The ornamental design for a guitar body, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a guitar body showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a lower end elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is an upper end elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a guitar hardware is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

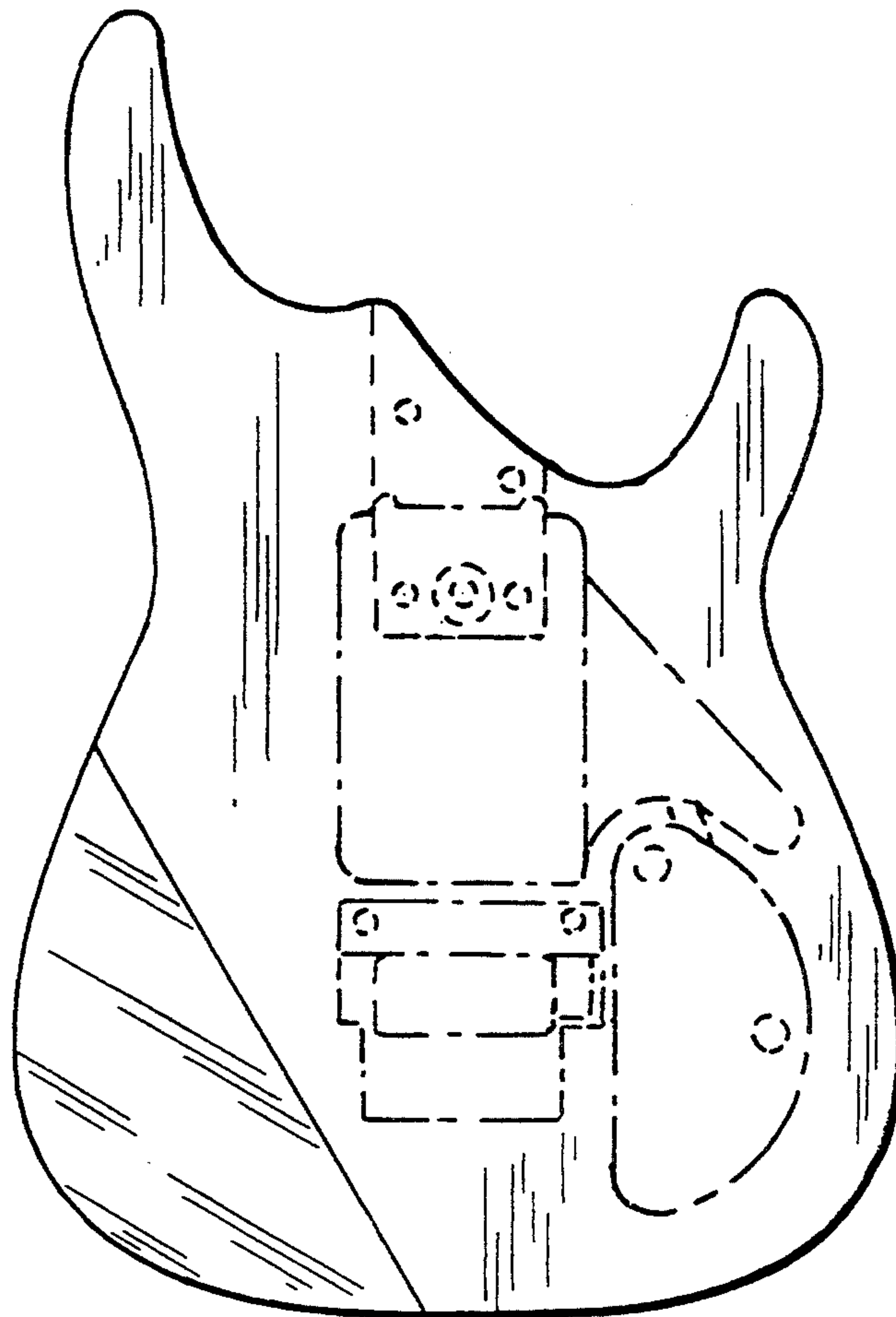

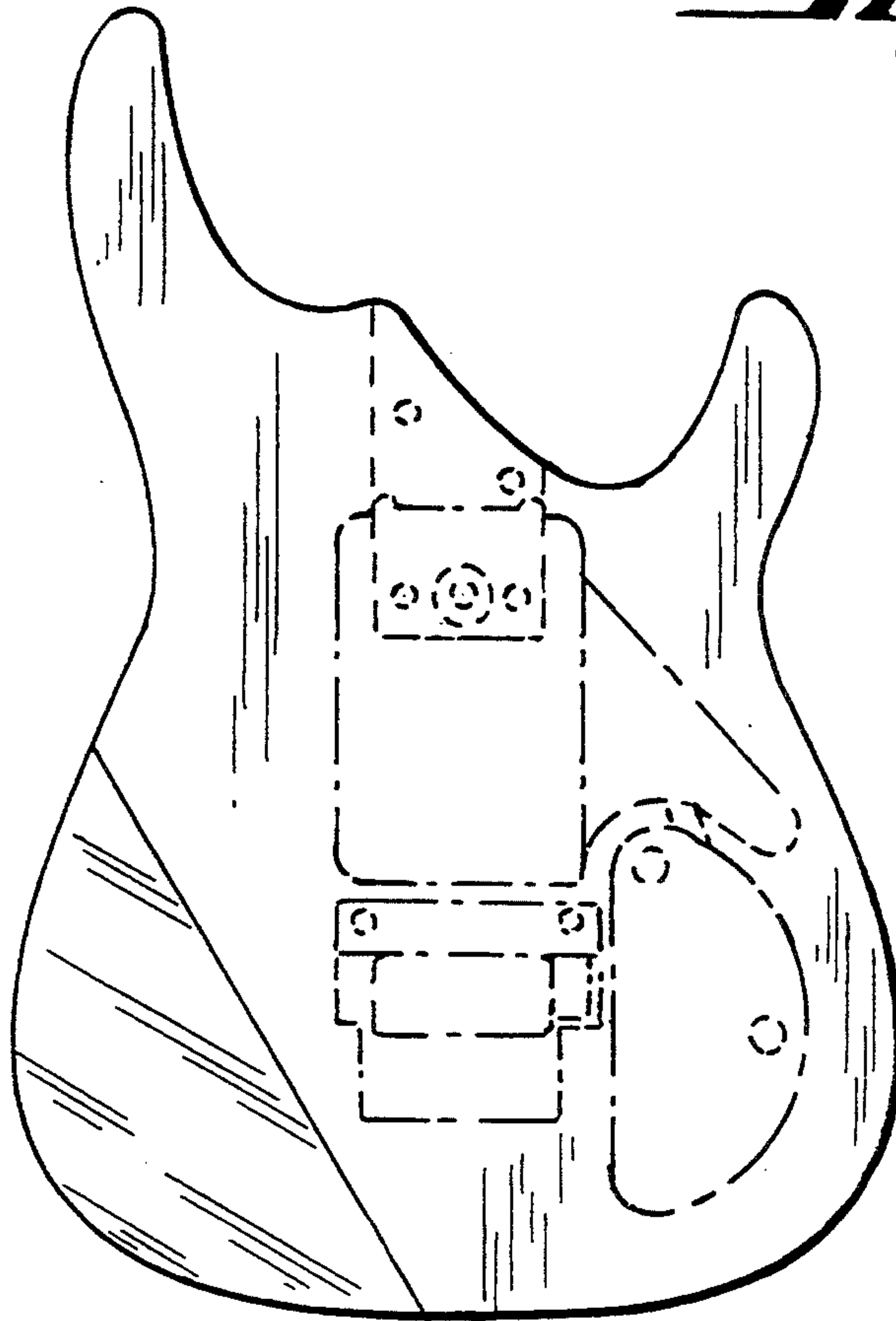

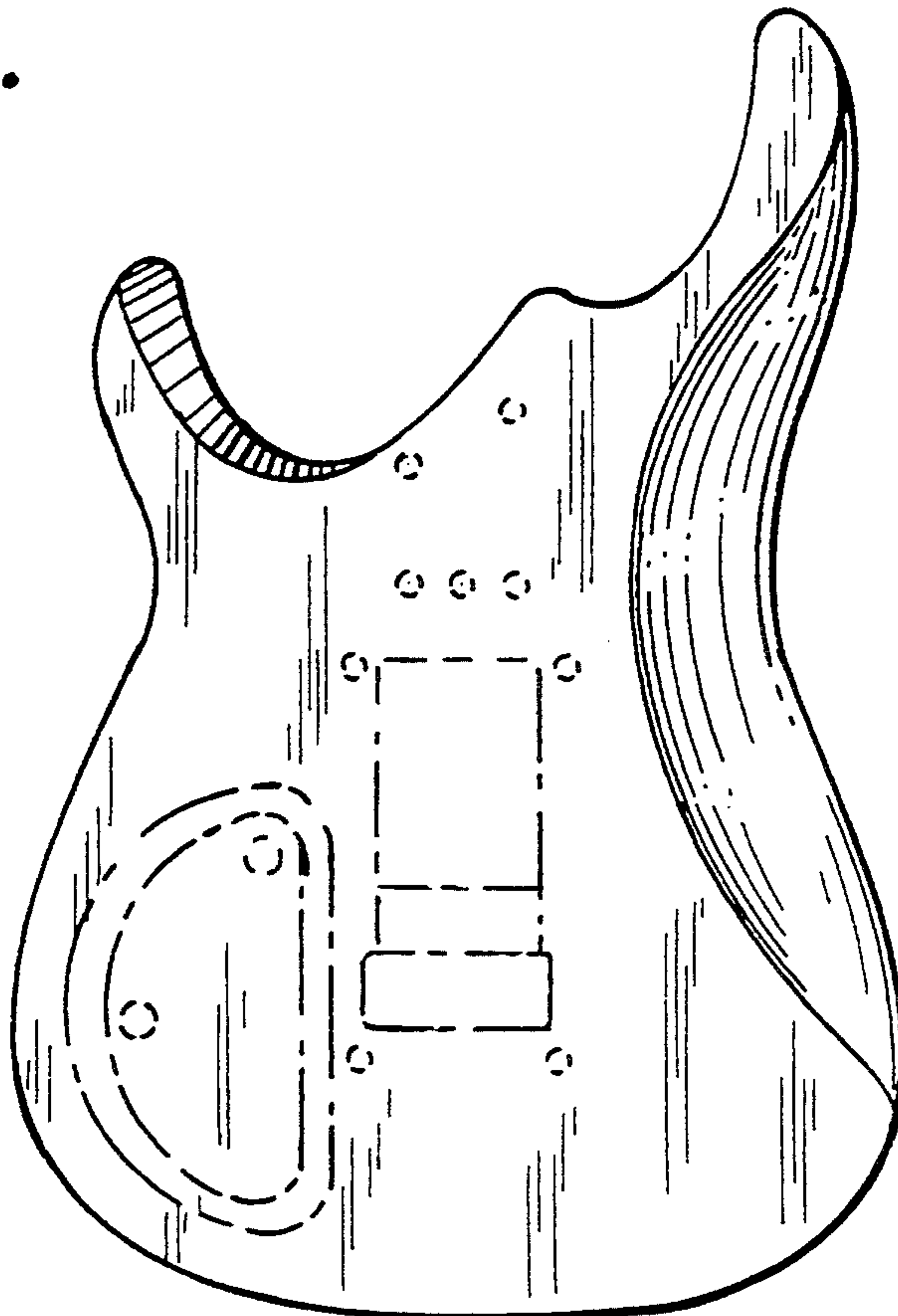
