FIG. 2 is an enlarged elevational view taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 4;

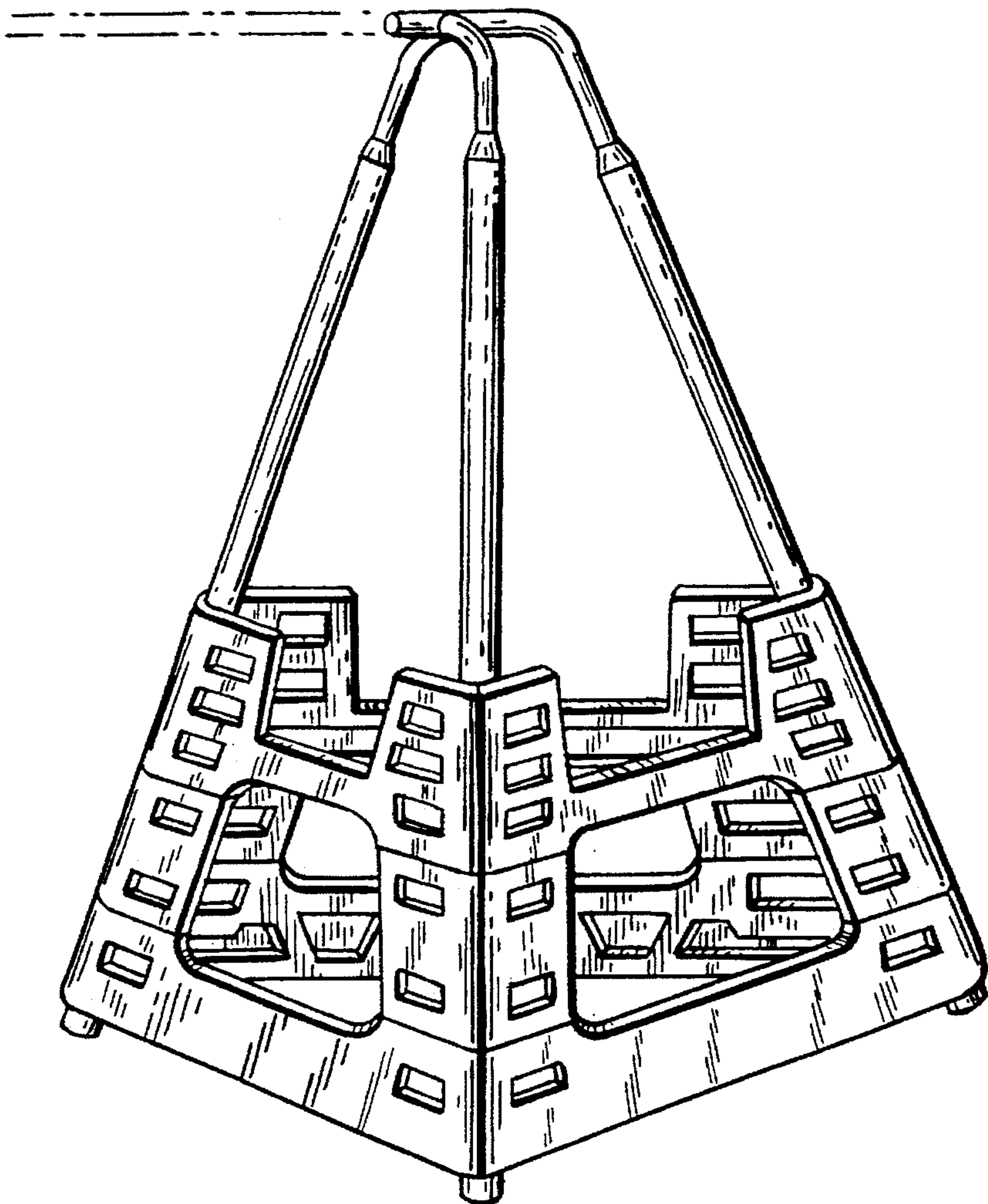
