FIG. 7 is an elevational right side view of the armchair; and,

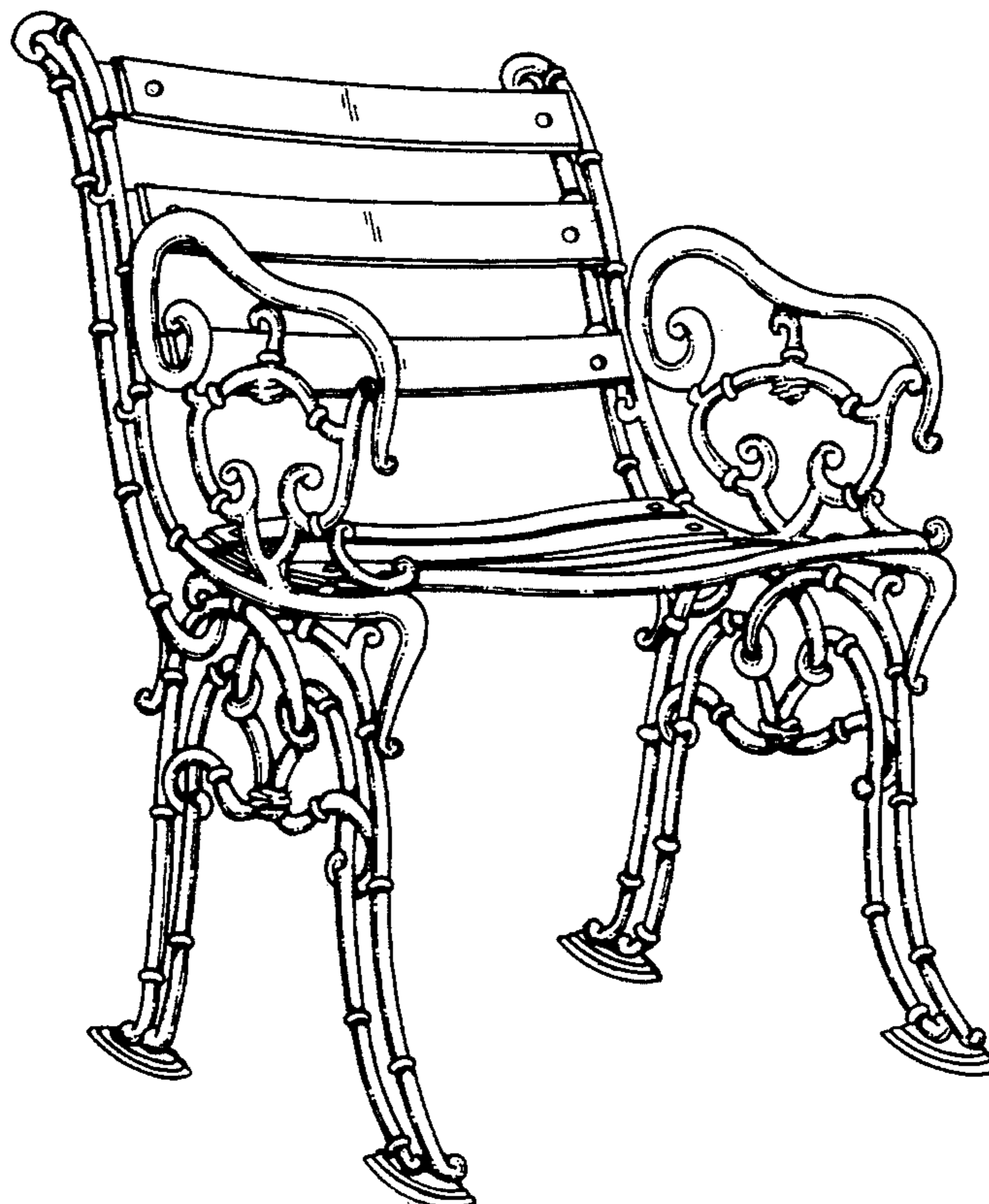

