FIG. 3 is a further perspective view thereof; and,

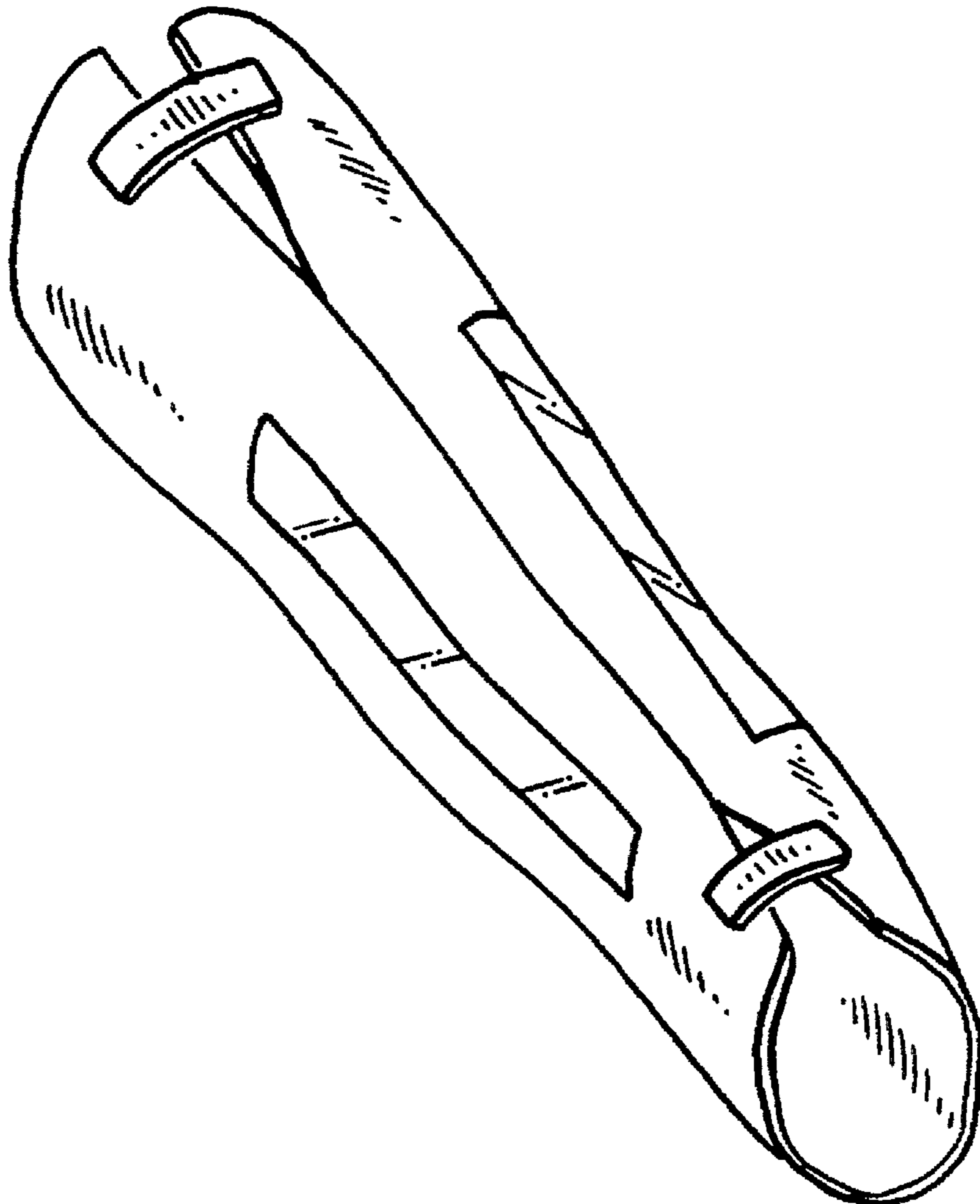
FIG. 4 is a reduced elevation view thereof showing the manner of use of the design.

