FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

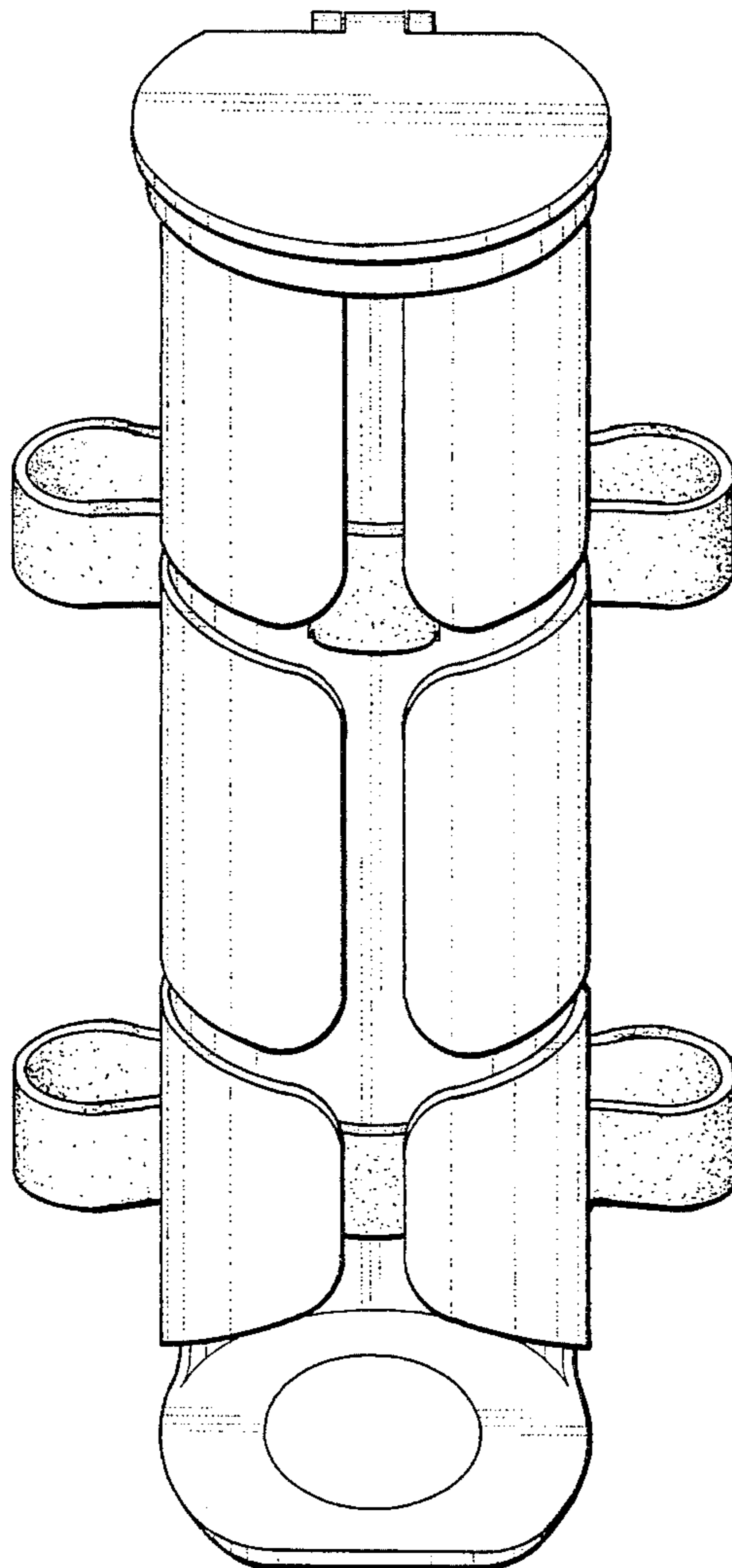
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view