The ornamental design for a pyramid-type swing support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pyramid-type swing support showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is an enlarged elevational view taken on line 2—2 of FIG. 4;

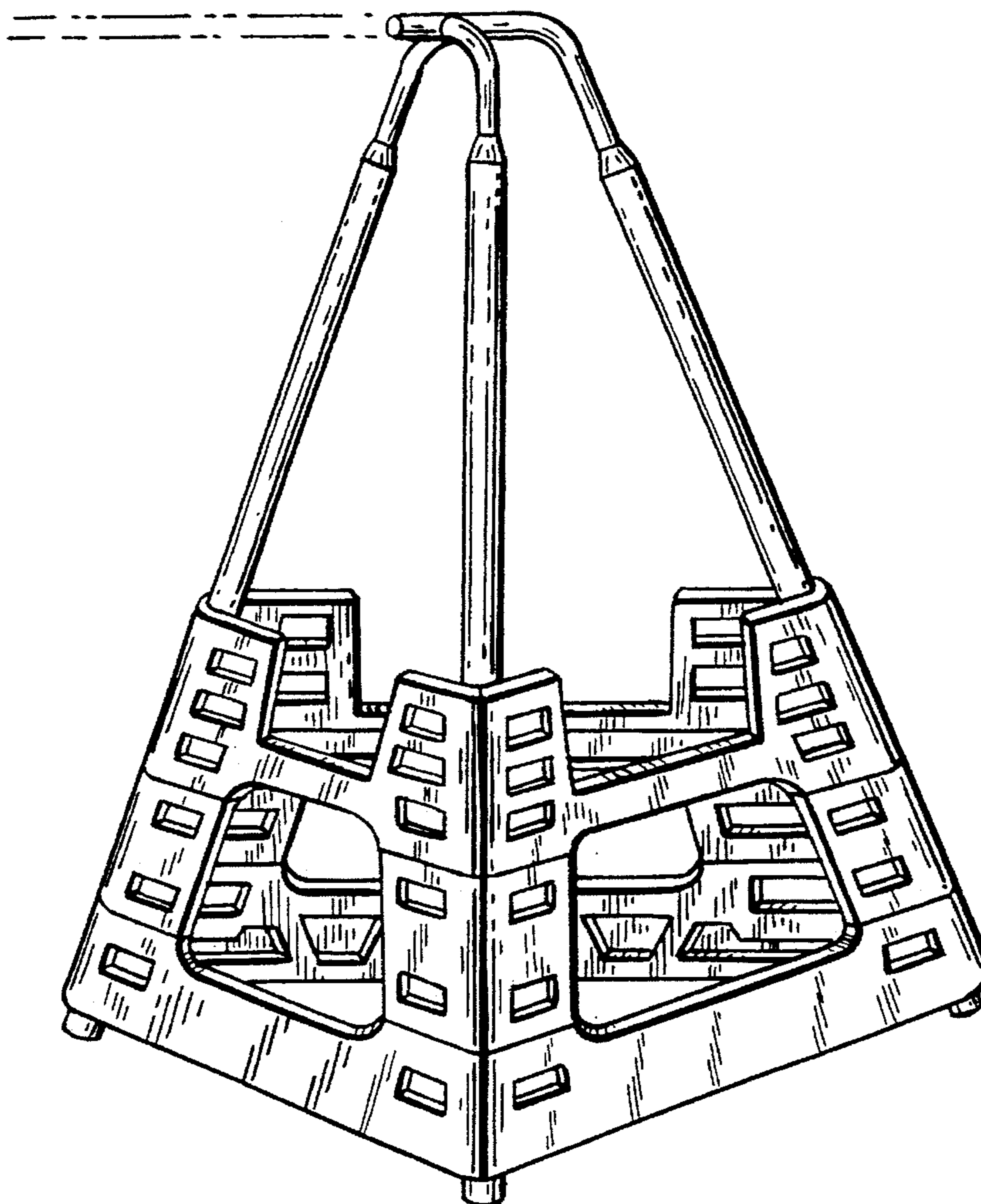
