[57] CLAIM

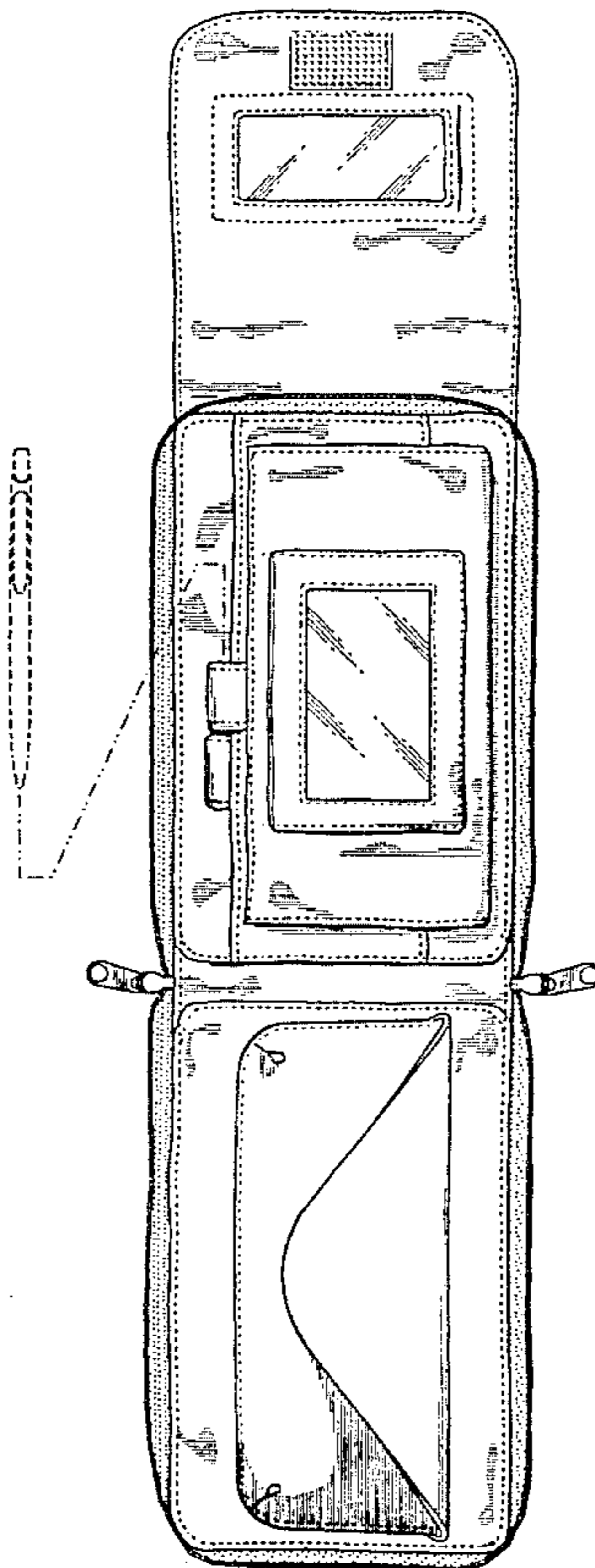
The ornamental design for a combined purse and wallet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a first embodiment of a combined purse and wallet showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of said first embodiment; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of said first embodiment; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of said first embodiment; FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view of said first embodiment; FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view of said first embodiment; FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a second embodiment of a combined purse and wallet showing my new design; FIG. 8 is a top plan view of said second embodiment; FIG. 9 is a rear elevational view of said second embodiment; FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of said second embodiment; FIG. 11 is a left side elevational view of said second embodiment; and, FIG. 12 is a right side elevational view of said second embodiment.

