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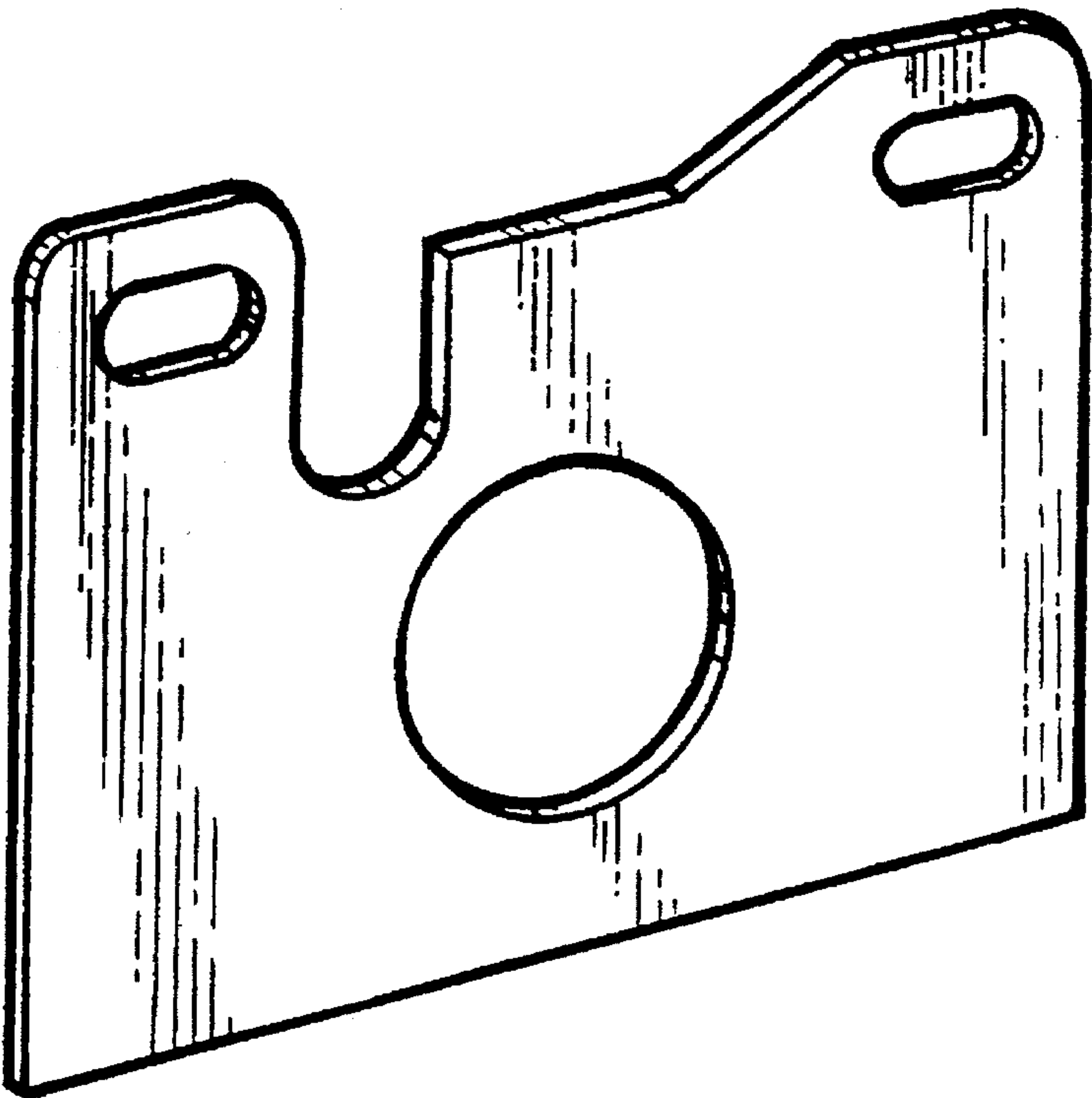

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a disc brake shim showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a side view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown.

