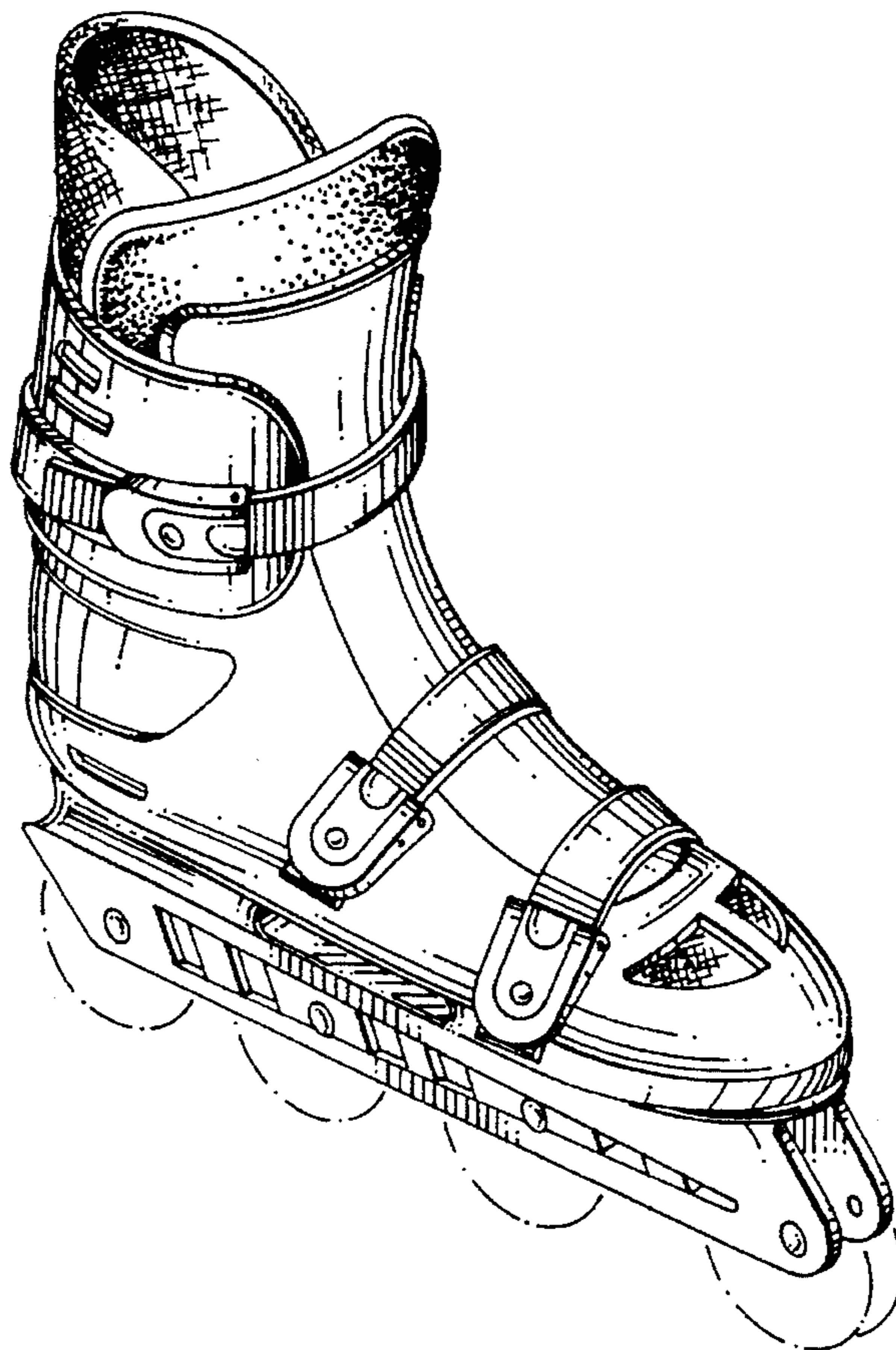

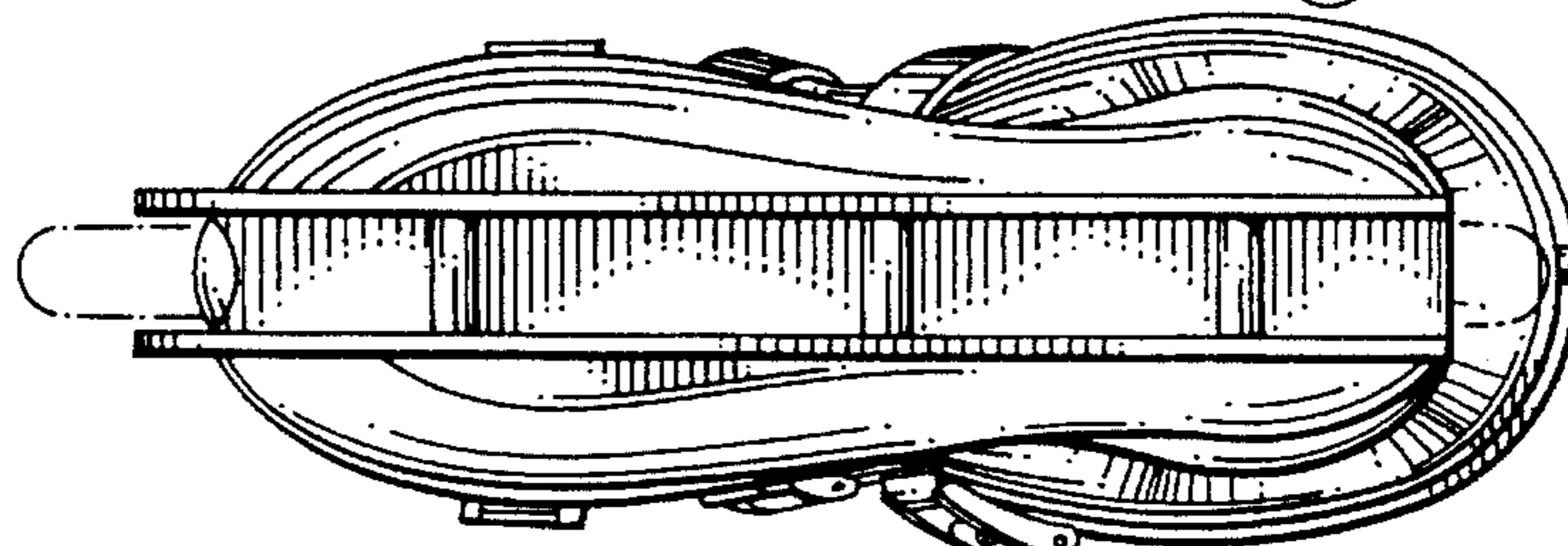
