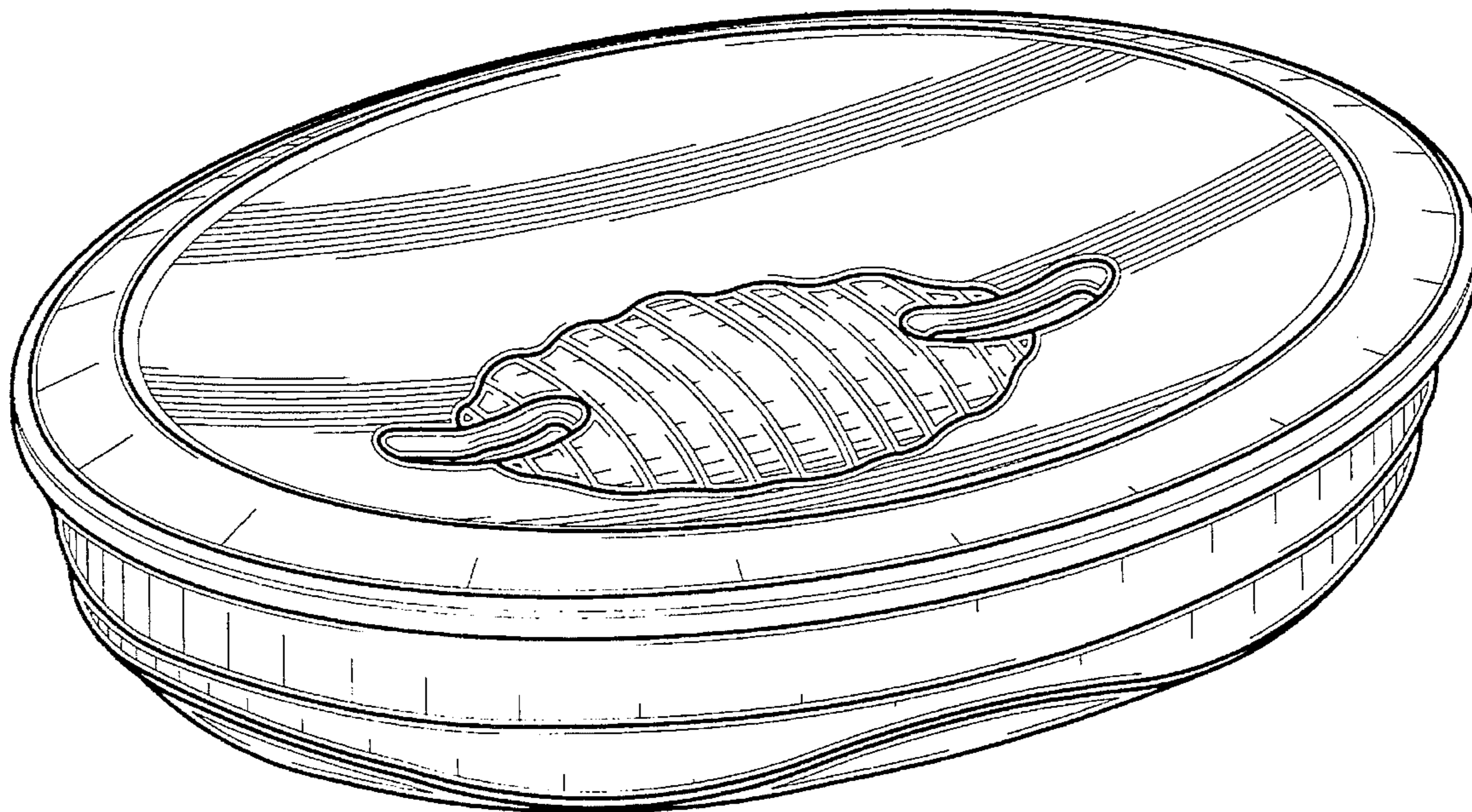
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a soap dish, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top left front perspective view of a soap dish showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof; the rear elevational view being a mirror image; and,
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.

