FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

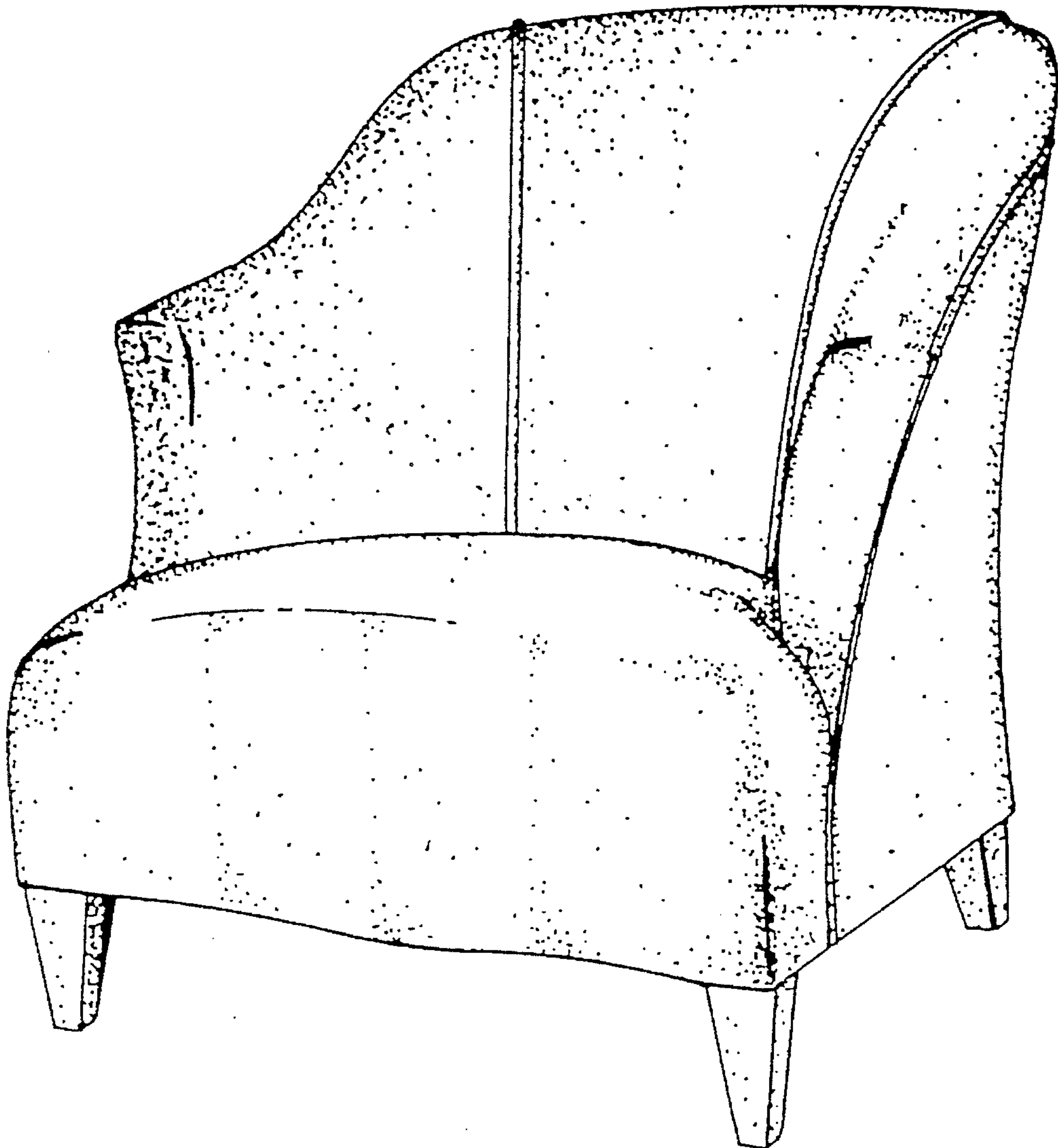
