The ornamental design for storm shutter, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of storm shutter, showing my new design, wherein a window of a residential or commercial building is shown in broken lines to illustrate the operative environment thereof and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof, partly broken away;

FIG. 5 is an enlarged view of the extreme lower right side of the storm shutter in FIG. 4, depicting a typical one of the cage nuts;

FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view thereof;

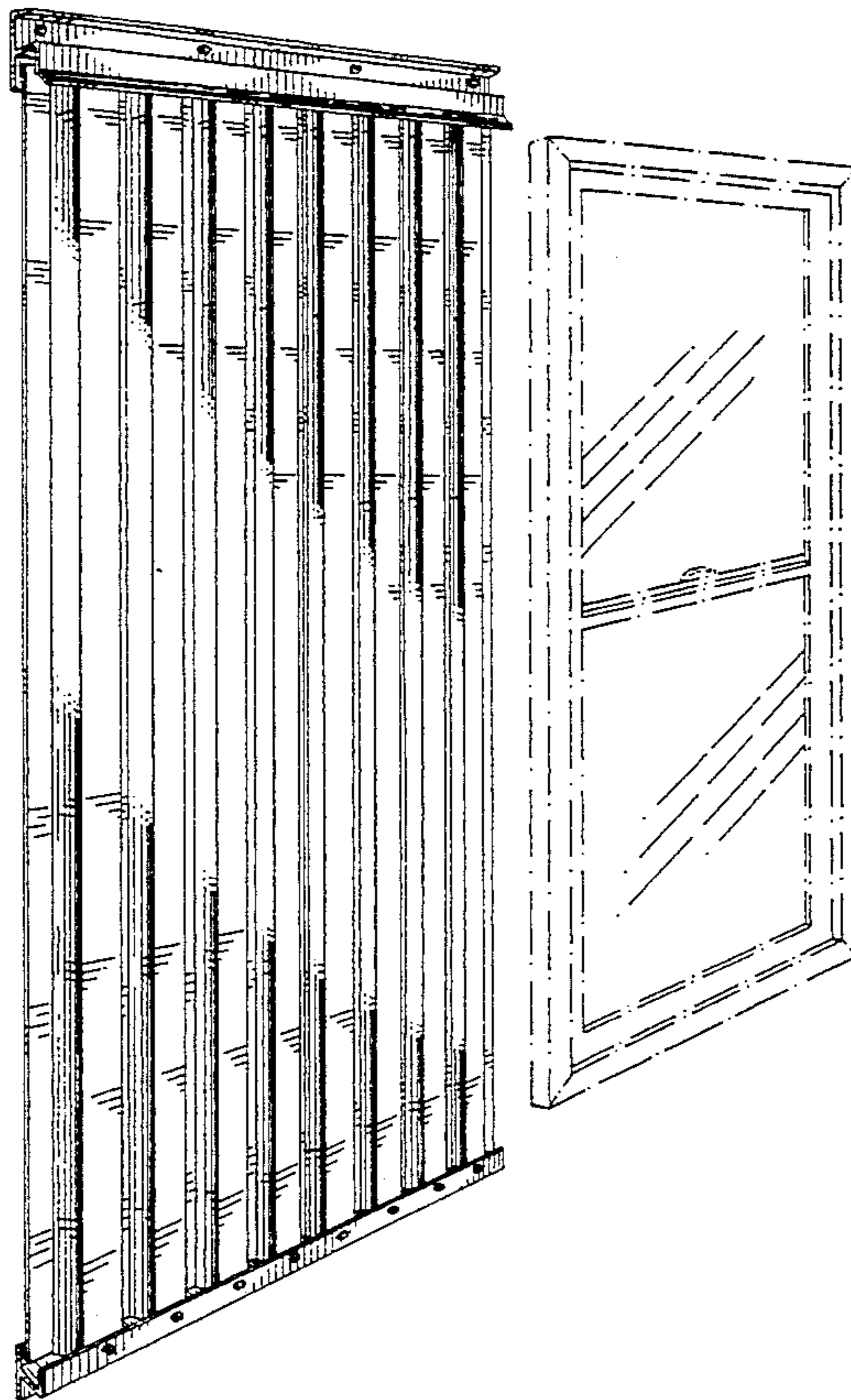
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof;

