[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an end of sledge hammer handle,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the end of a sledge hammer
handle, showing our new design, wherein the broken line
showing of the sledge hammer is for illustrative purposes
only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the end of the sledge hammer
handle, the bottom plan view being identical;

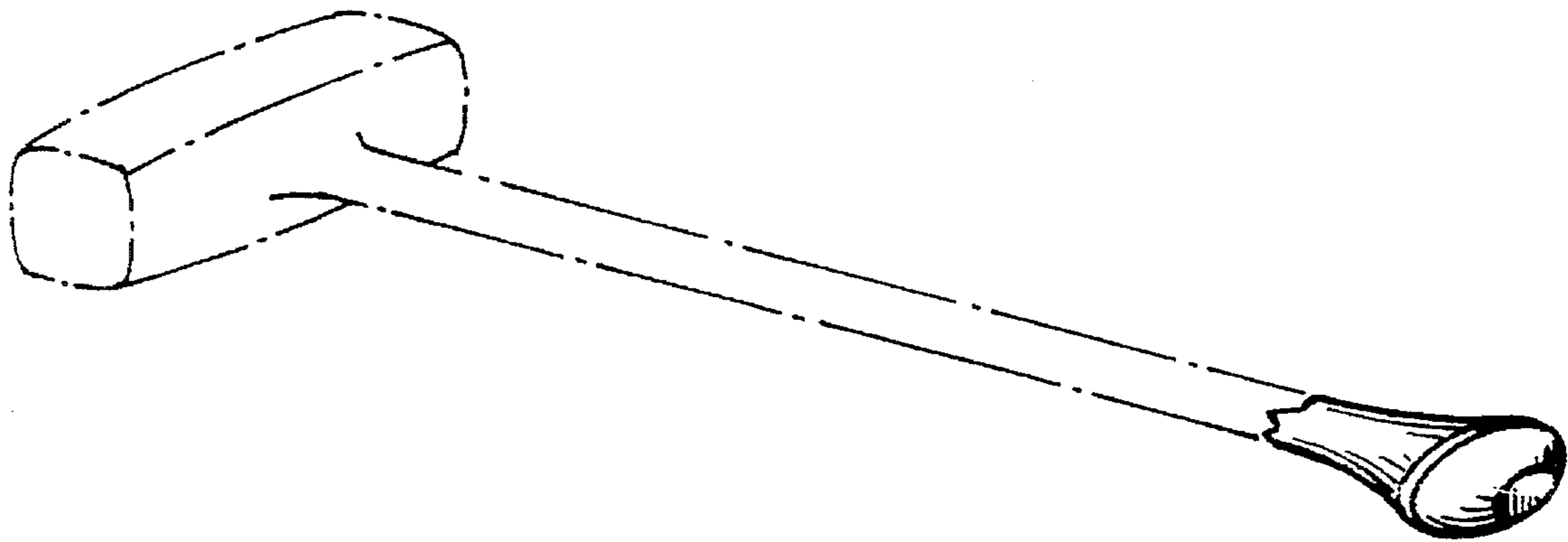
FIG. 3 is a side view of one side of the end of the sledge
hammer handle, the other side being identical;

FIG. 4 is an end view of the butt end of the sledge hammer
handle;

FIG. 5 is a view in section taken along the line 5-5 of FIG.
2; and,

FIG. 6 is a view taken along the line 6-6 of FIG. 2.

