The ornamental design for an combined eraser system and dry markers, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a combined eraser system and dry markers shwoing our new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 4 is an end elevational view;



FIG. 5 is an end elevational view of the end not shown in FIG. 4;















