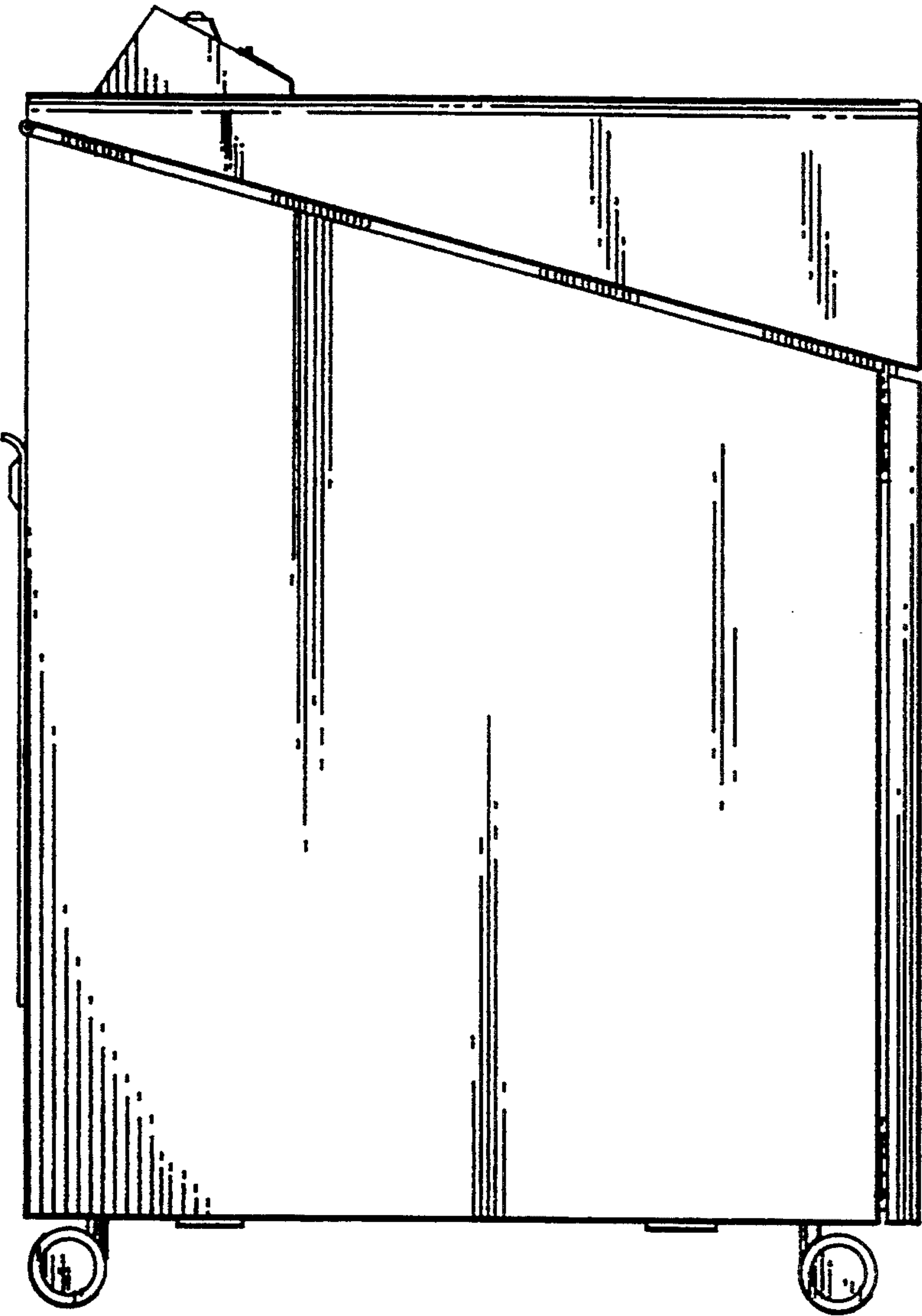

