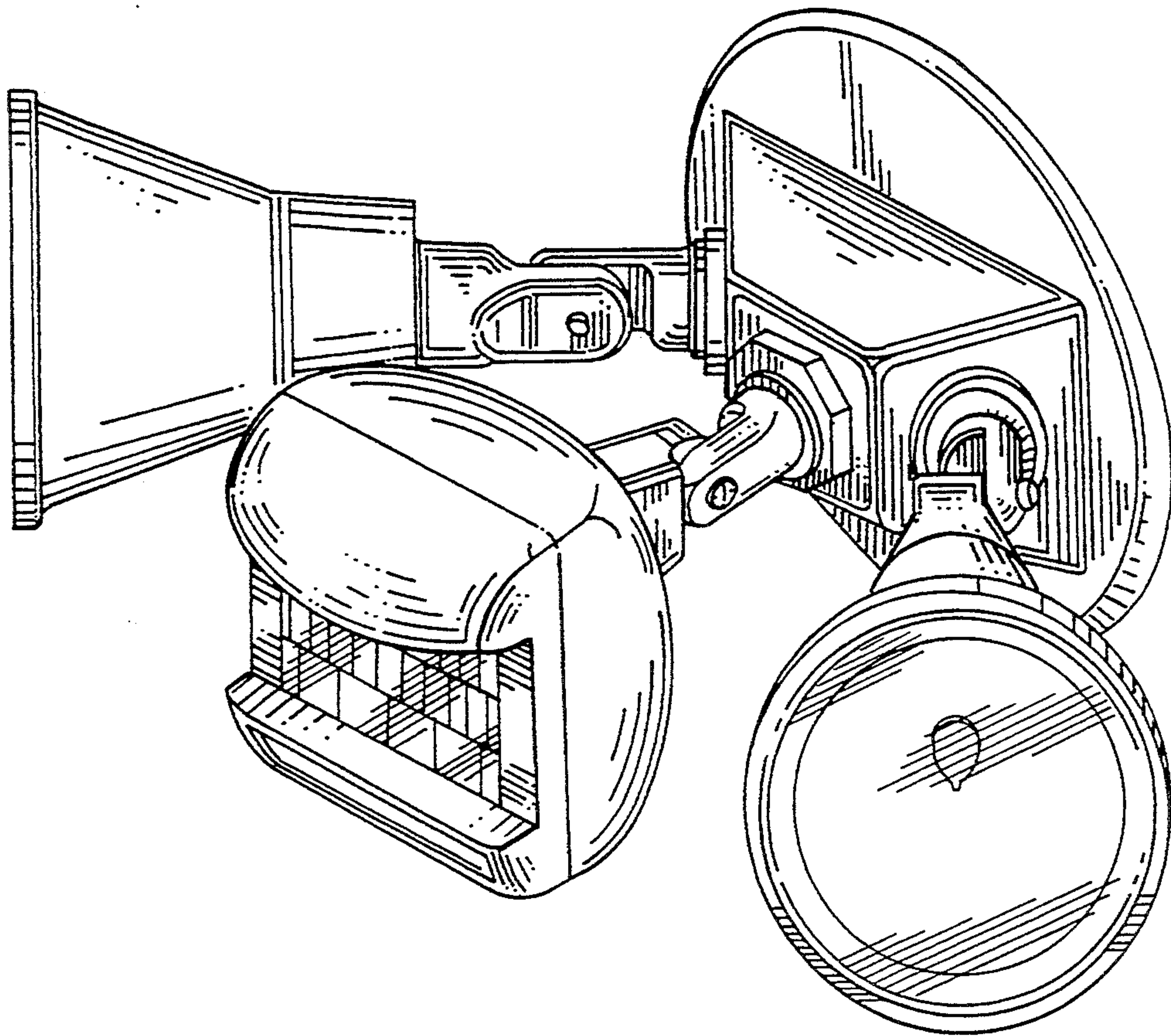

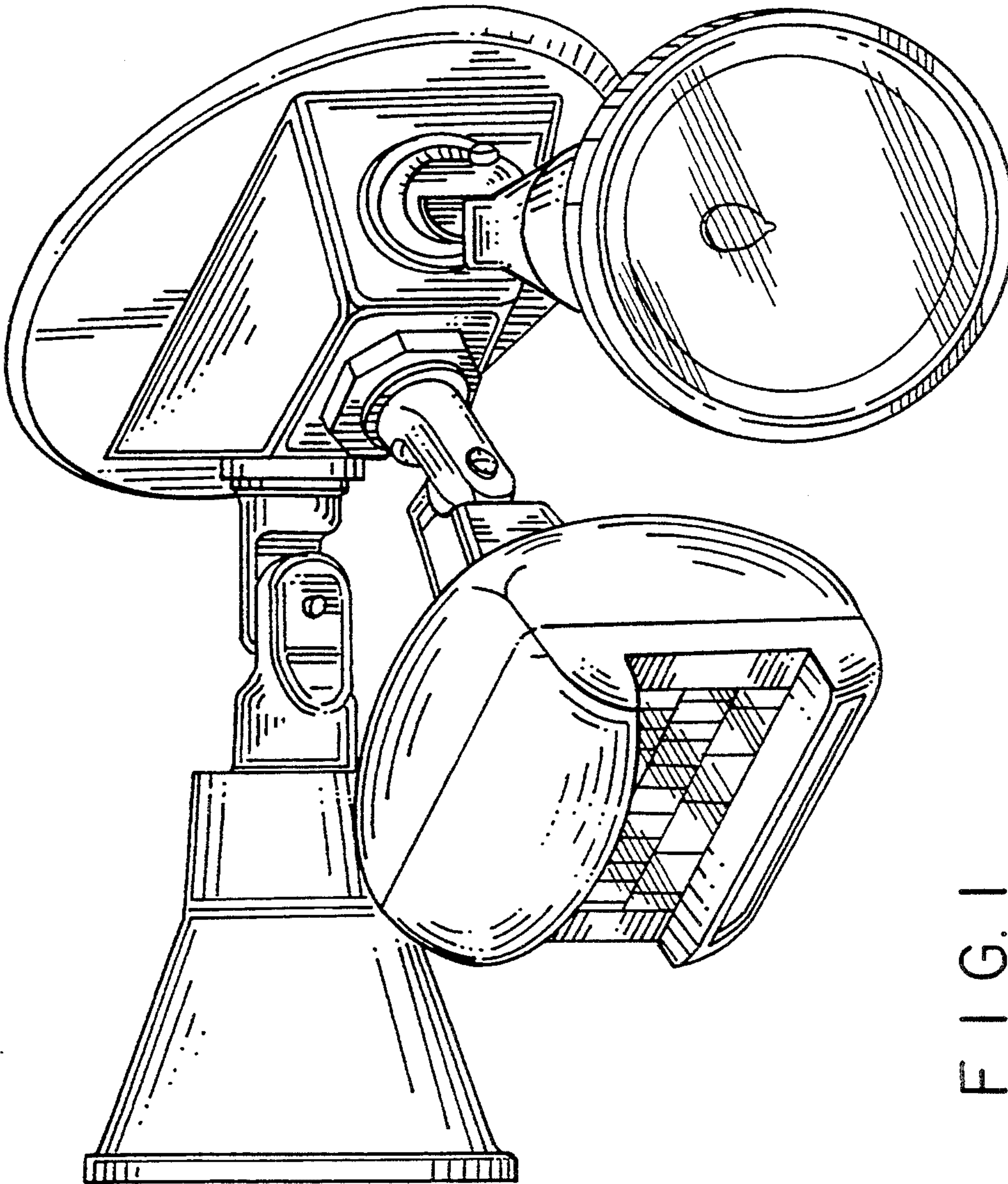
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of the assembly of FIG. 2.

