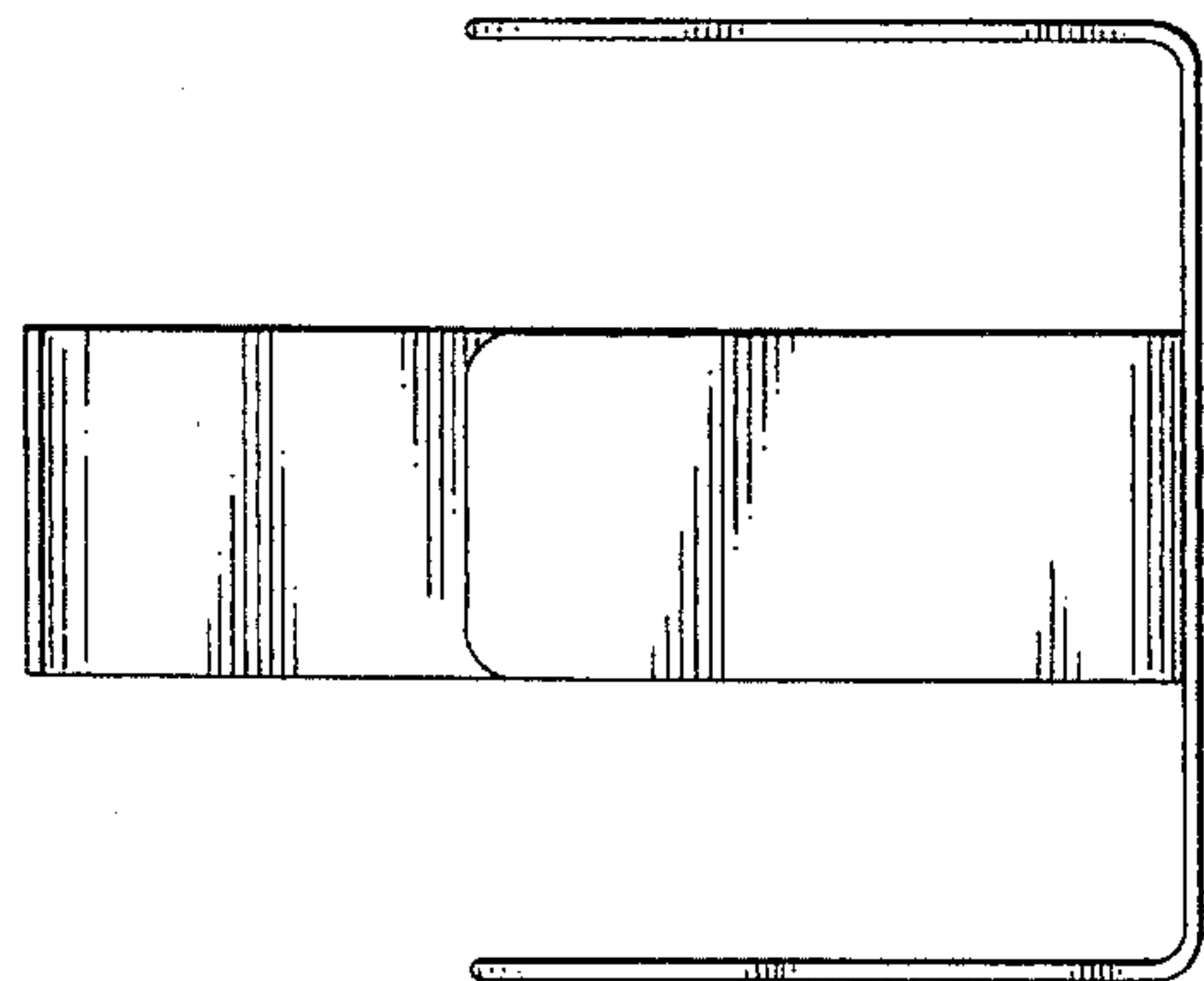
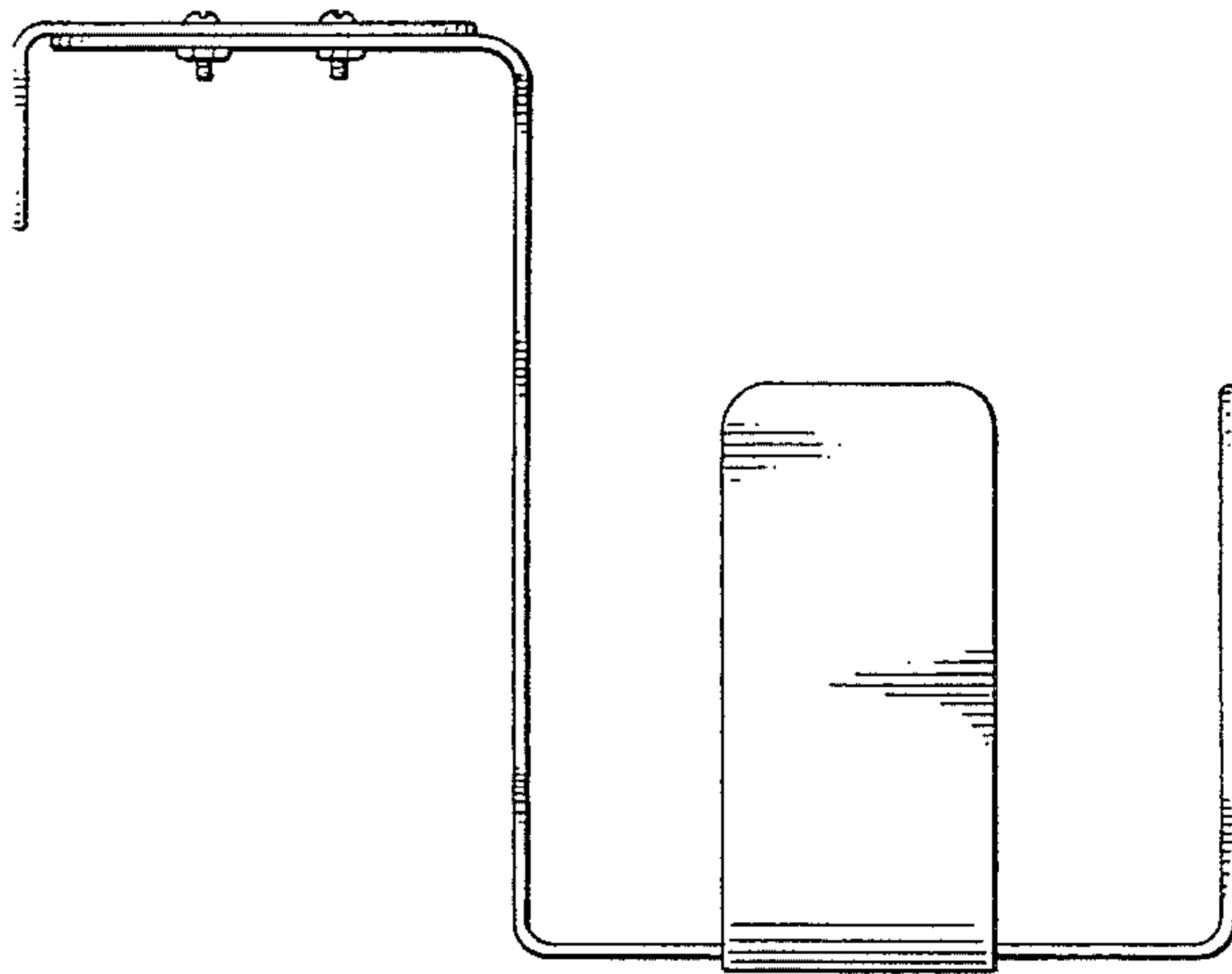
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the cup holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side-elevational view of the cup holder showing my new design; the opposite side being a mirror image; FIG. 2 is a front-elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear-elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a bottom-plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a top-plan view thereof, the beverage mug is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; FIG. 6 is a partial top-plan view of a readily adjustable extender clamp with a wing nut, the rest of the cup holder being identical to FIGS. 1-5; and, FIG. 7 is a side-elevational view of the partial view of the embodiment of FIG. 6.