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image thereof;

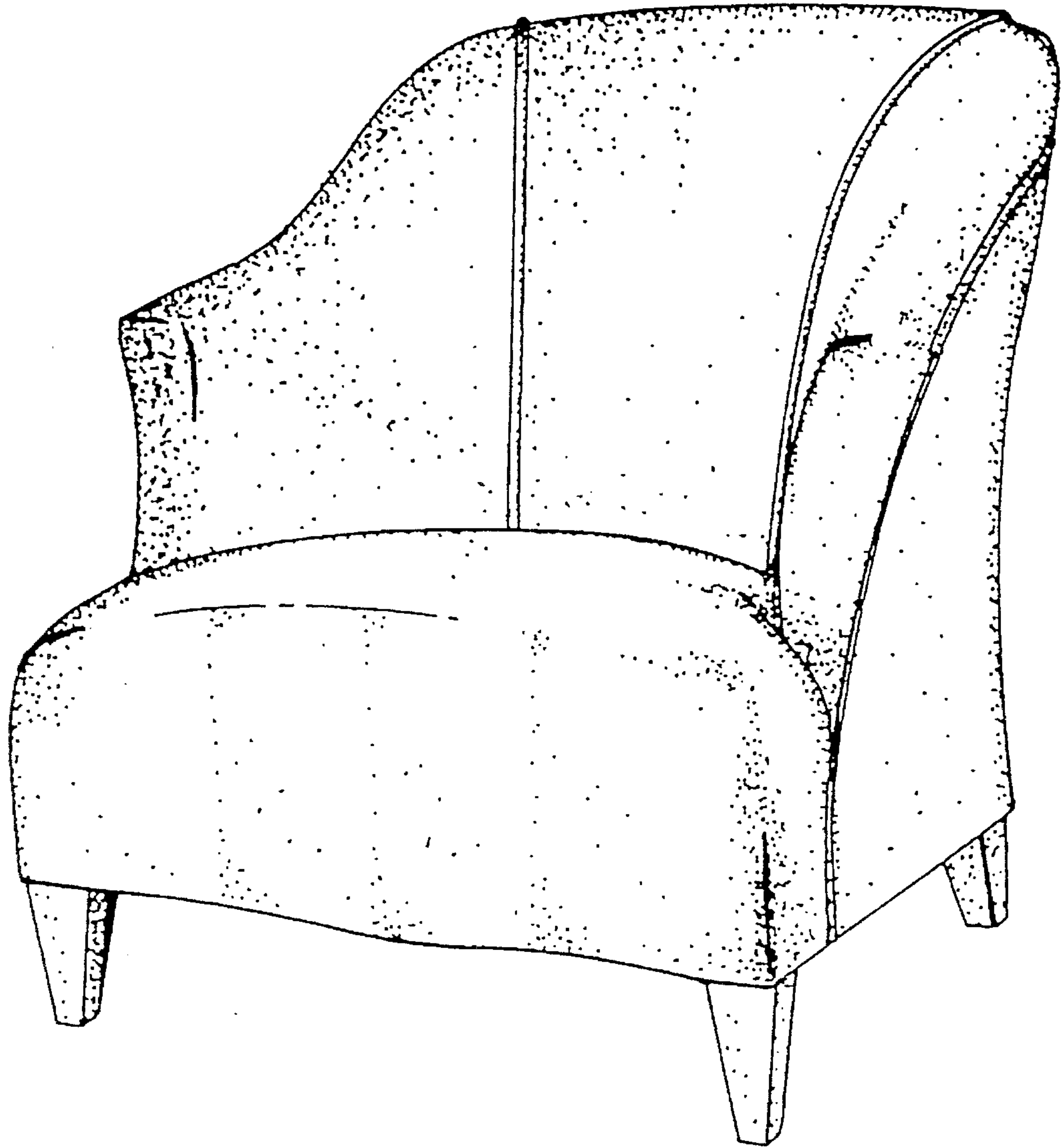

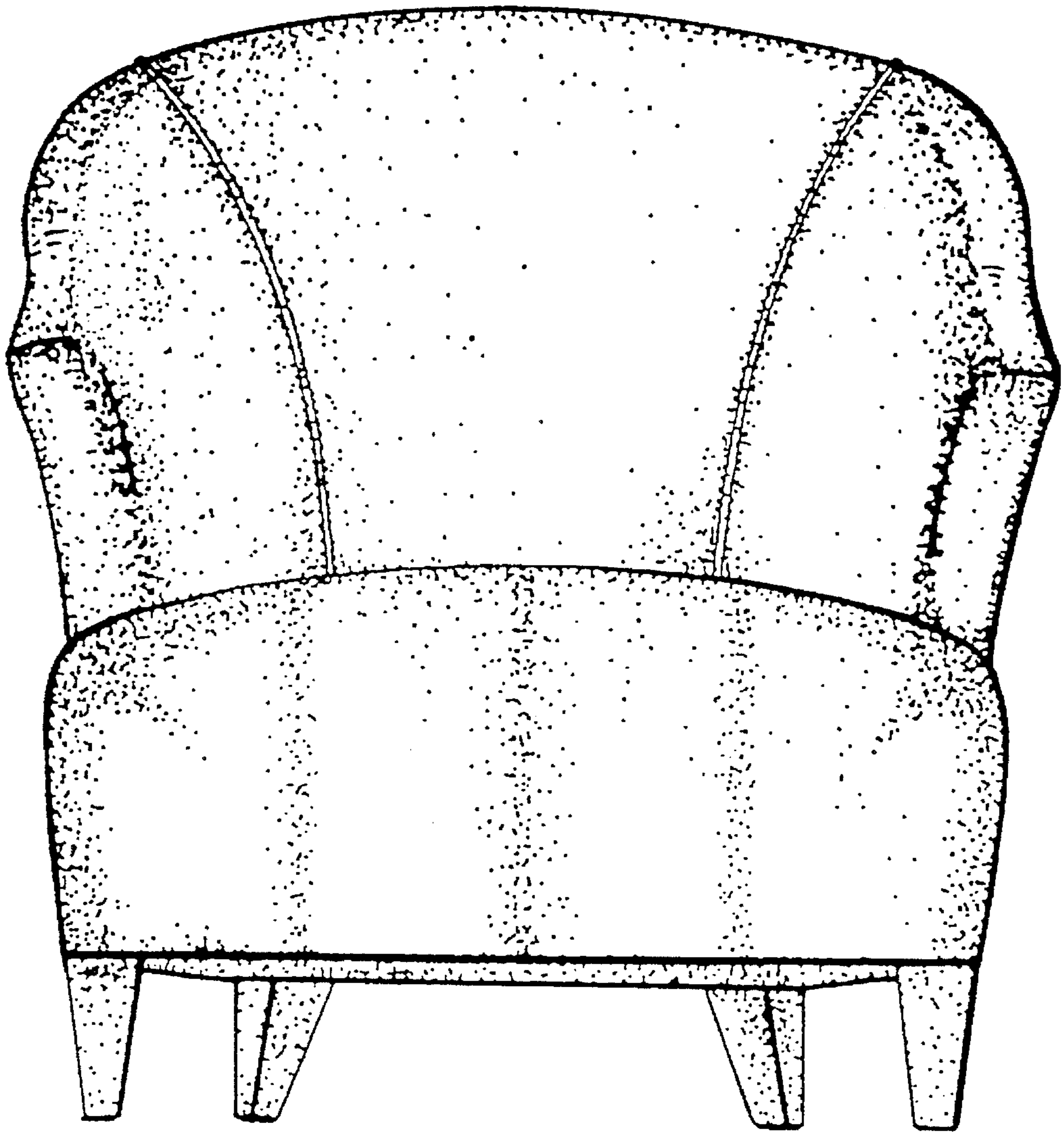

