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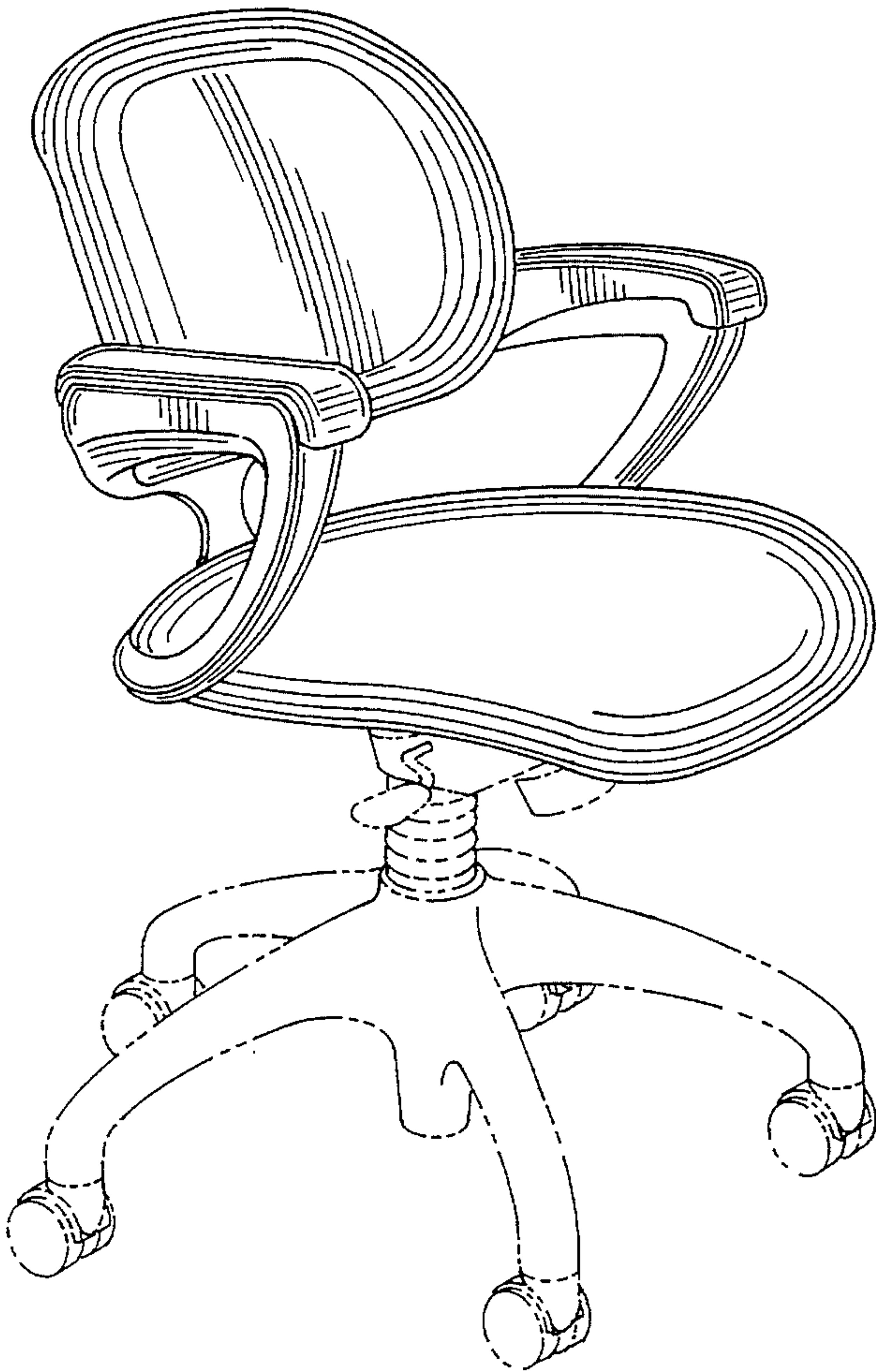