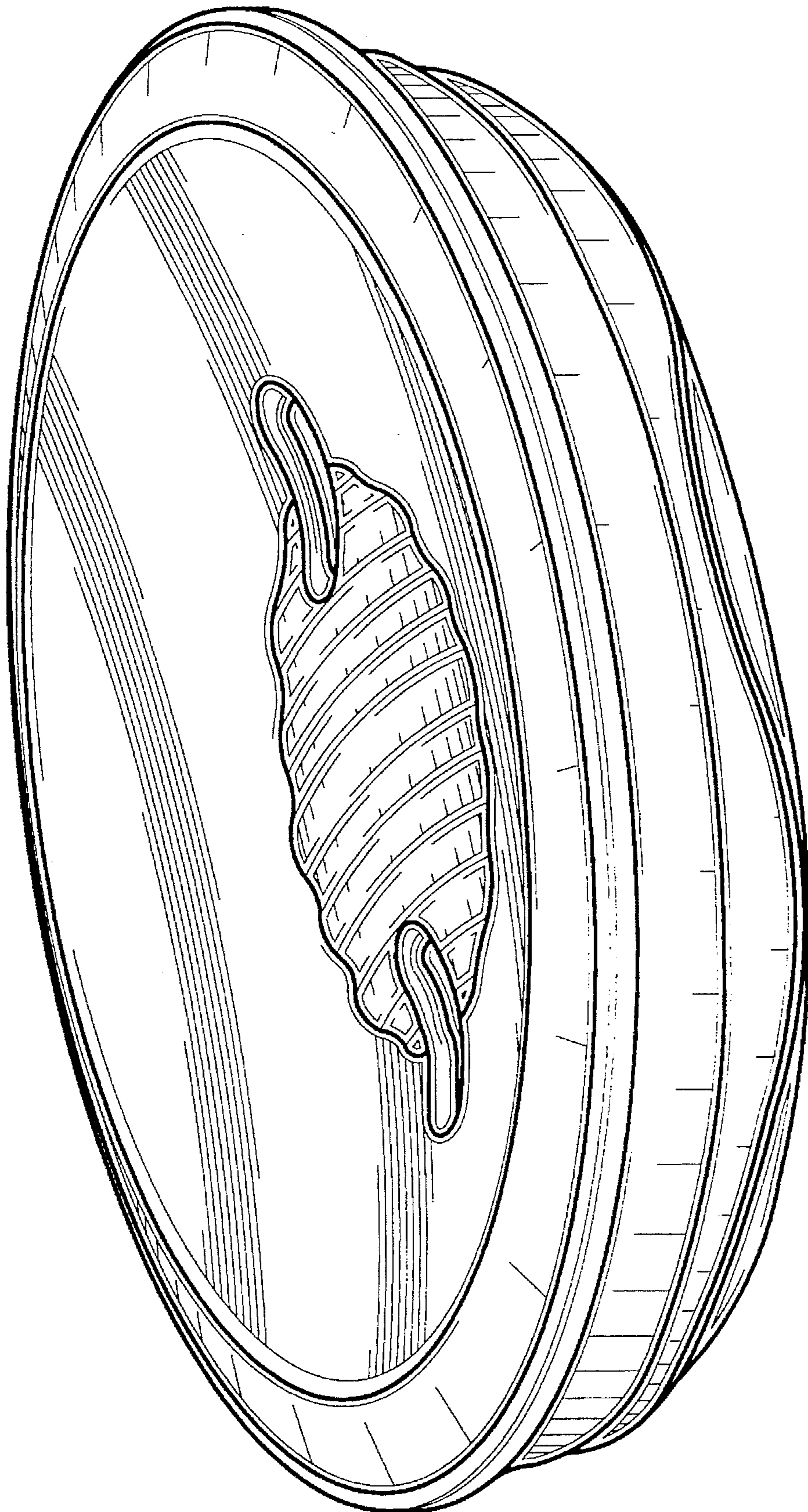

