FIG. 17 is a left end elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 18 is a right end elevational view thereof.

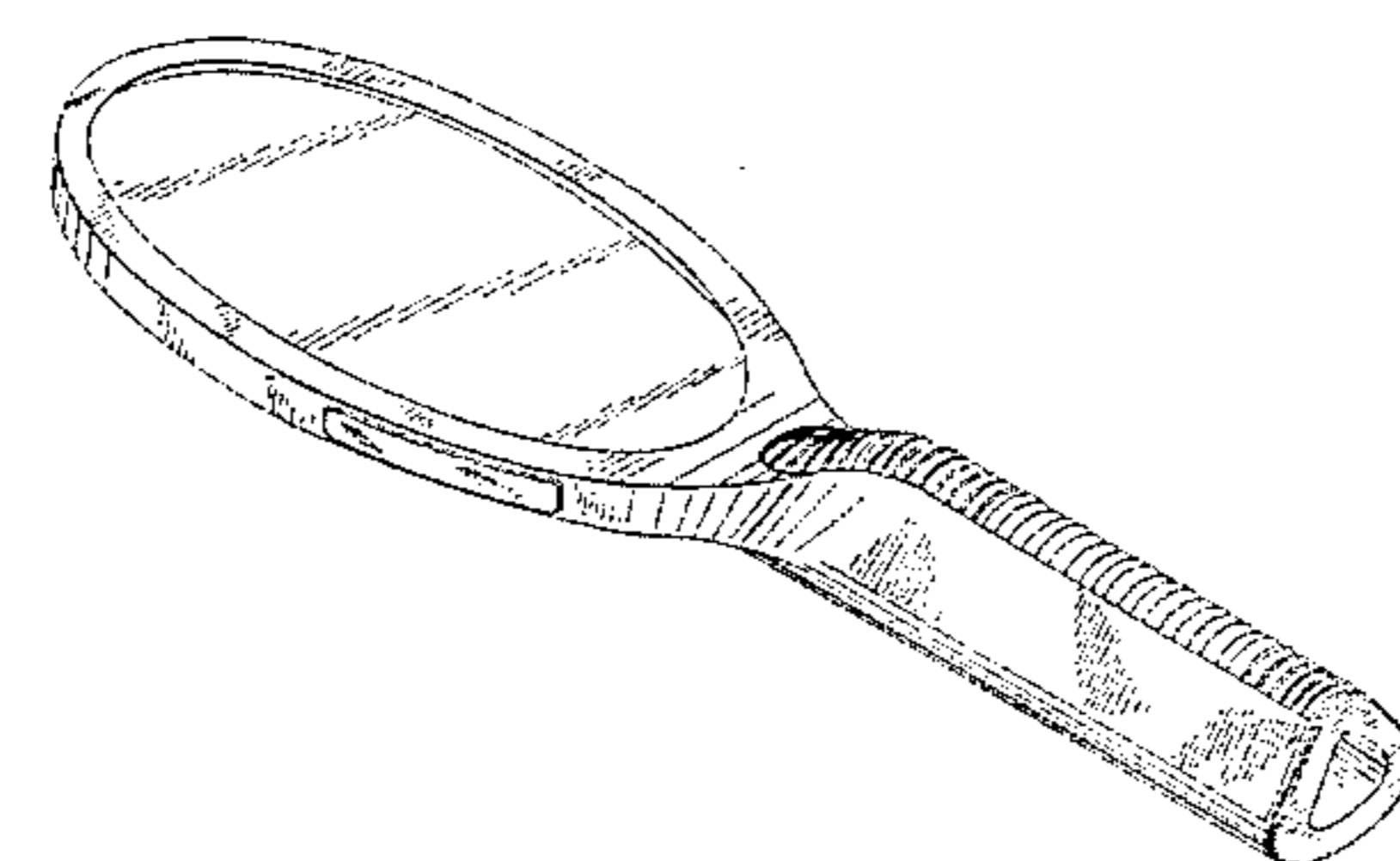
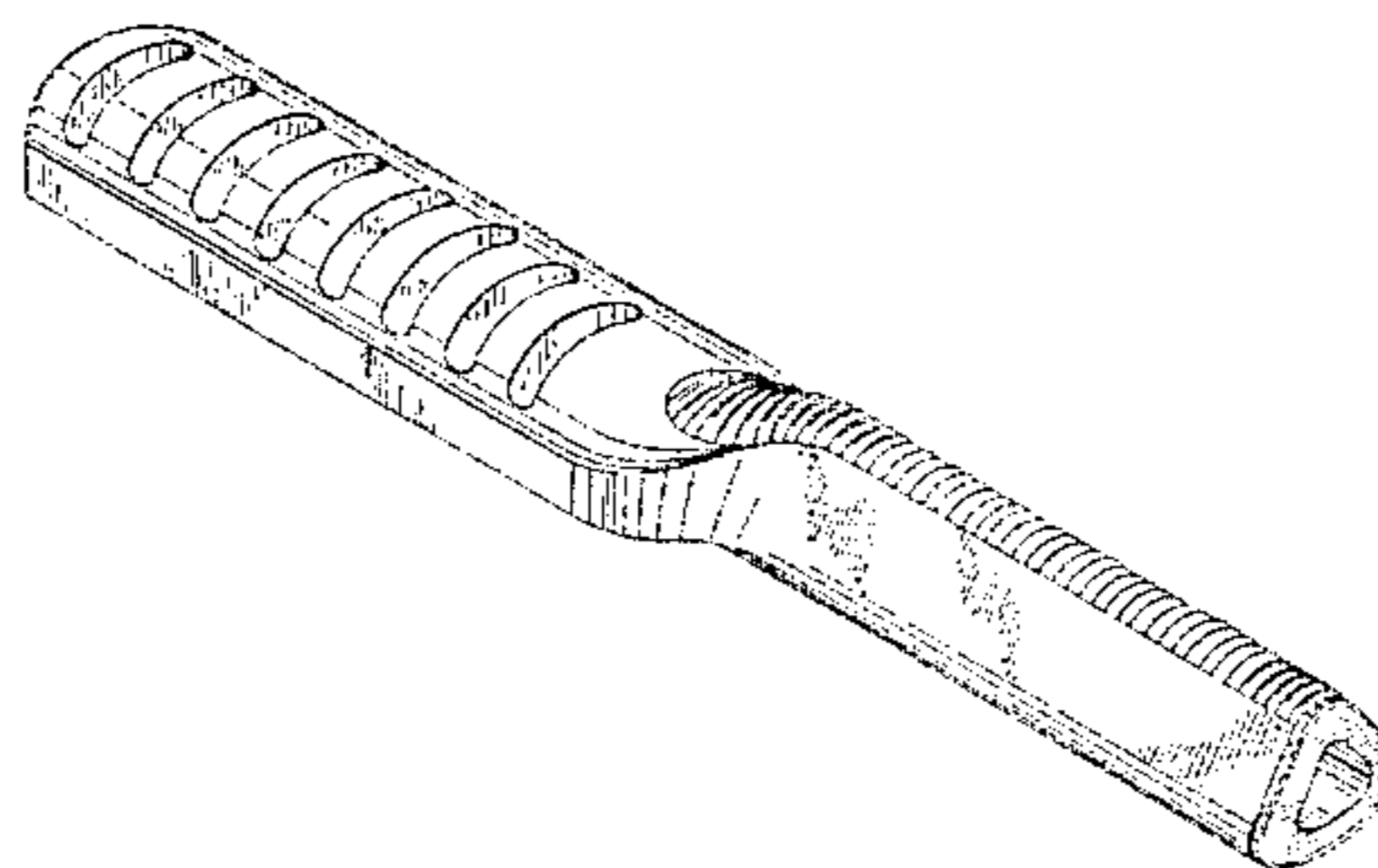