with the left side being a mirror image thereof;

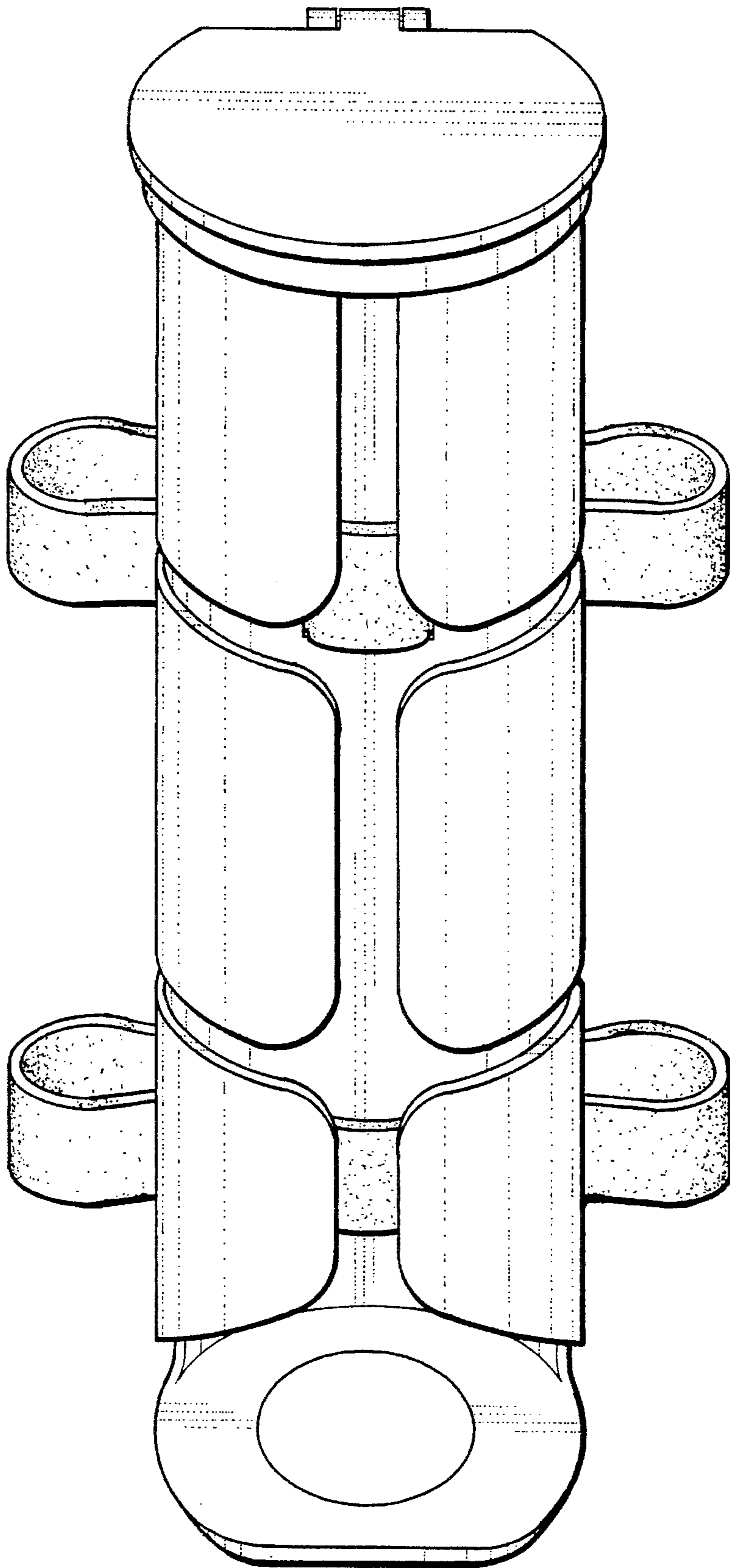