FIG. 3 is an enlarged elevational view taken on line 3—3 of FIG. 4;

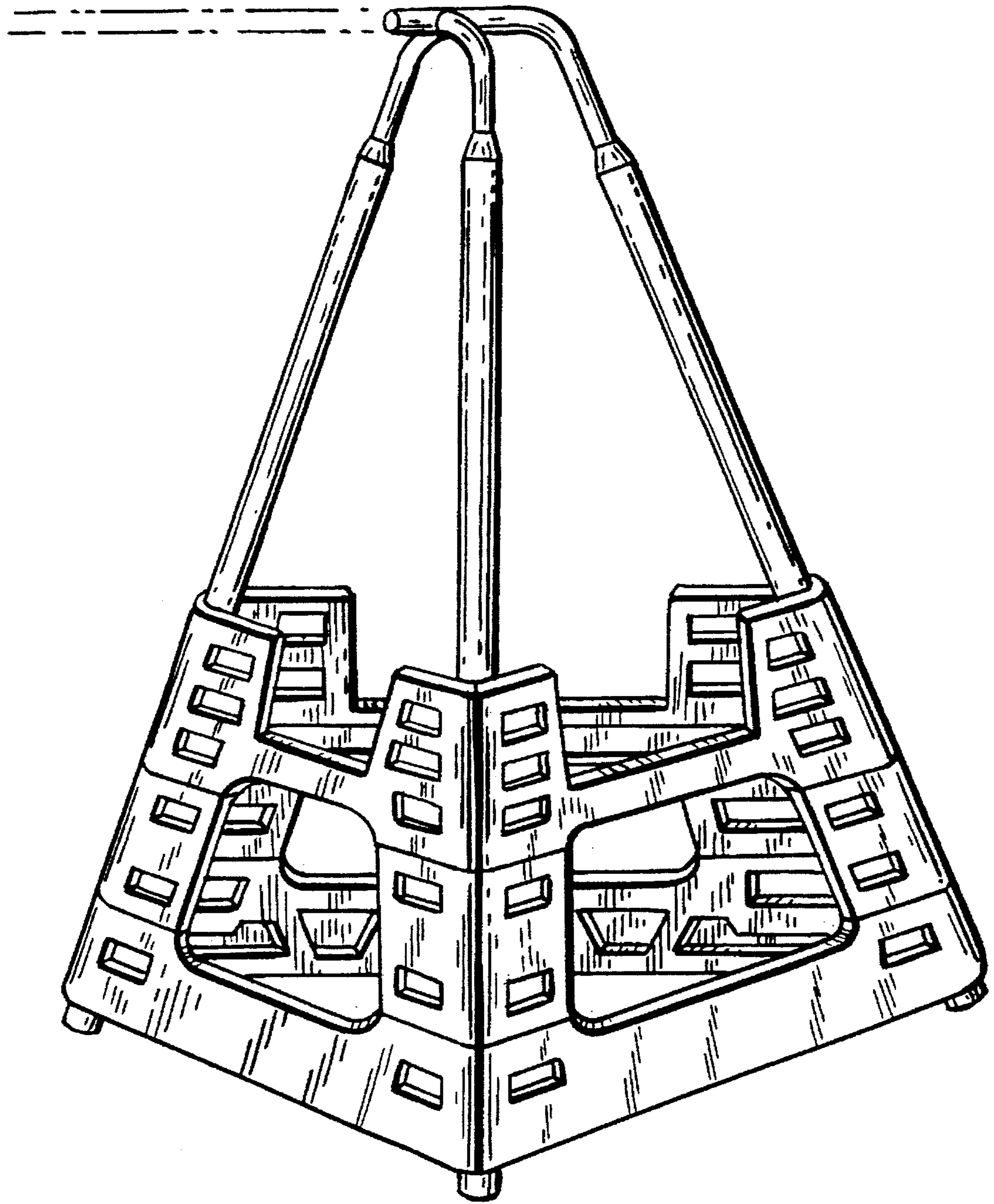

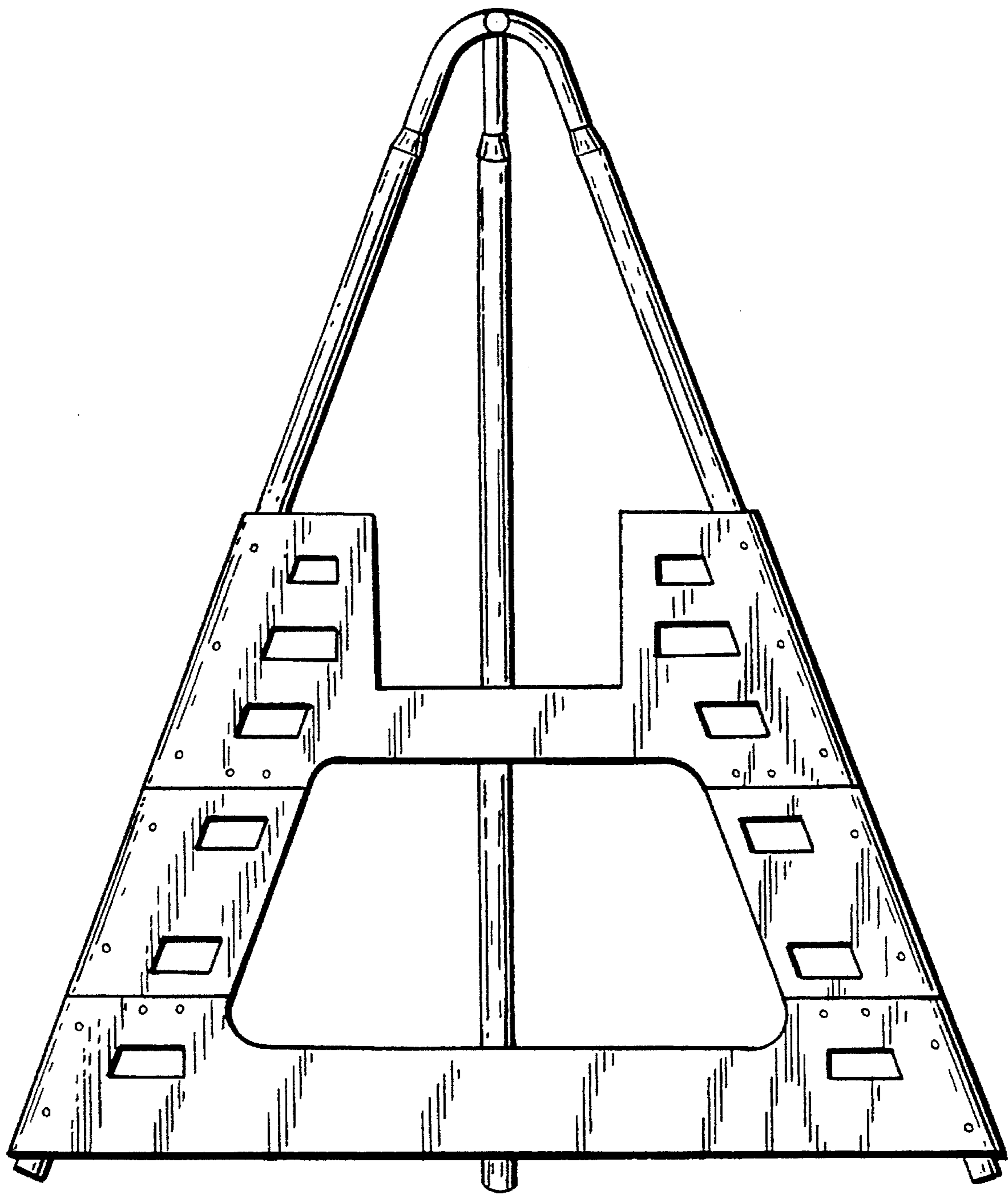

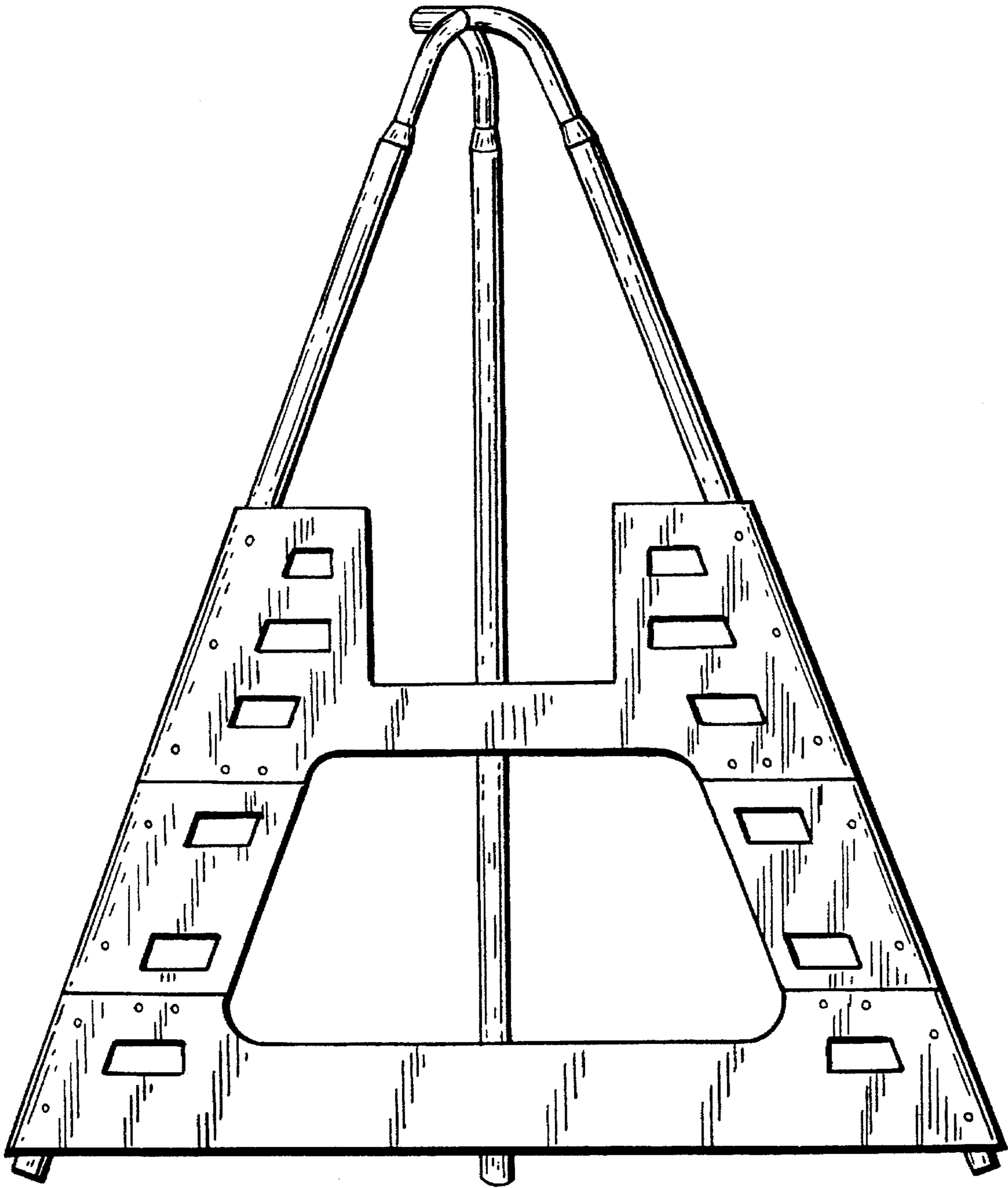

