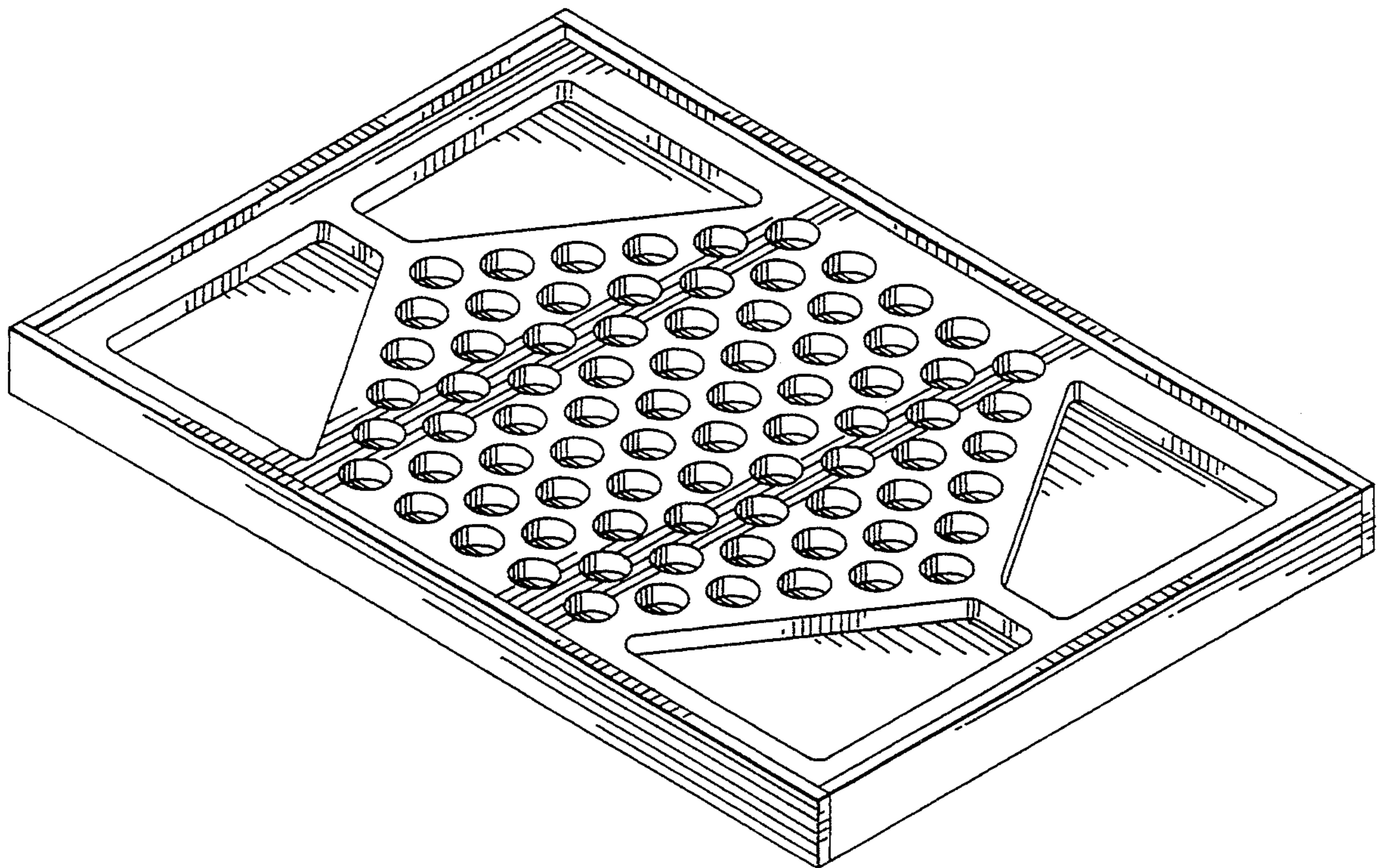

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, three-quarter perspective view of a board game showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a right side view, the left side view being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view, the rear view being identical thereto; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



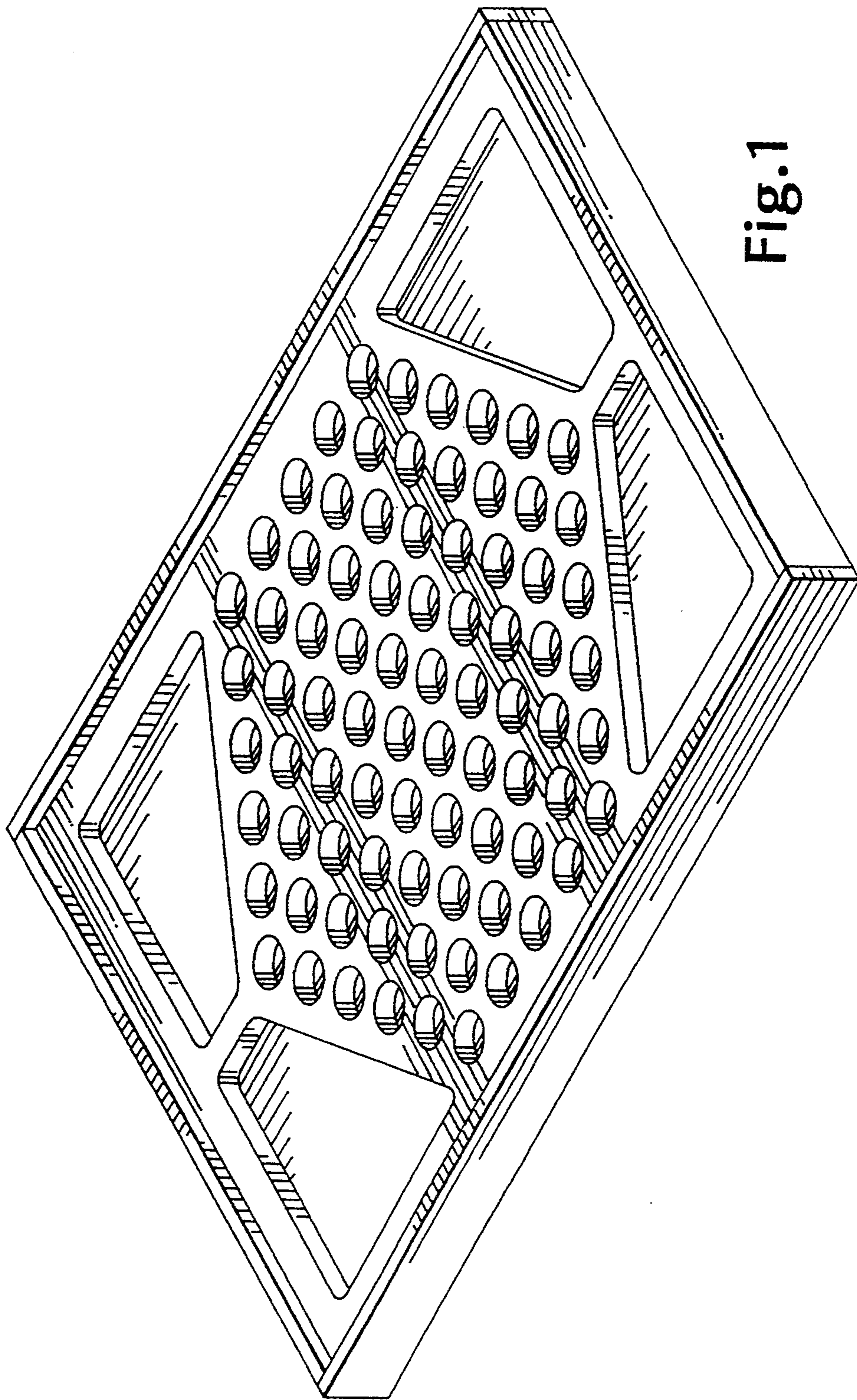

