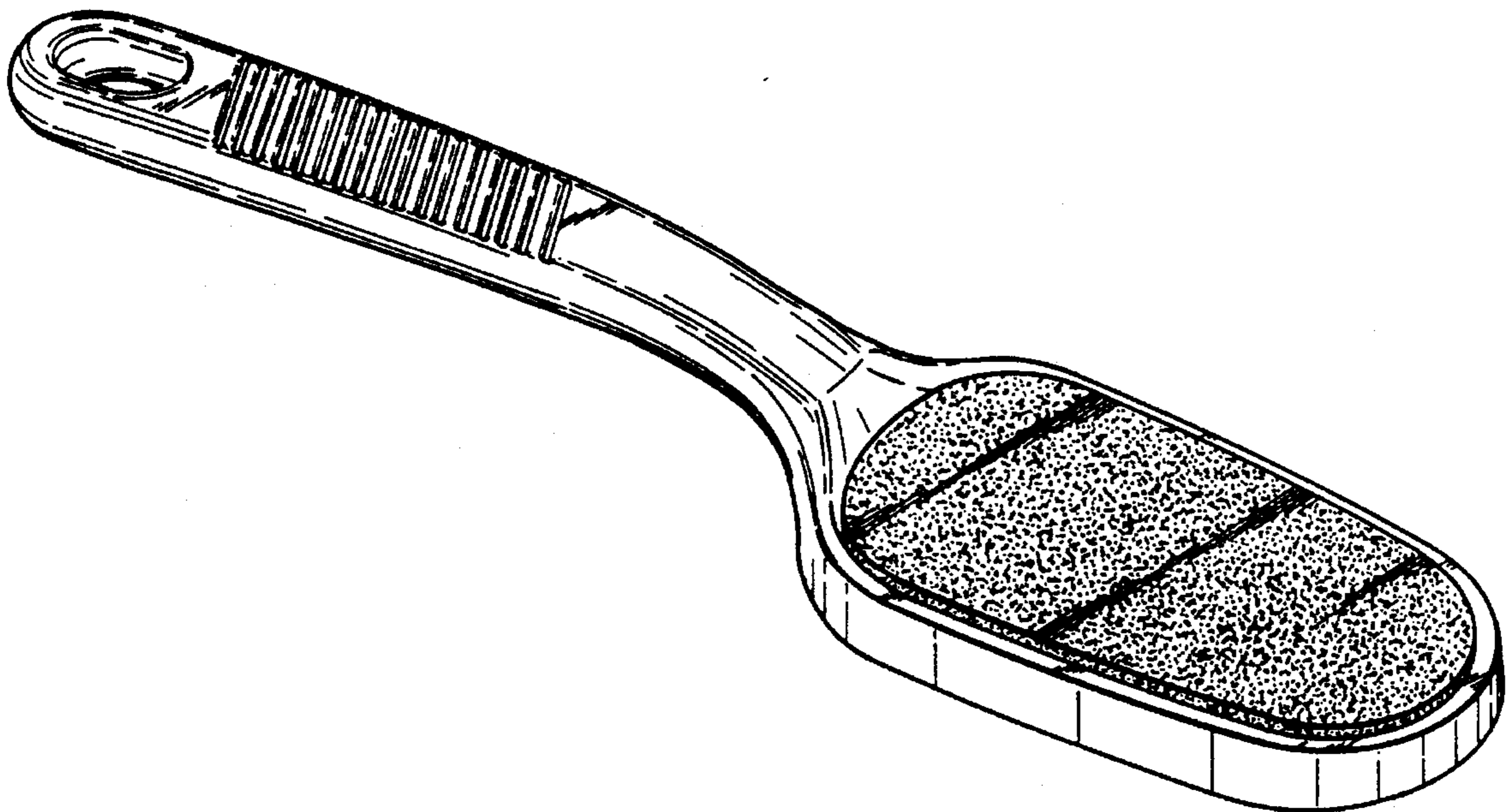
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a callus remover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an instrument for callus remover in accordance with the present invention; FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the callus remover of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is an end view taken from the upper end of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is an end view taken from the lower end of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the callus remover with the opposite side being a mirror image; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the callus remover of FIG. 1.

