The ornamental design for a child's toy, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top left perspective view of a child's toy showing my new design; the broken line showing of a generic graphic is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claim;

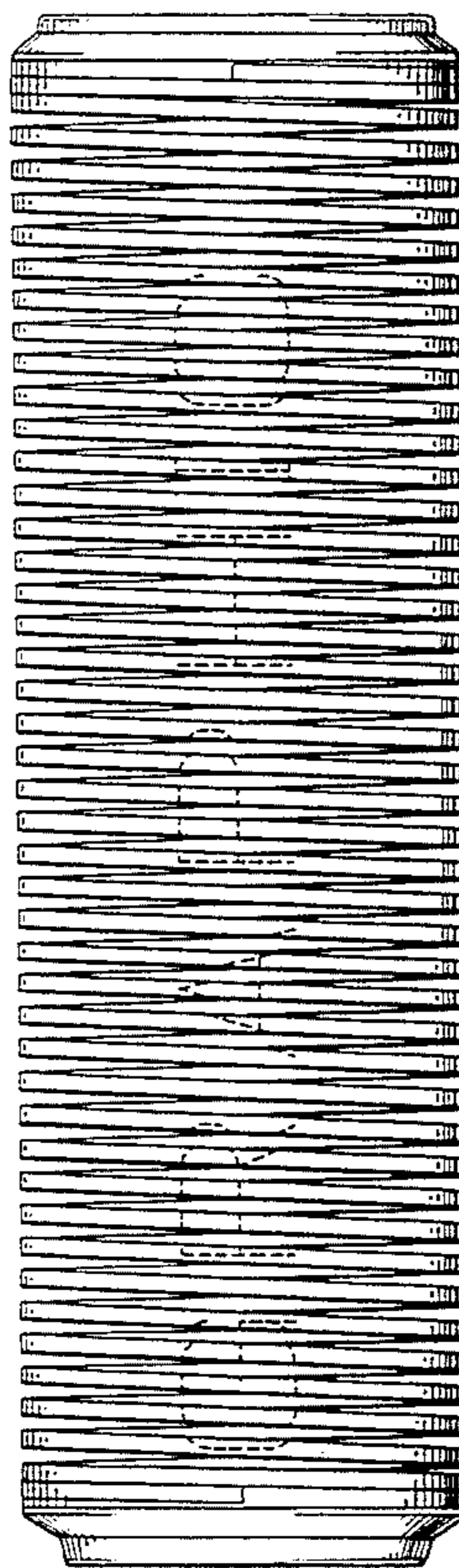
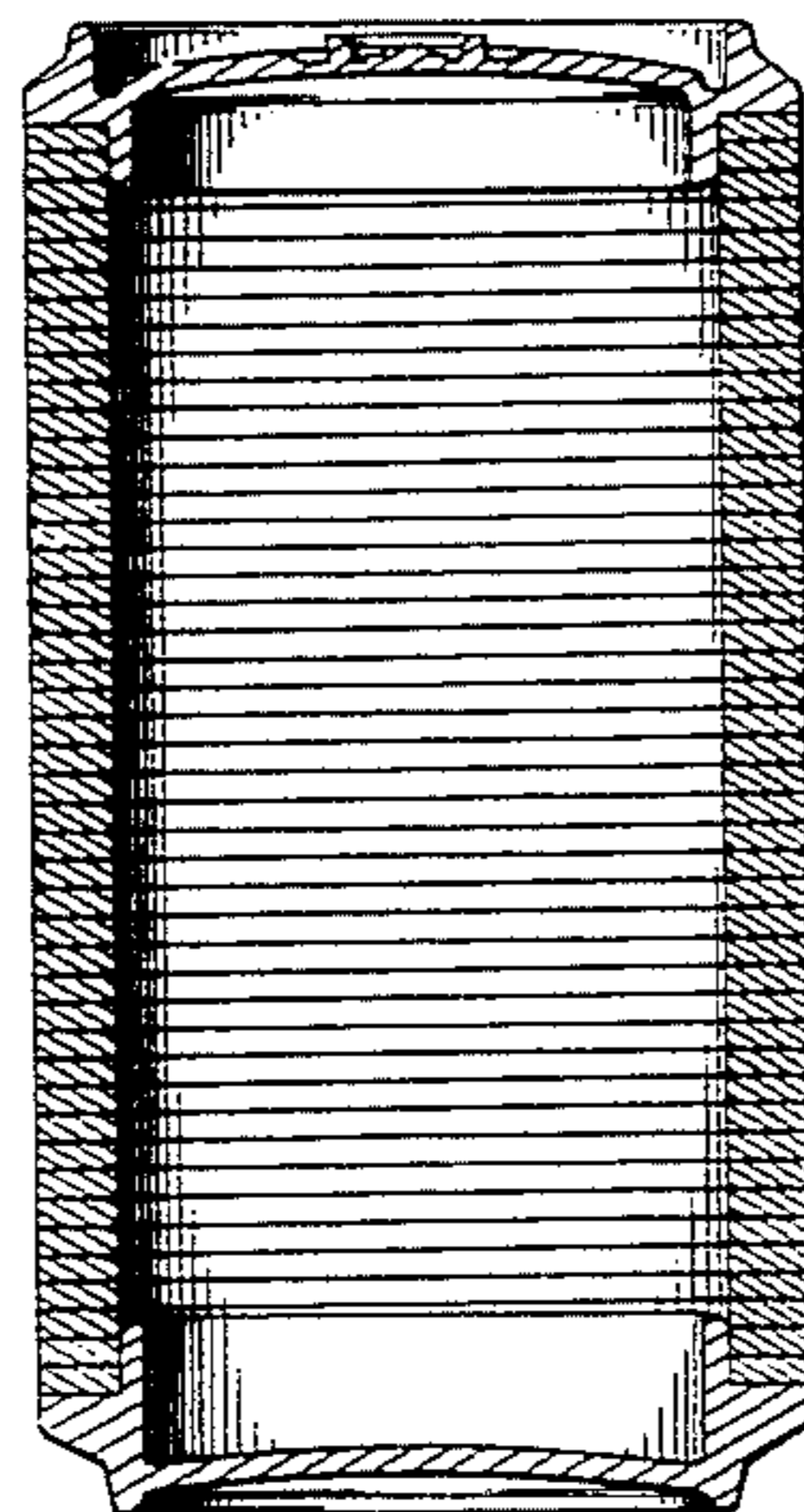
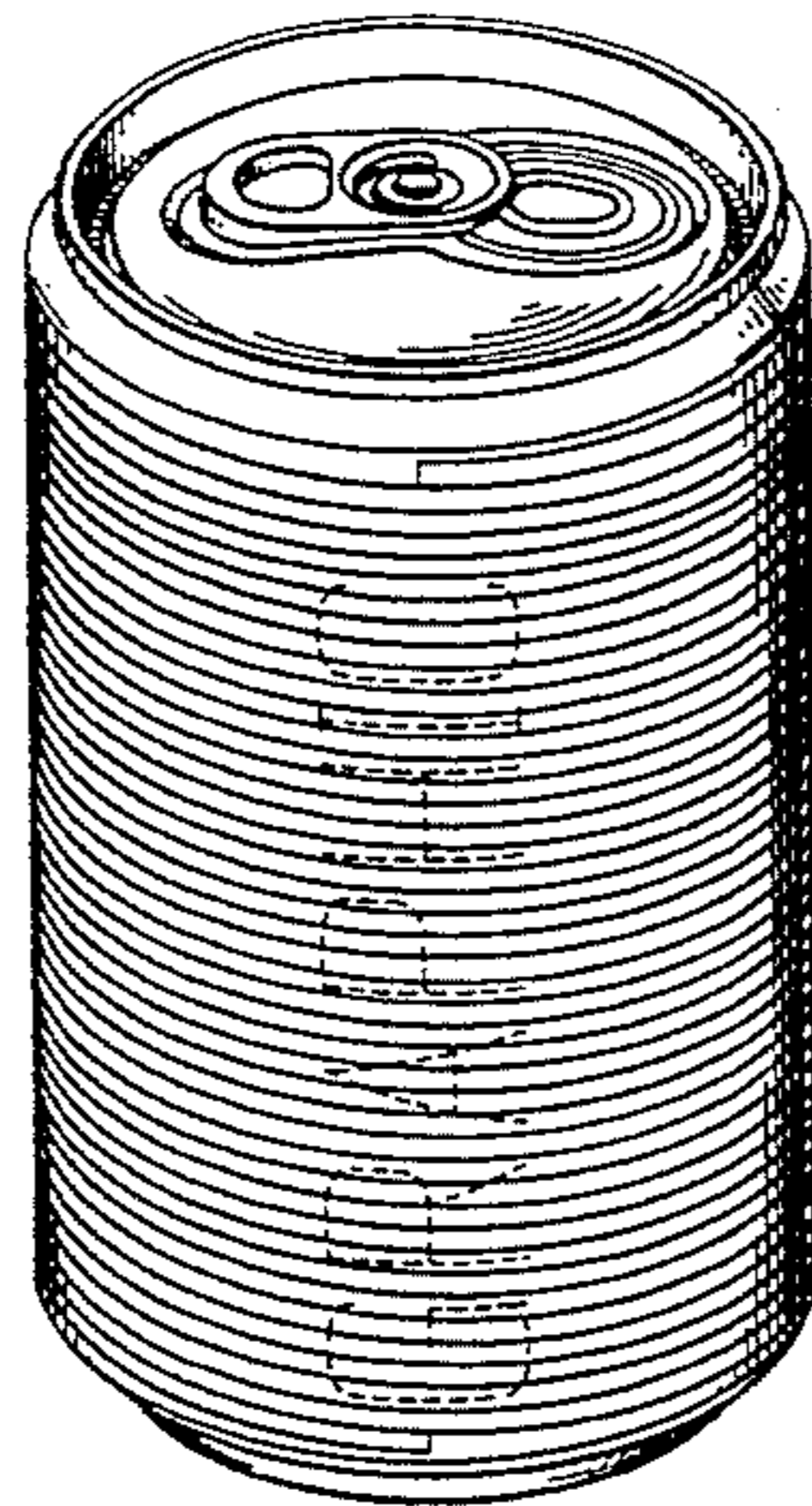