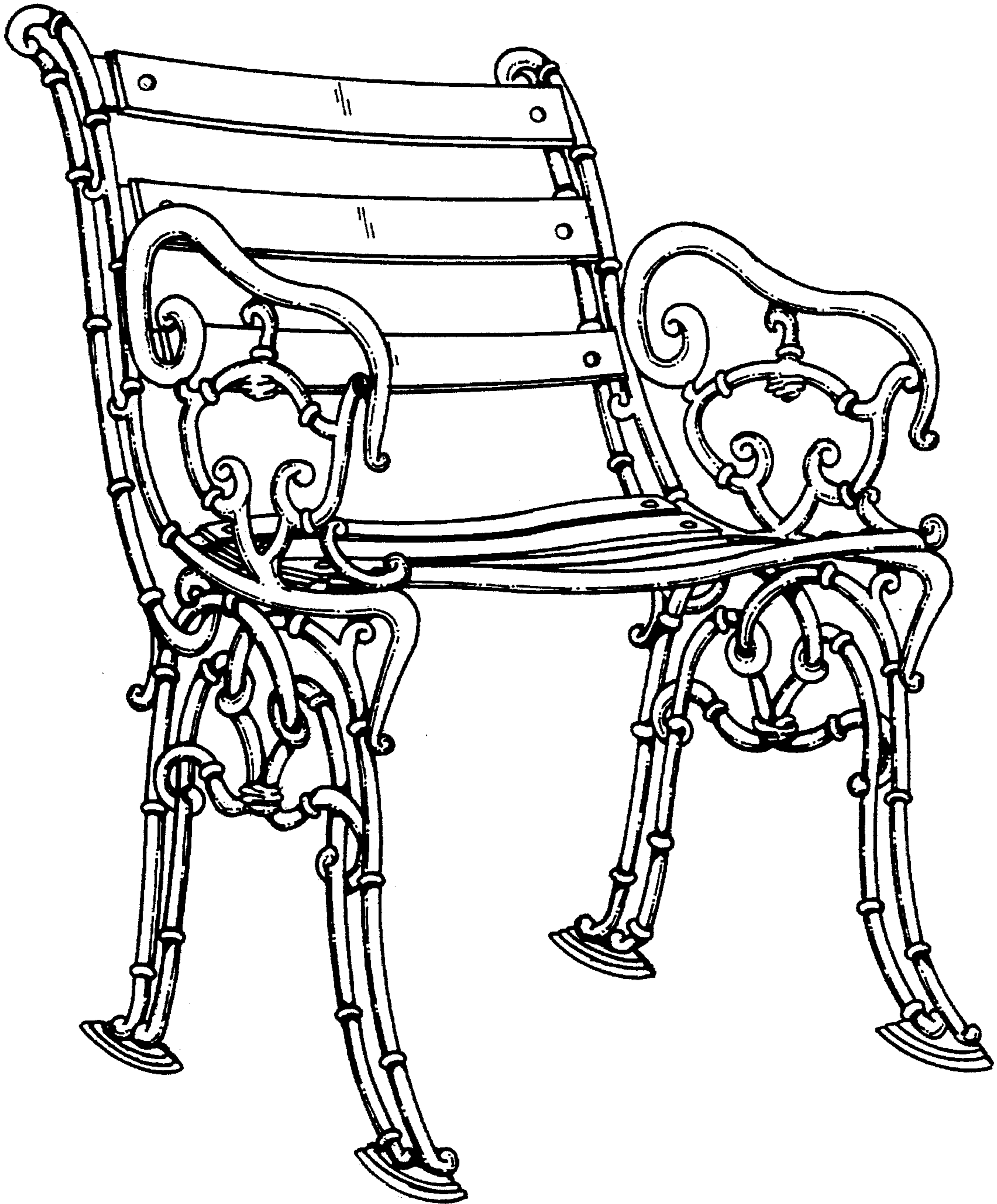