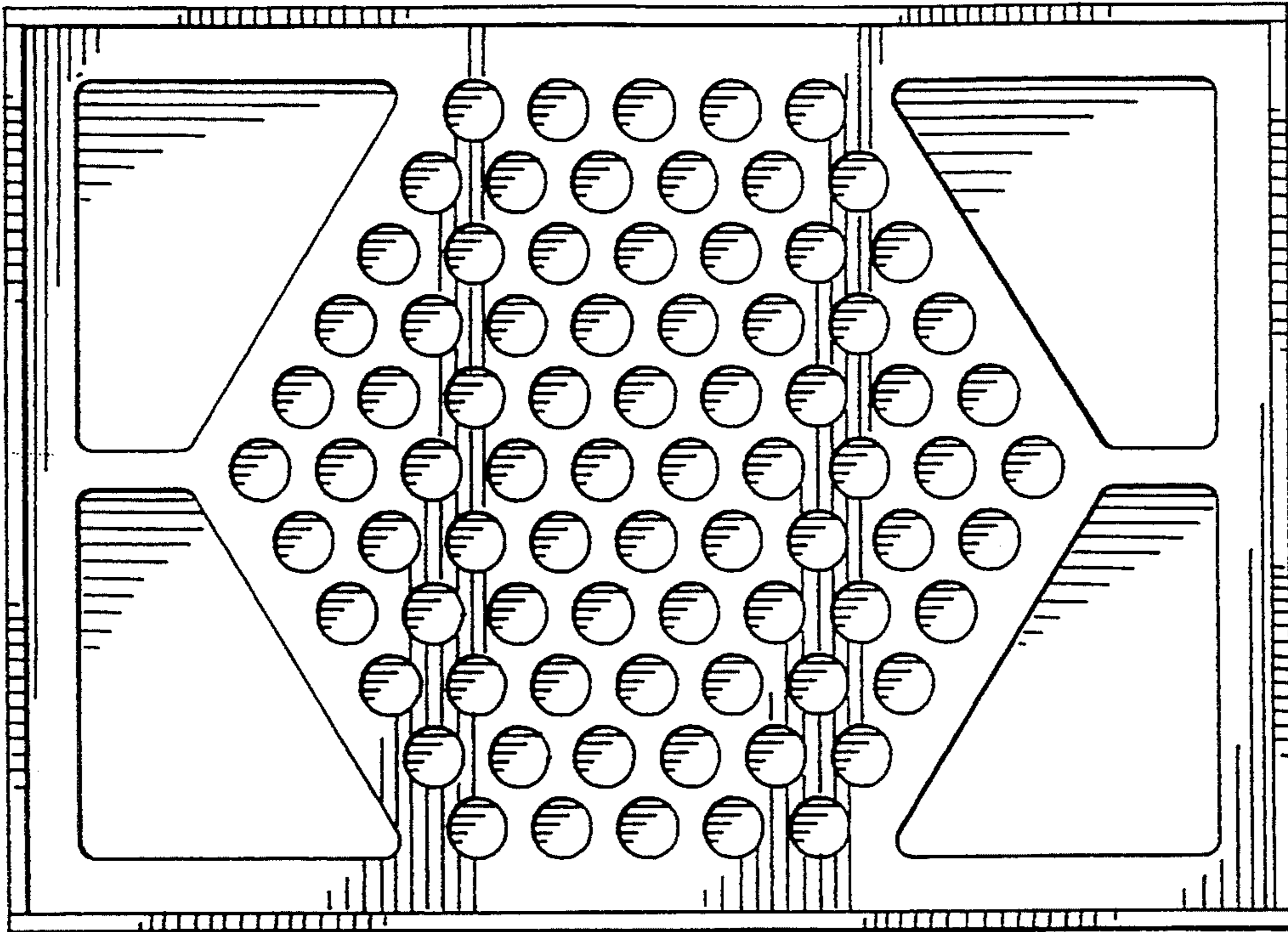

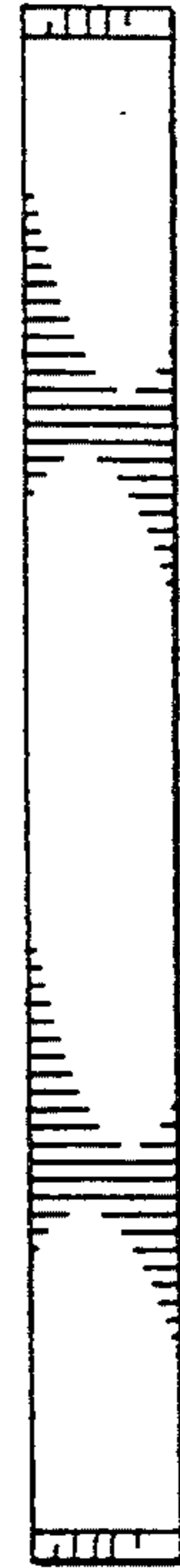

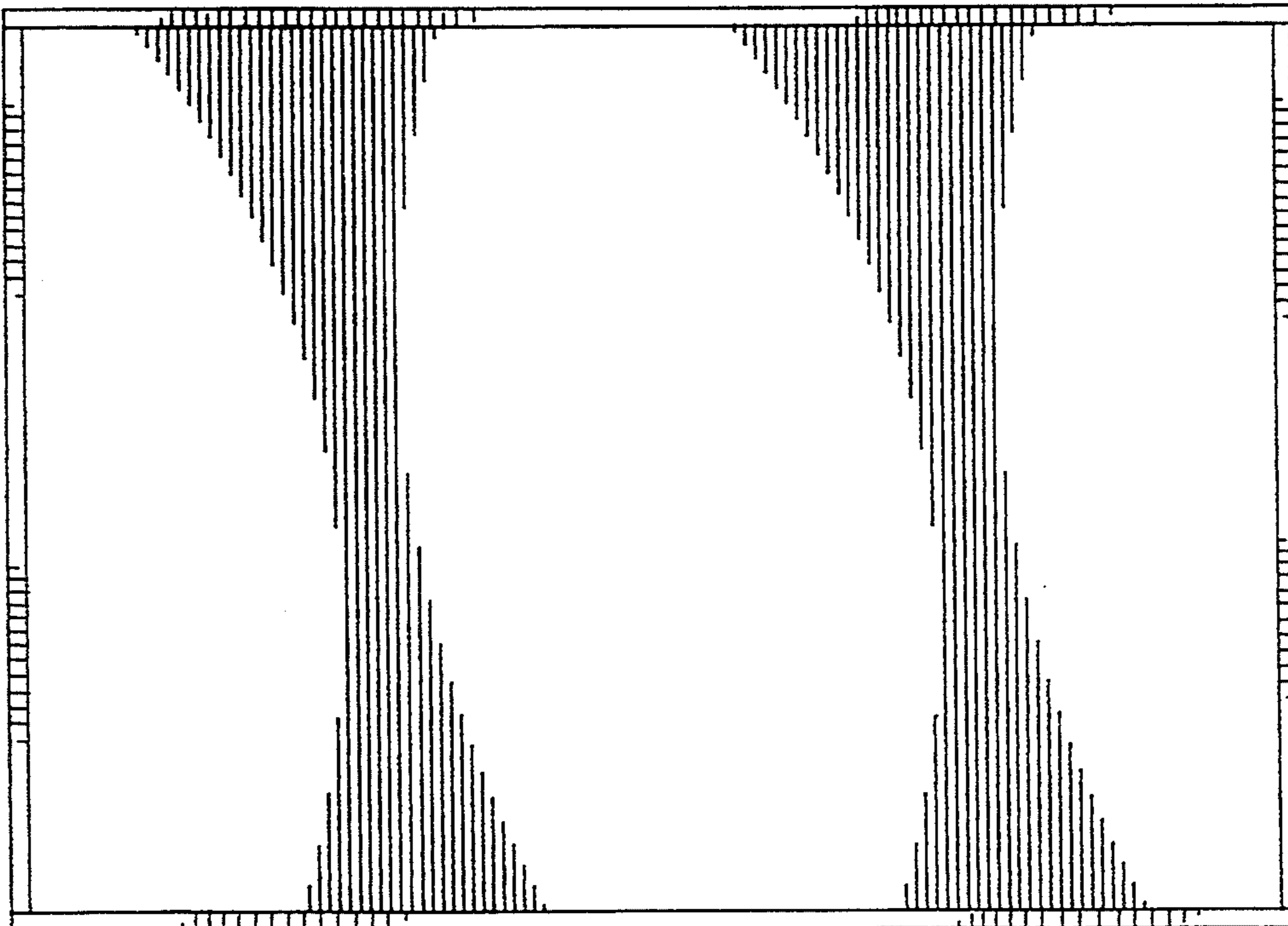
