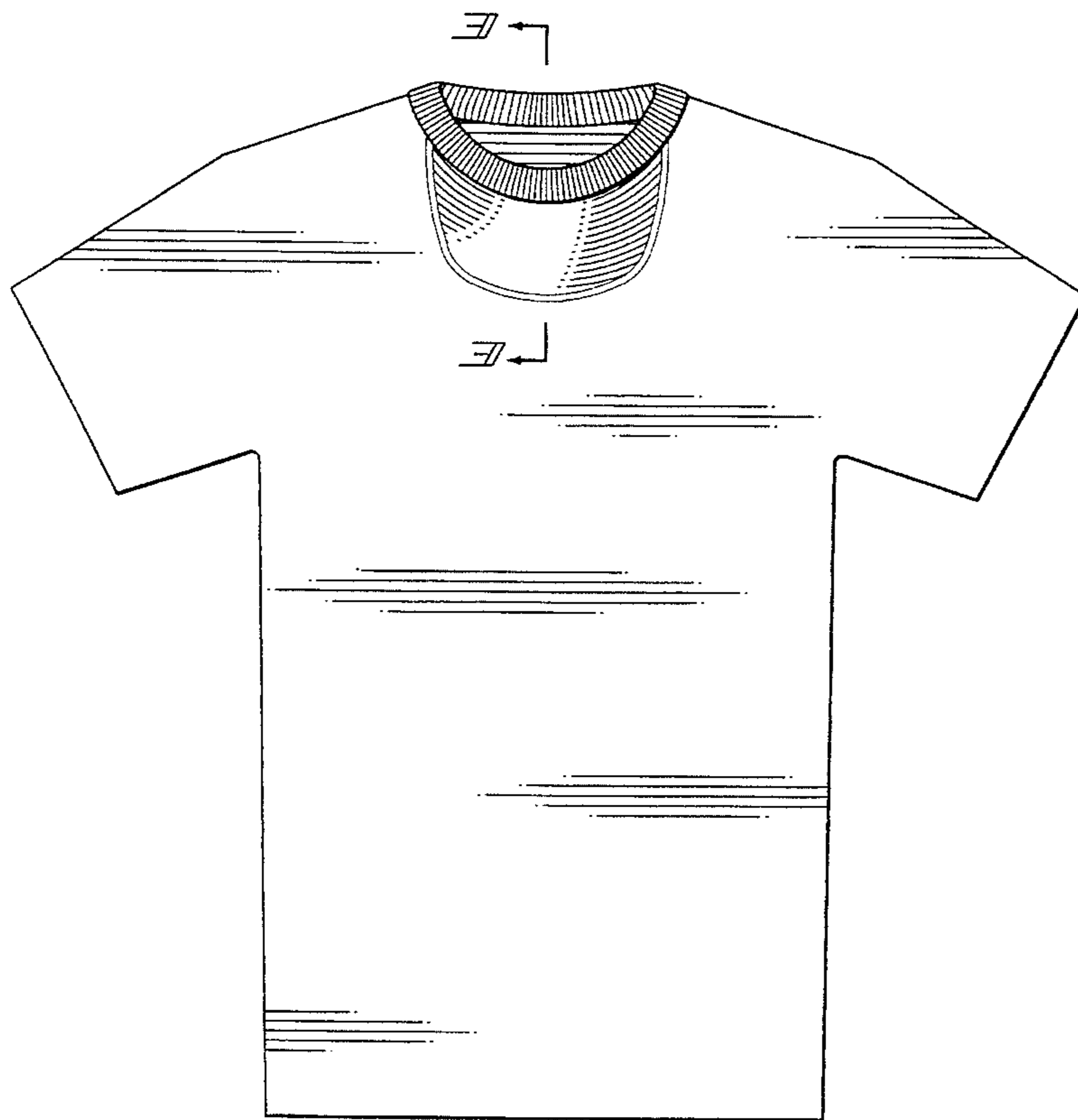

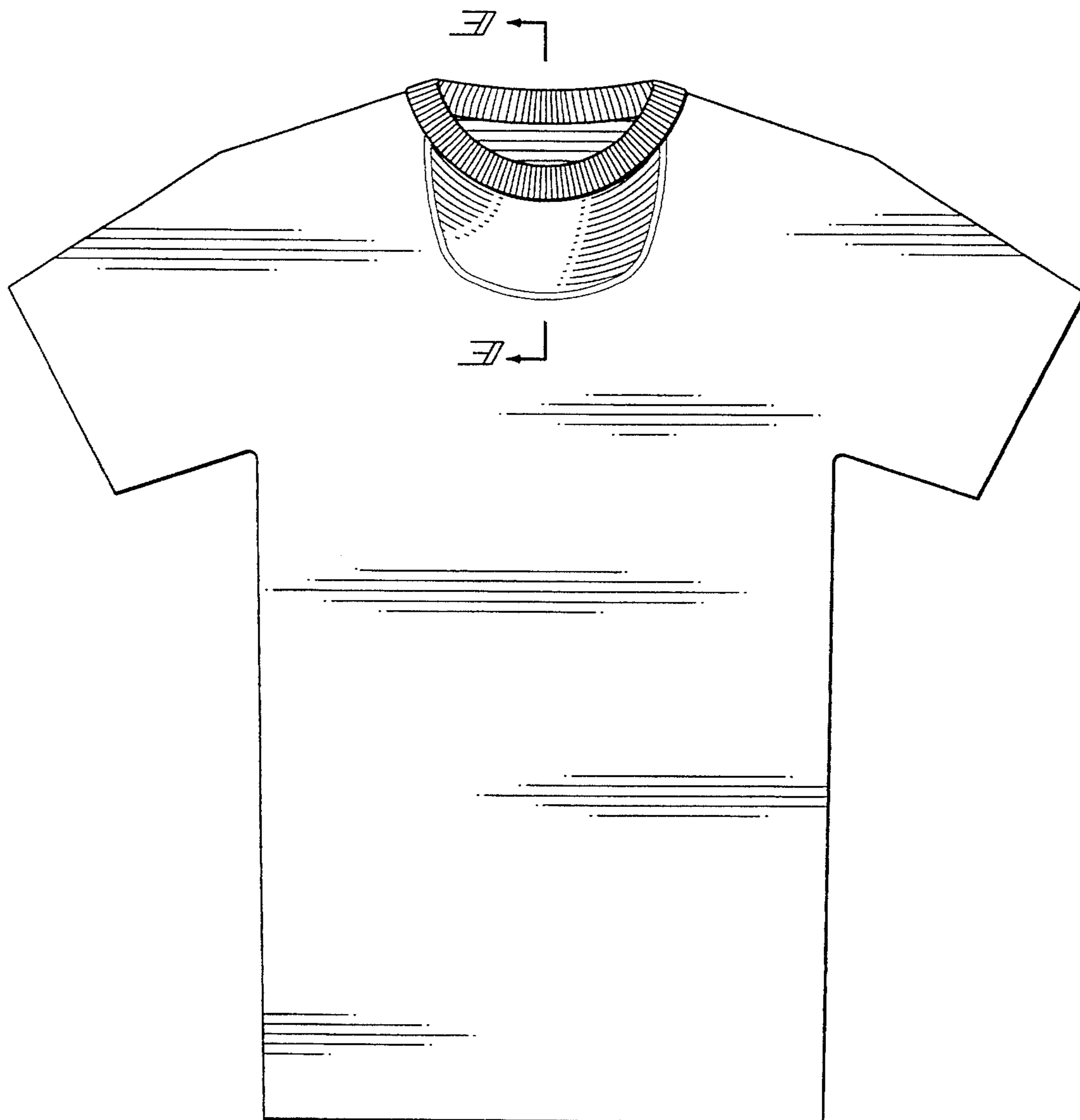
