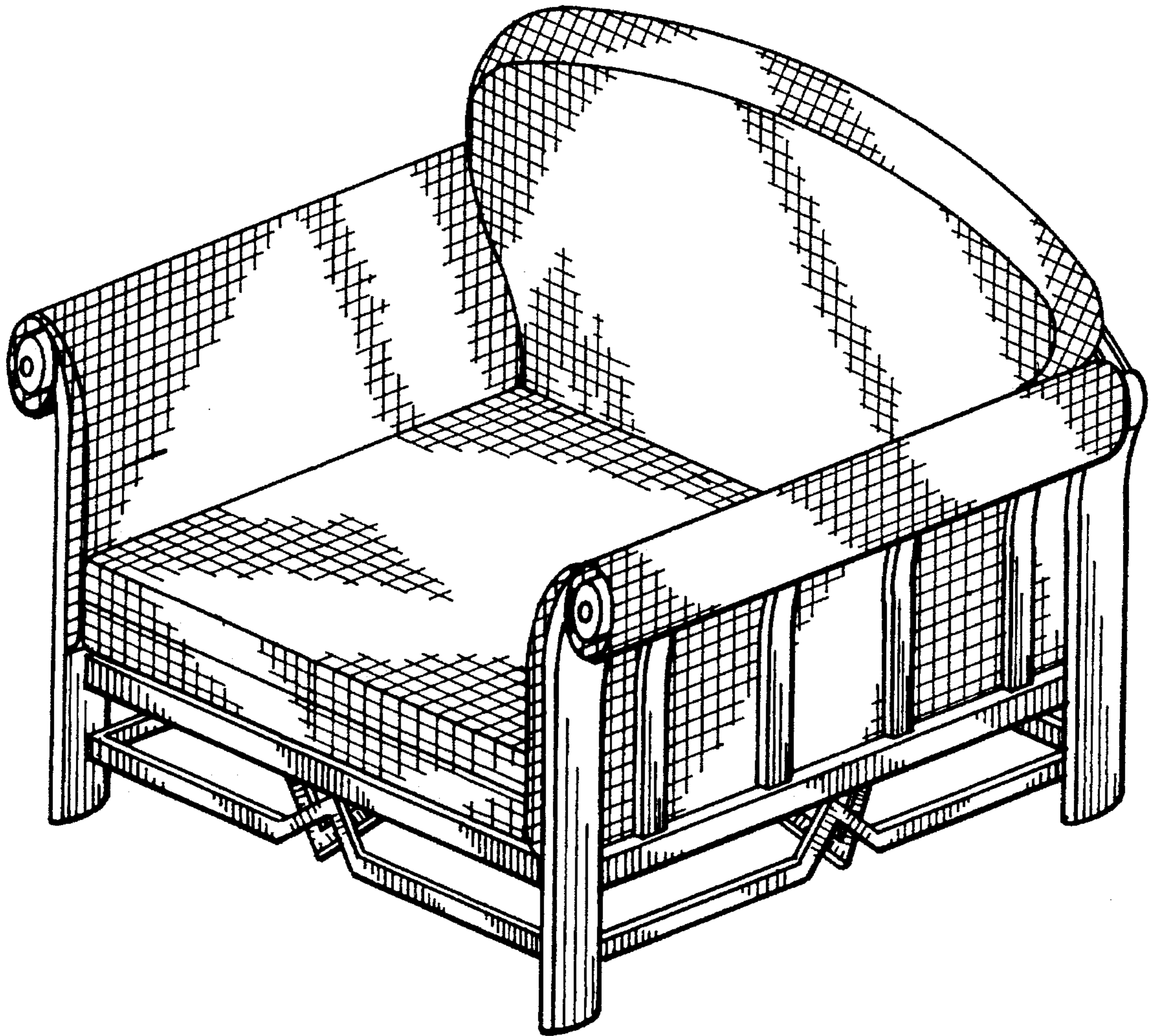