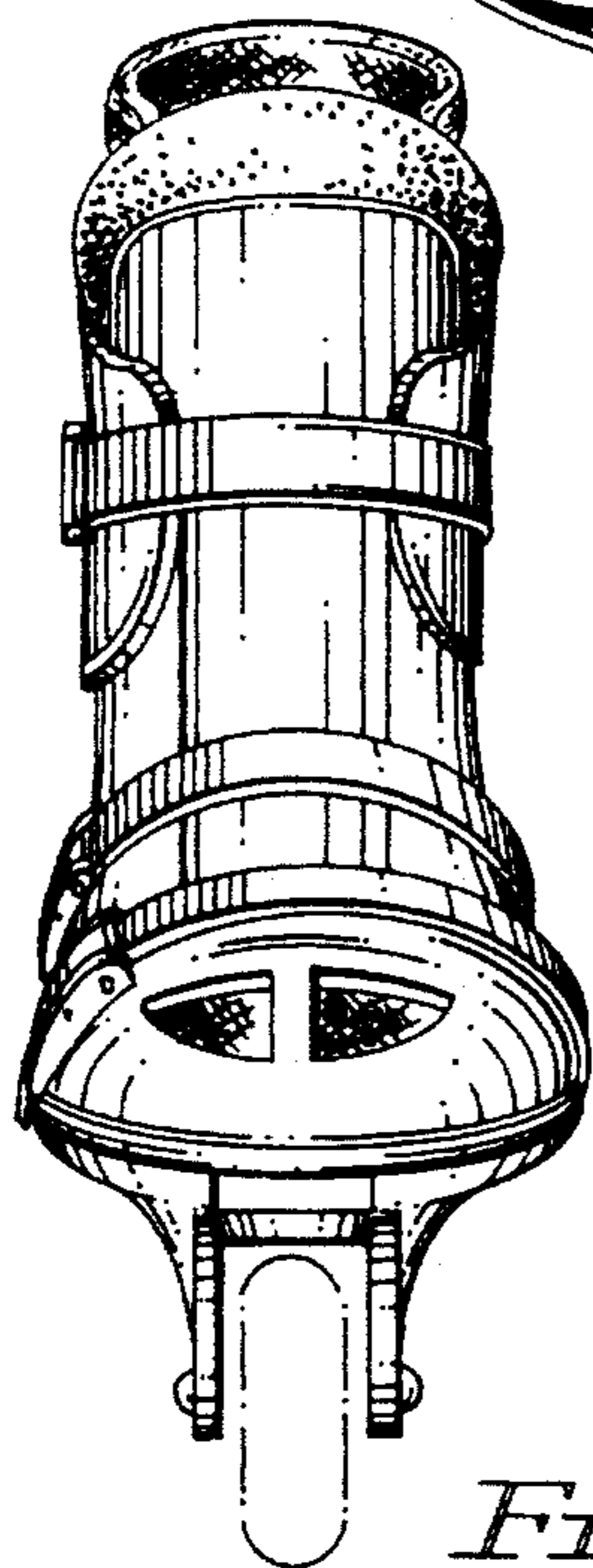
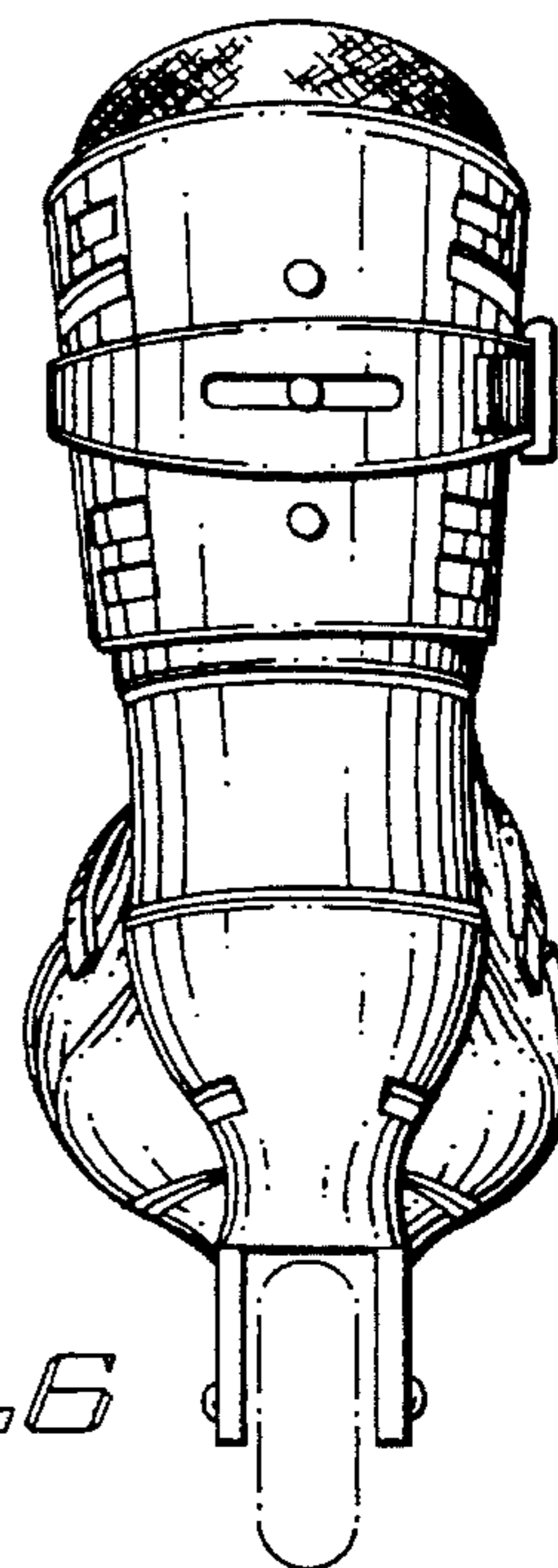
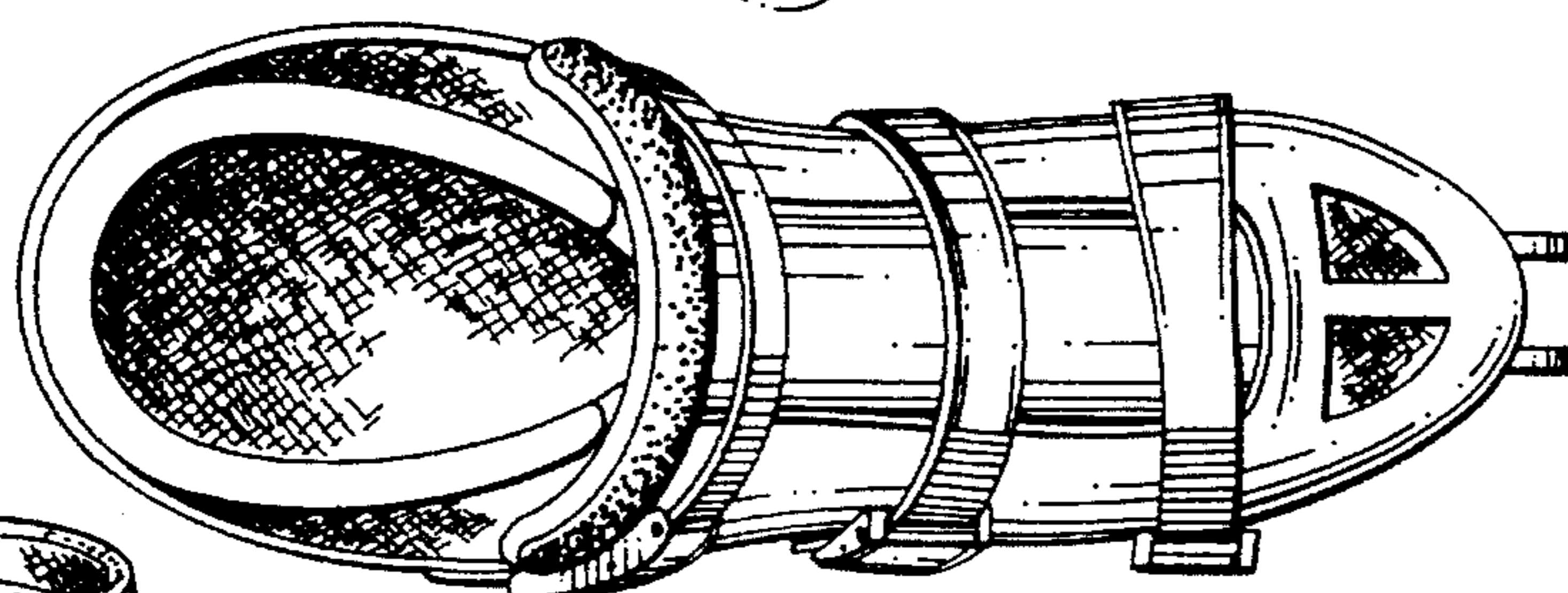
