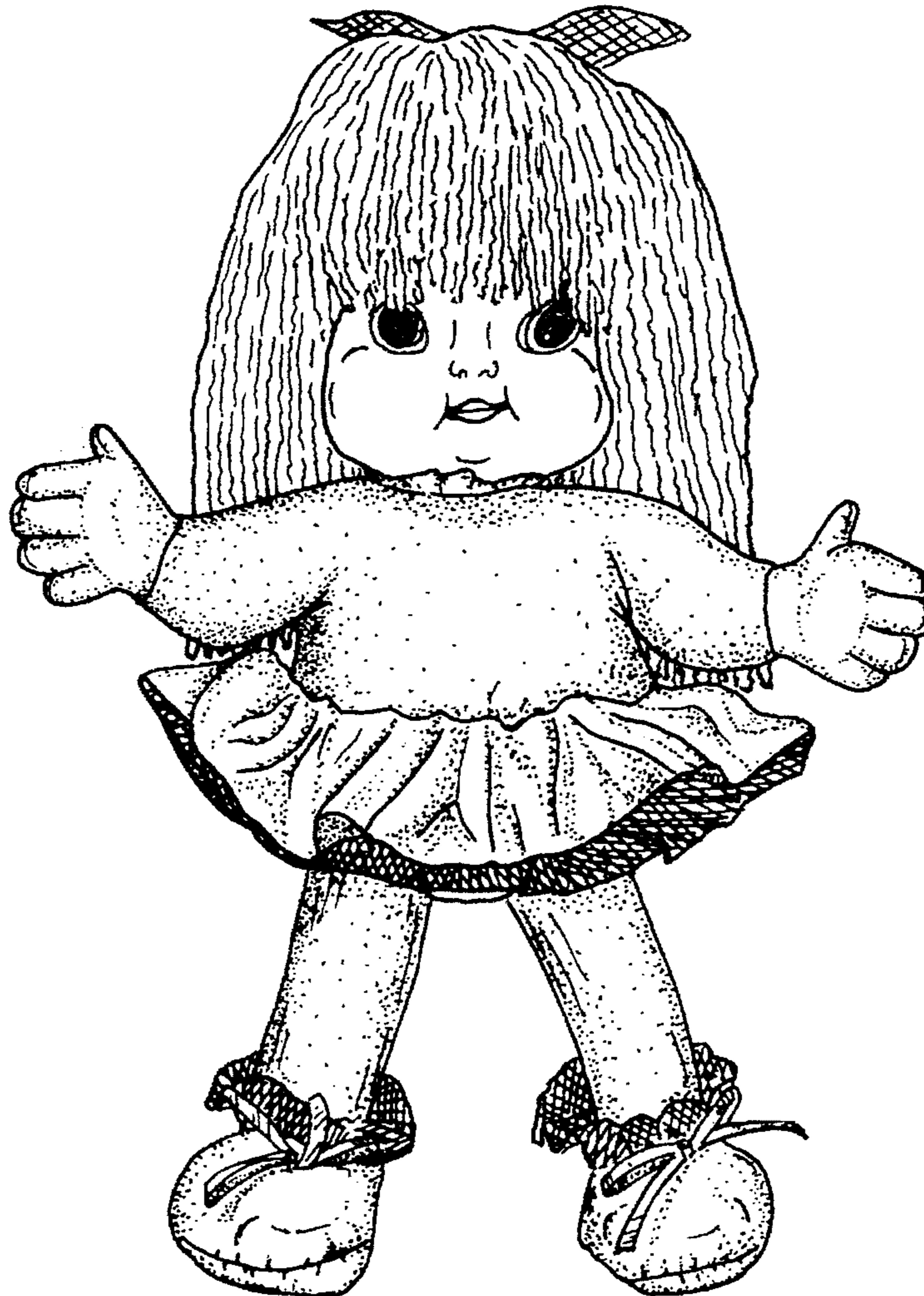
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a