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined shirt and sun shade showing my new design;

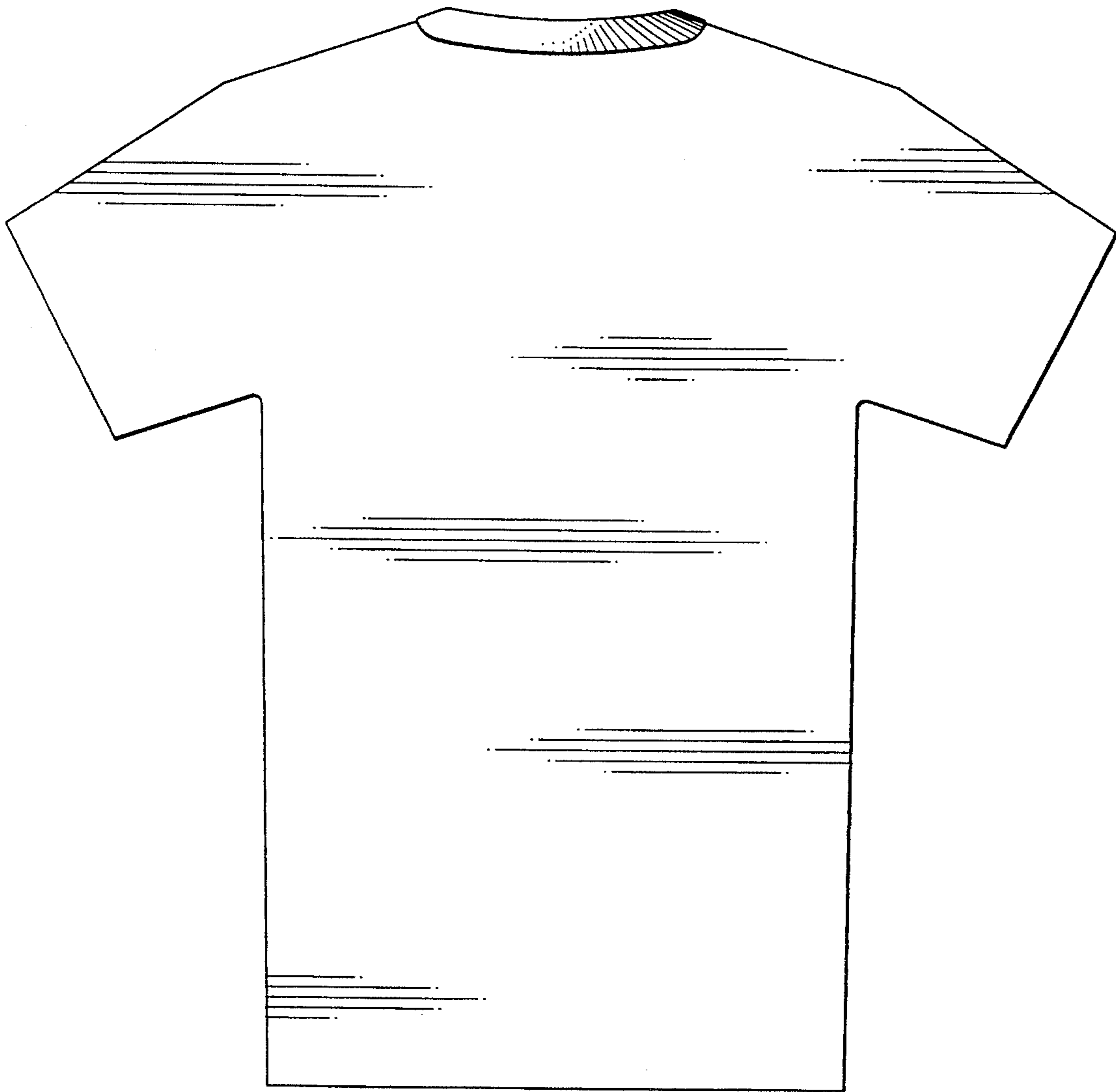