[57] **CLAIM**

**DESCRIPTION**

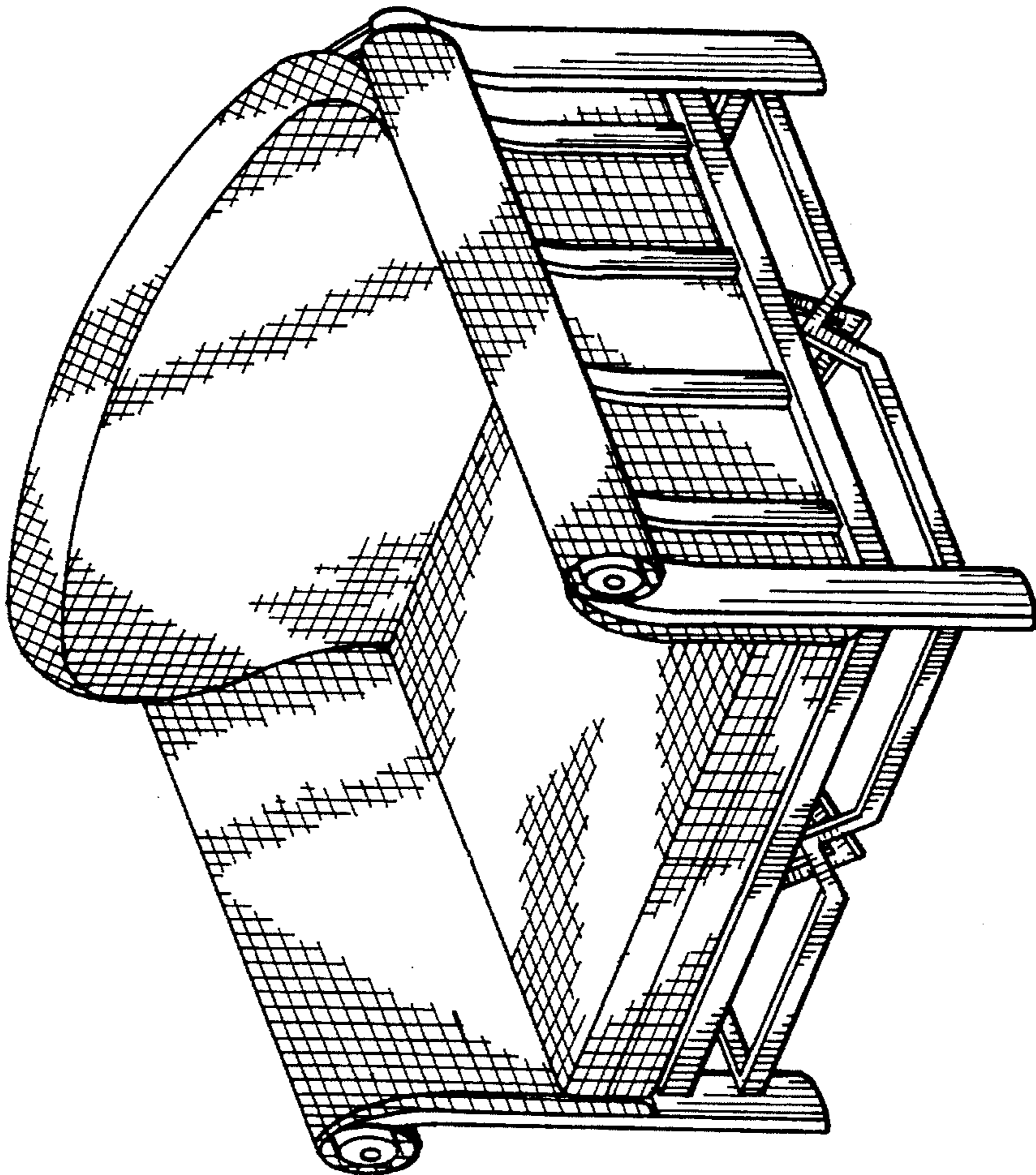

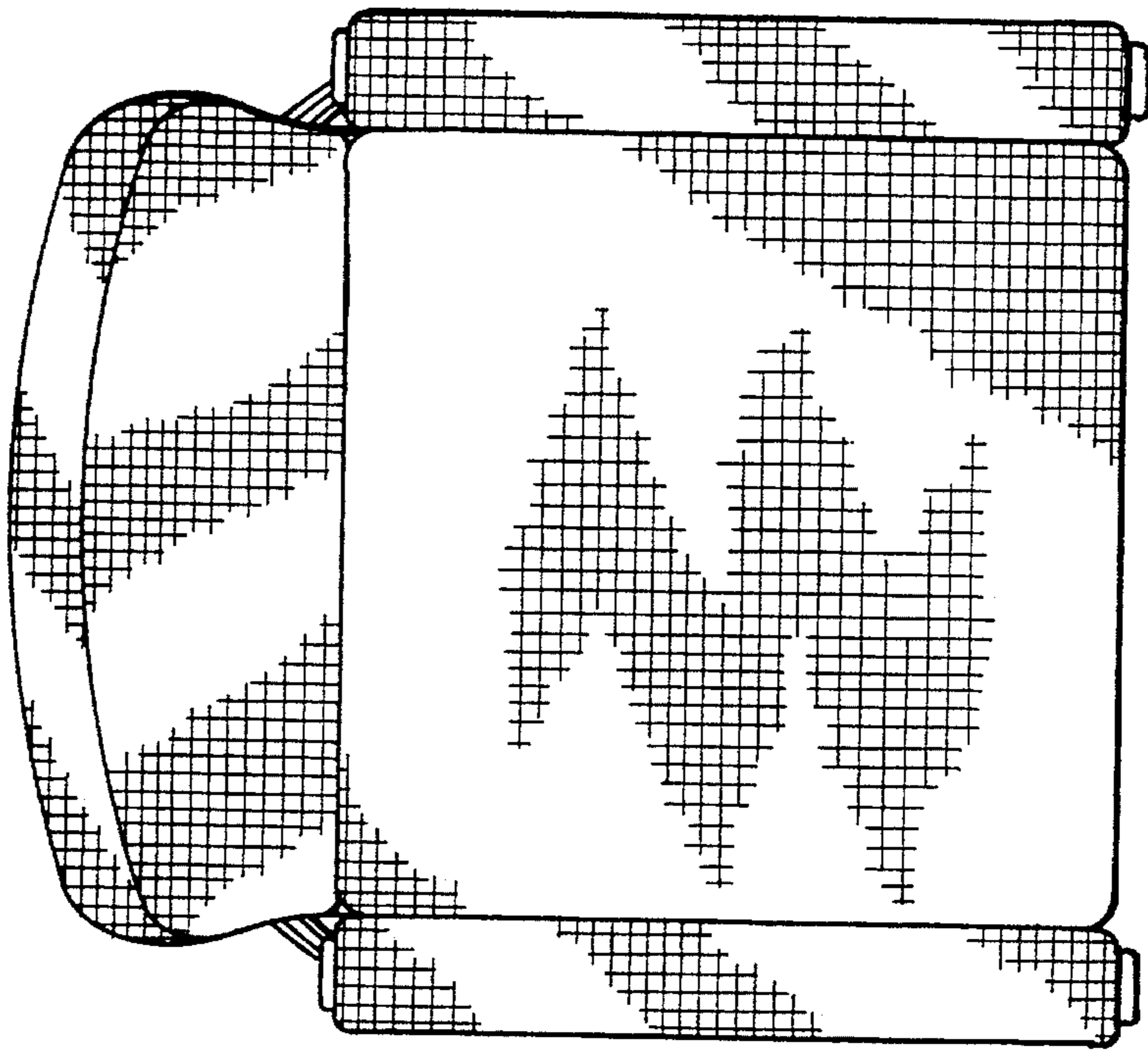