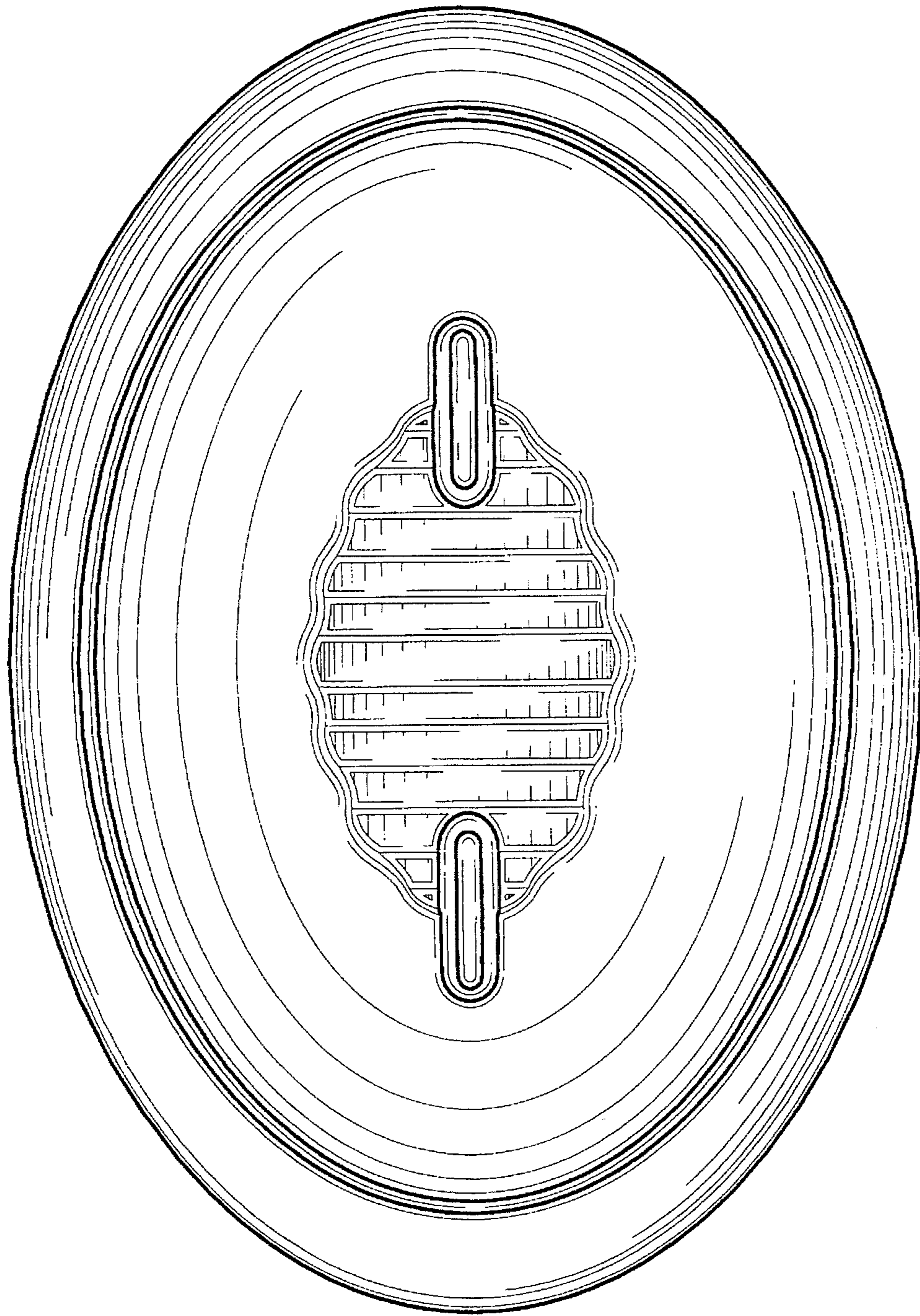