FIG. 3 is an enlarged elevational view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 4;

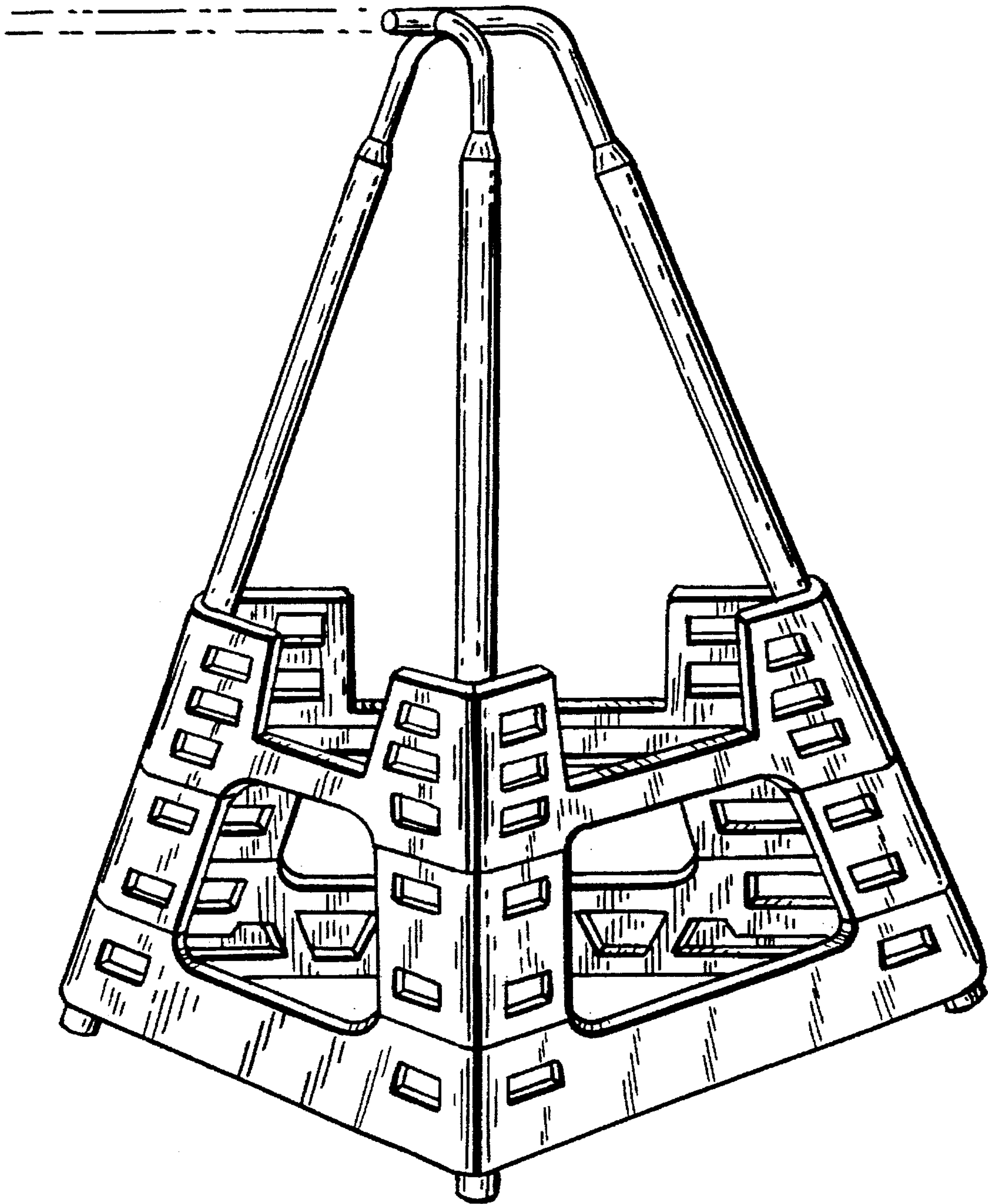

