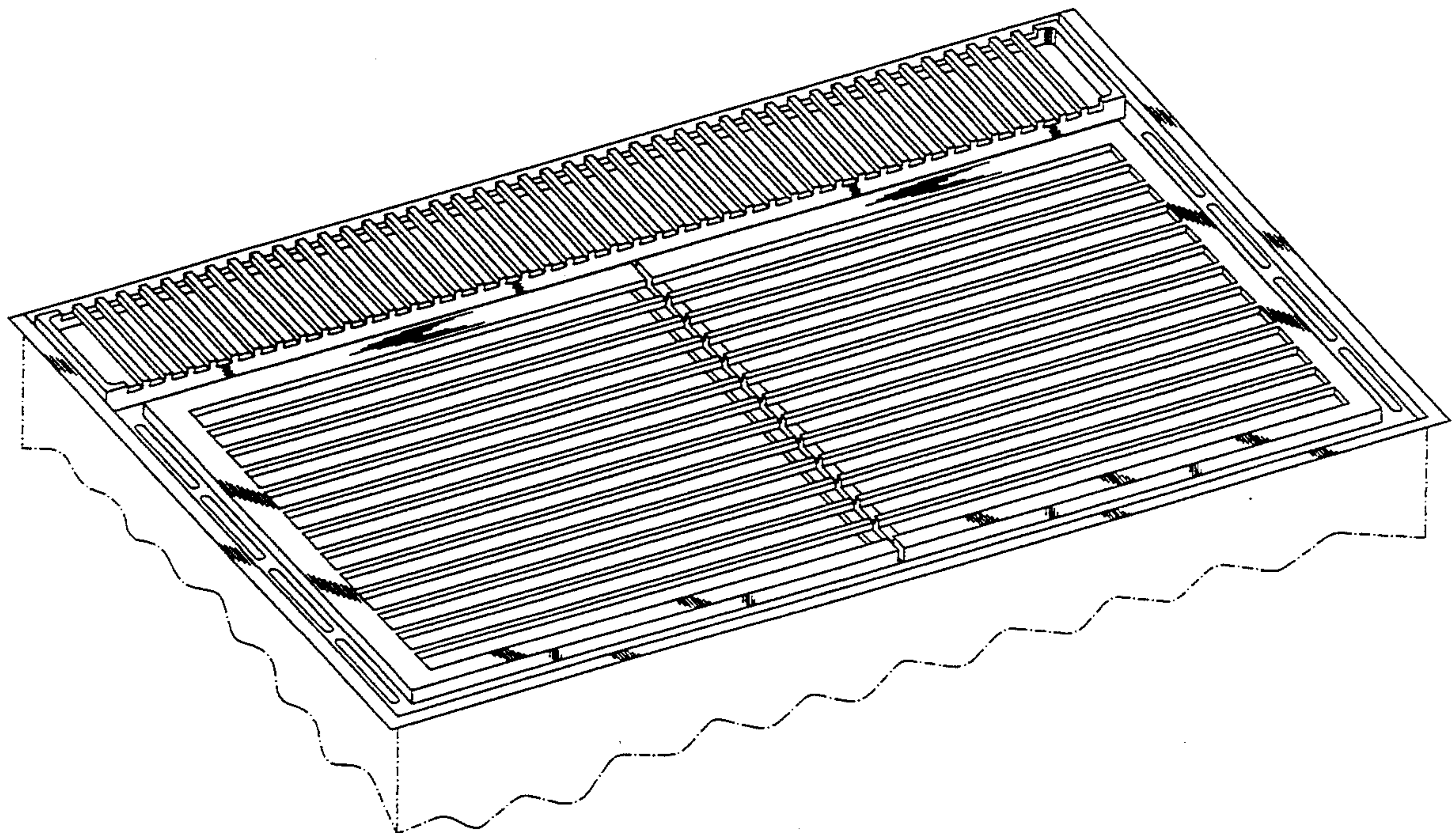
The ornamental design for a stove top, as shown and described.

FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof, the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.



