described.

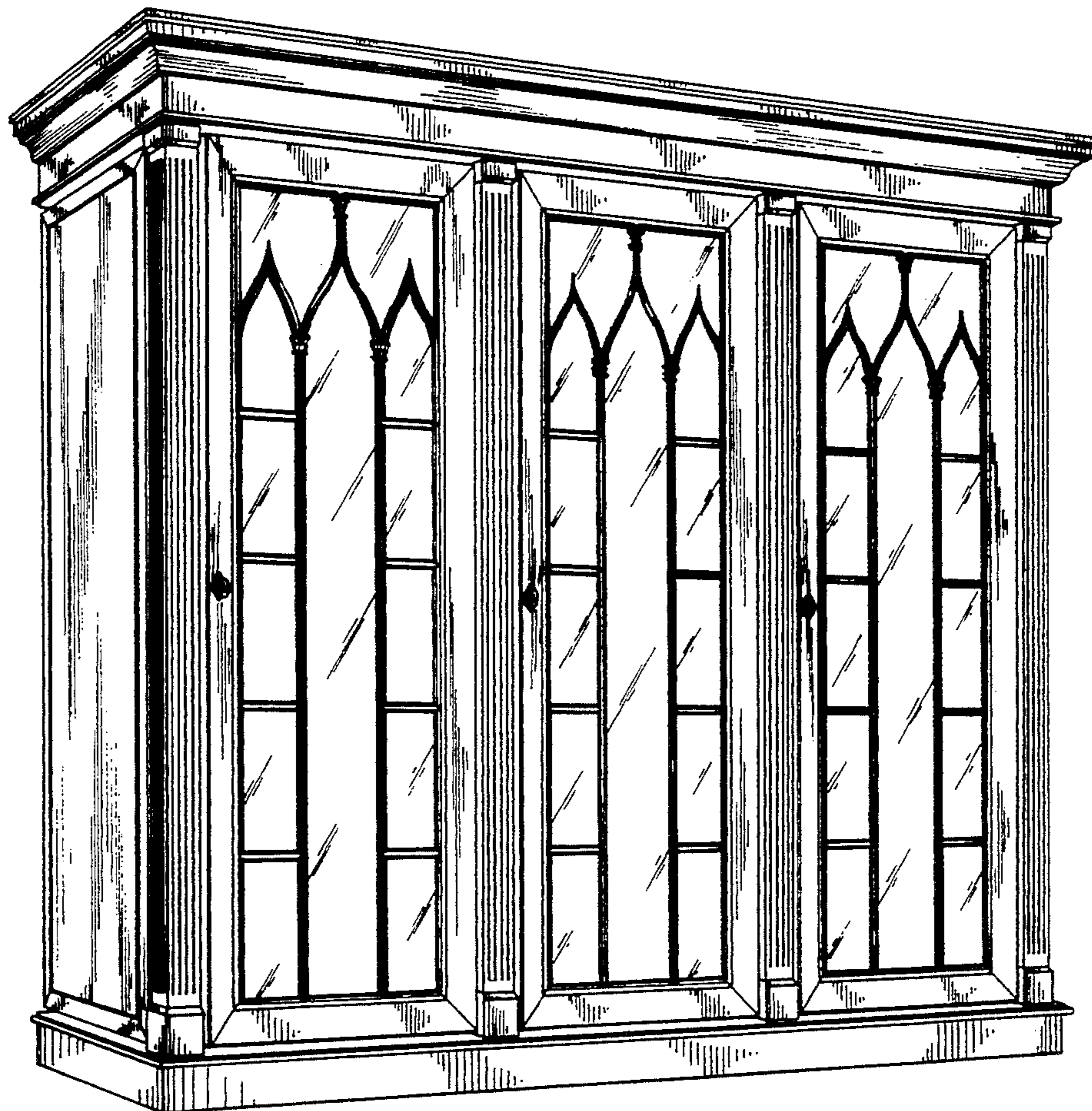
### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view the glass case showing our  
new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the top, back  
and bottom being plain and unornamented;

FIG. 3 is a side view thereof with the opposite side view  
being a mirror image thereof; and,

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of an alternate em-  
bodiment of the glass case of FIG. 1; the sides, top and  
bottom being identical to those of FIGS. 1-3 but re-  
duced in height.