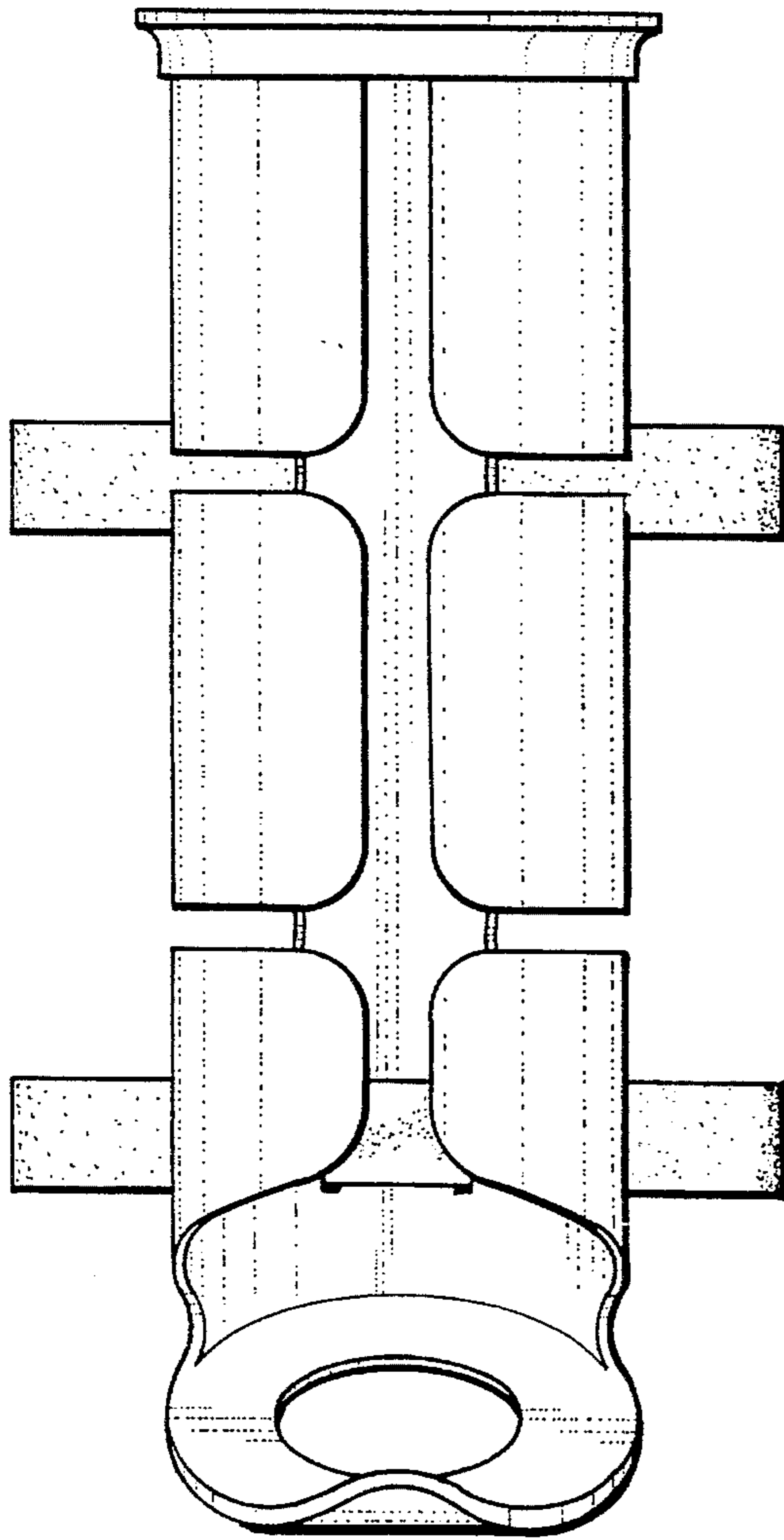

