our new design;

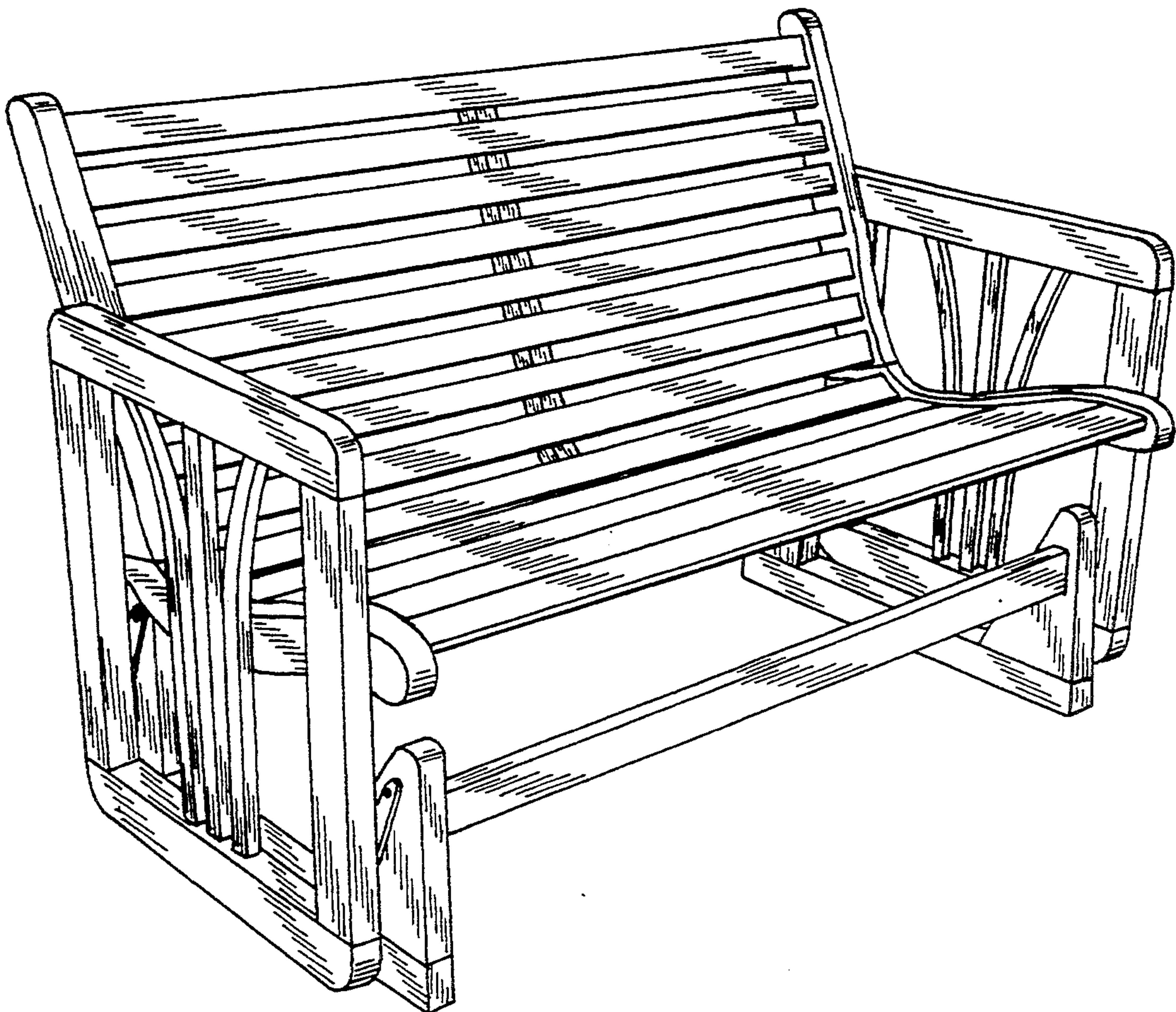