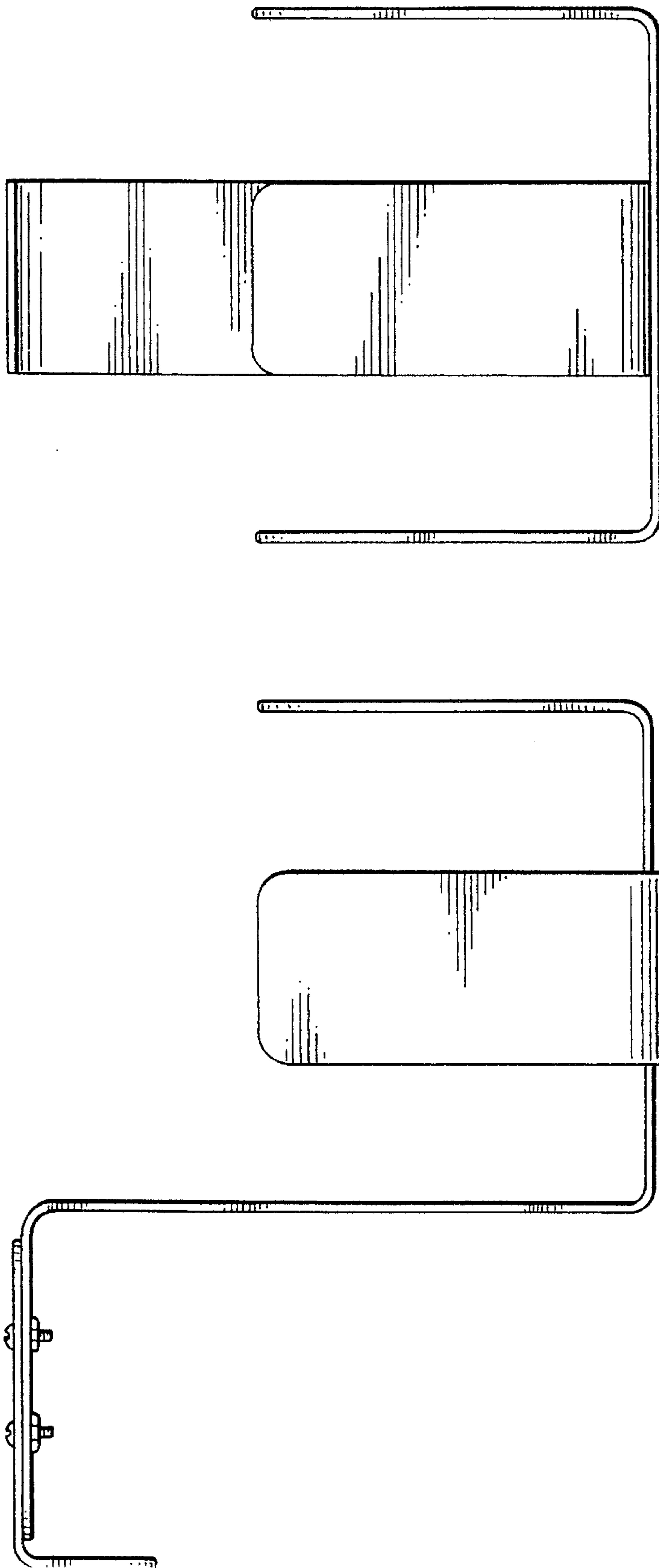

