FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a sign for signalling direction of traffic flow showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, with the cord broken away to indicate indeterminate length;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

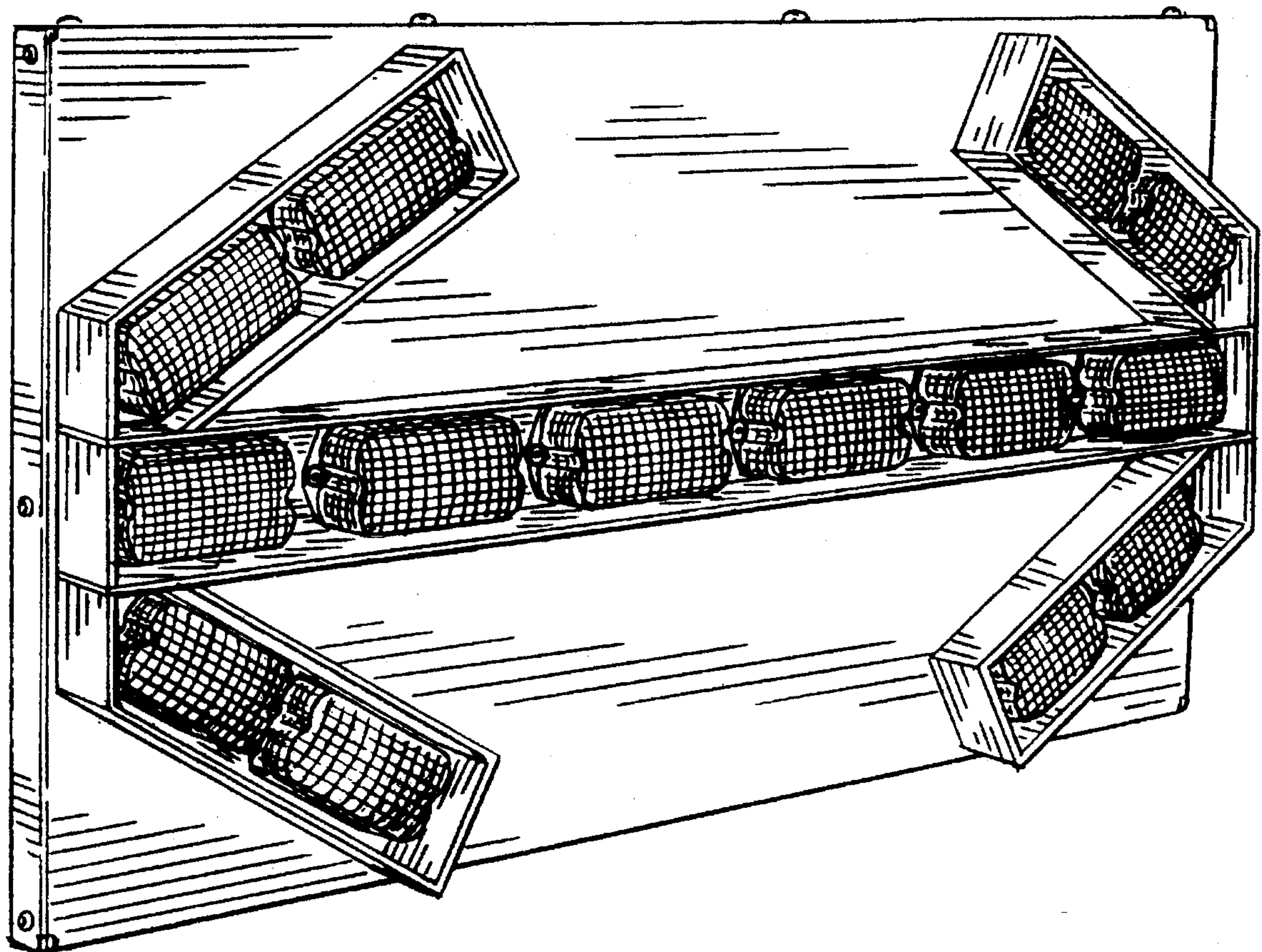
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

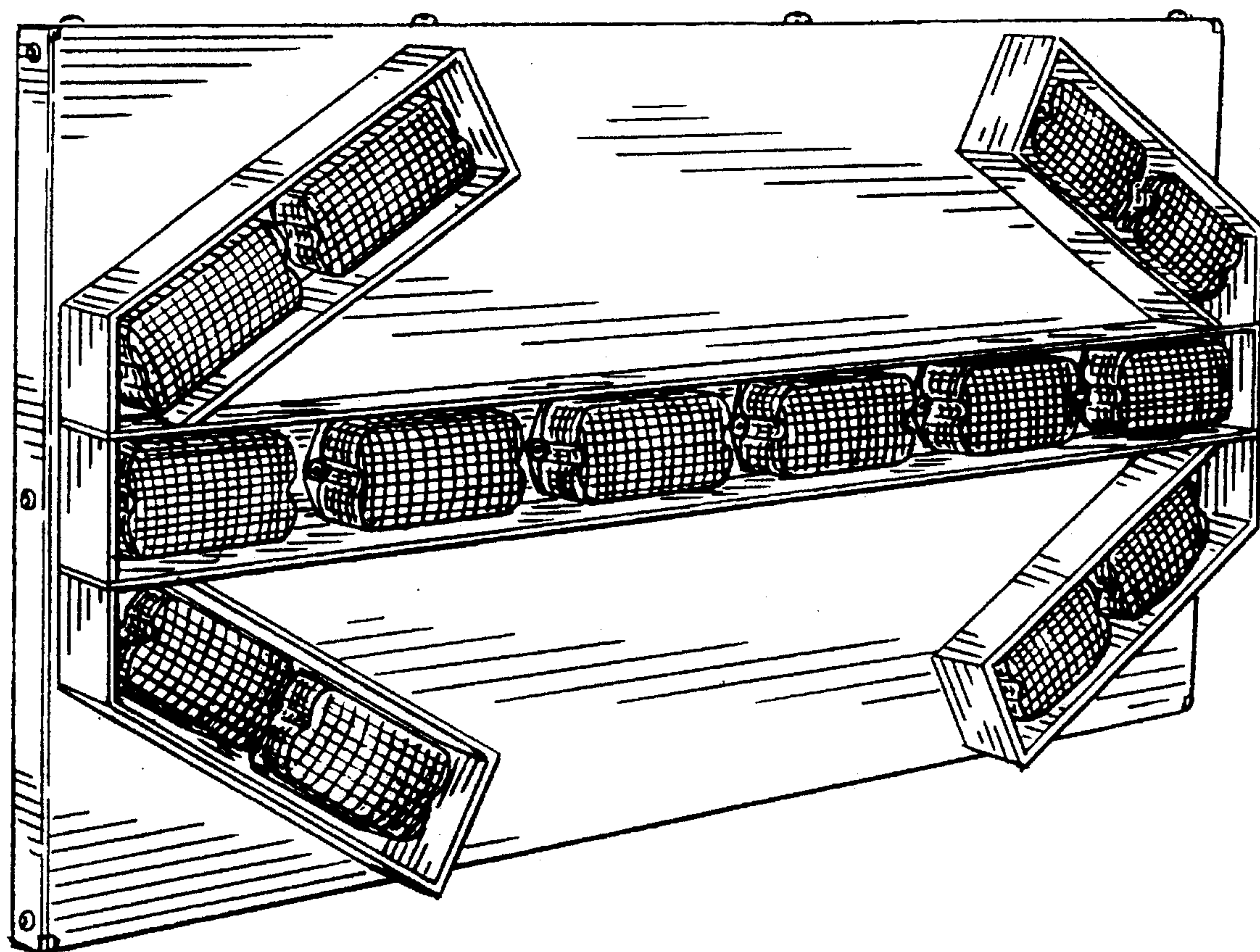