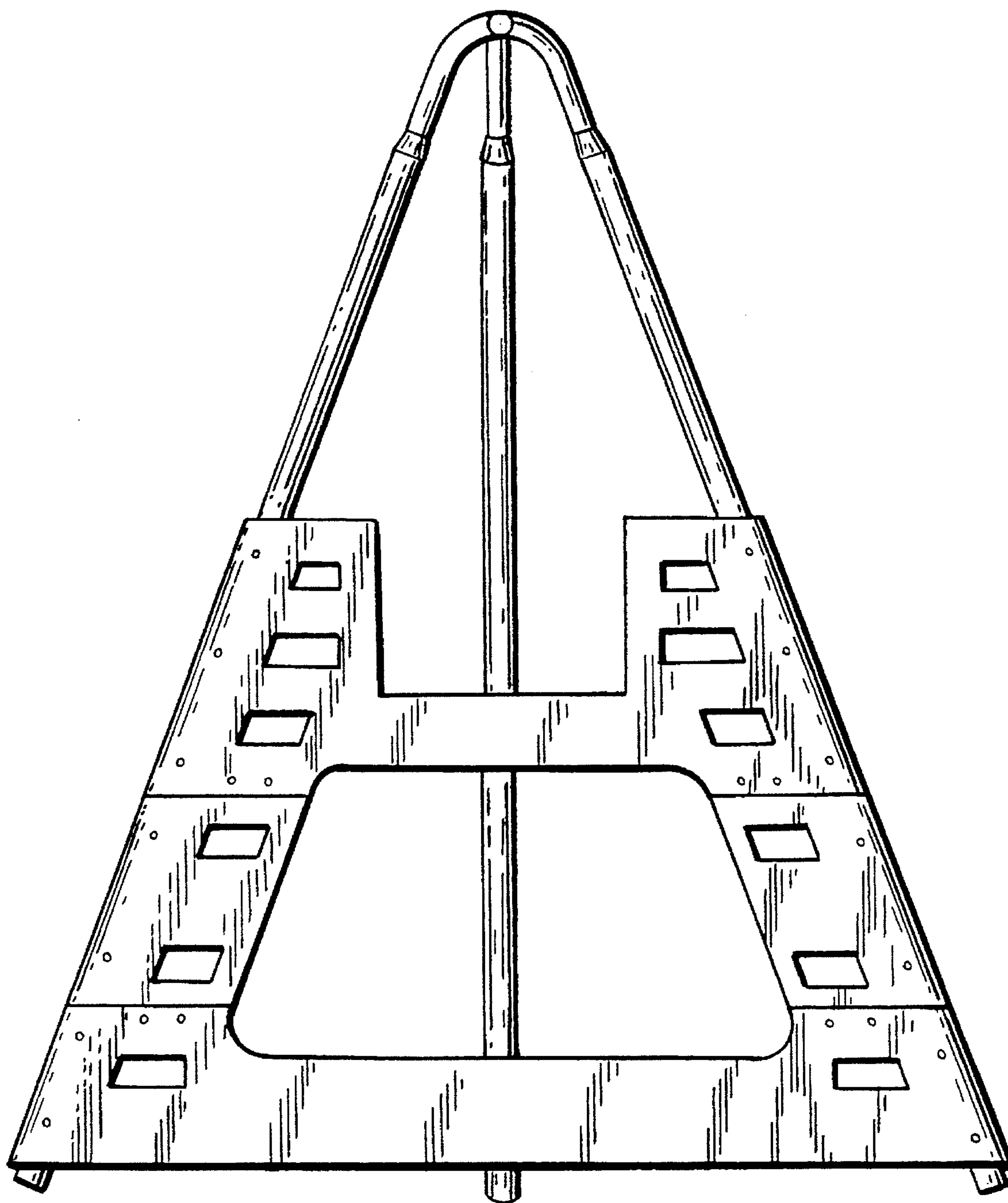

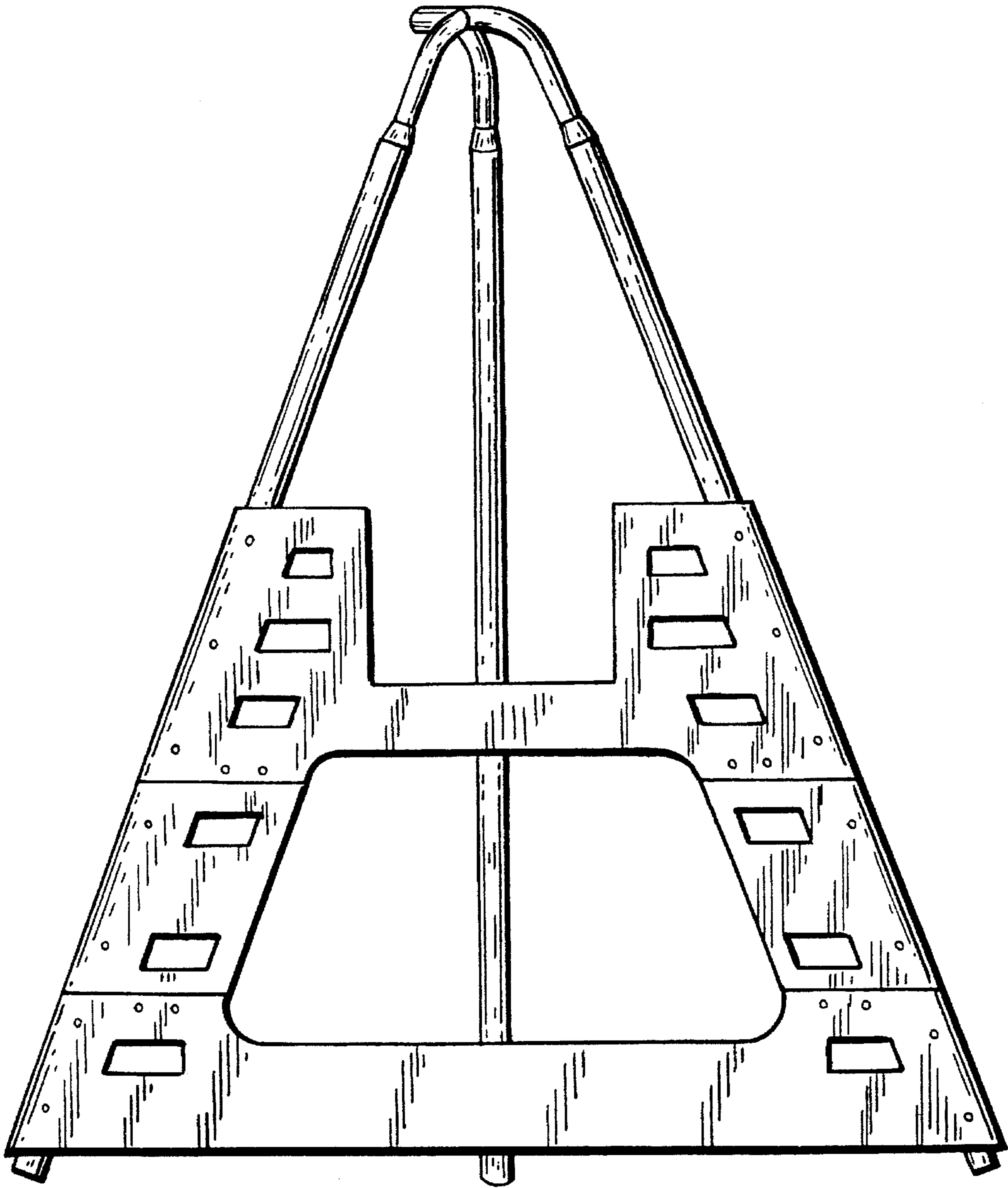

