[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a combined tape player and radio receiver, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and right-side perspective view of a combined tape player and radio receiver showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top, front and right-side perspective view thereof, shown with handle and antenna in the raised positions;

FIG. 3 is a top, front and right-side perspective view thereof, shown in the opened position;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

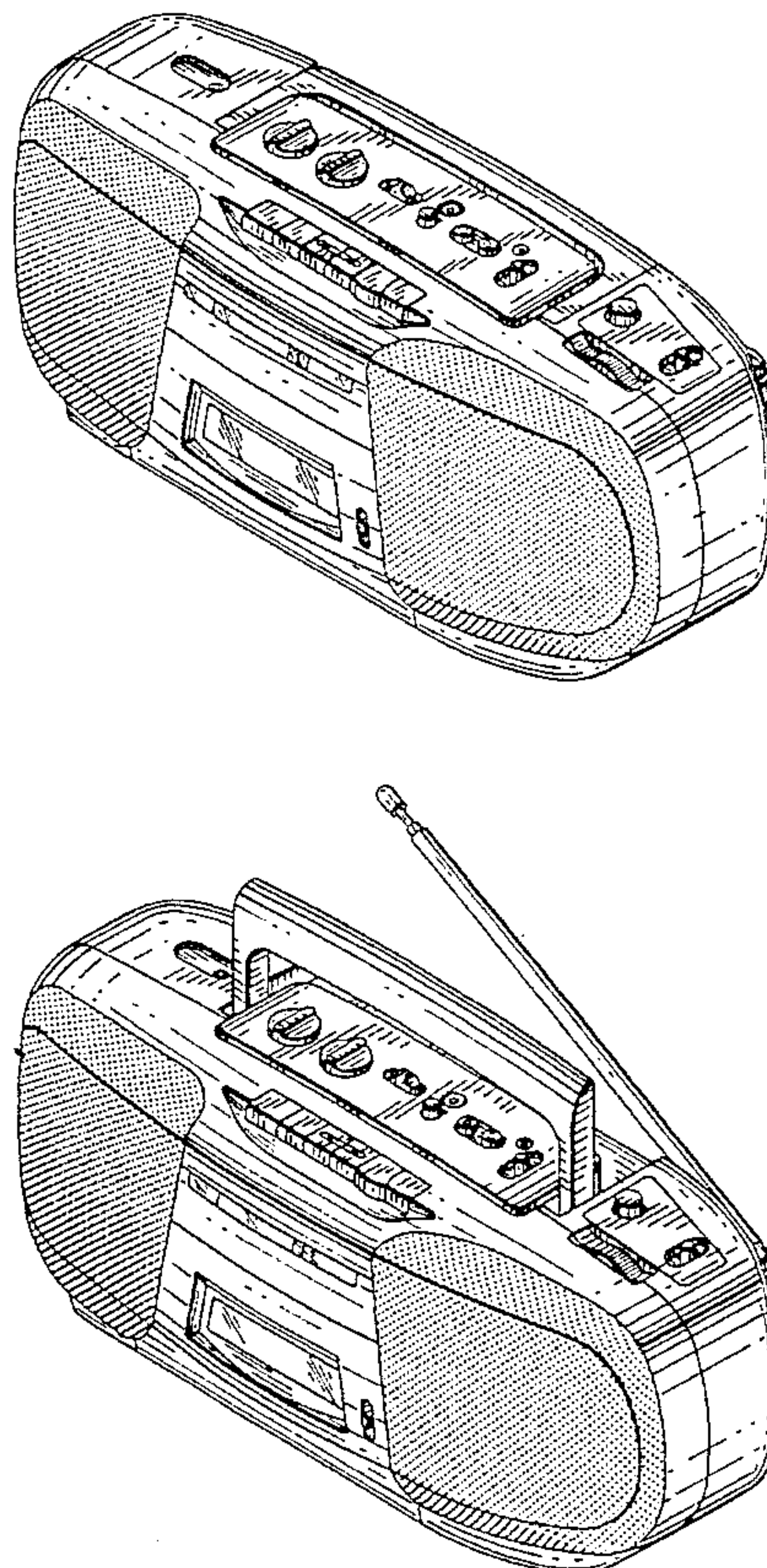
FIG. 6 is a left-side