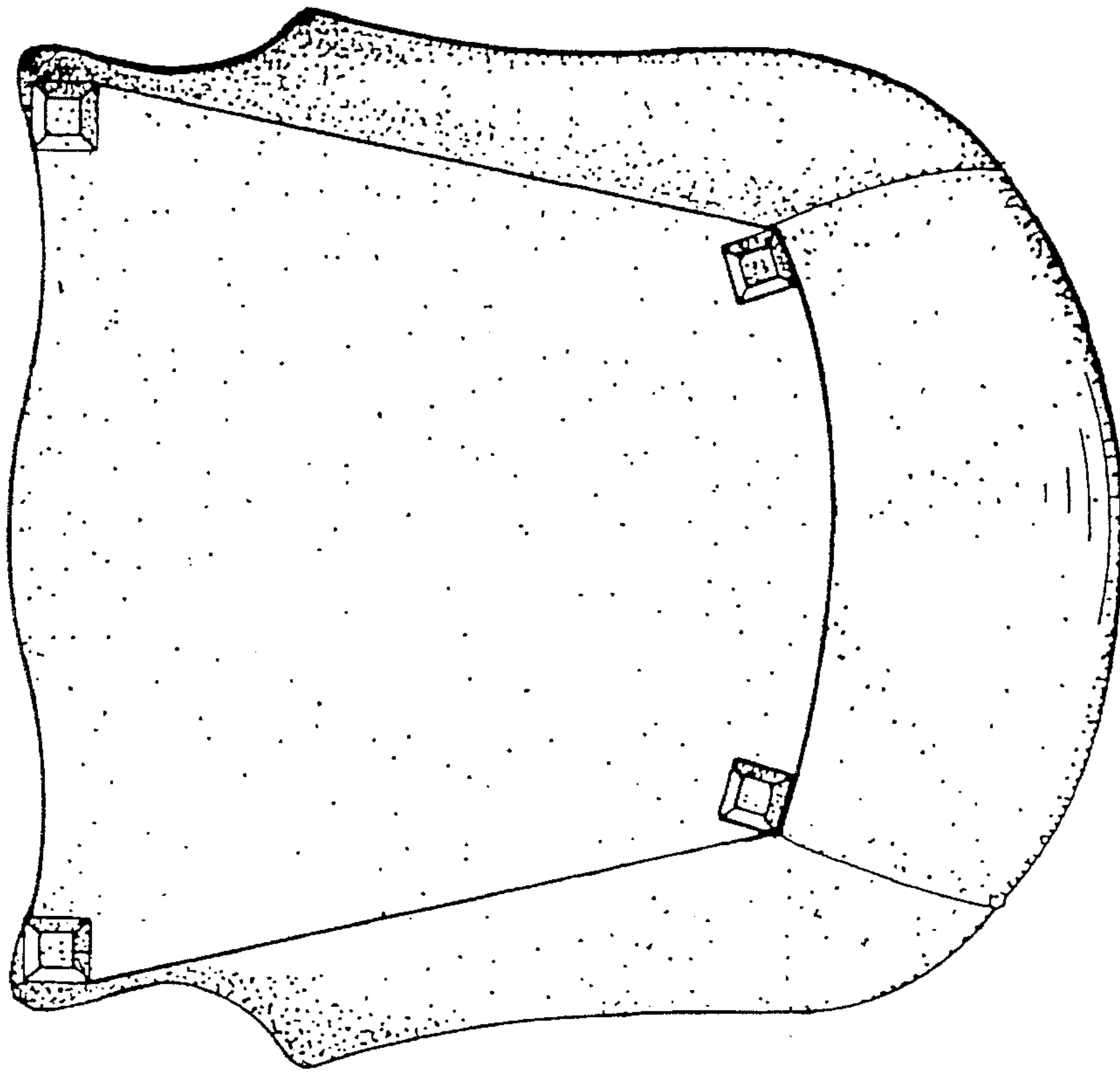