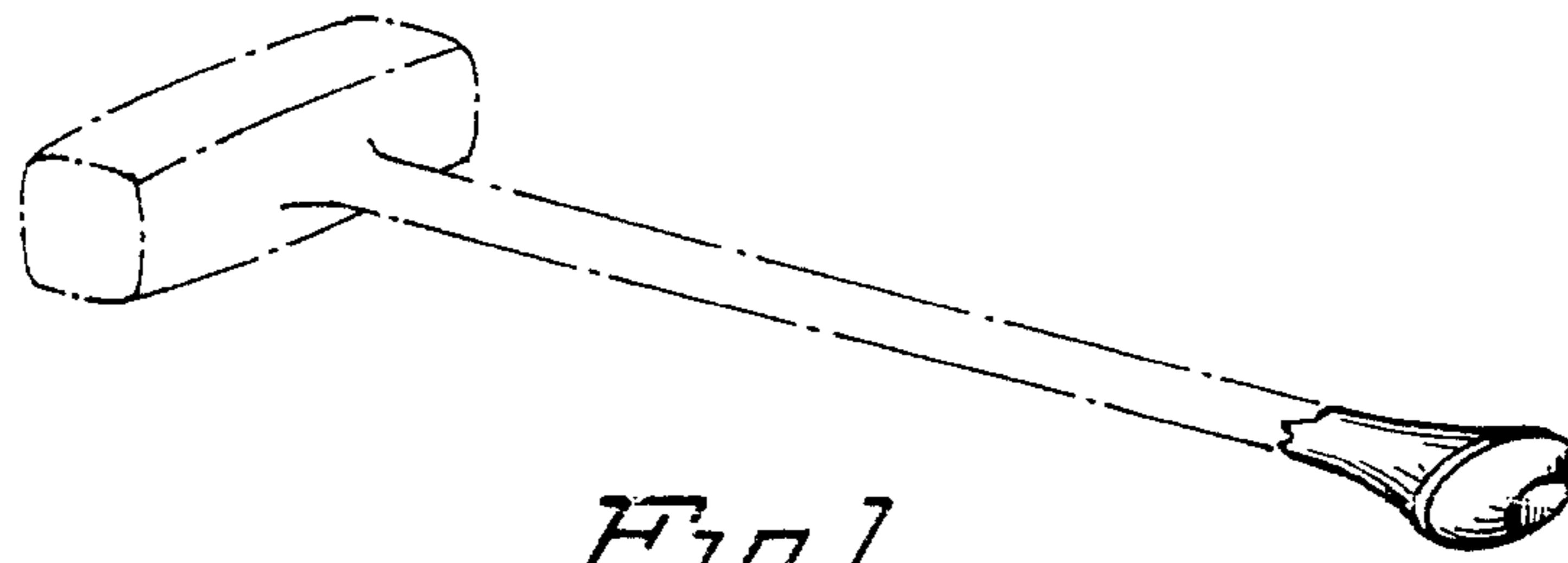

