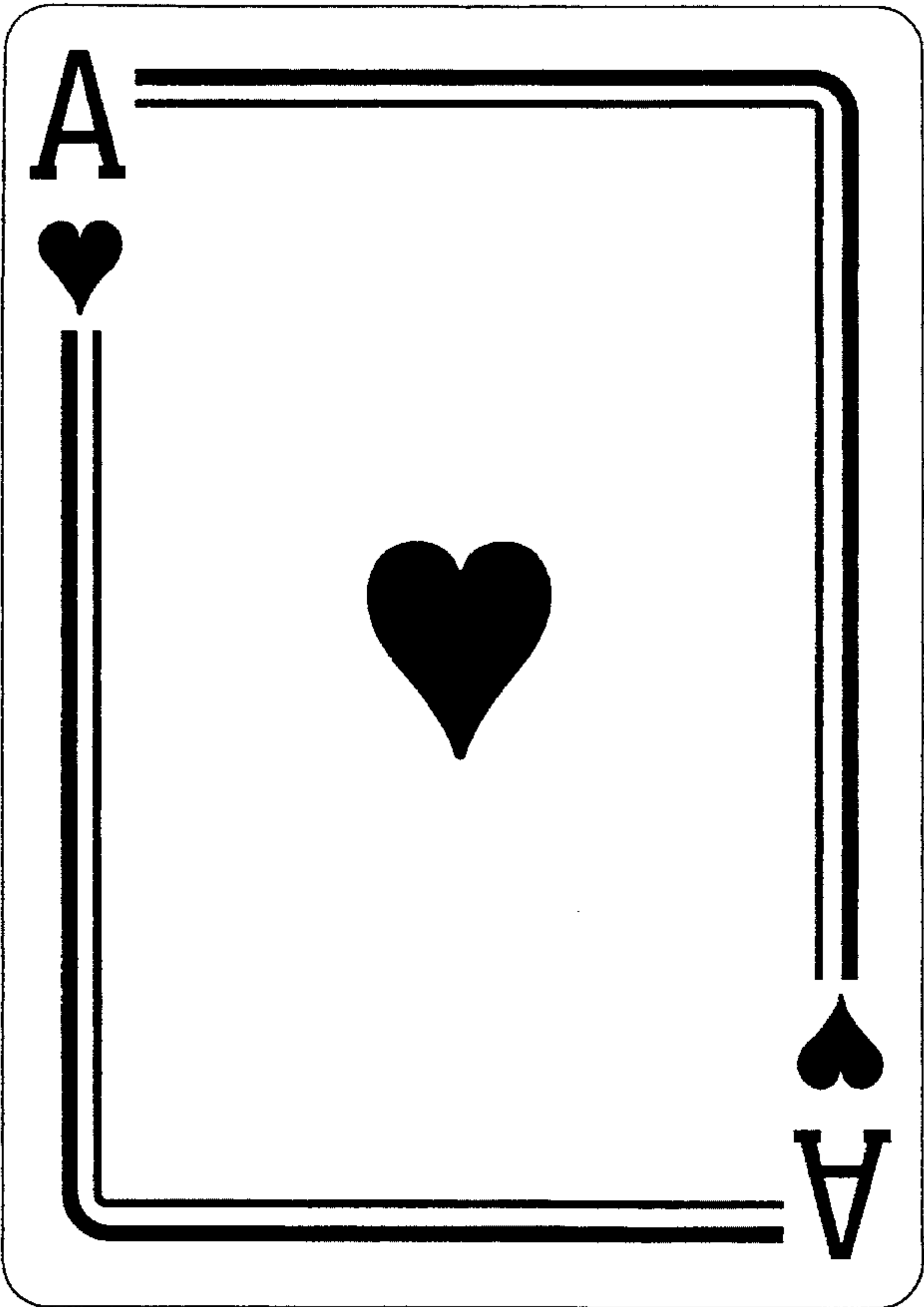
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