FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a chair showing my new design;

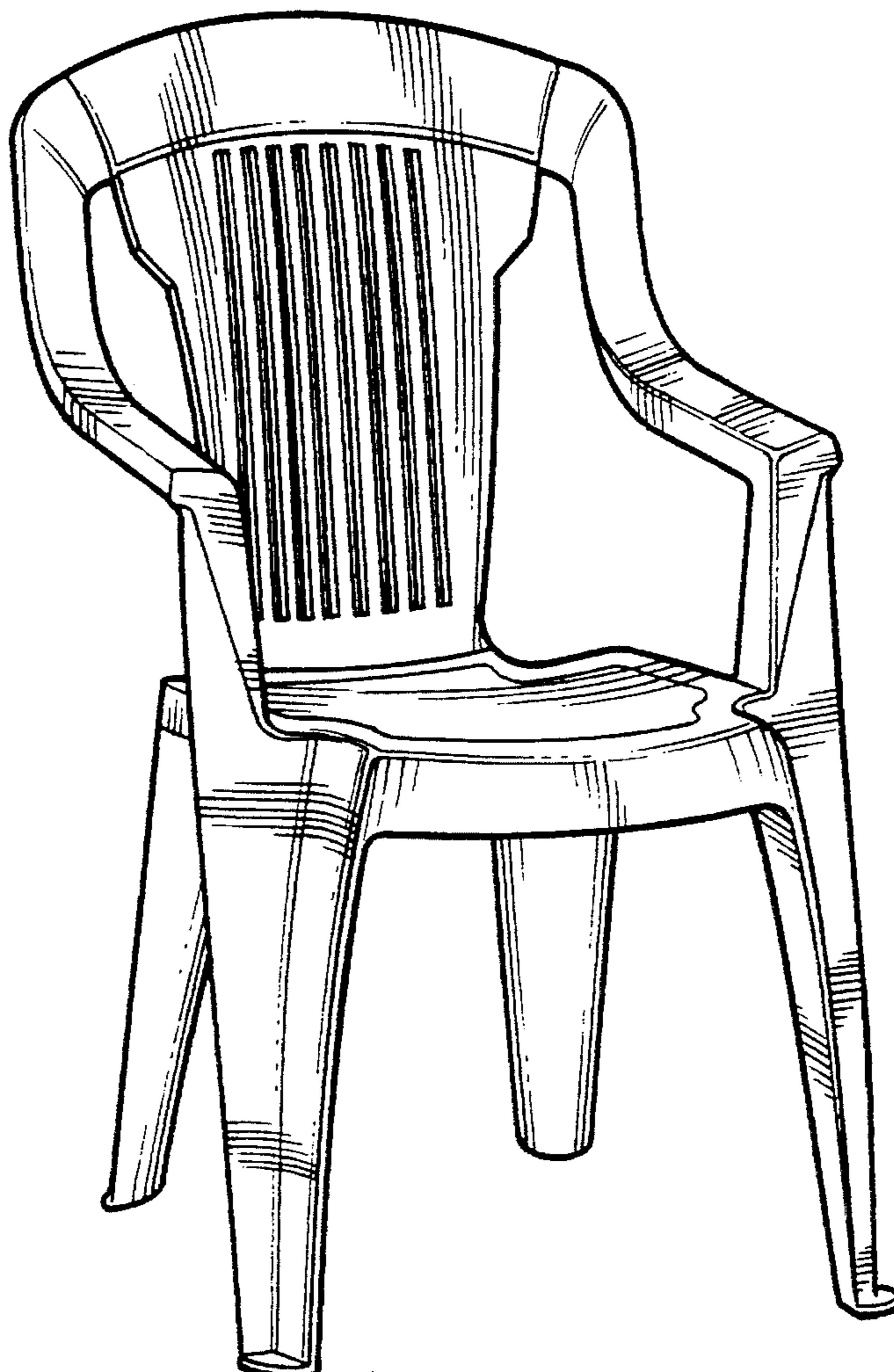
