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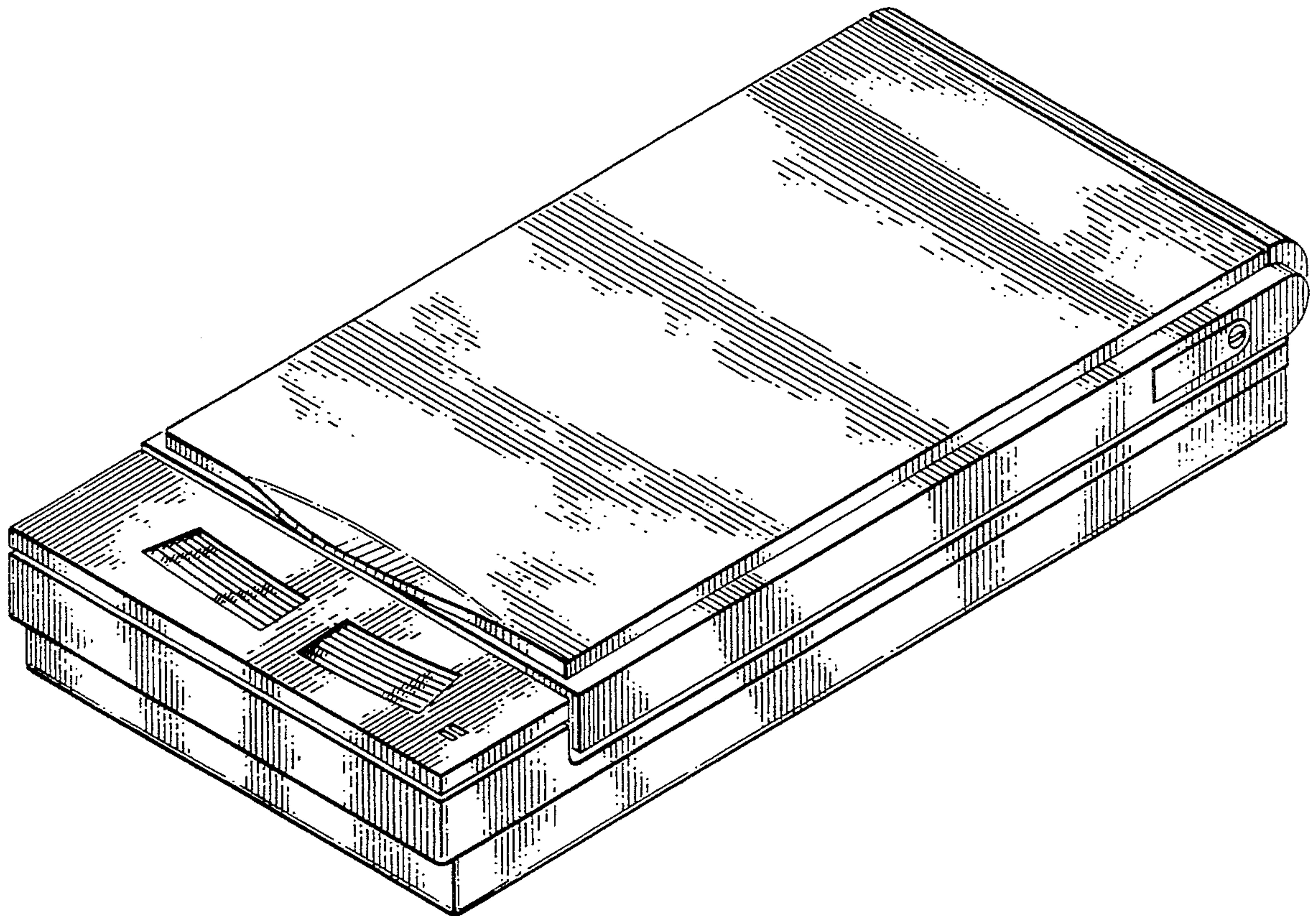
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