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



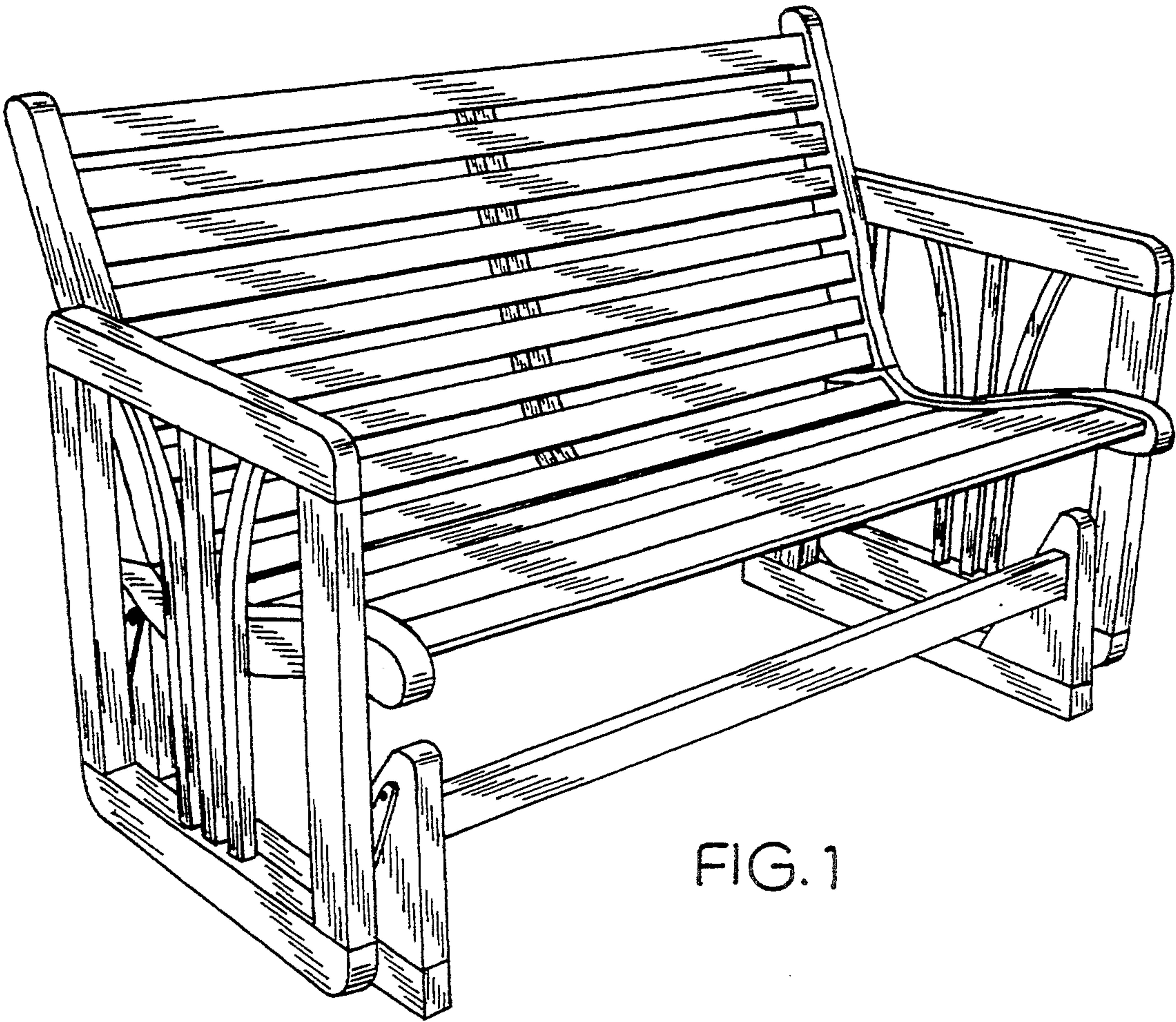

