DESCRIPTION

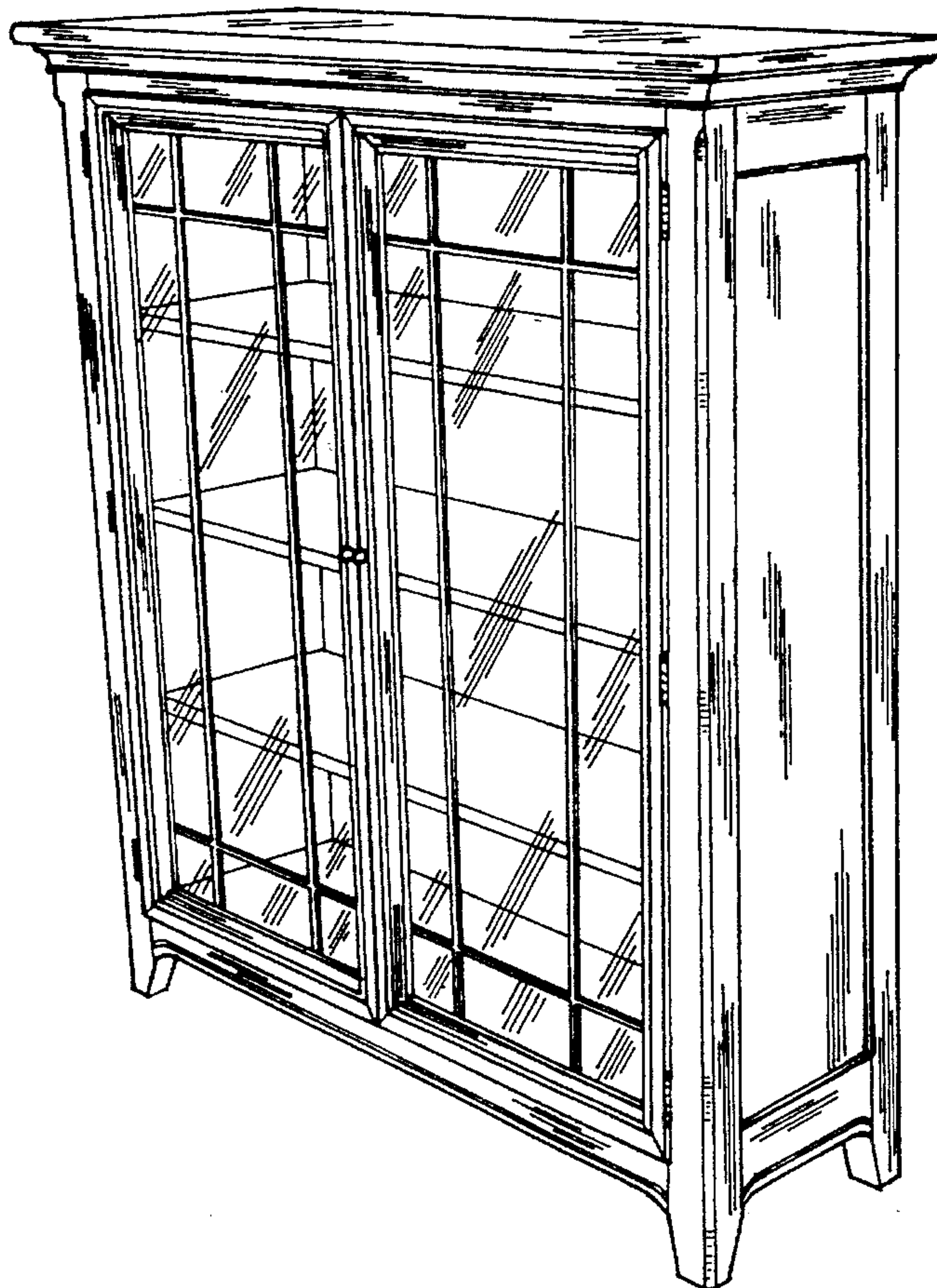