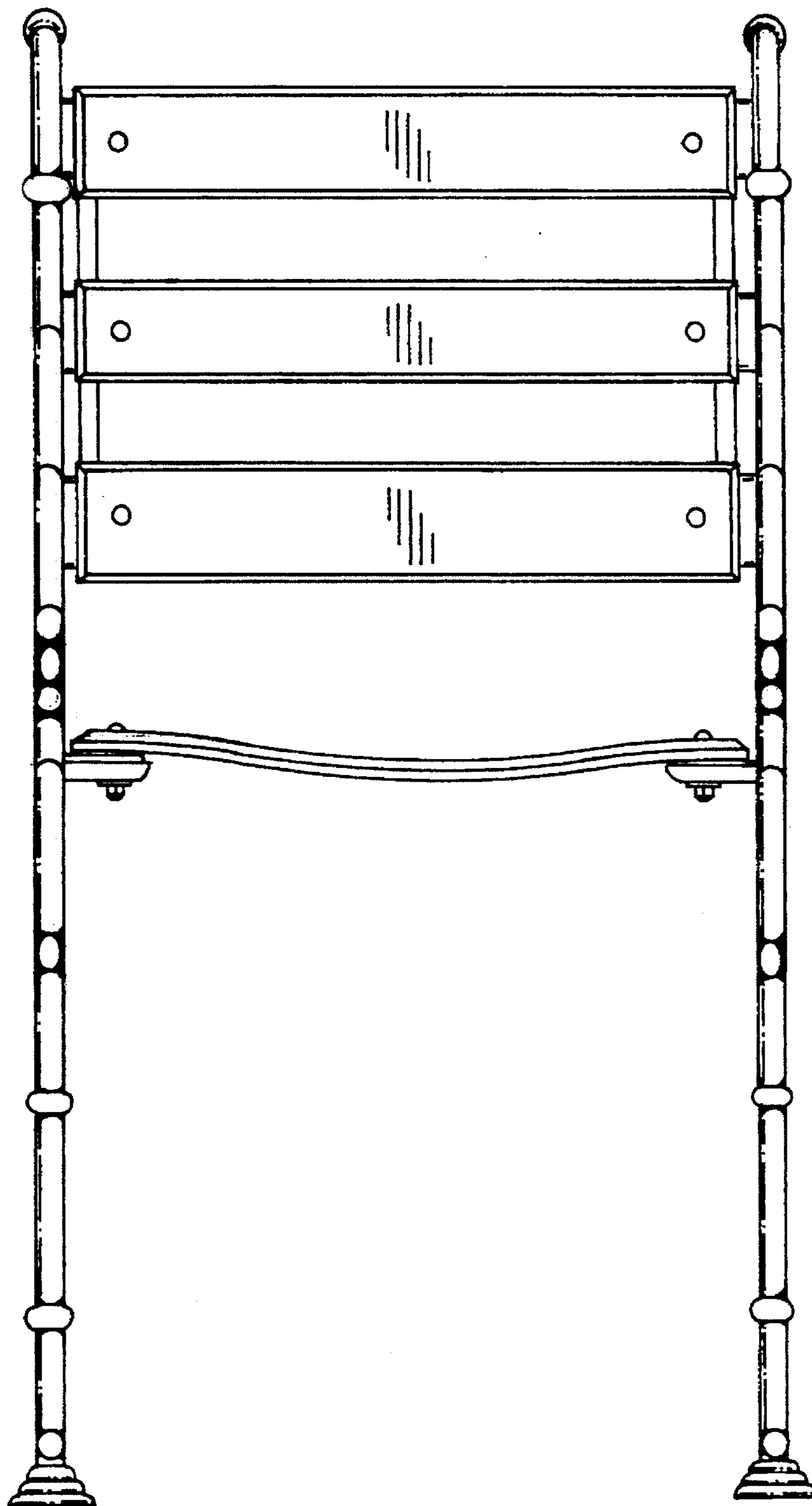

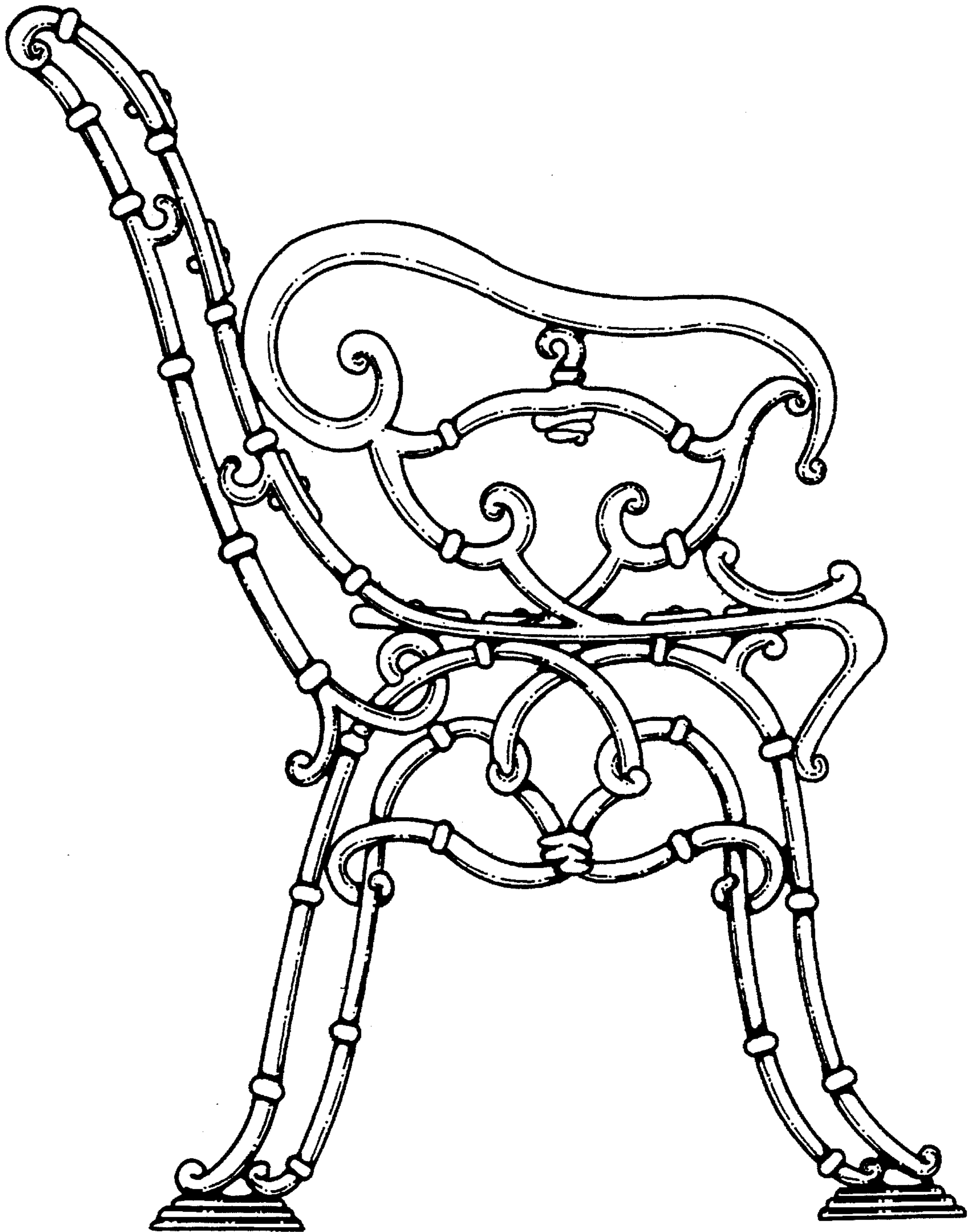