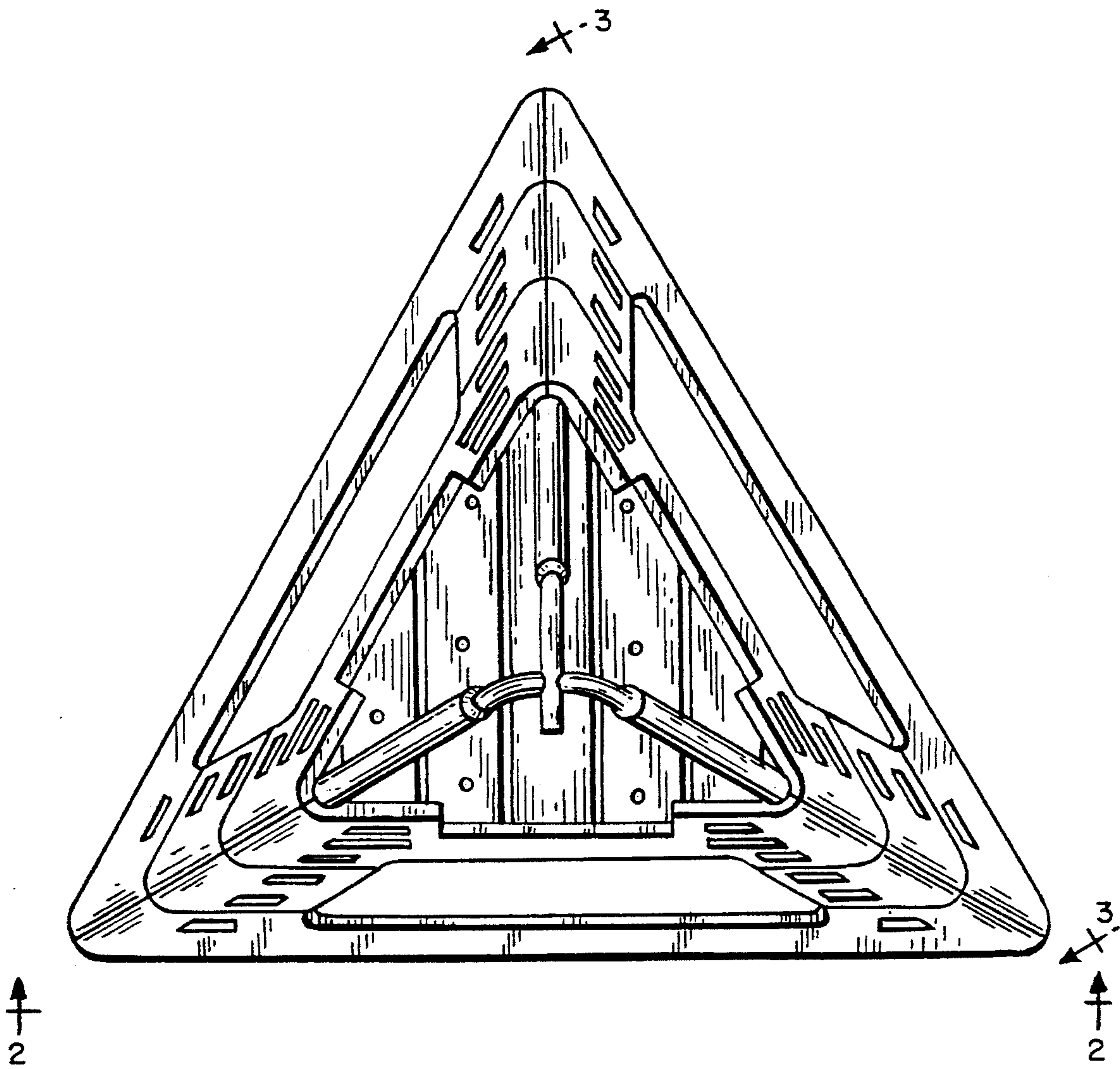

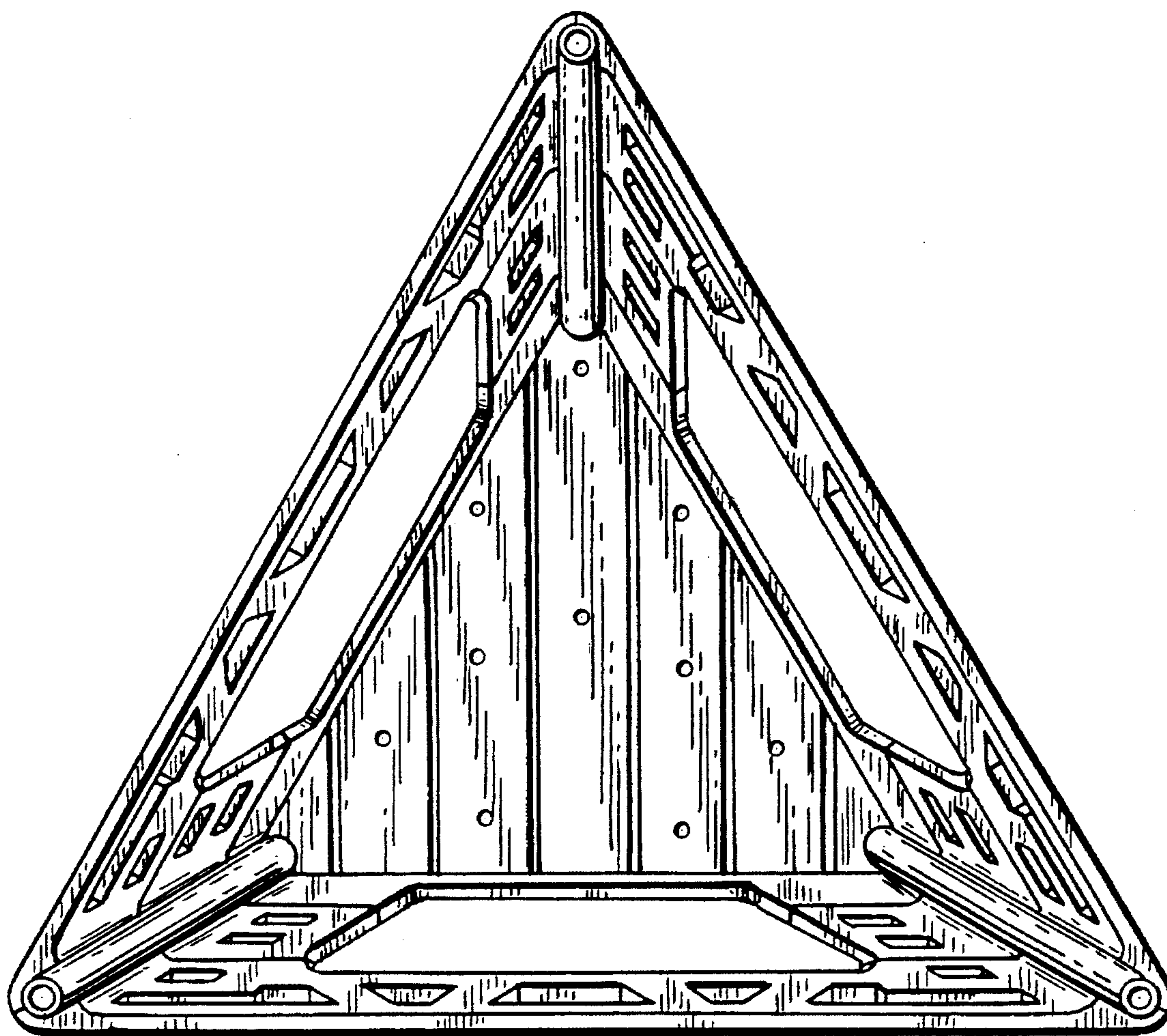