elevational view thereof;

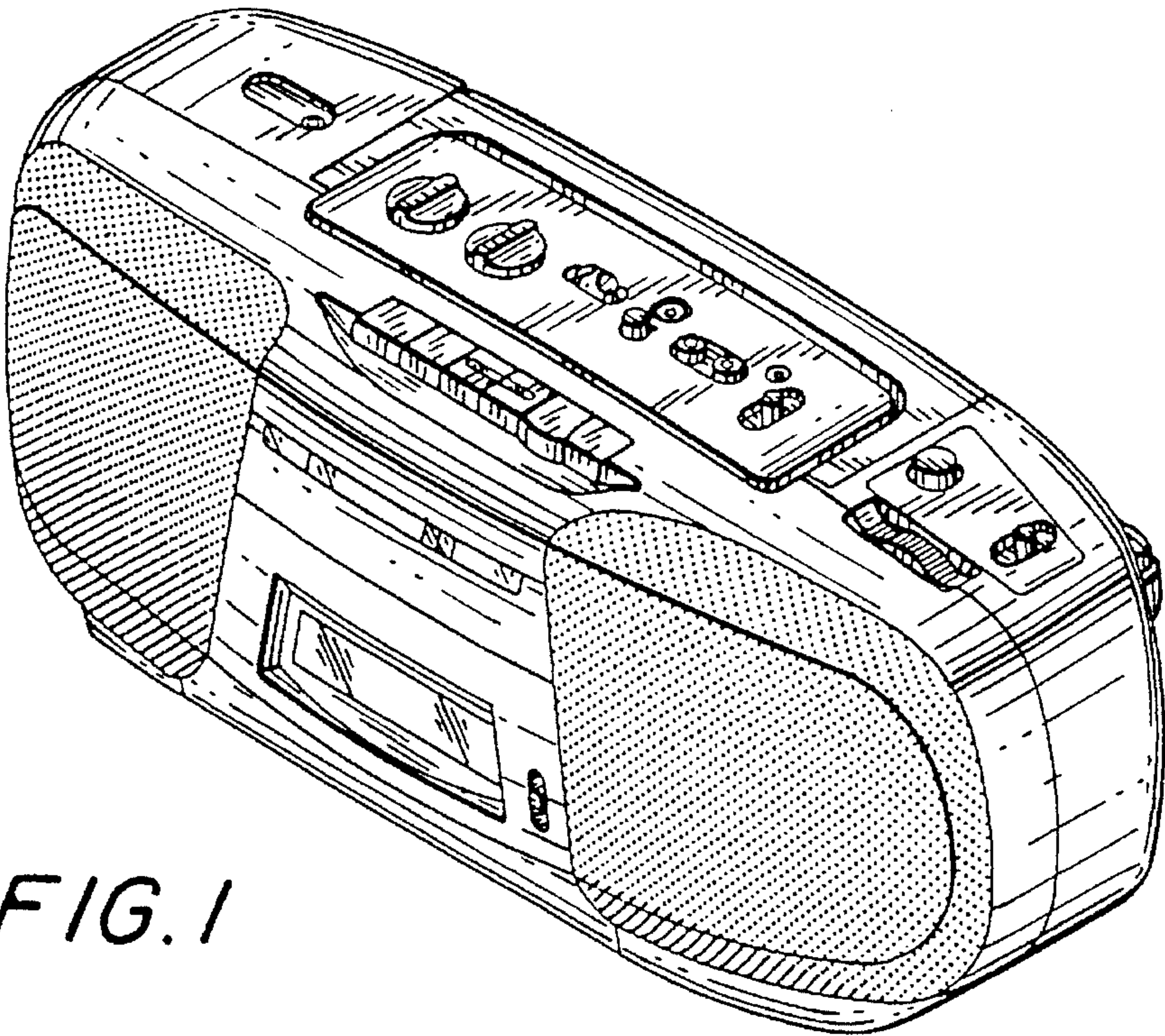

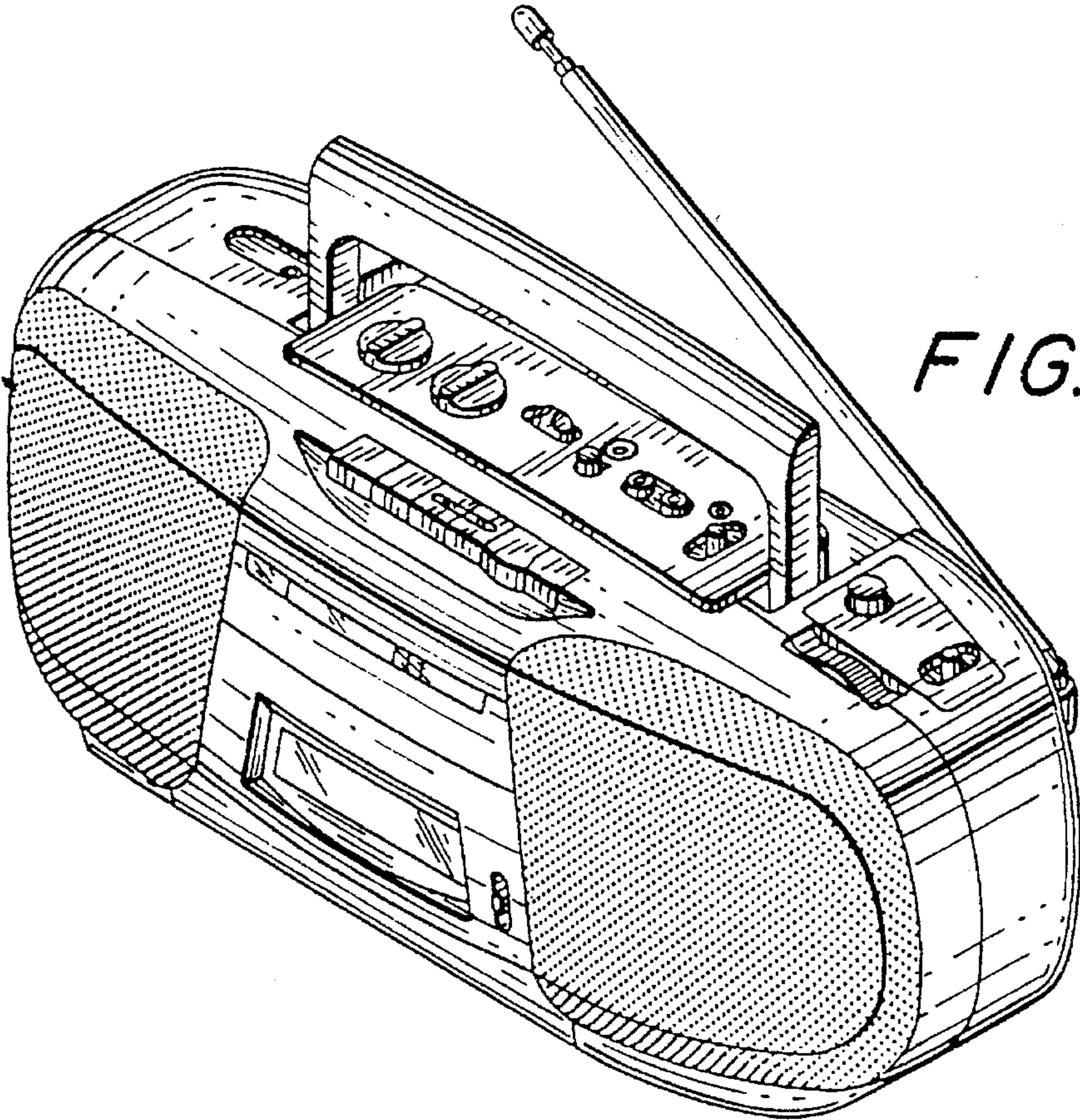