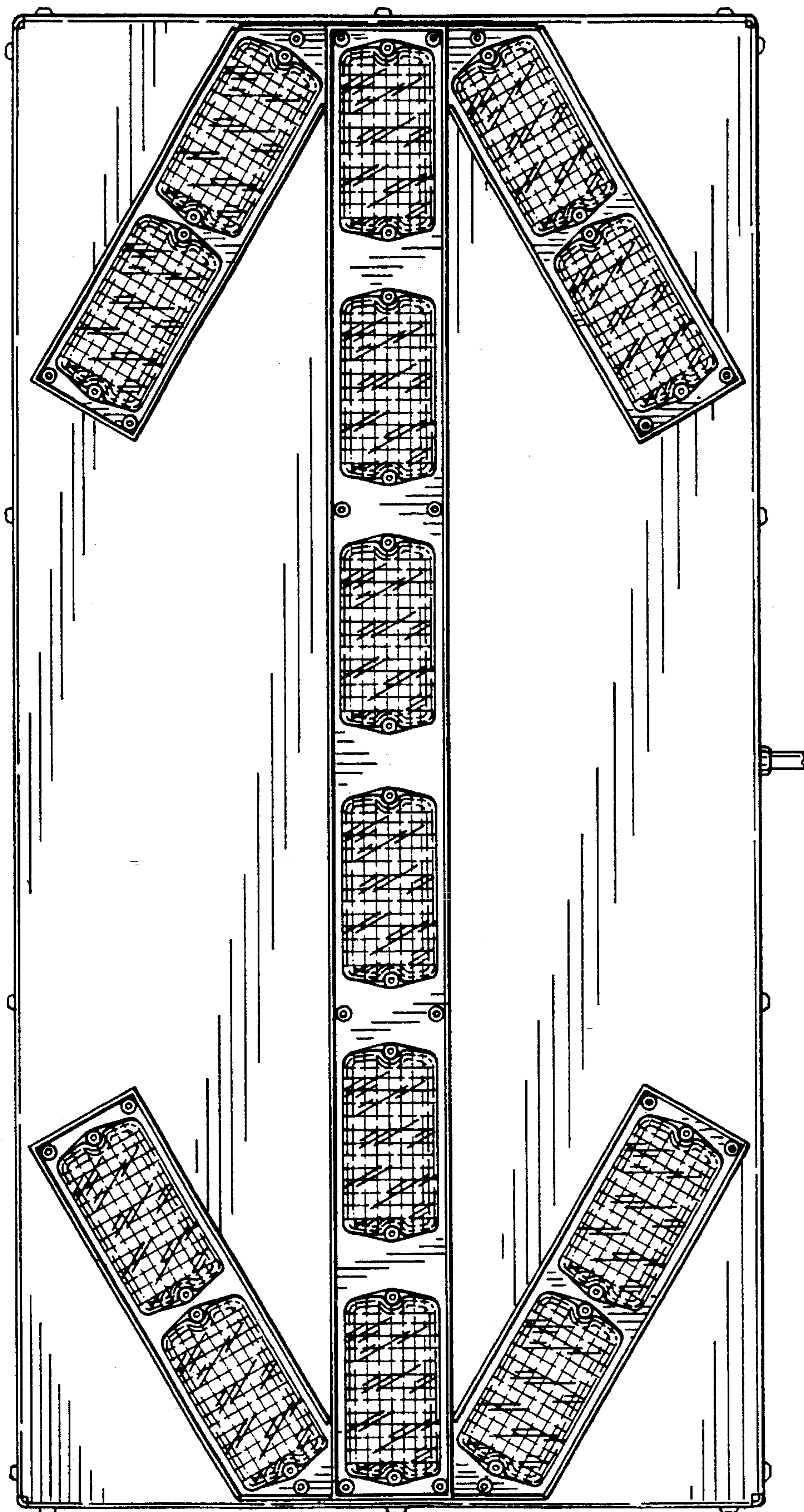

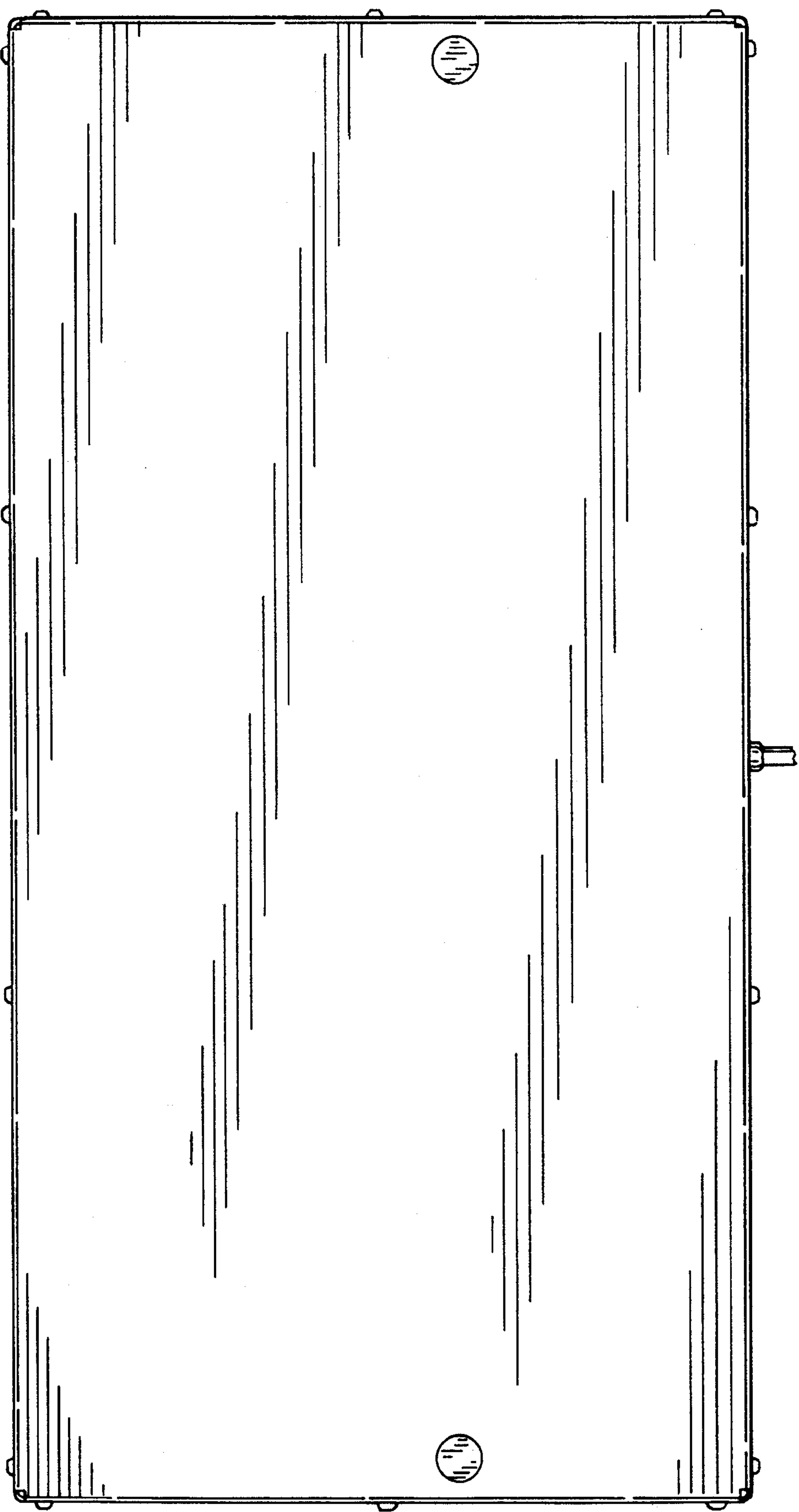

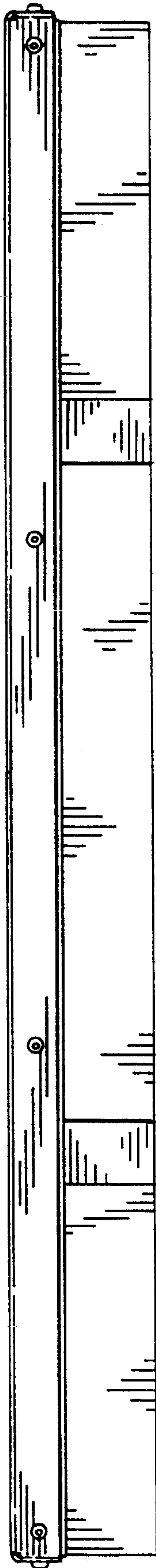
