DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a computer monitor memorandum board of the present invention, on a reduced scale, the broken line drawing of a computer monitor is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the memoboard of the present invention;

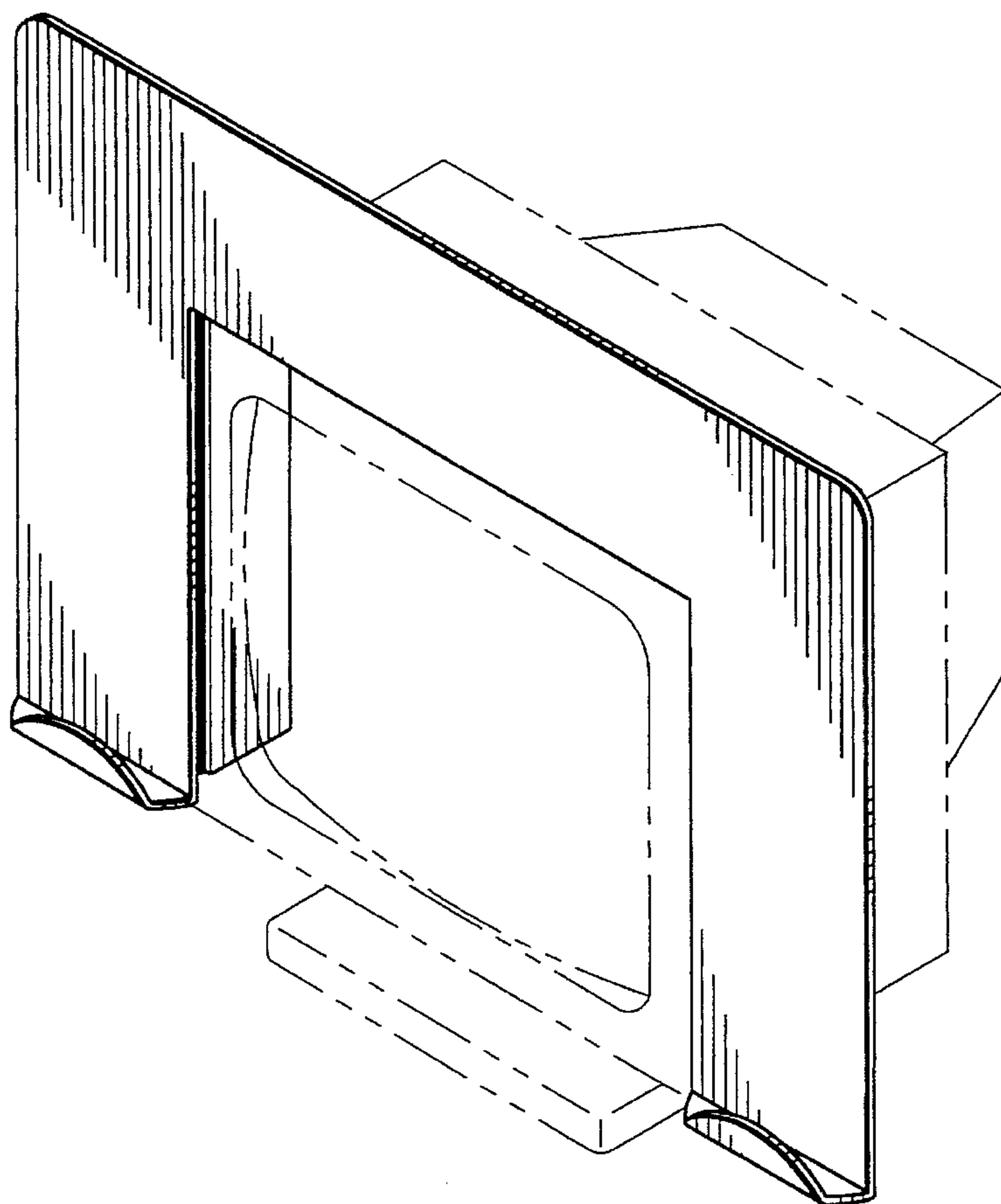
FIG. 3 is a front view of the memoboard of the present invention;

