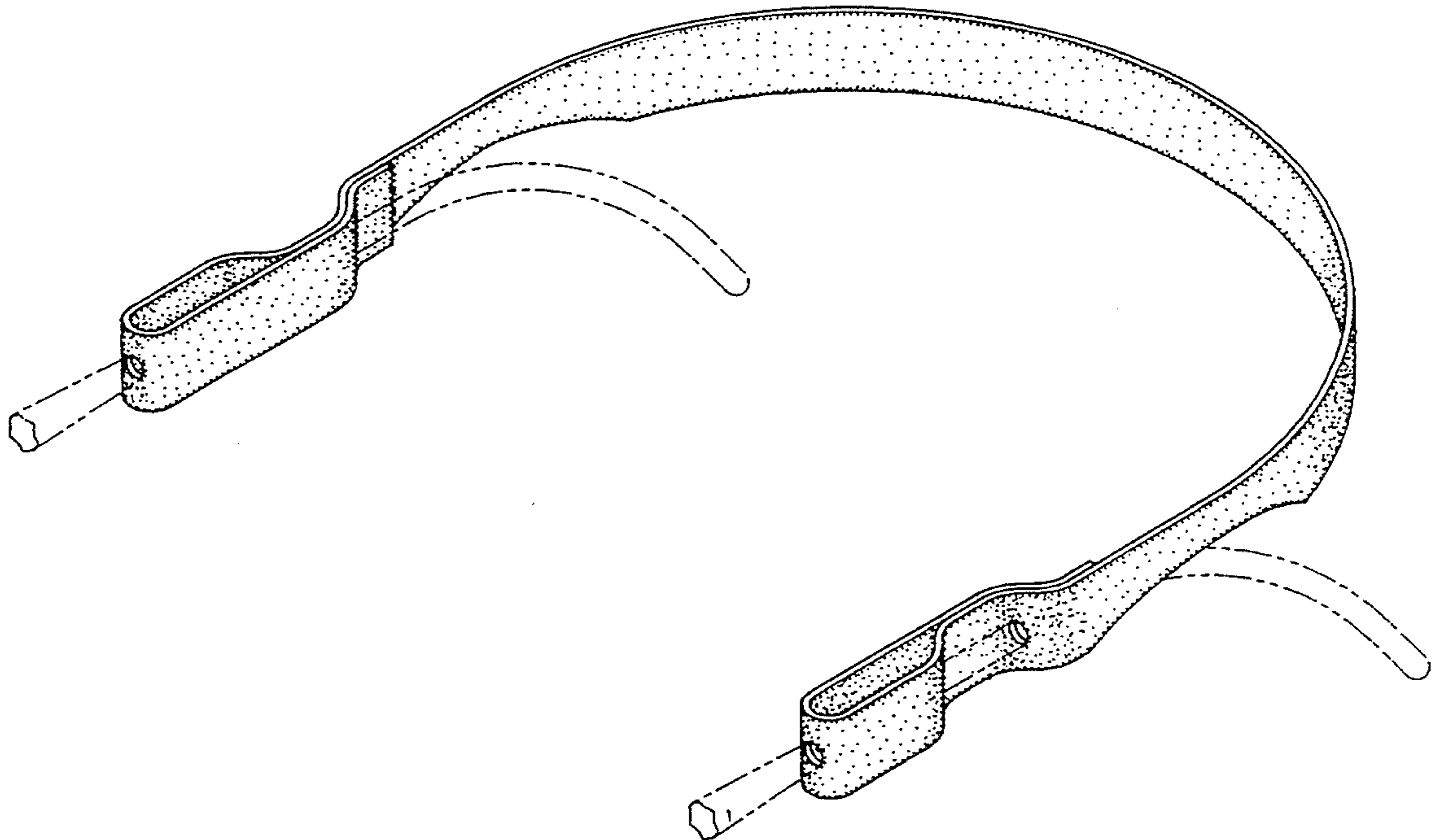
The ornamental design of an eye glass holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 perspective view