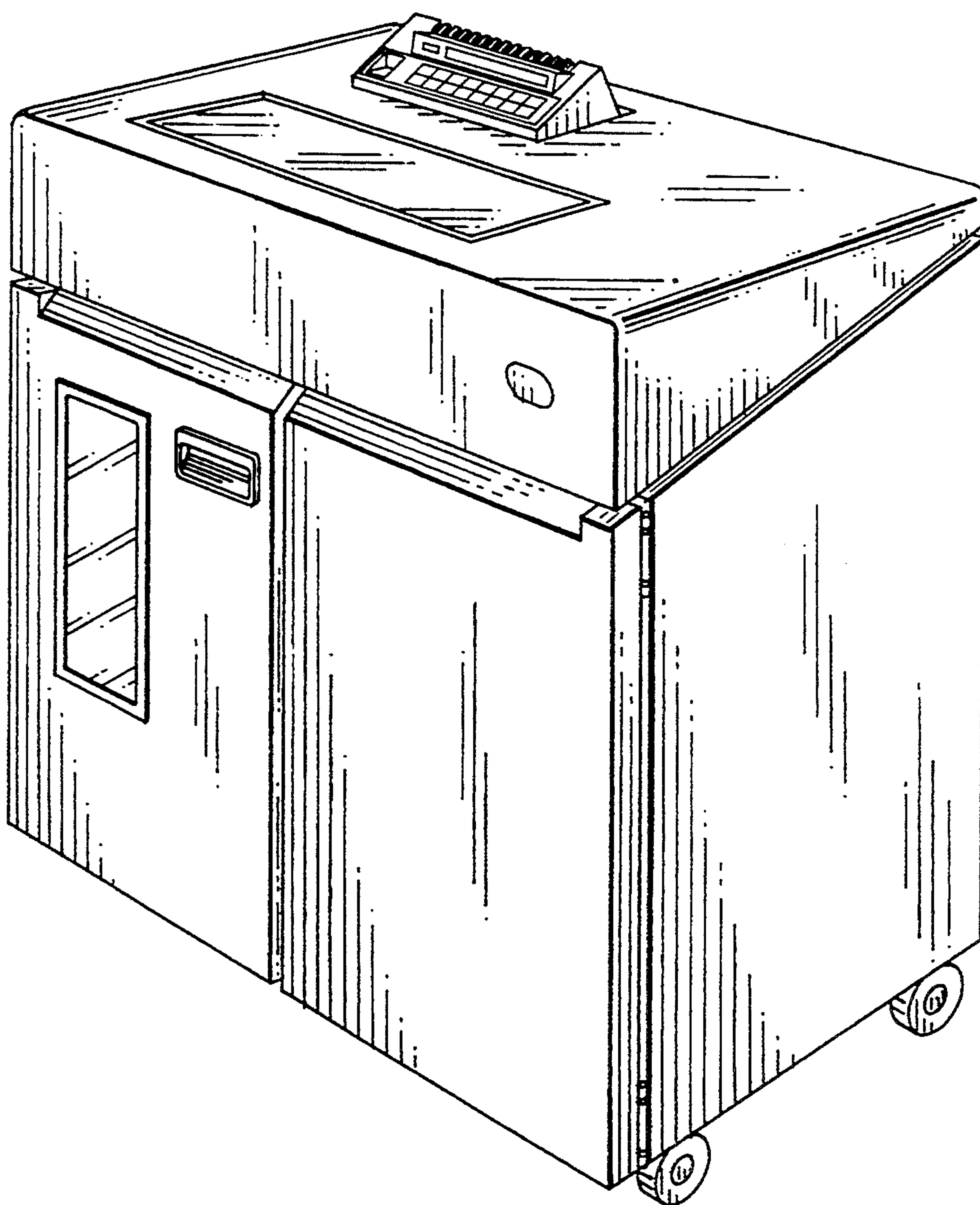