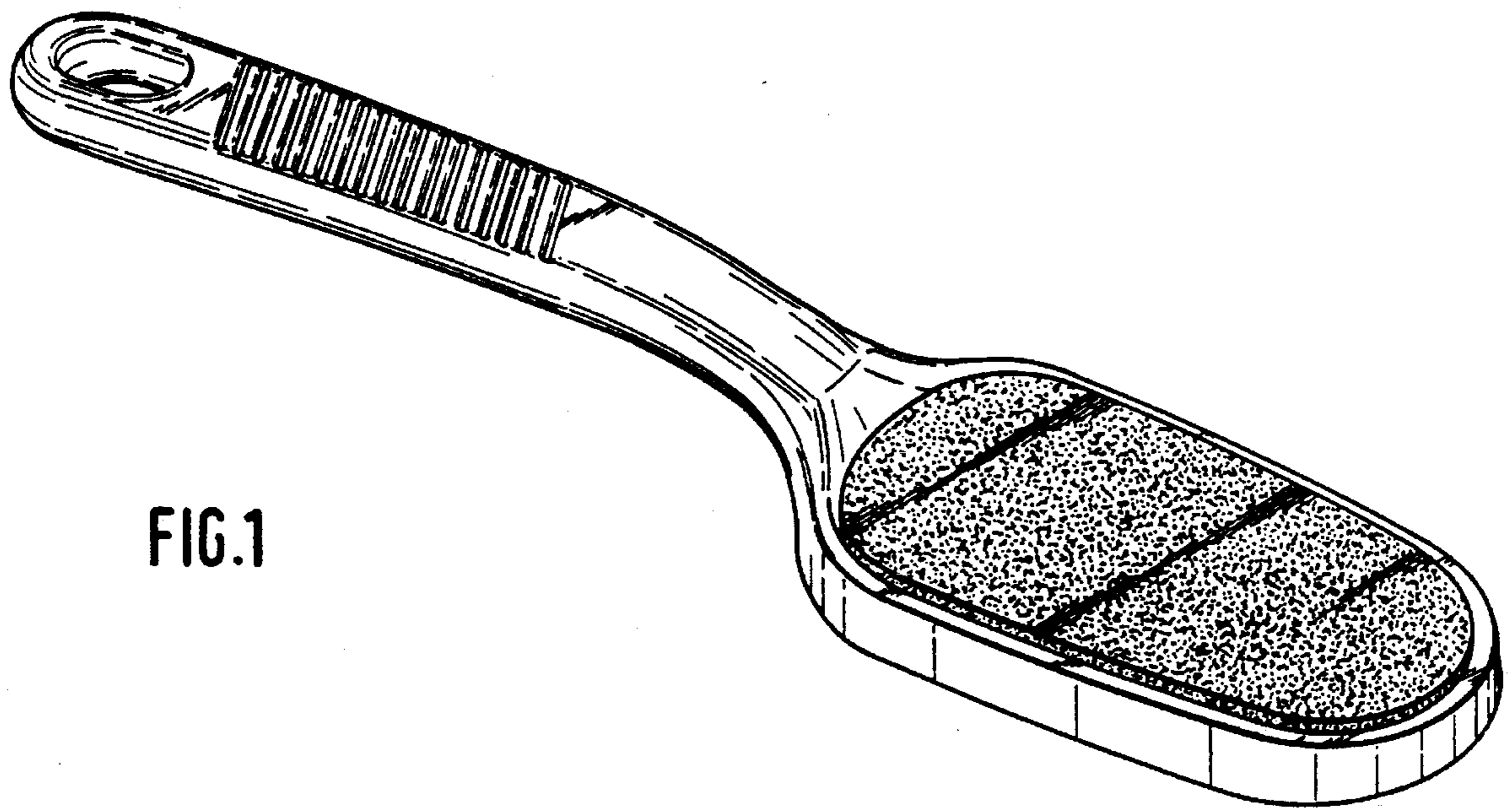

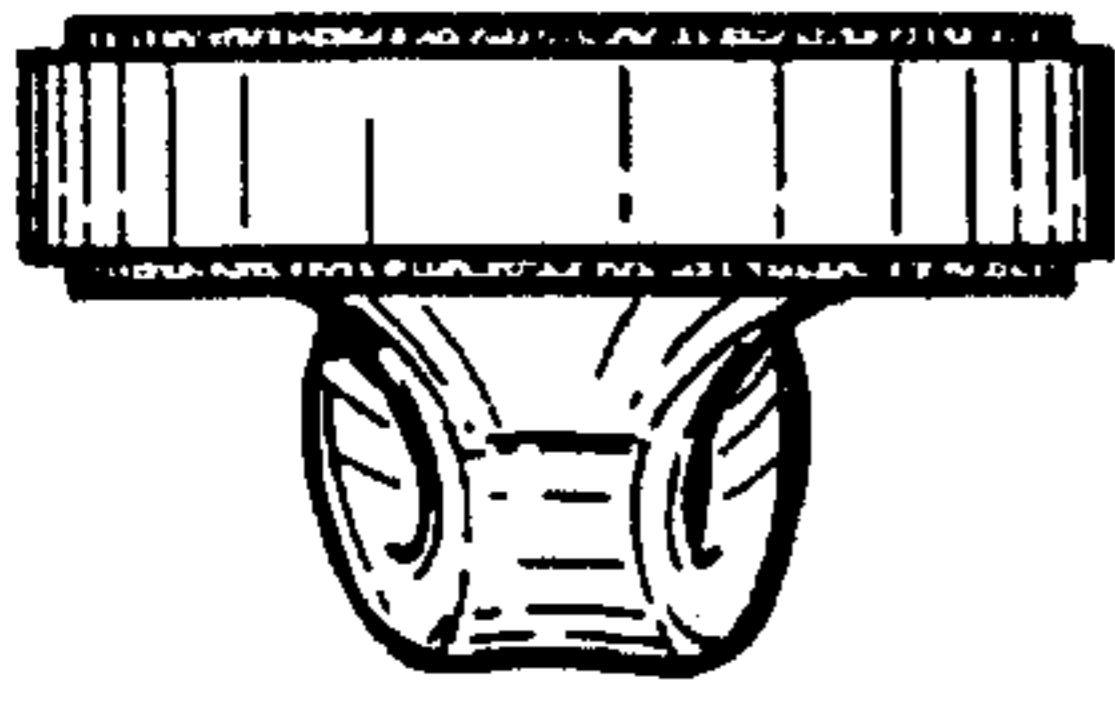