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

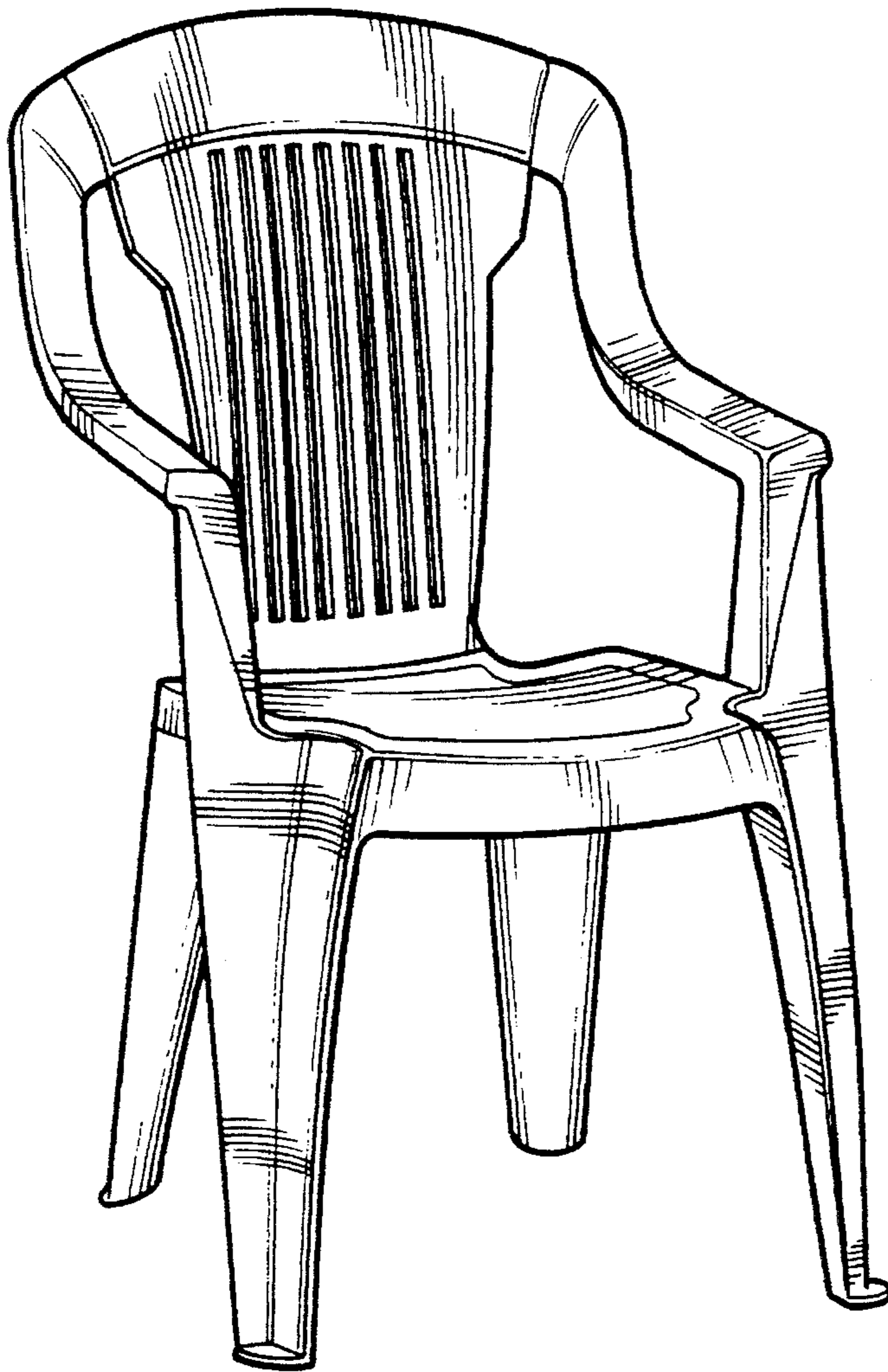

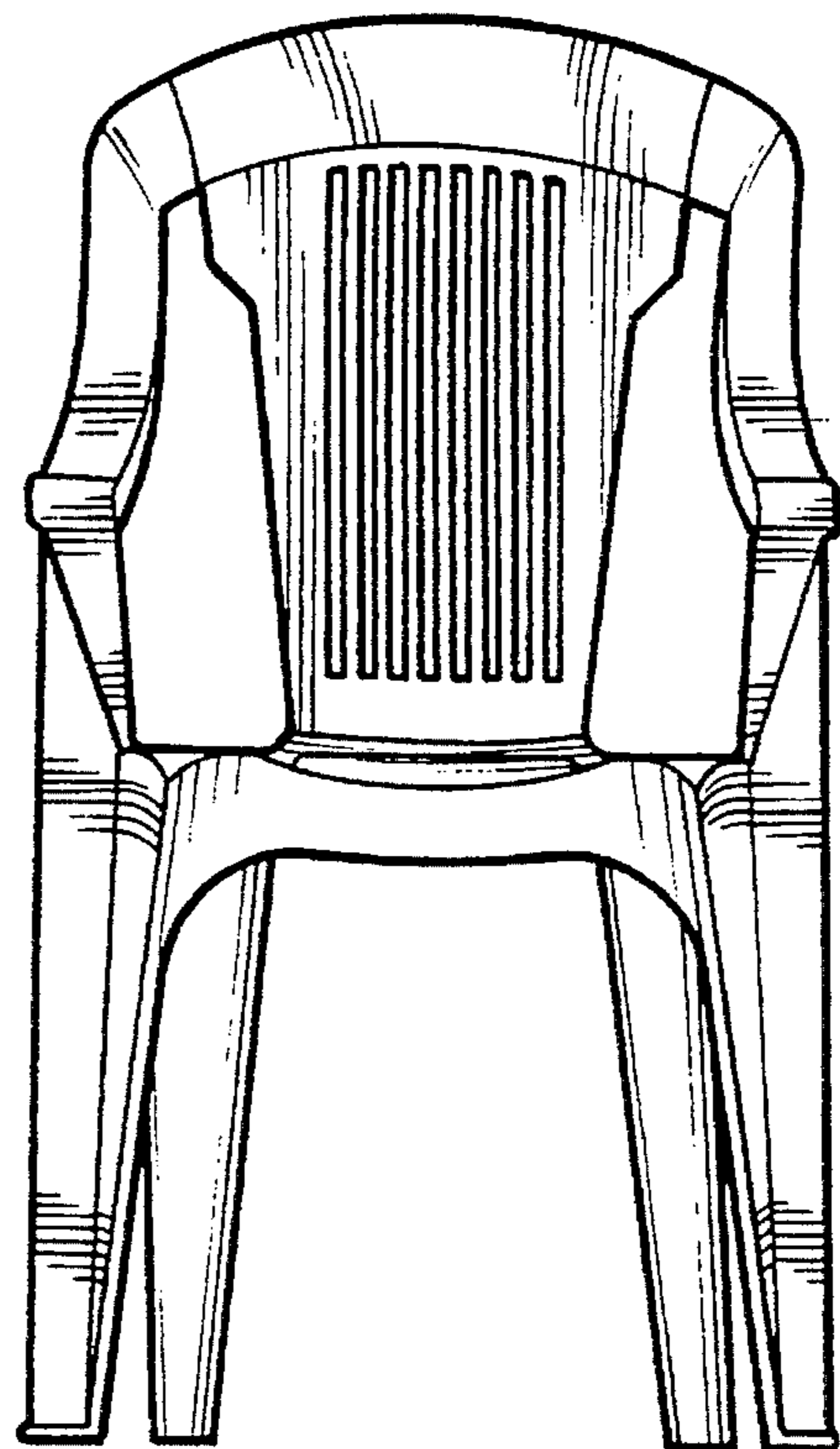