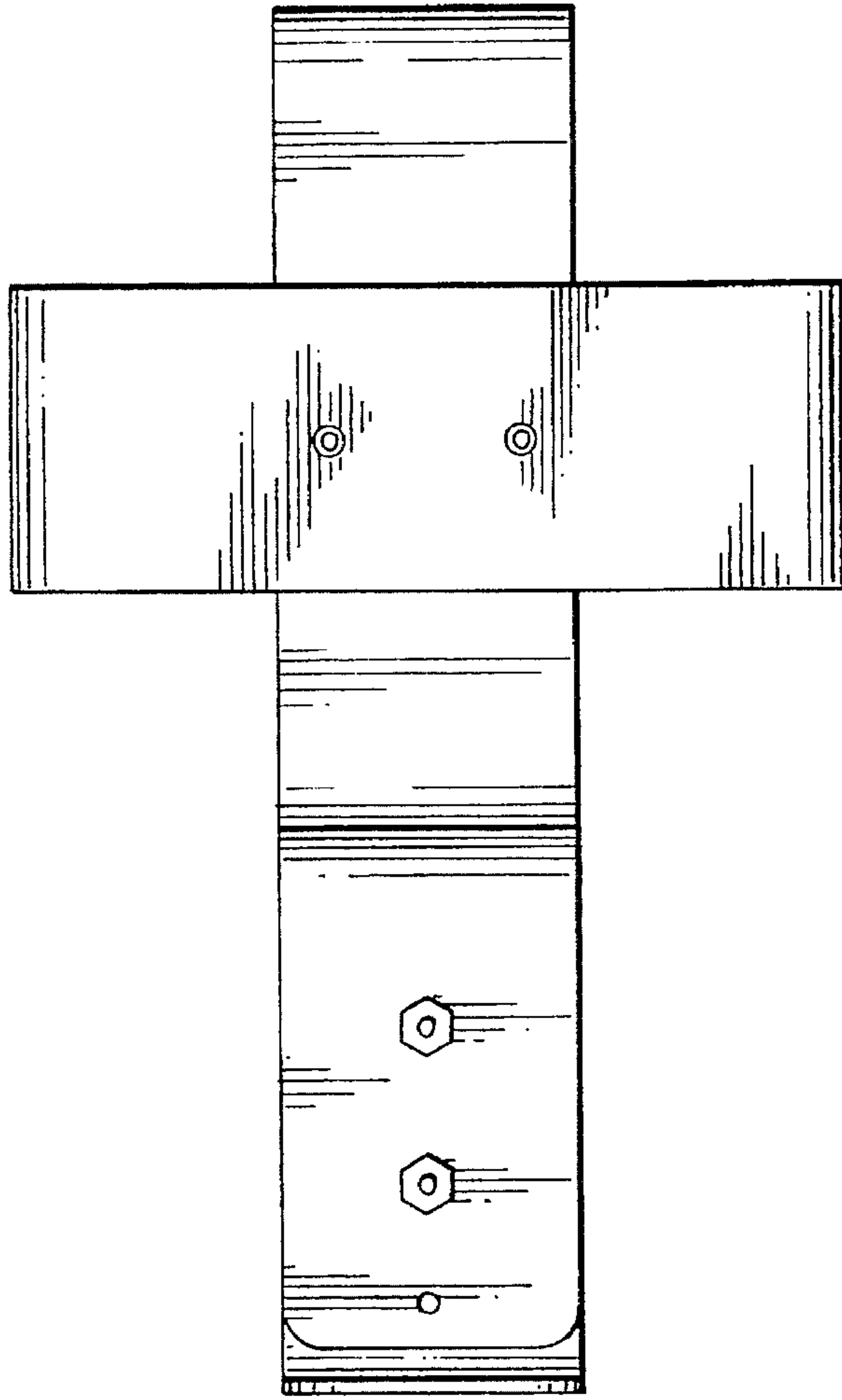