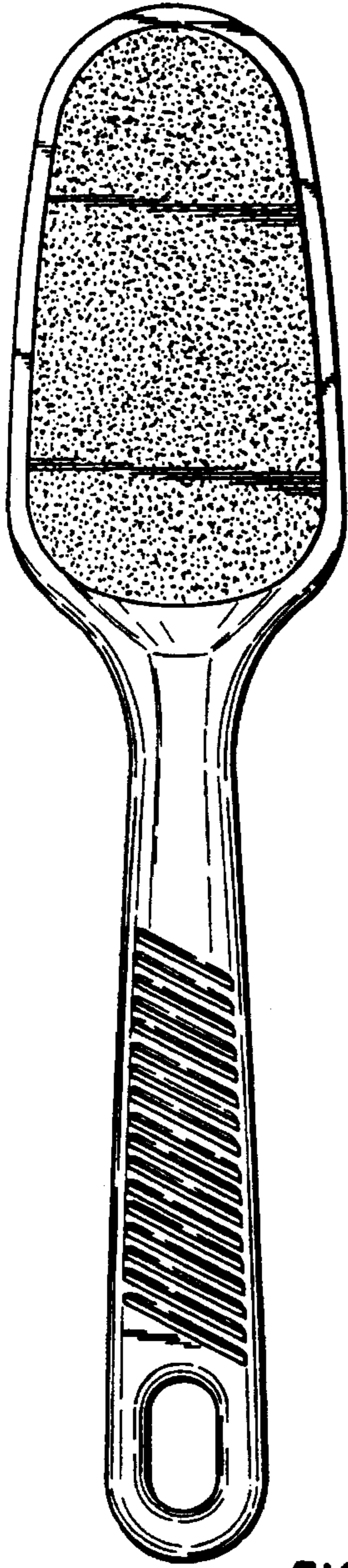

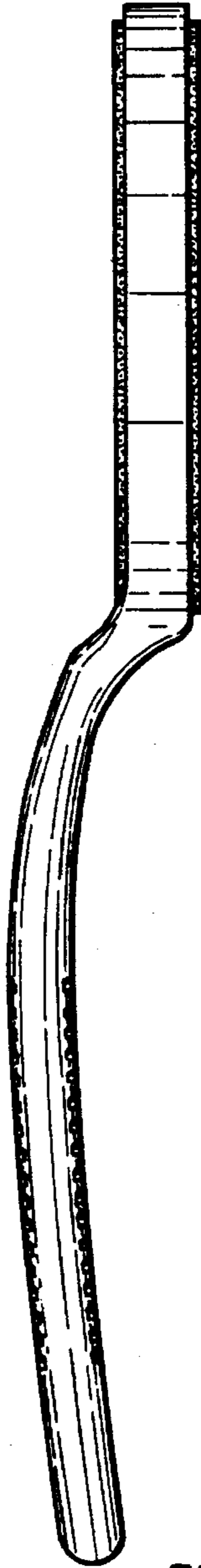

