[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an awning fabric, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

The sole FIGURE is a top plan view of an awning fabric showing our new design. The pattern continues indefinitely toward either side and the rear plan view is identical thereto.

The claimed awning fabric is of conventional thickness.
