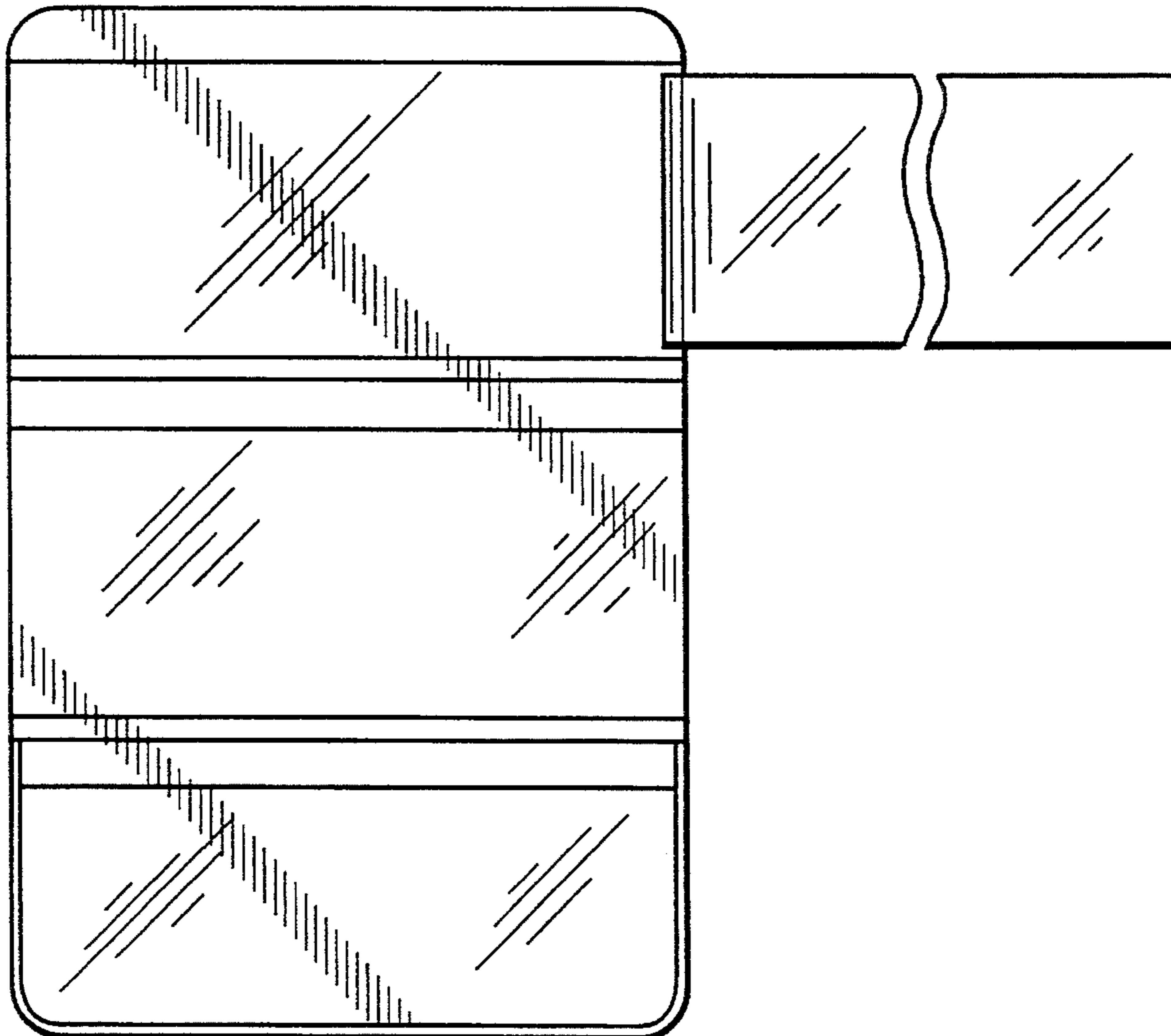

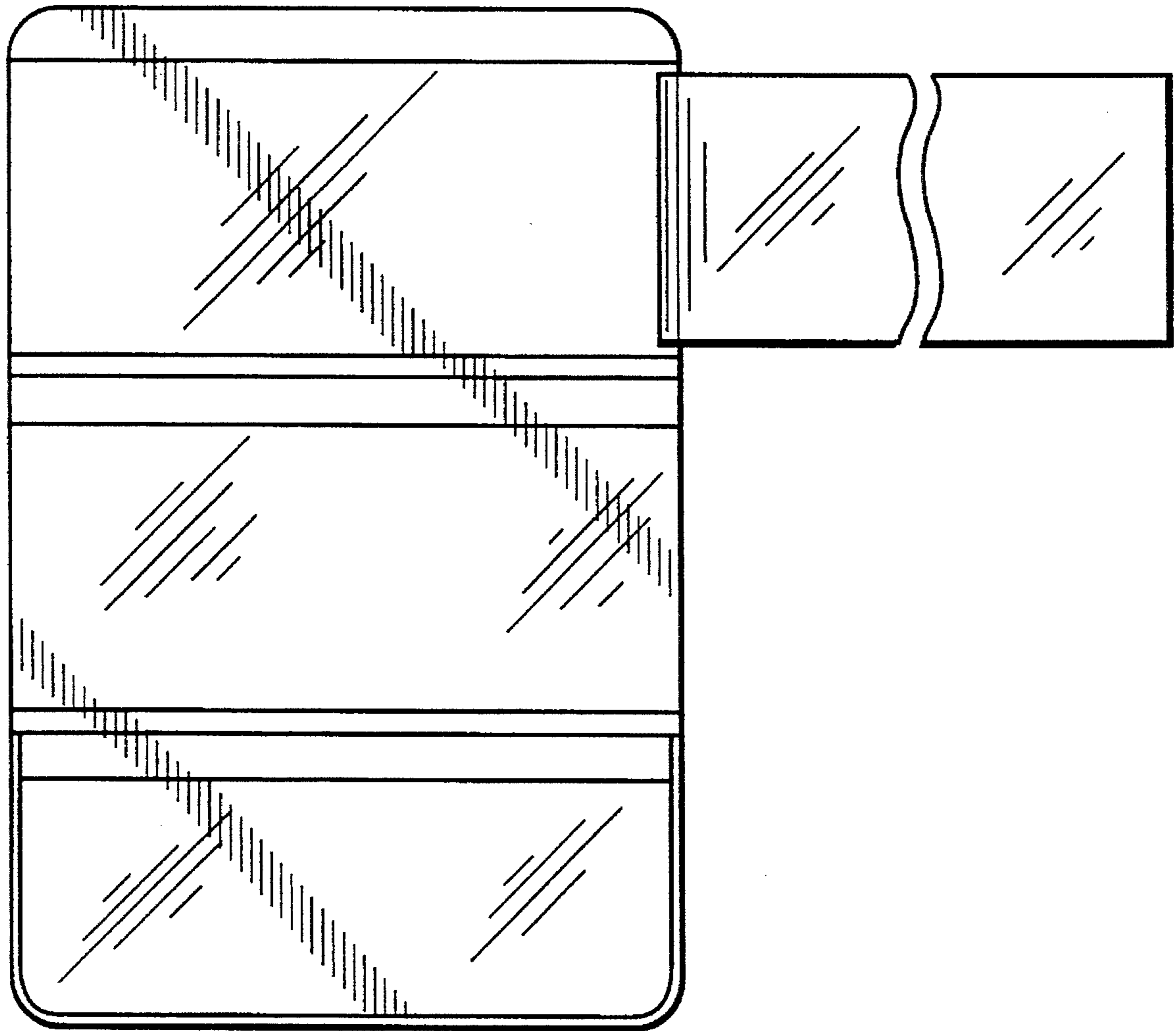
