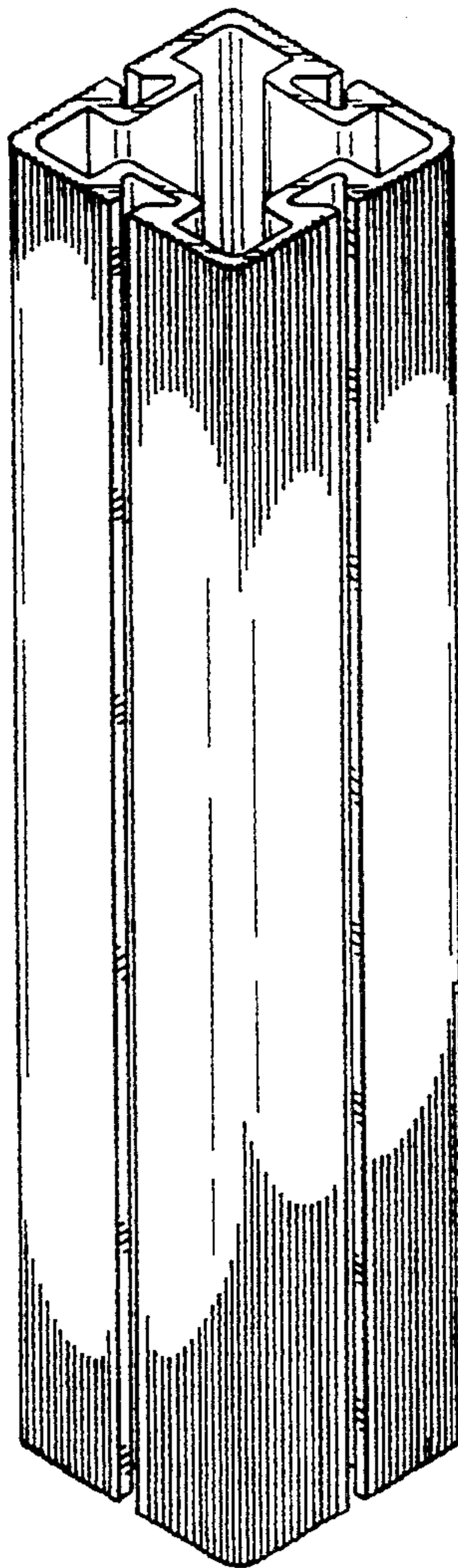

The ornamental design for a post design for playground equipment, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the top and sides of the