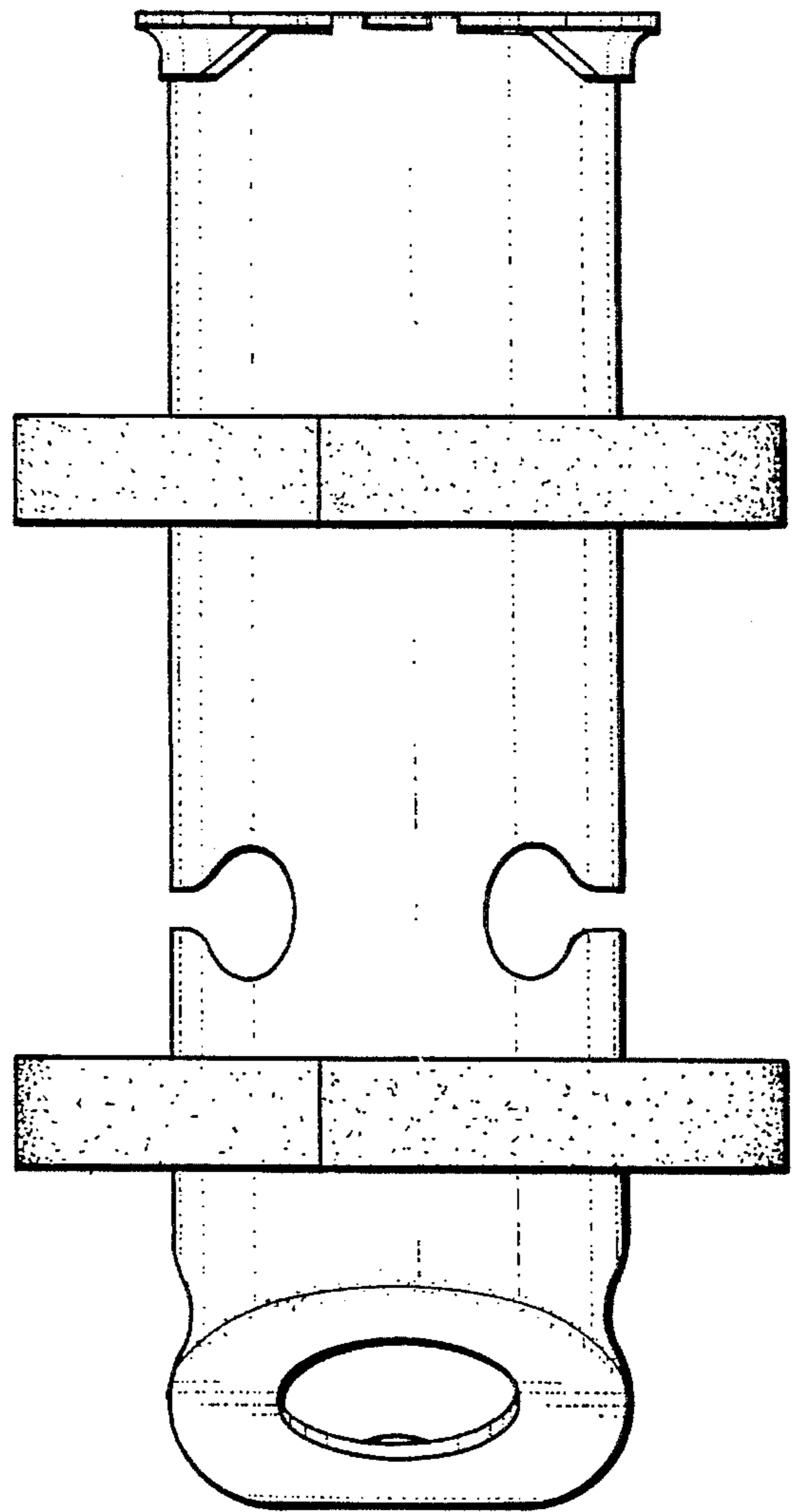

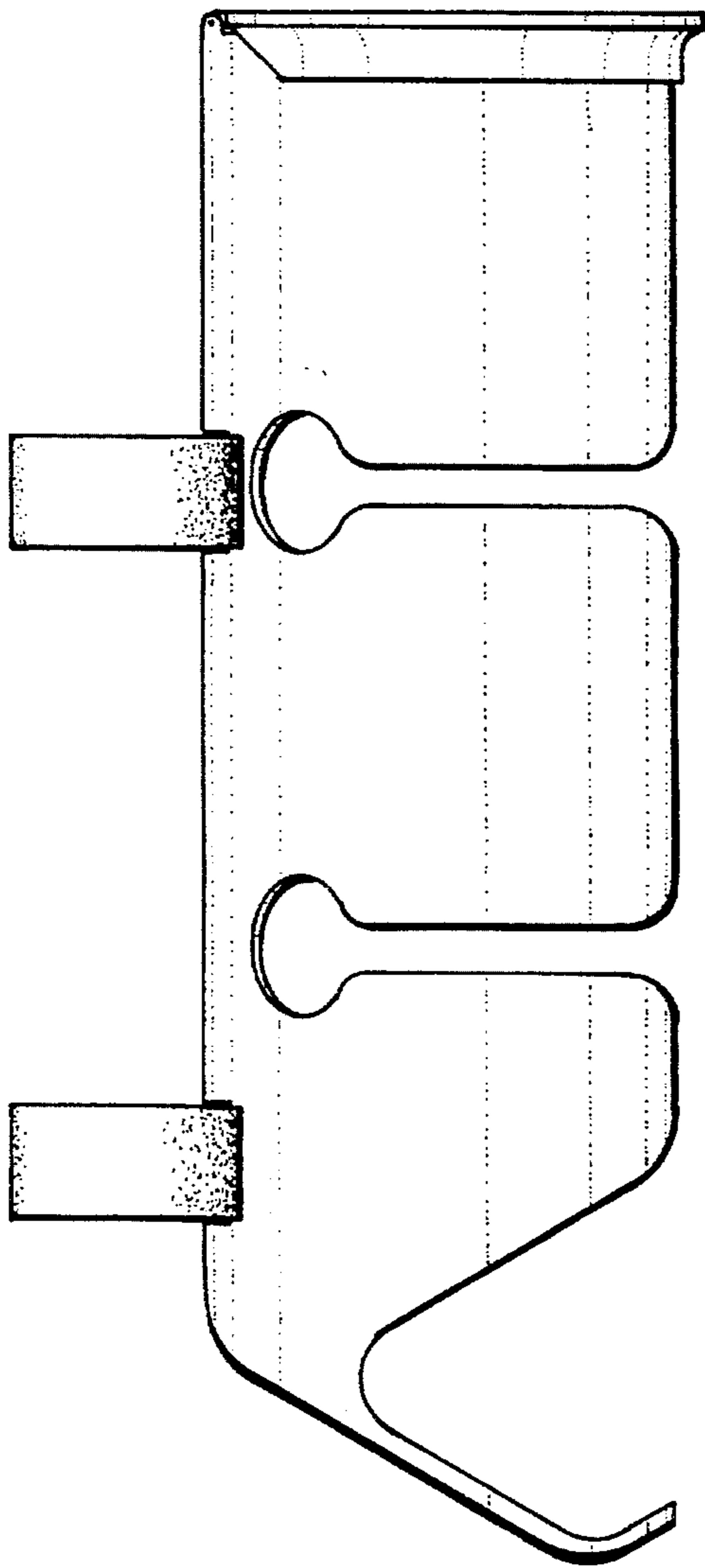