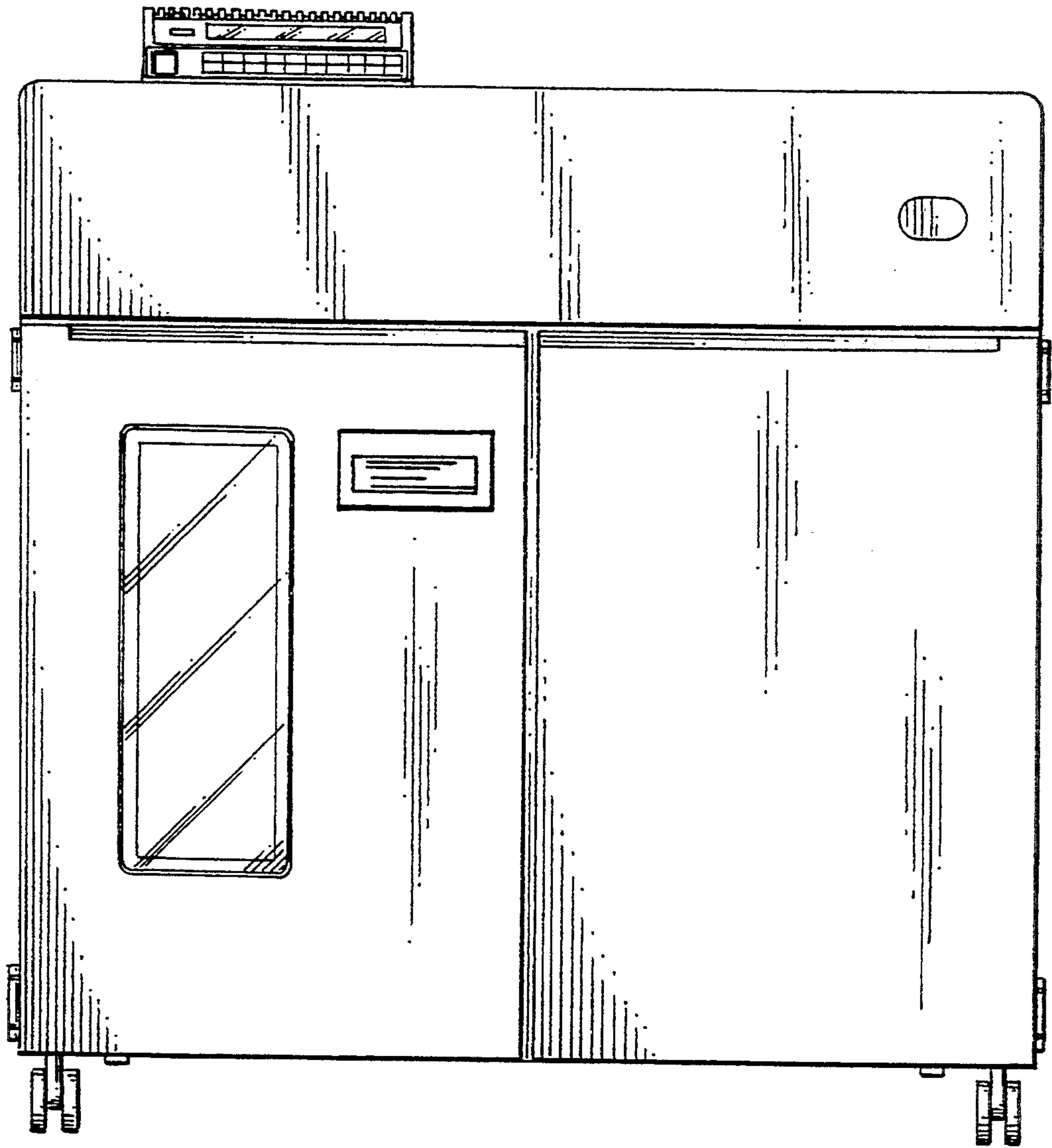