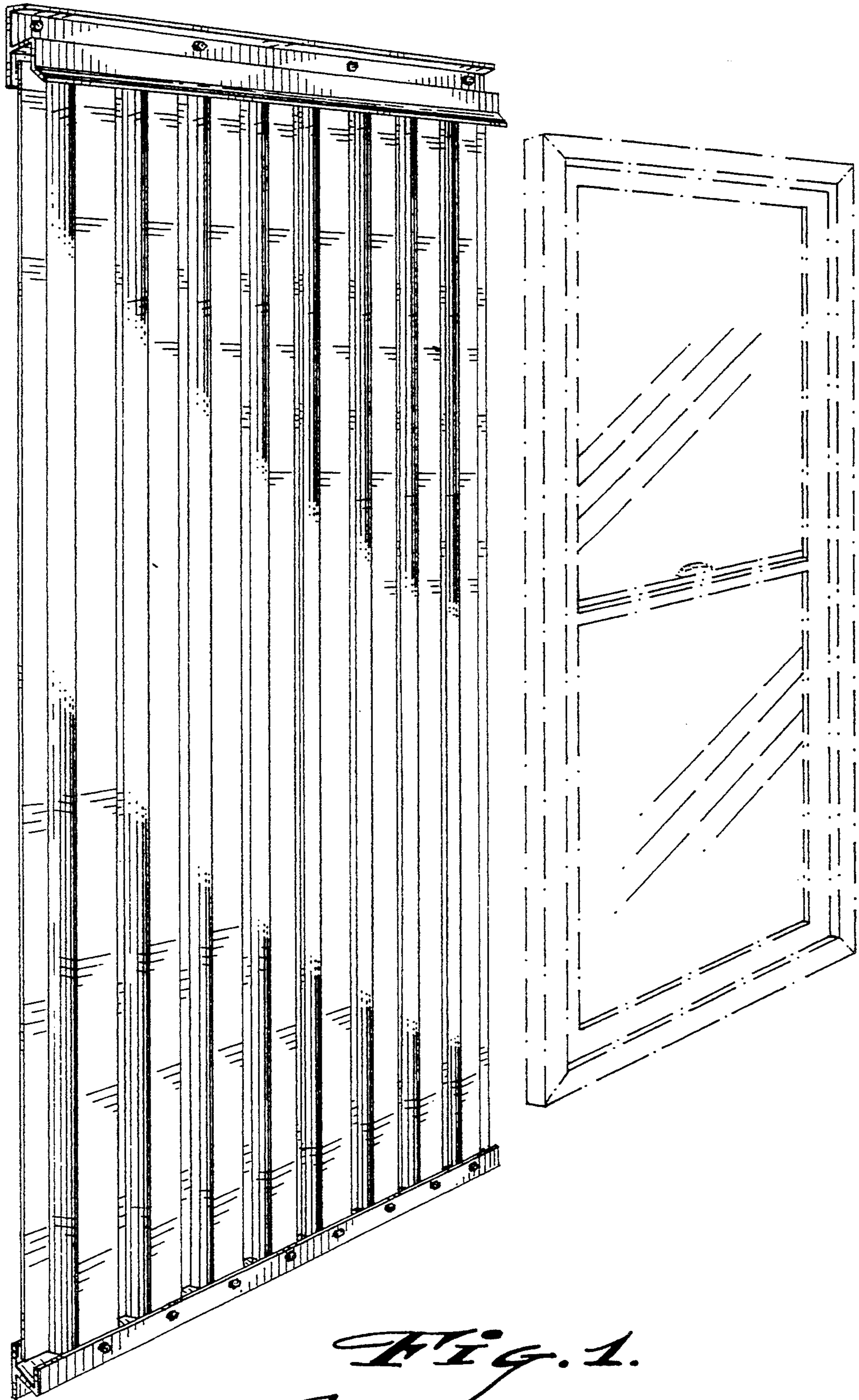
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the top rail, with the overlapped corrugated panels removed;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of the overlapped corrugated panels; and,

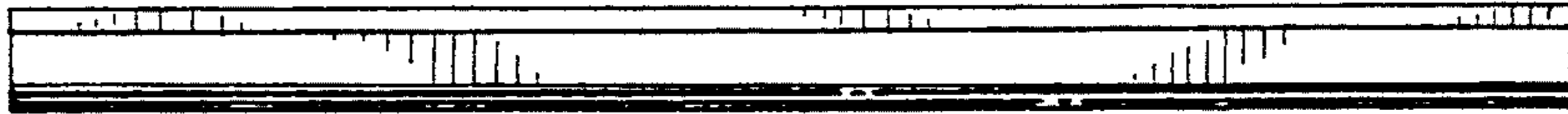
FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view of the overlapped corrugated panels.