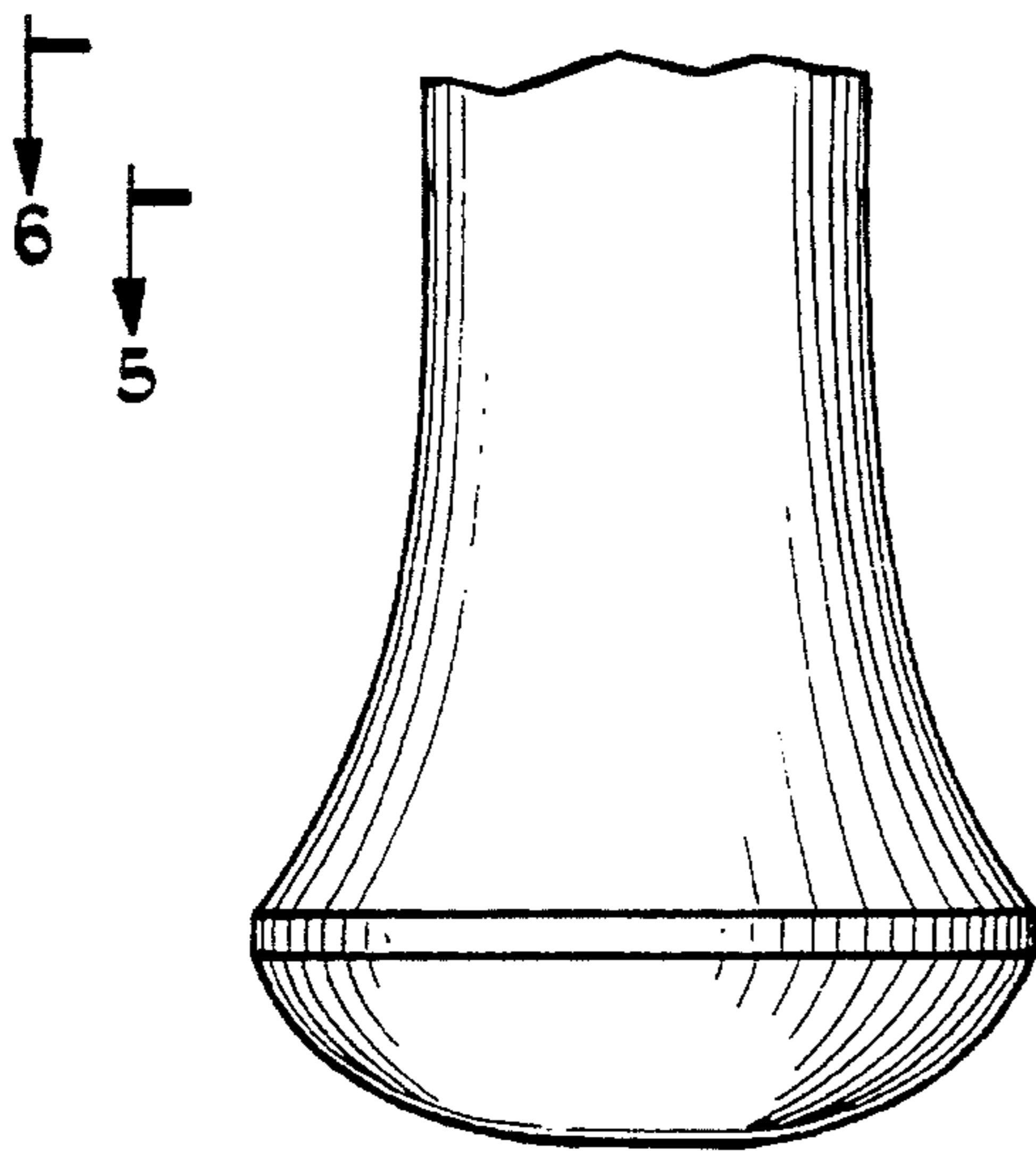

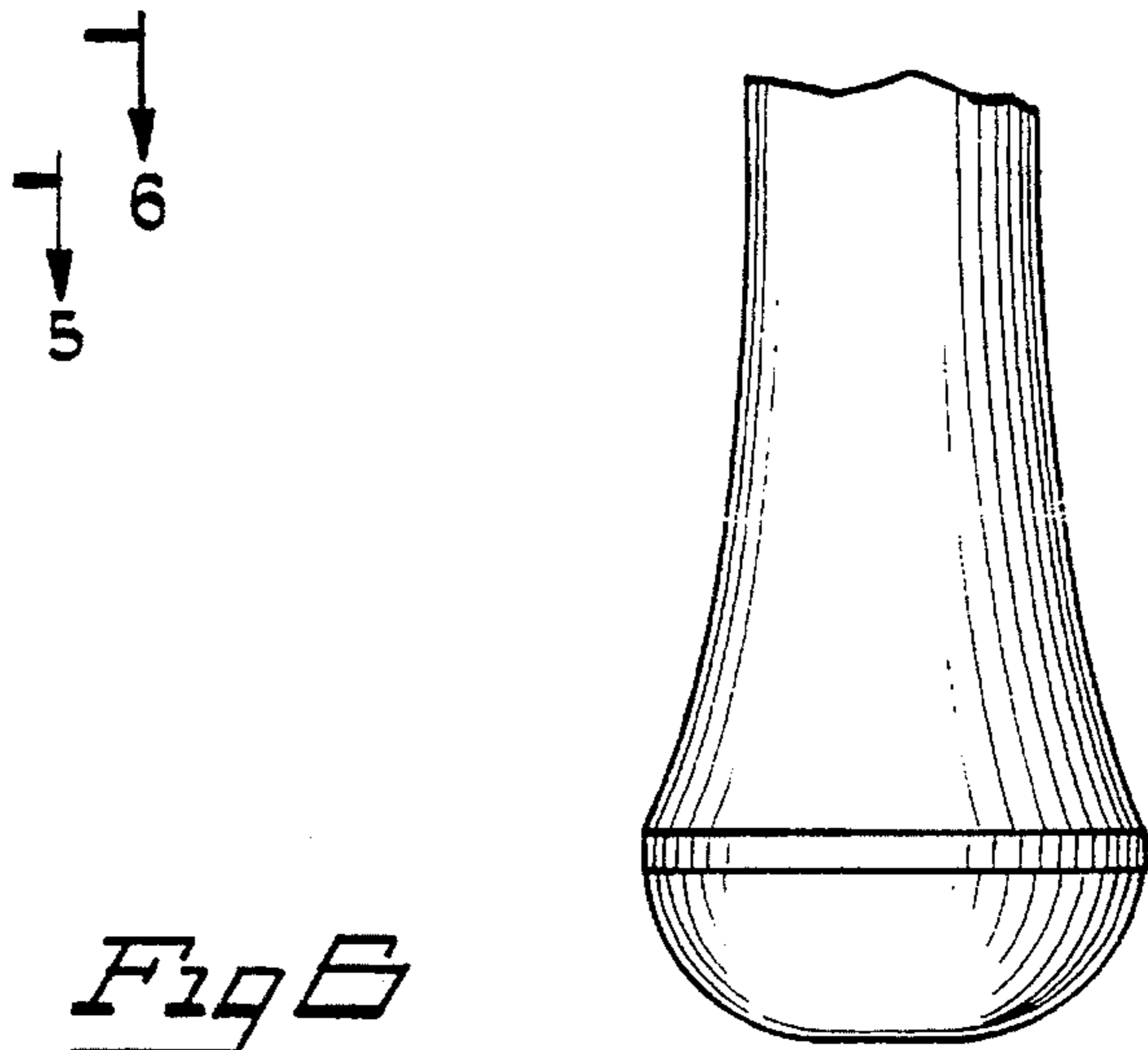

