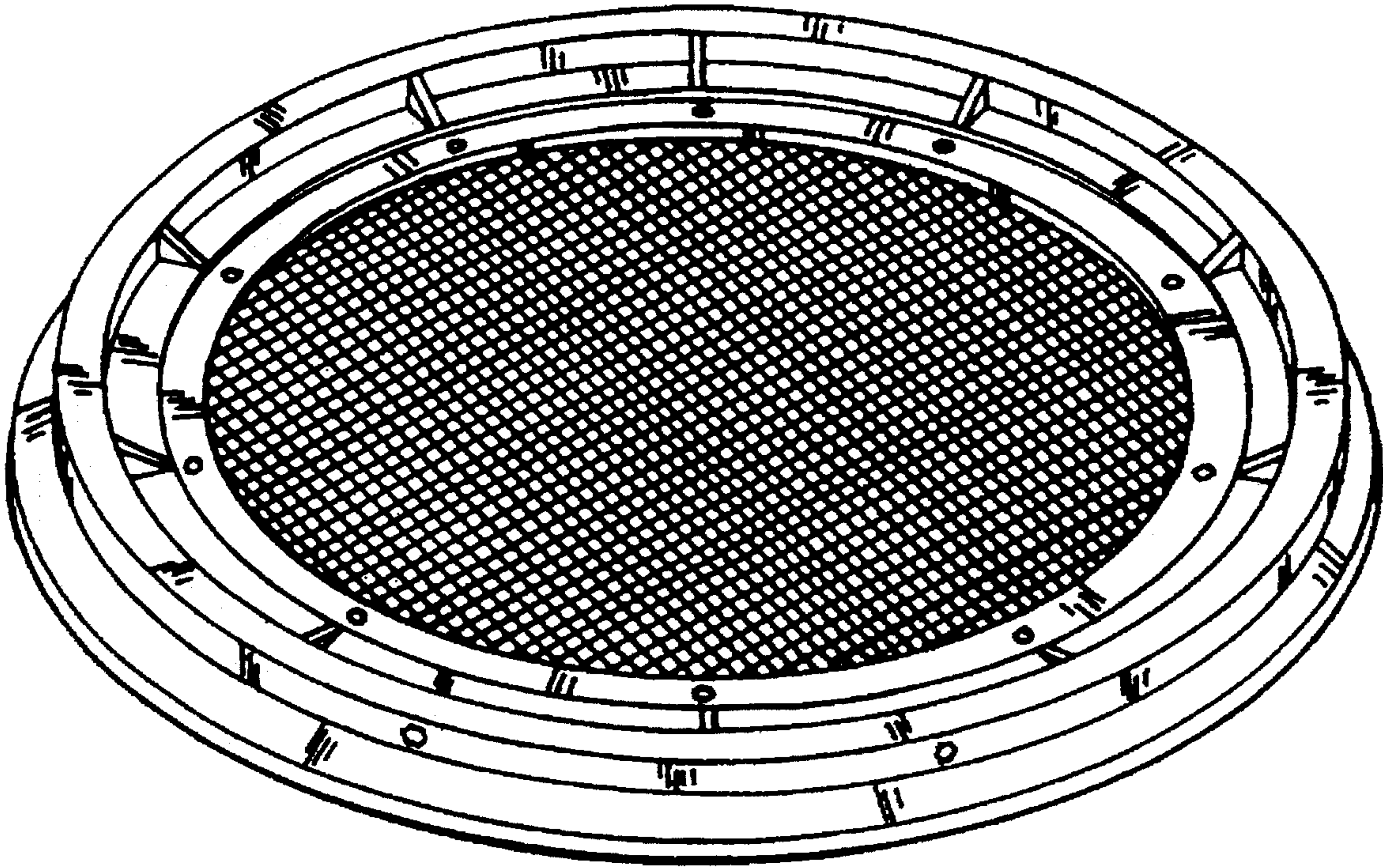
[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view, from above, of a snap-on paint strainer in accordance with and embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a fragmentary cross sectional view thereof, taken along line 5—5 in FIG. 3.