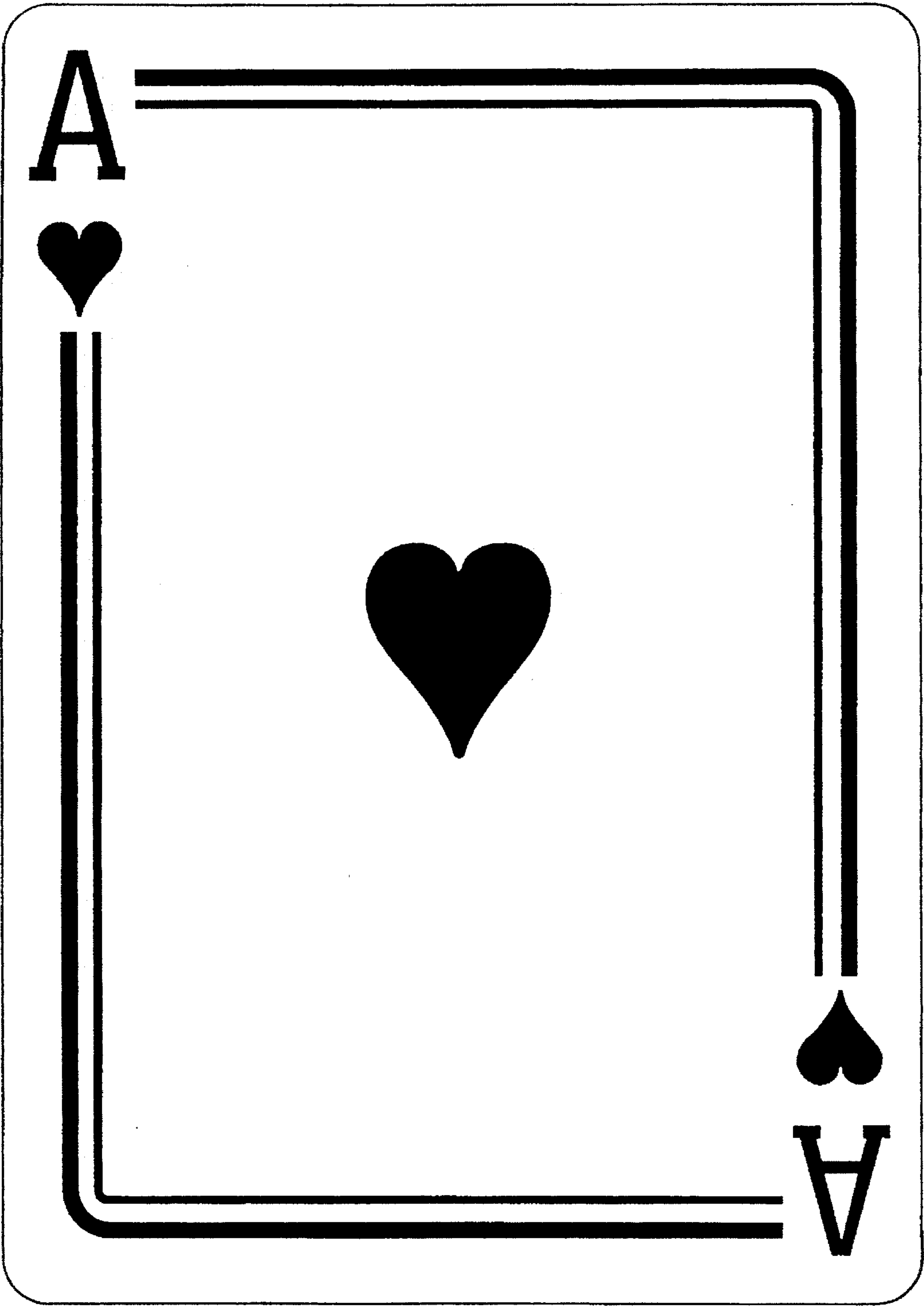
[57] **CLAIM**

and described.

