FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

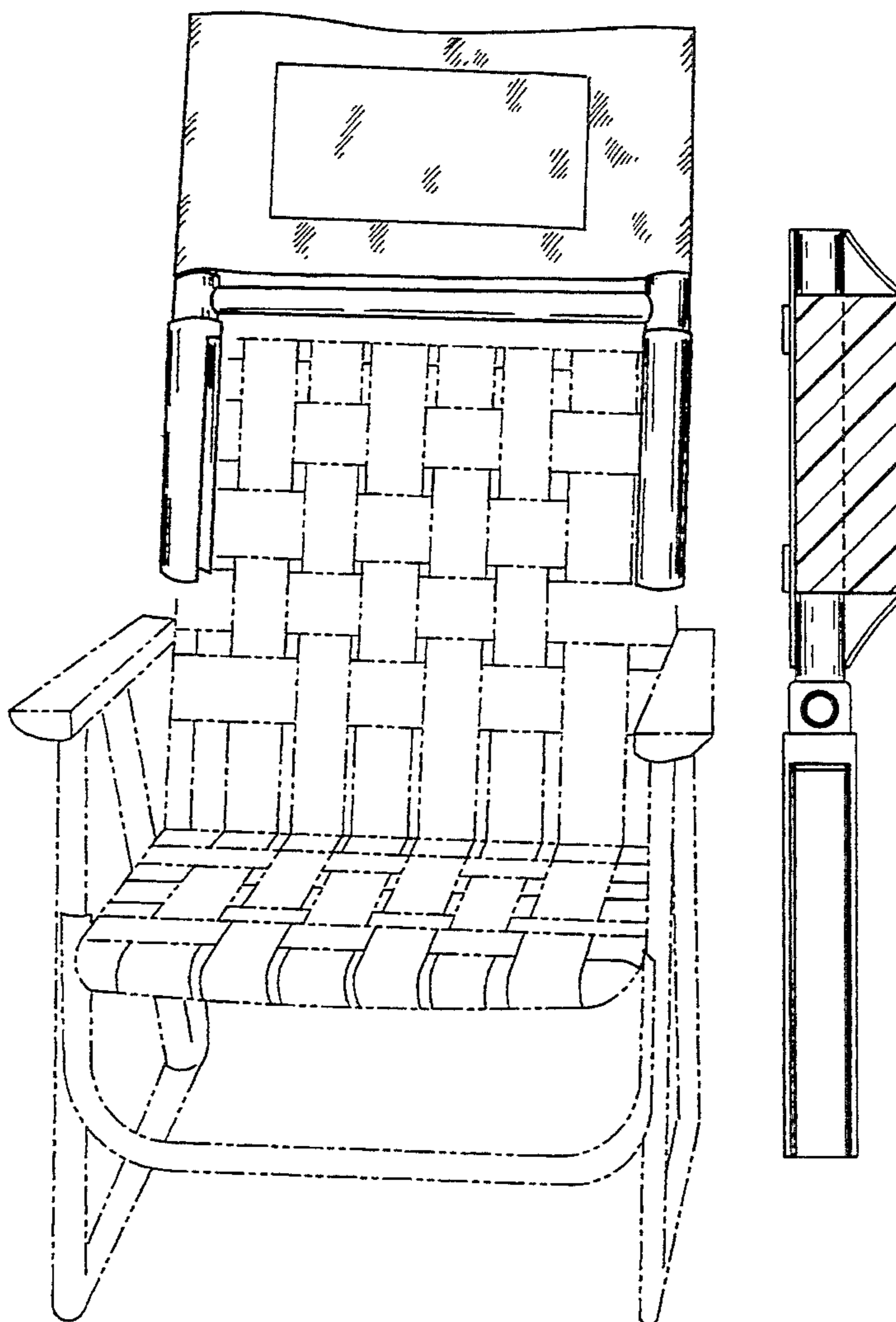
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a rear perspective view thereof.