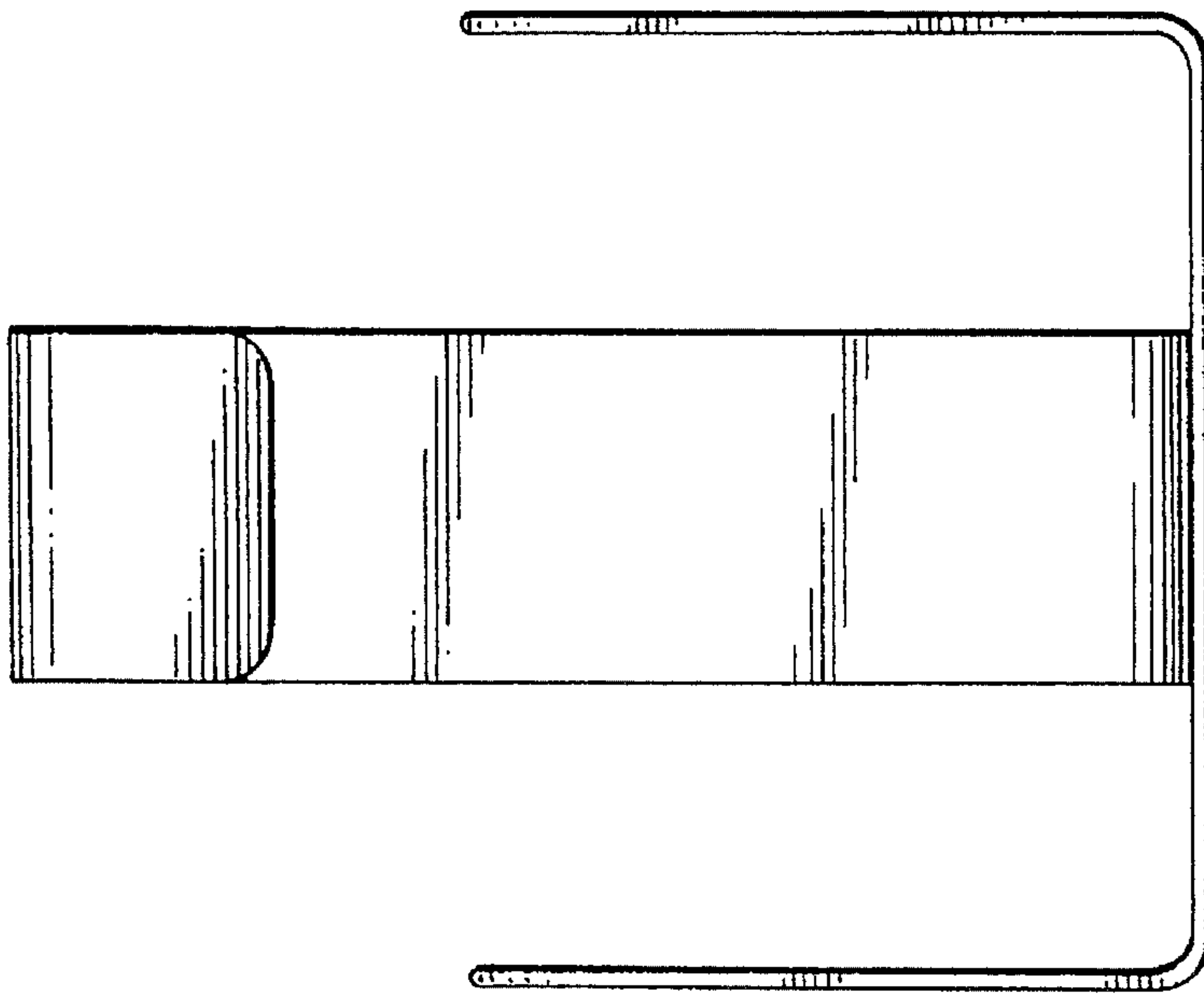