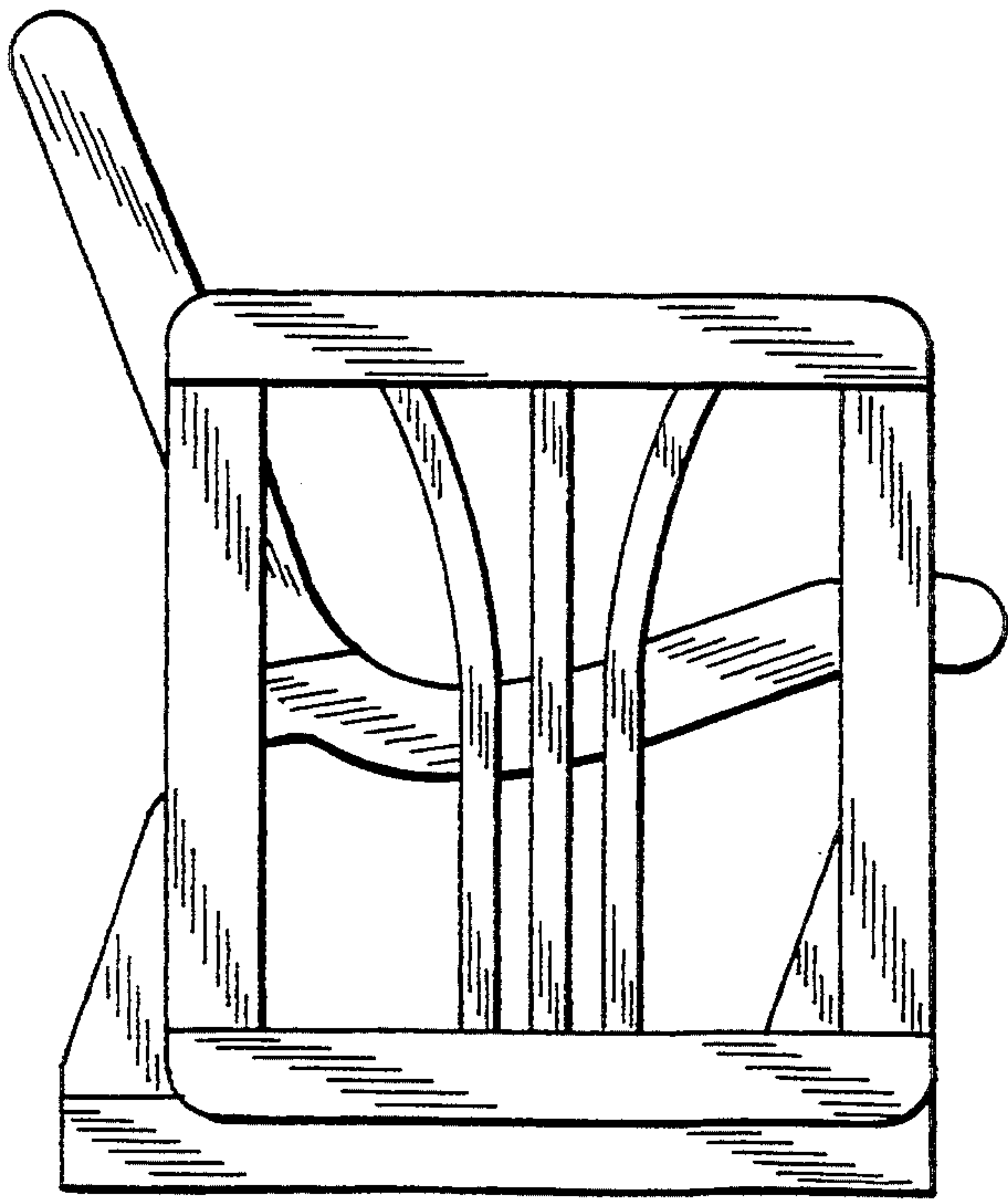