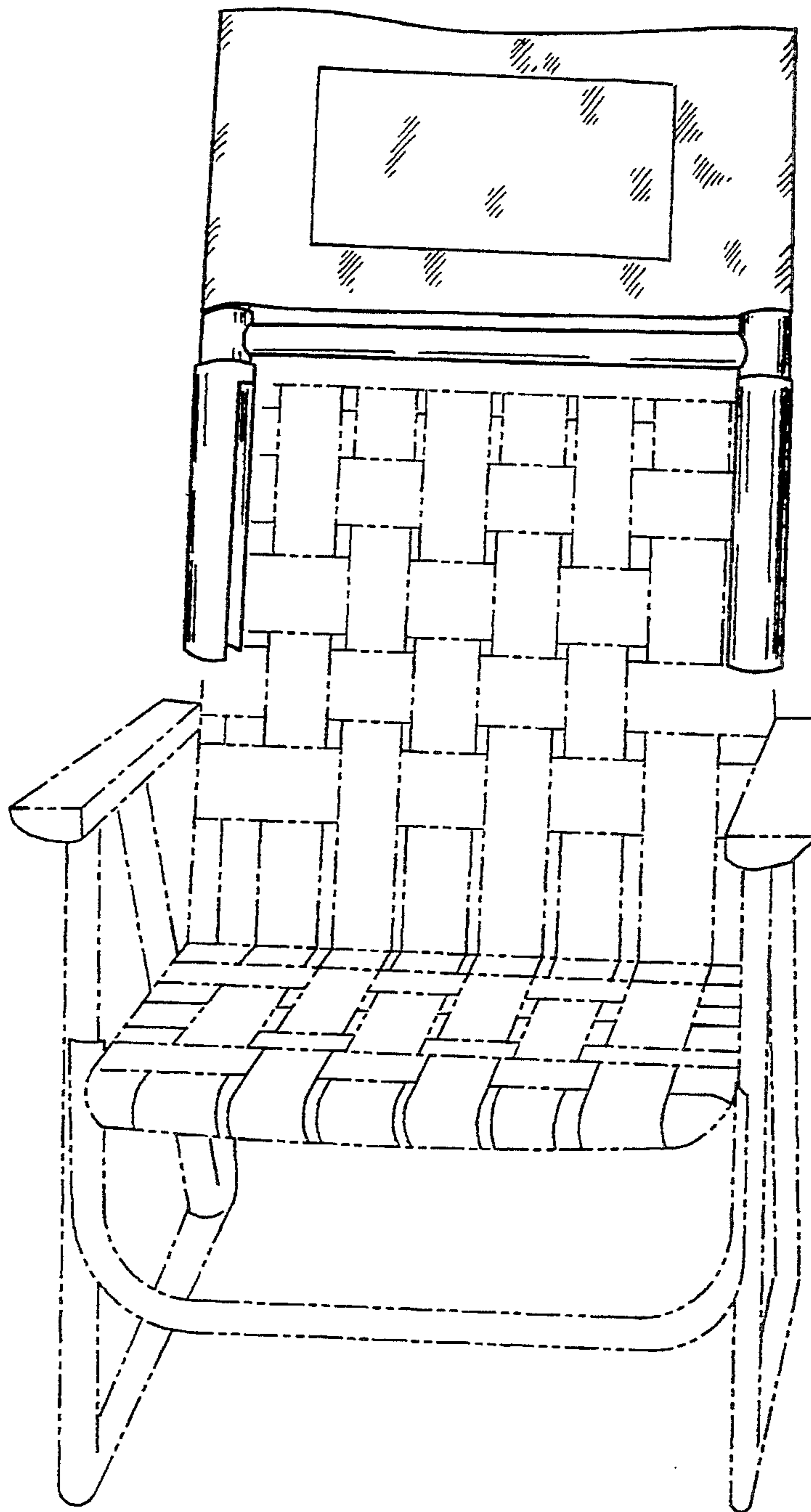
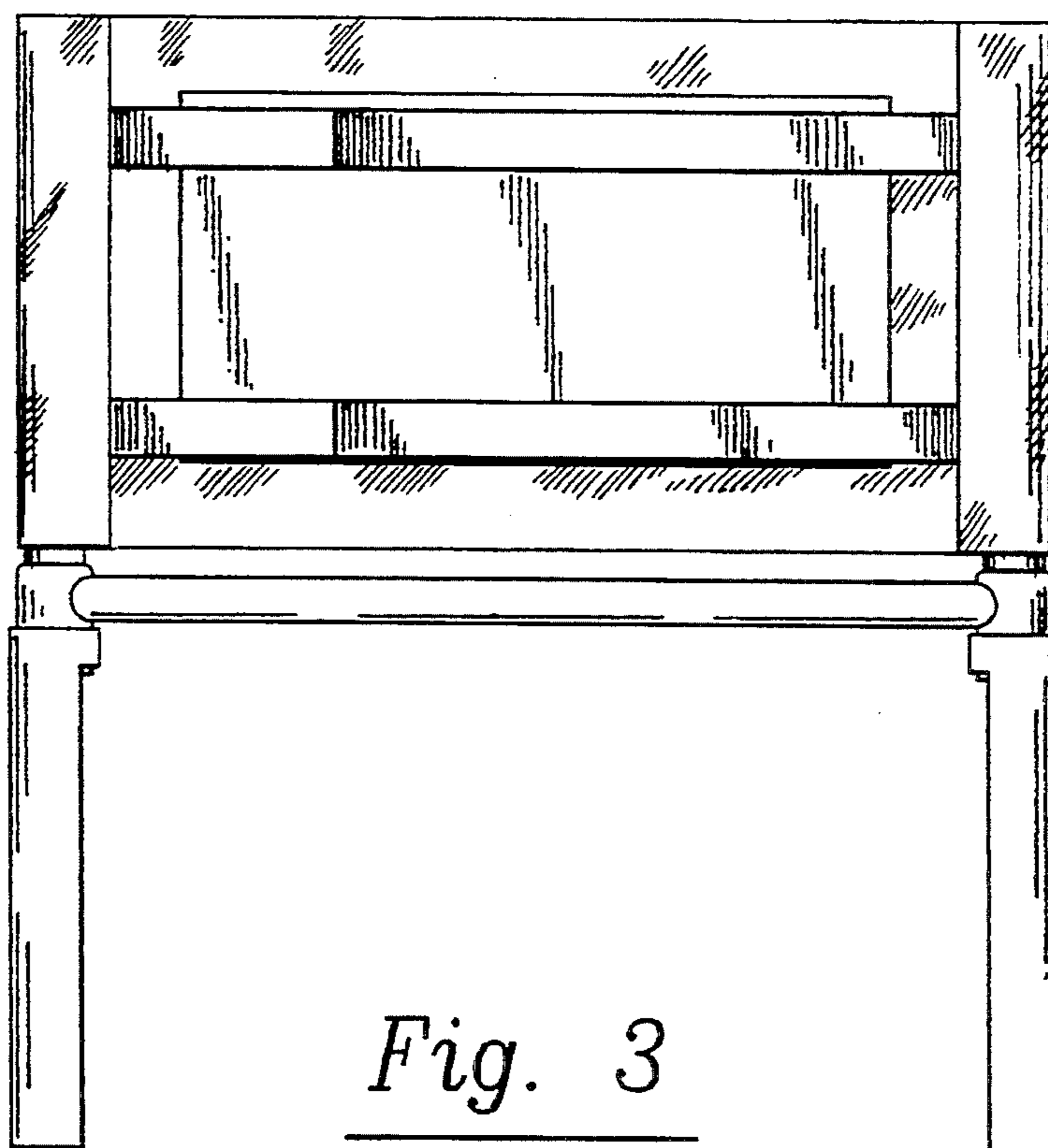