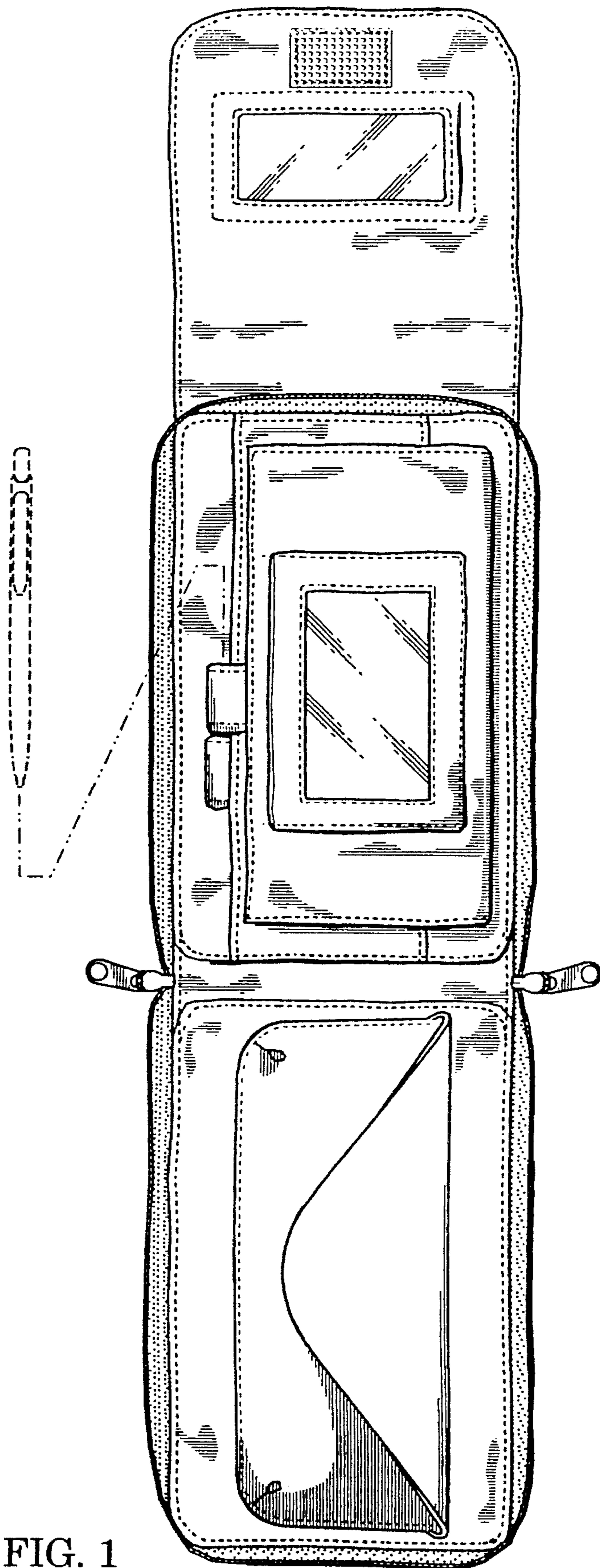

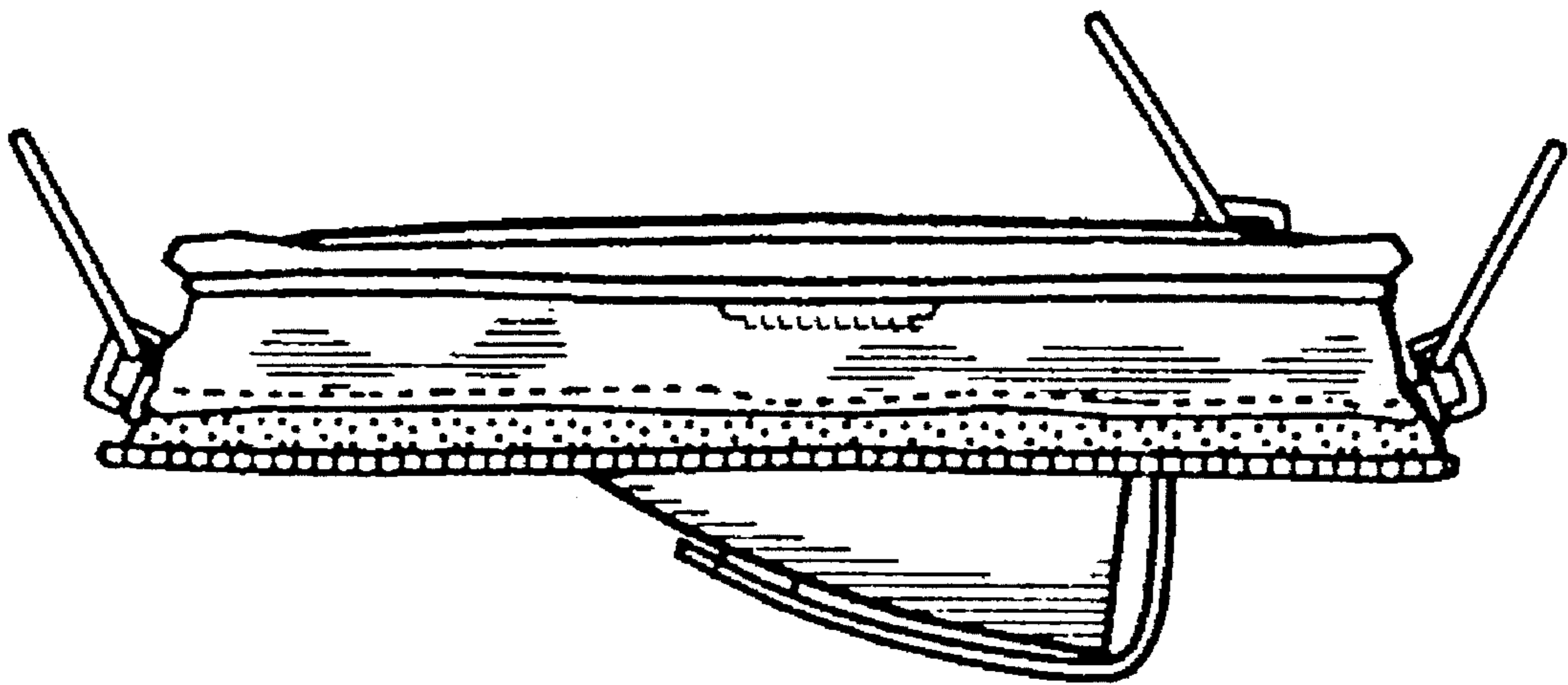