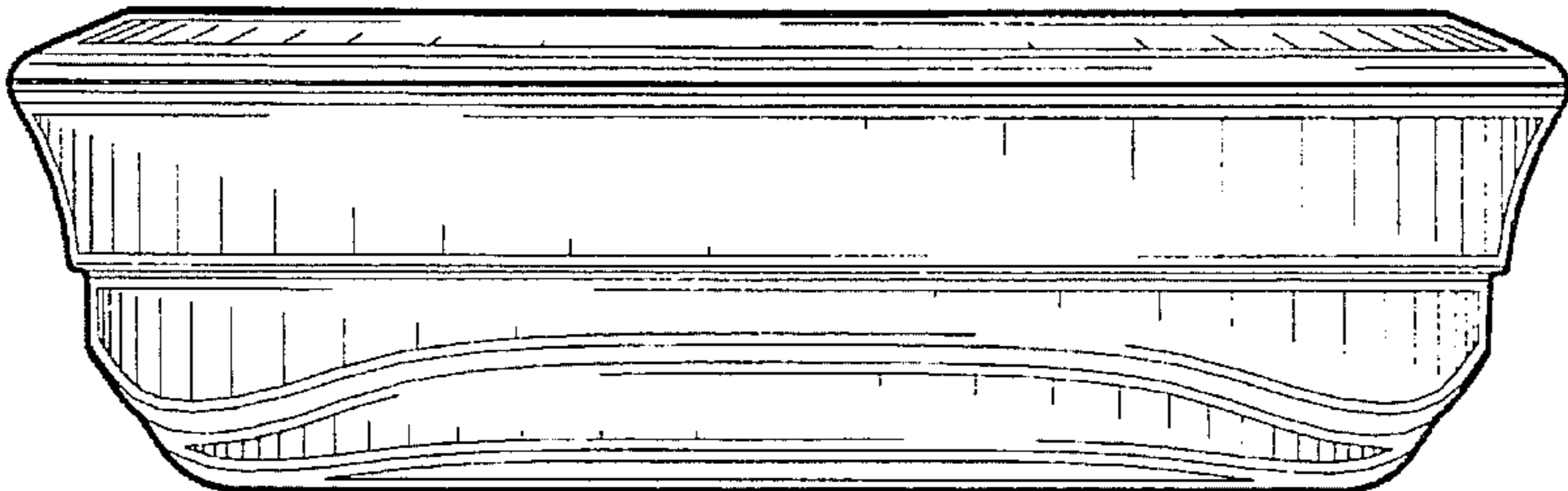

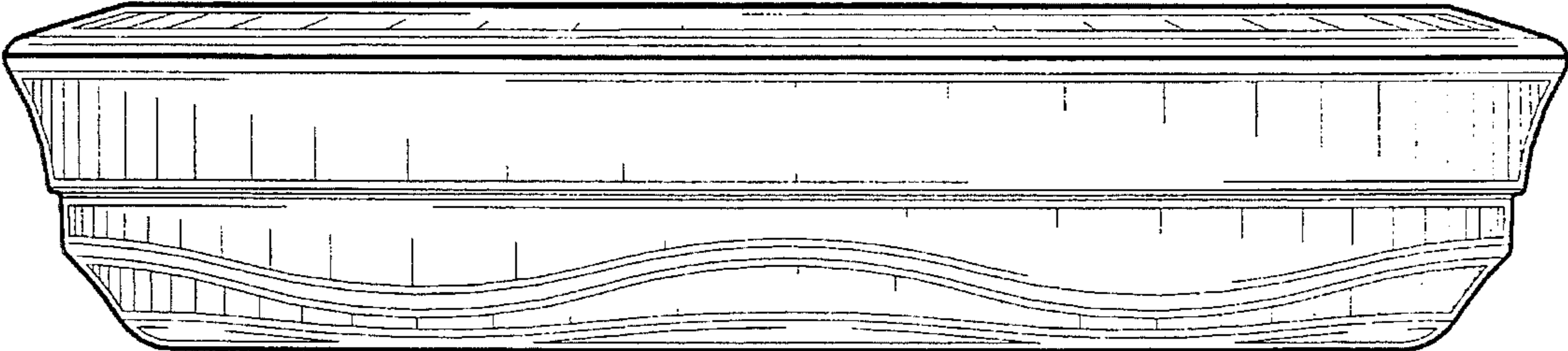