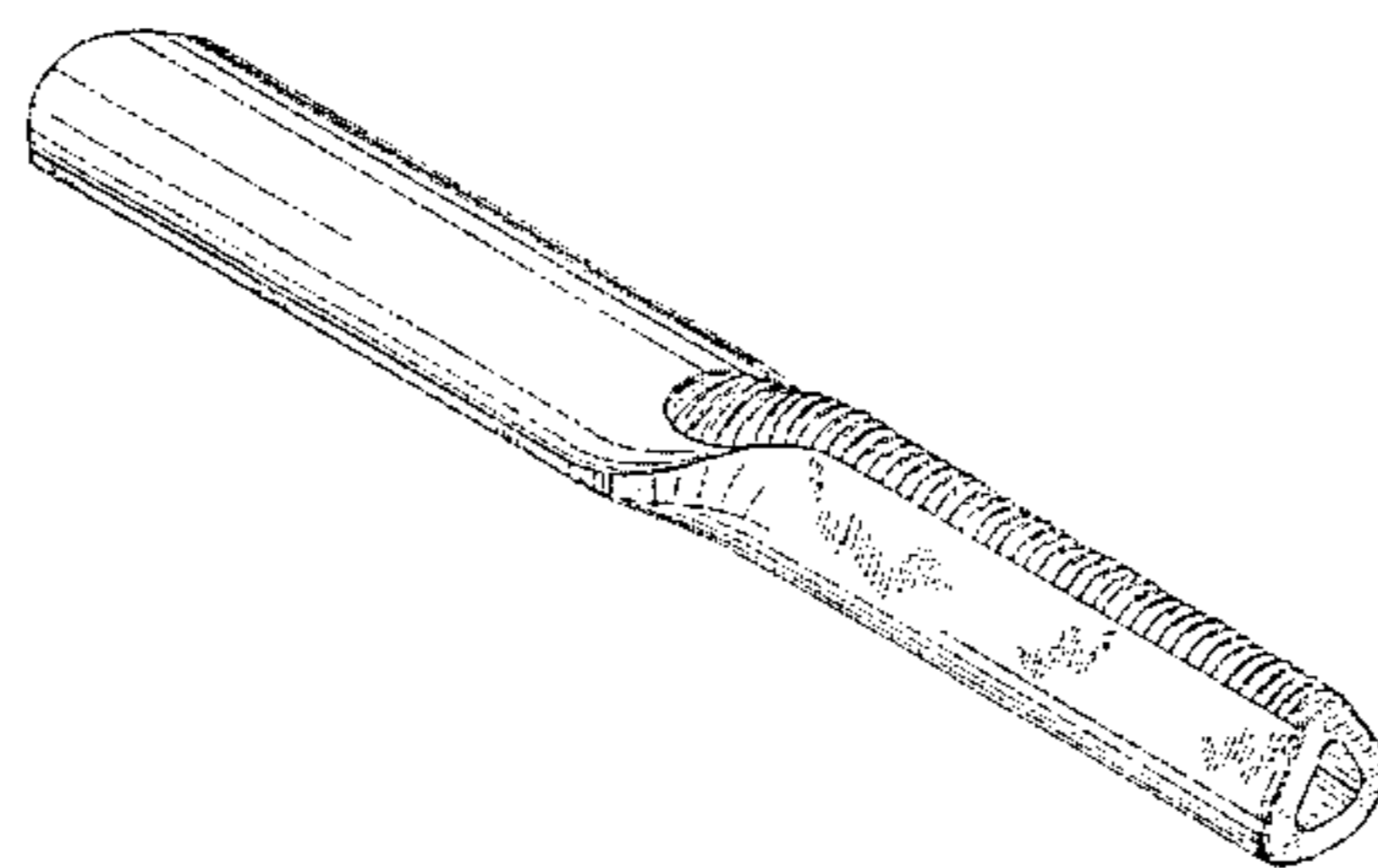

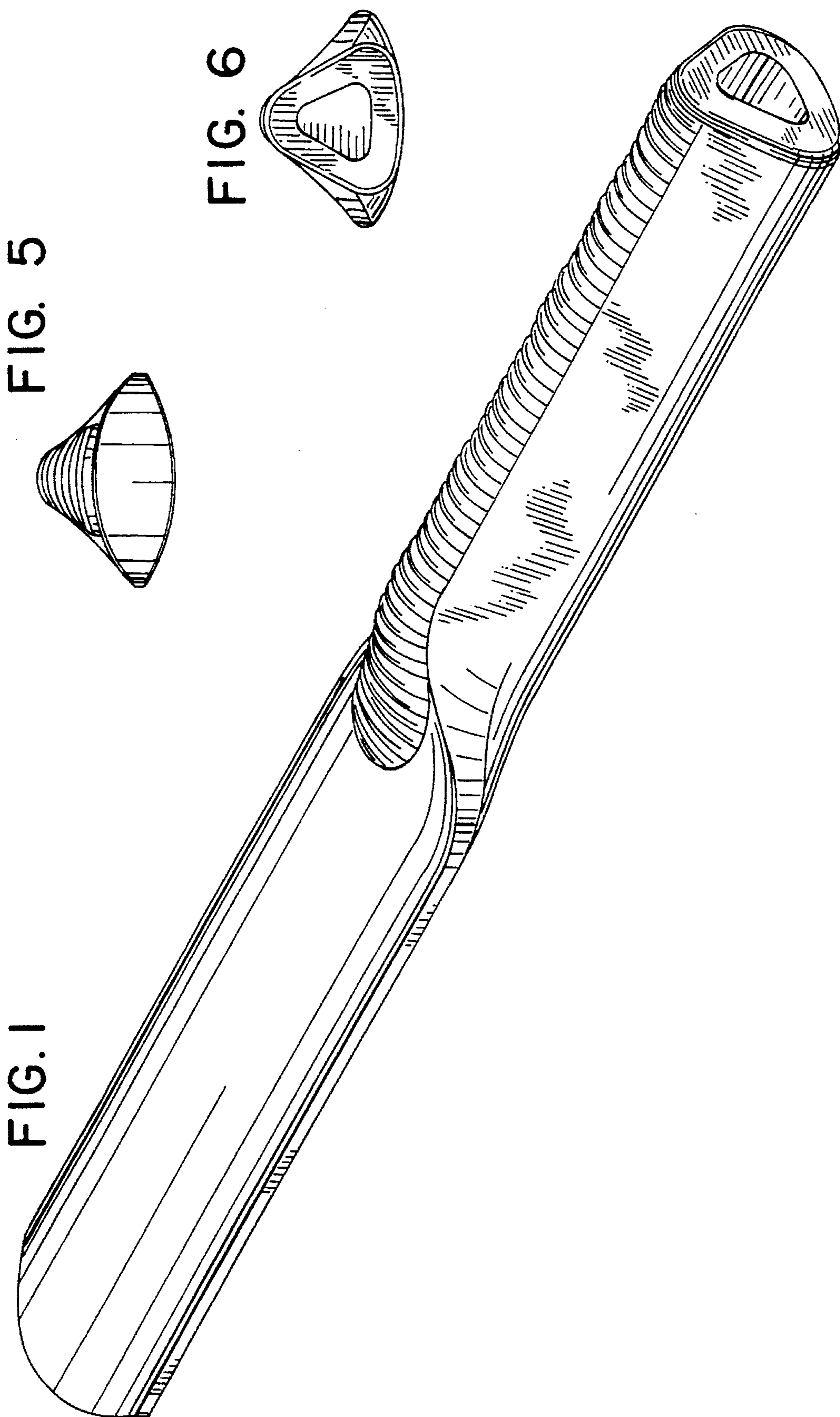

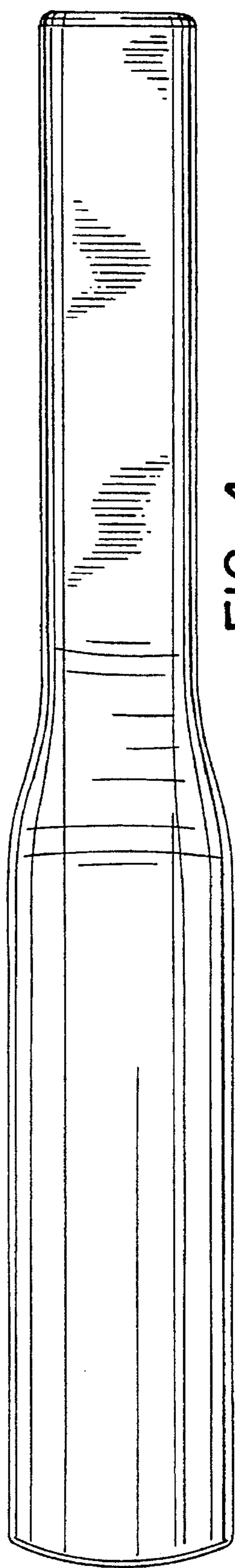