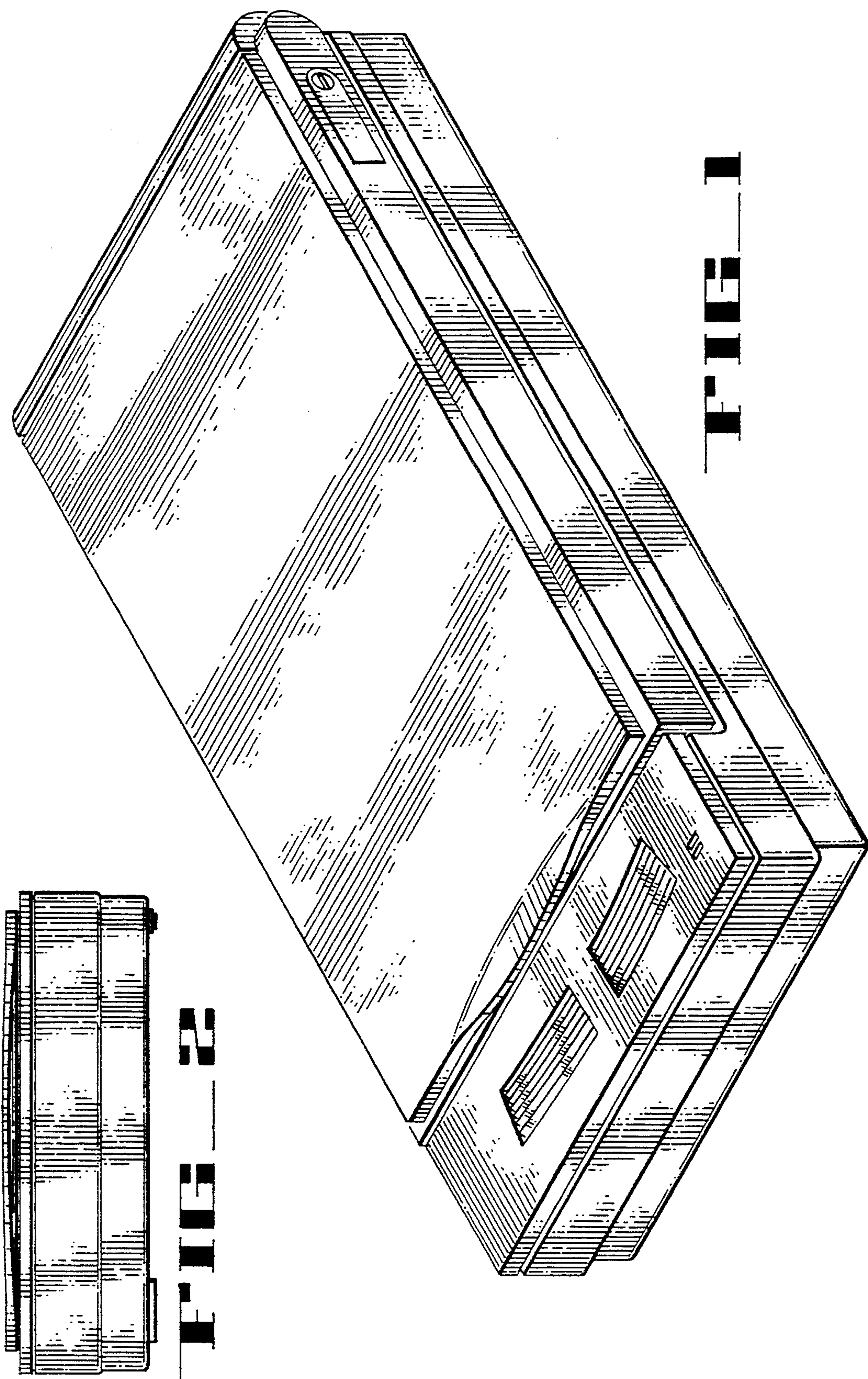
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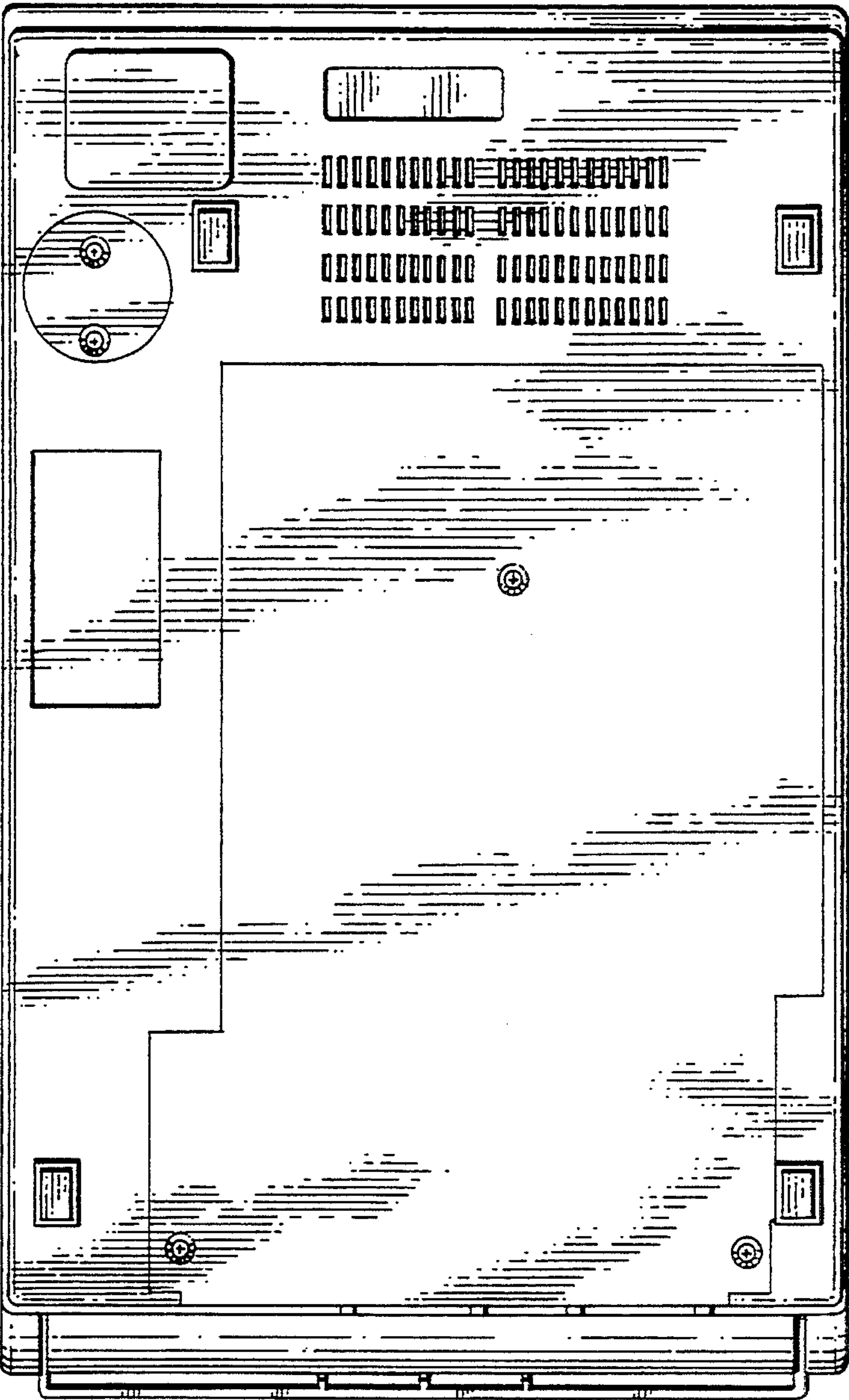