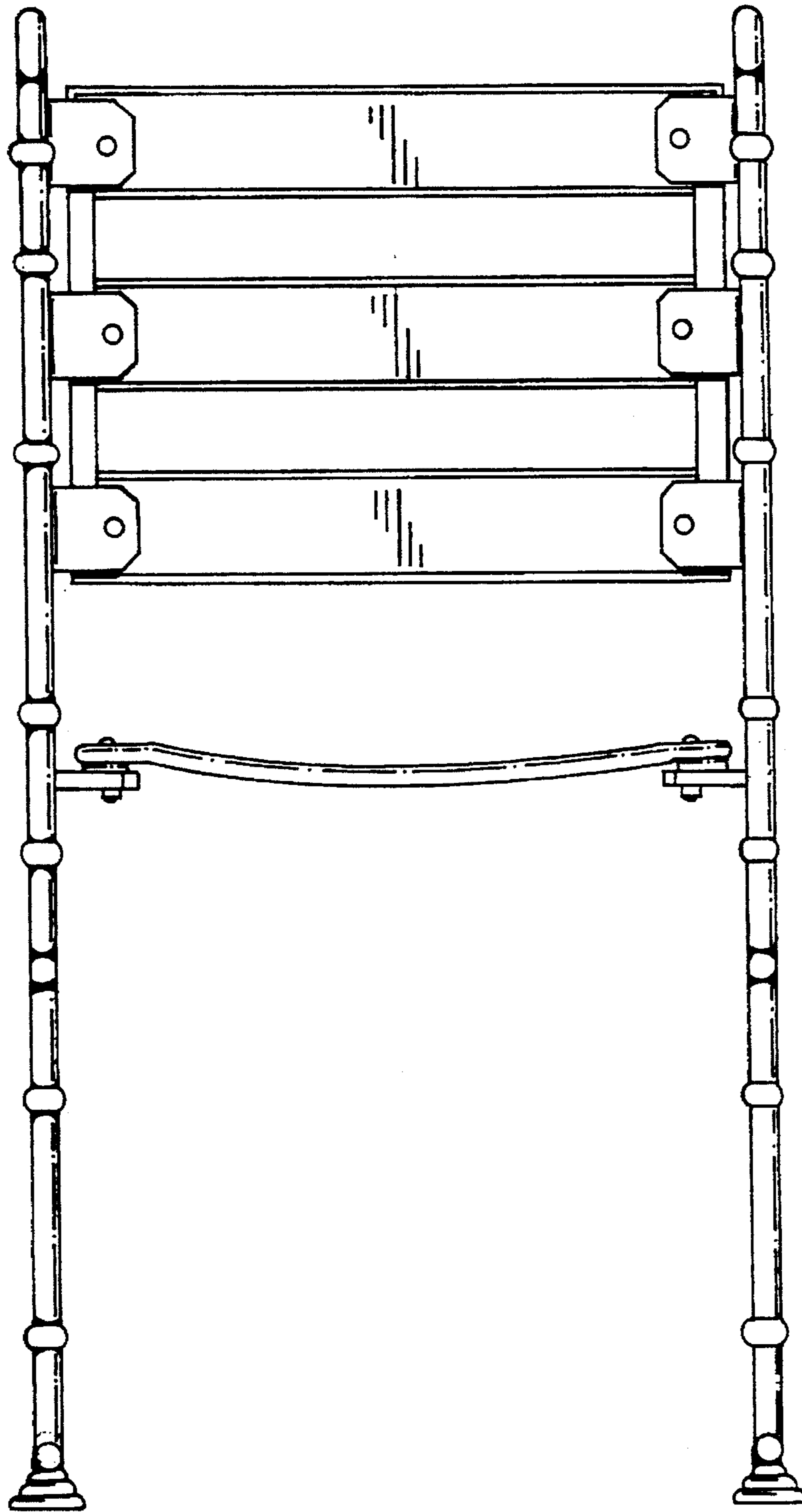