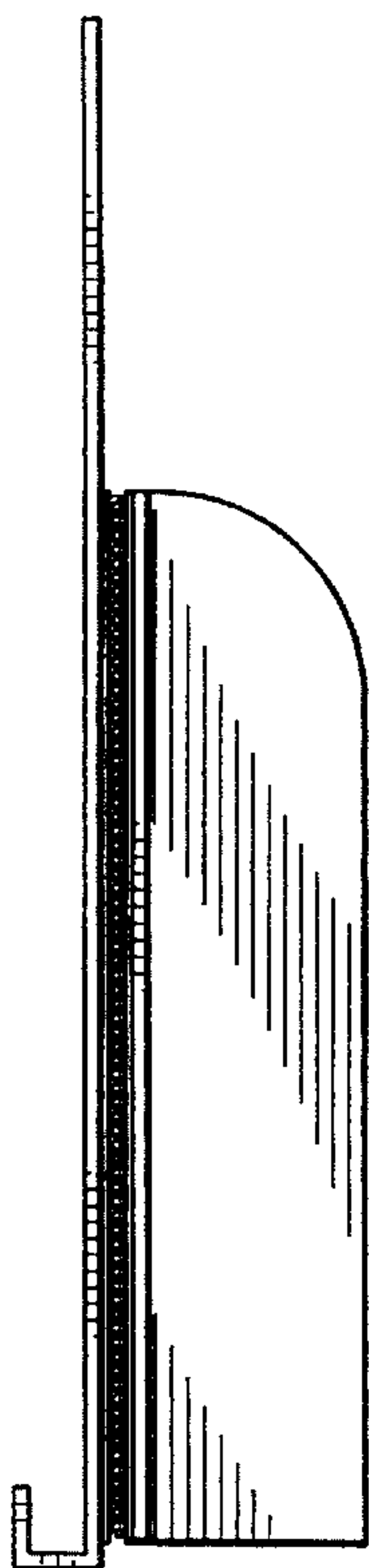

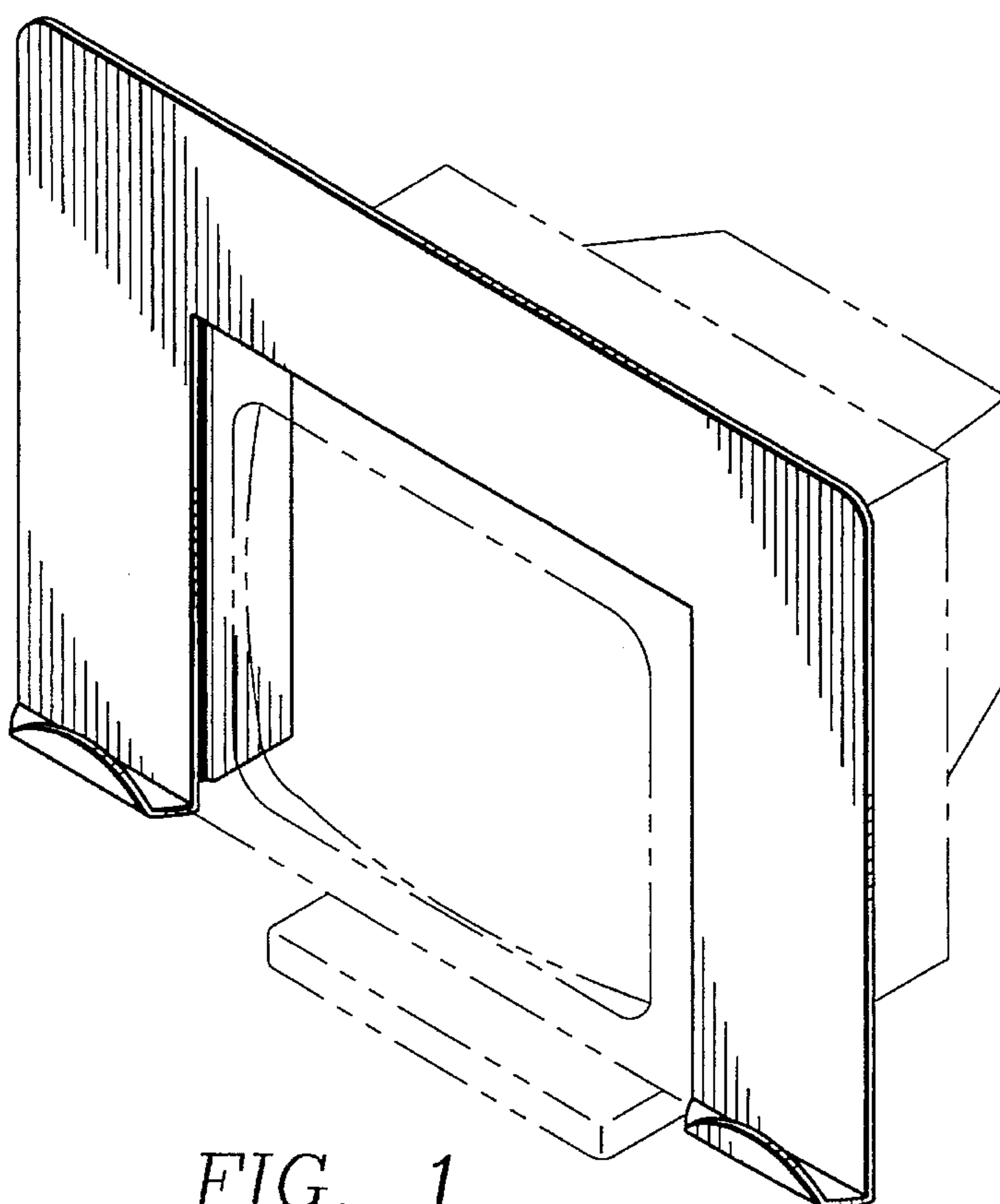

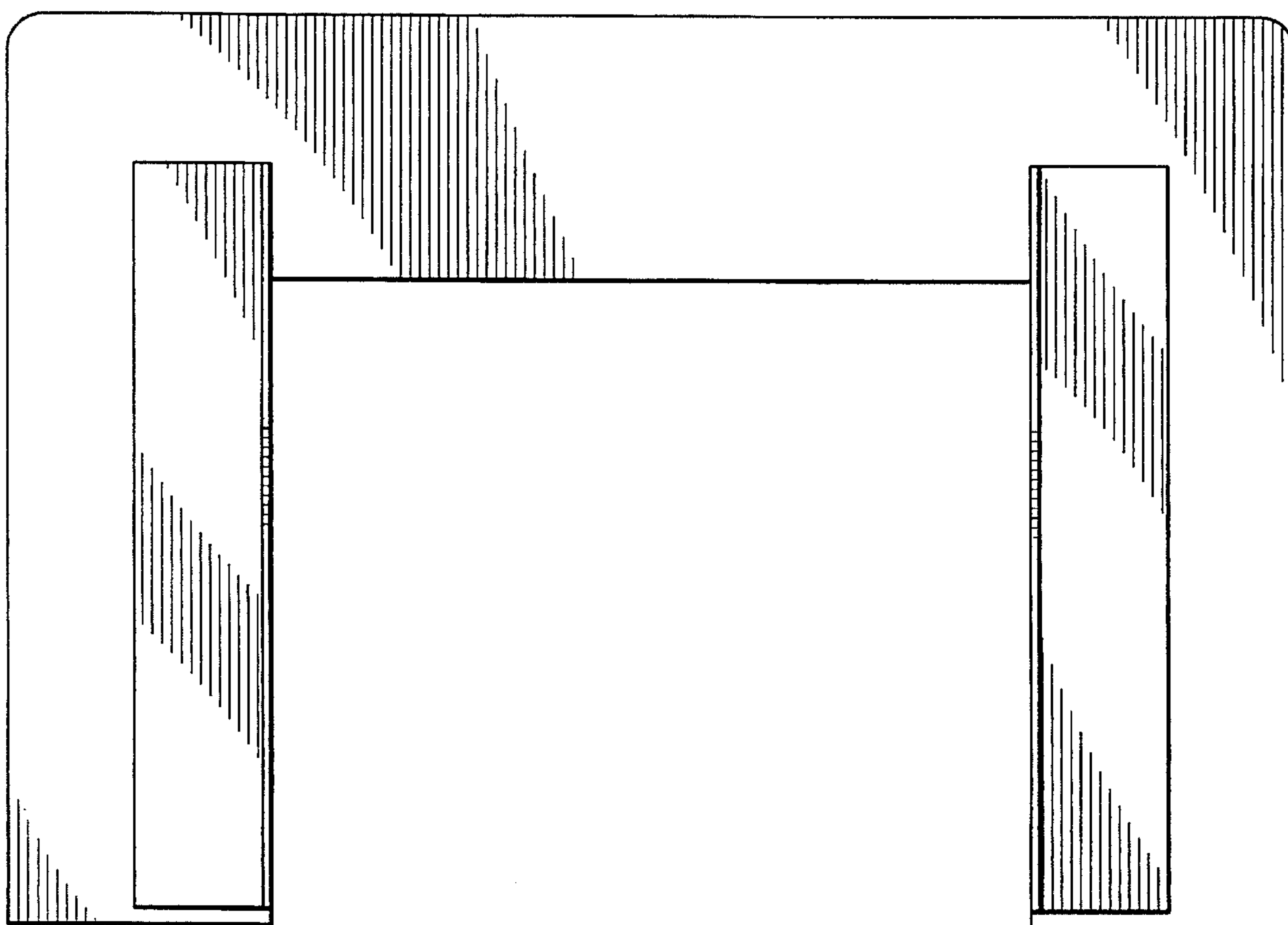