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, in a partially opened position, the undisclosed side being a mirror image; and,

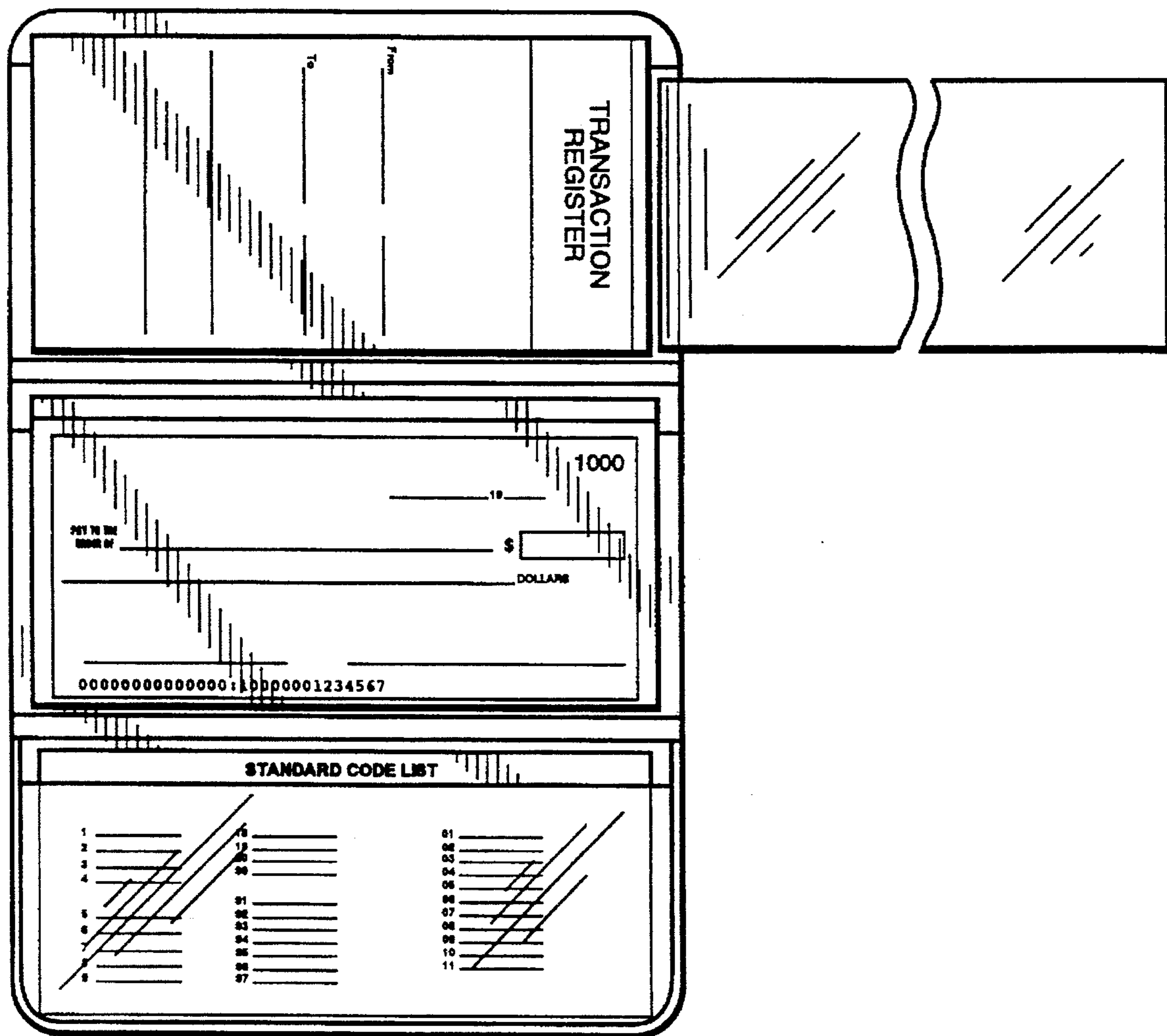
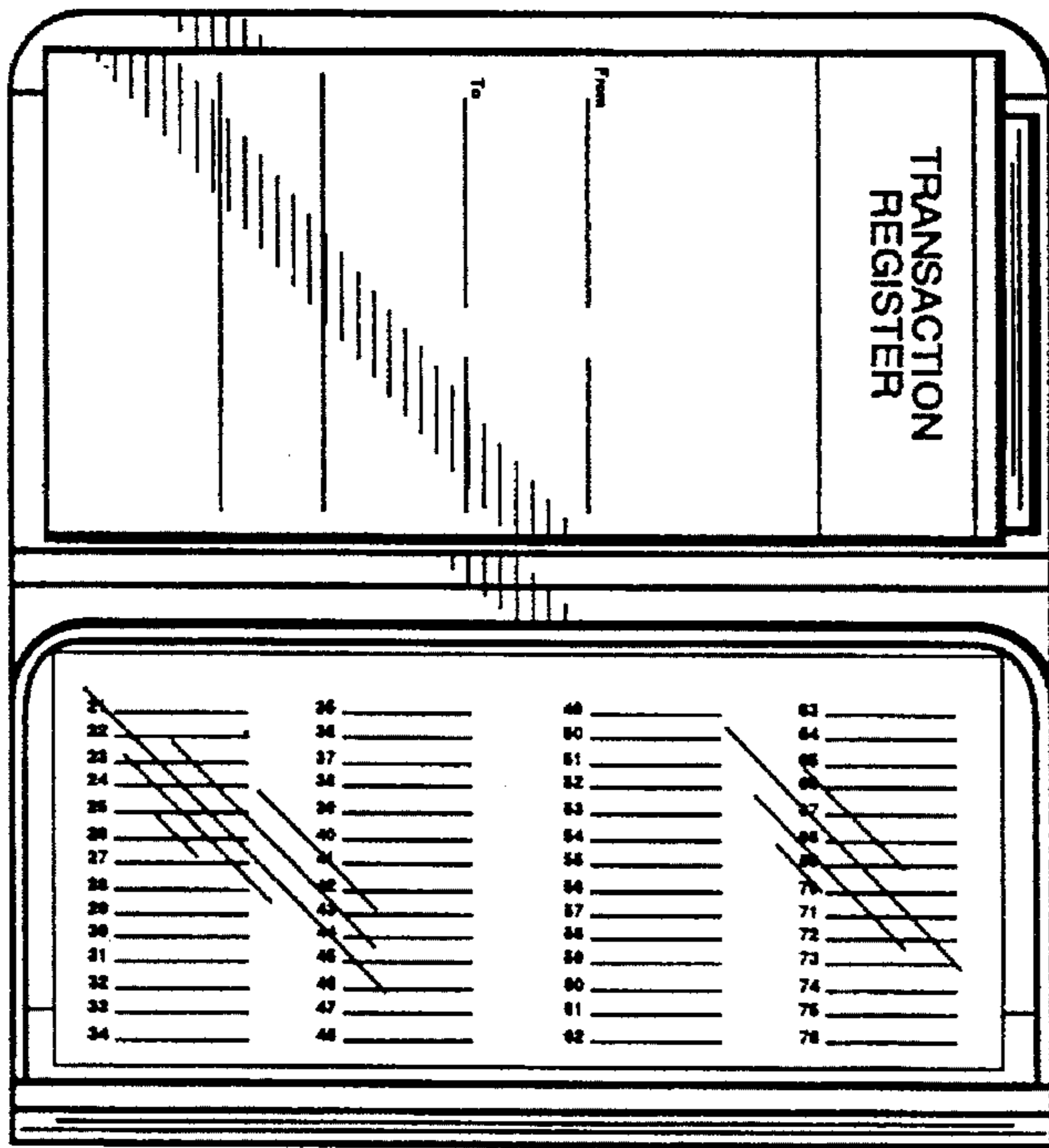