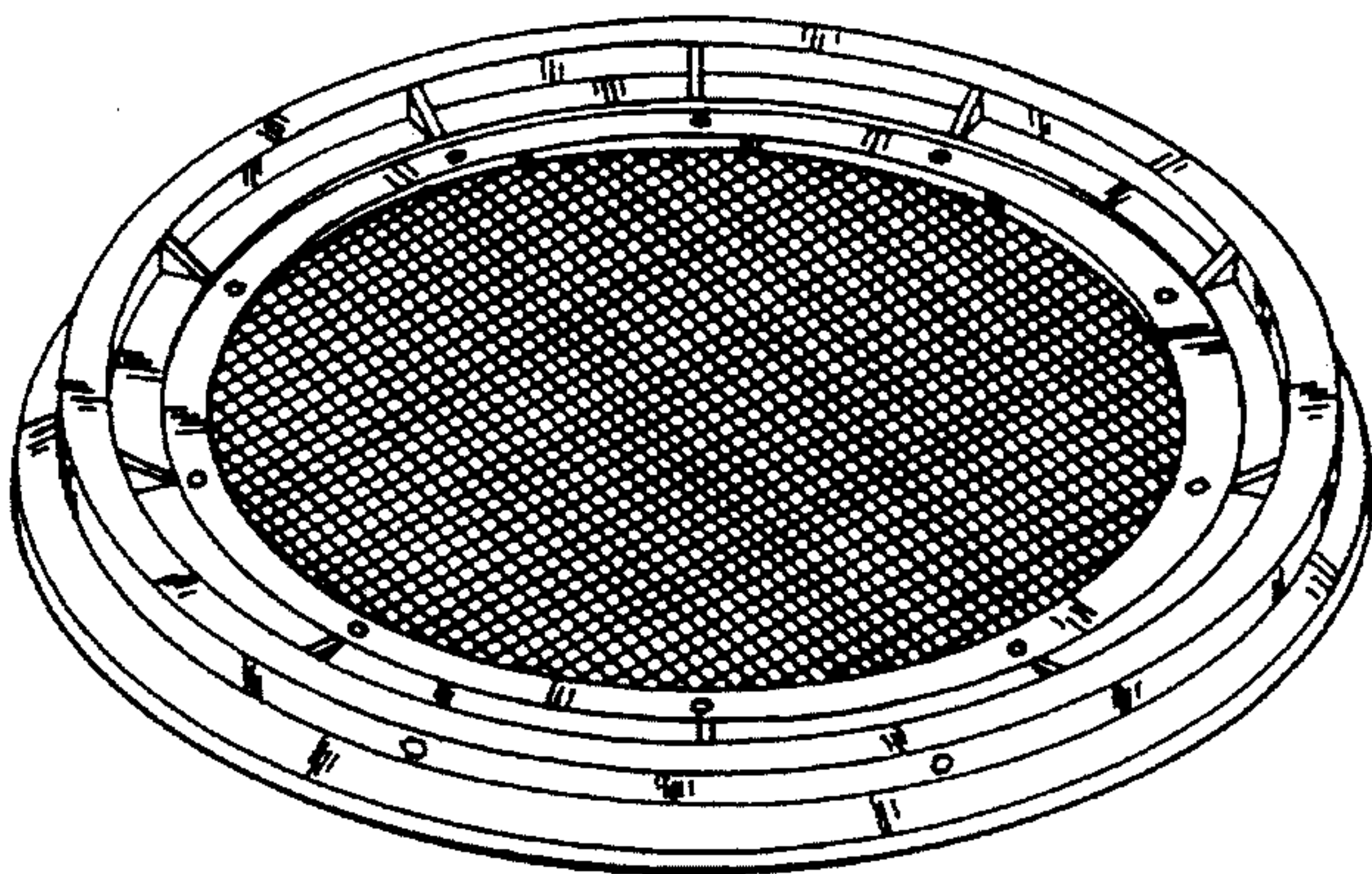

