**CLAIM** 

The ornamental design for a luggage cart, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a luggage cart, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side elevational view thereof being a mirror image of the left side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is an elevational view thereof, taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 2, in a direction indicated by arrows;

FIG. 4 is an elevational view thereof, taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 2, in a direction indicated by arrows;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view thereof, taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 2, in a direction indicated by arrows; and,

FIG. 6 is an elevational view thereof, taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 2, in a direction indicated by arrows.
