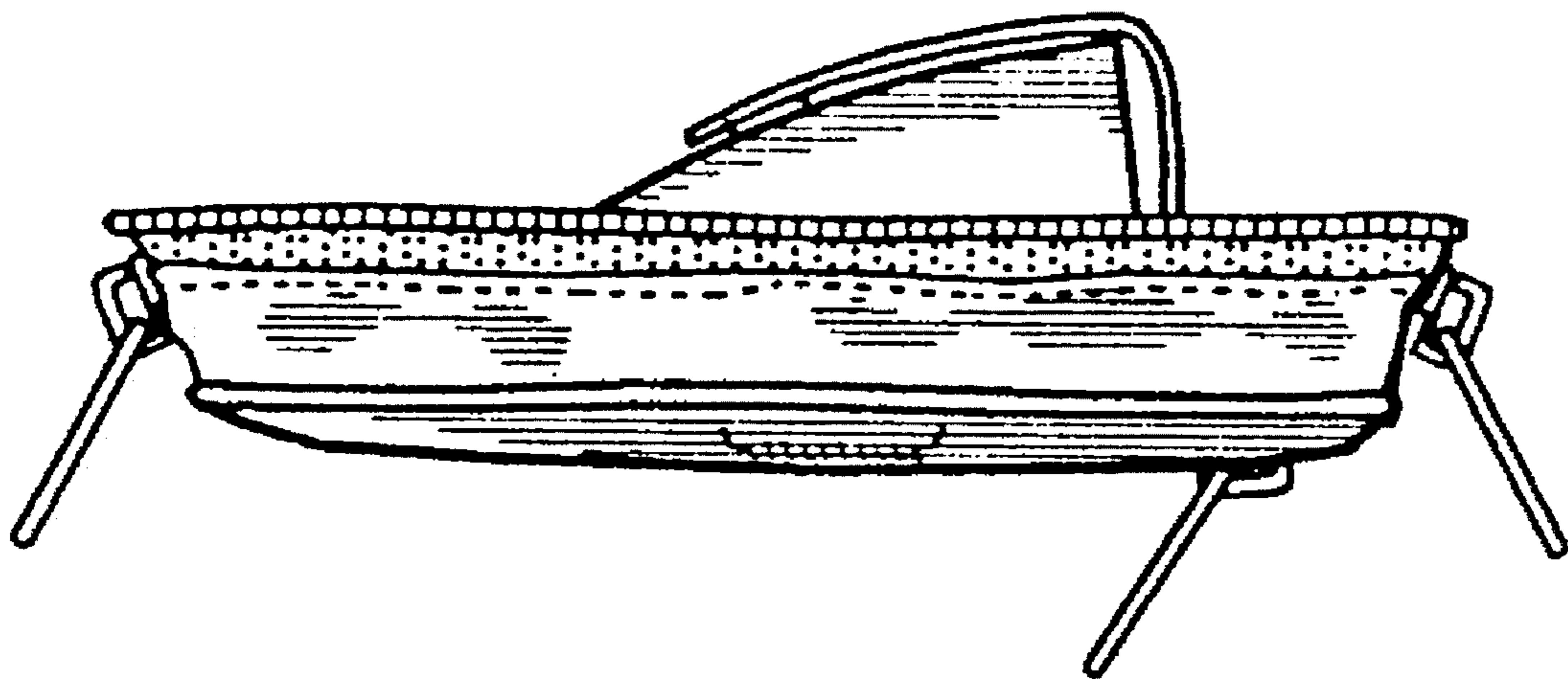