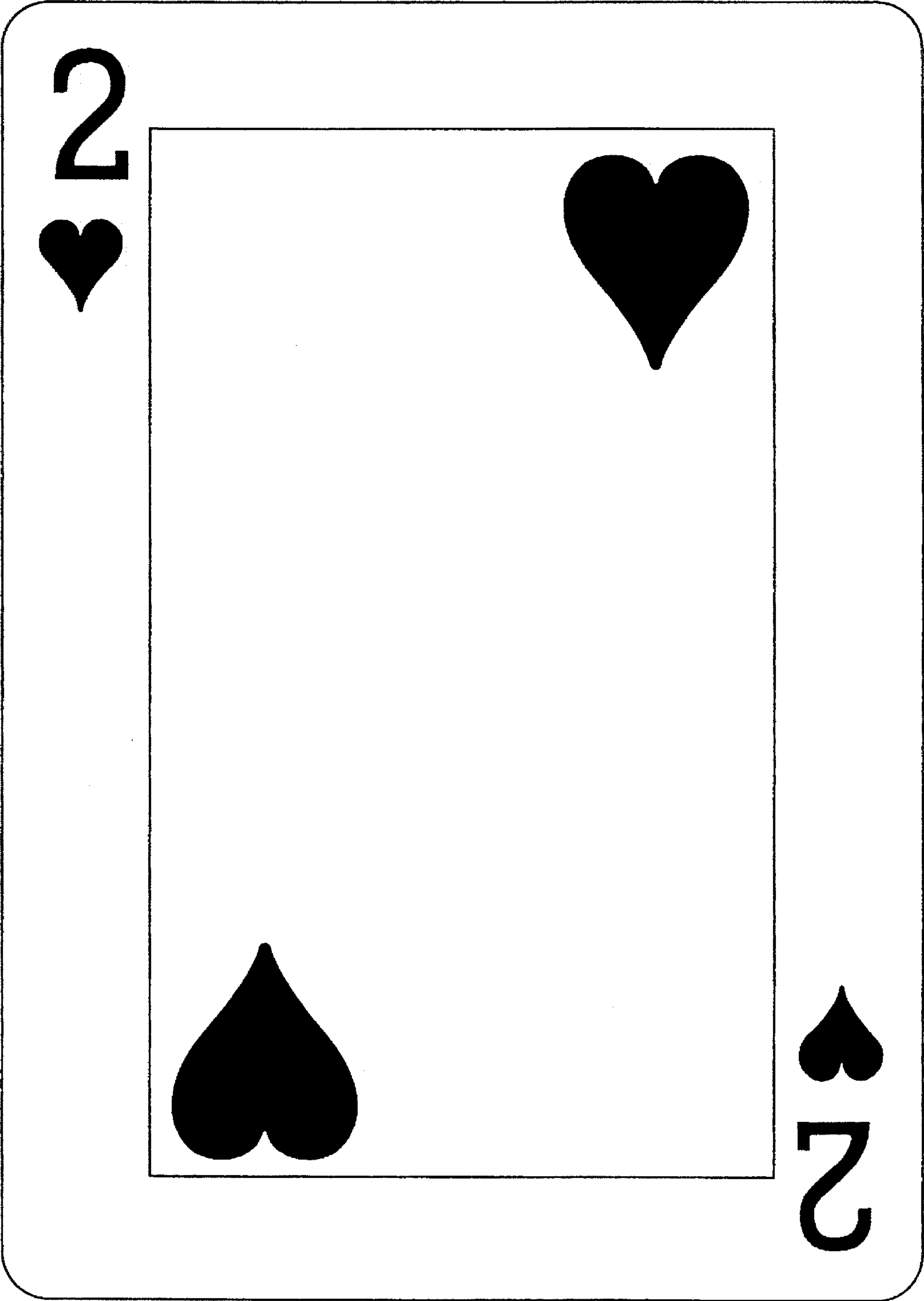
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