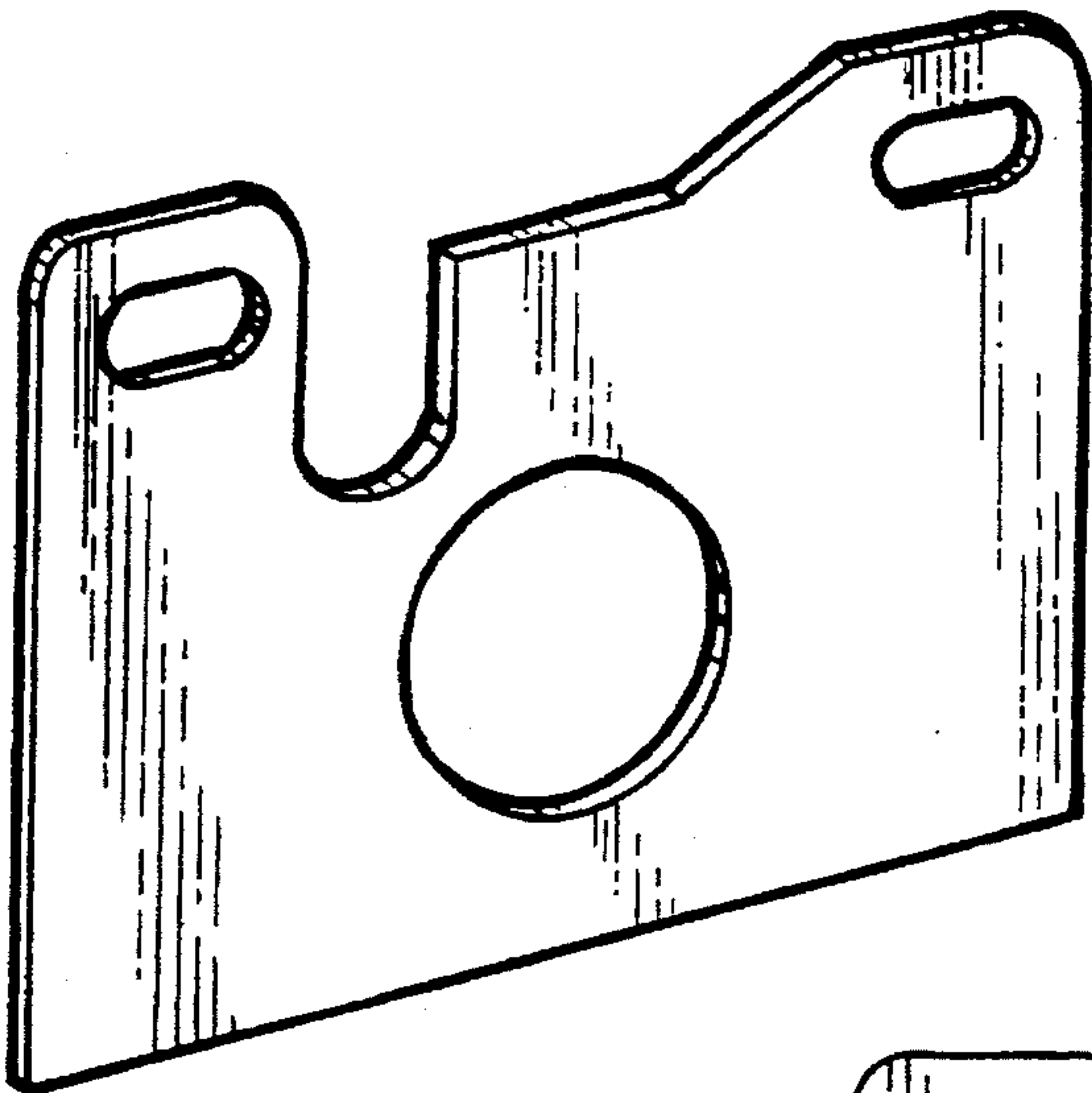