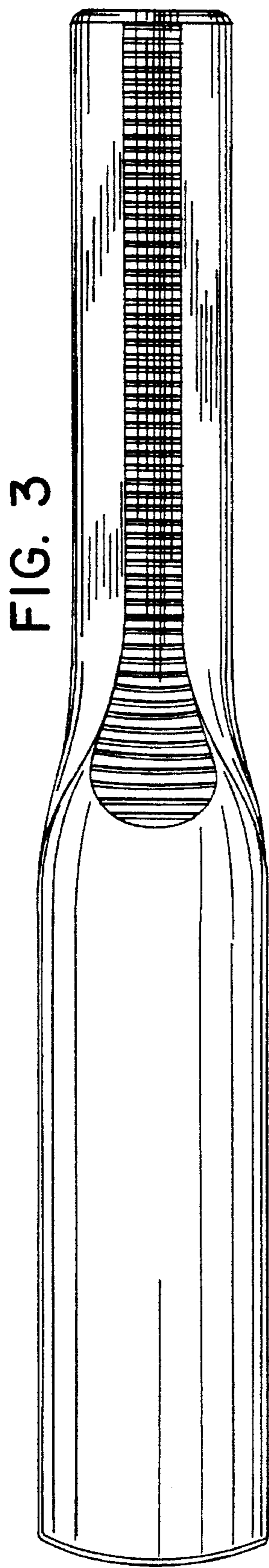
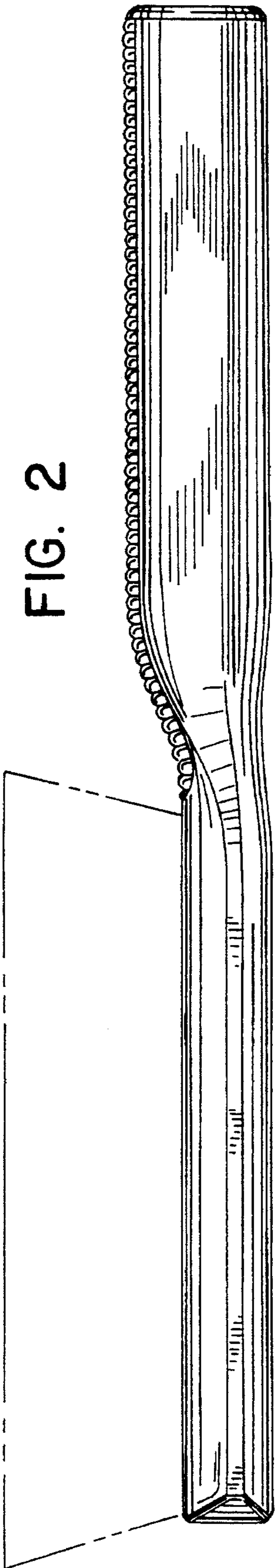

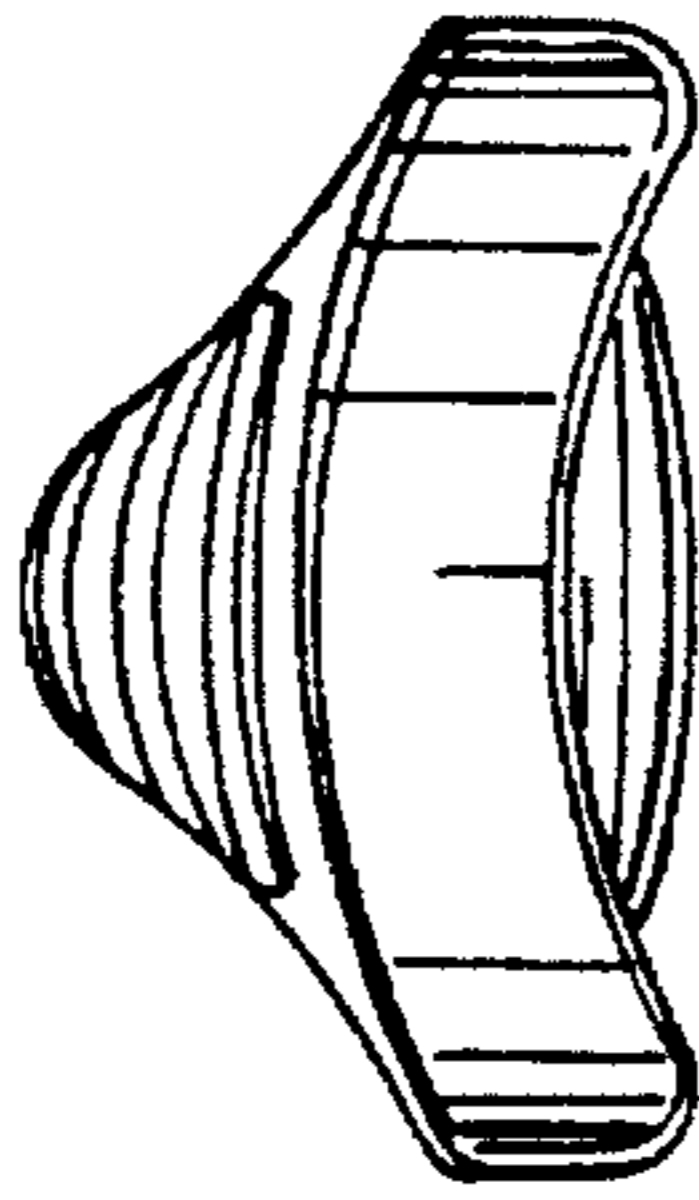