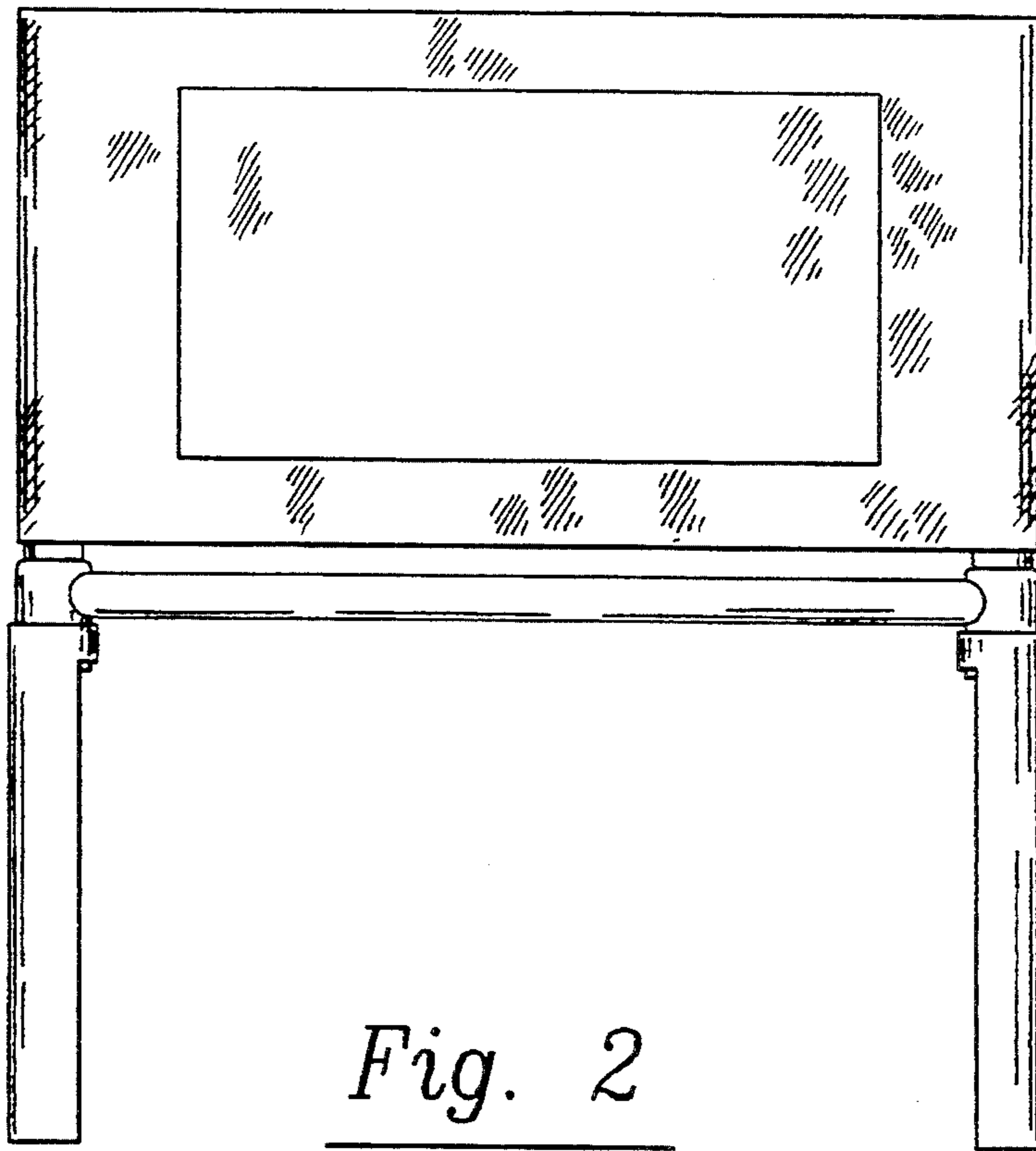