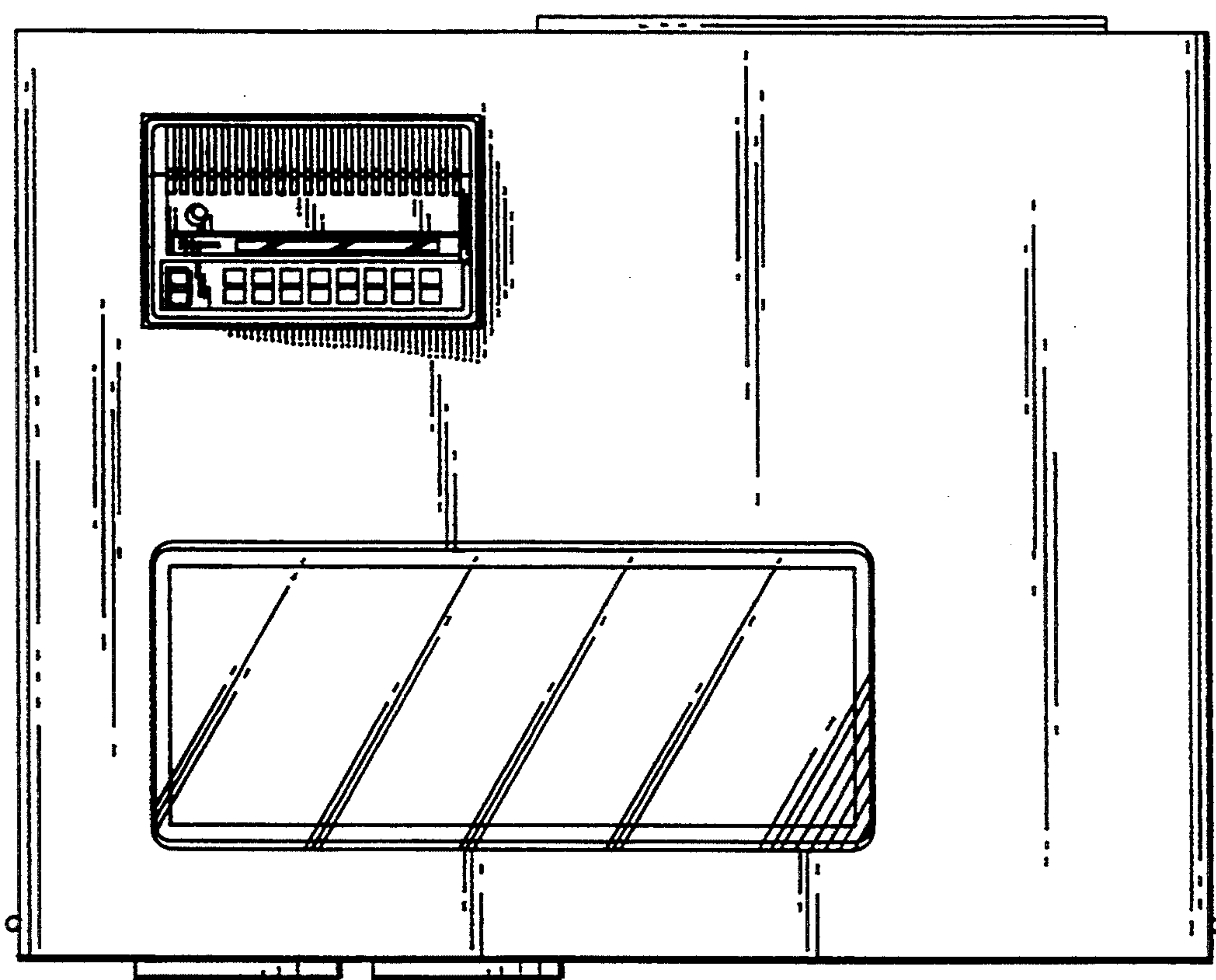