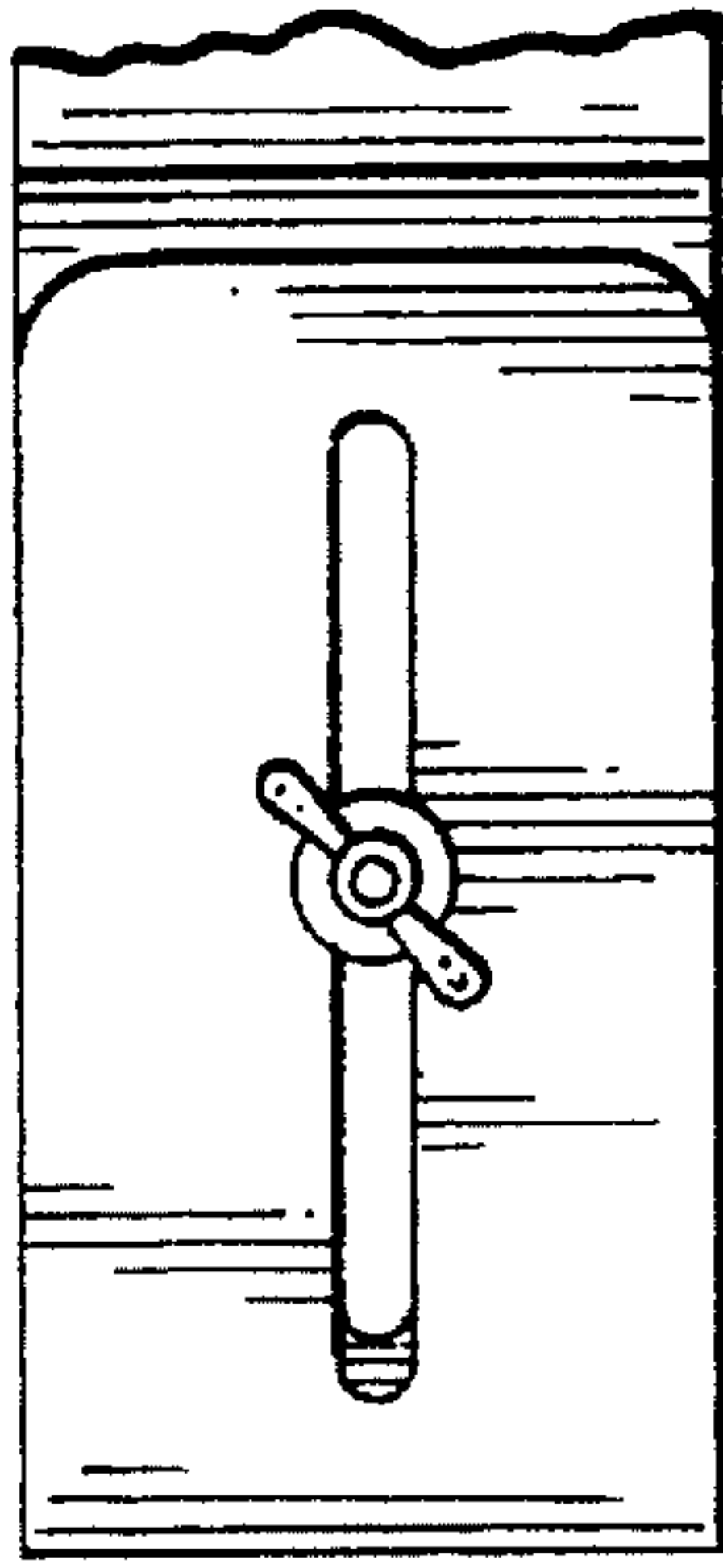