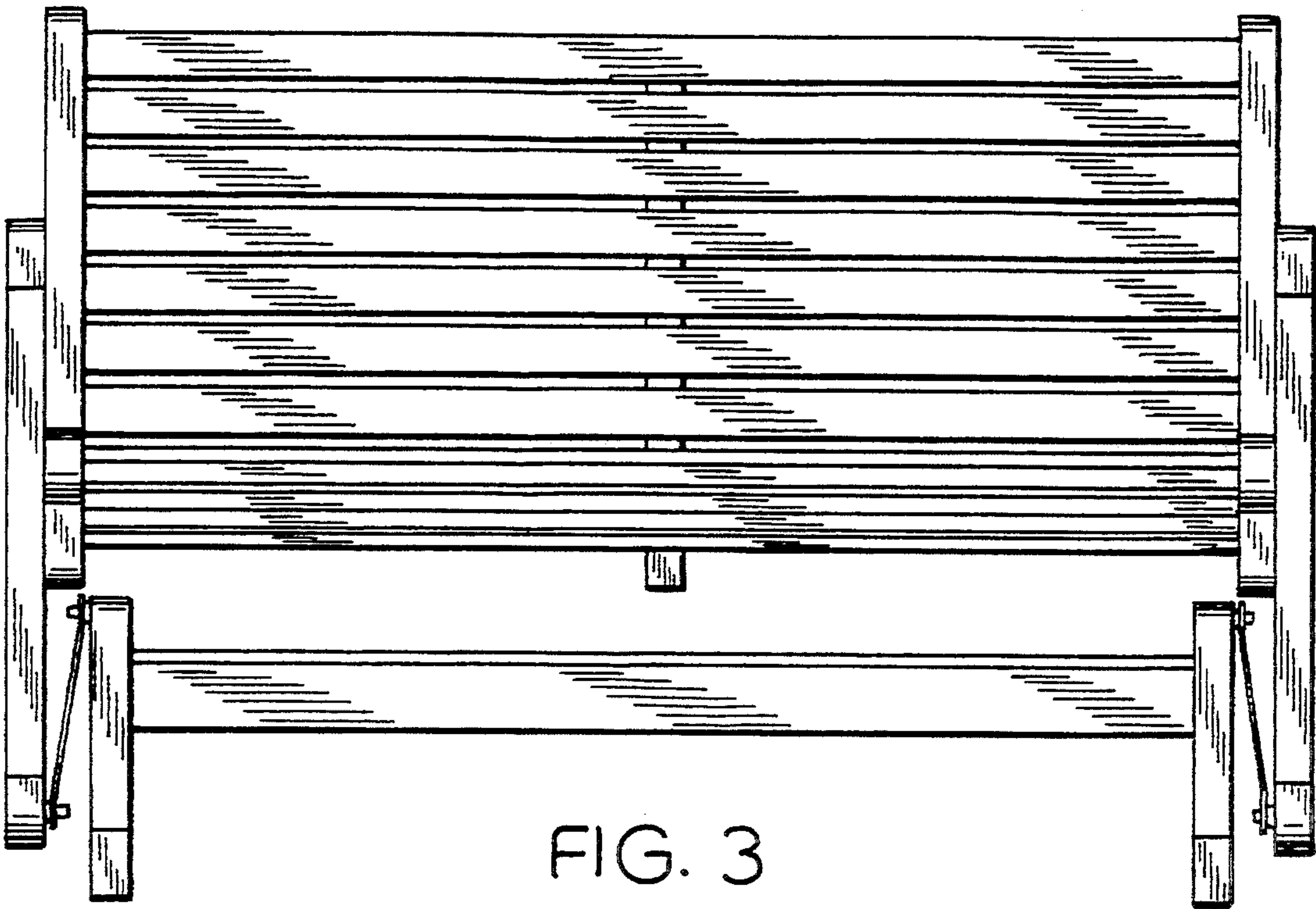