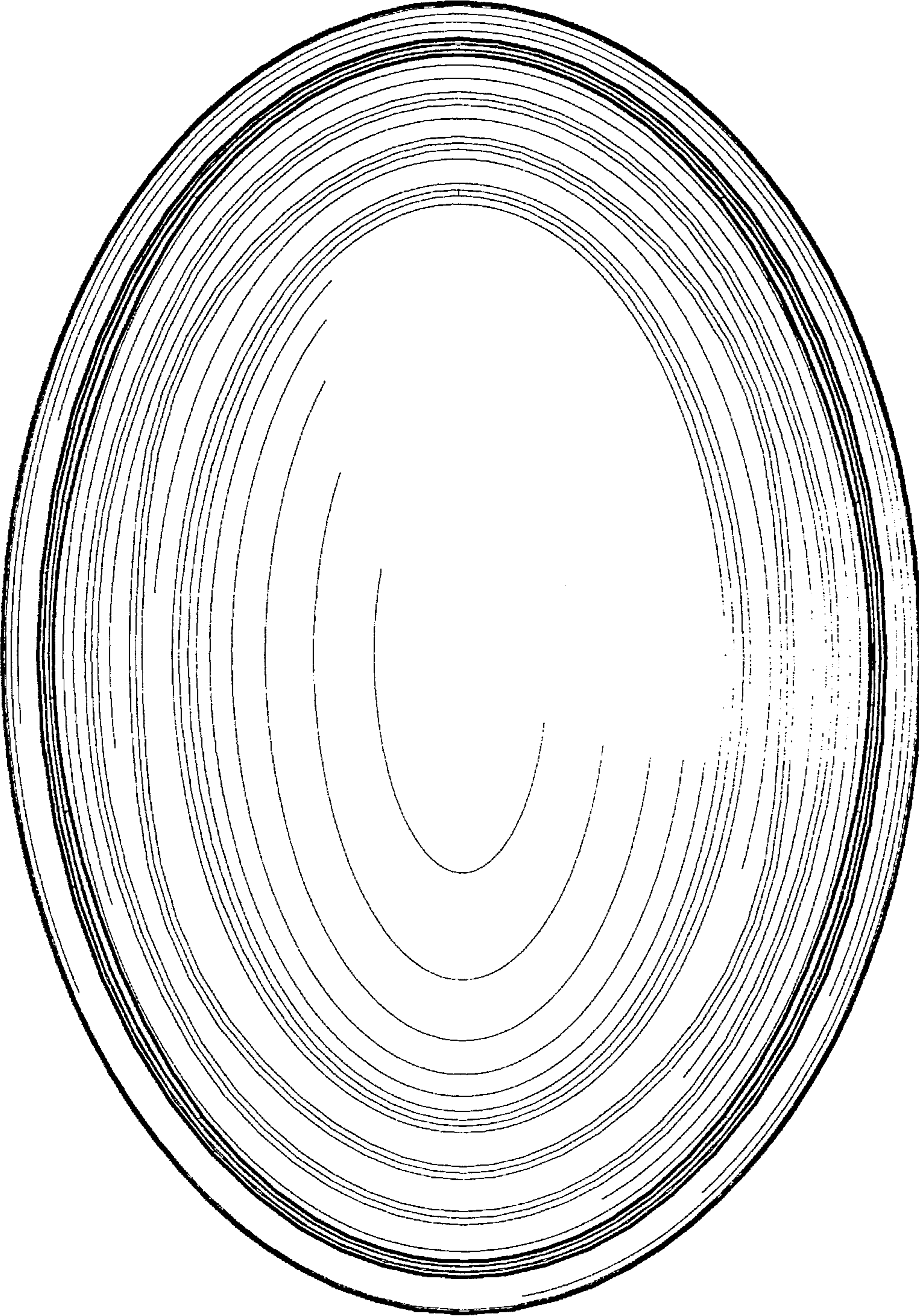