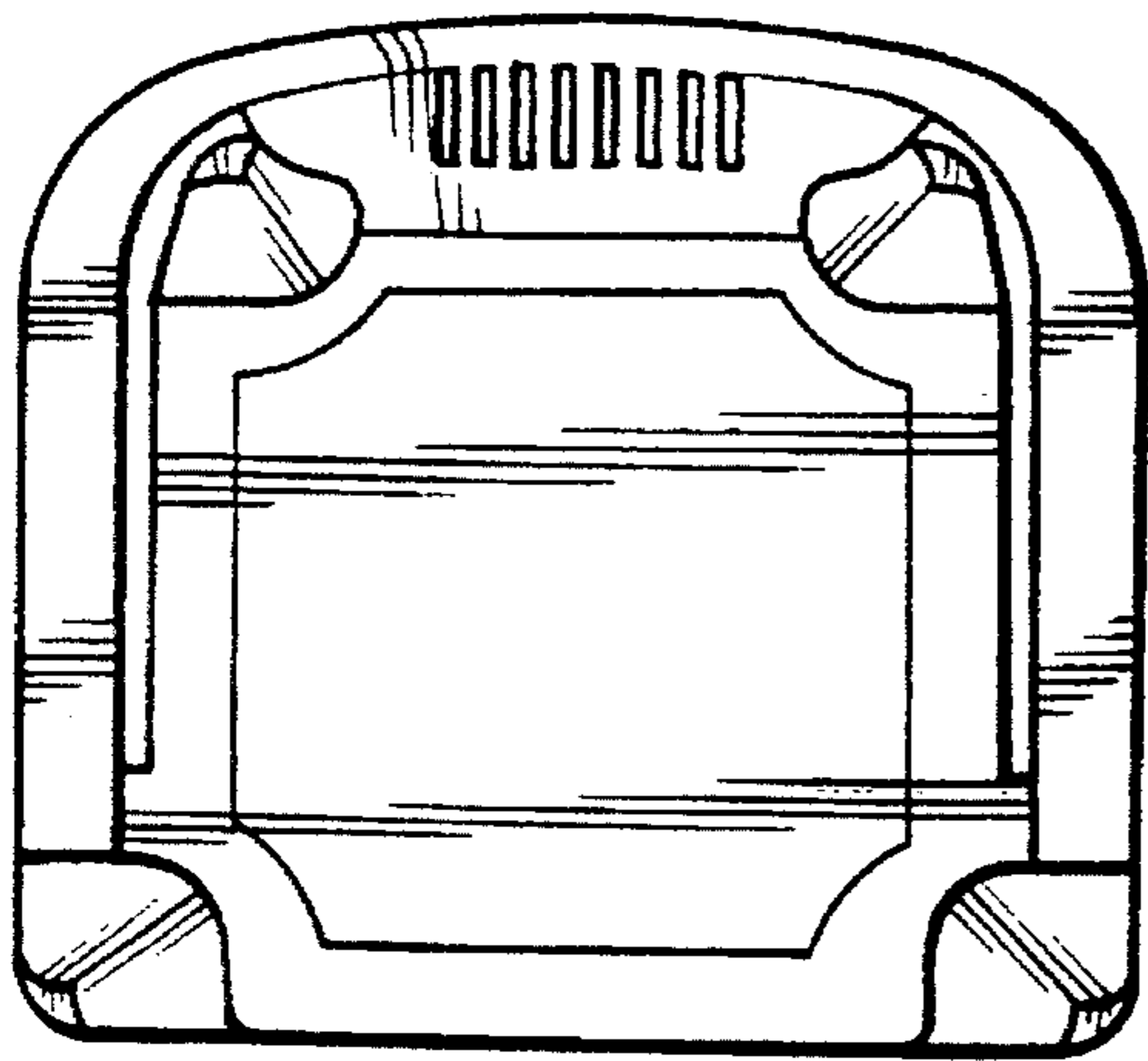