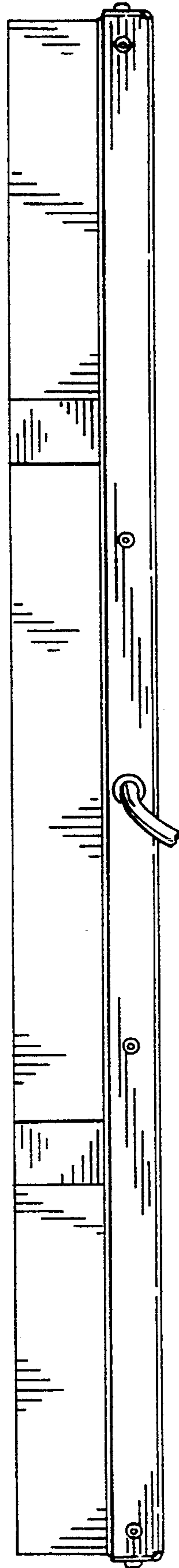

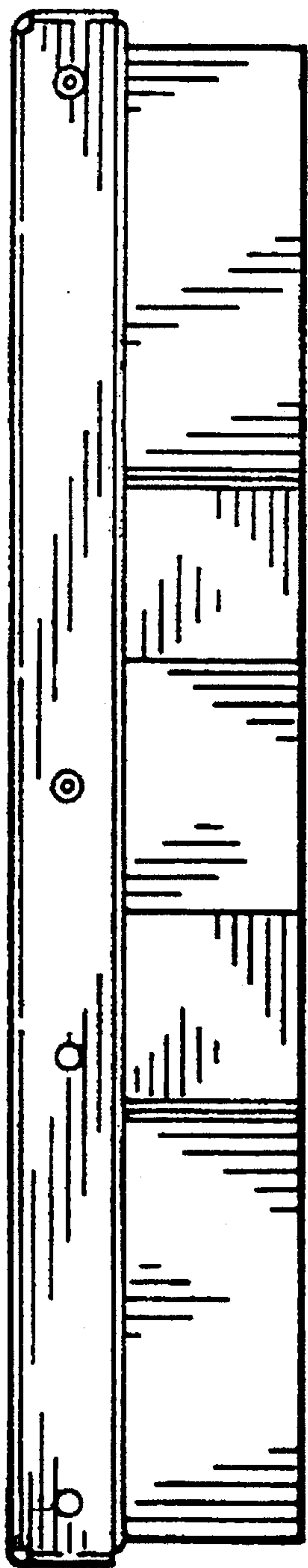

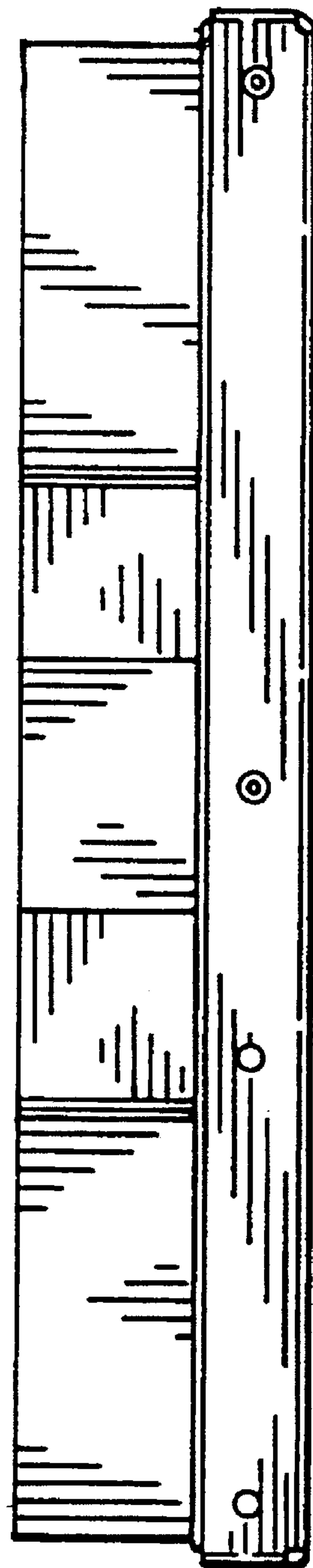
