[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cushioned heel cup, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of my new design for a cushioned heel cup;

FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof, with the right side view a mirror image of the left side view;

FIG. 4 is a front view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.













