The broken line showing of a tear gas canister in FIG. 2 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

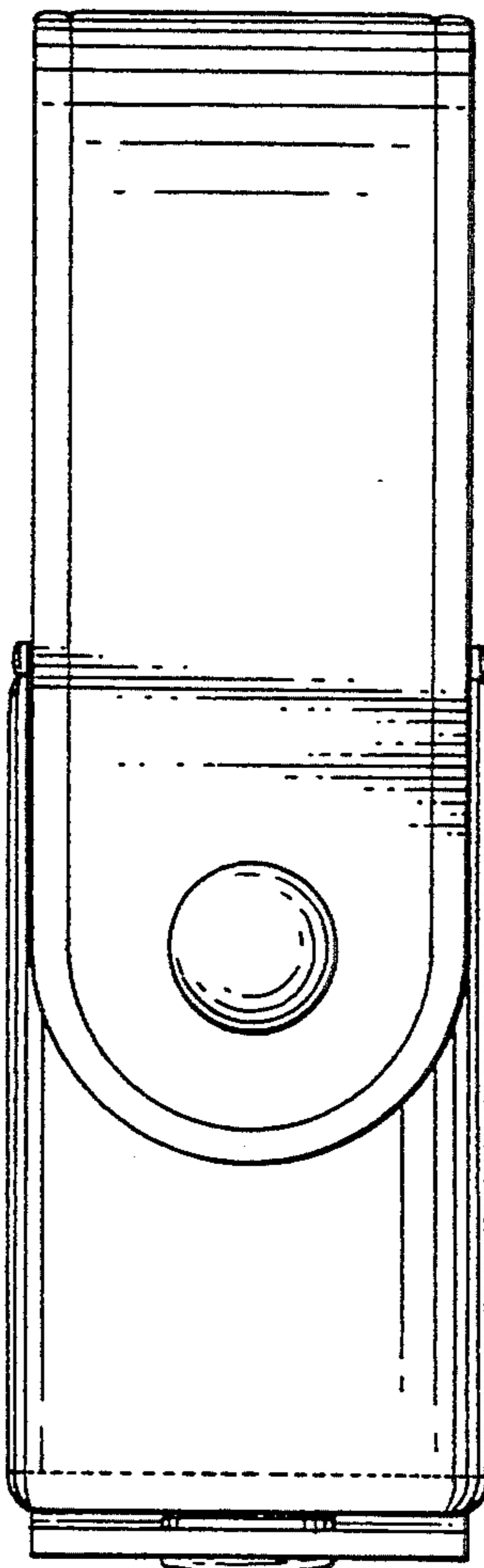