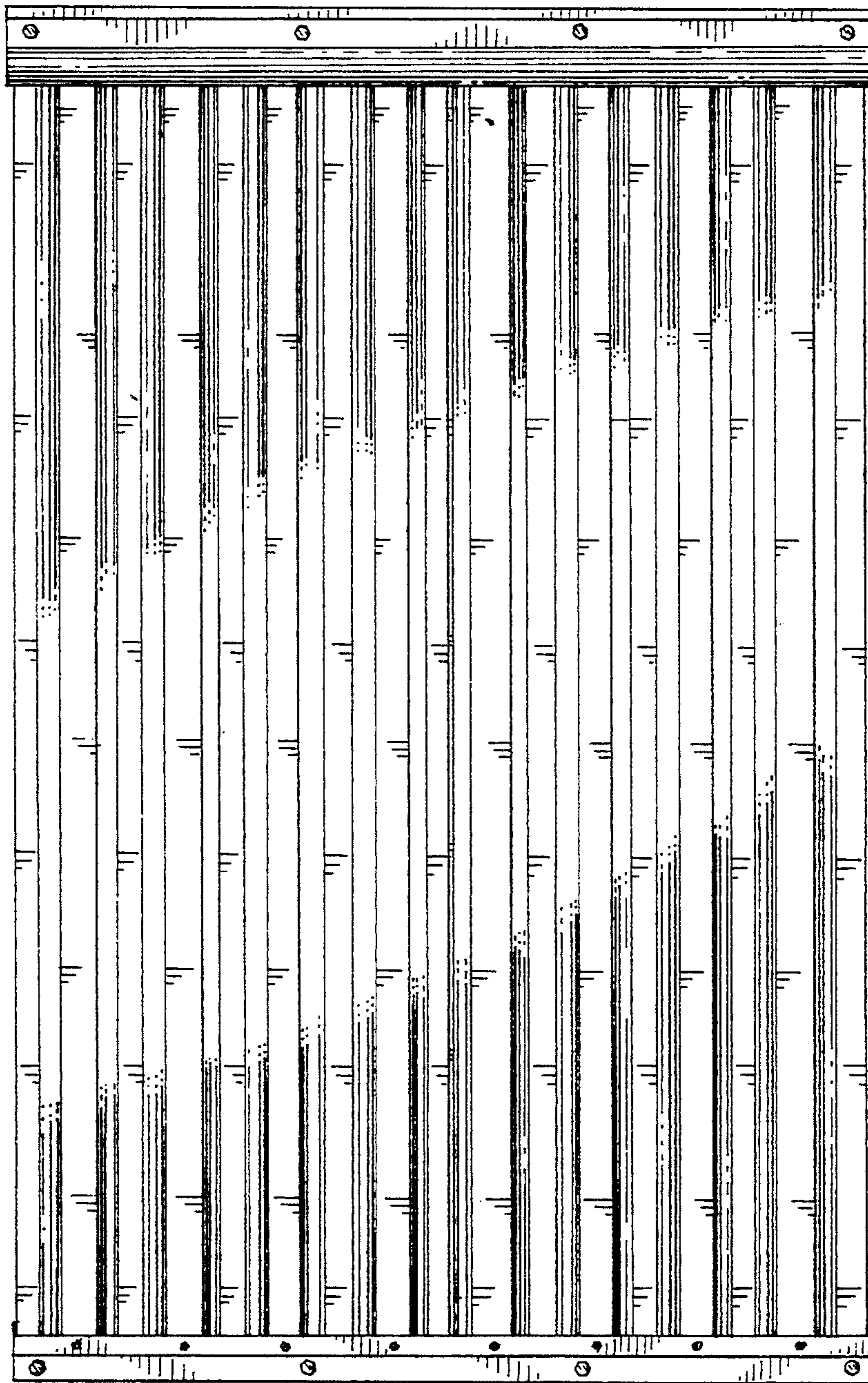