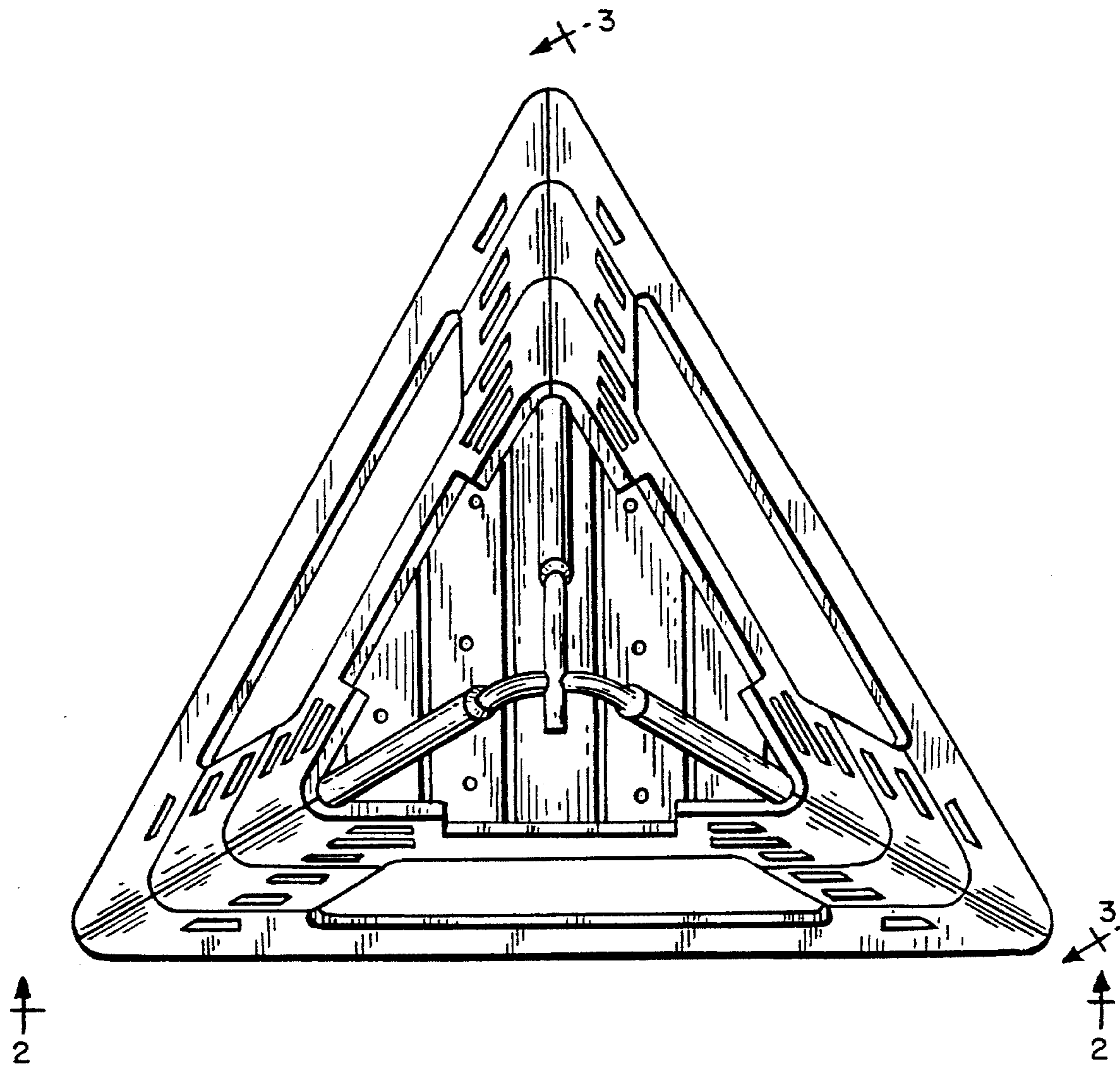

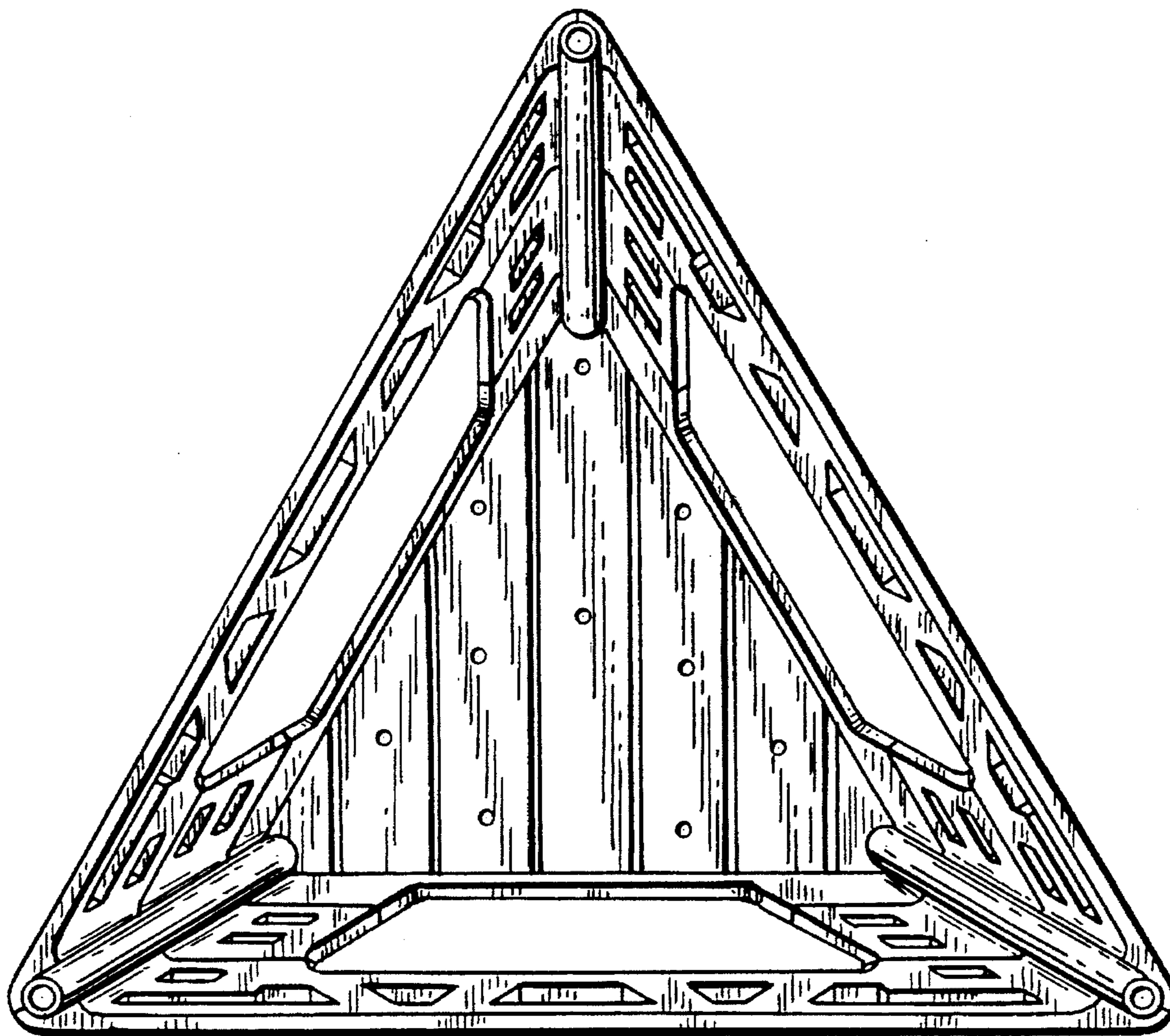