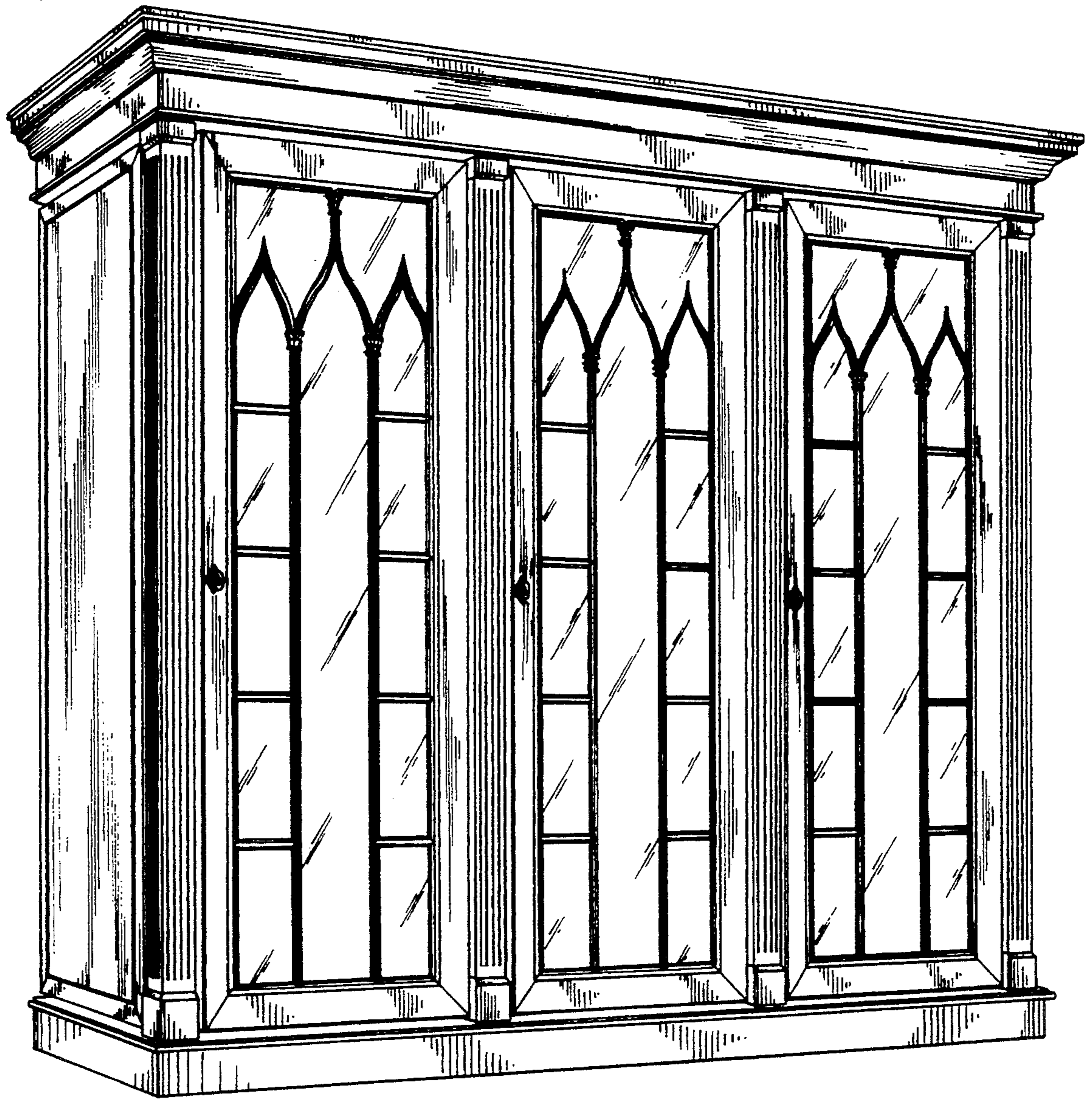