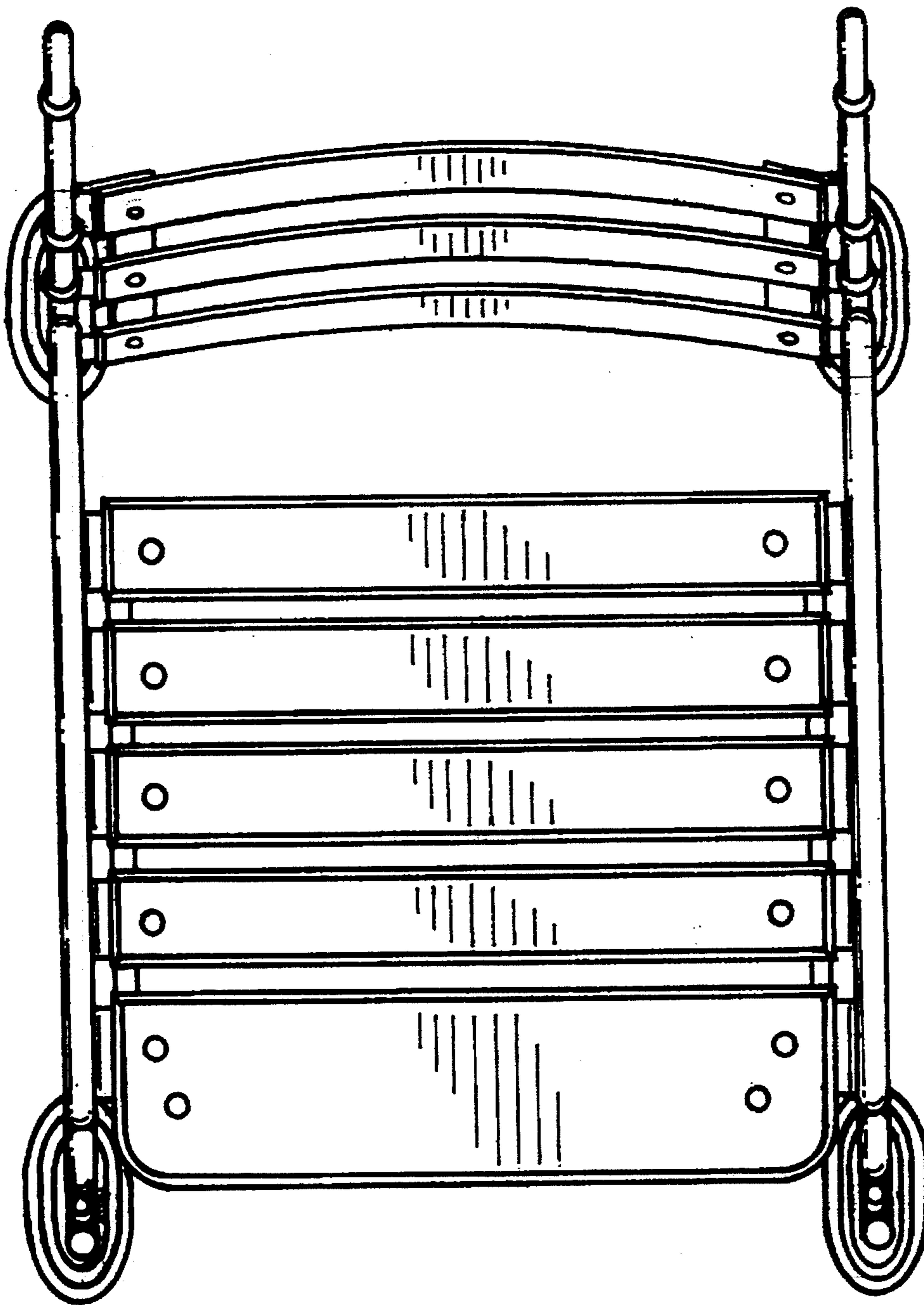