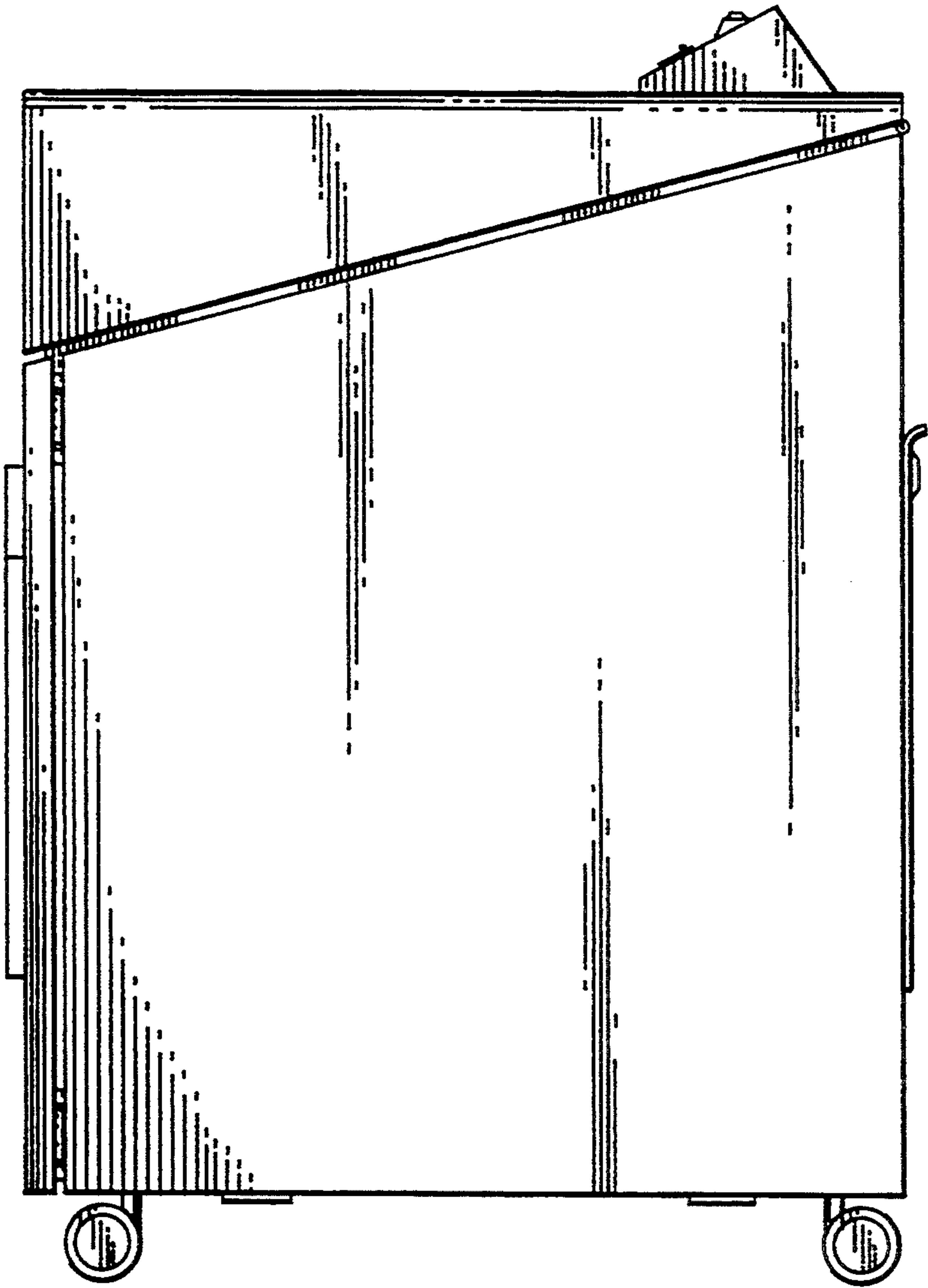