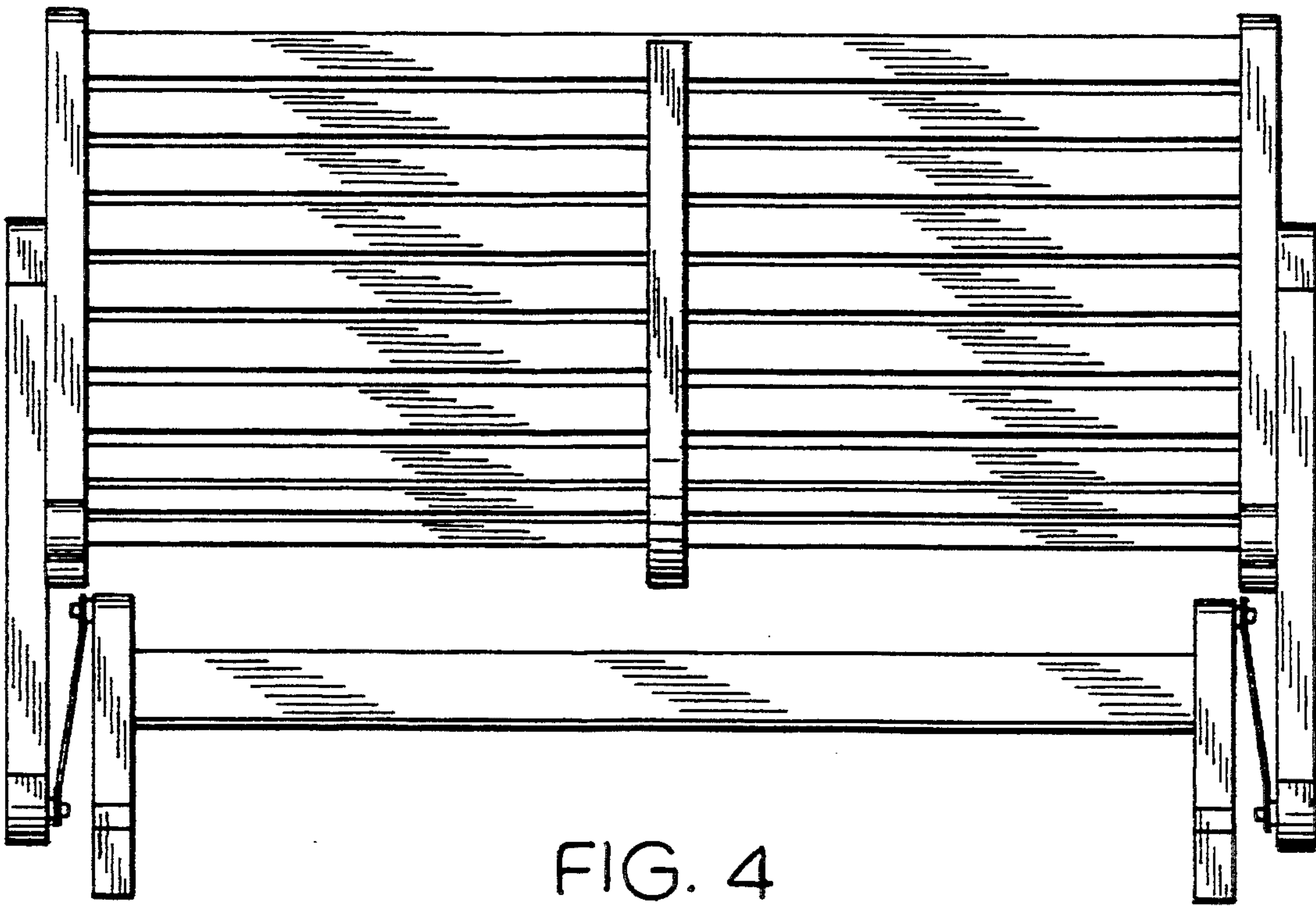

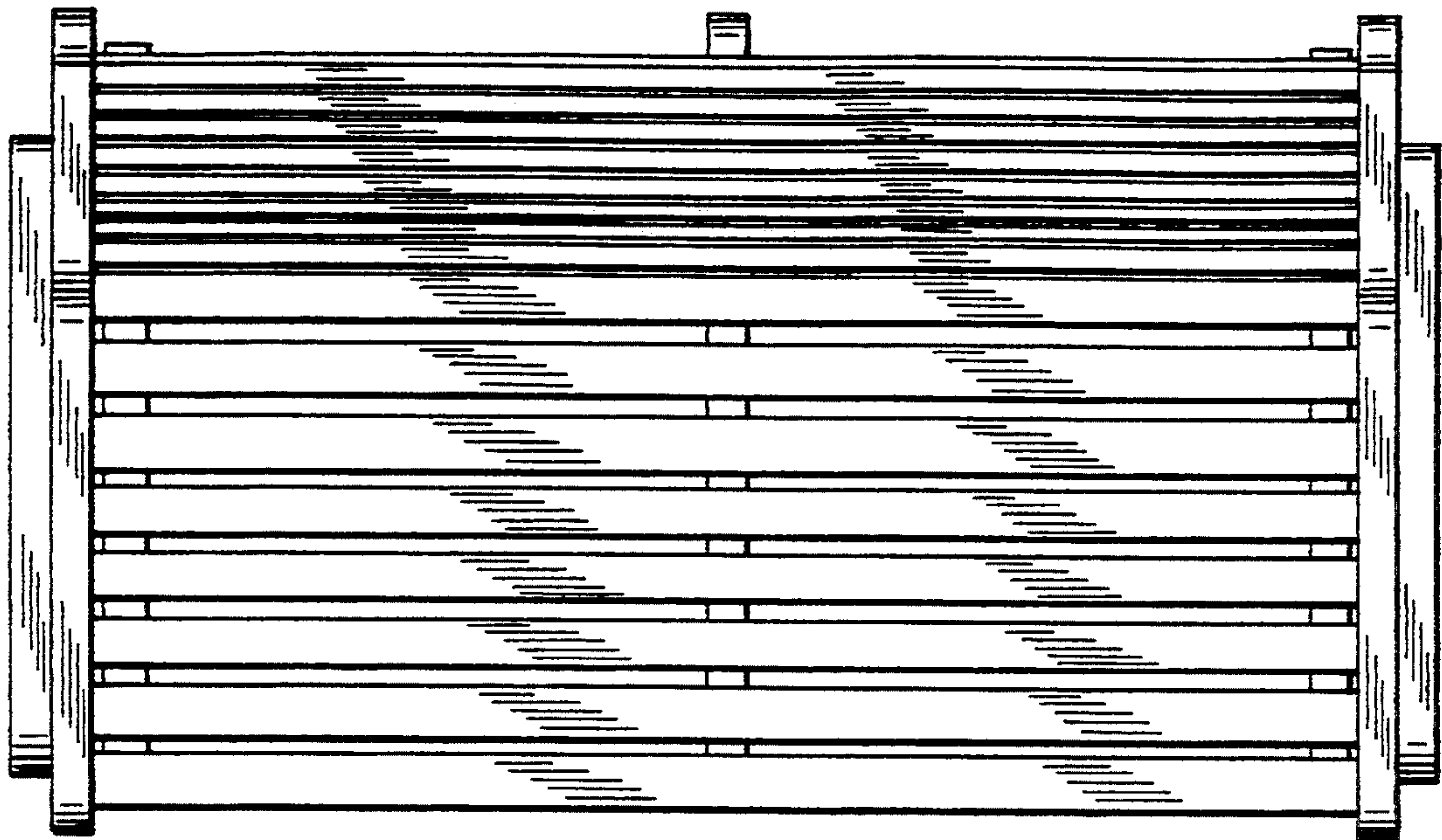