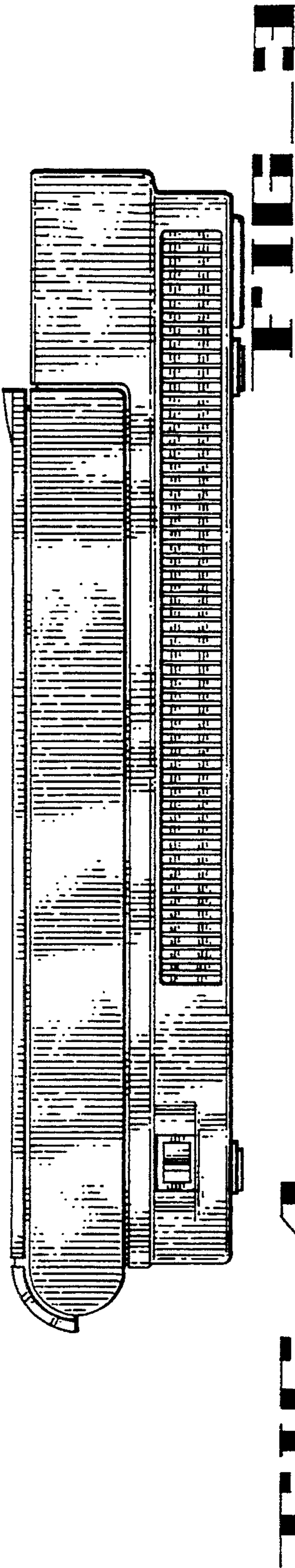
The ornamental design of the document scanner, as shown and described.