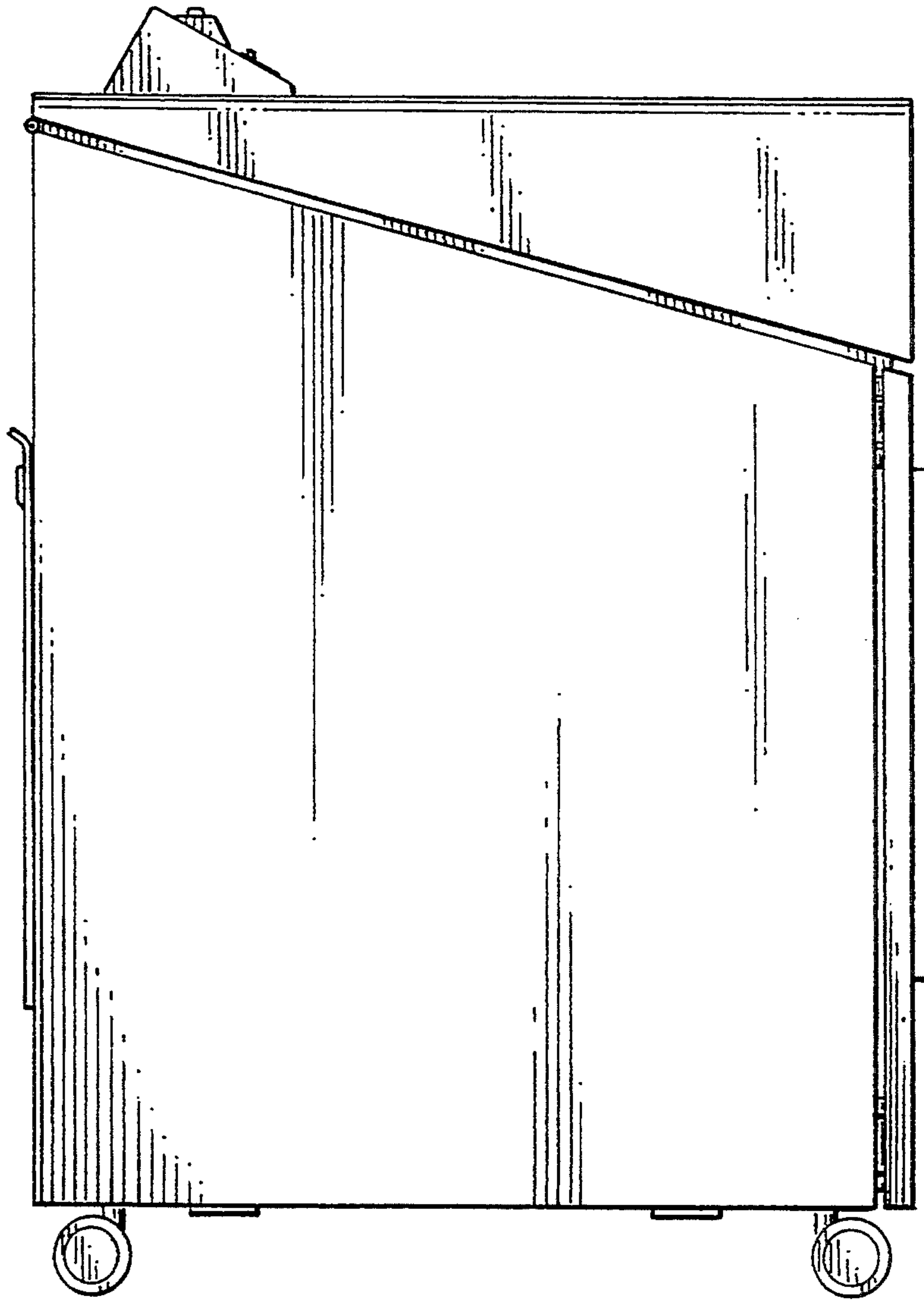