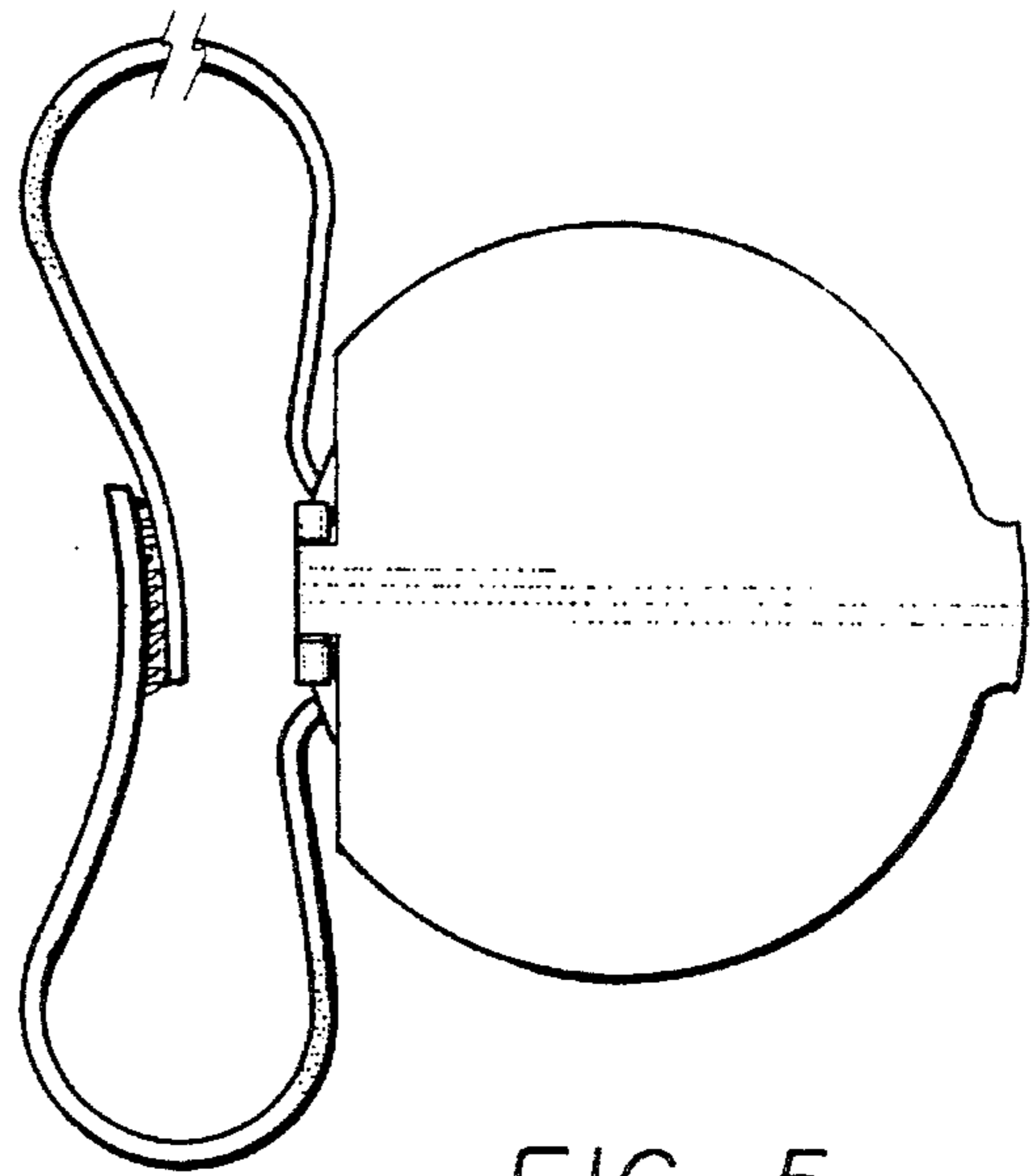

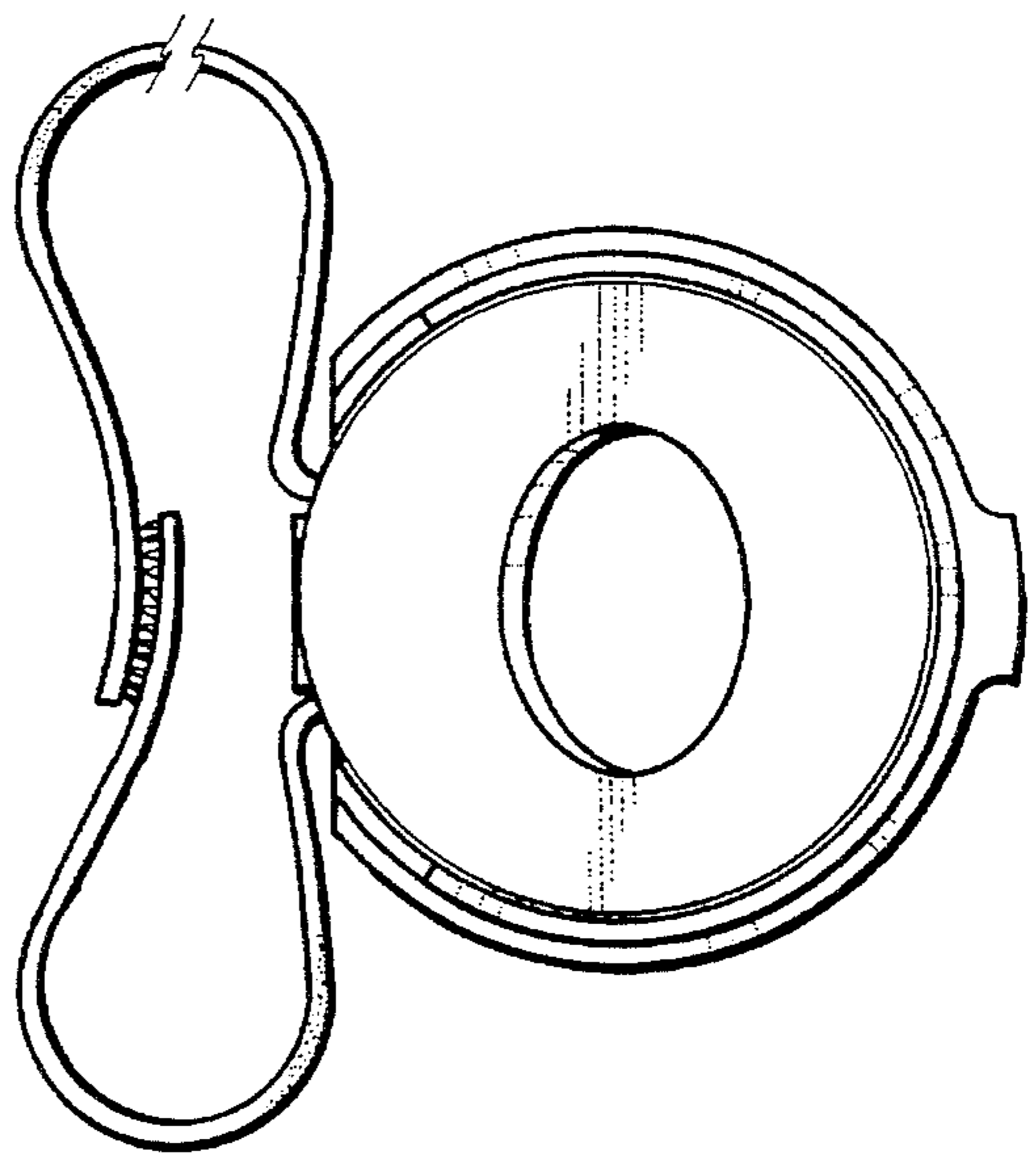