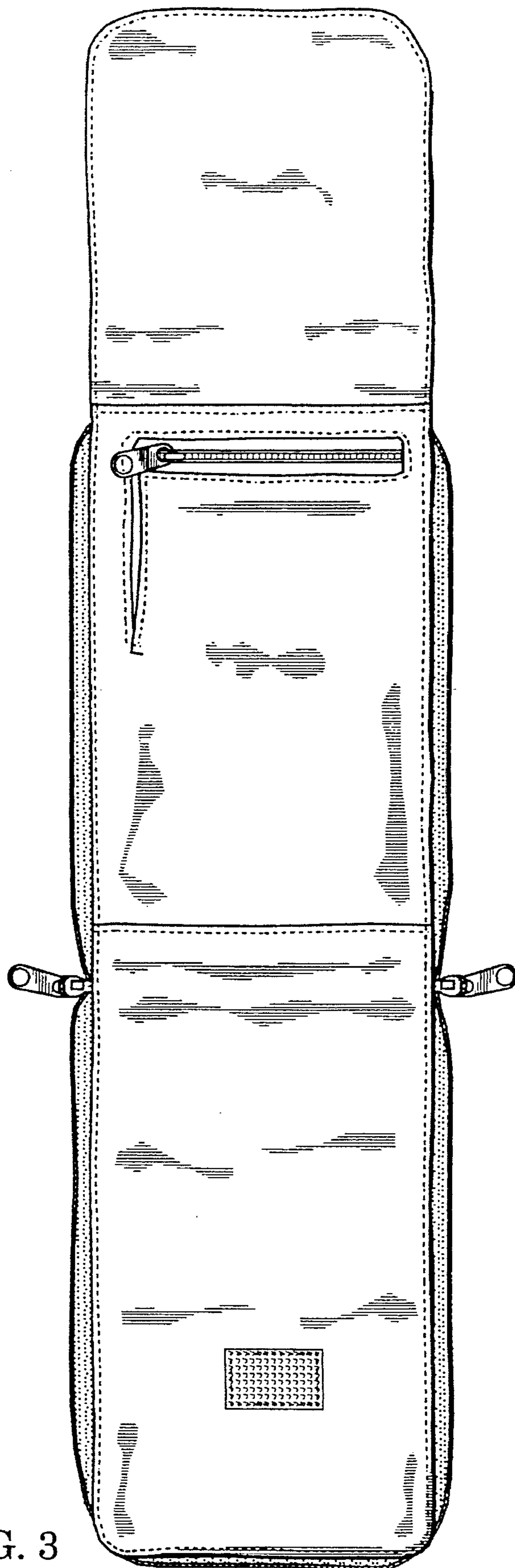

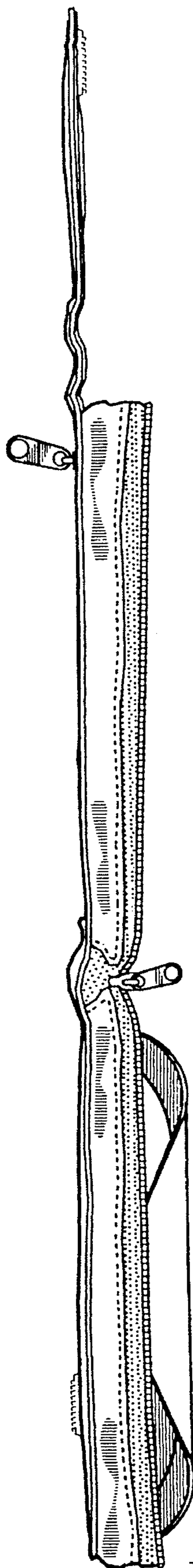