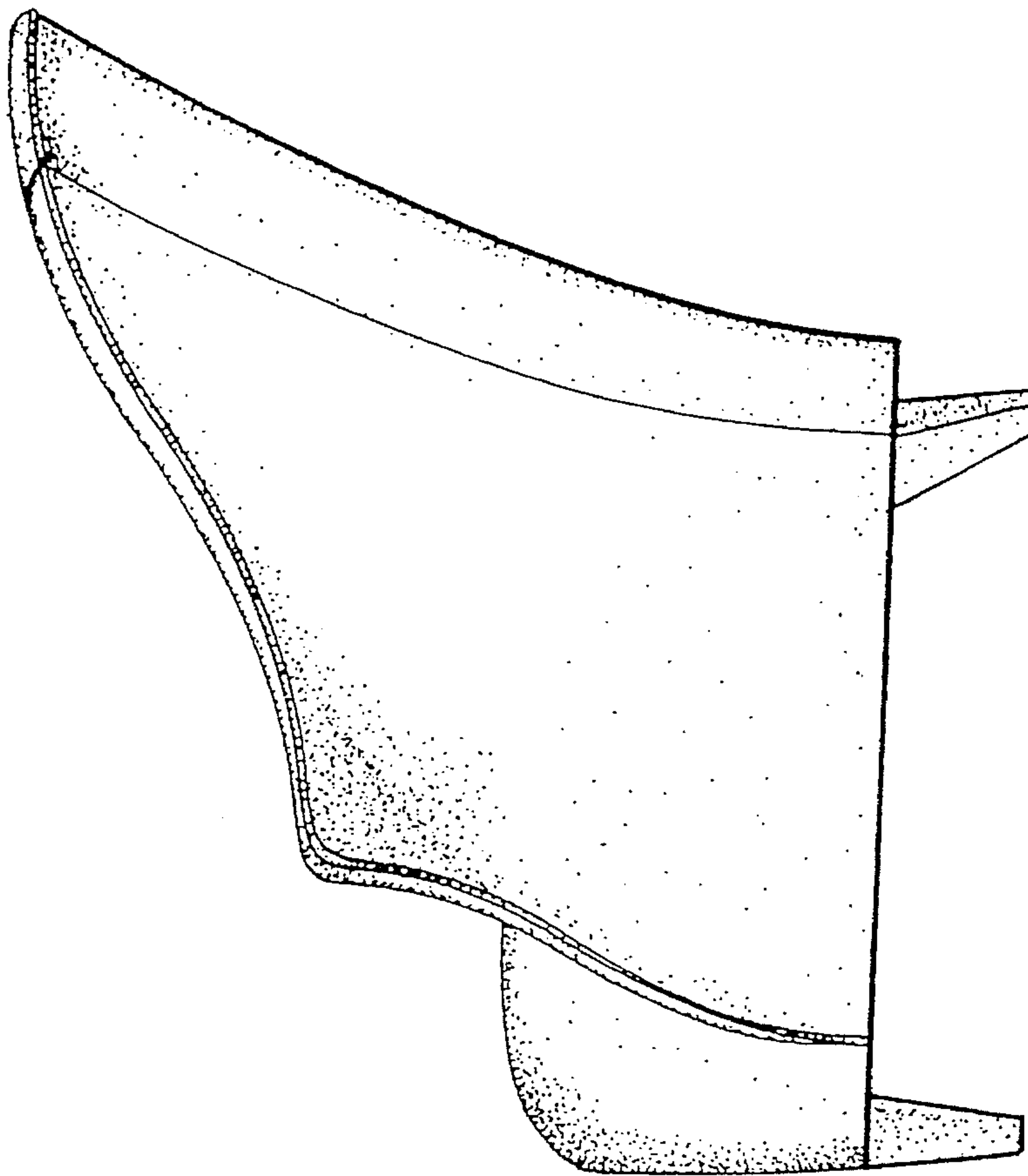

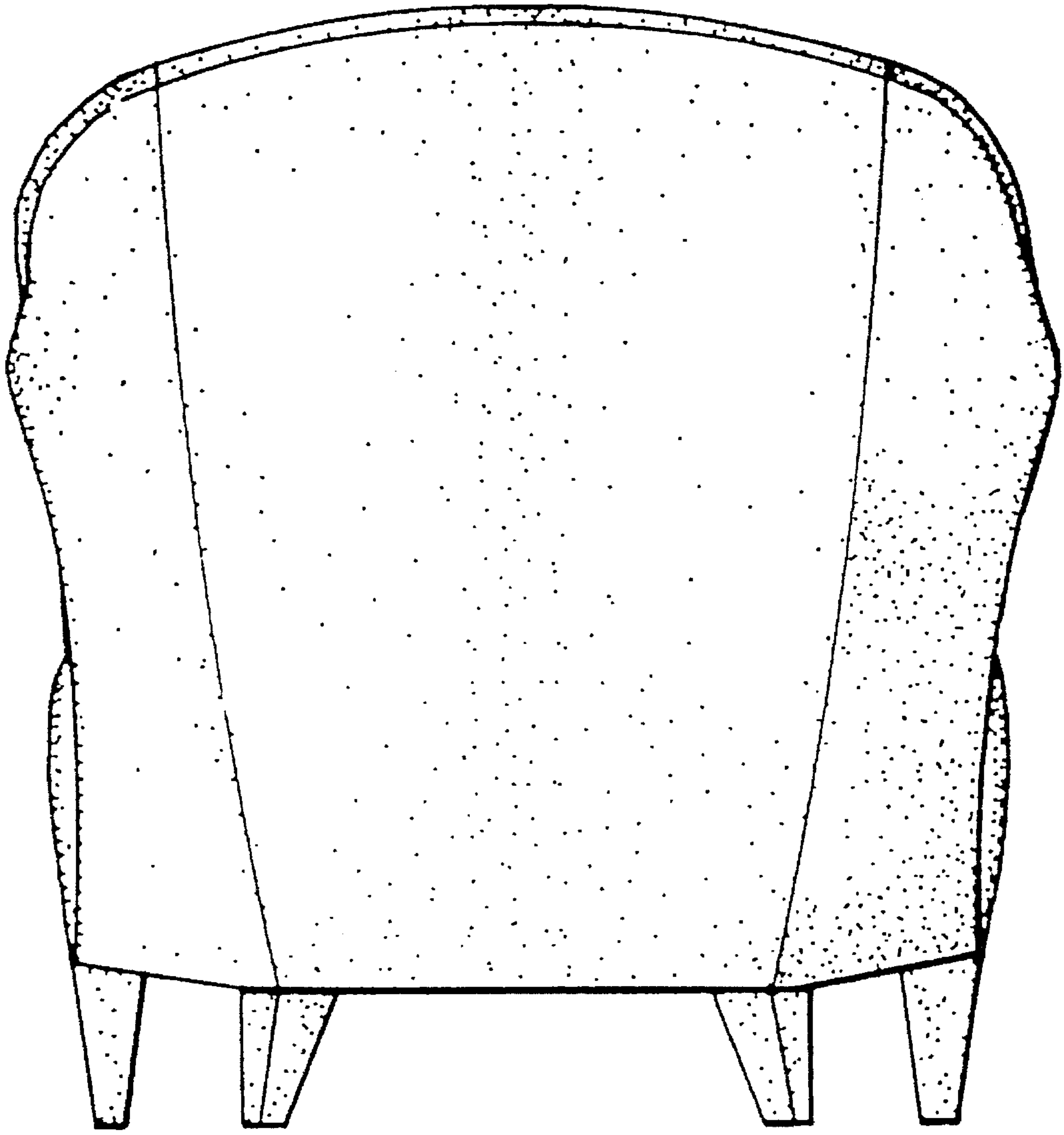