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a bookcase showing our new design;

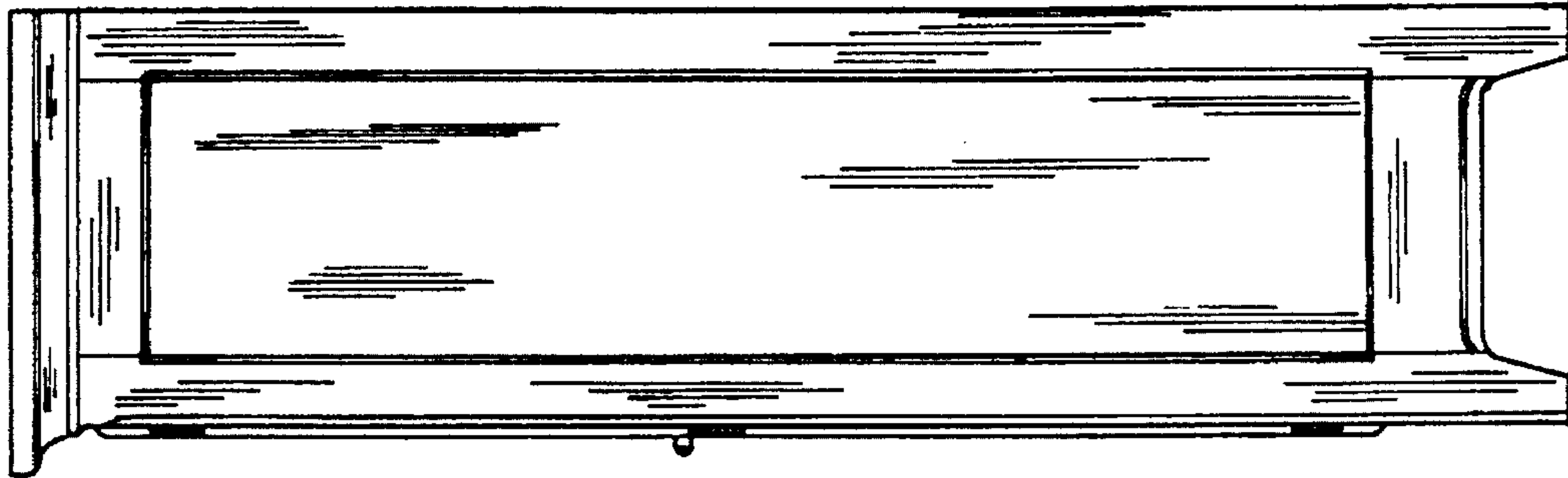

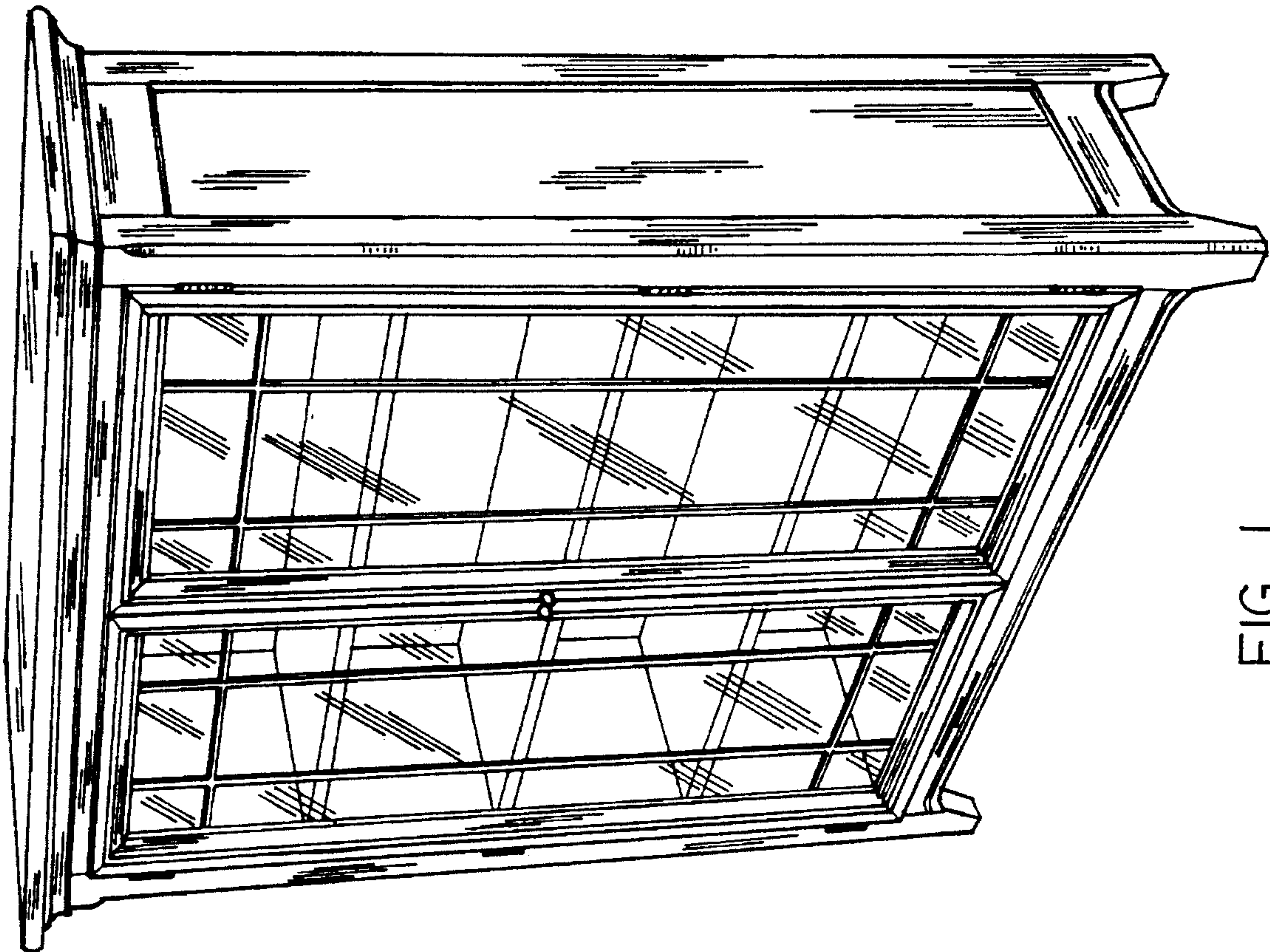