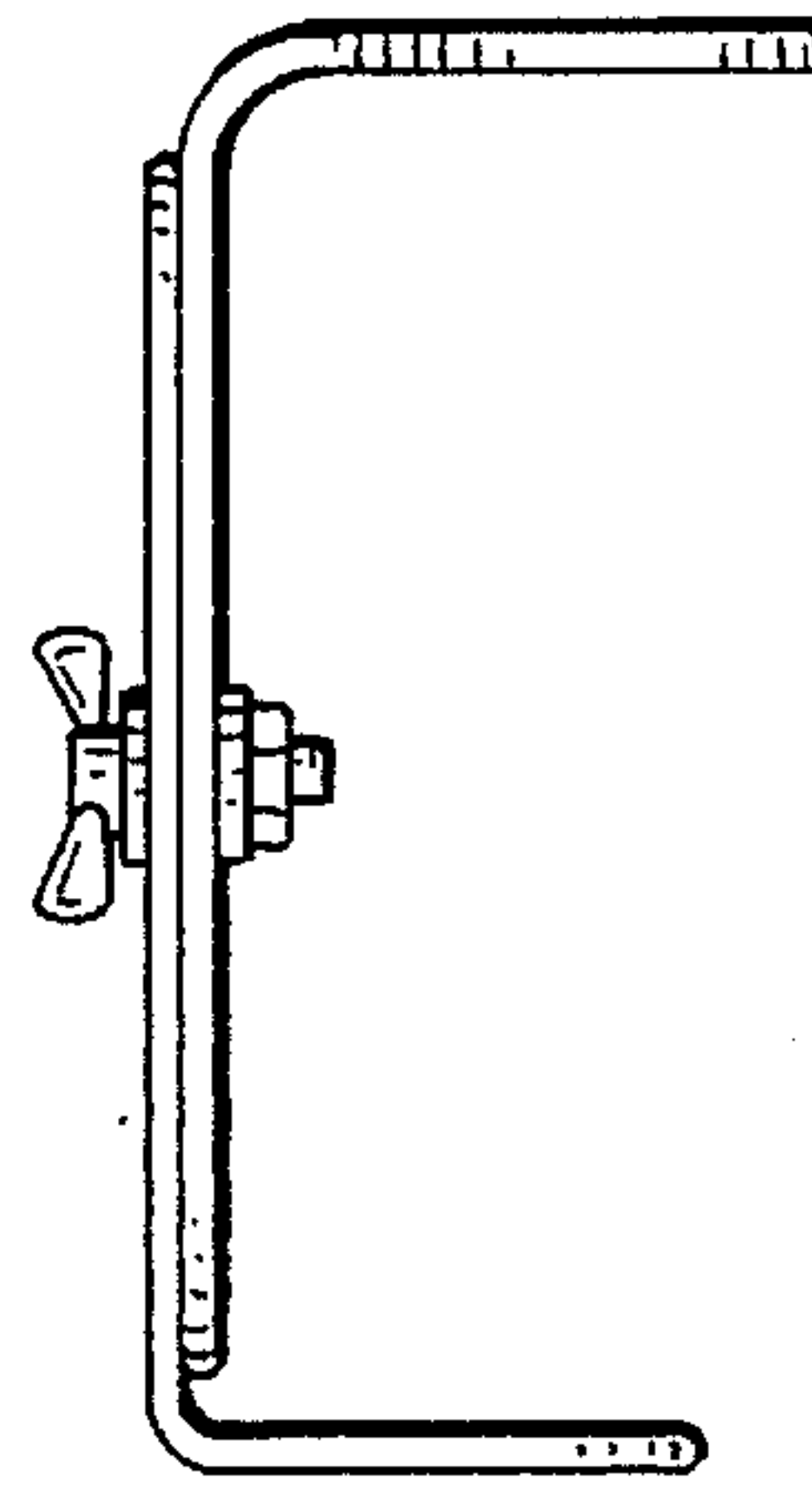