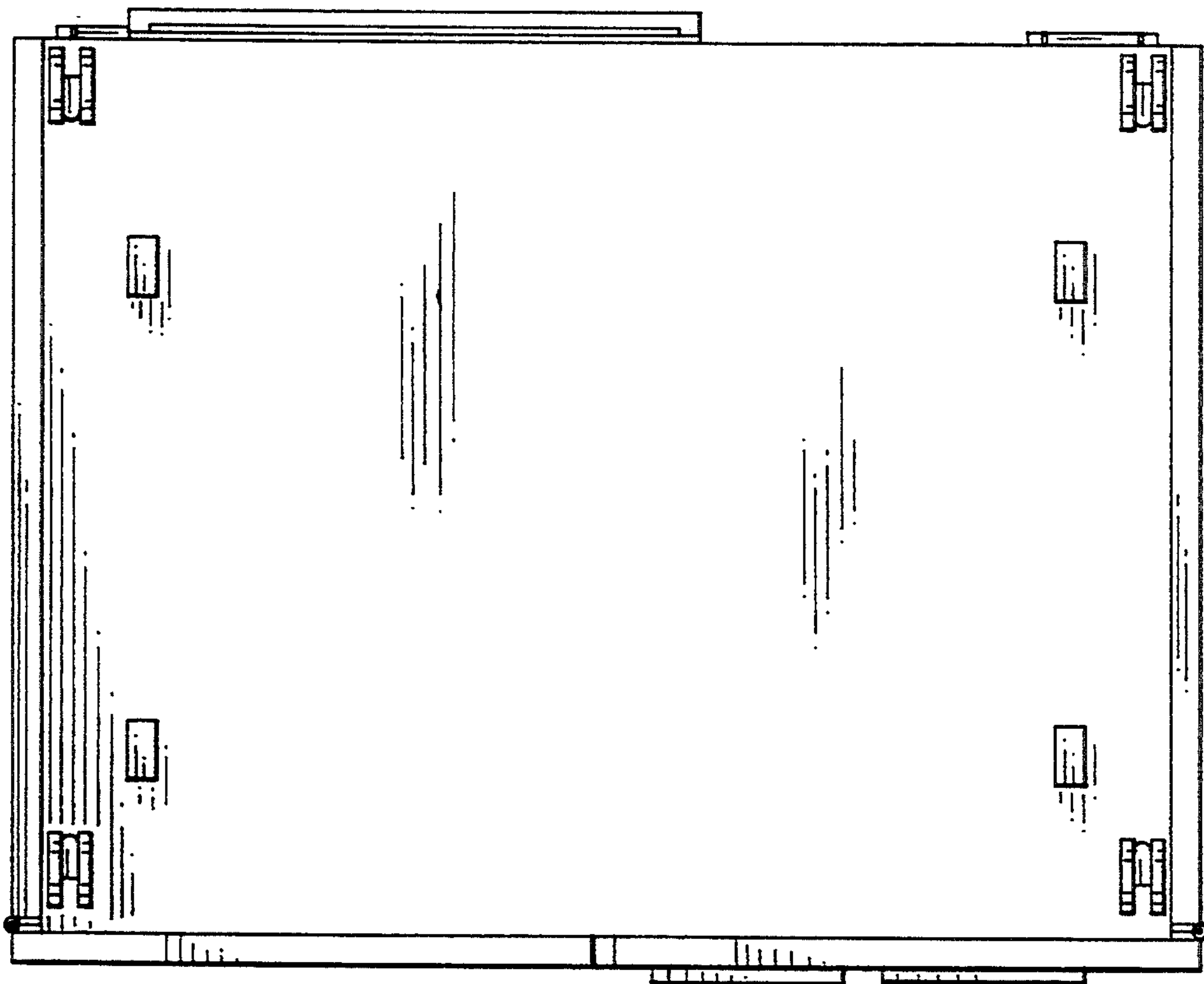