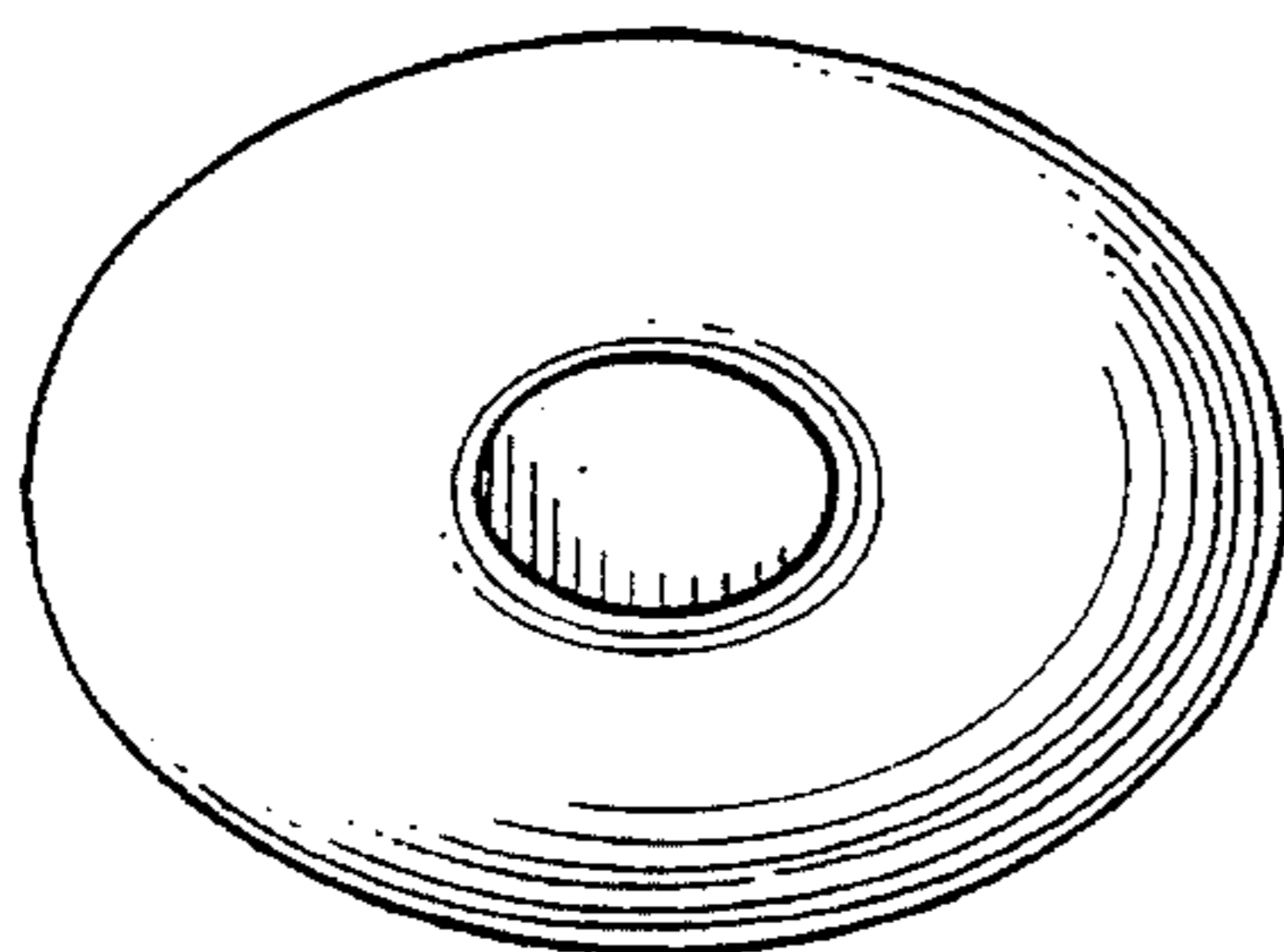