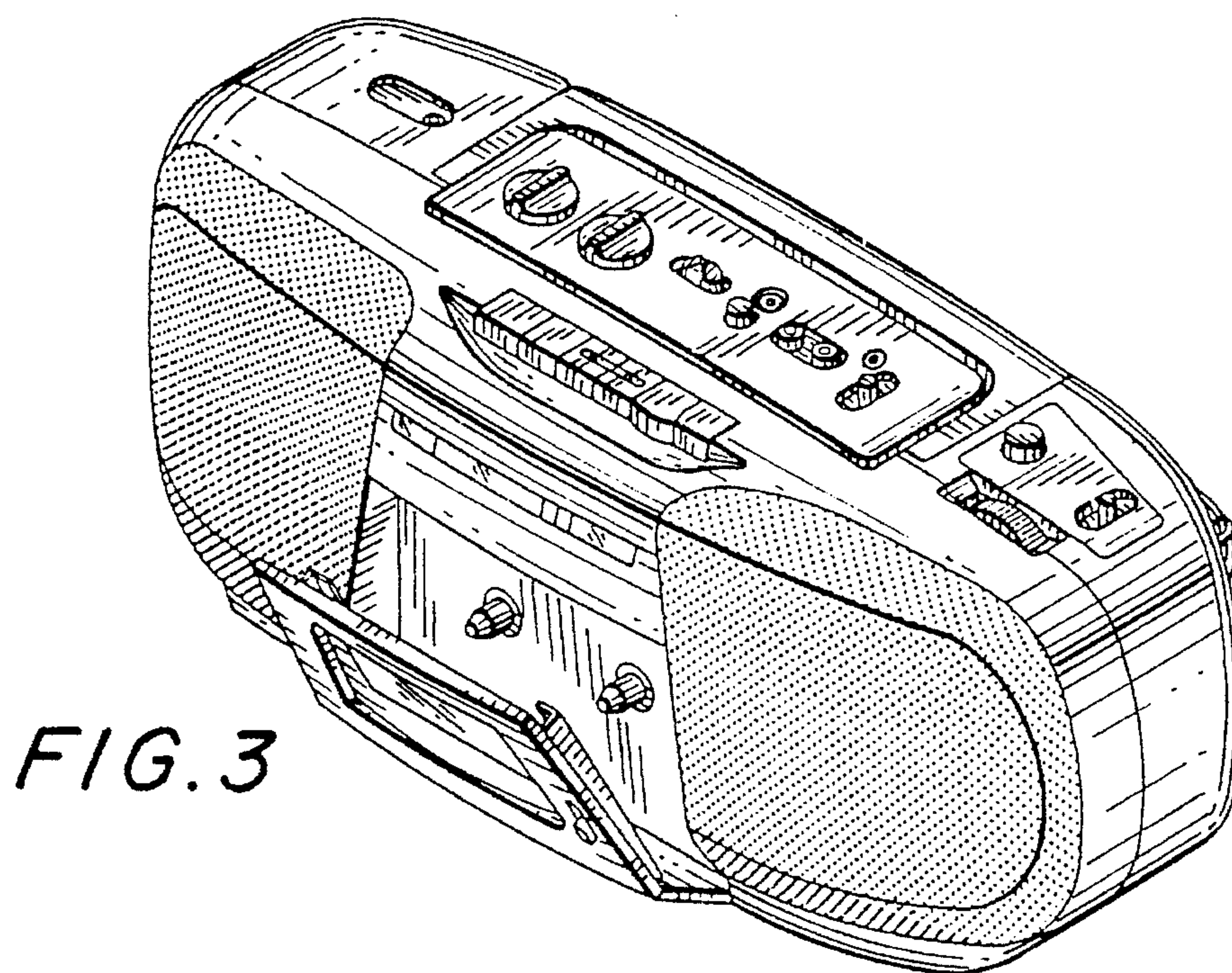

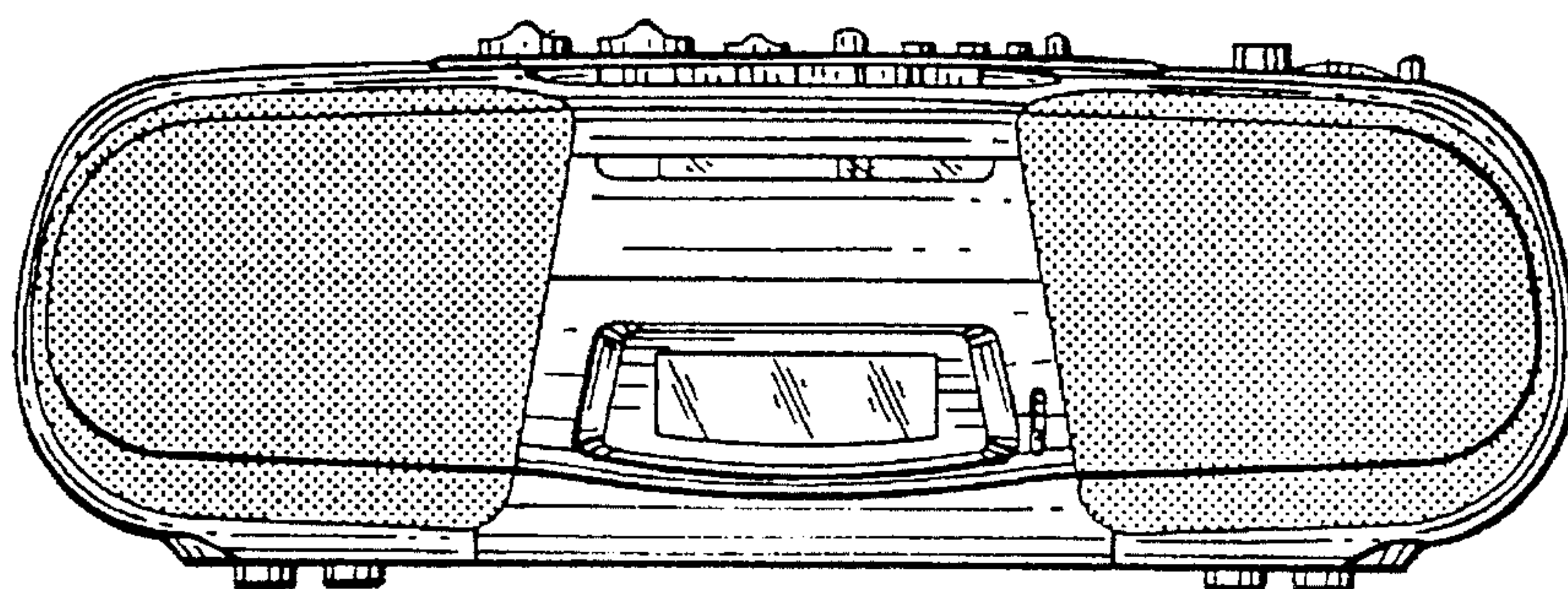

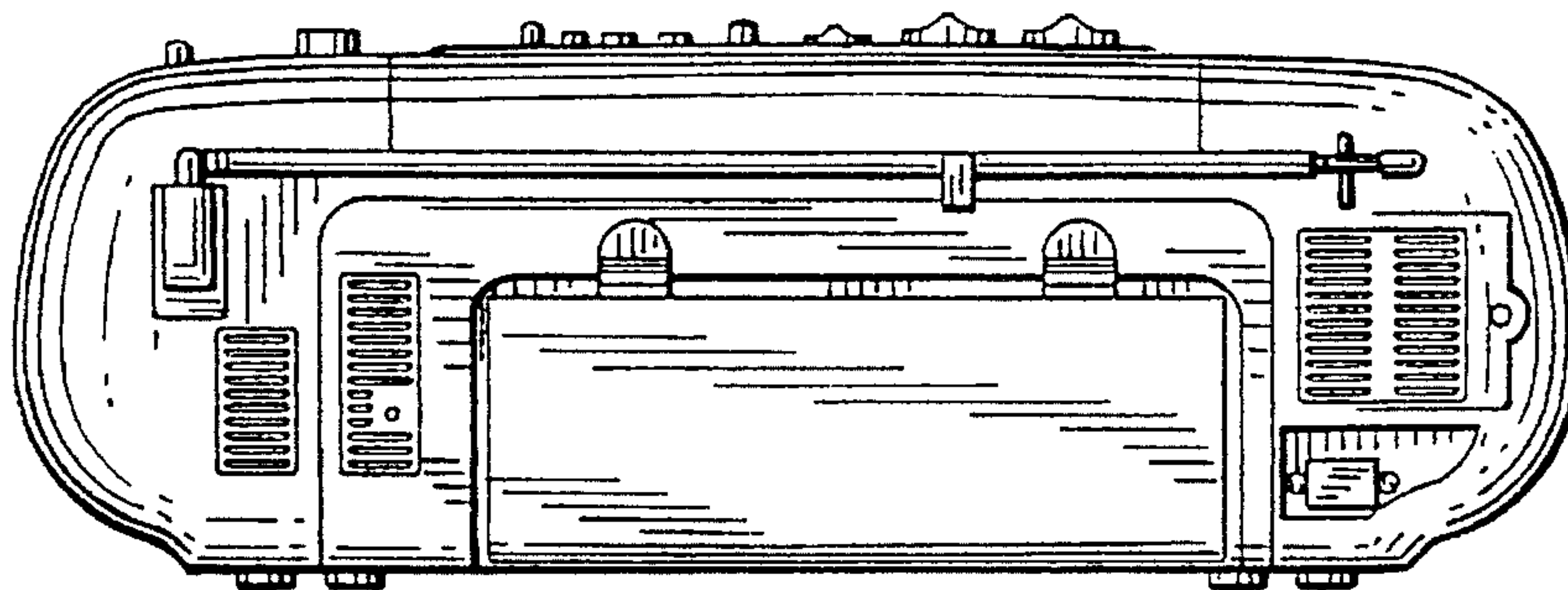