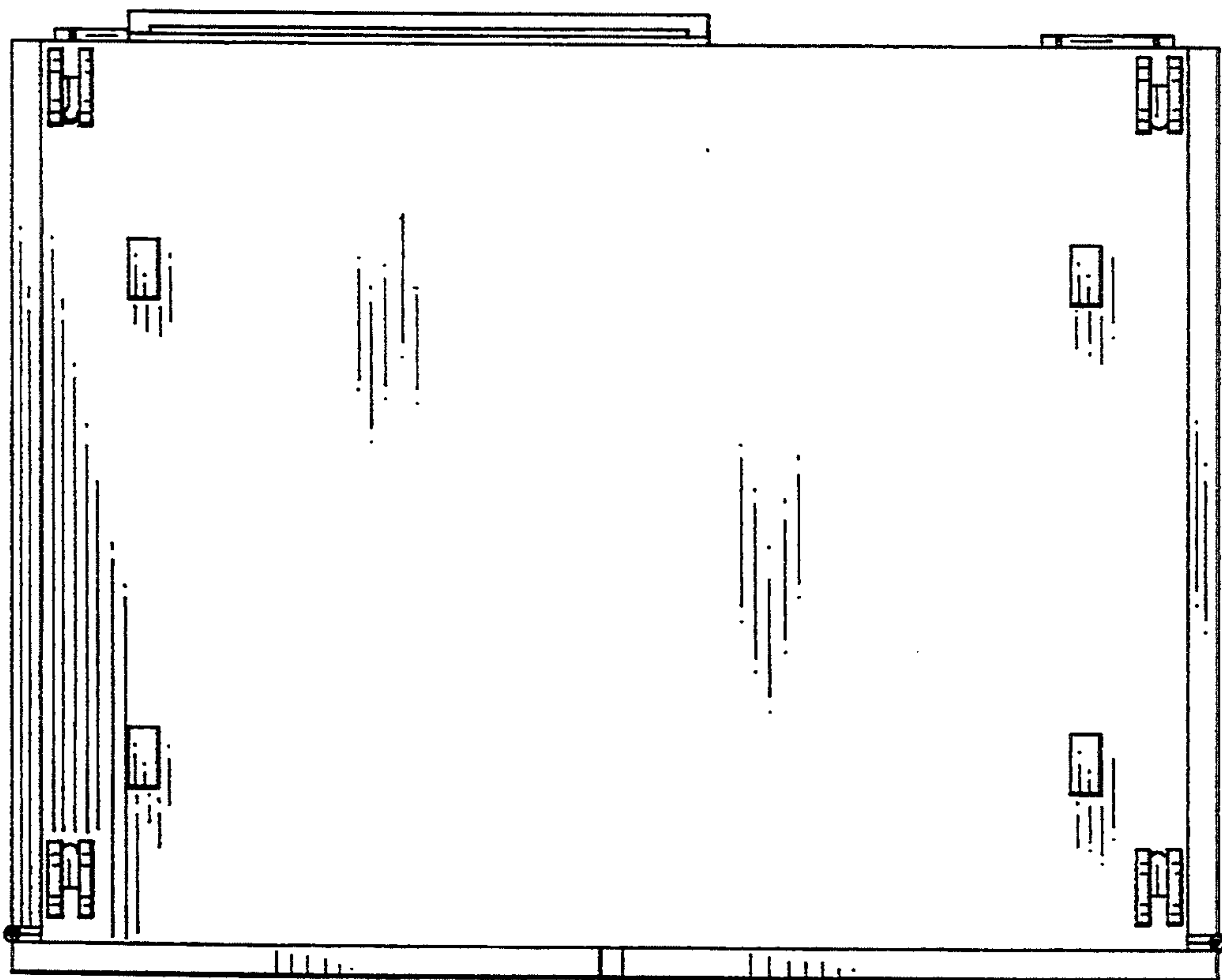