FIG. 7 is an enlarged rear view thereof.







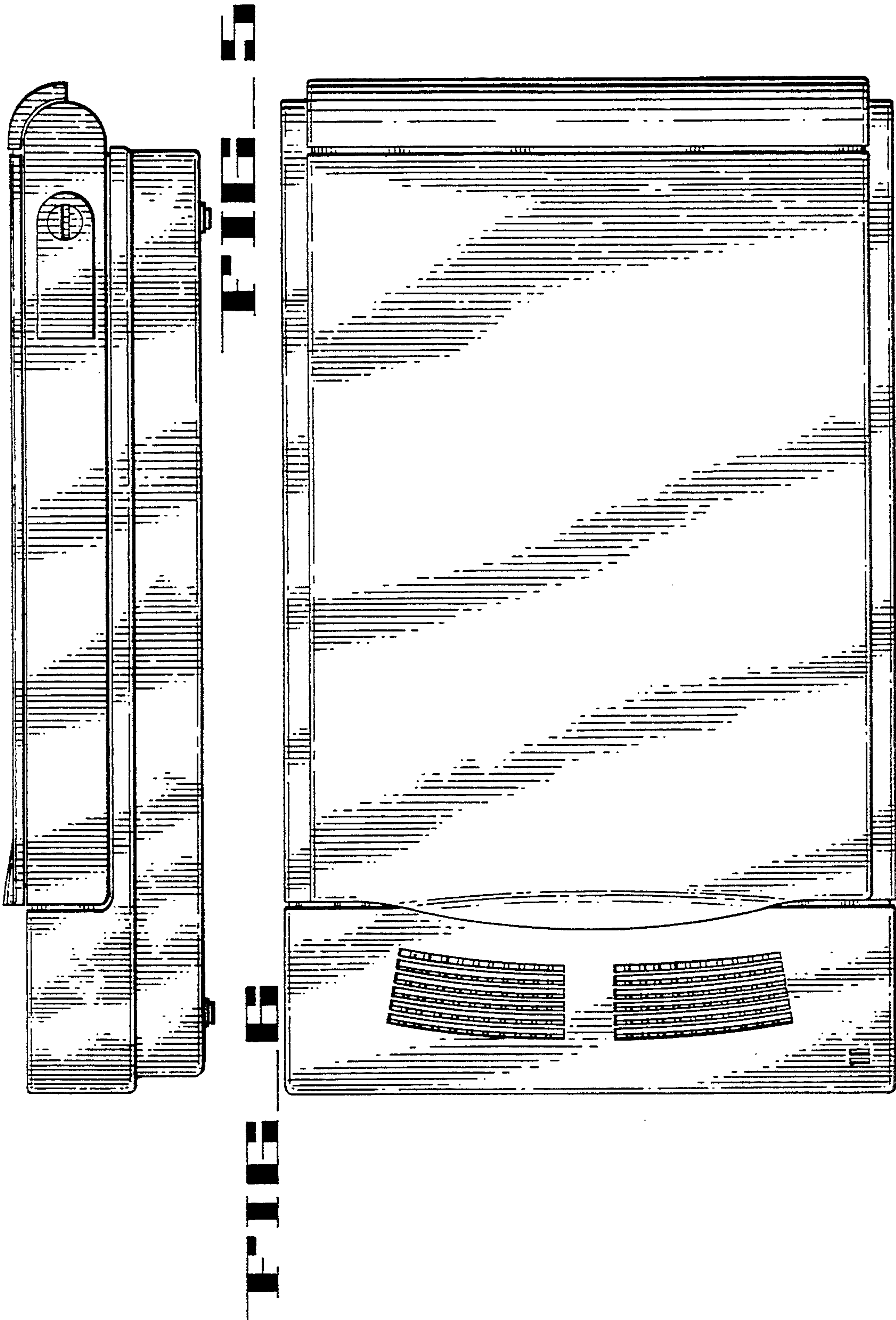