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DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a chair showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side being a mirror image of the right side;

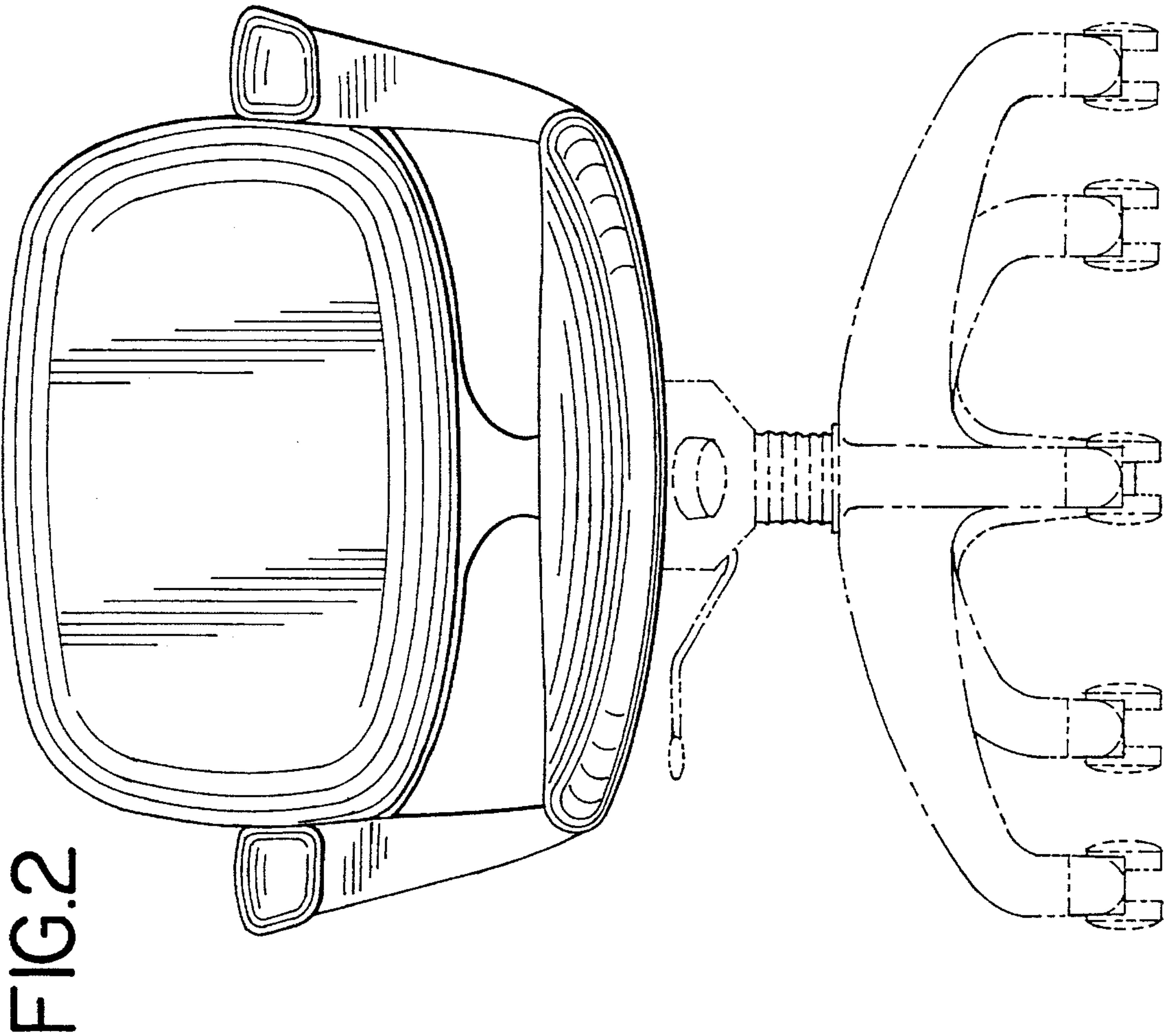
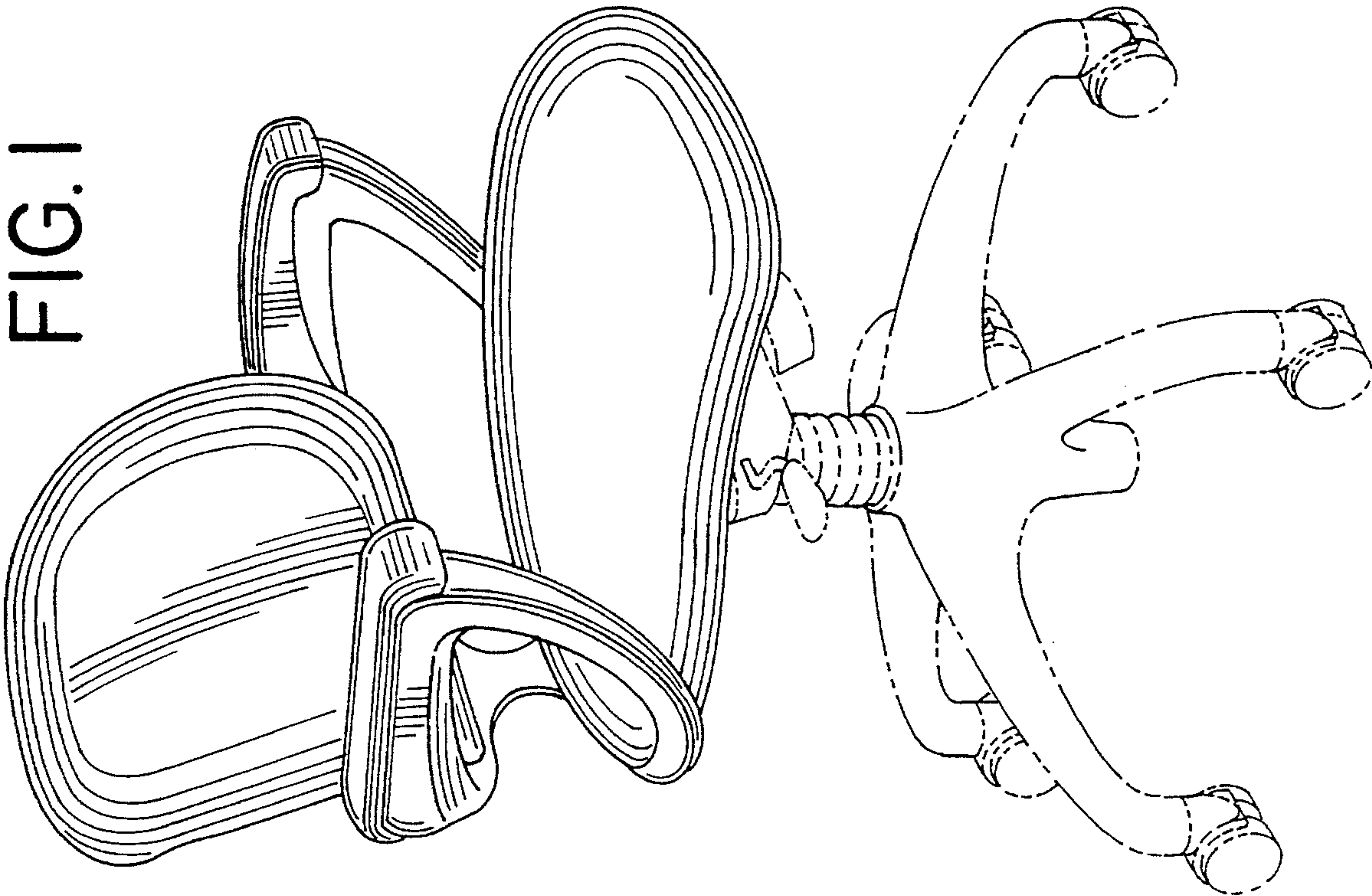