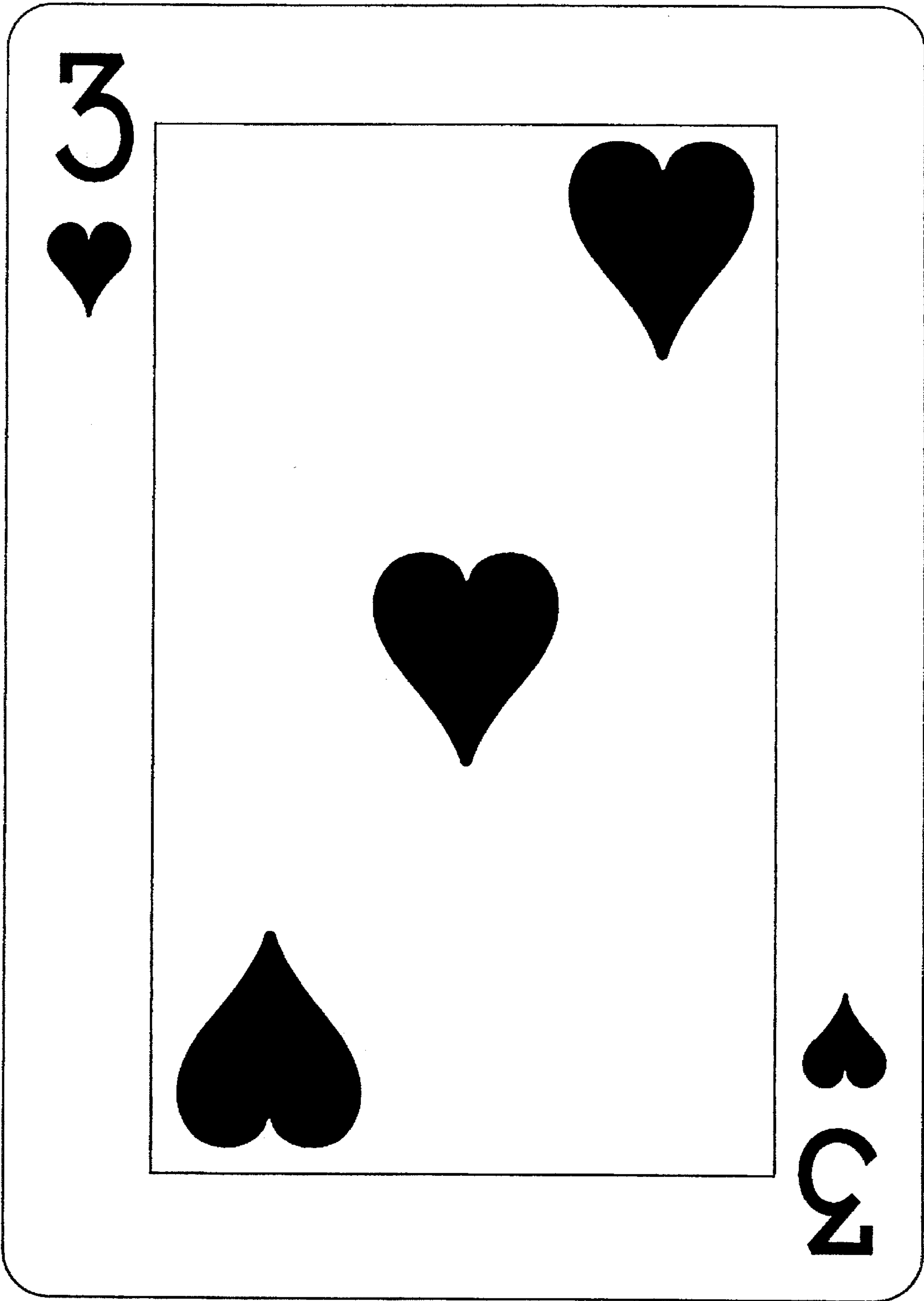
FIGS. 1-52 are top plan views showing a set of cards