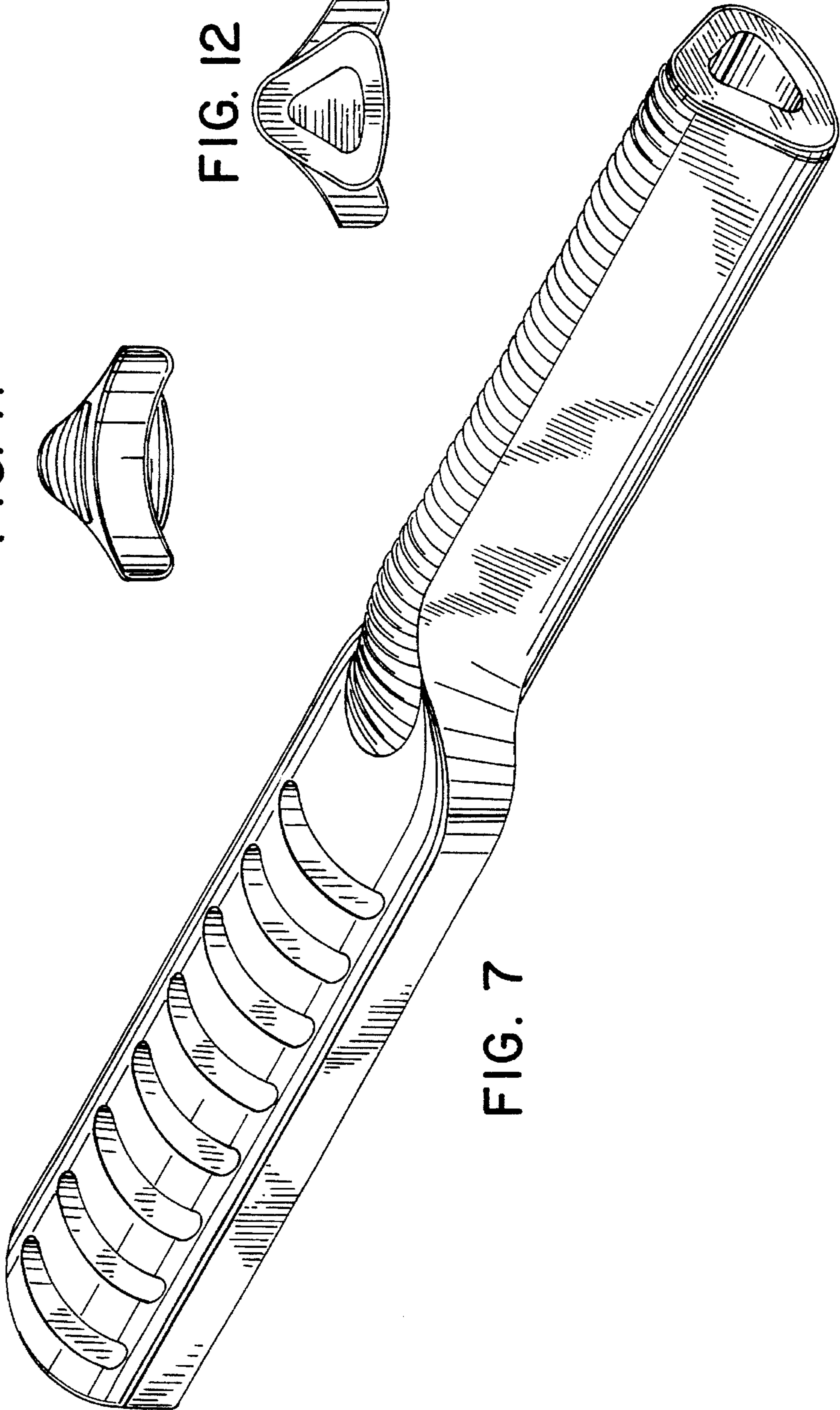
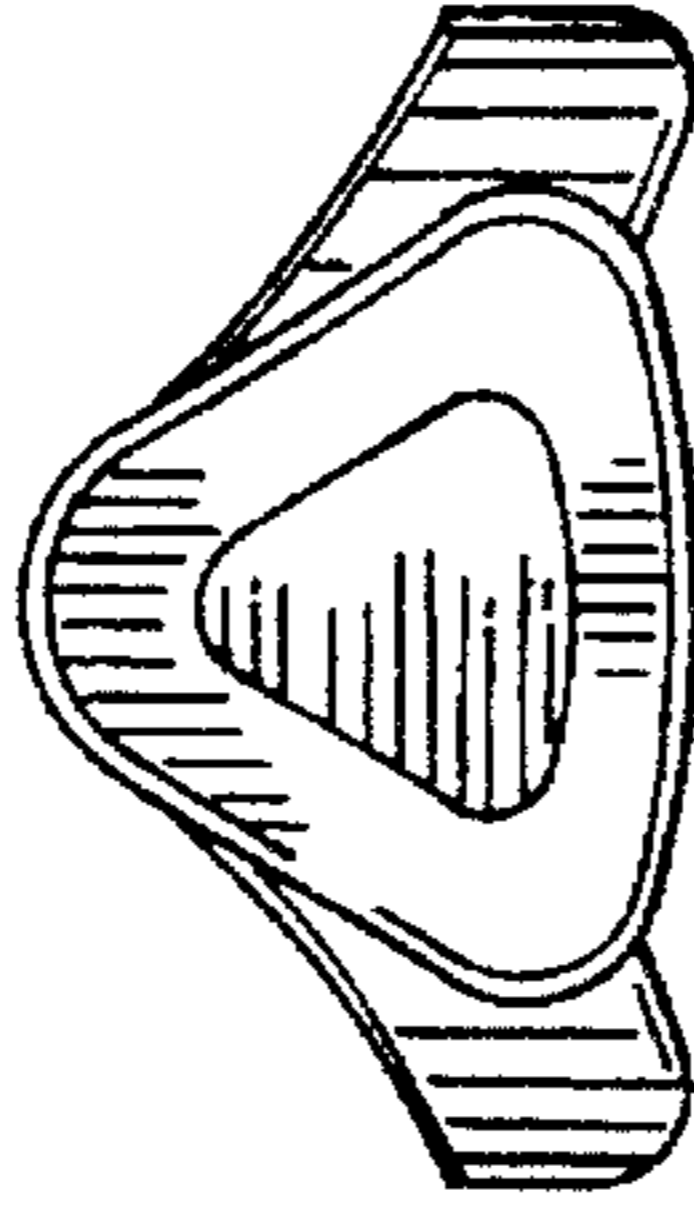