inventive post design for playground equipment; FIG. 2 is an end view of the post design for playground equipment, the ends being identical; and, FIG. 3 is a fragmentary side view of the post design for playground equipment, all four sides being identical.



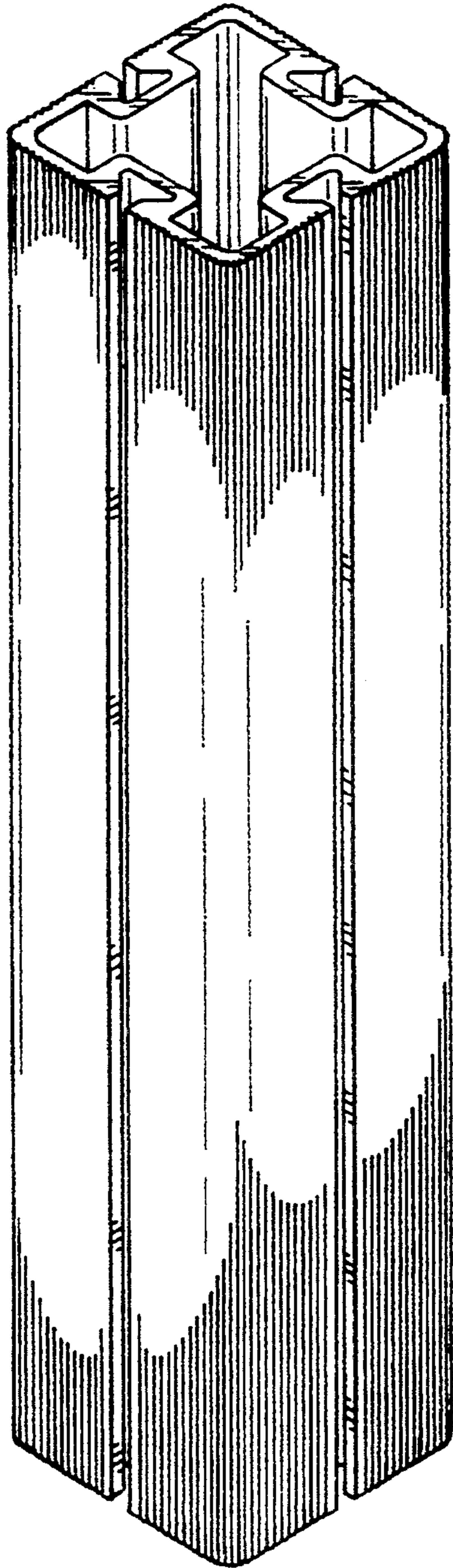

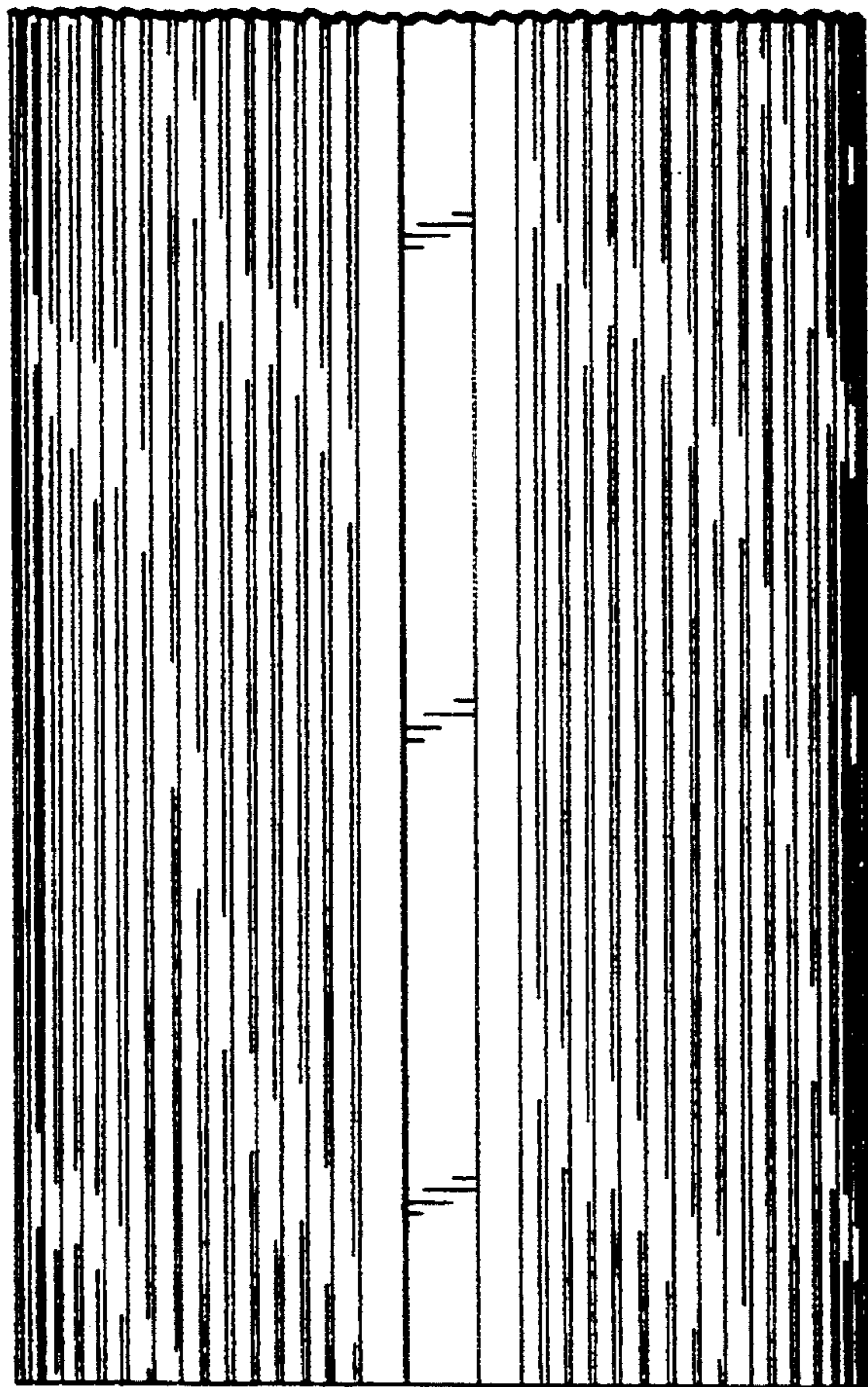

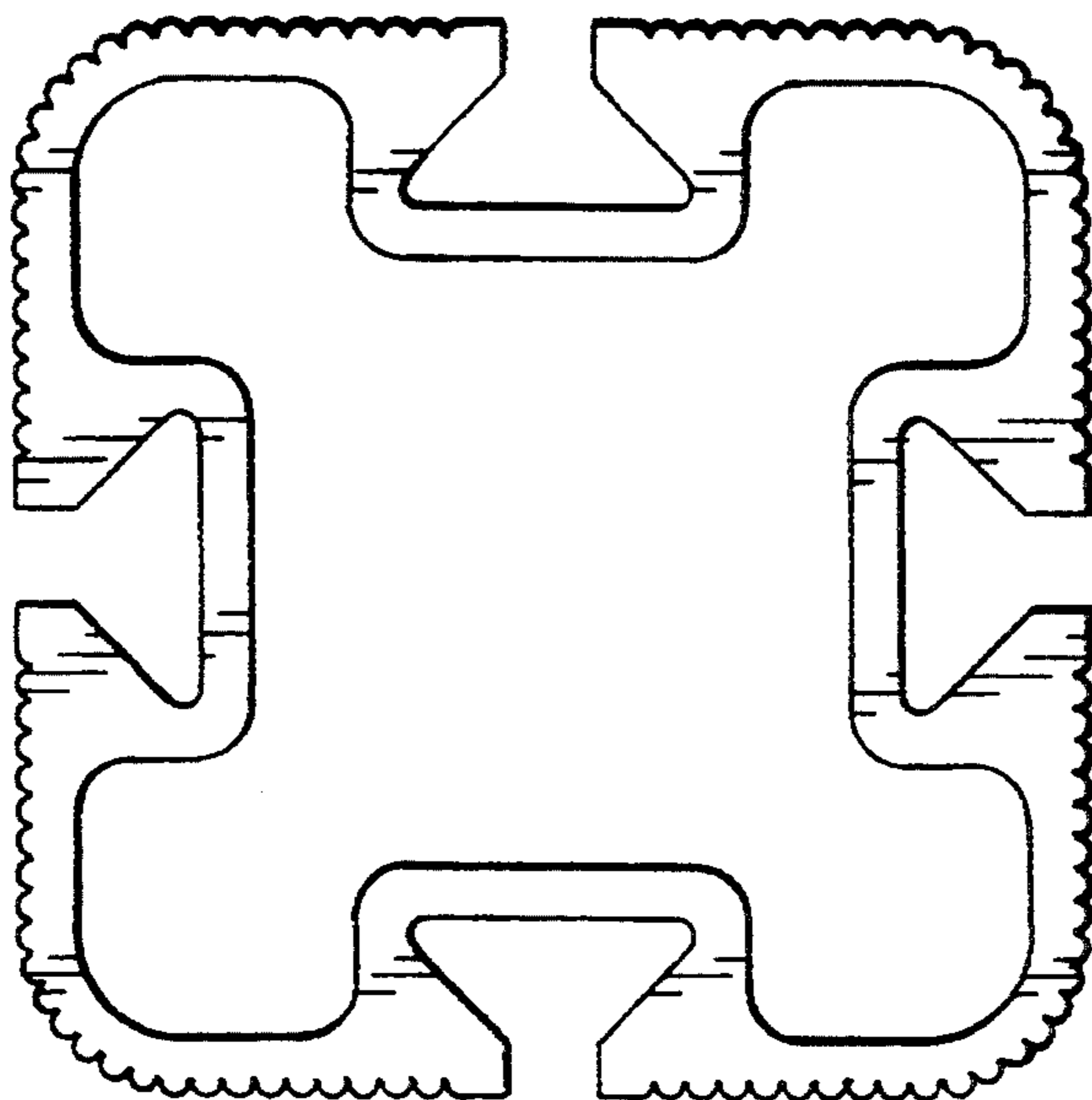