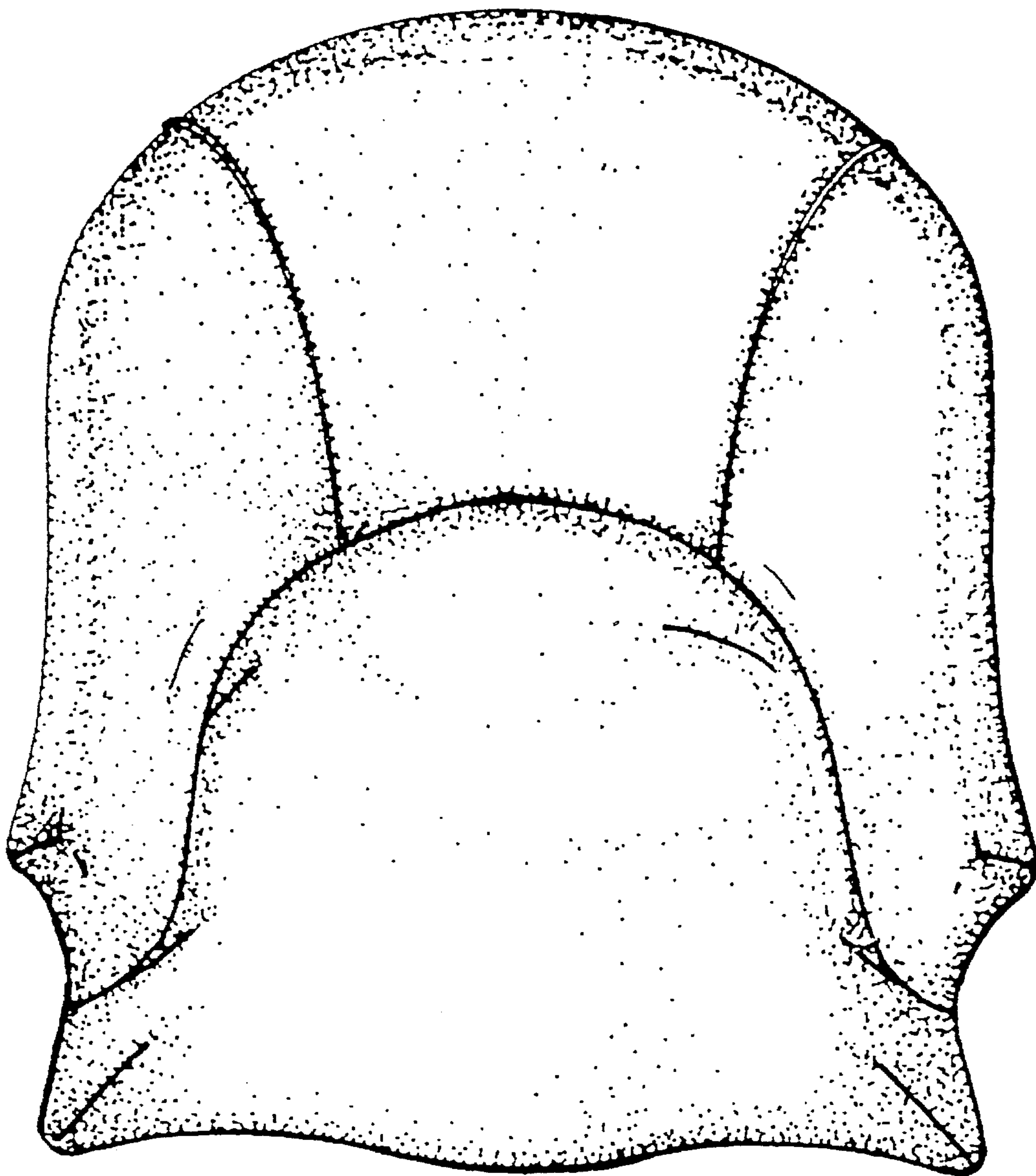