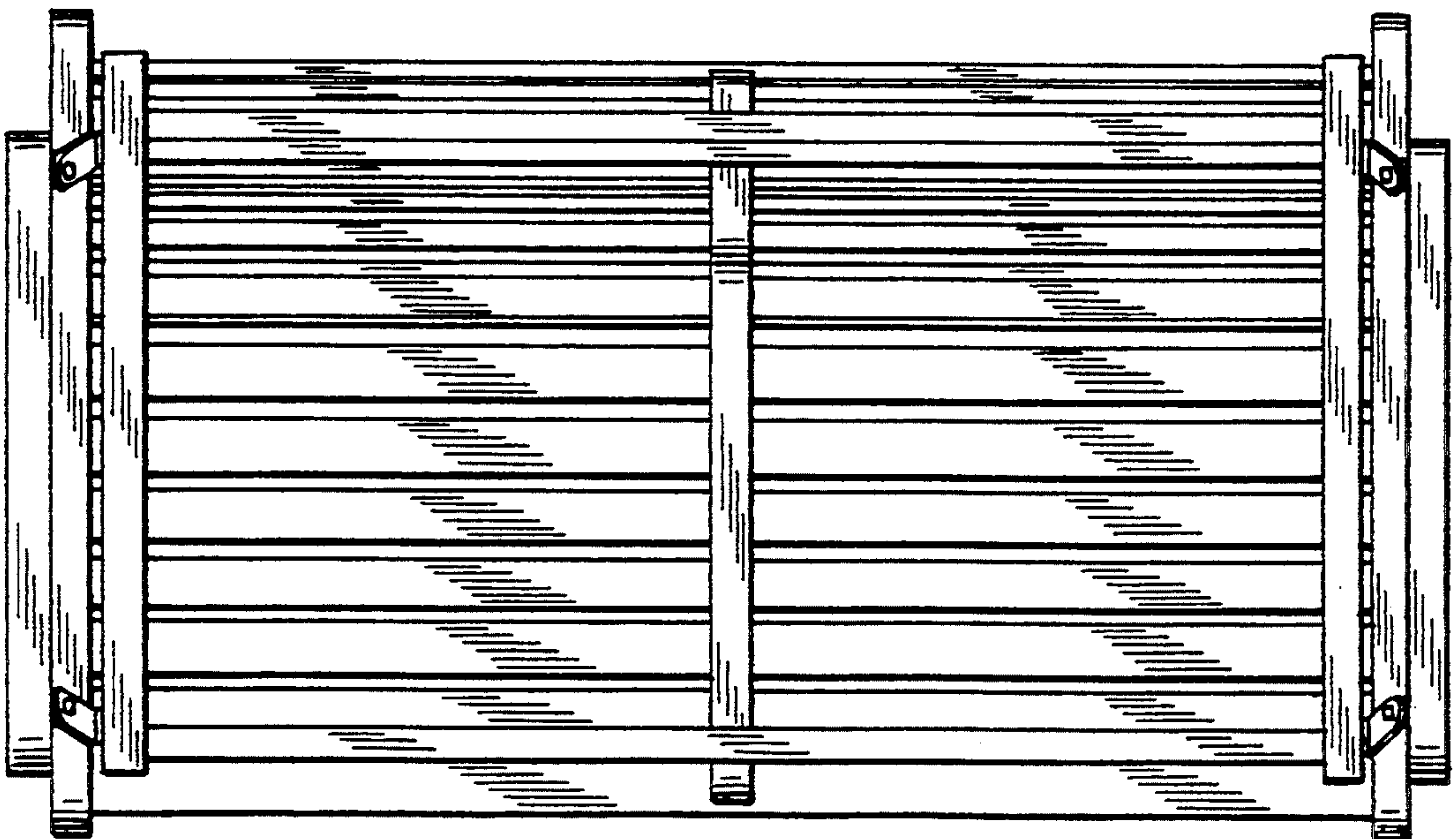