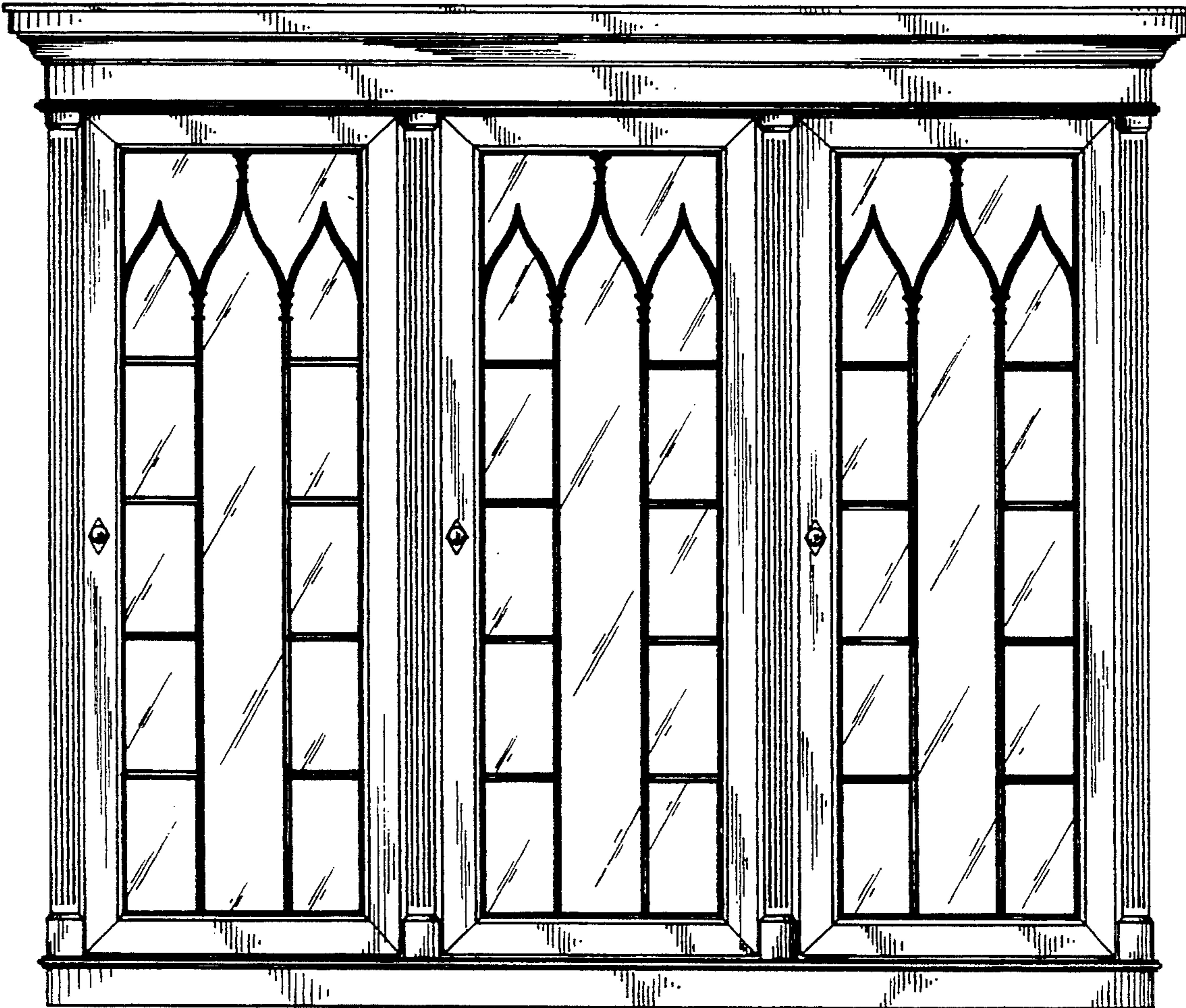

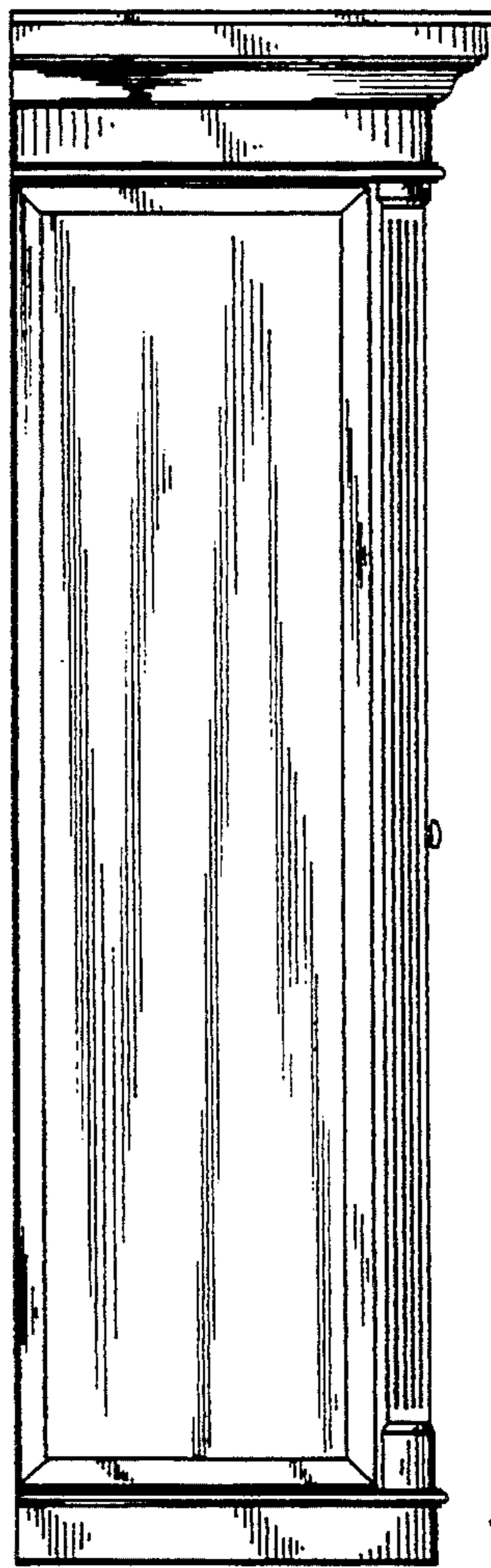

