DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fish gaff according to our new design; the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

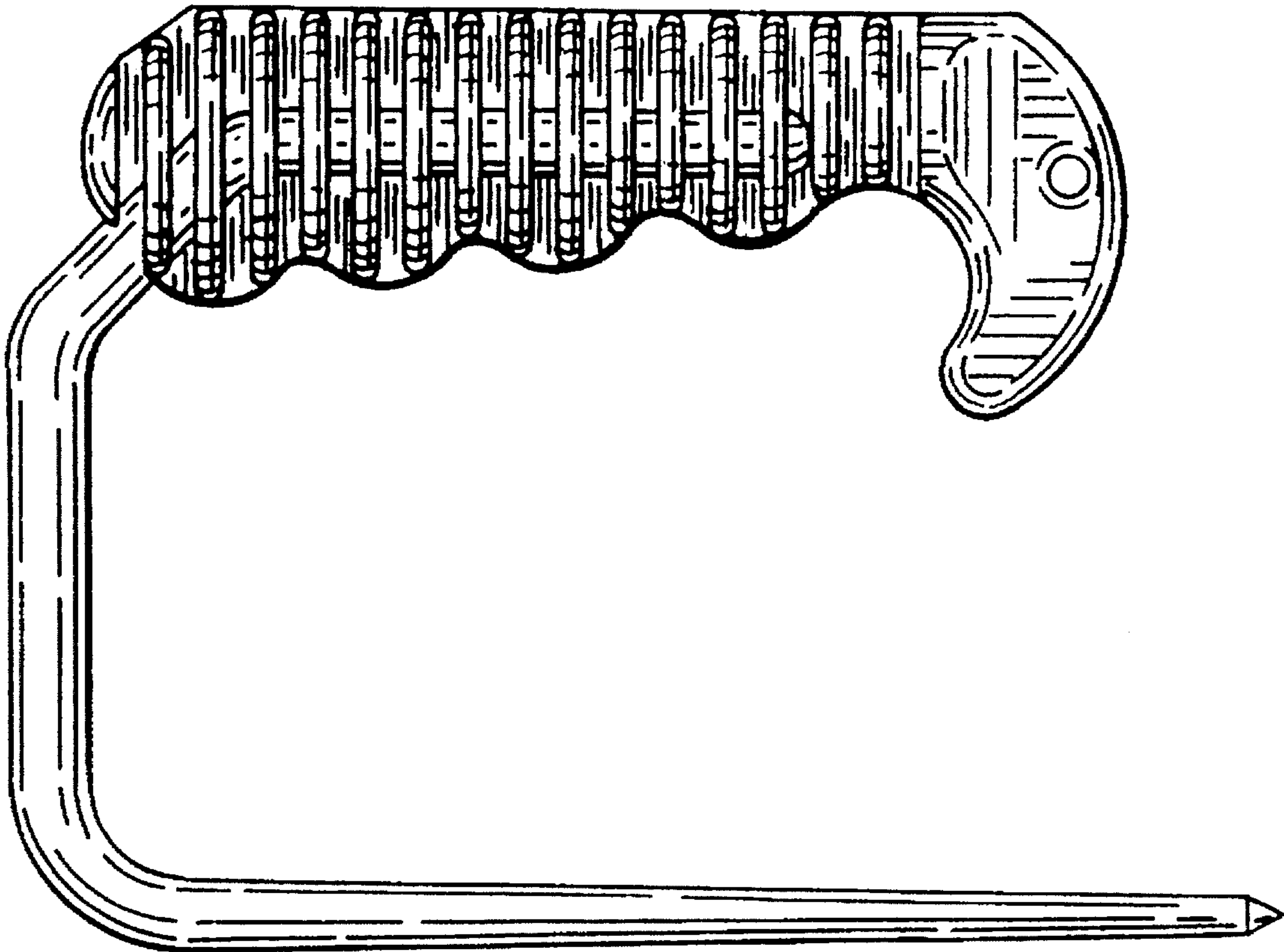

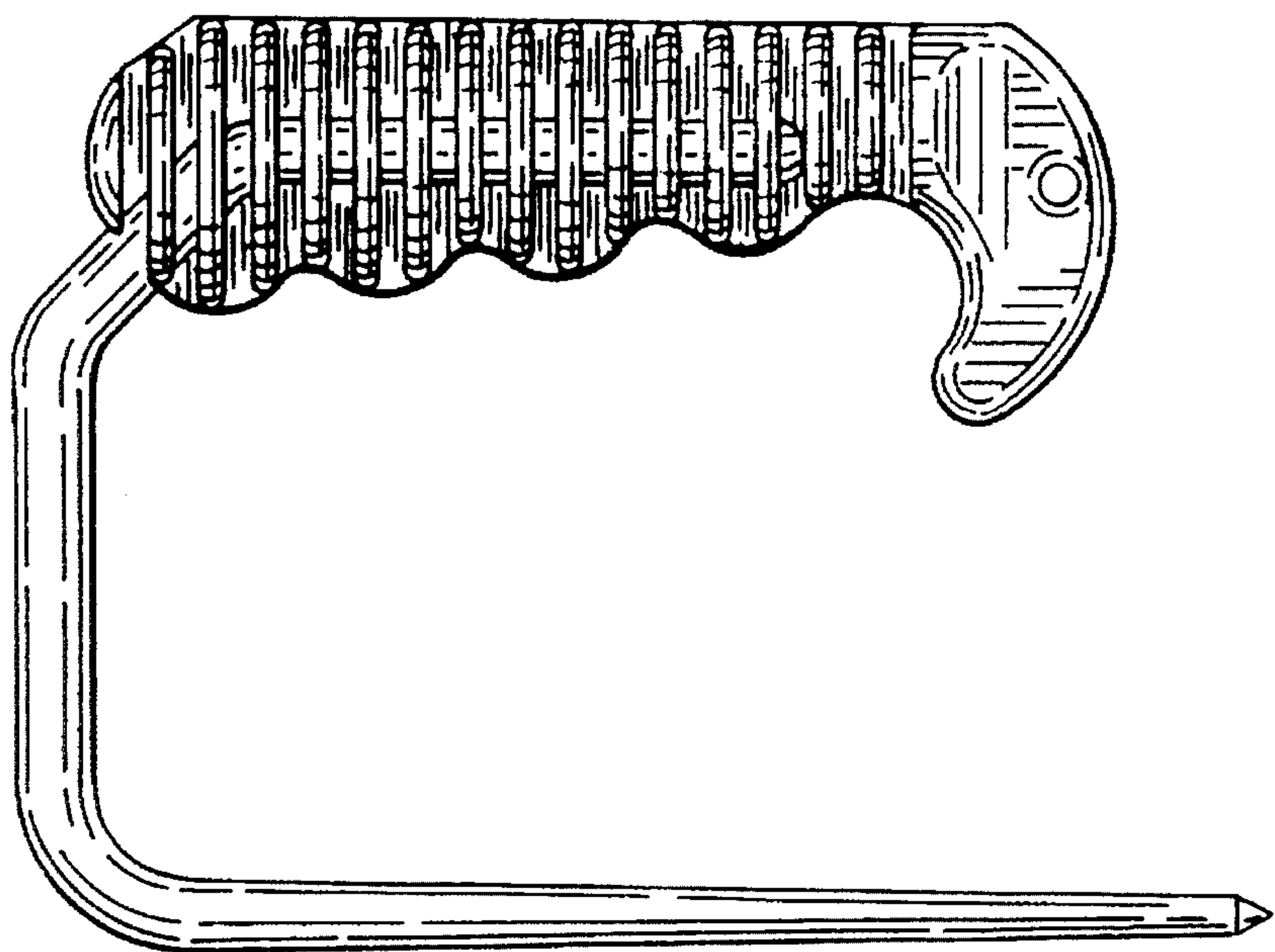