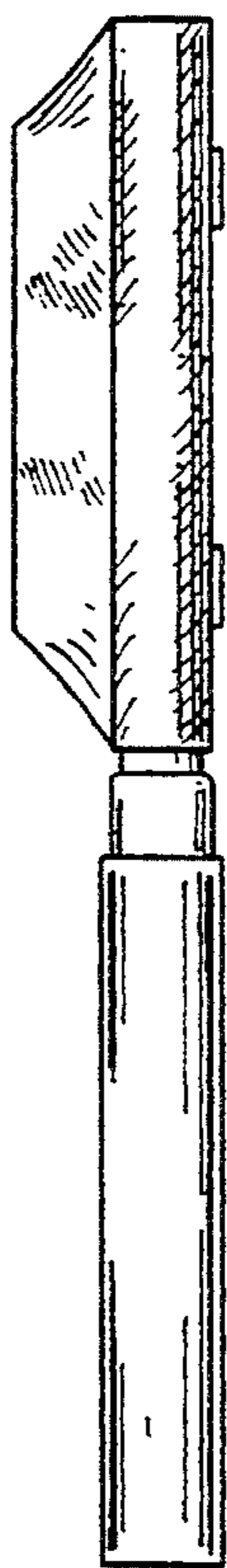

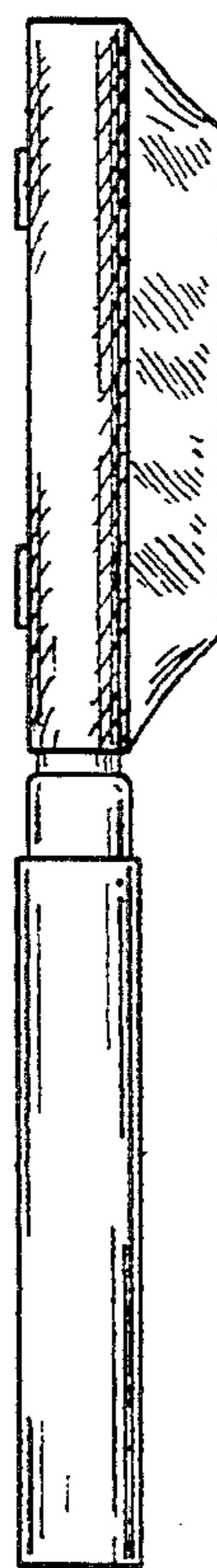