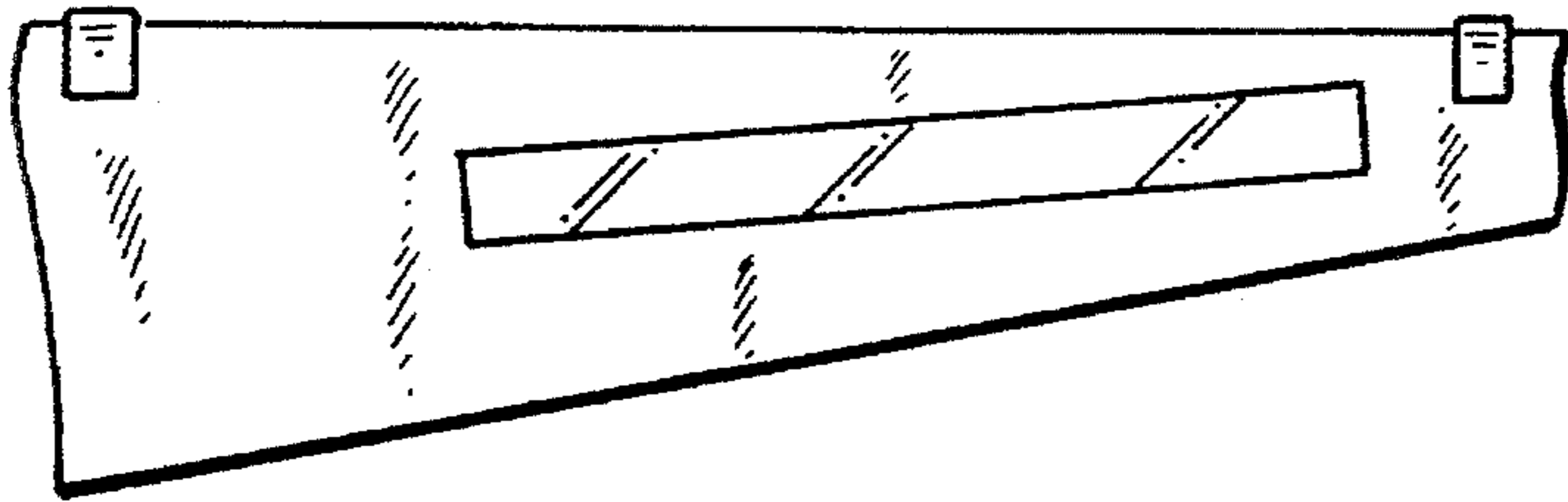