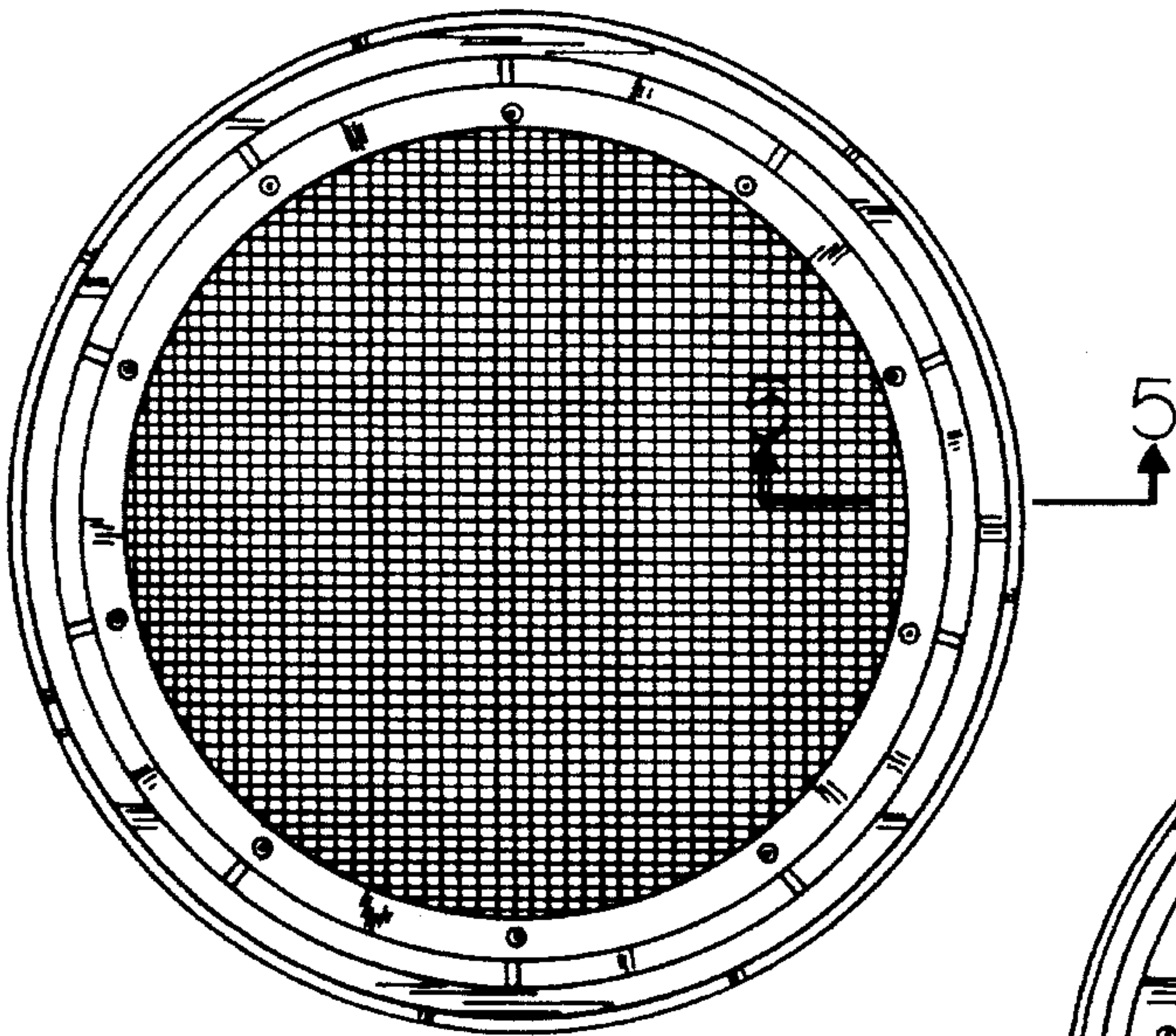

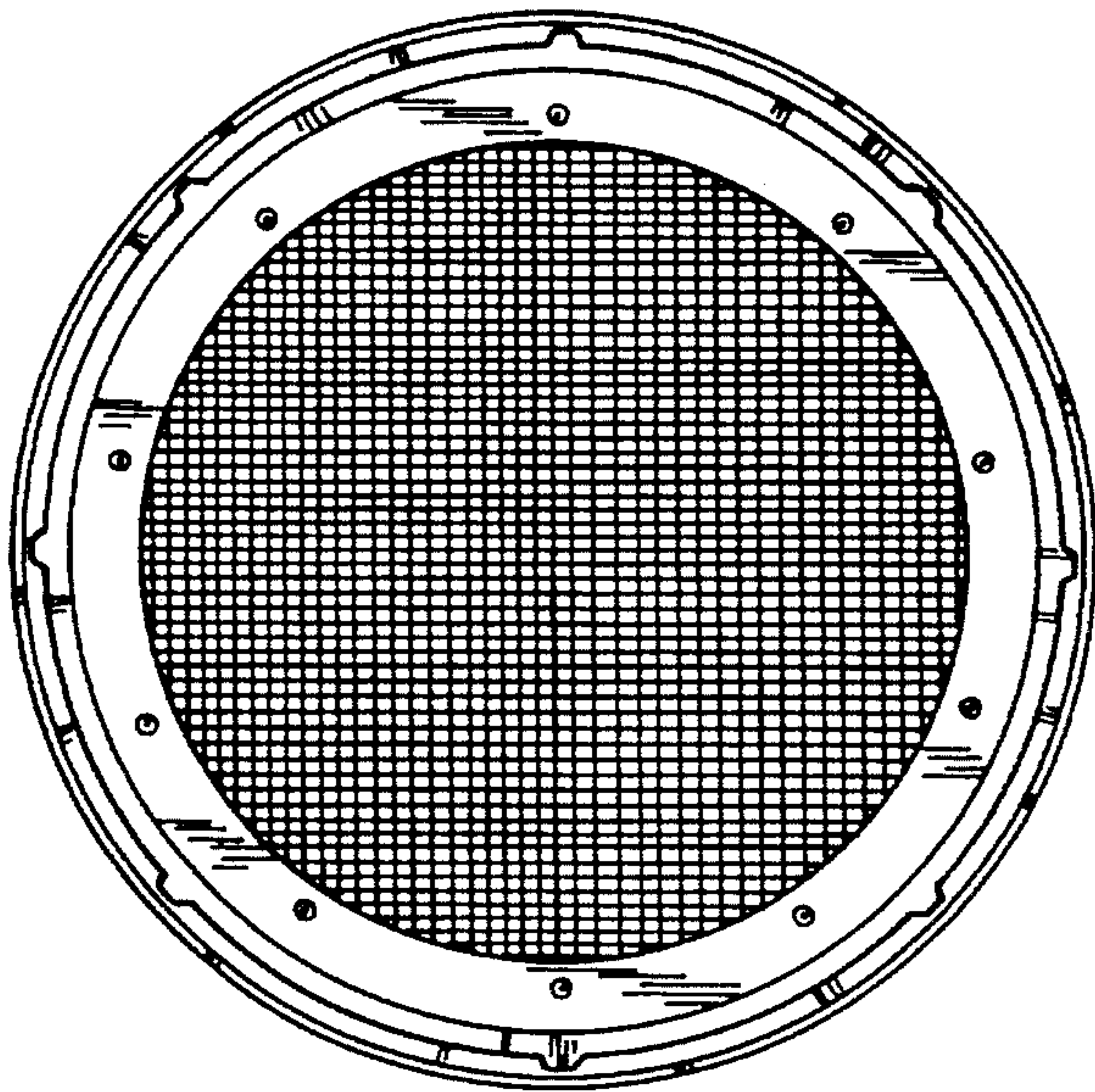

