#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevation view of a combination bee-shaped container and toy showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is an exploded perspective view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.