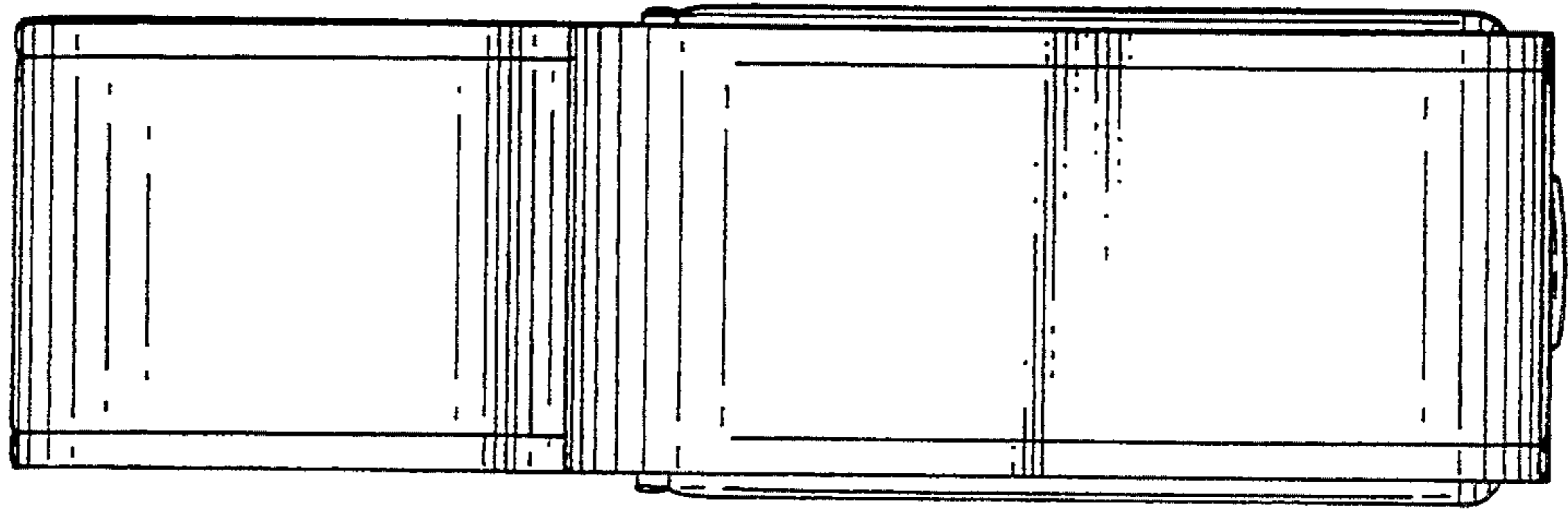

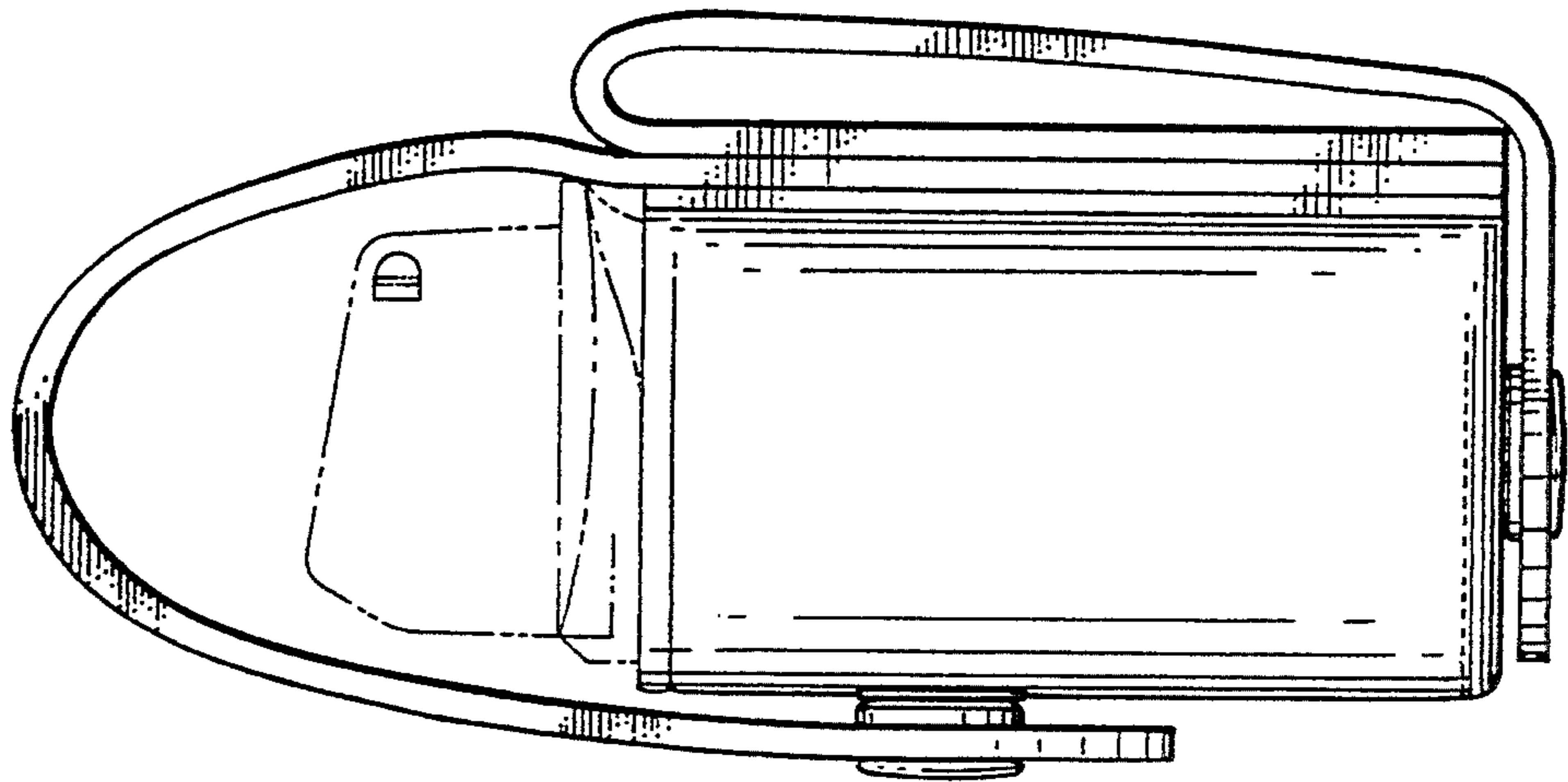