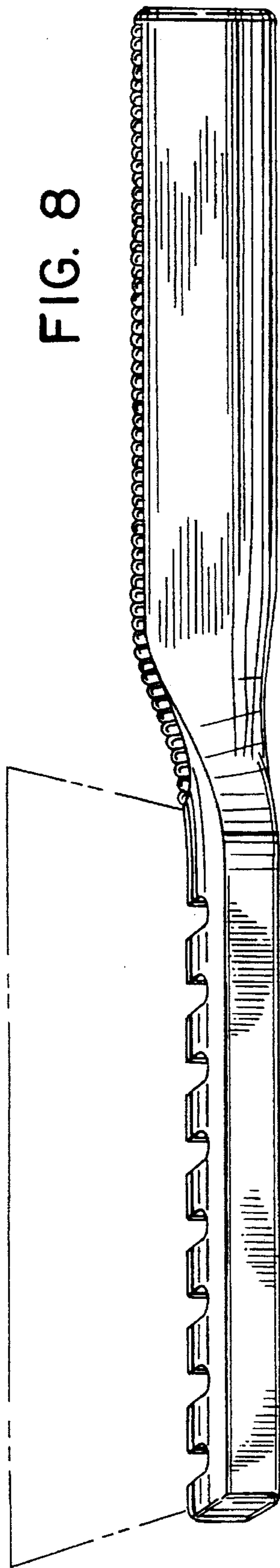

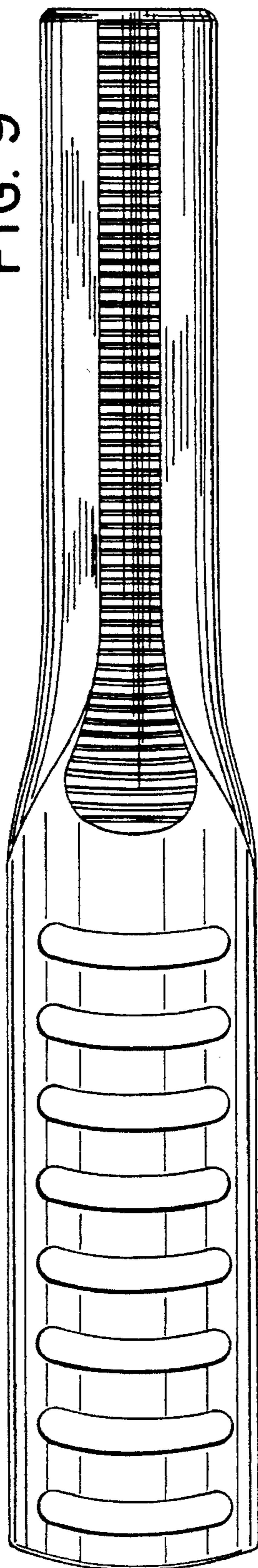

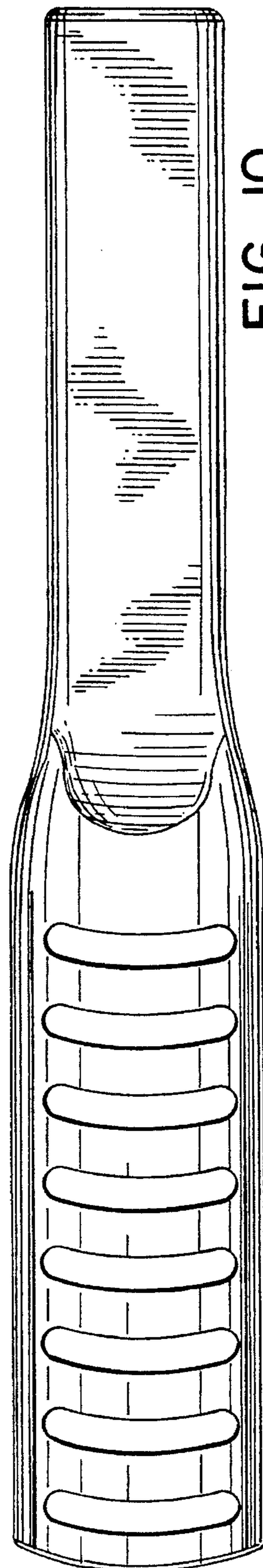