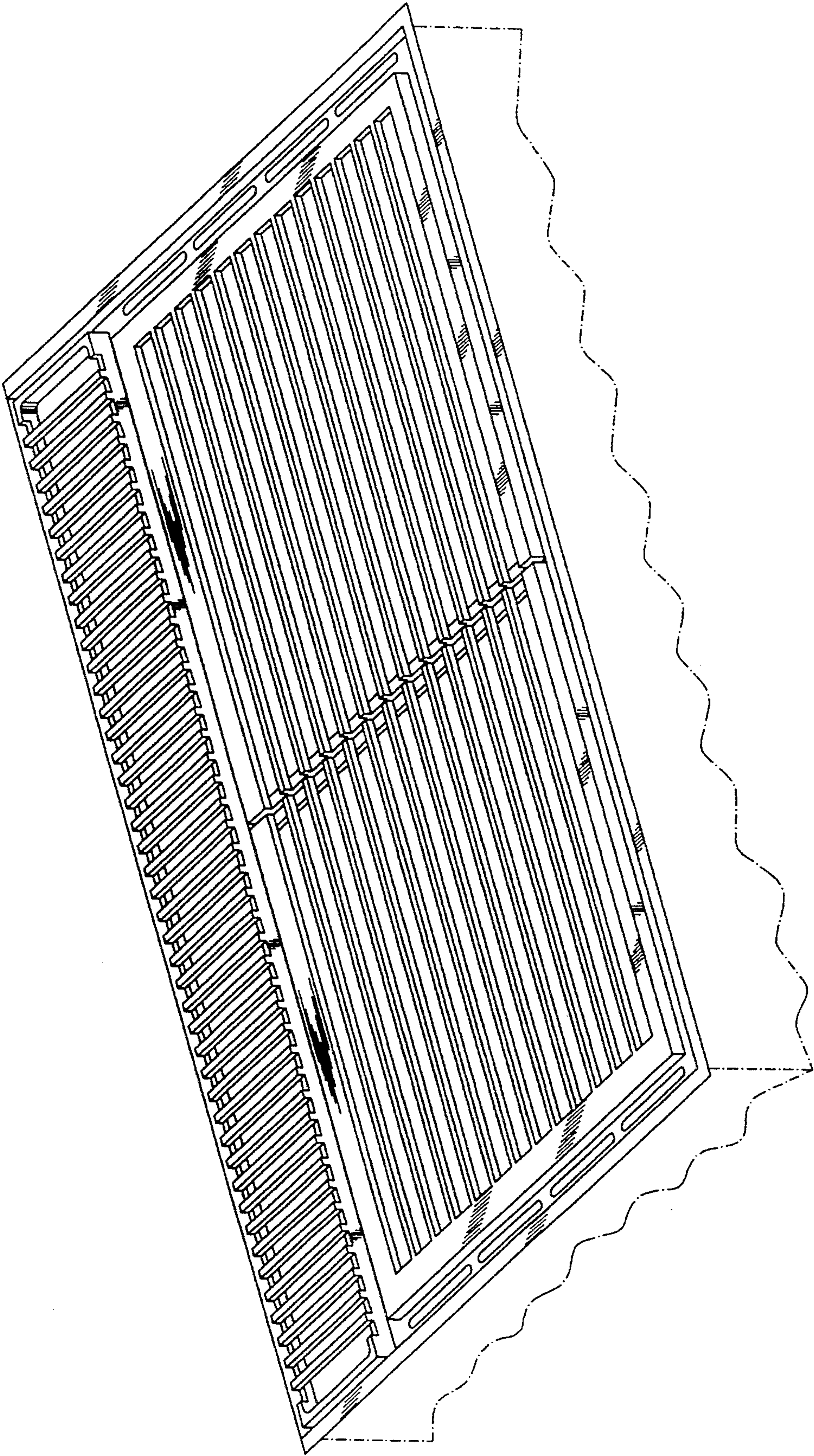