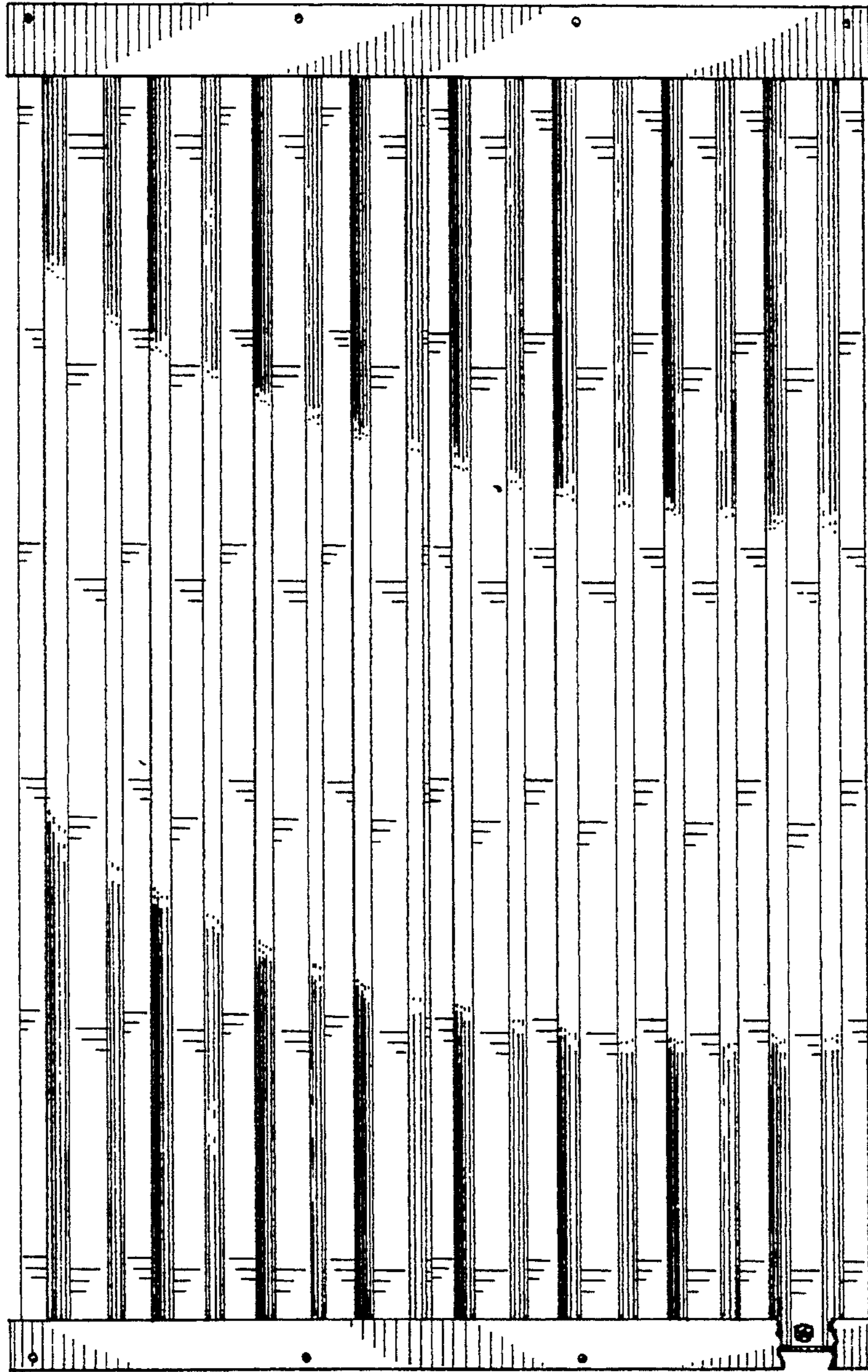




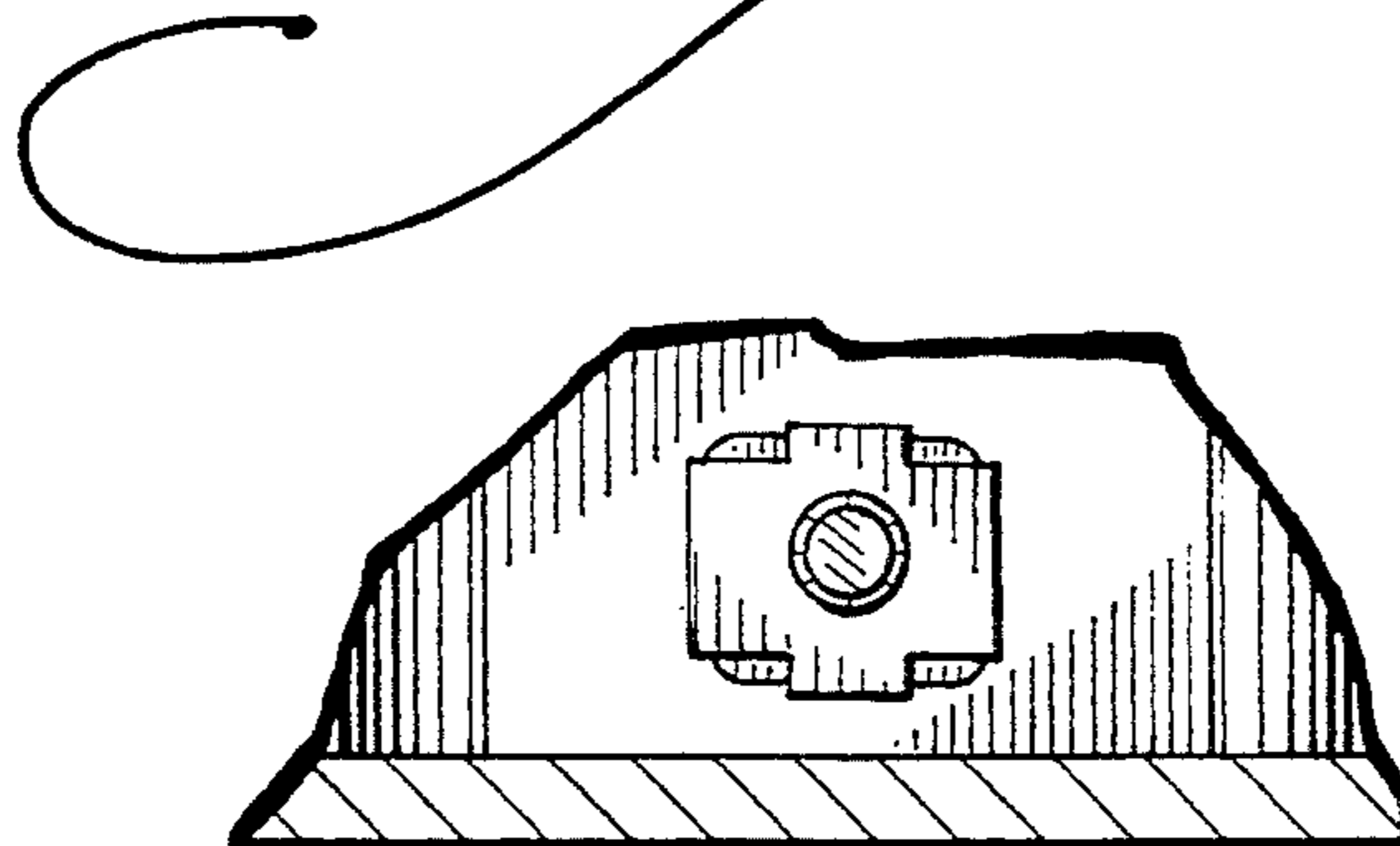

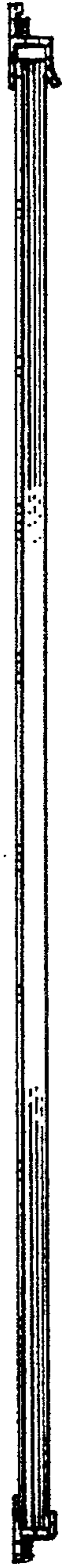