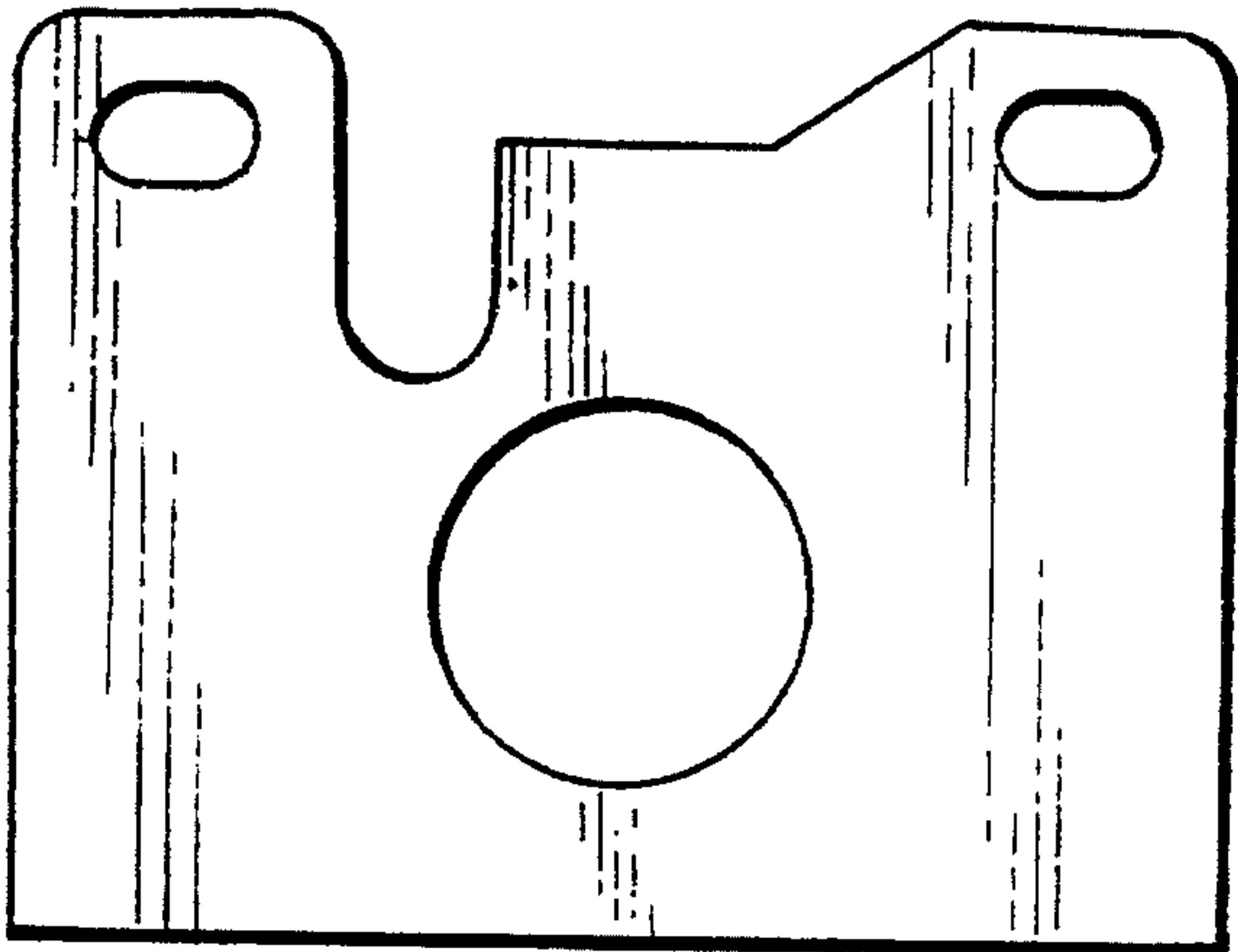

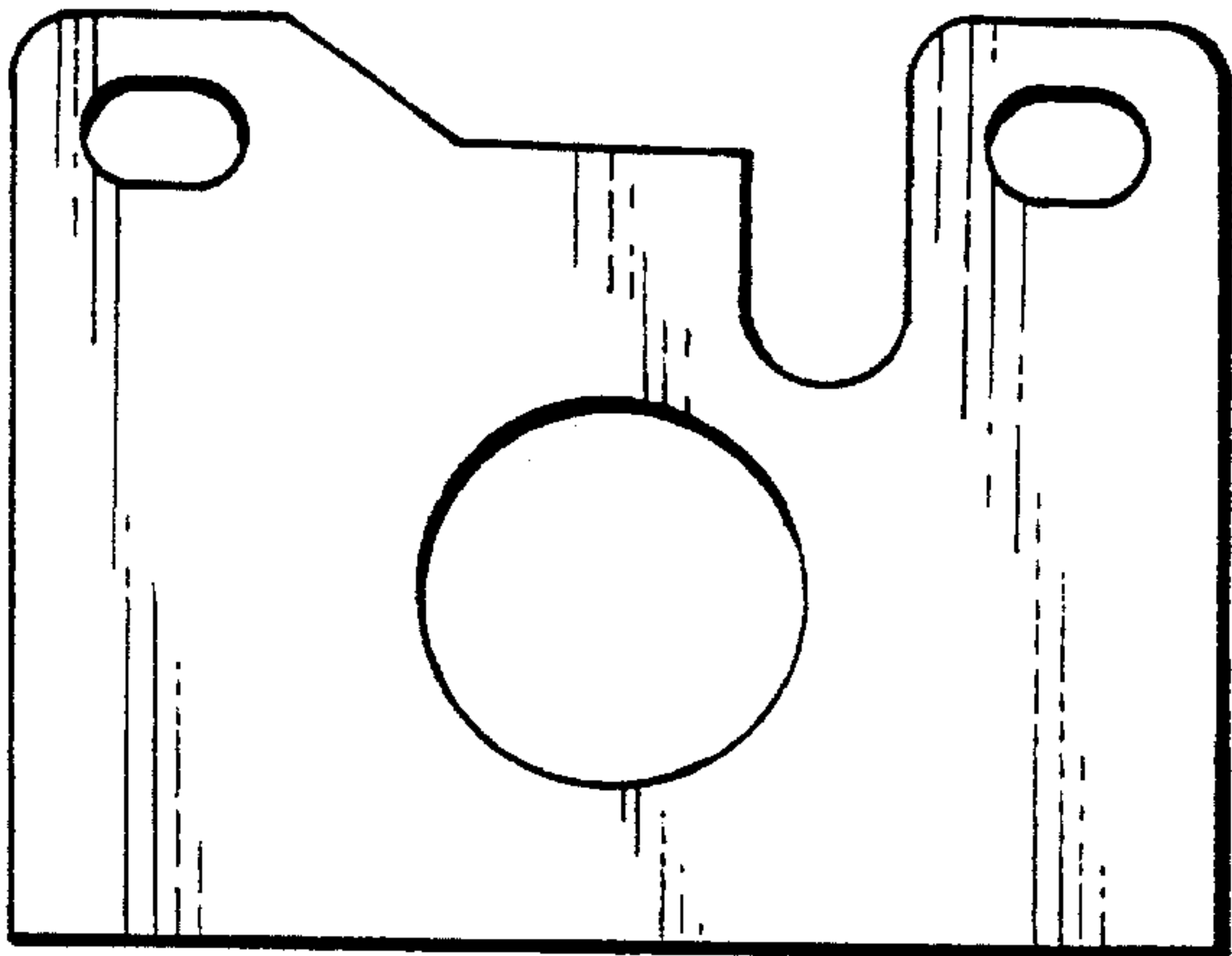

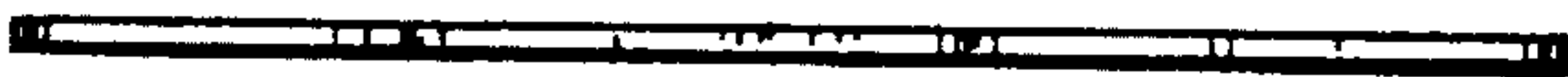