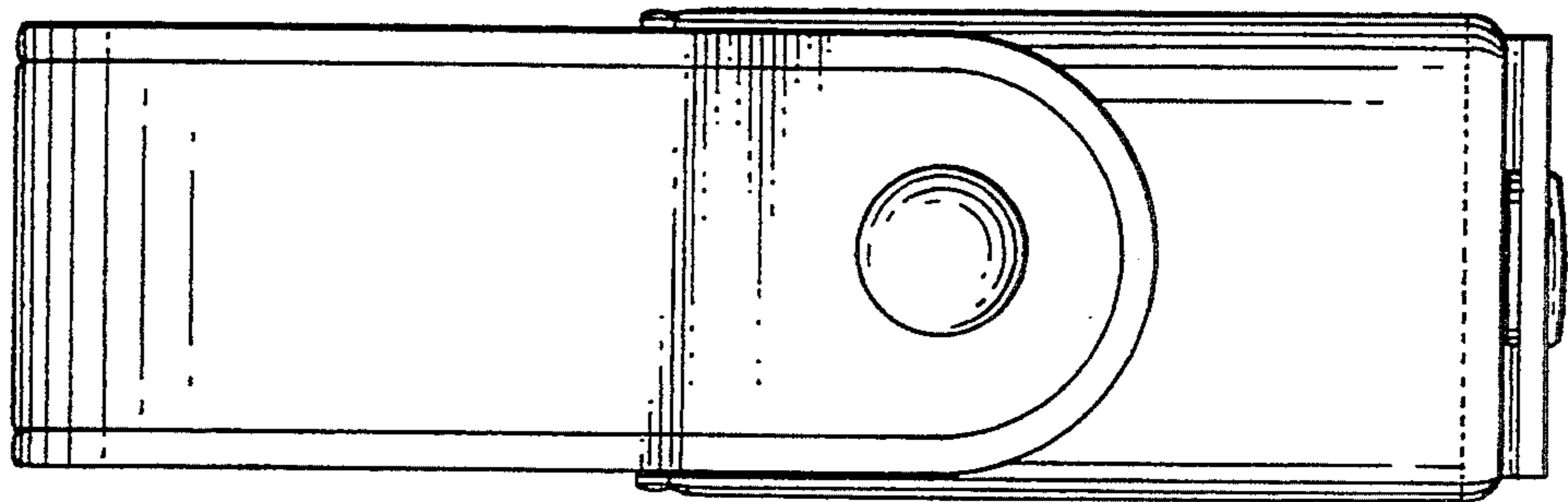

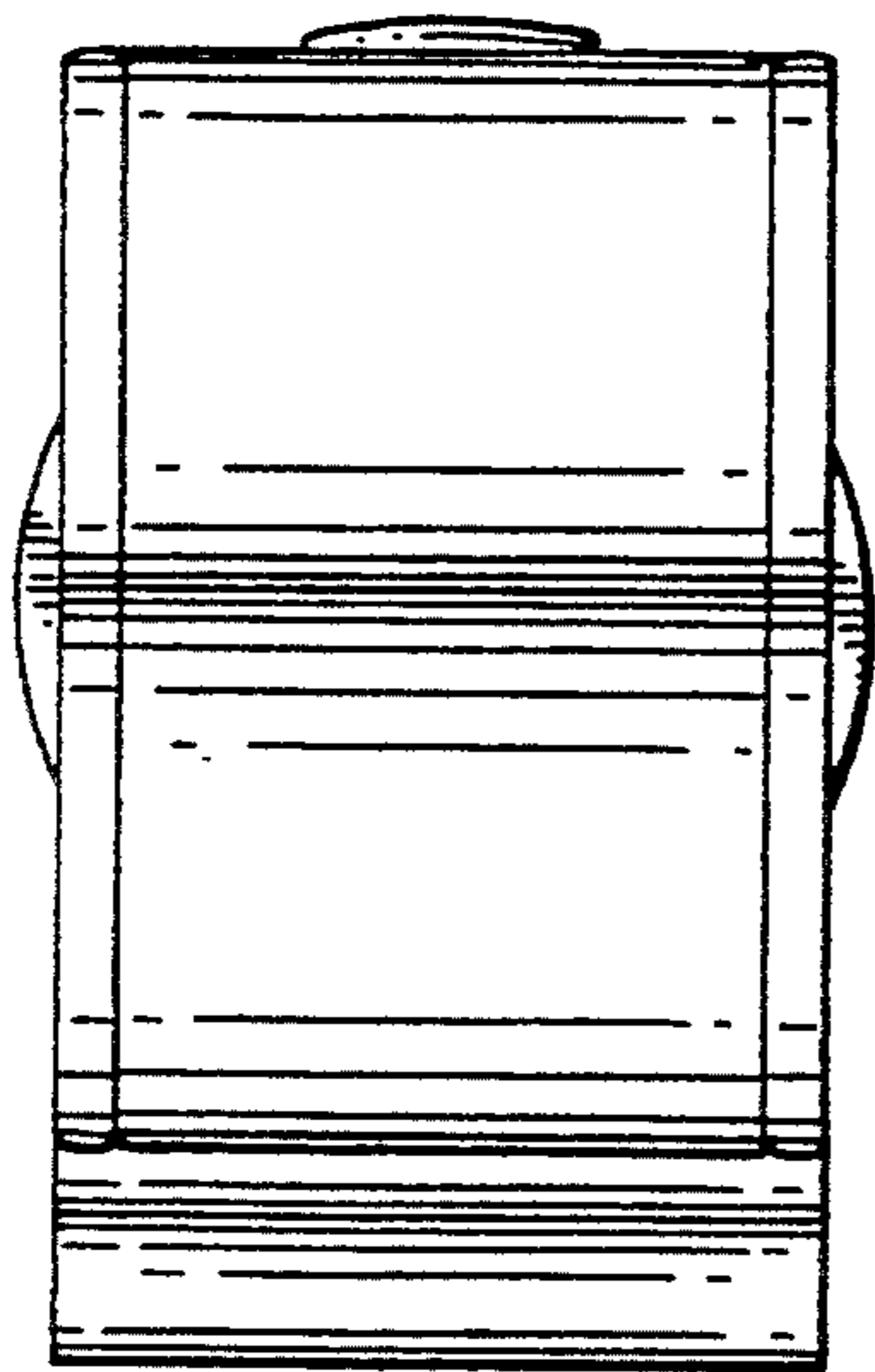