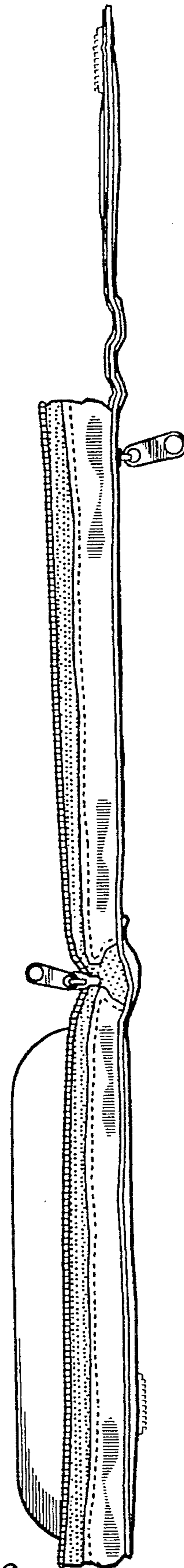

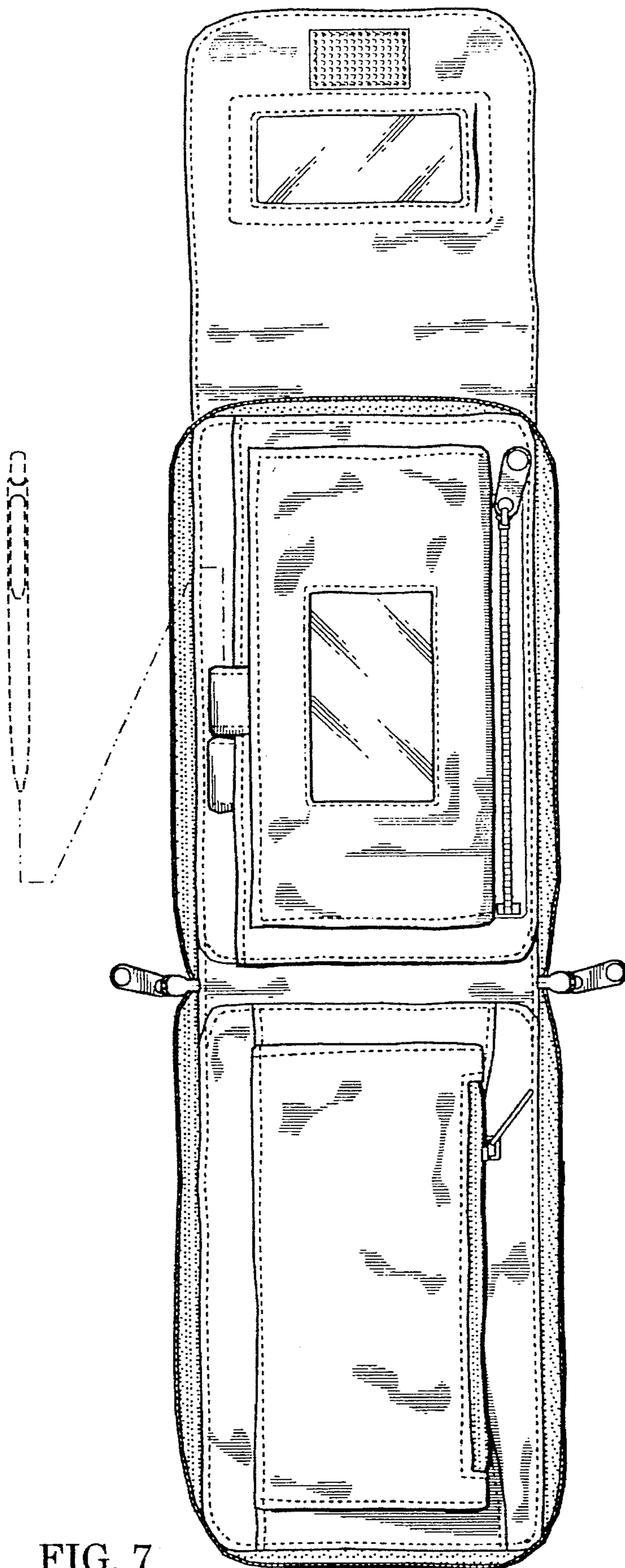