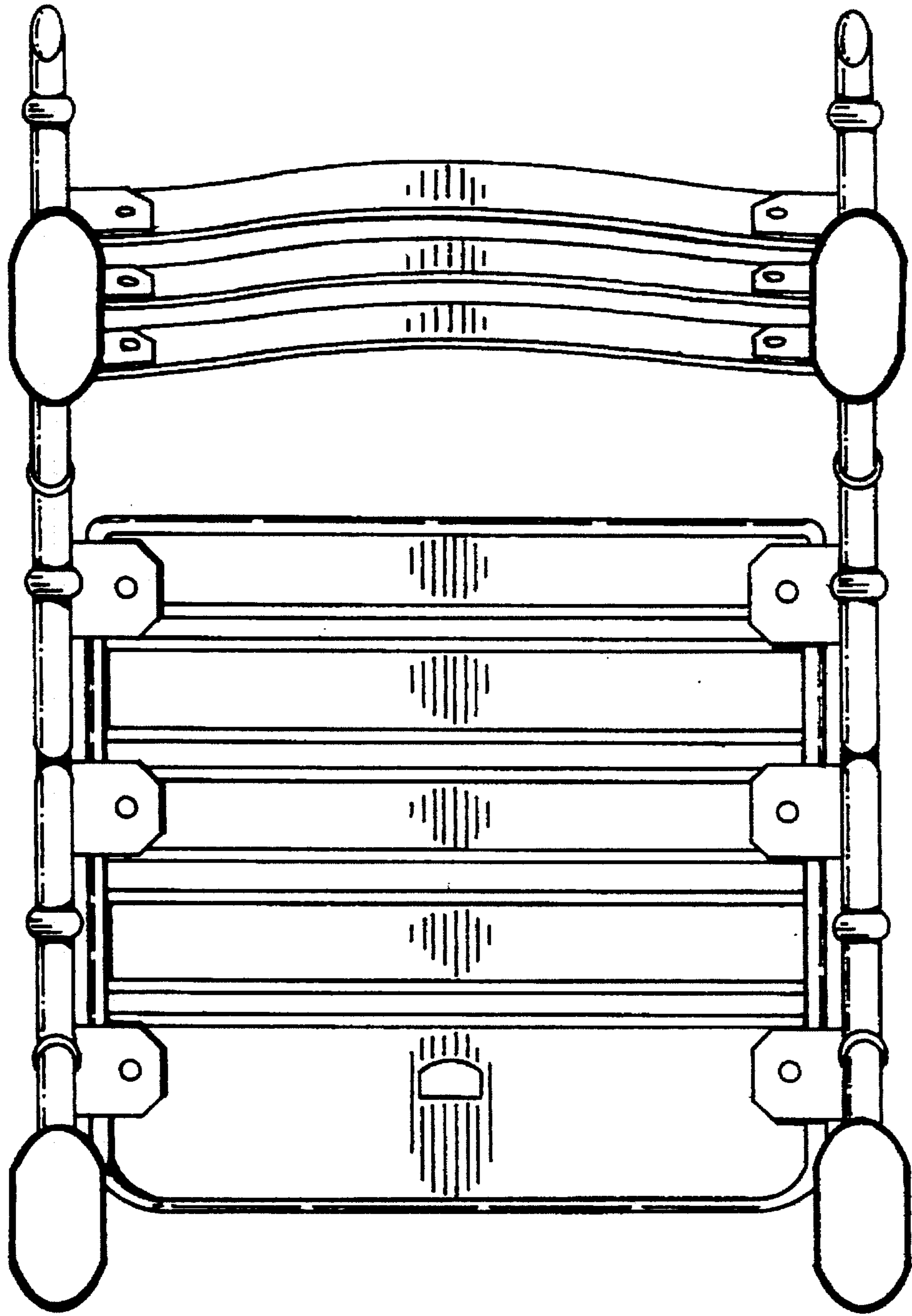

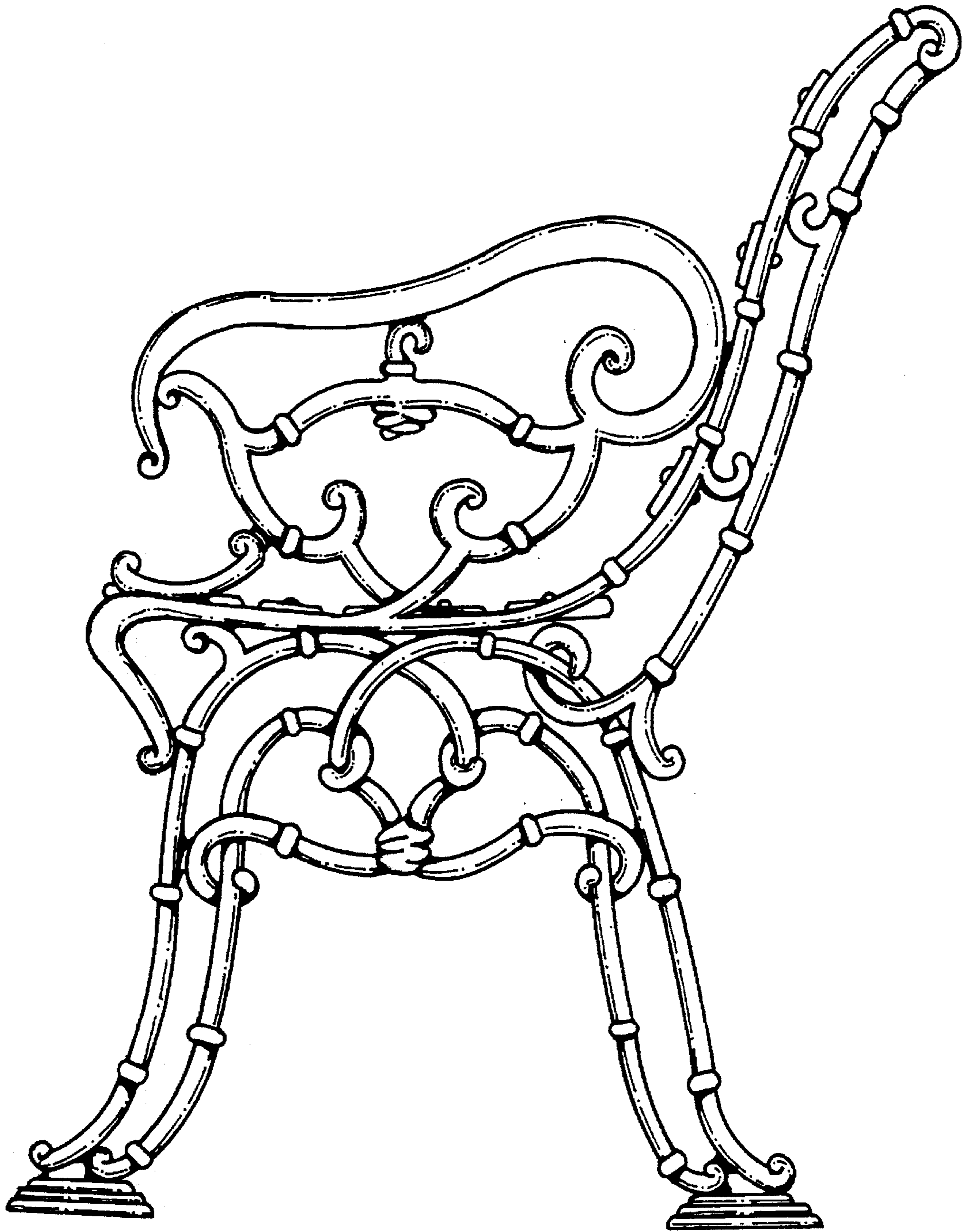