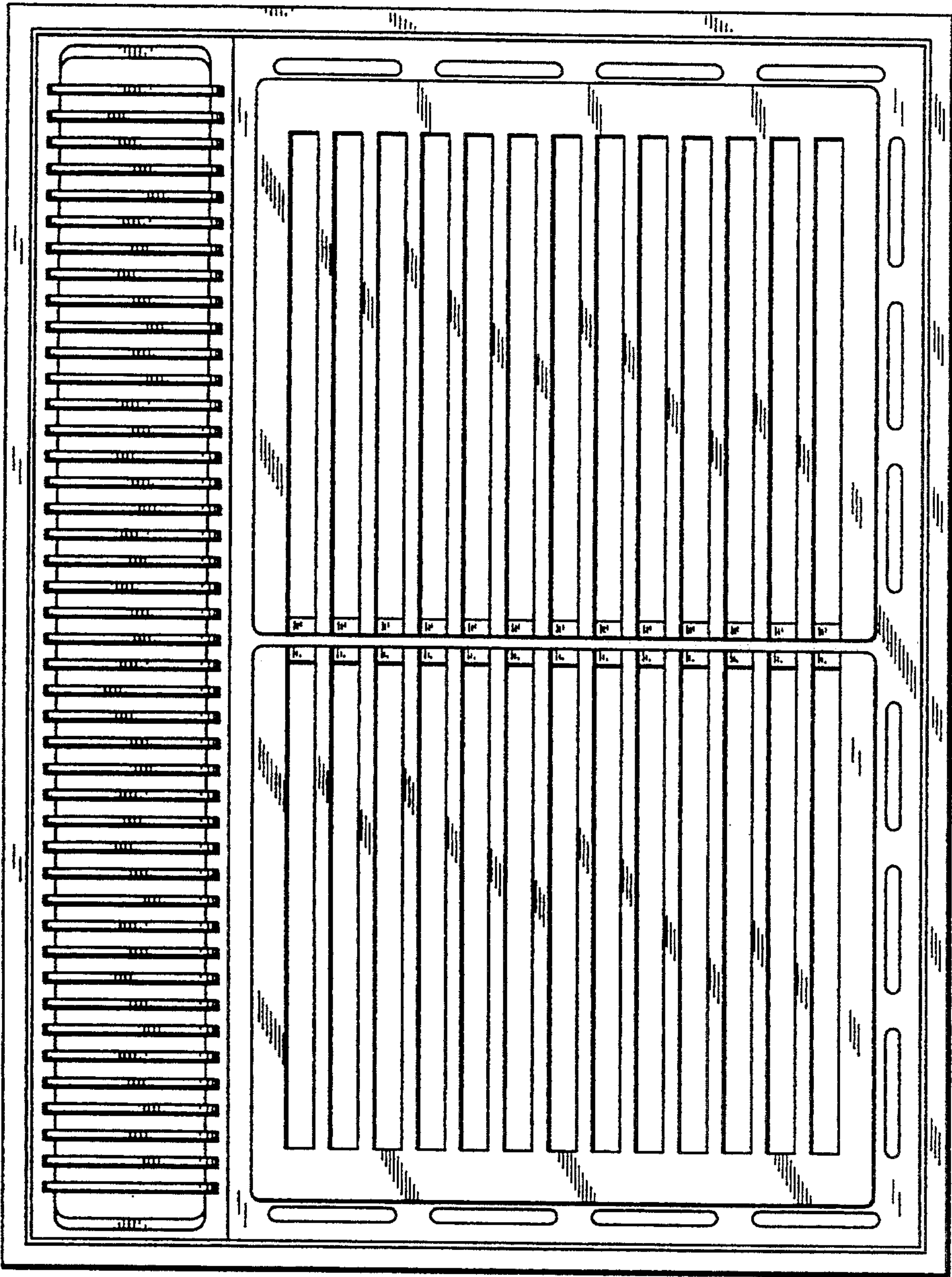

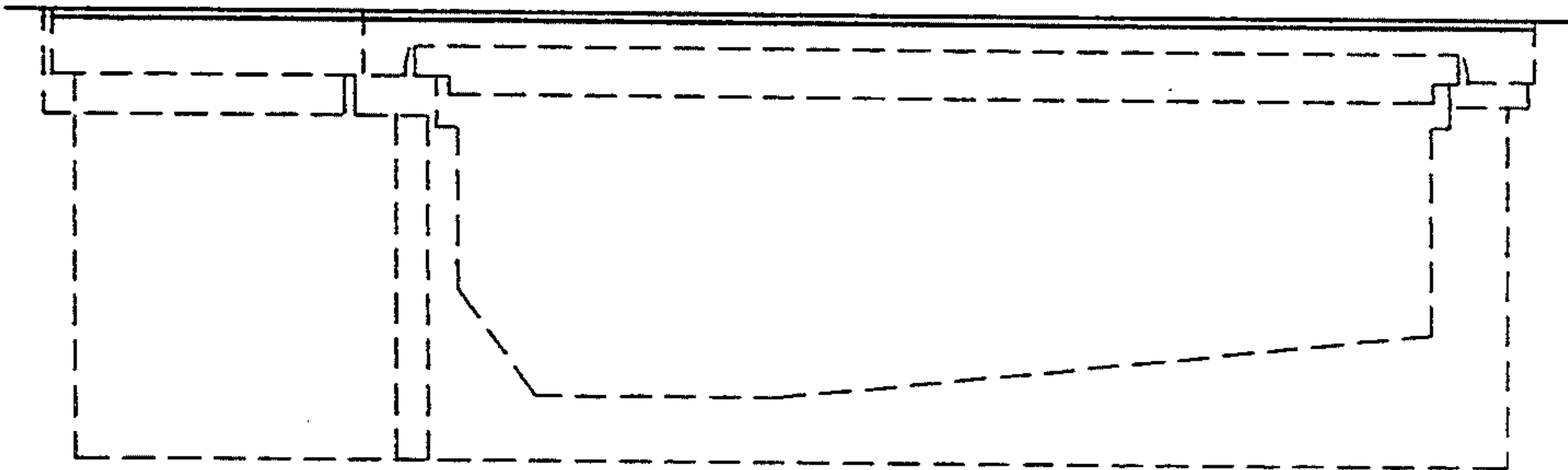