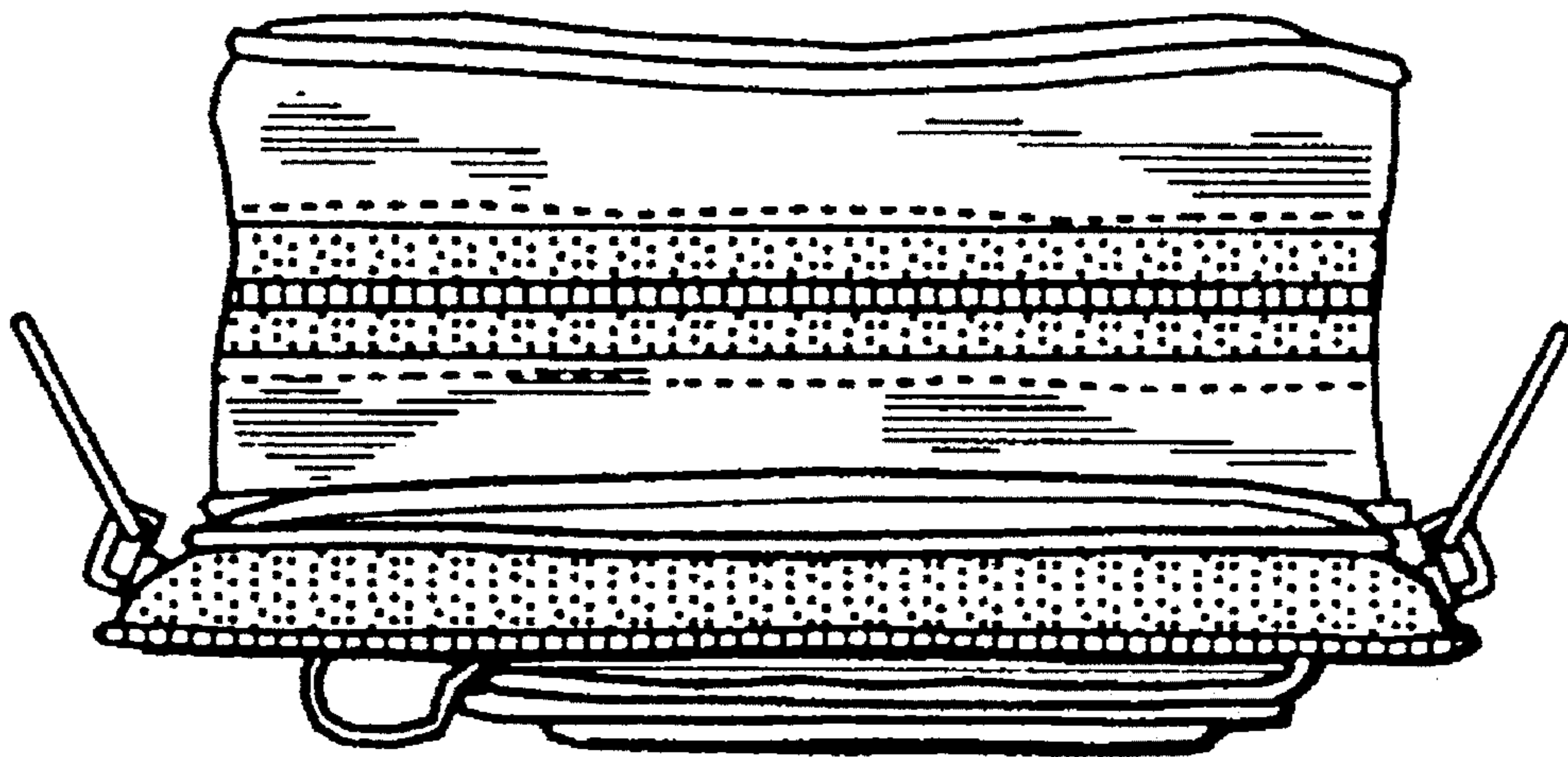

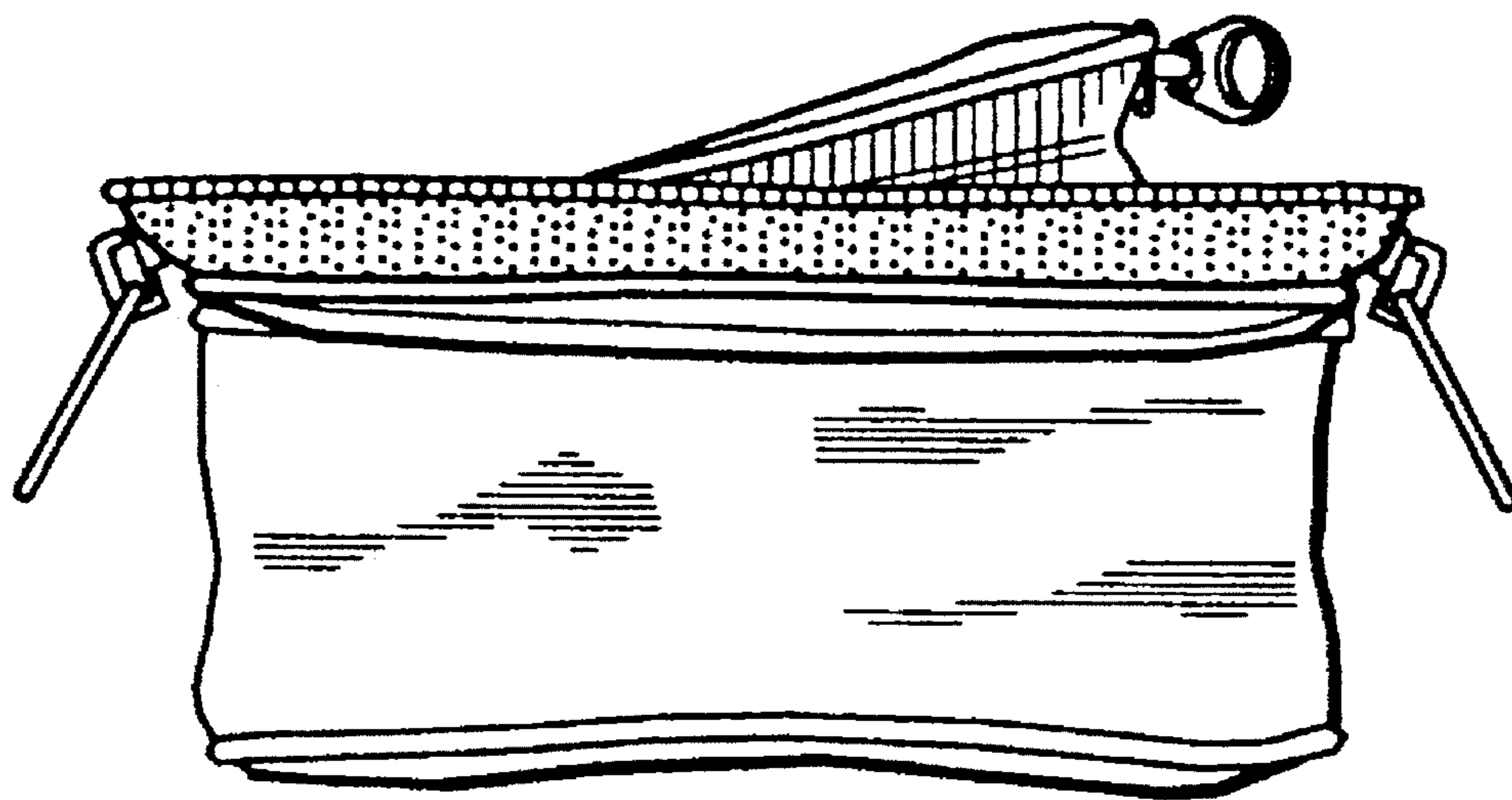