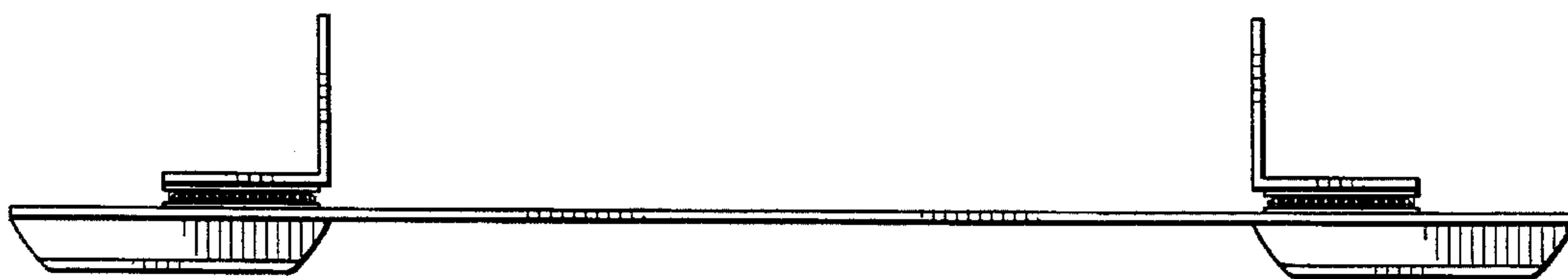

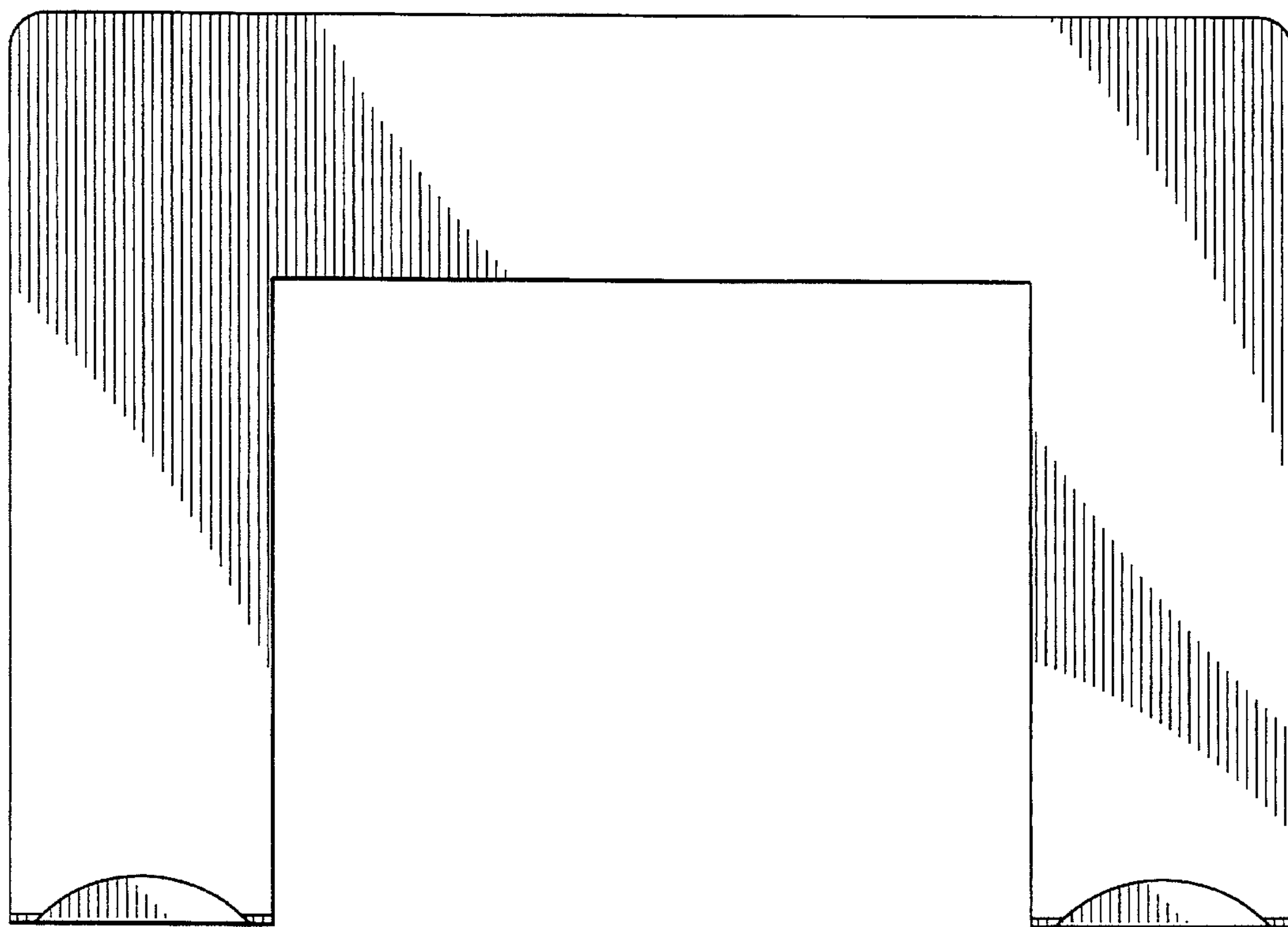

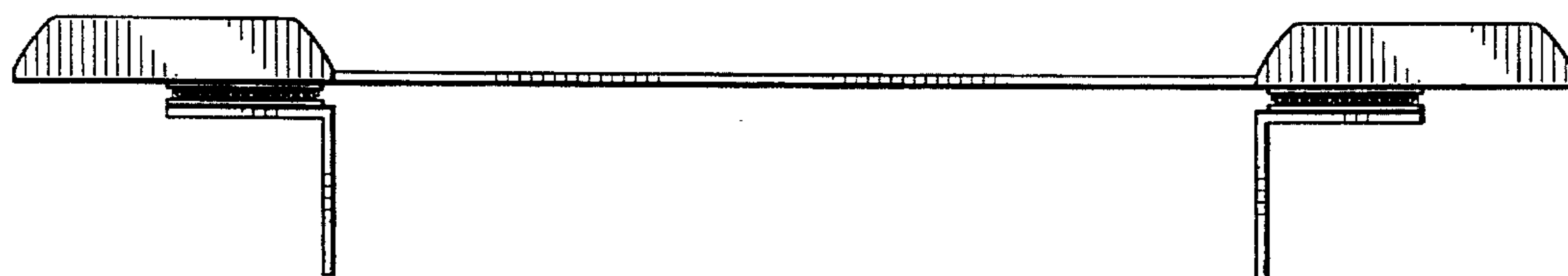