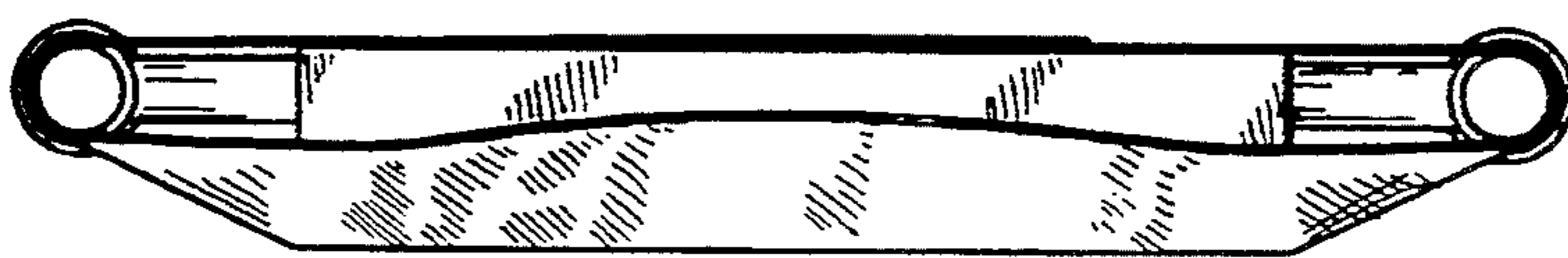

