[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a support brace for hanging posters, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a reduced perspective view of a support brace for hanging posters showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, with the rear being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a top perspective view thereof, with the top layer peeled away for clarity of illustration only. The broken lines showing a poster are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.