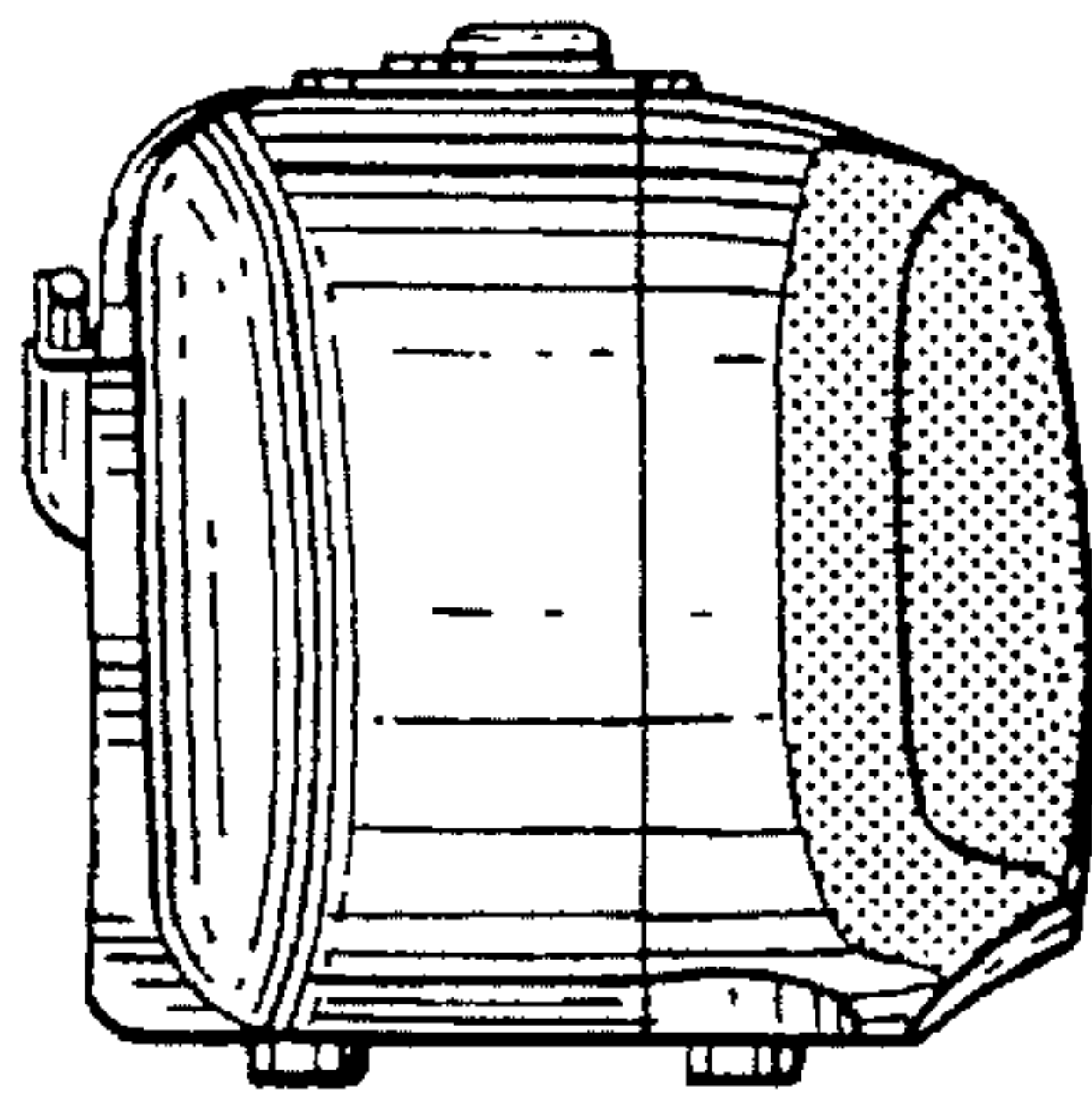

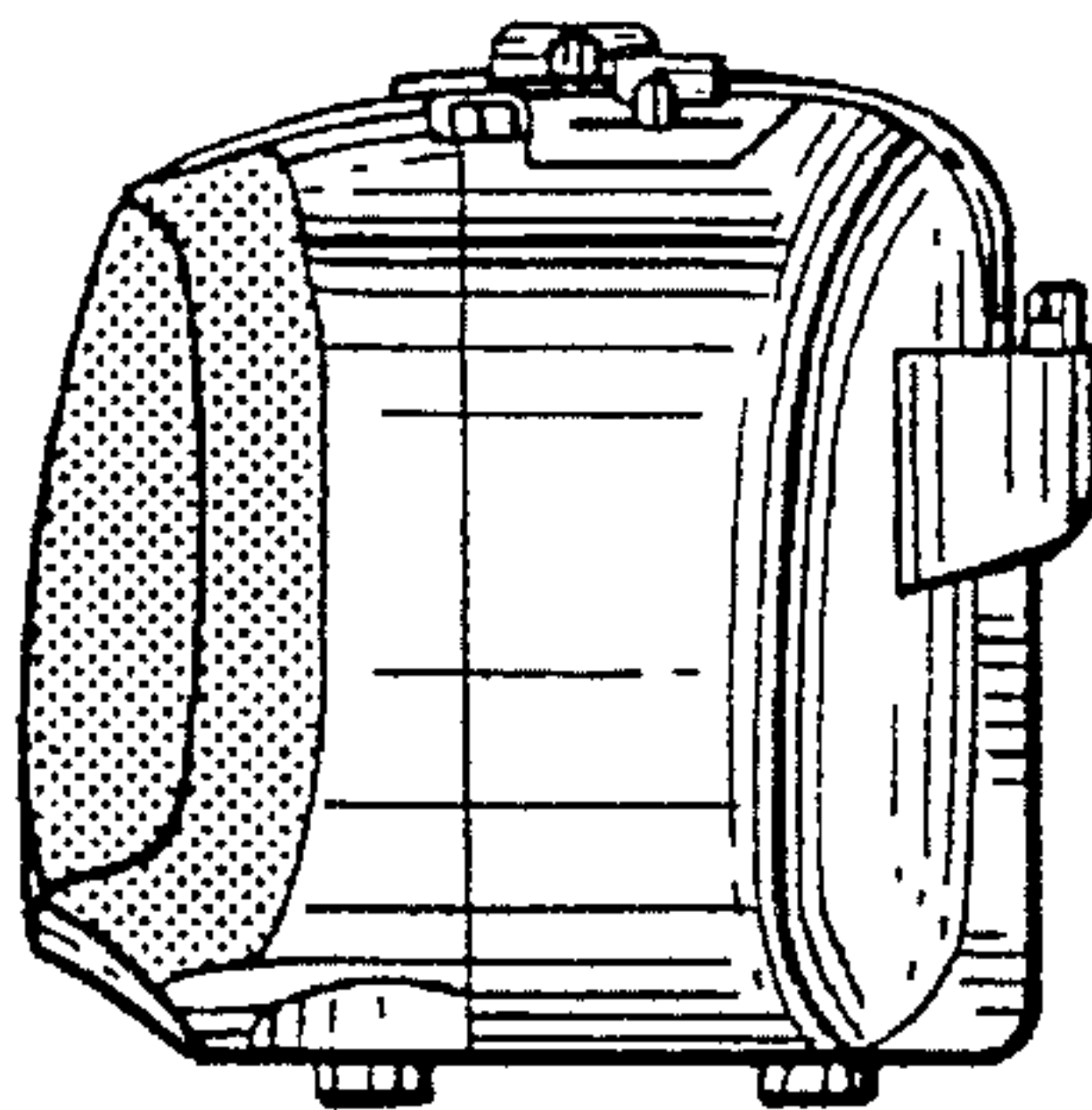

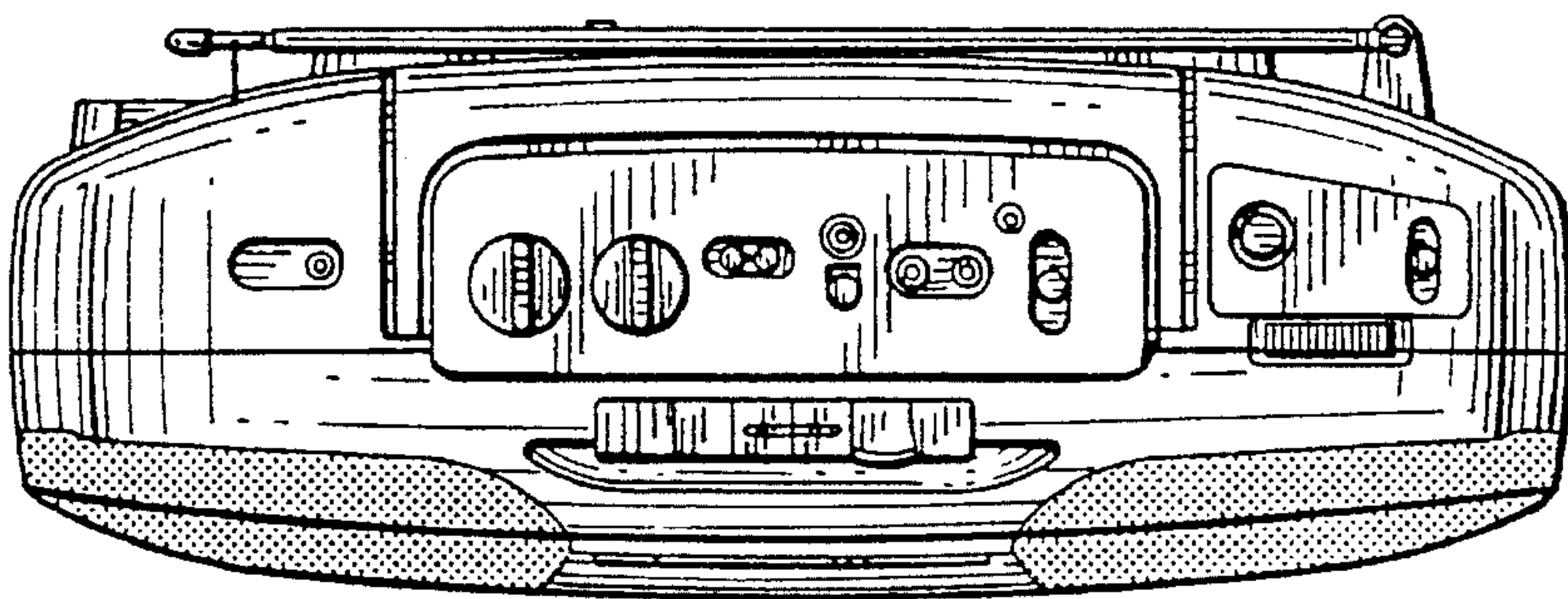