of an eye glass holder showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a perspective view the eye glass holder assembled on the temples of a pair of eyeglasses, the broken line showing of the temples is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof; the right side being identical thereto;

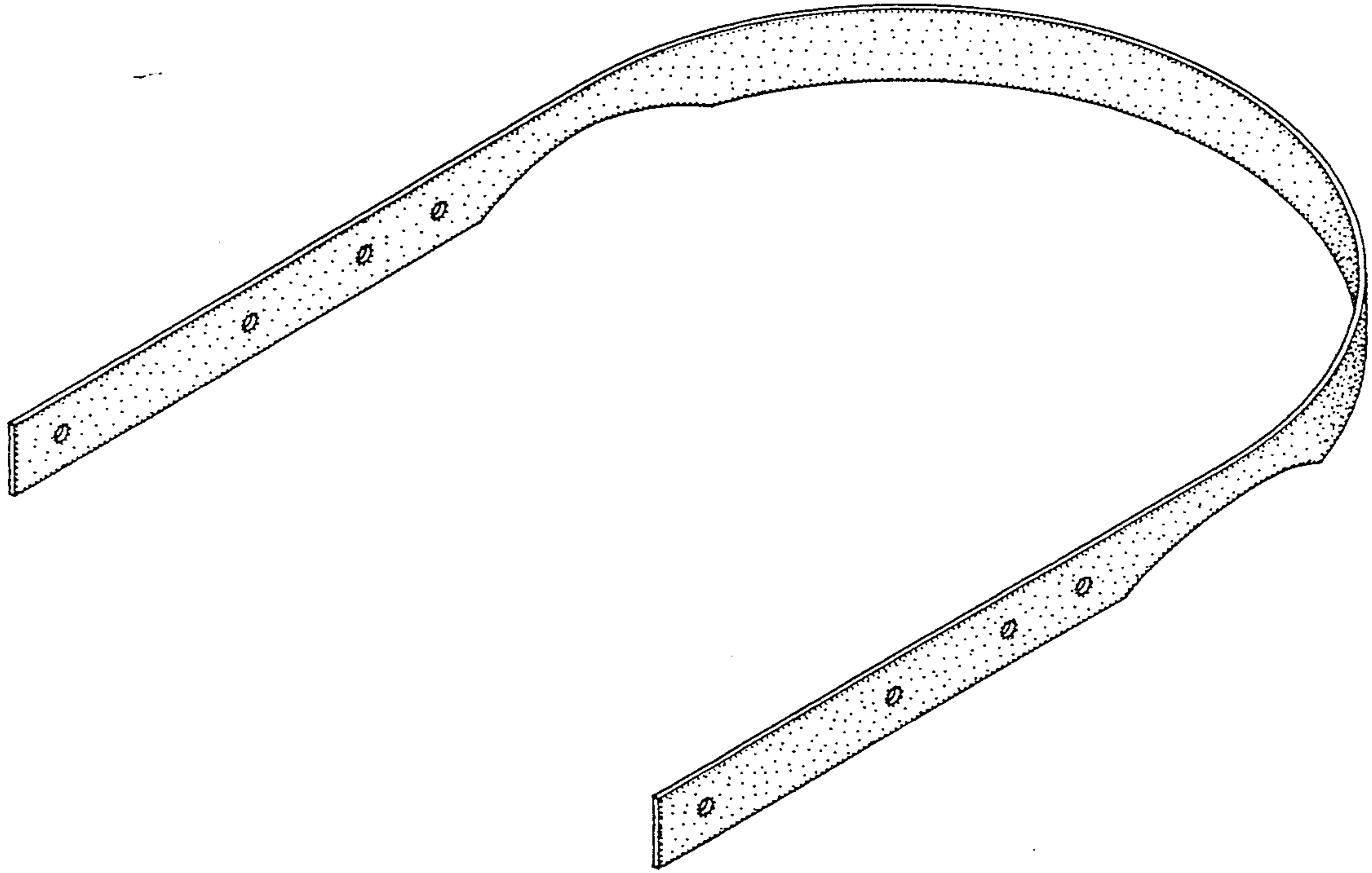

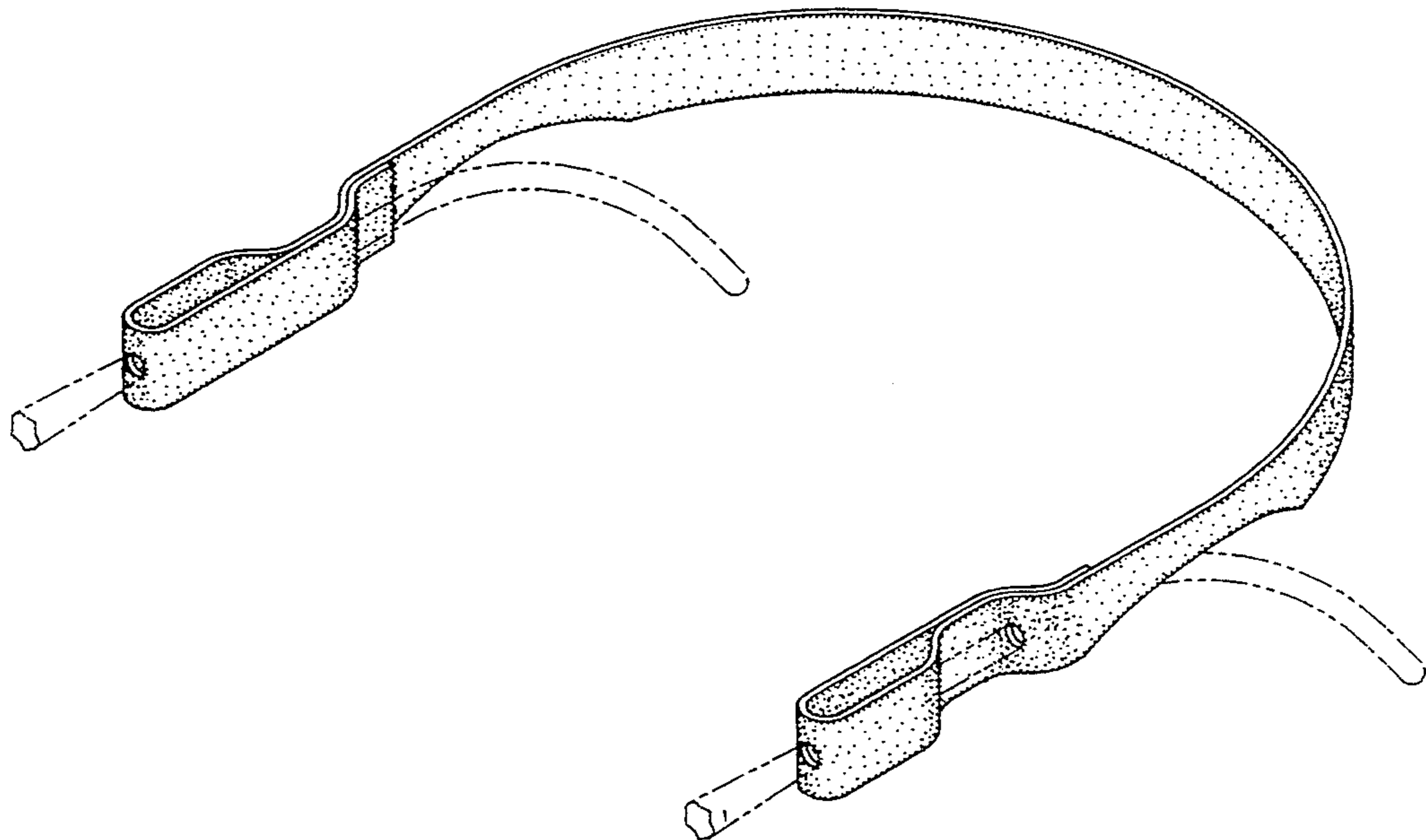

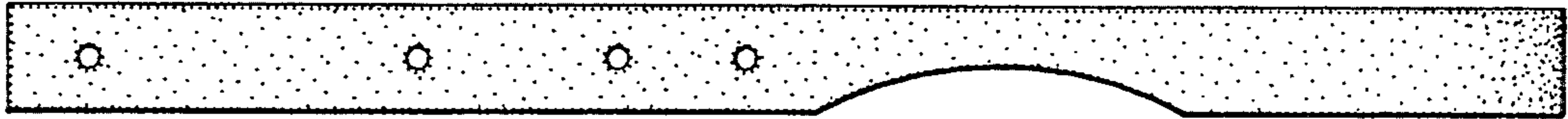