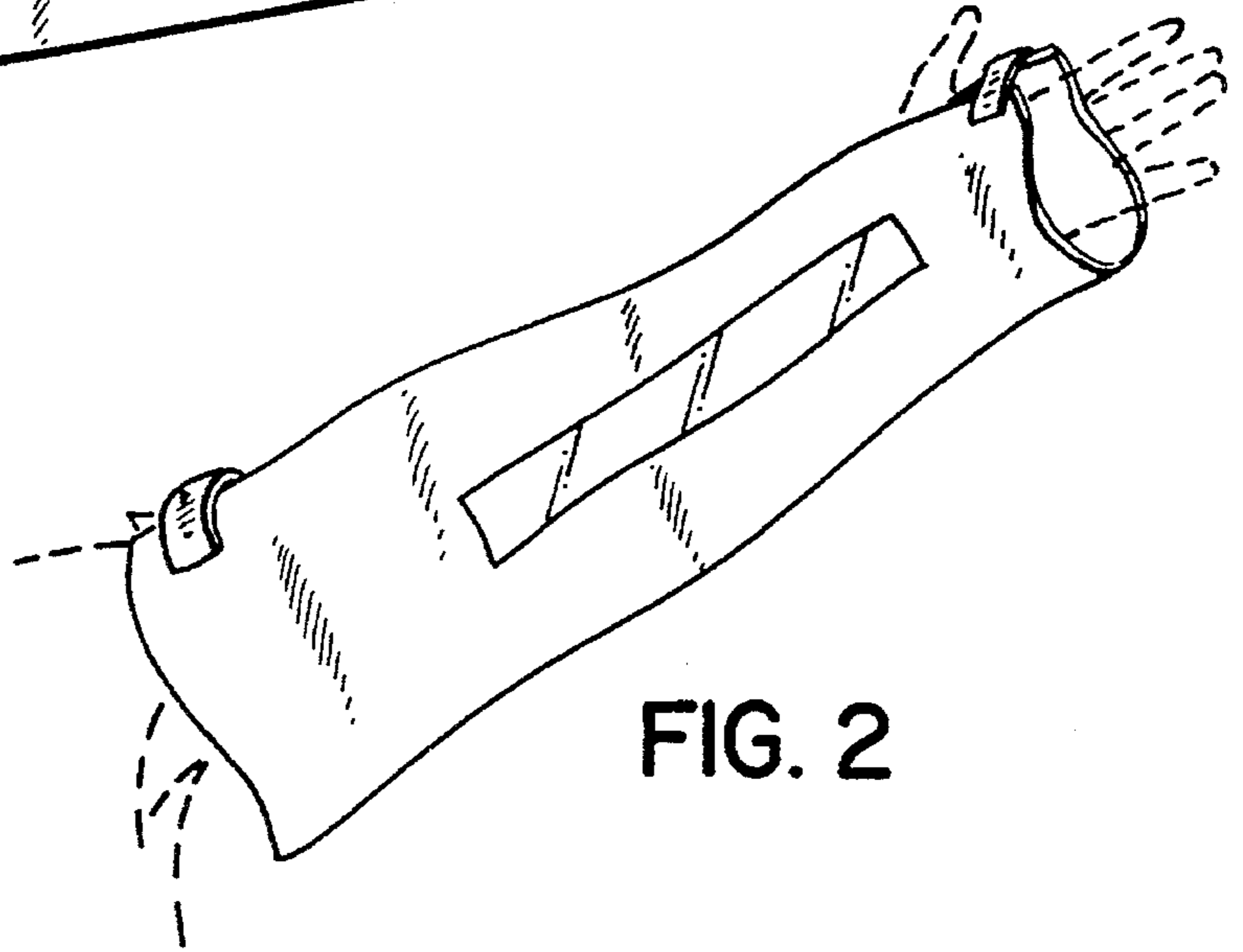

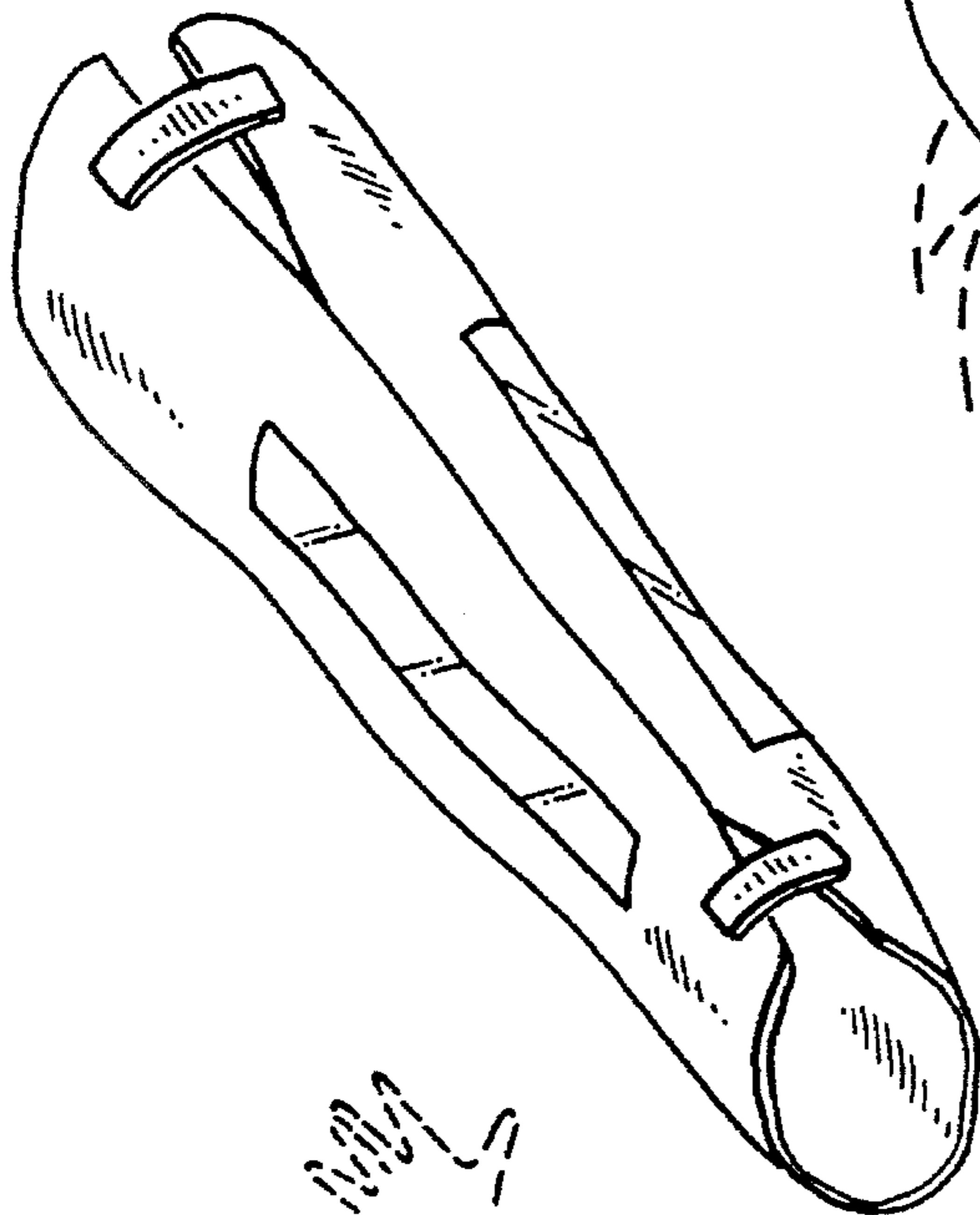