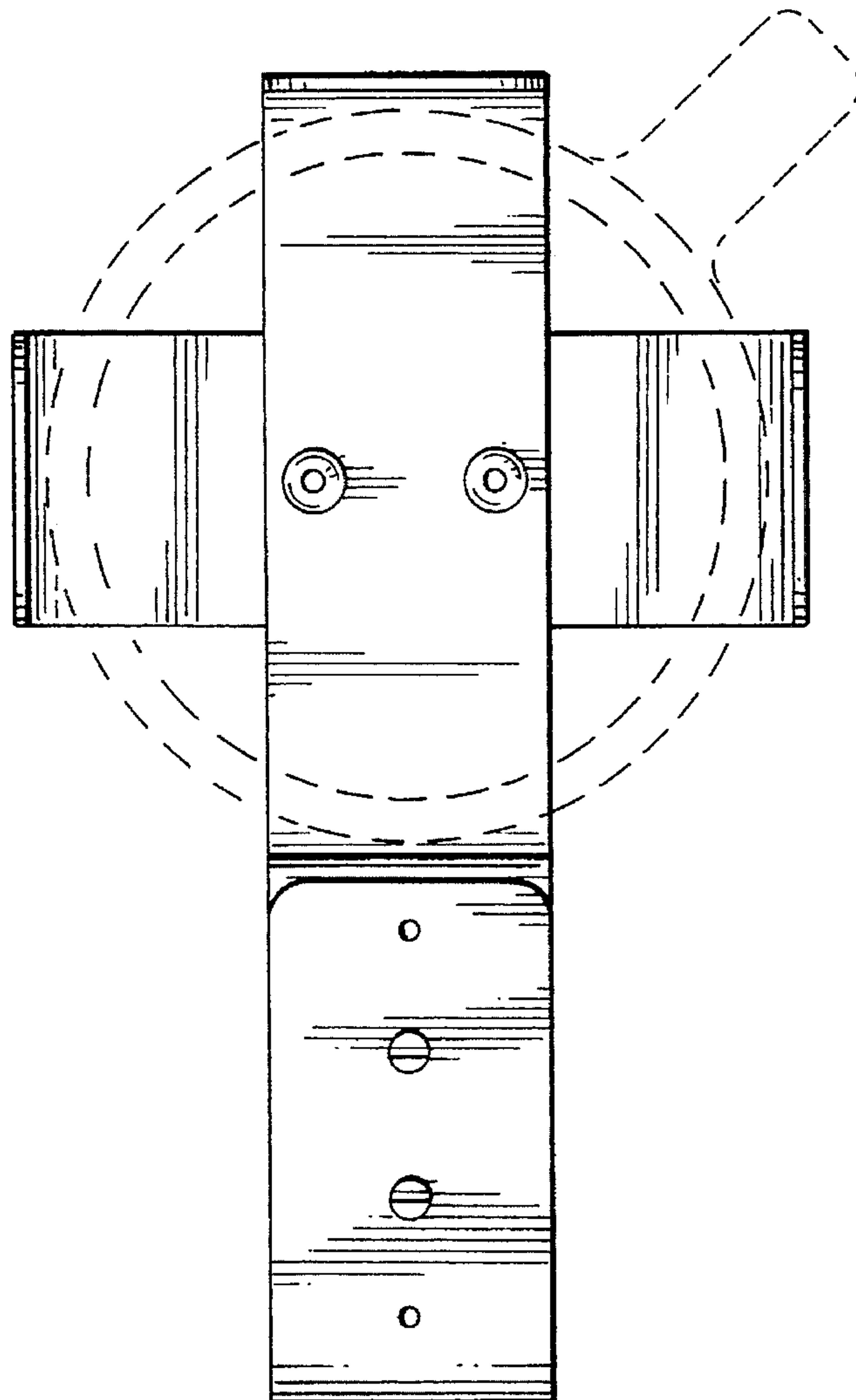