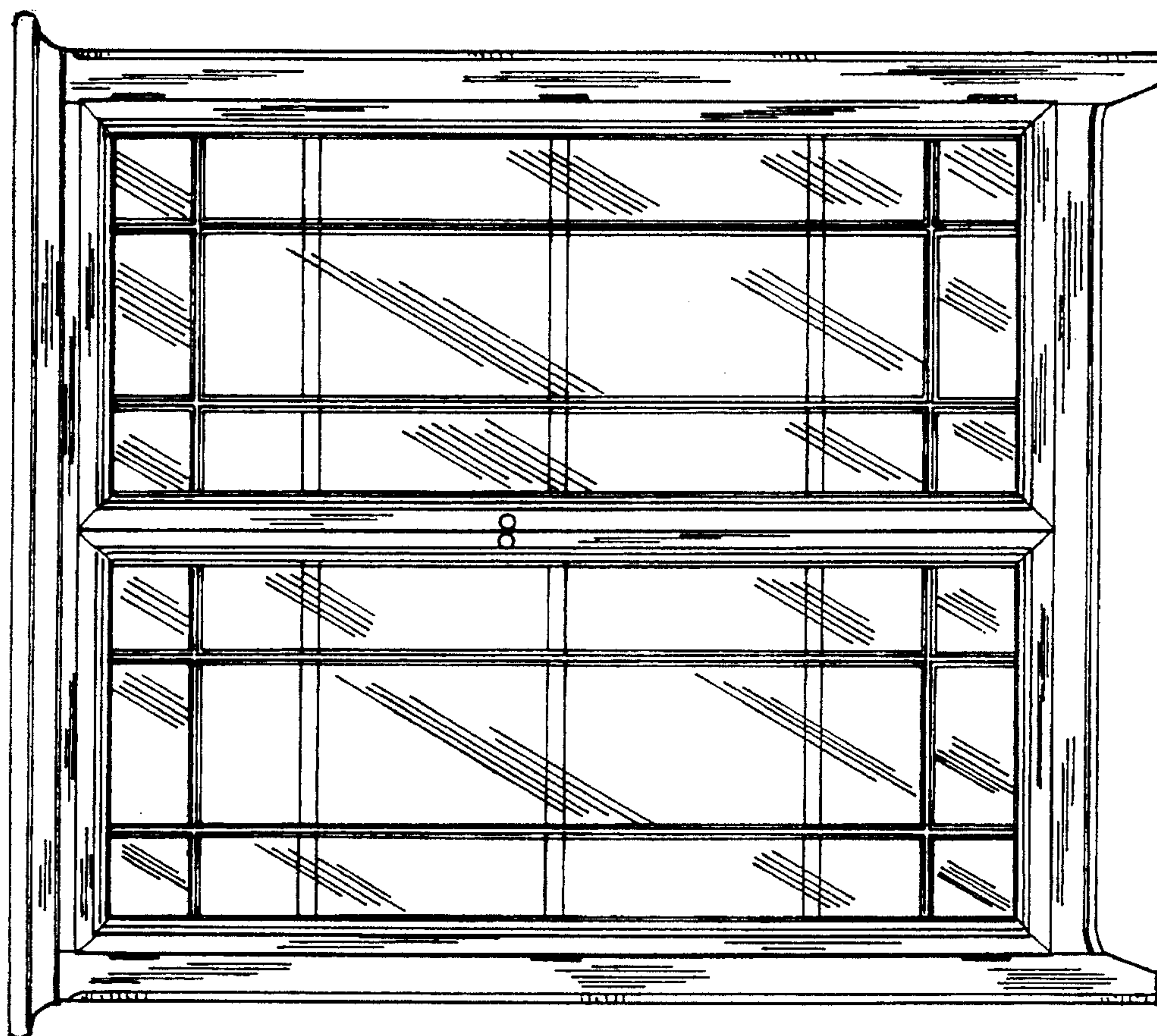

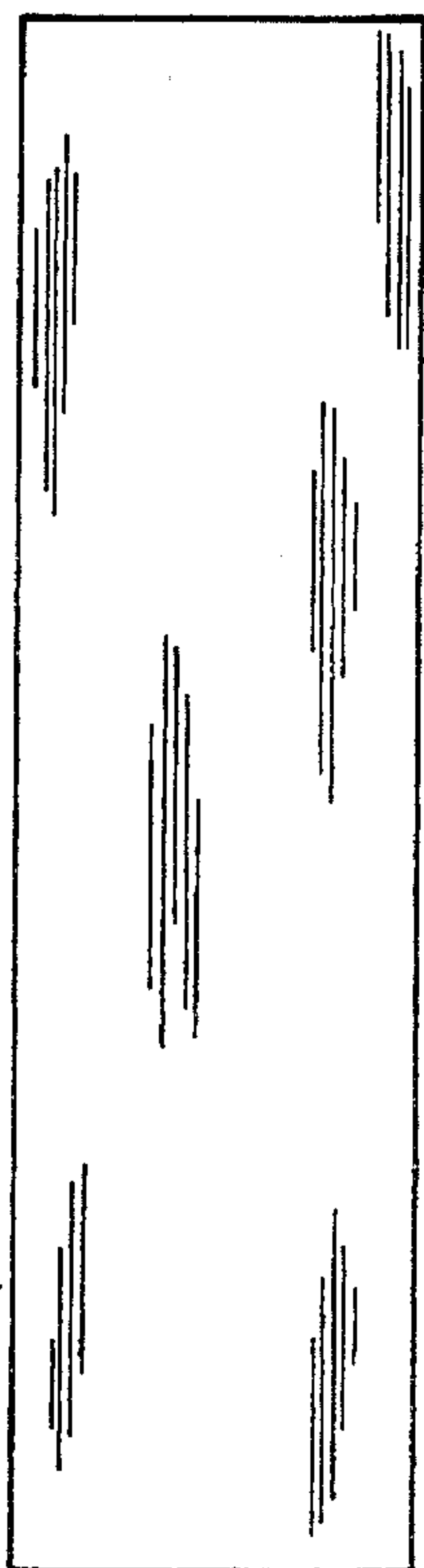