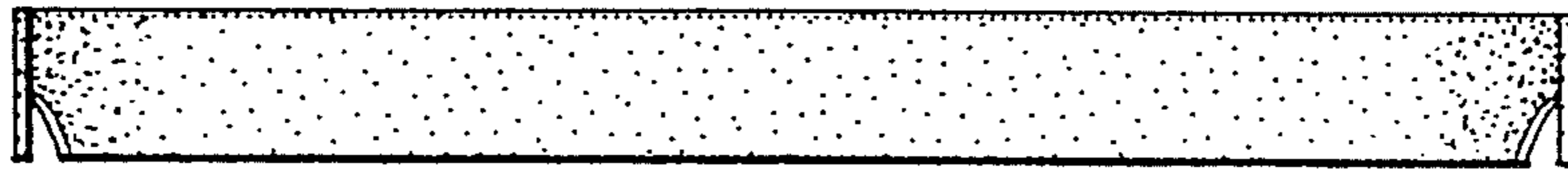

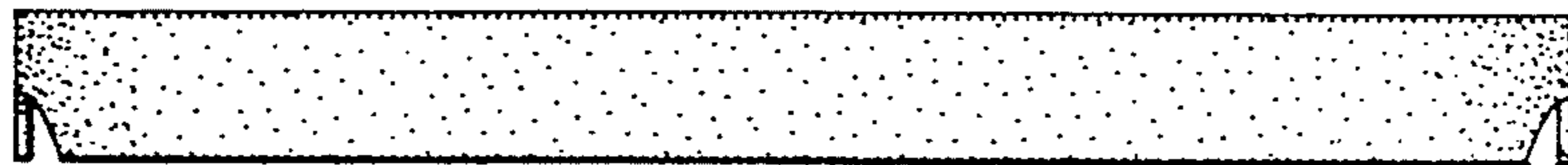

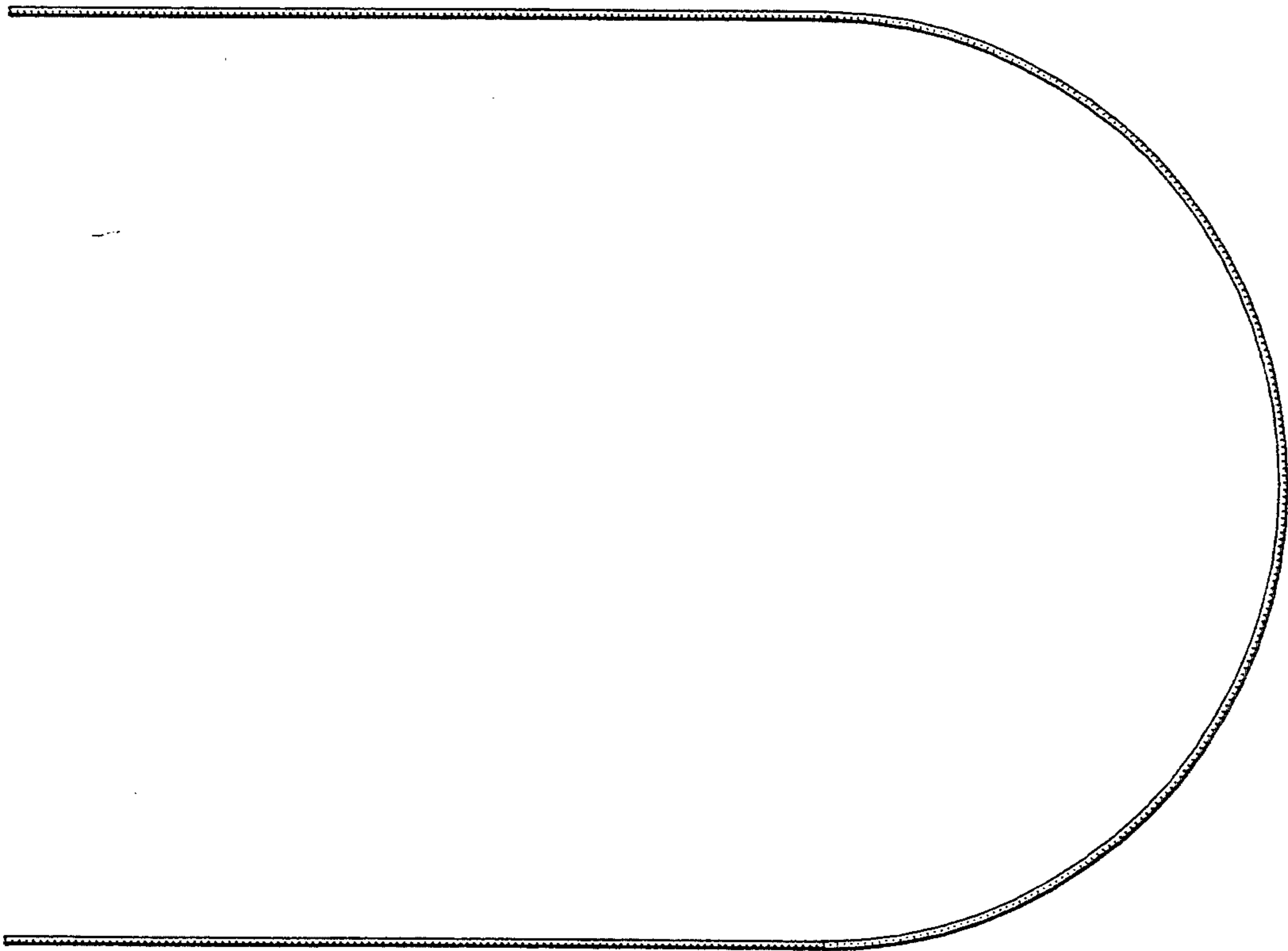

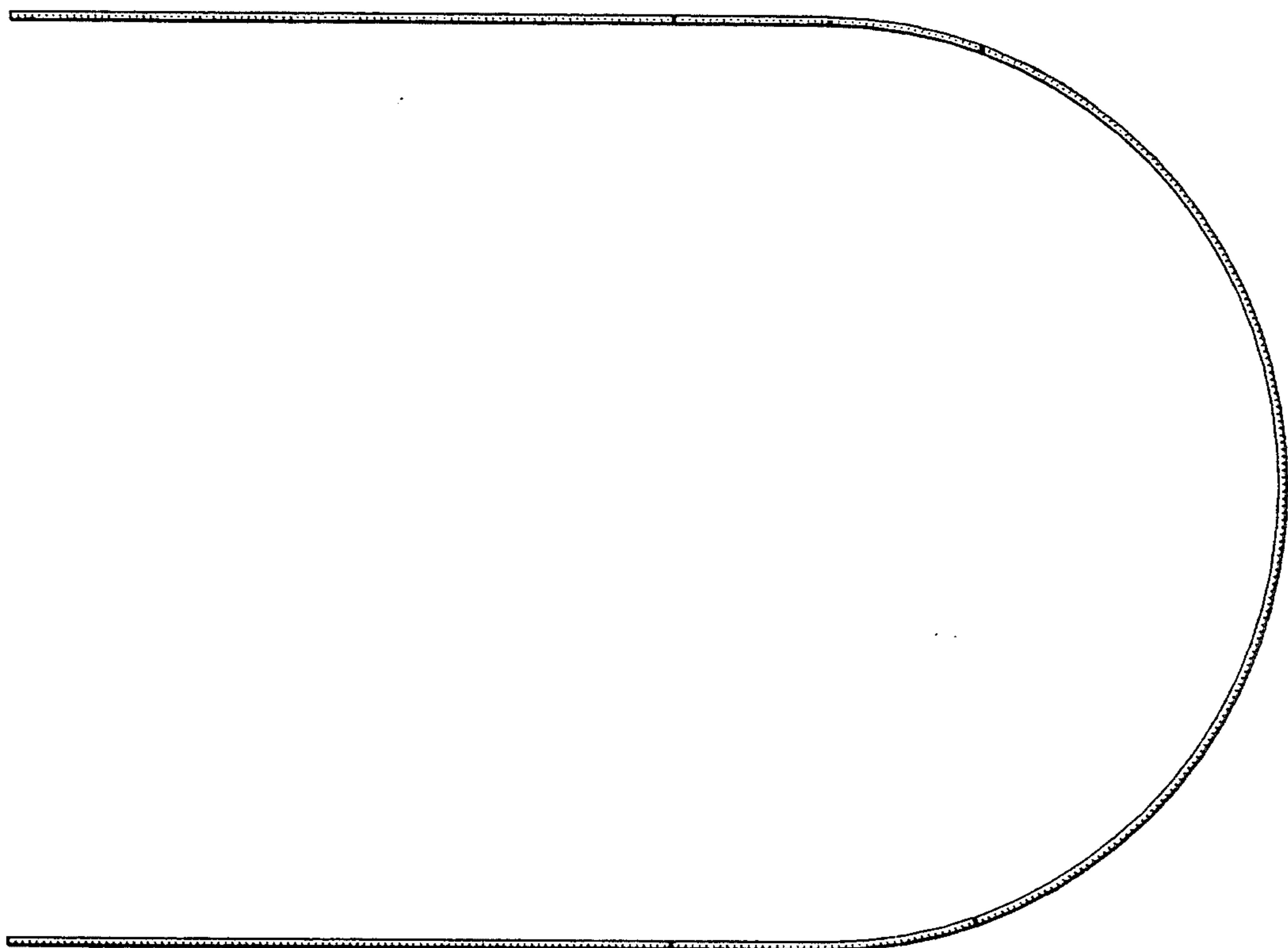