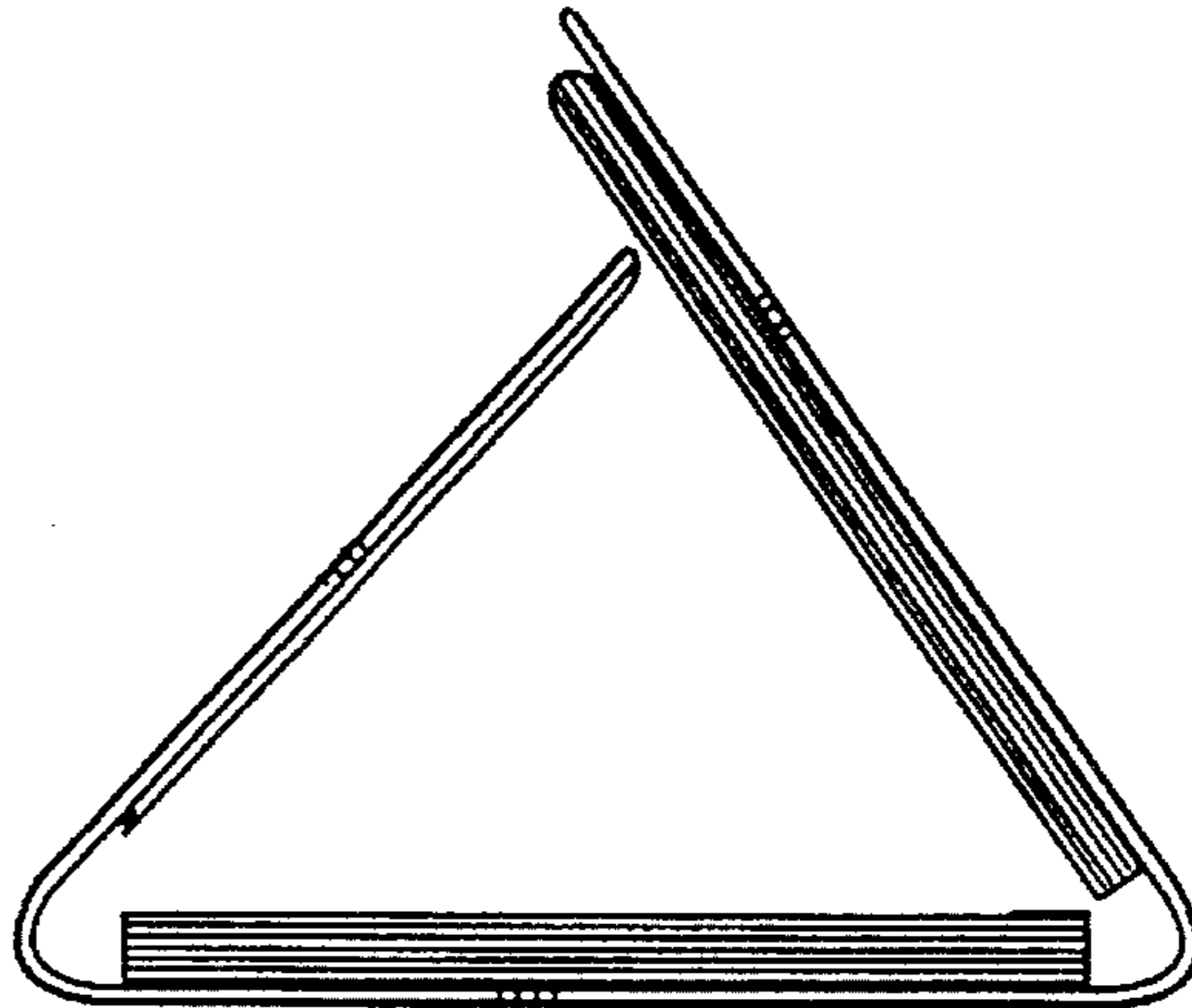


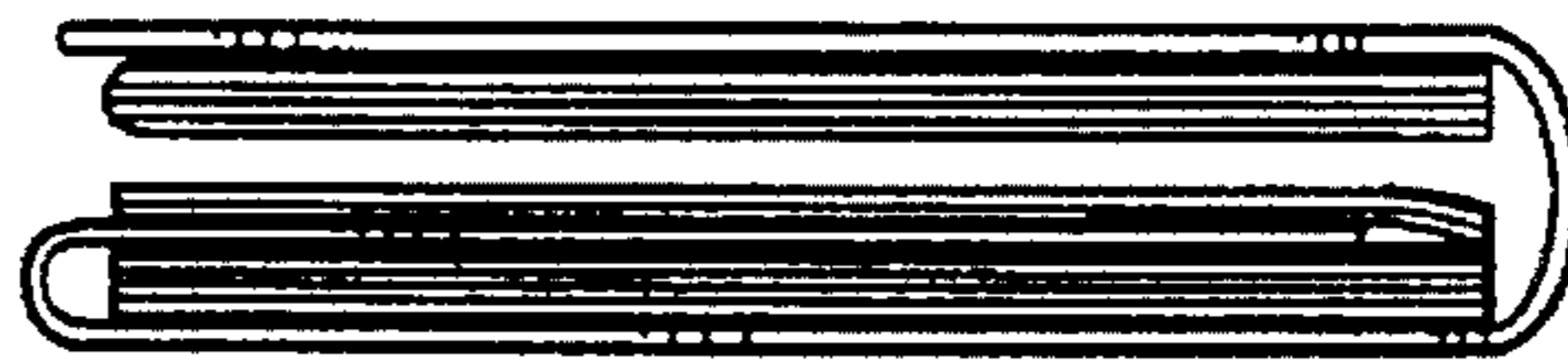