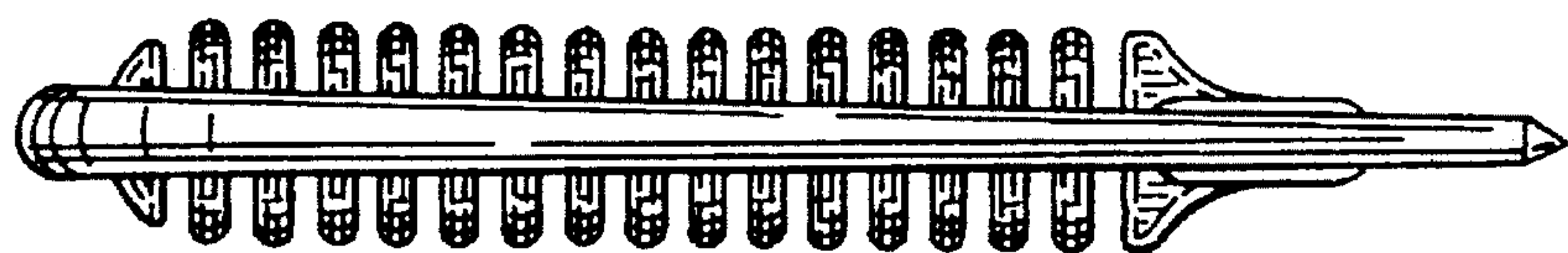

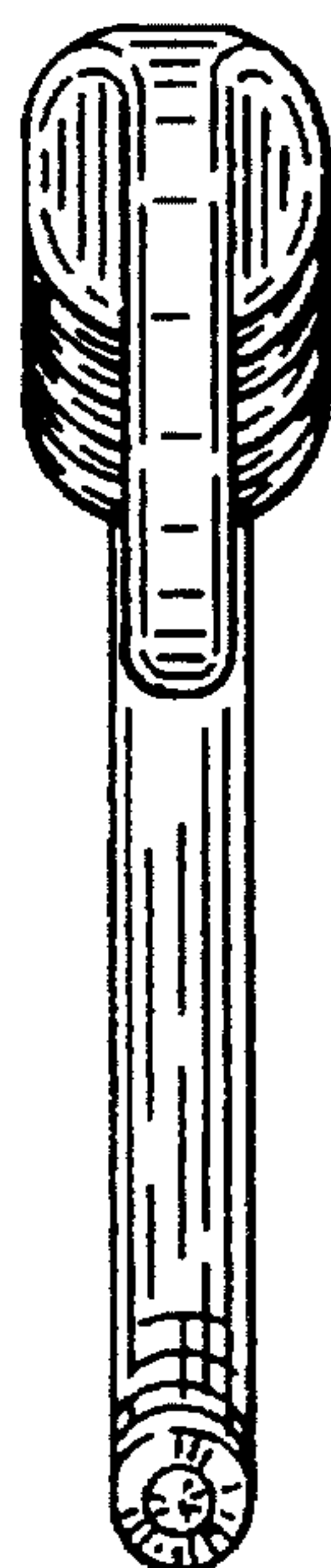

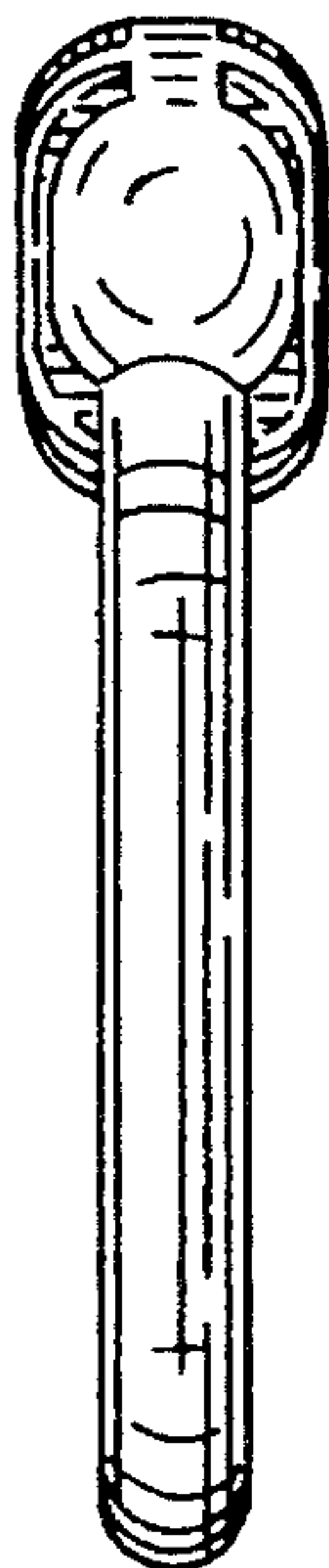