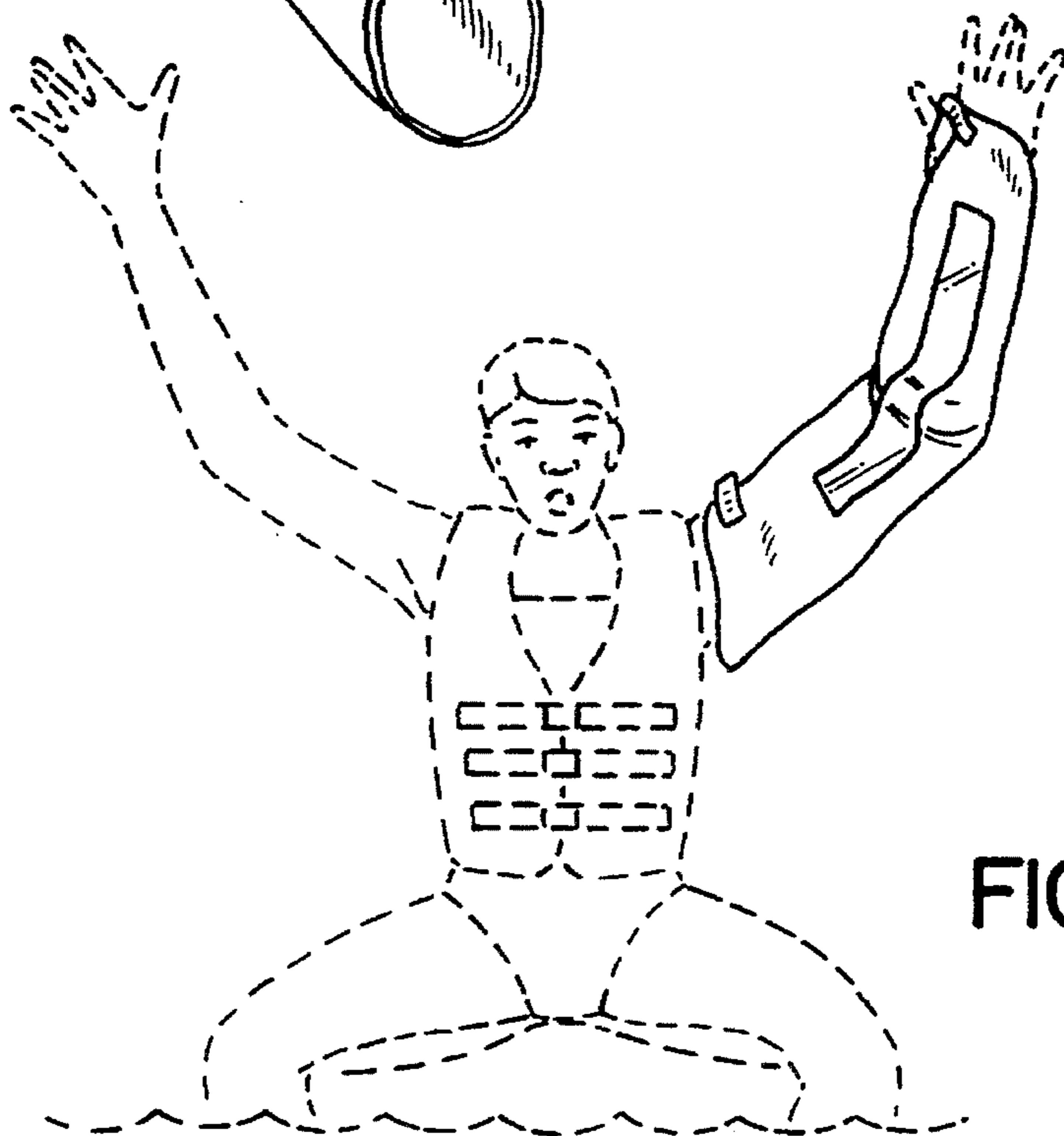