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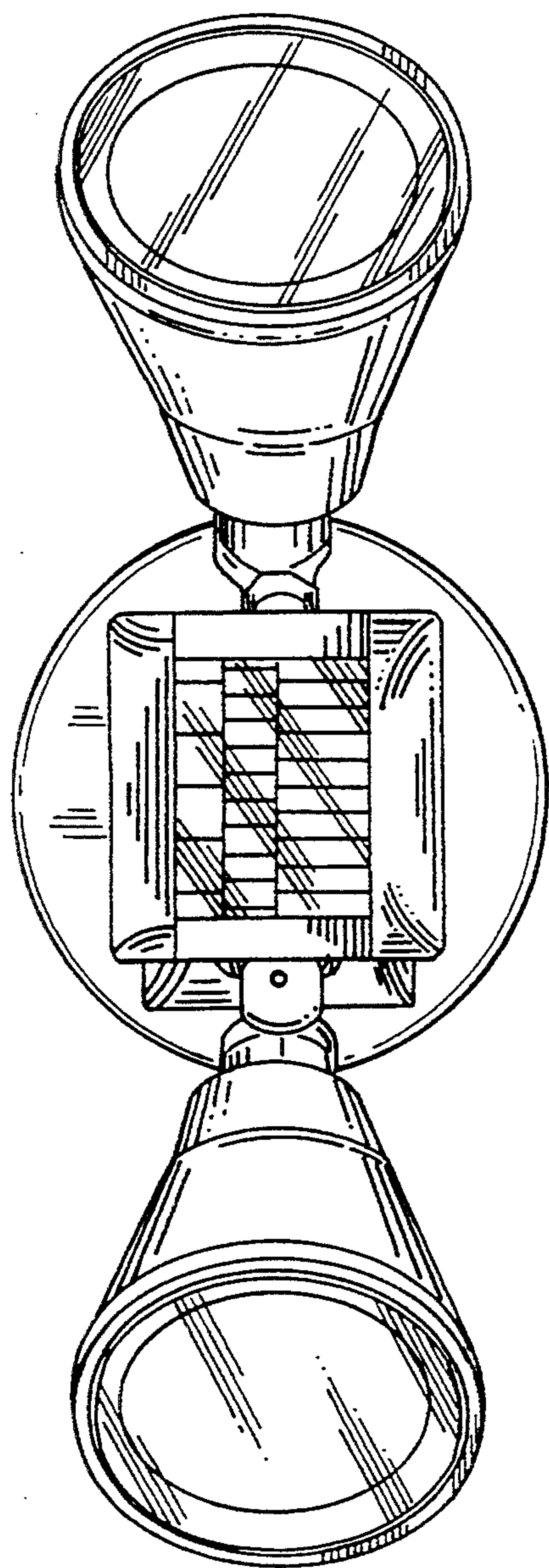

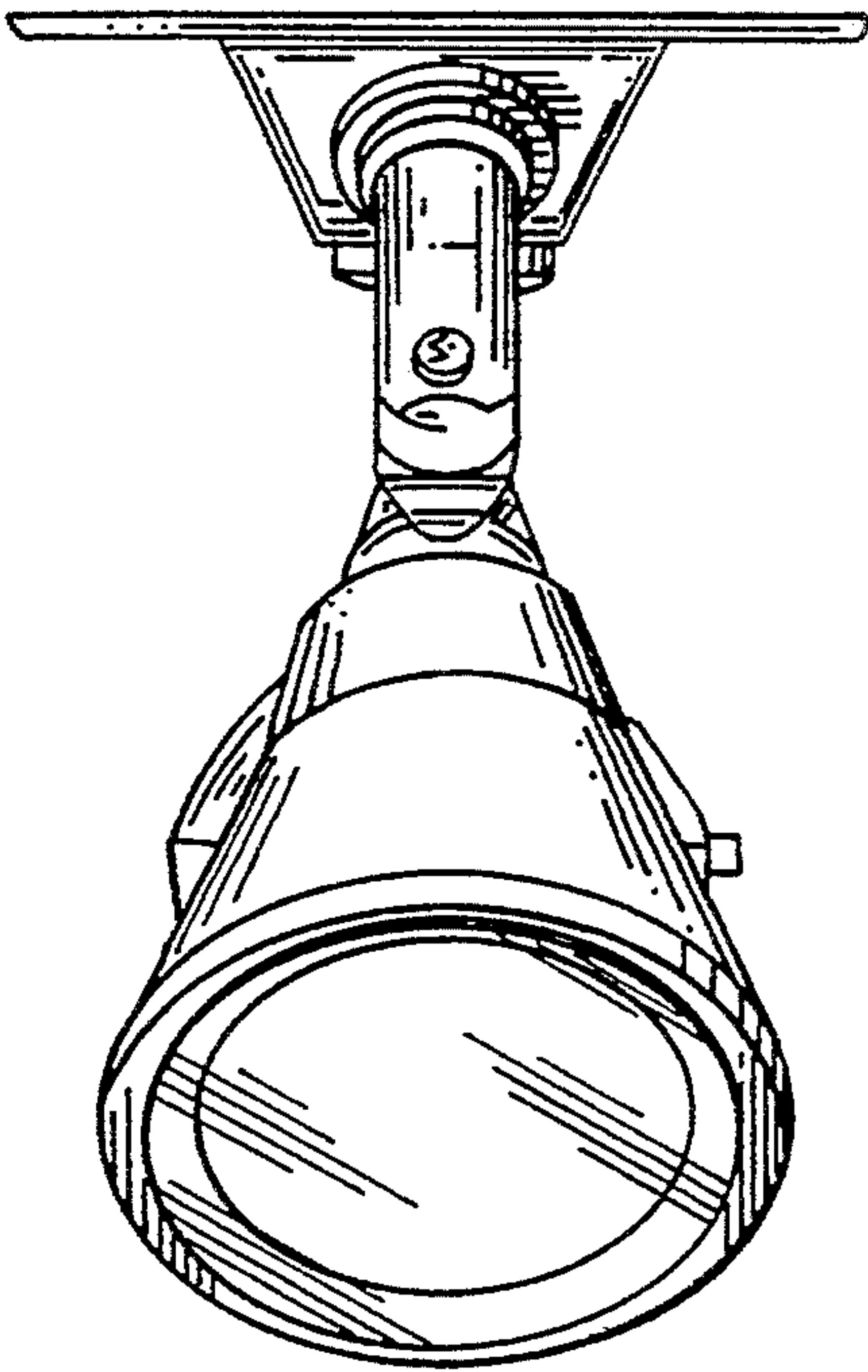

