[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the bottle; FIG. 2 is a side elevation of the bottle, the opposite side elevation being the mirror image of FIG. 2; FIG. 3 is a vertical cross-section through the bottle; FIG. 4 is a front elevation of the bottle; FIG. 5 is a rear elevation of the bottle; FIG. 6 is an underside plan view of the bottle; and, FIG. 7 is a plan view of the bottle, the section of FIG. 3 having been taken on the line 3—3 of FIG. 7.

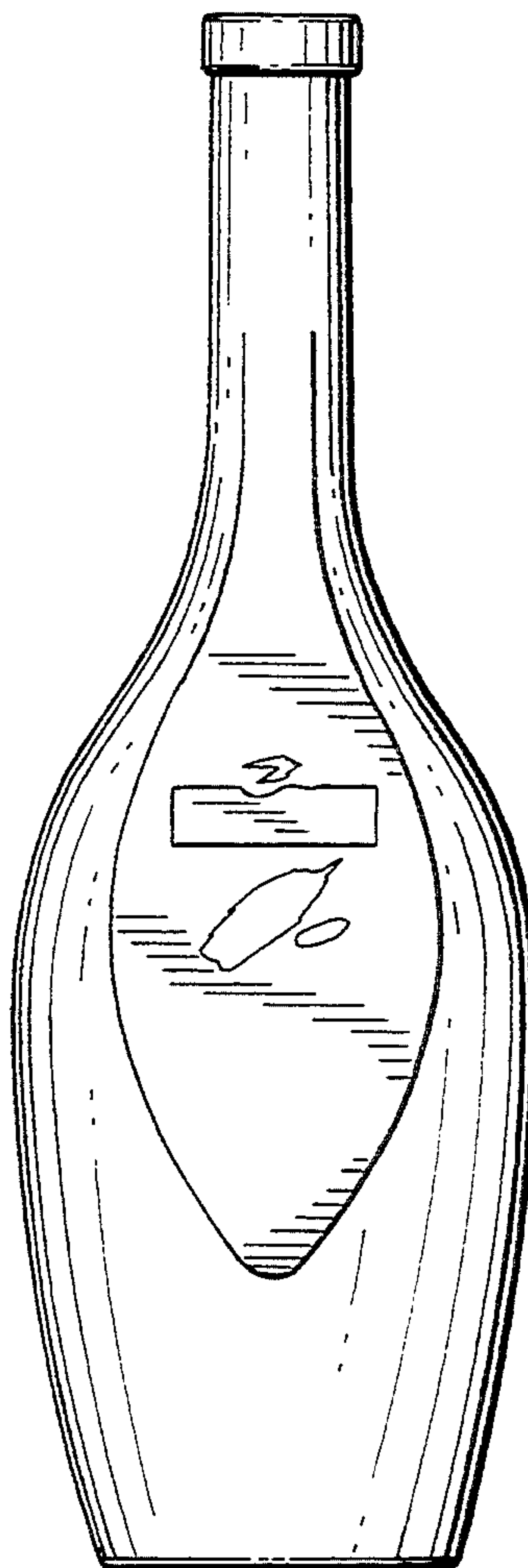
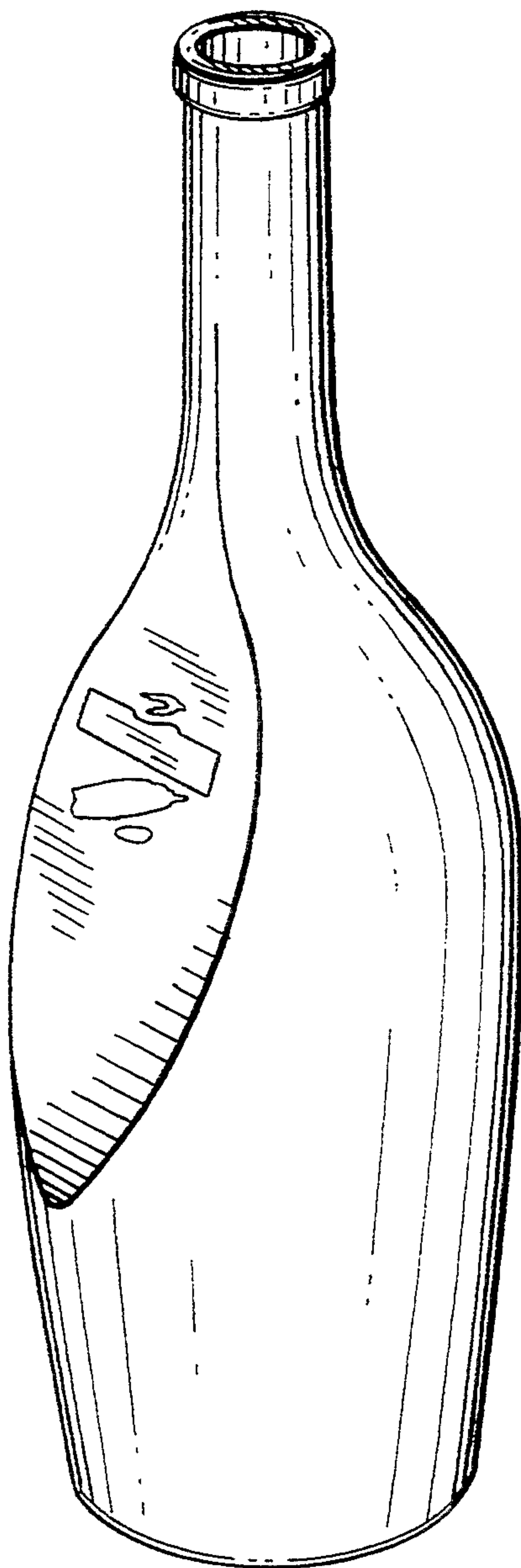