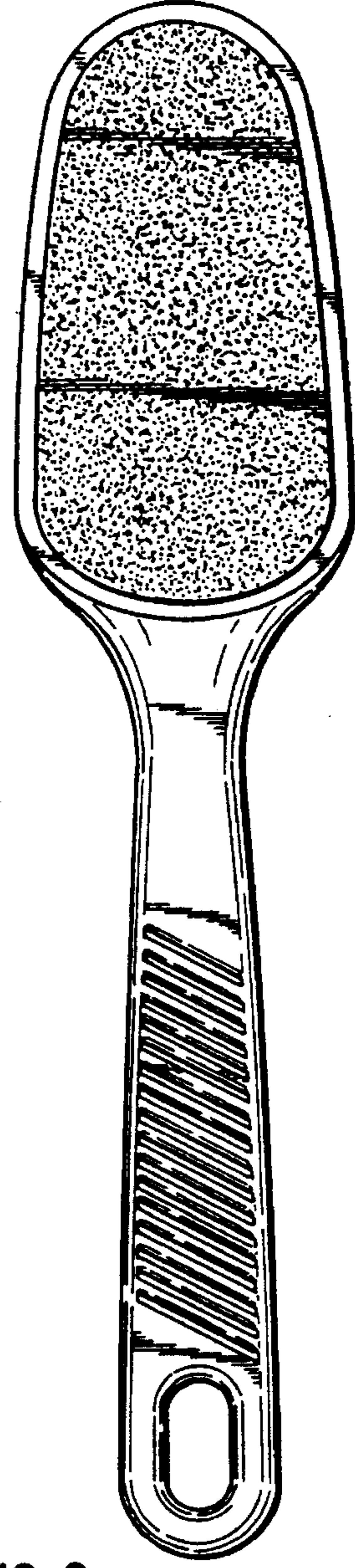

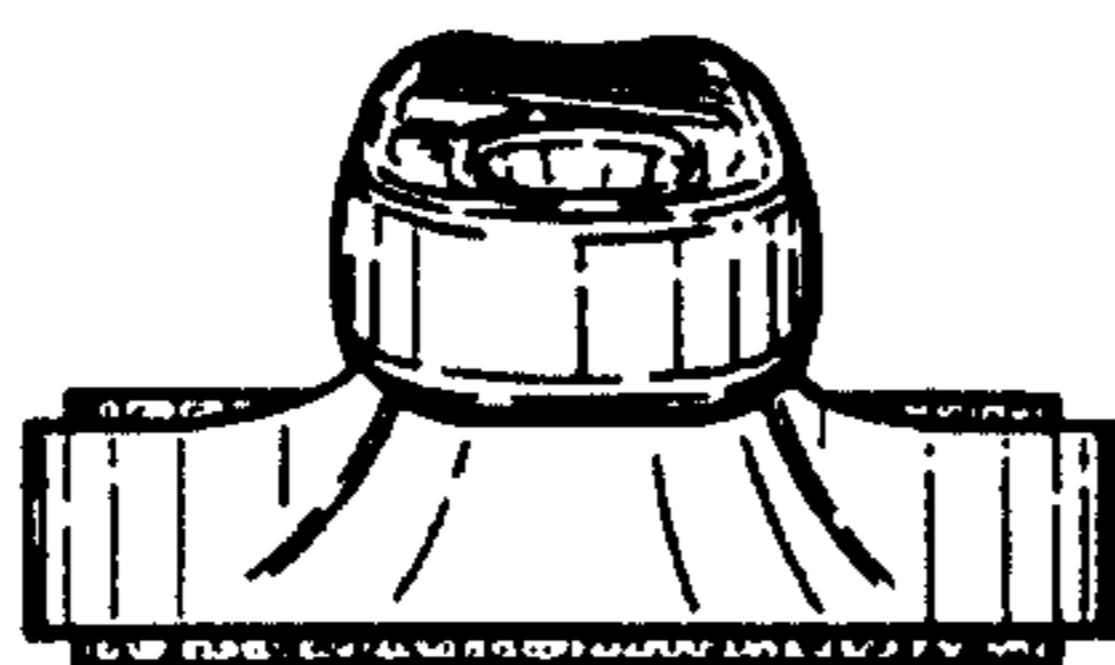