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, all sides being identical, except for the conventional spiral of the spring member;

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view thereof, taken in the direction of the arrows along line 4—4 of FIG. 2;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view thereof, in an alternate position.



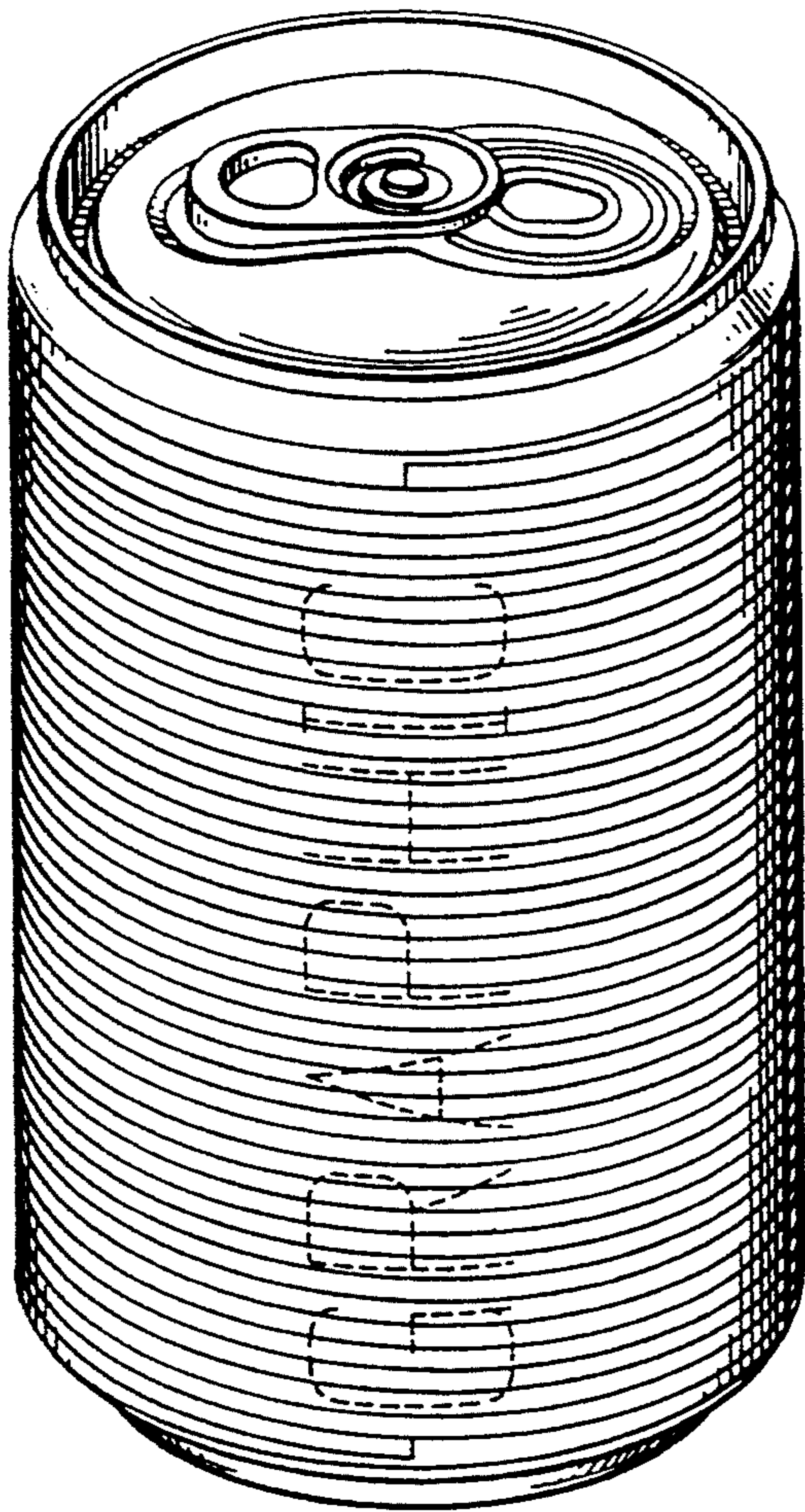

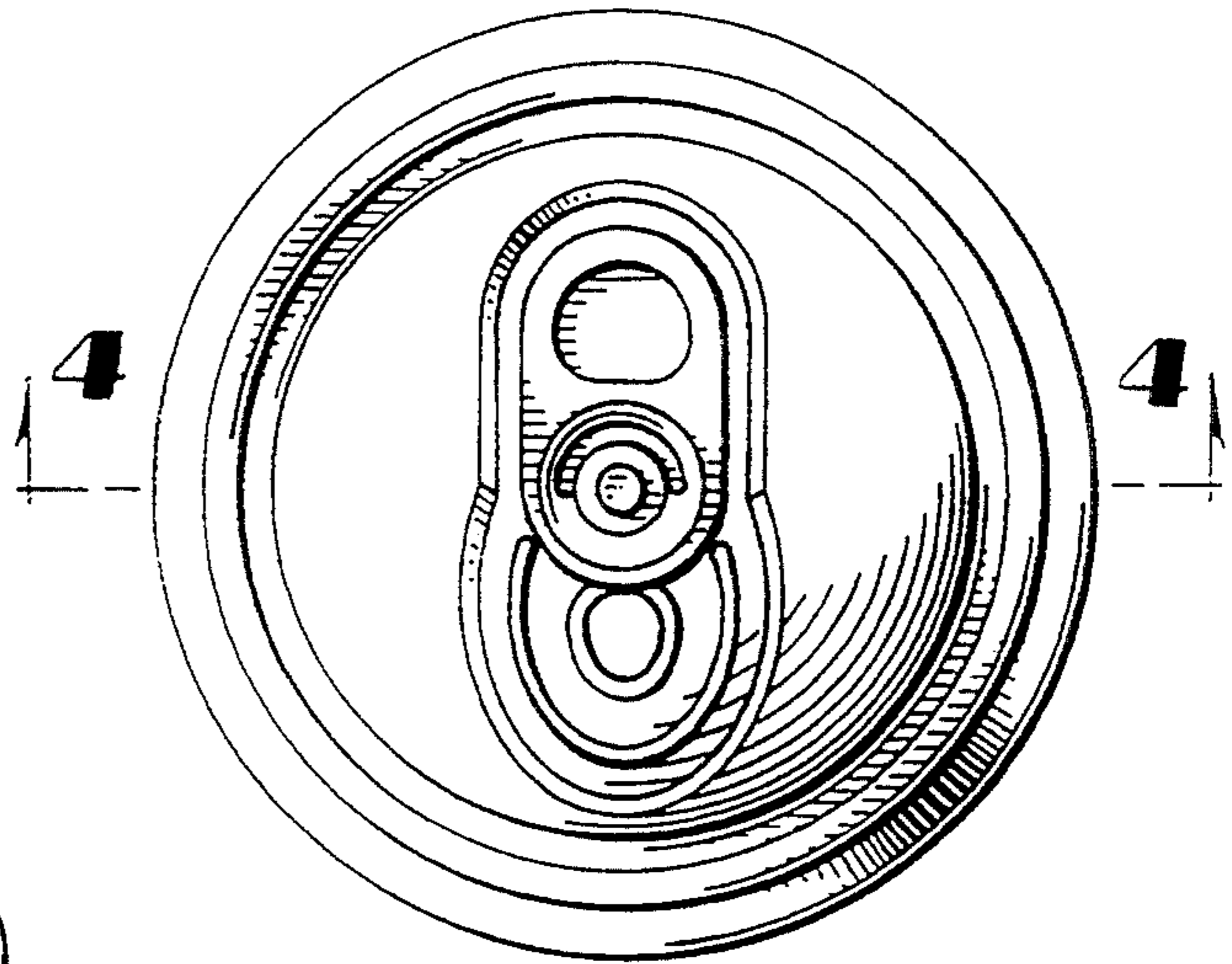

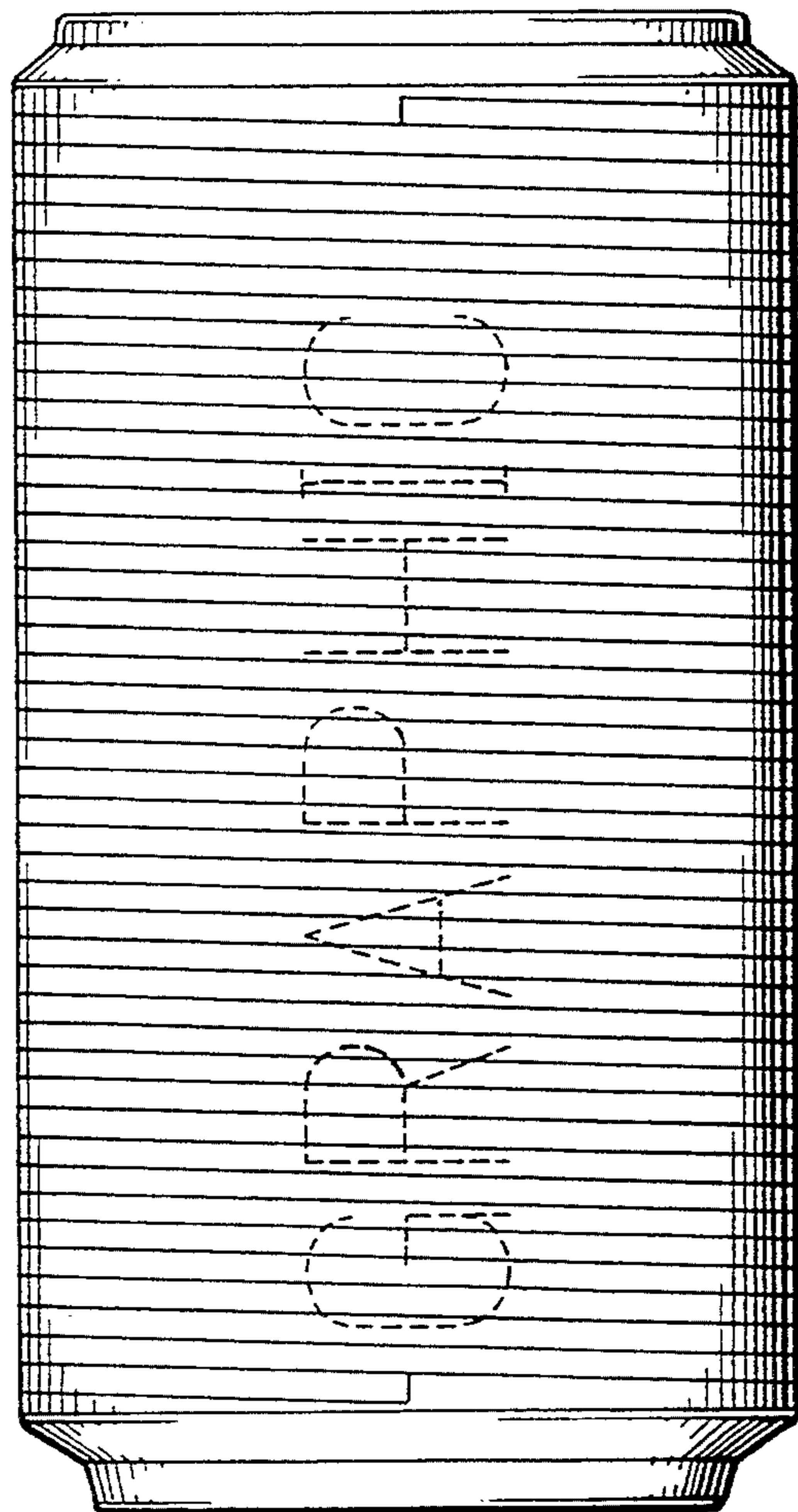