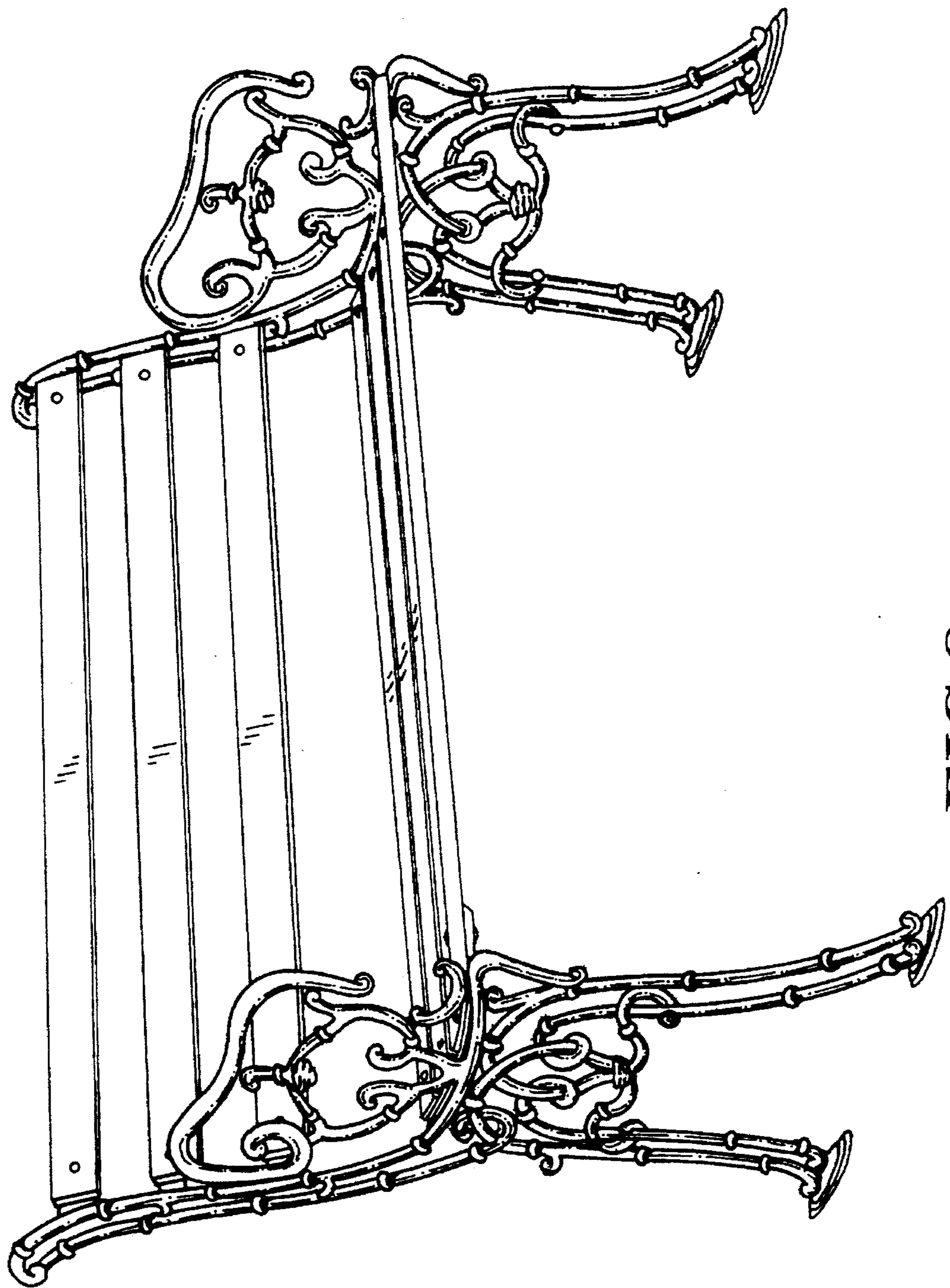