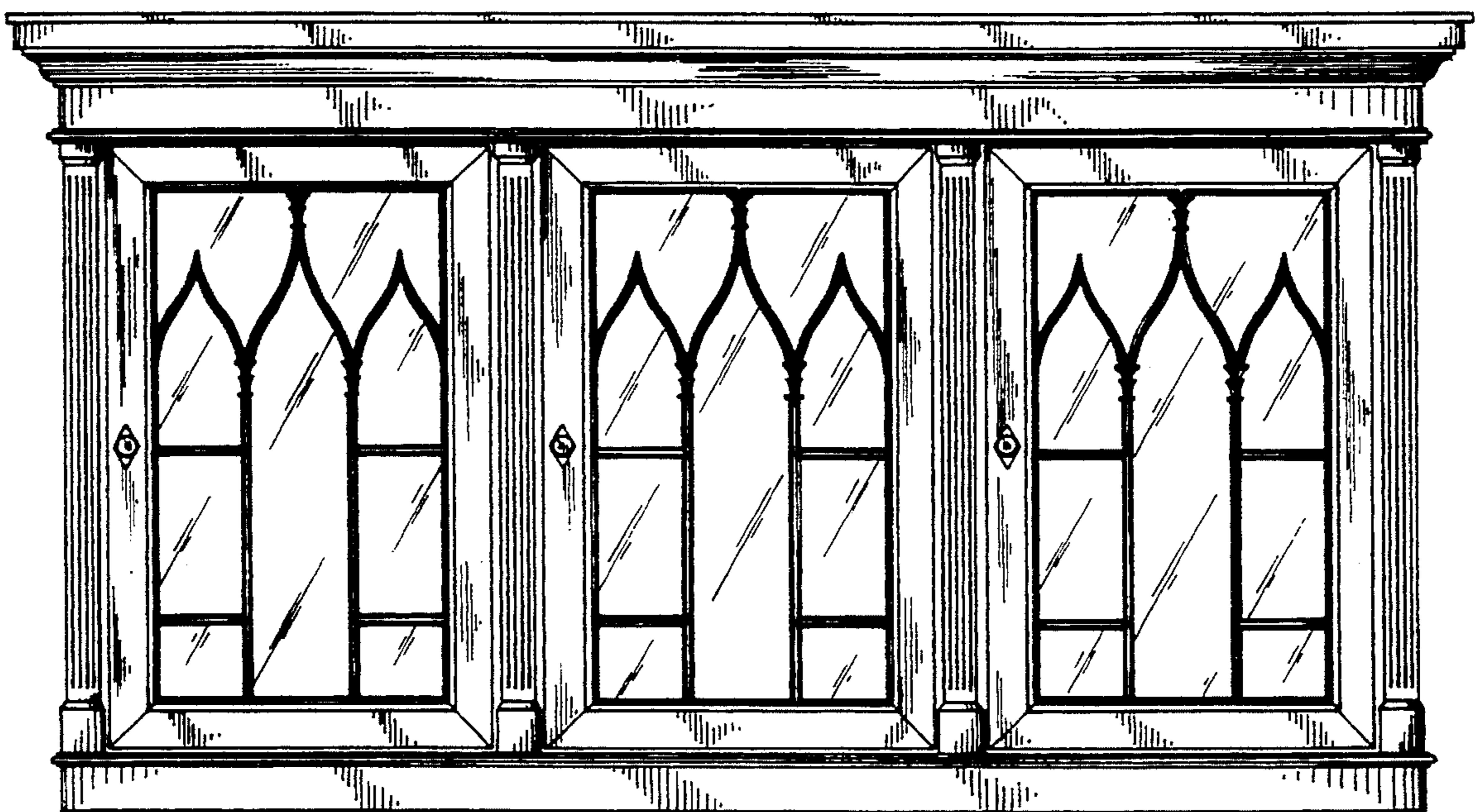