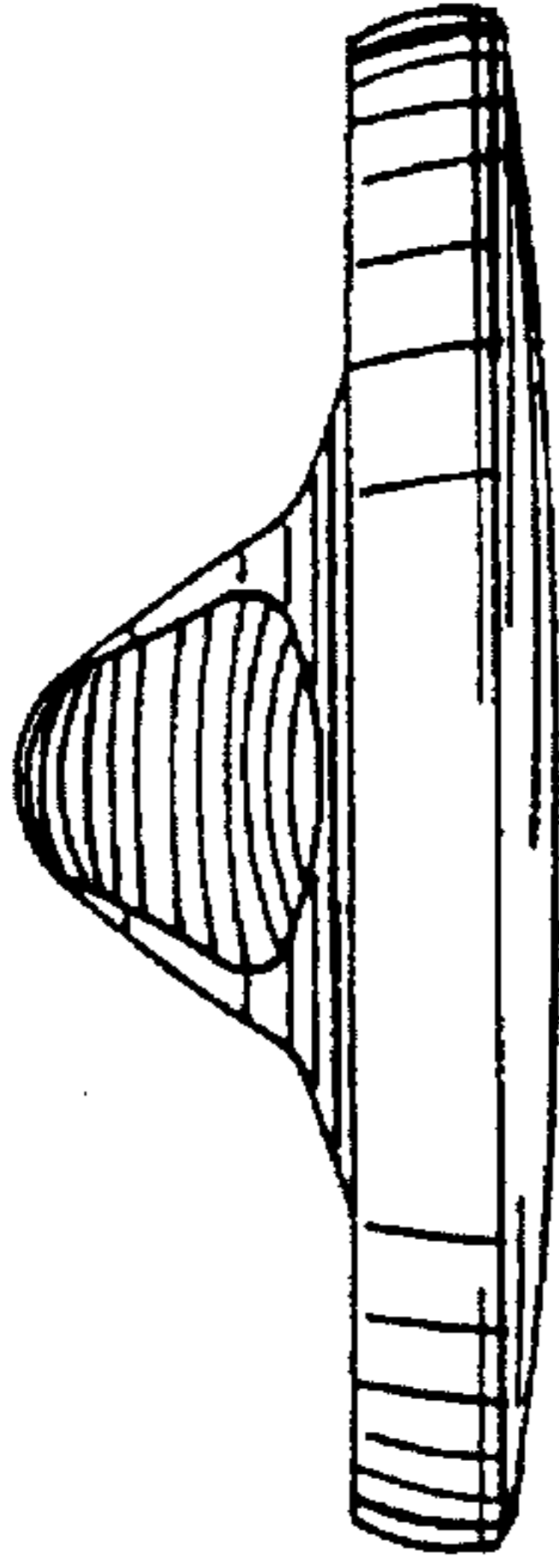

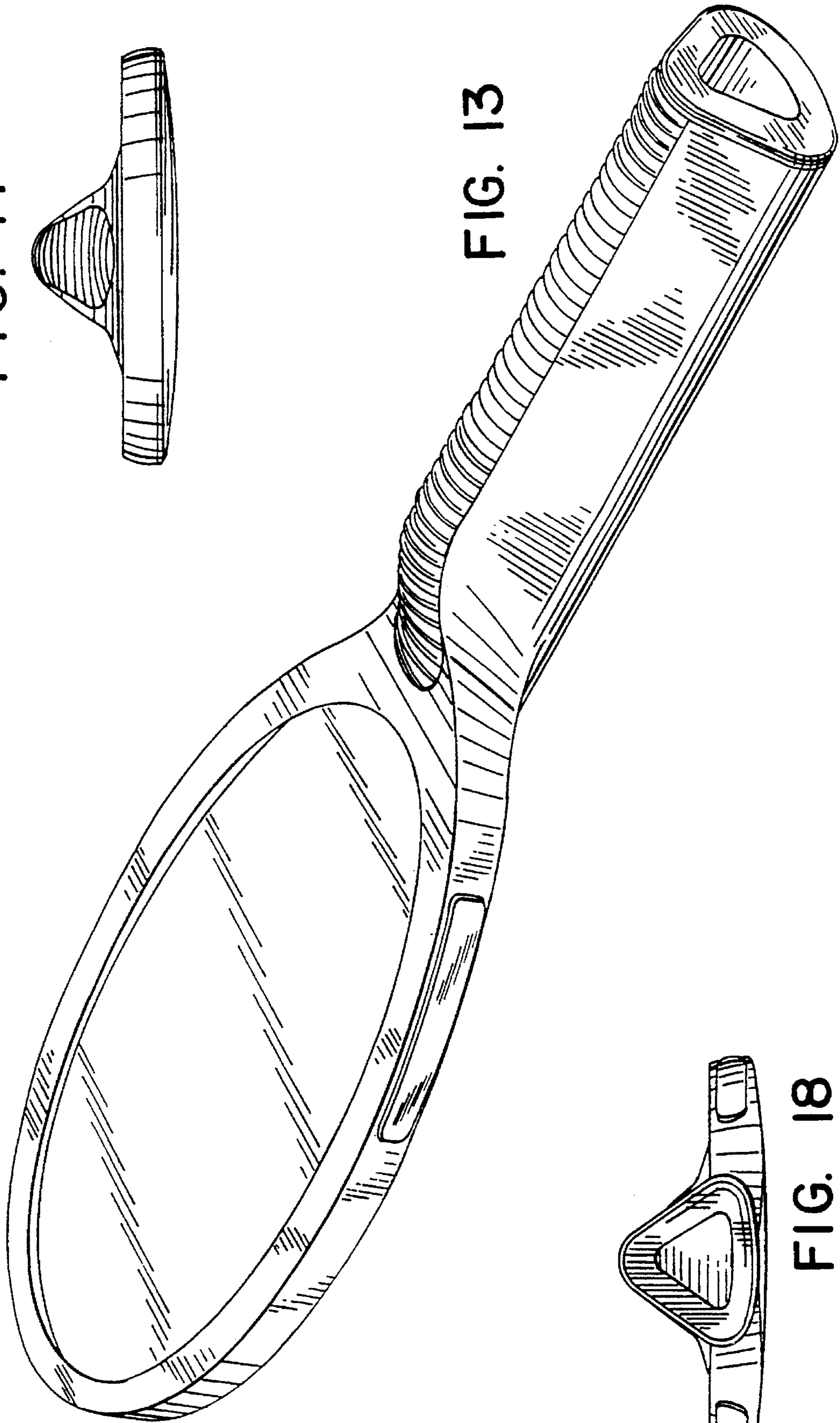

