The ornamental design for a badge, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of card badges showing my new design, the opposite side being identical thereto;
FIG. 2 is an end elevational view of my new design shown in FIG. 1, the opposite end being identical thereto; and,
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of my new design shown in FIG. 1, the opposite side being identical thereto.

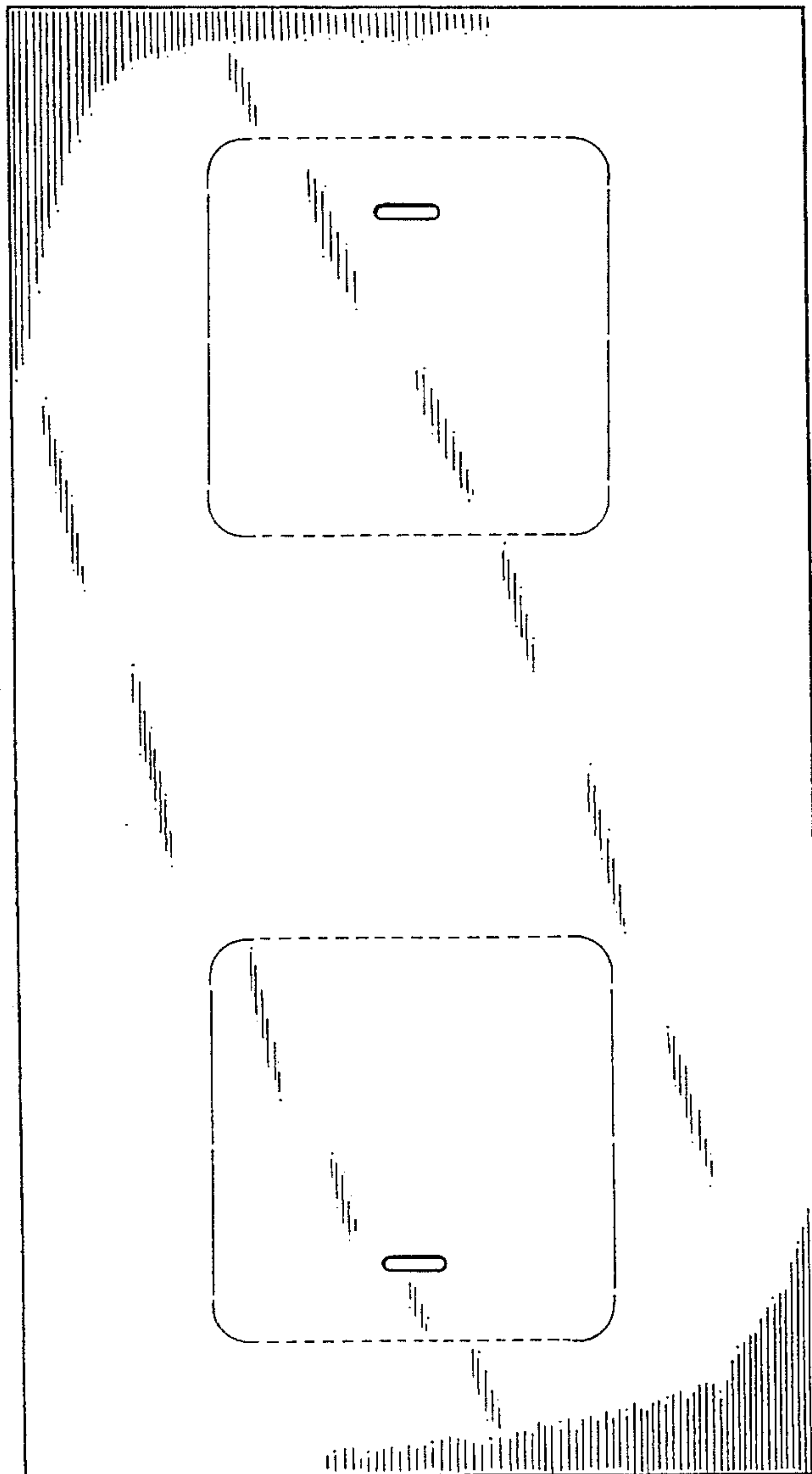

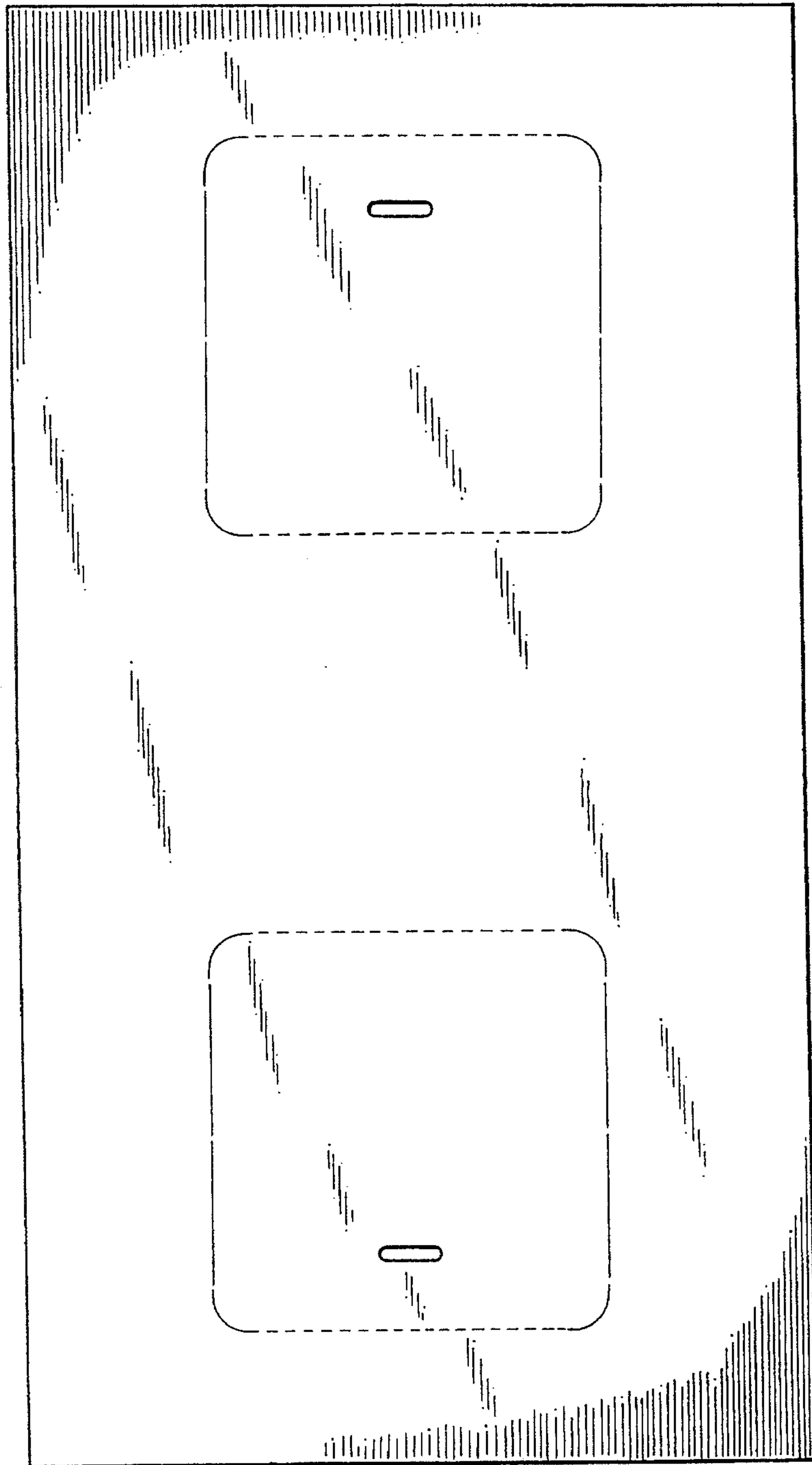