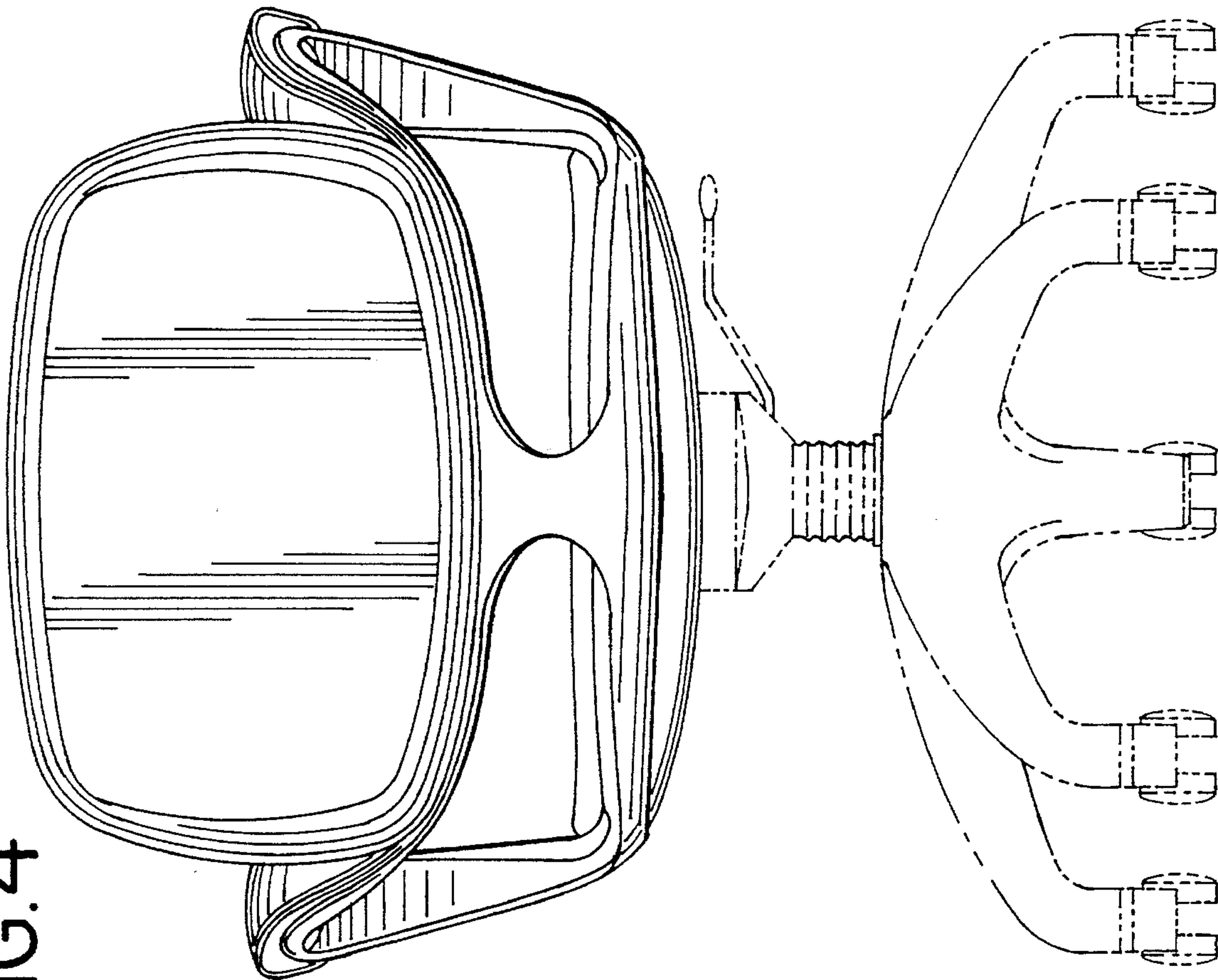

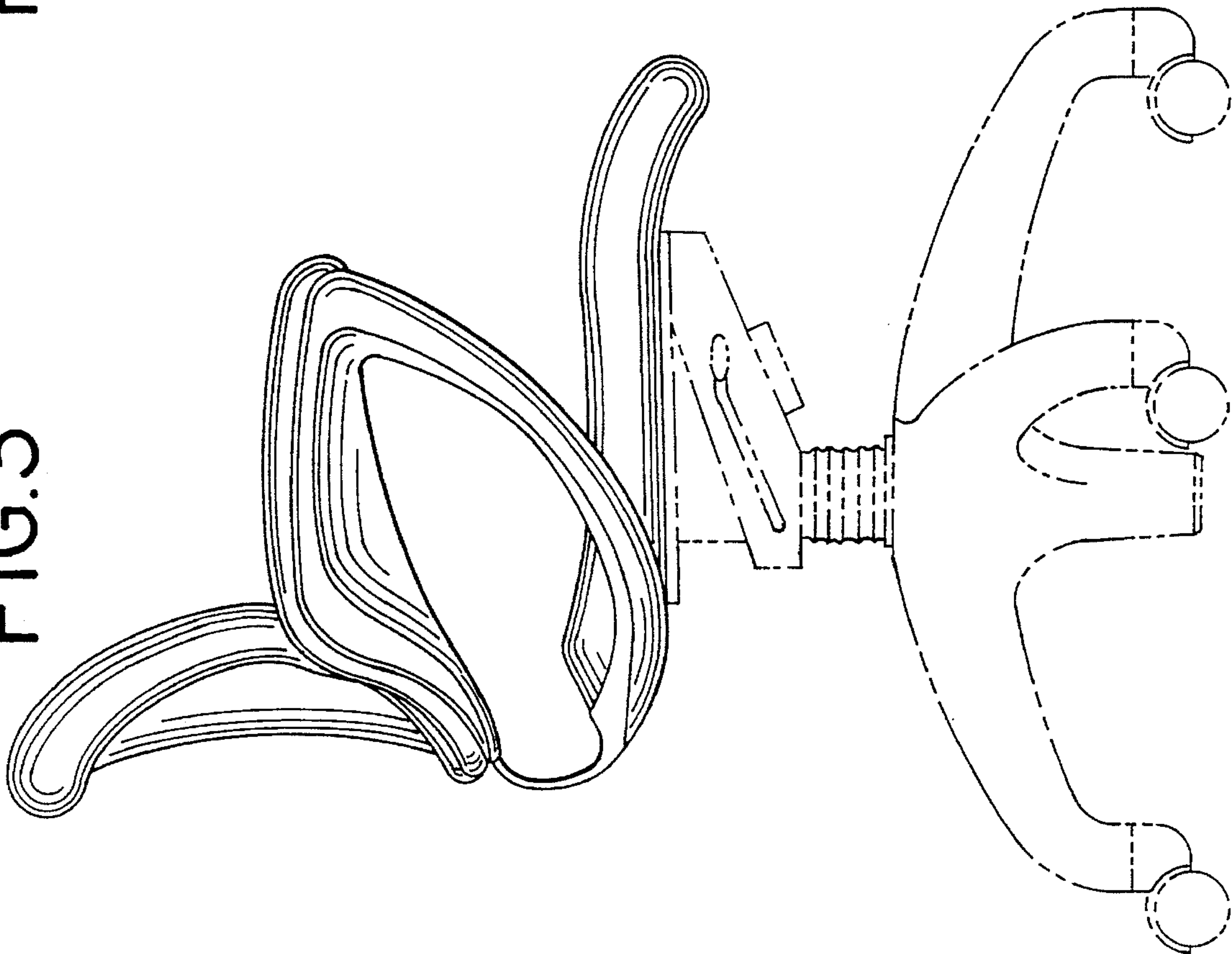