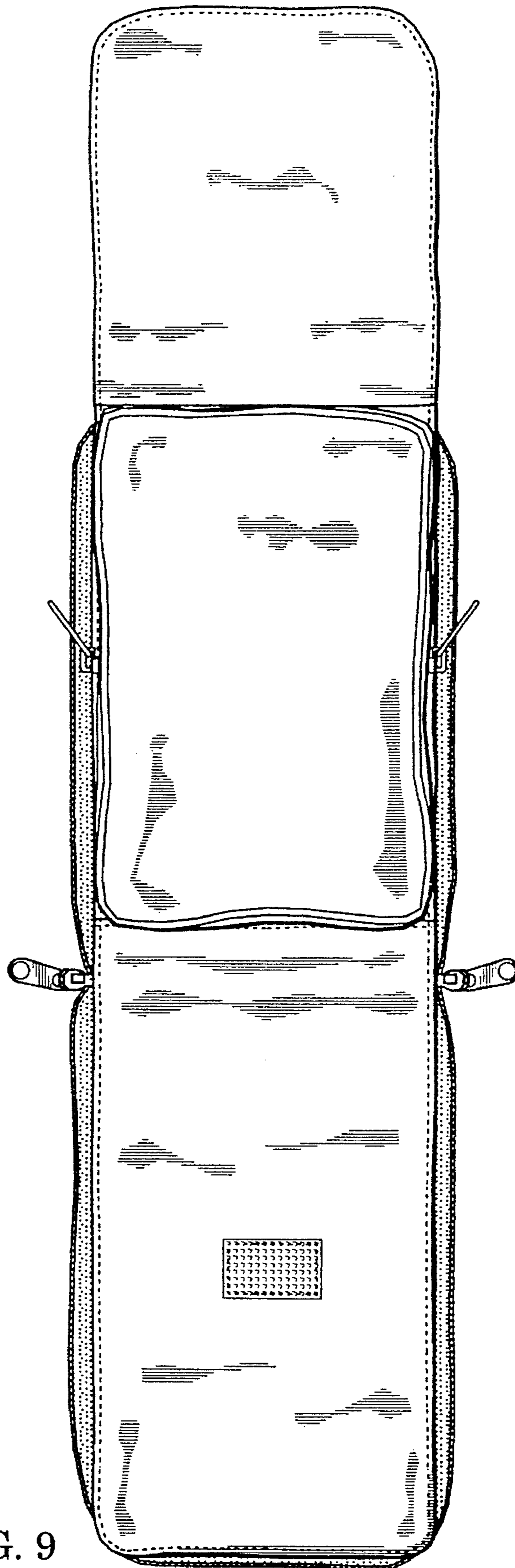