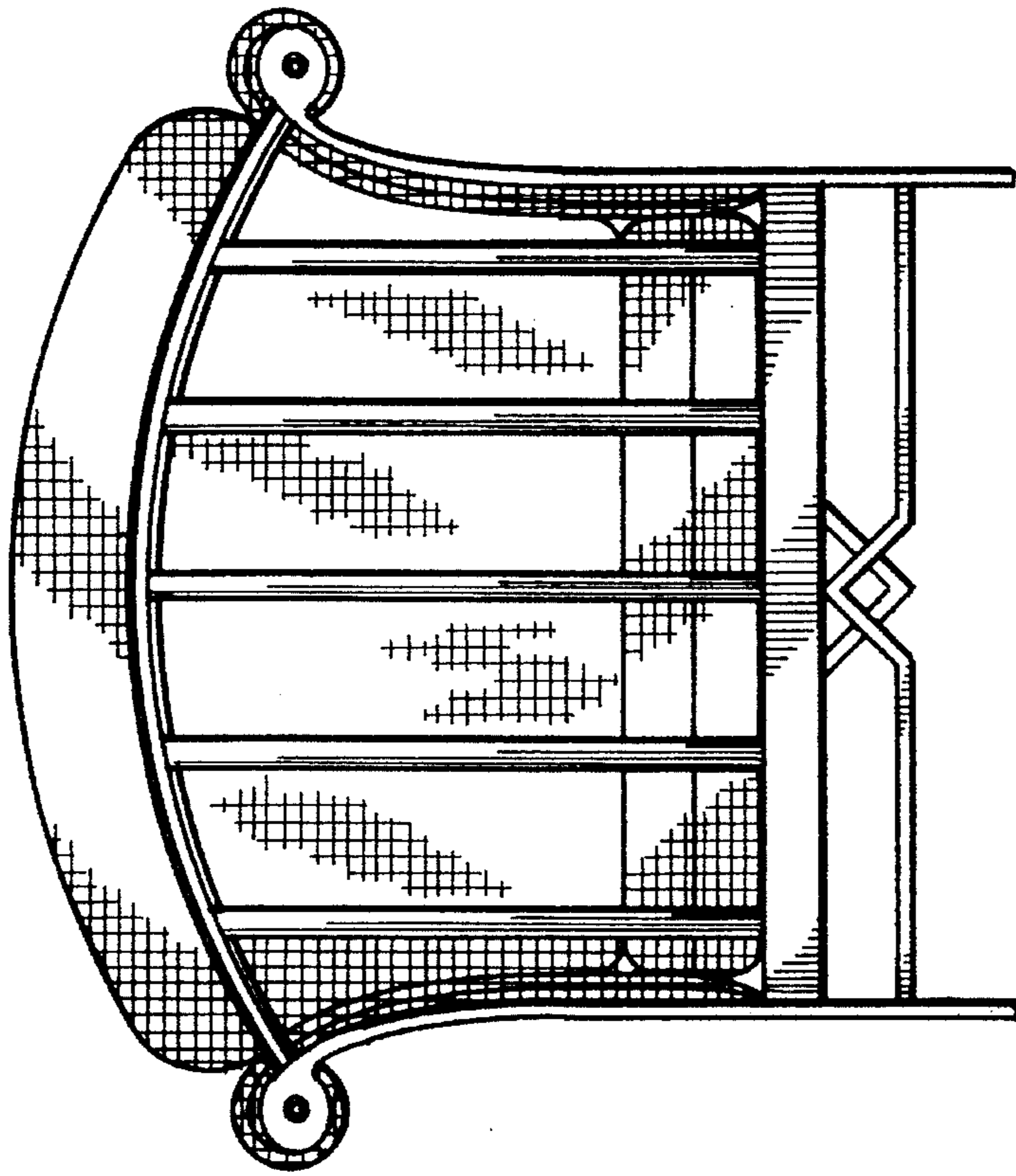