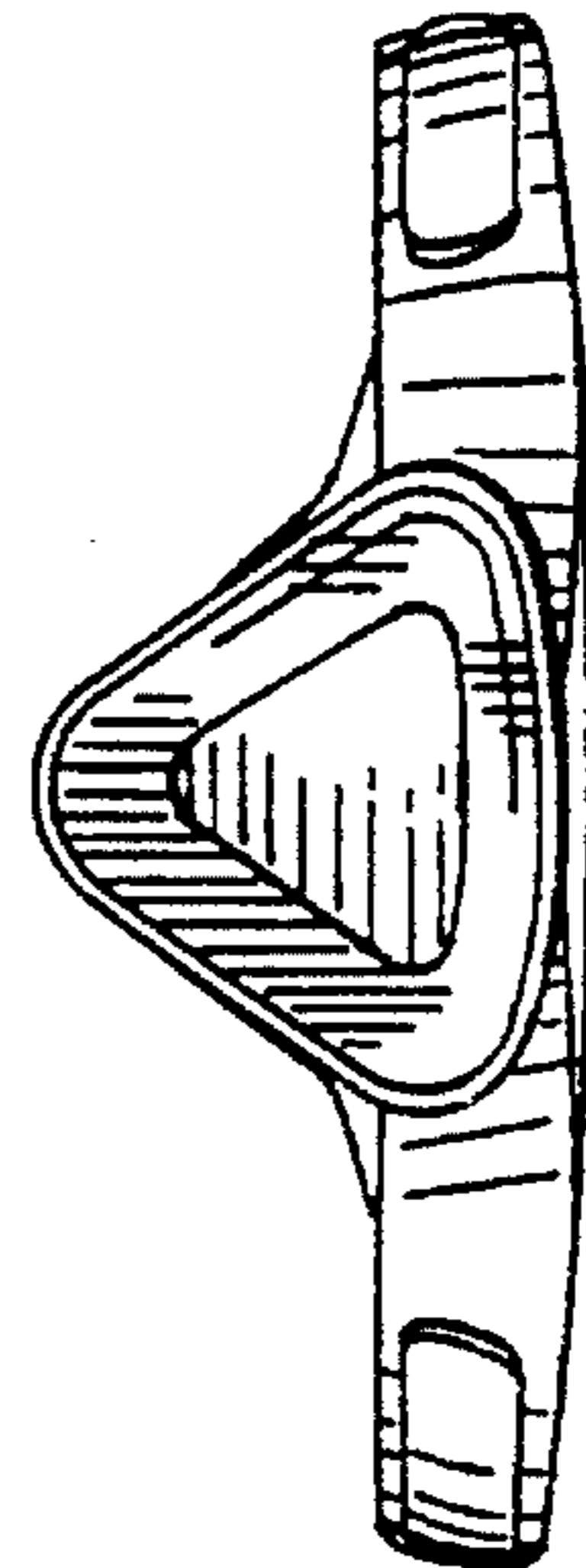

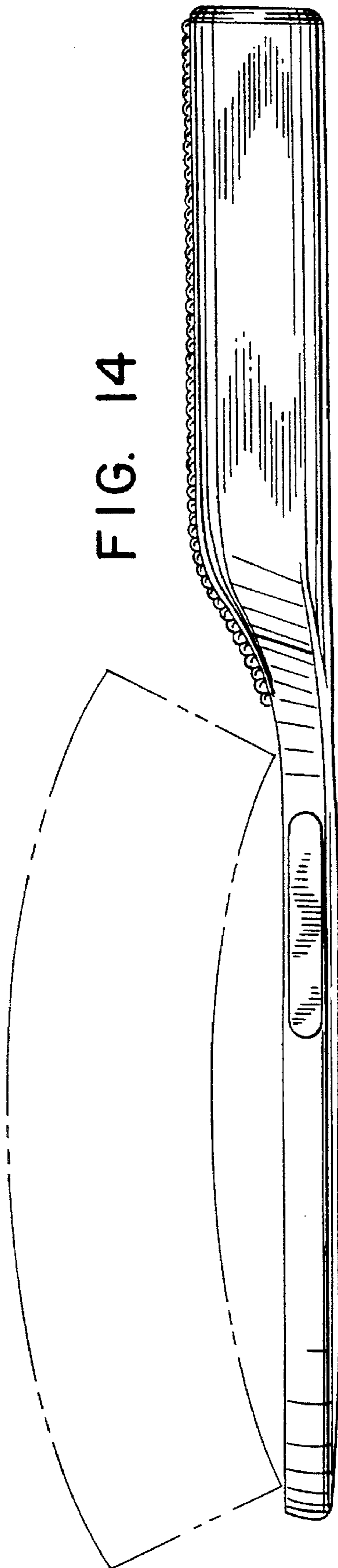

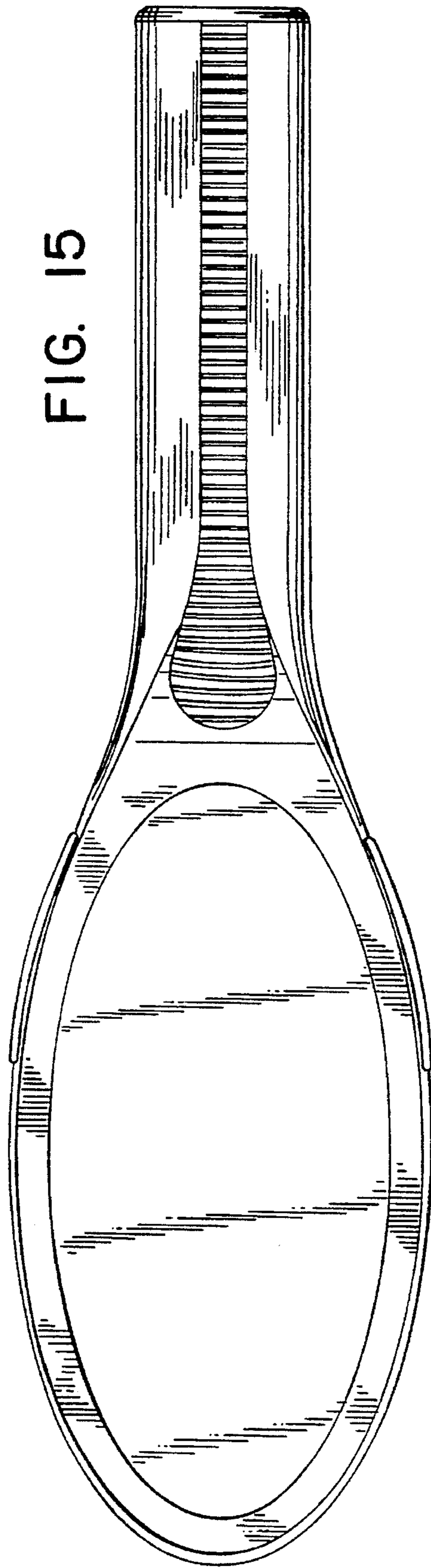