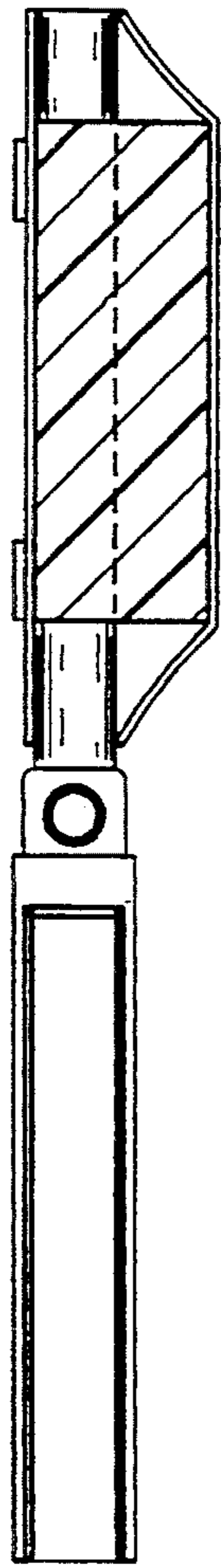

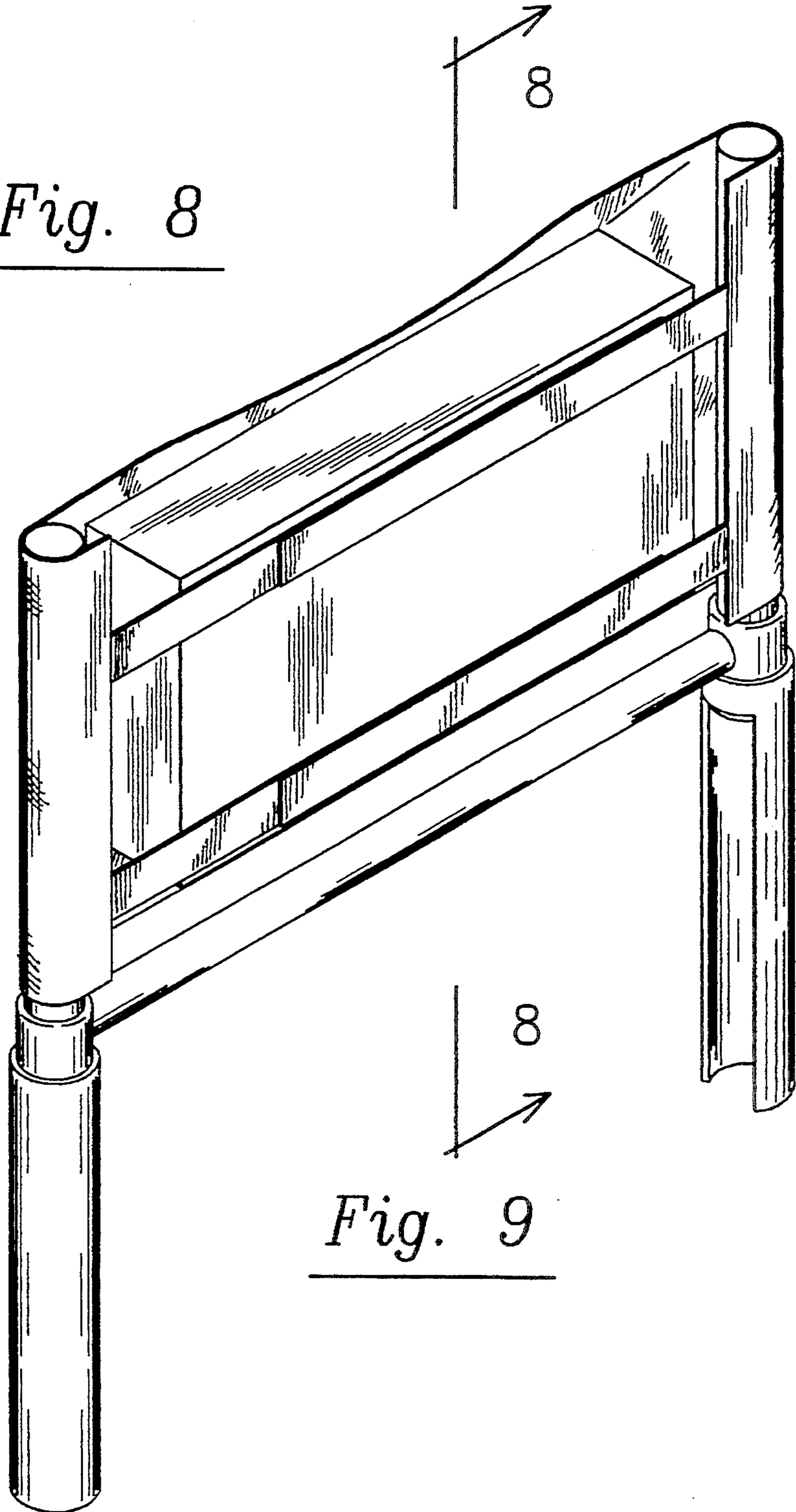