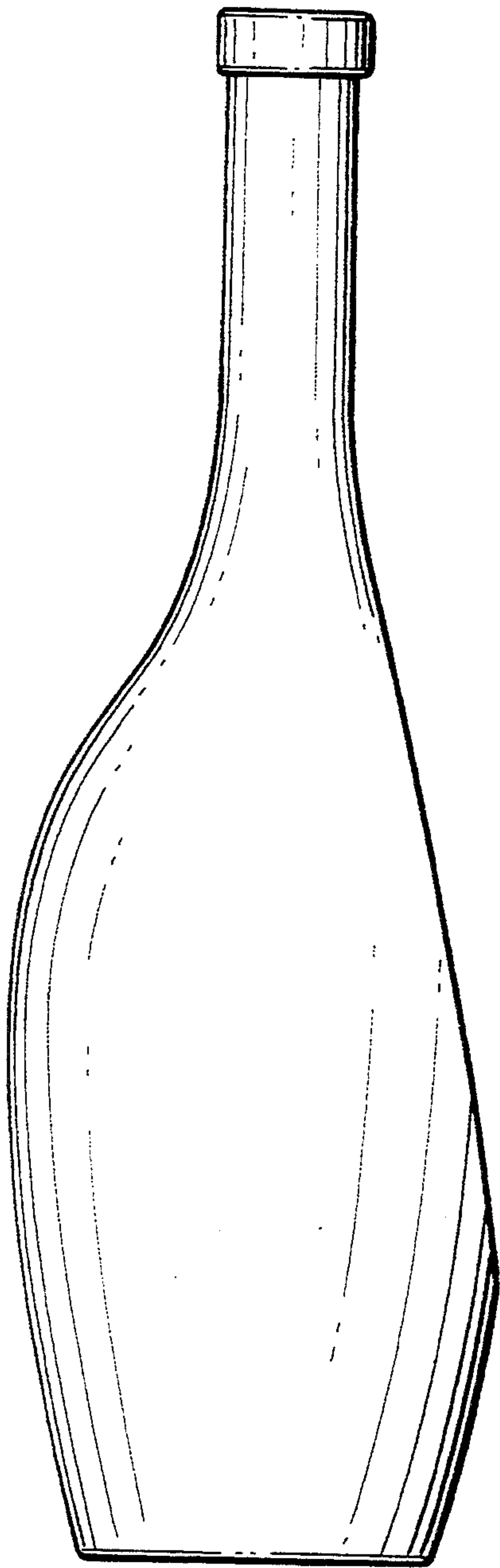

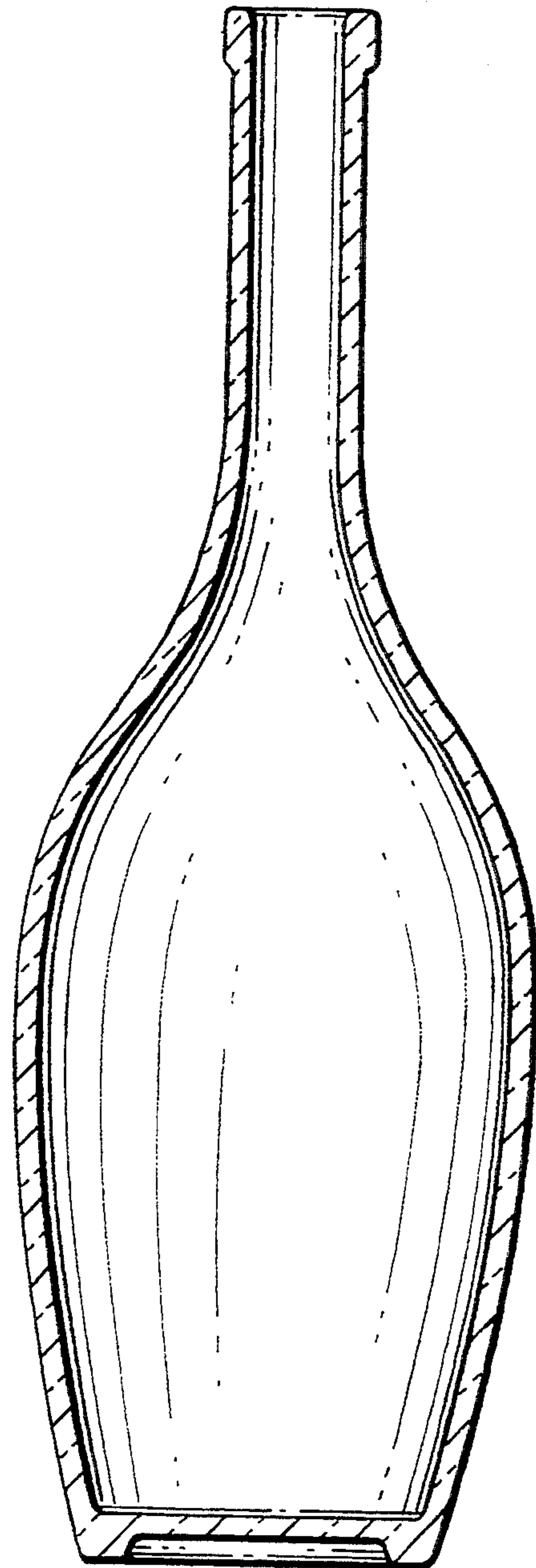

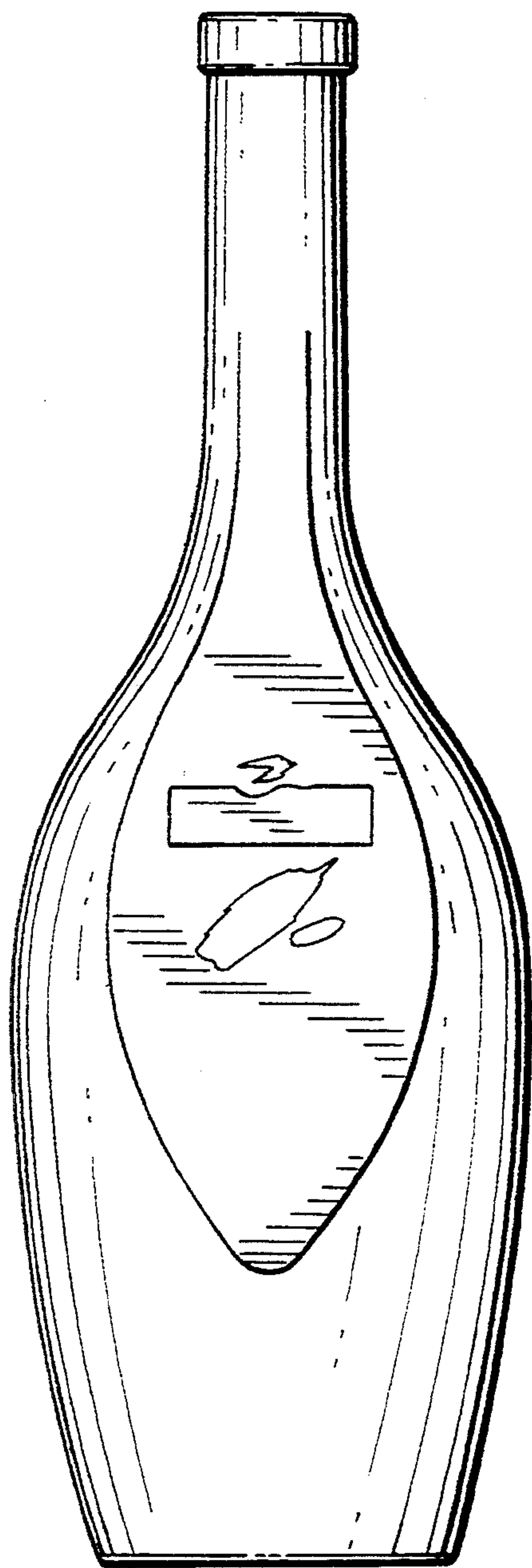