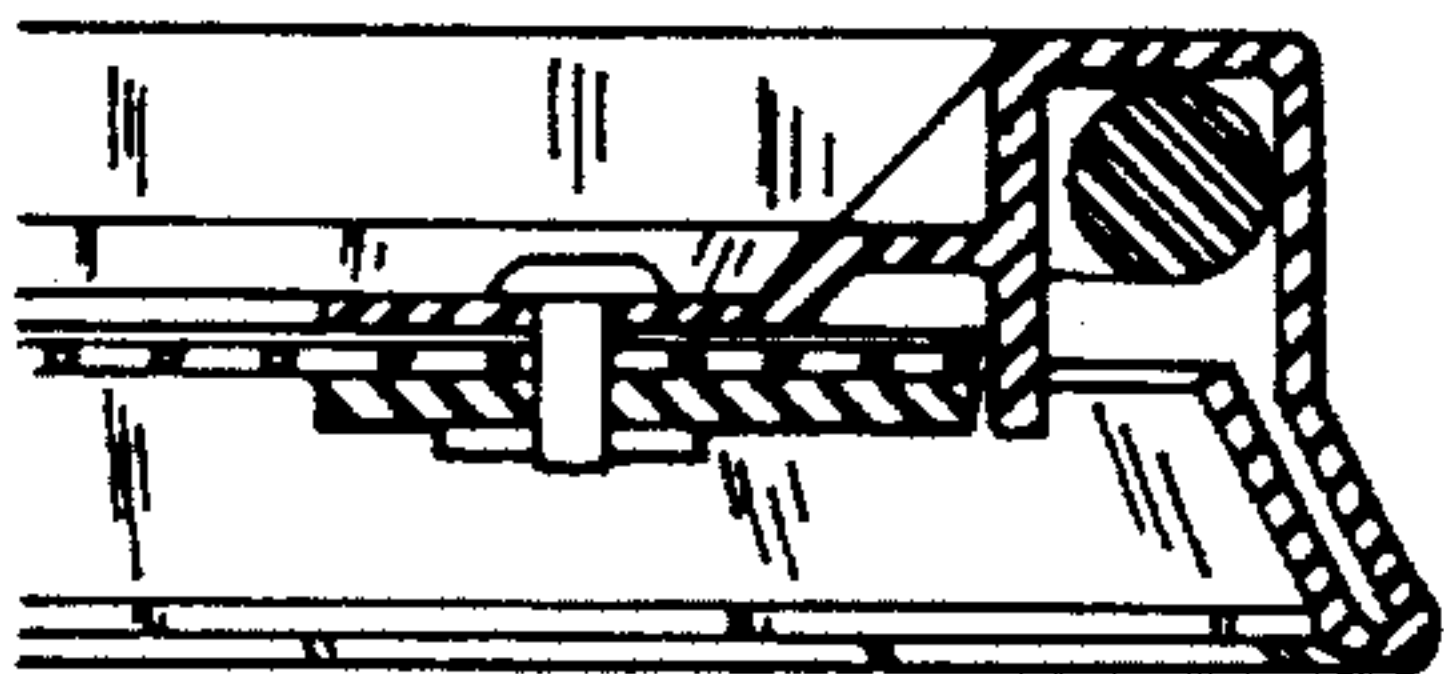