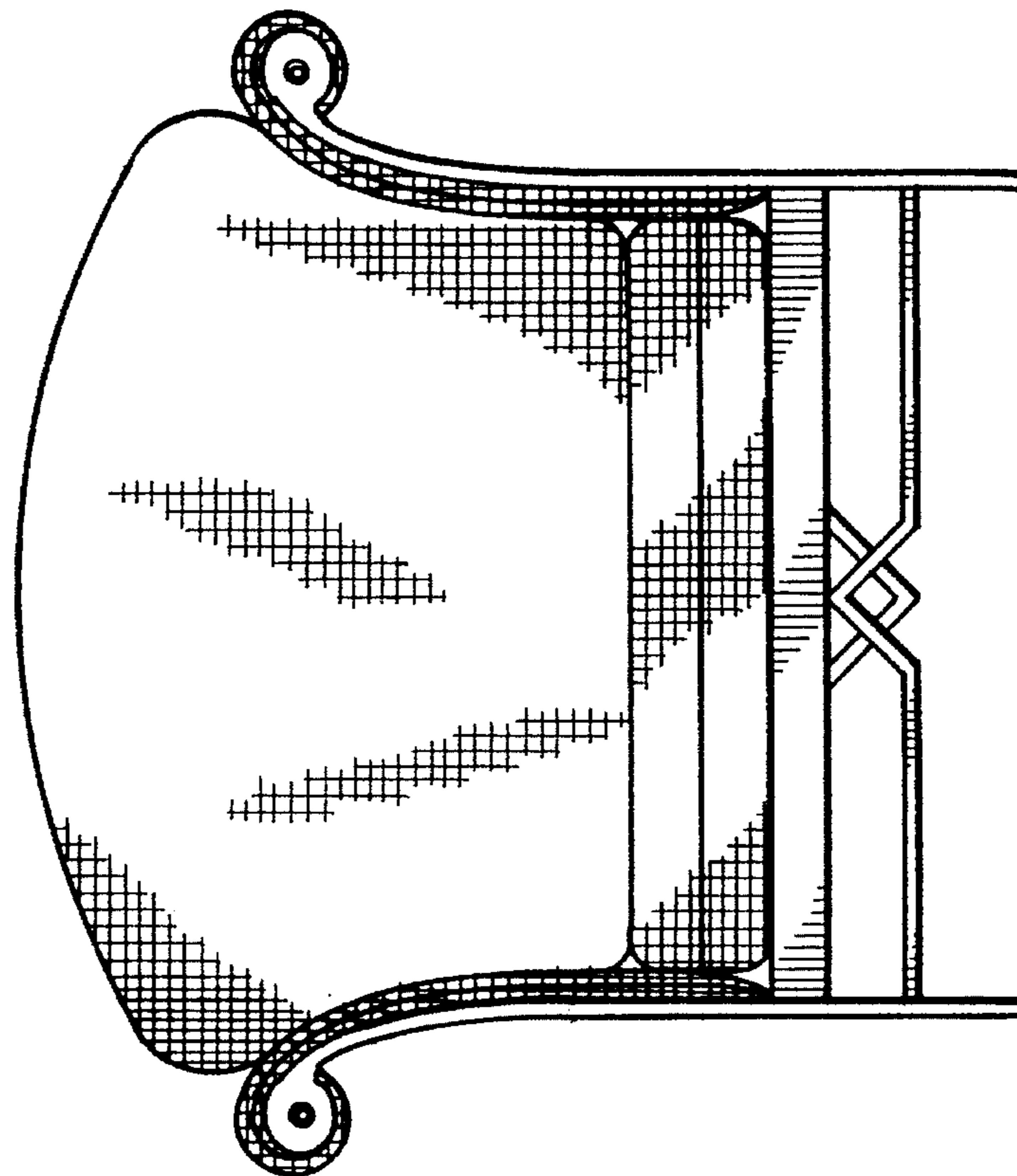

