[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pillow, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front right side perspective view of a pillow, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof, the bottom being substantially a mirror image of that shown, except for the diagonal line on the right side;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

FIG. 6 is a front elevational view thereof.

The cross-hatching represents conventional fabric and is understood to extend throughout the areas represented.