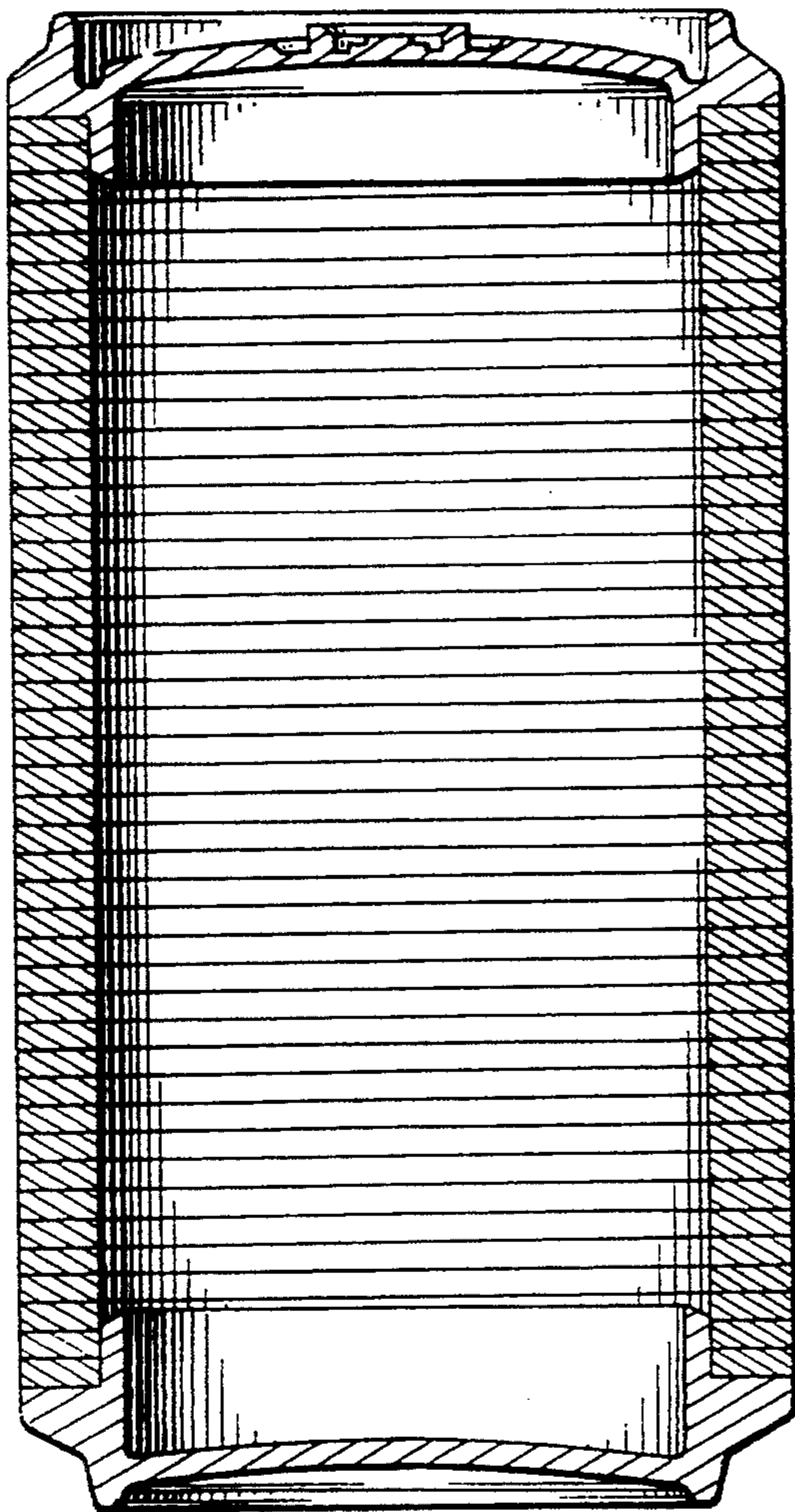

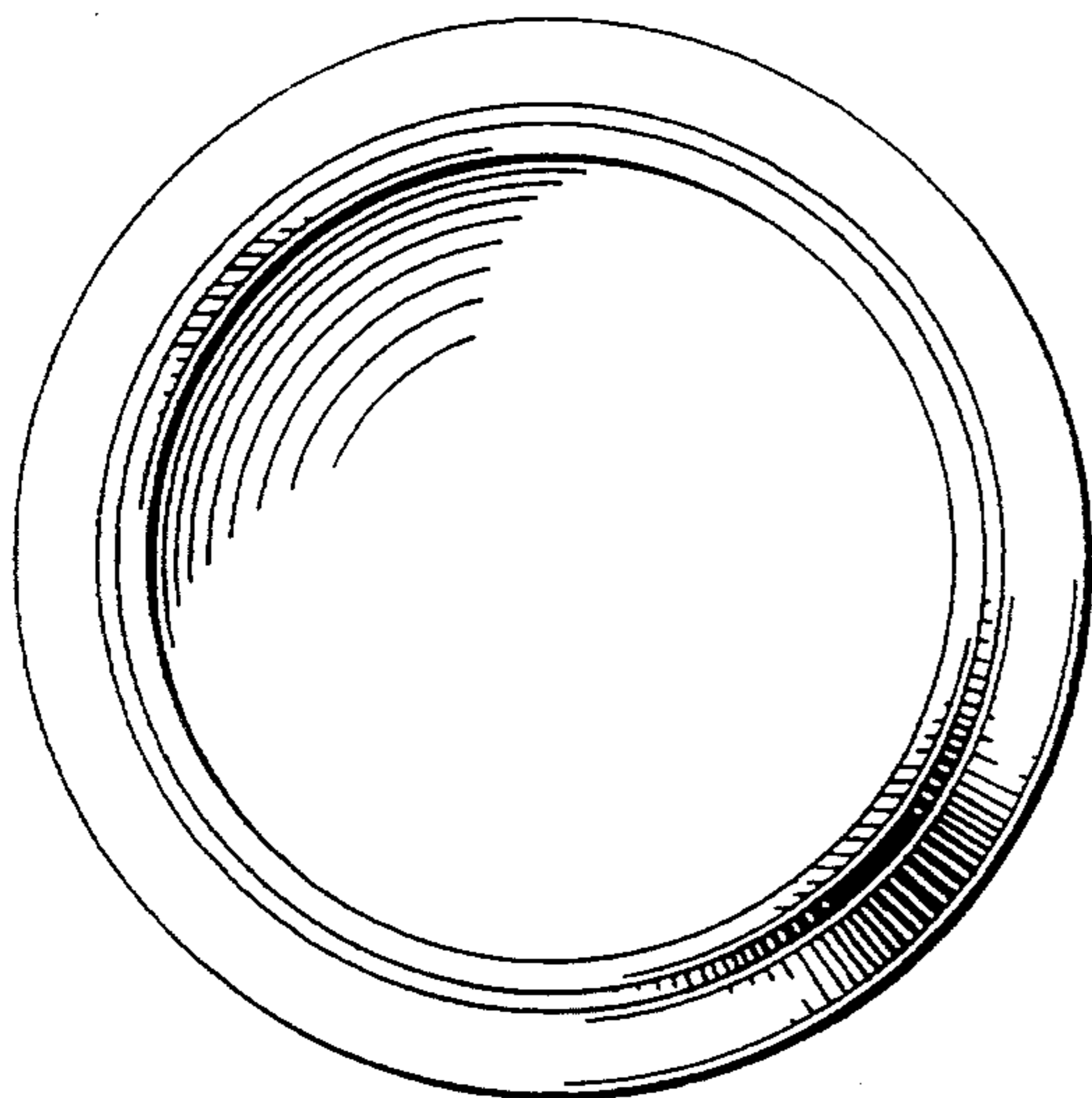

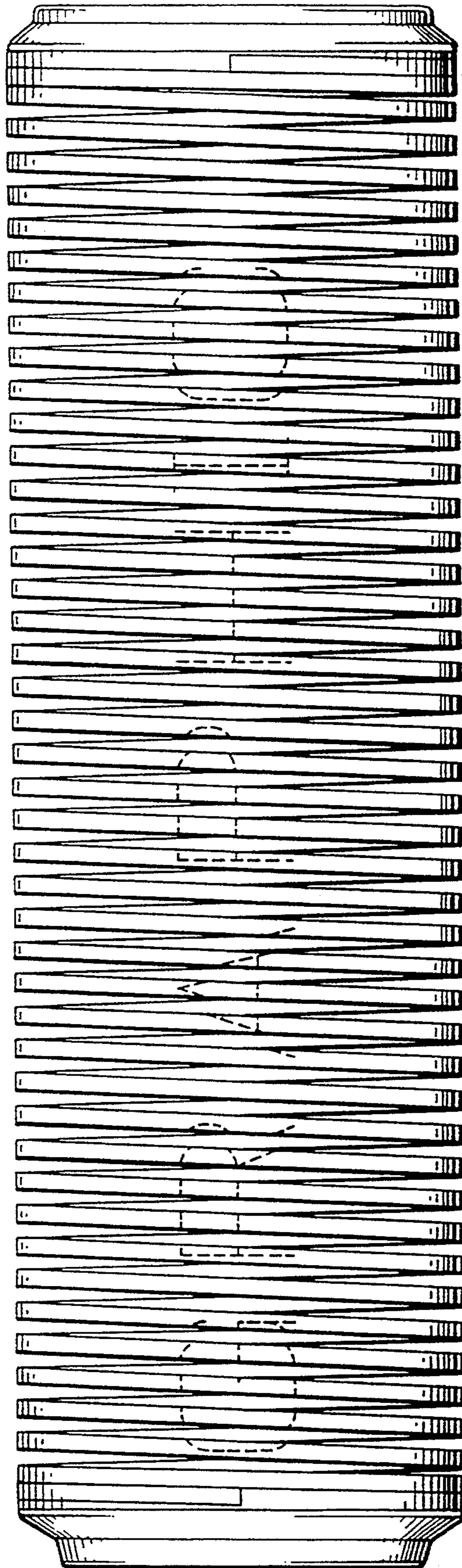