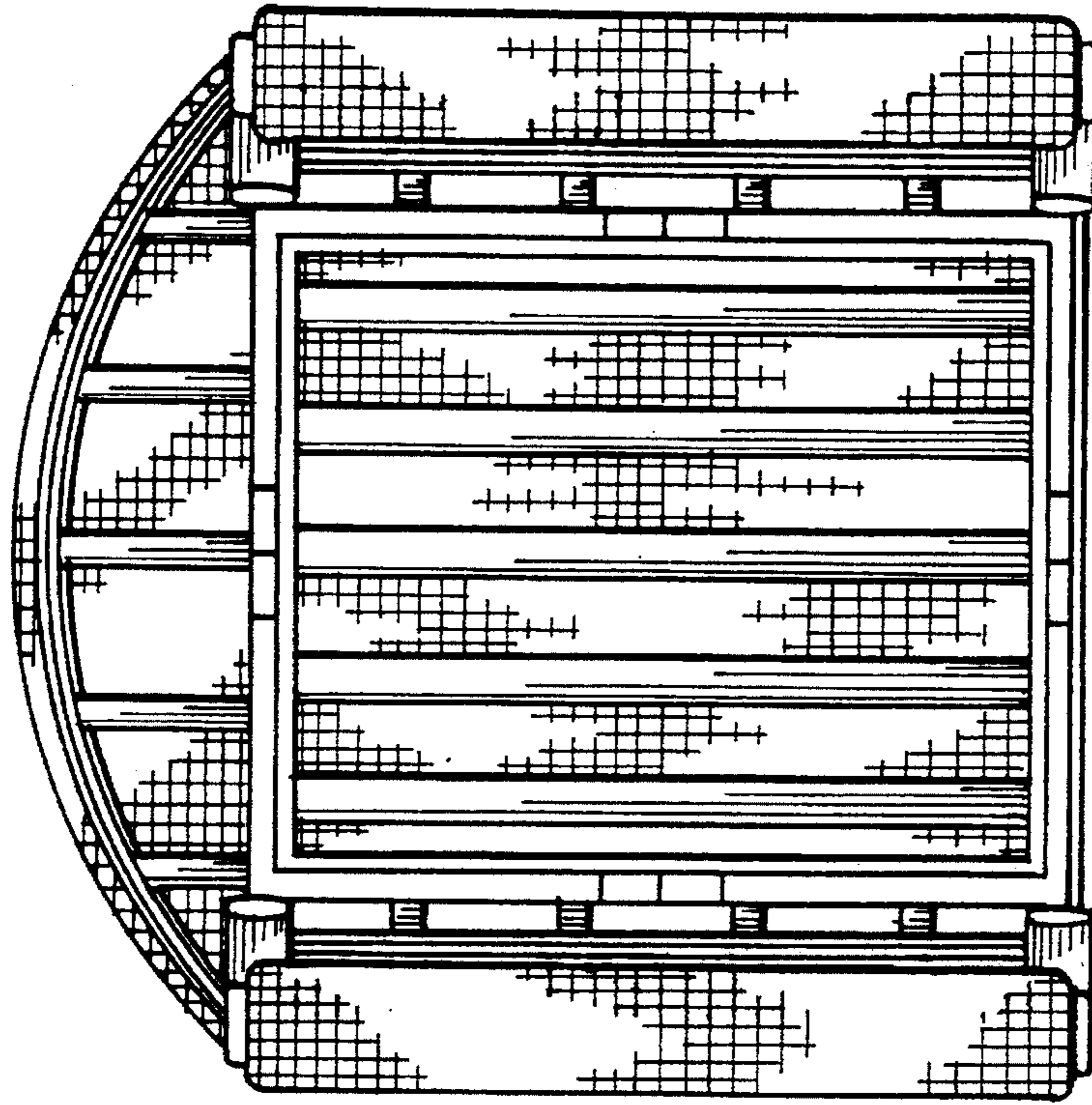