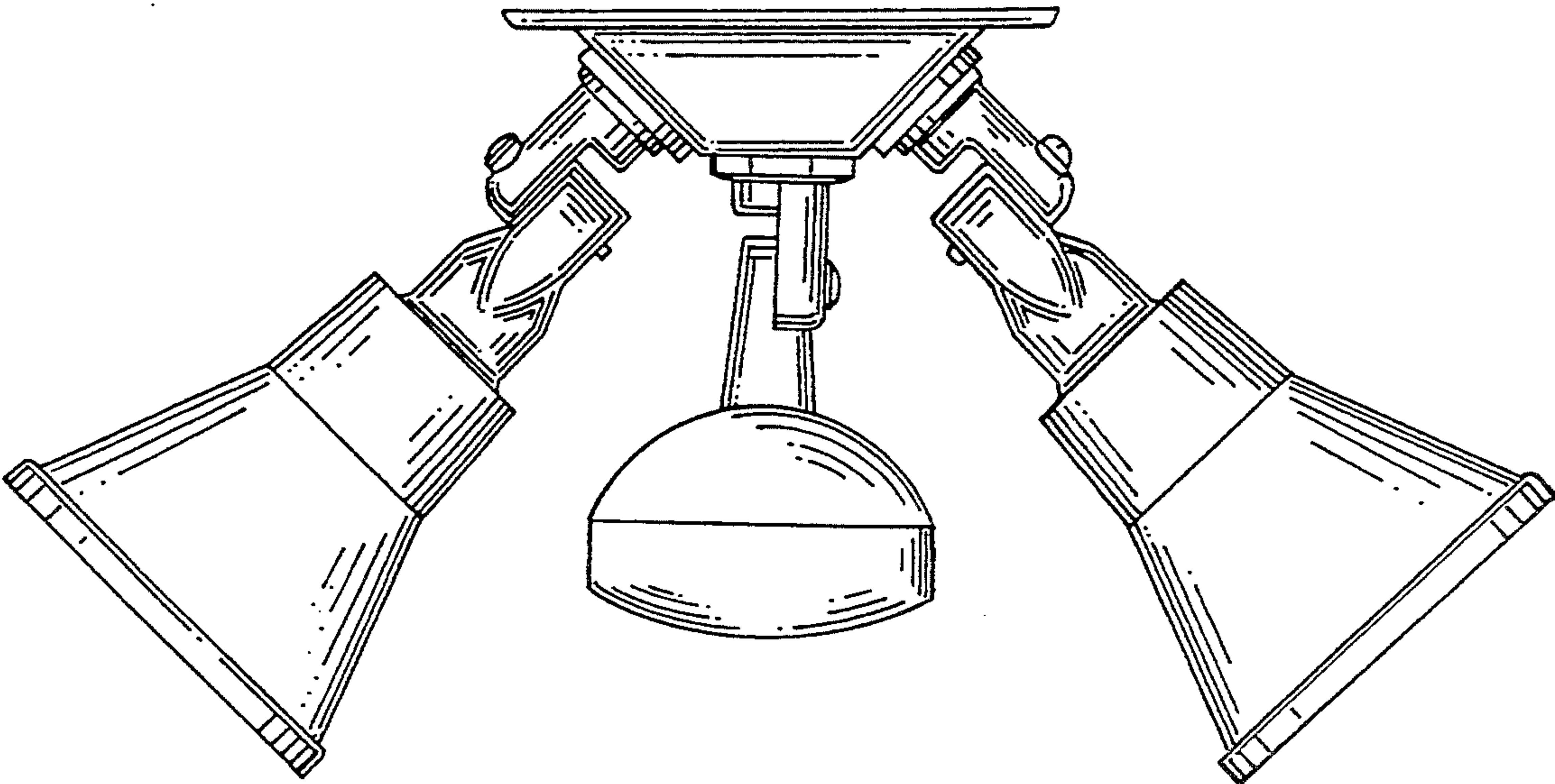

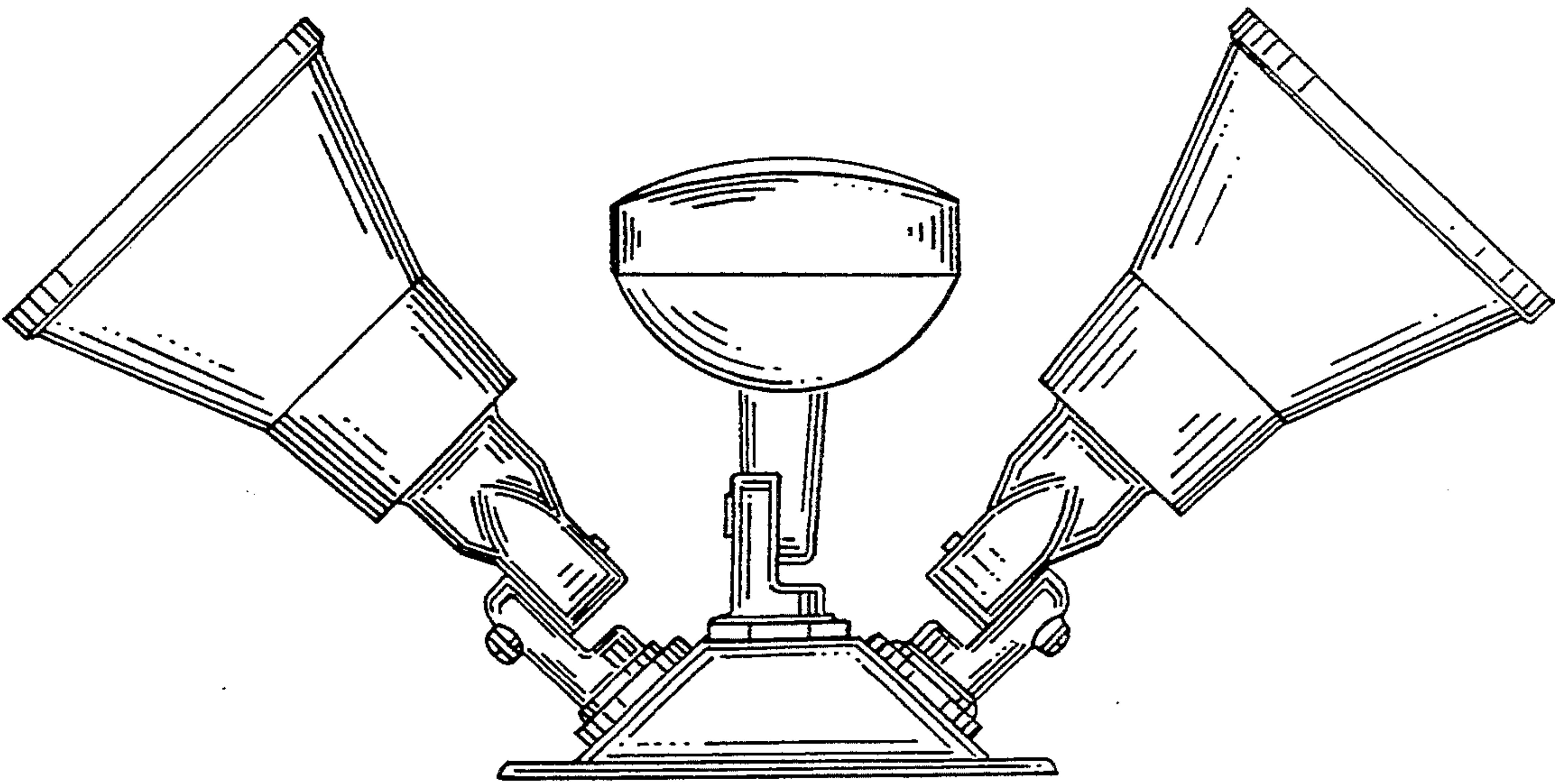