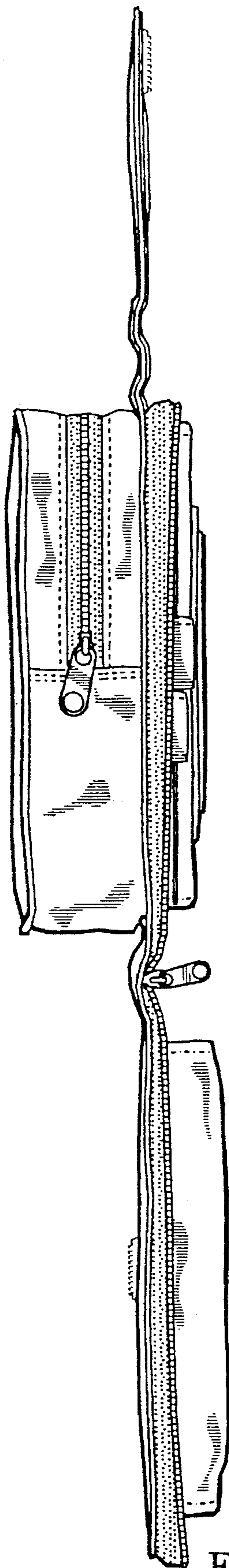

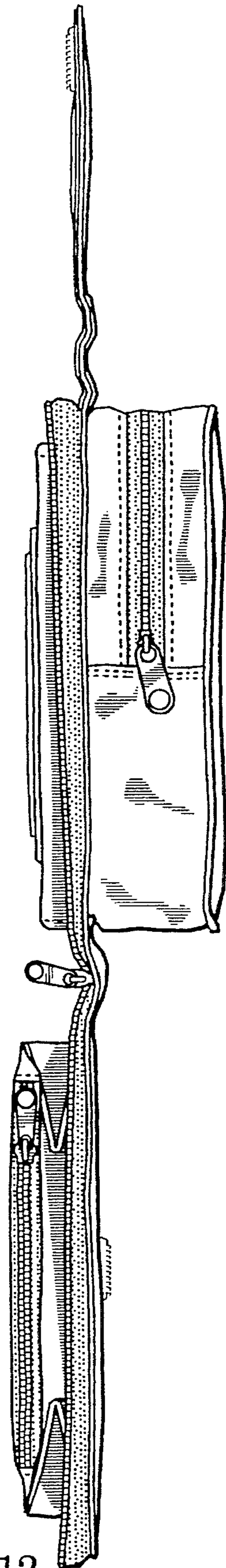