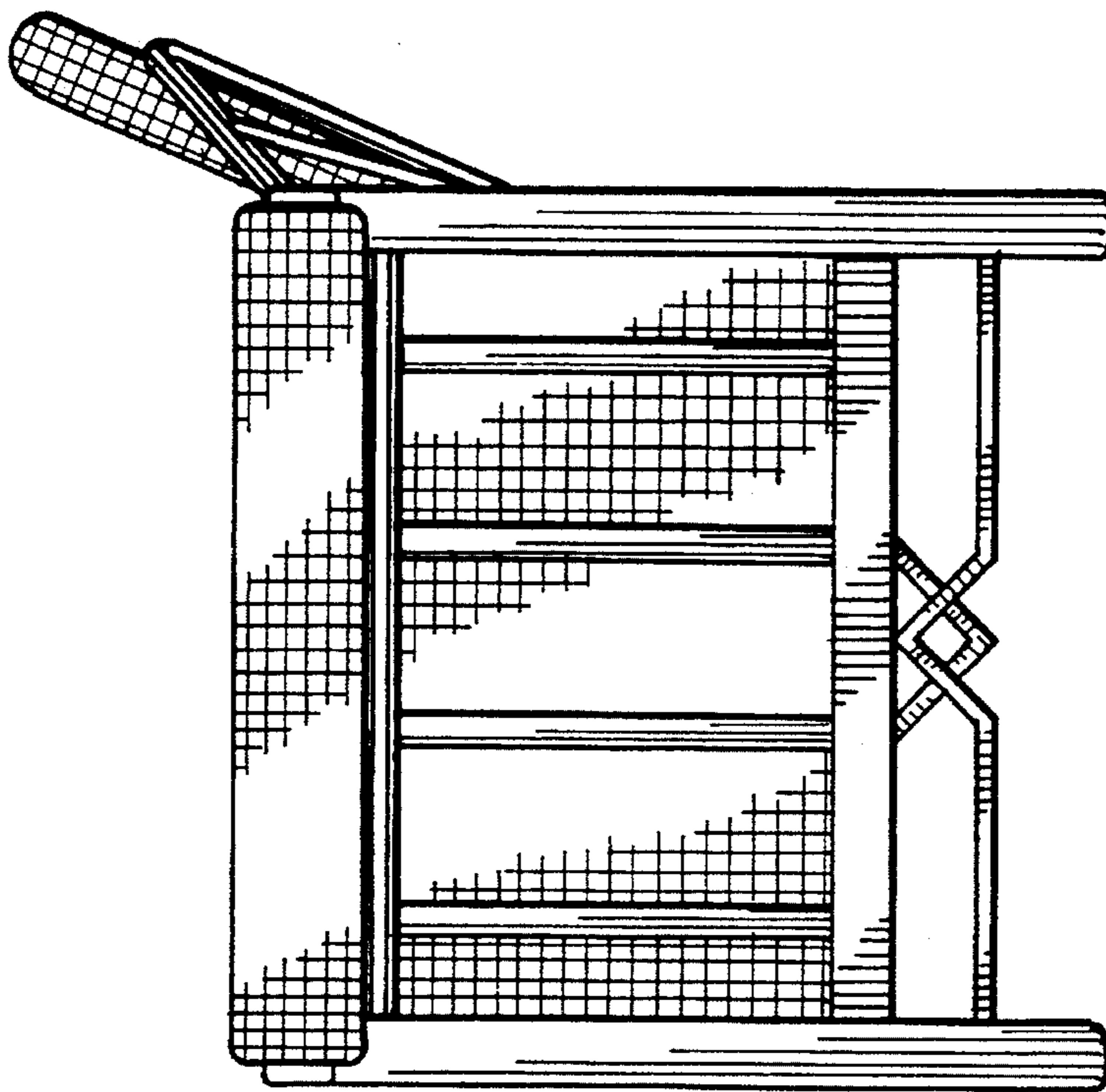