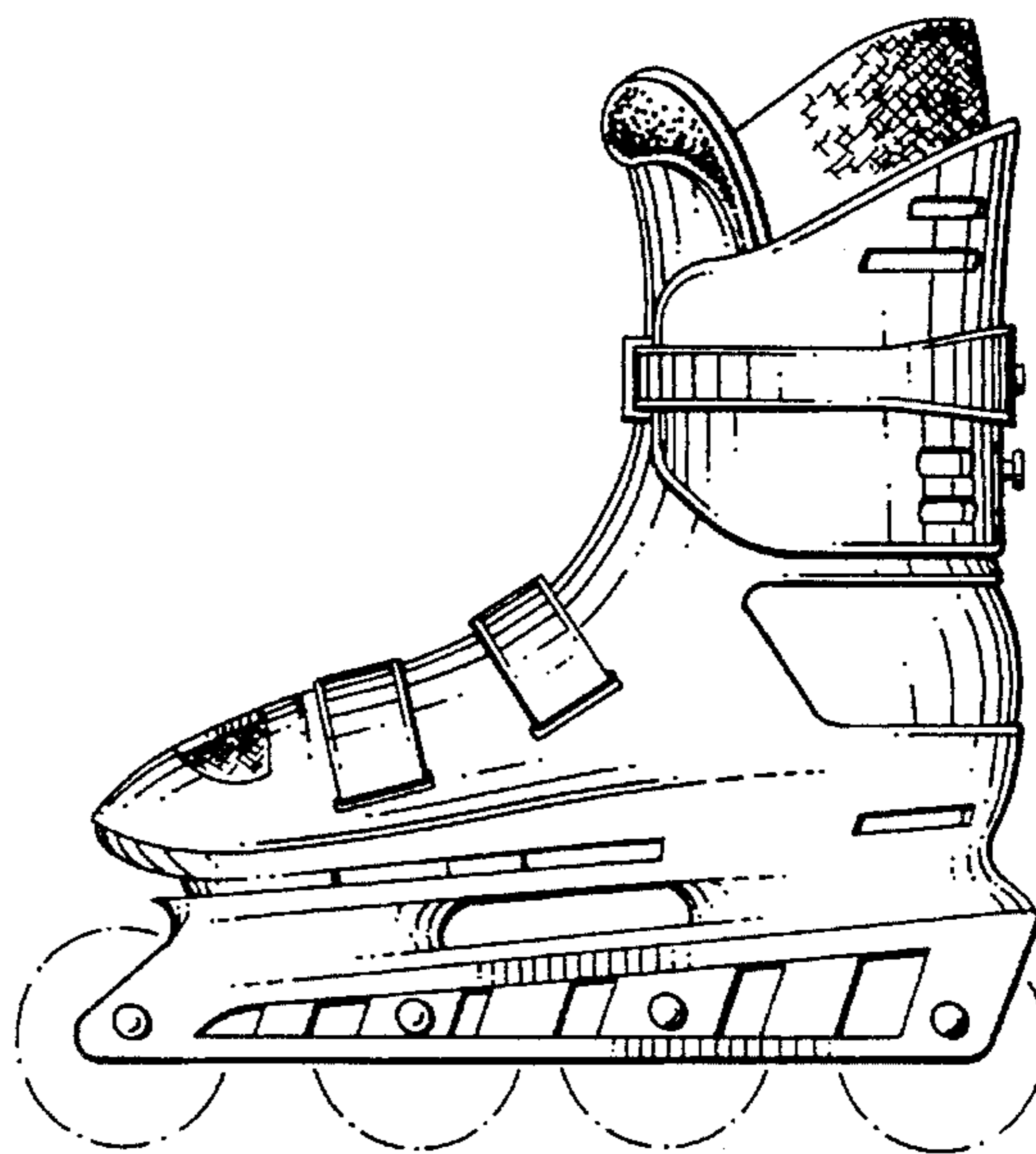
The ornamental design for a in-line skate, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right side perspective view of an in-line skate embodying my new design;
FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.