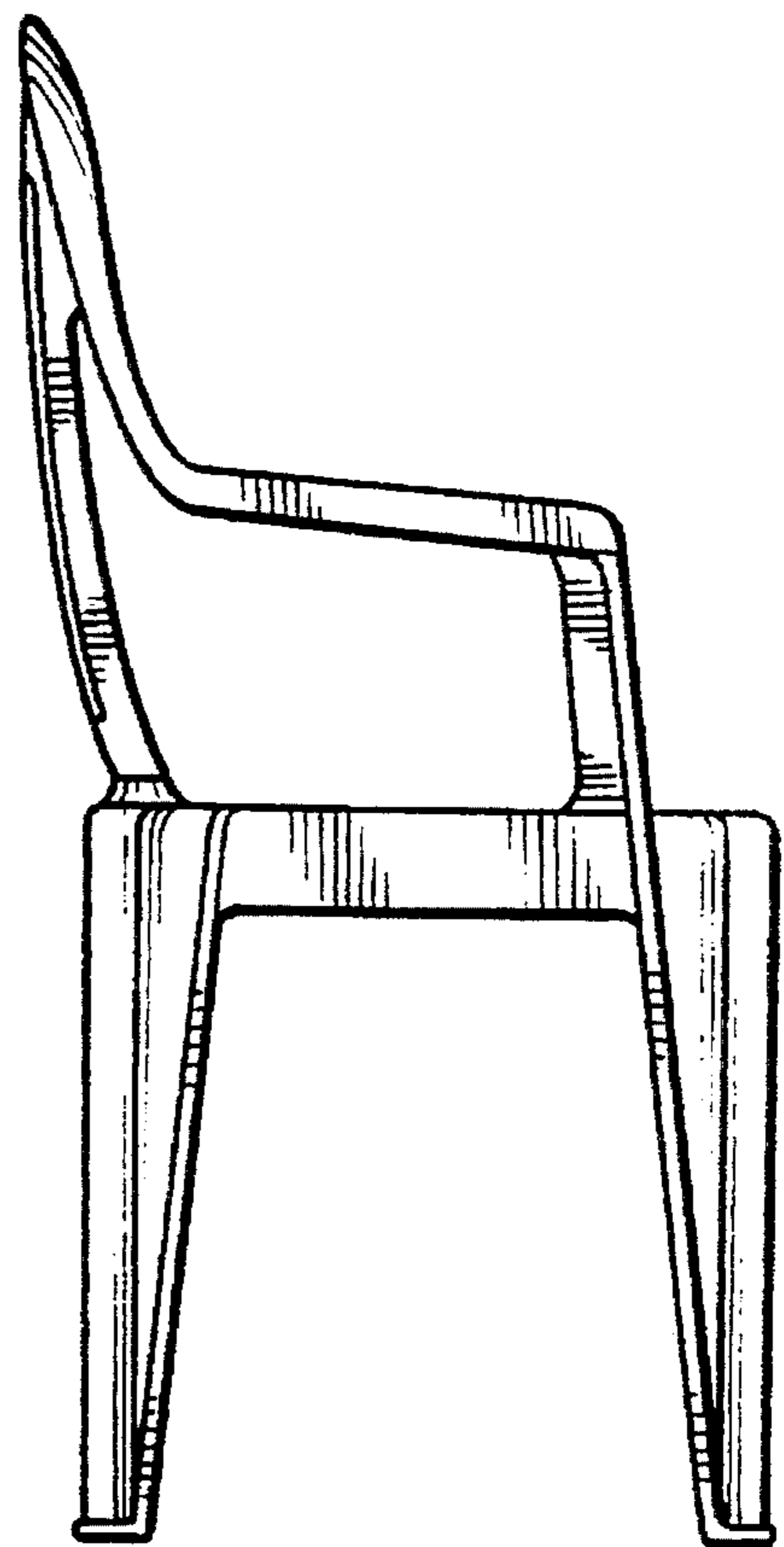

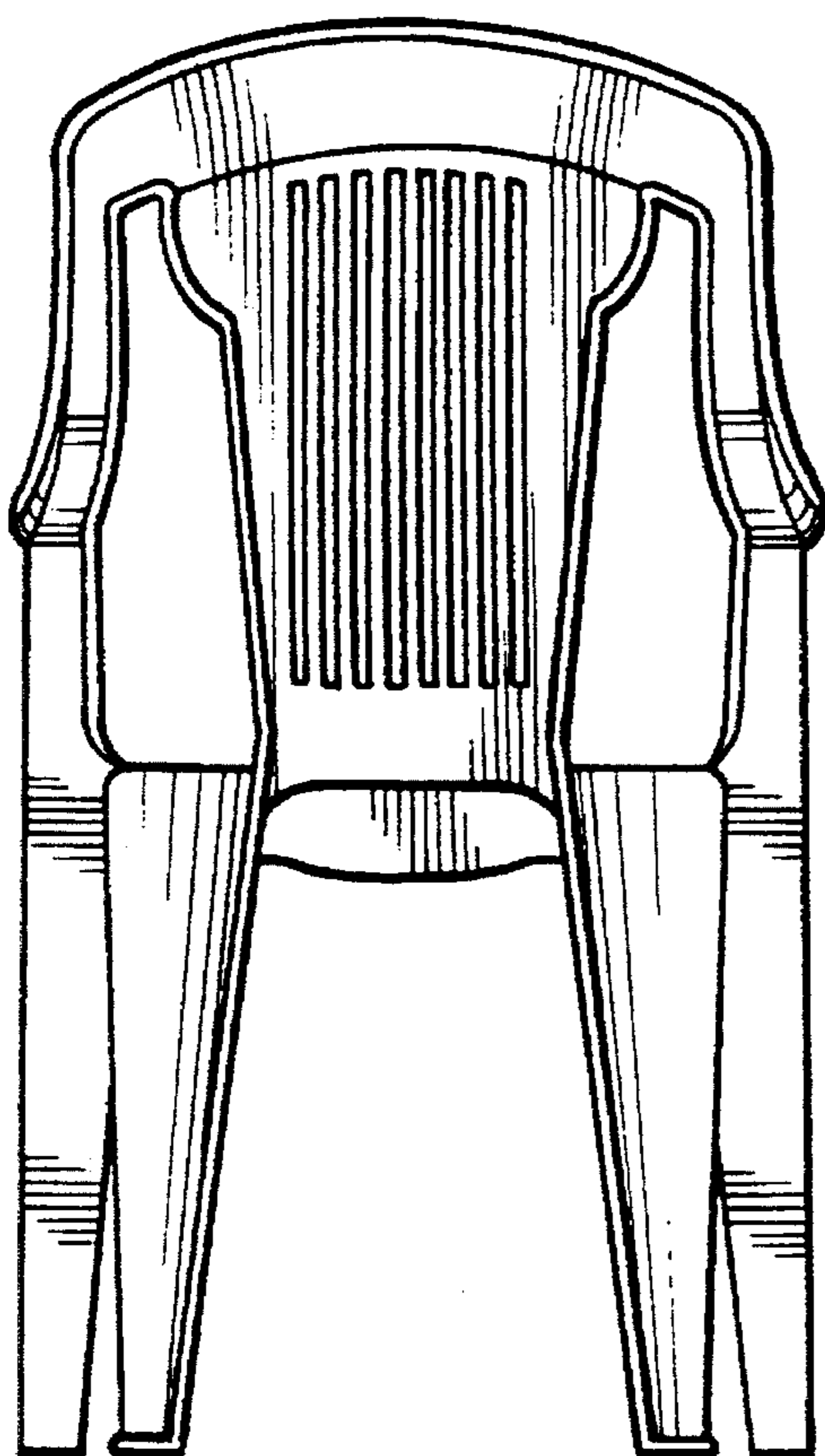