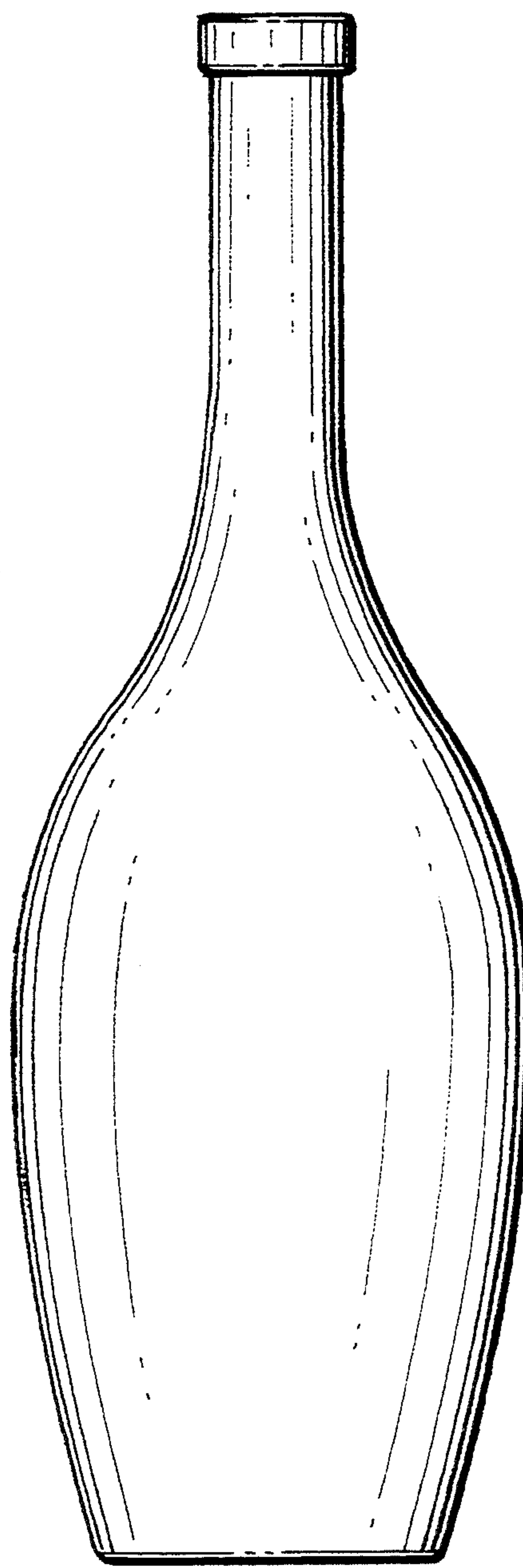
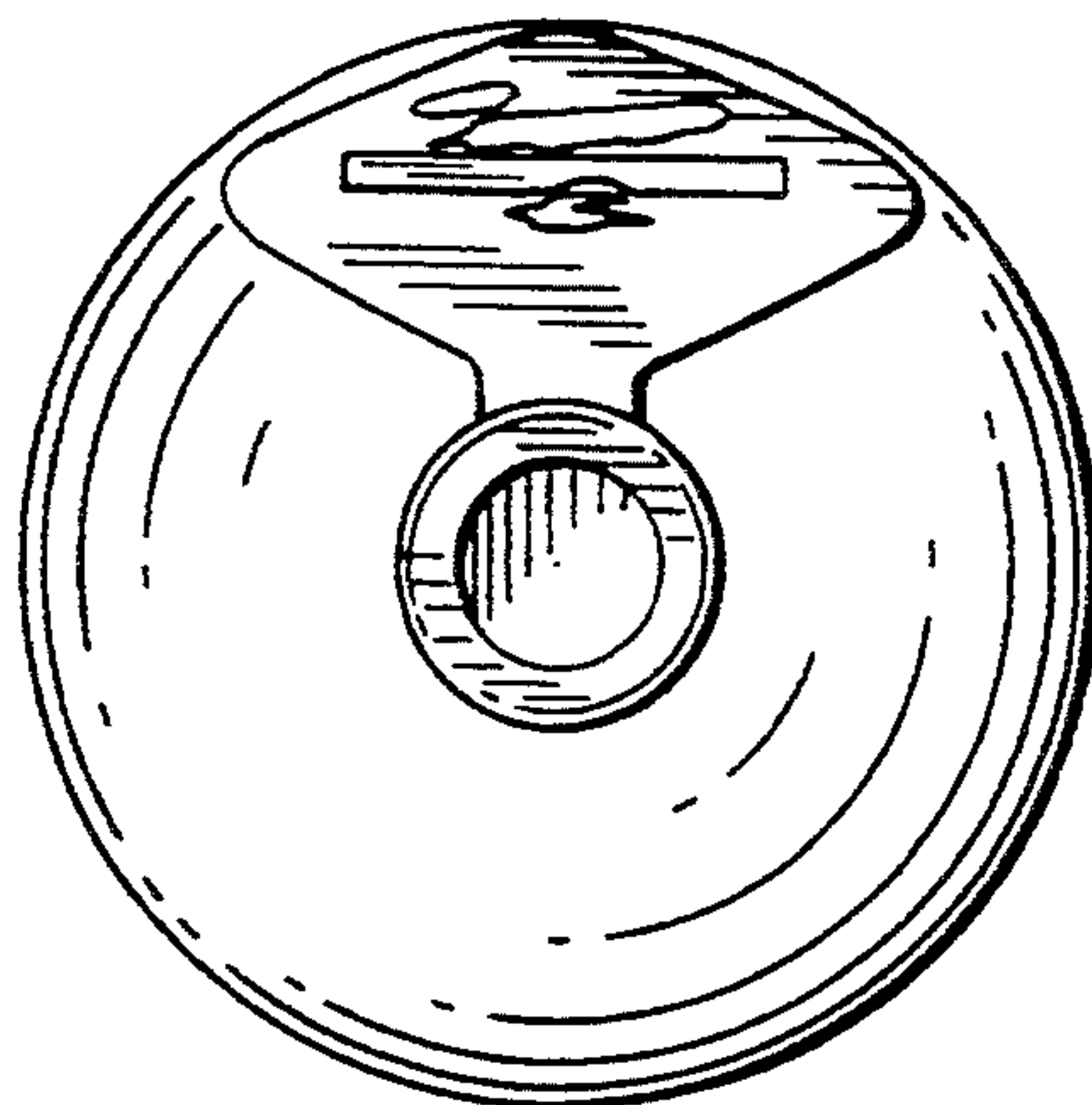
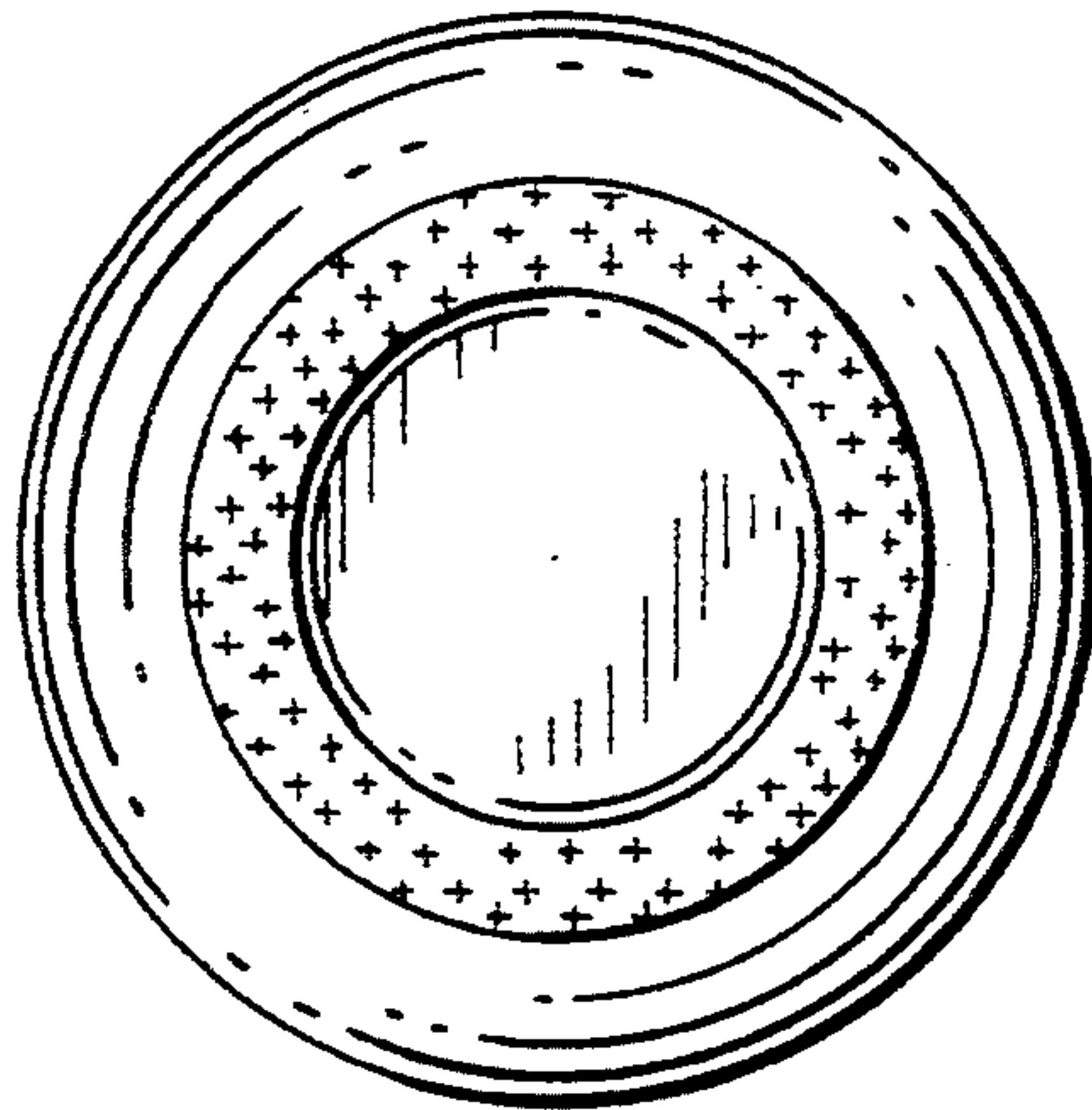