doll, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the doll of the present invention;

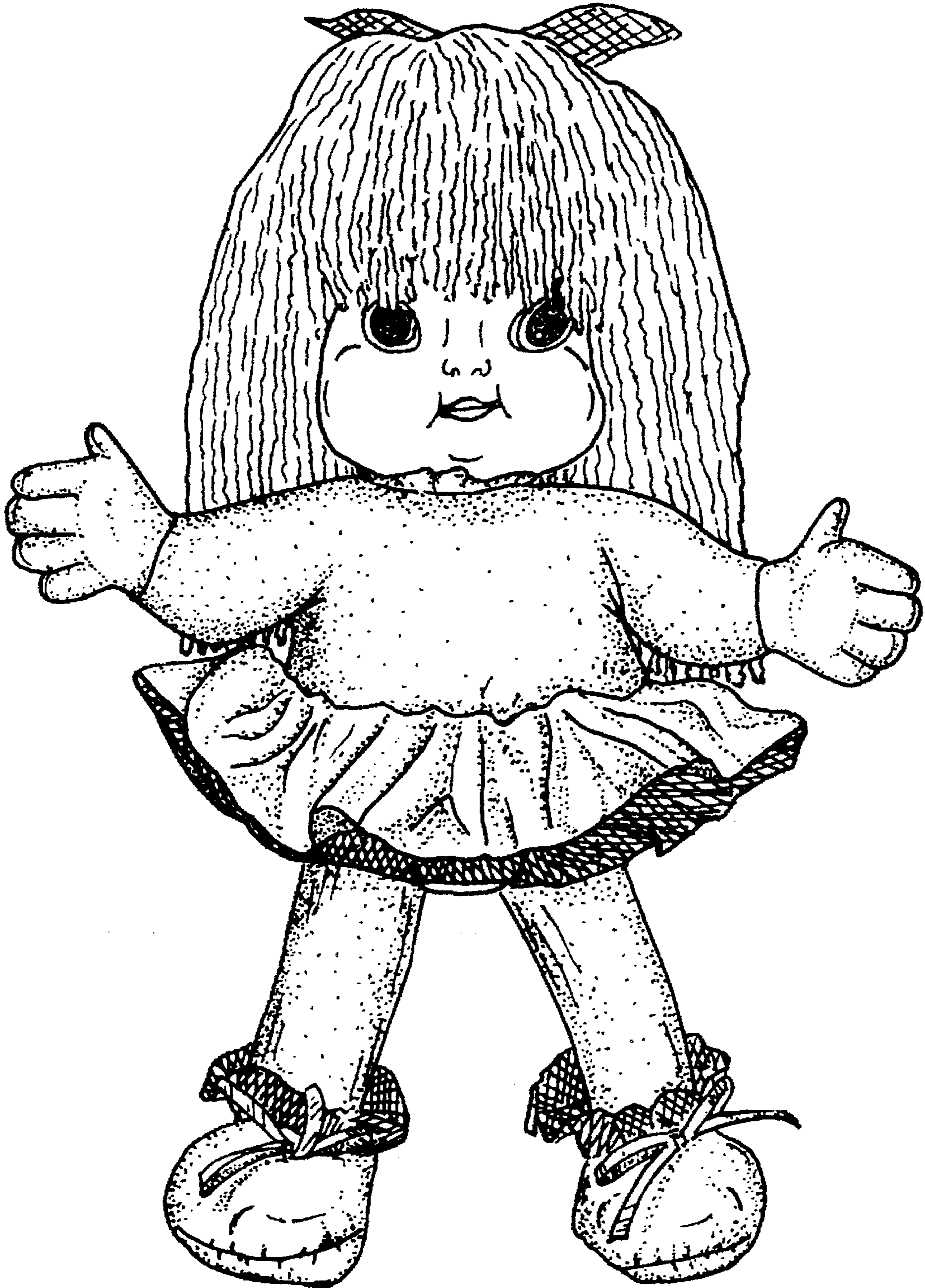

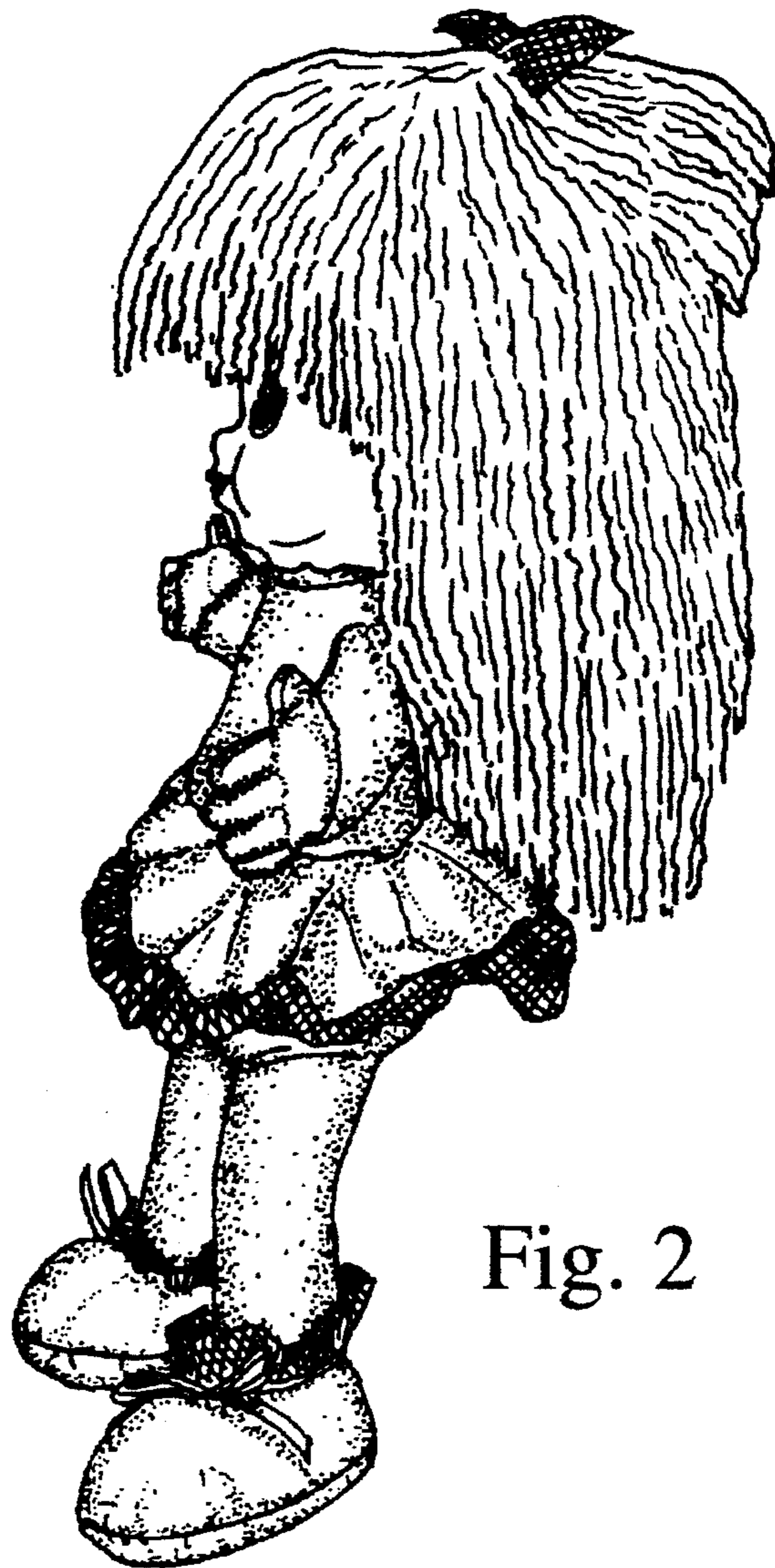

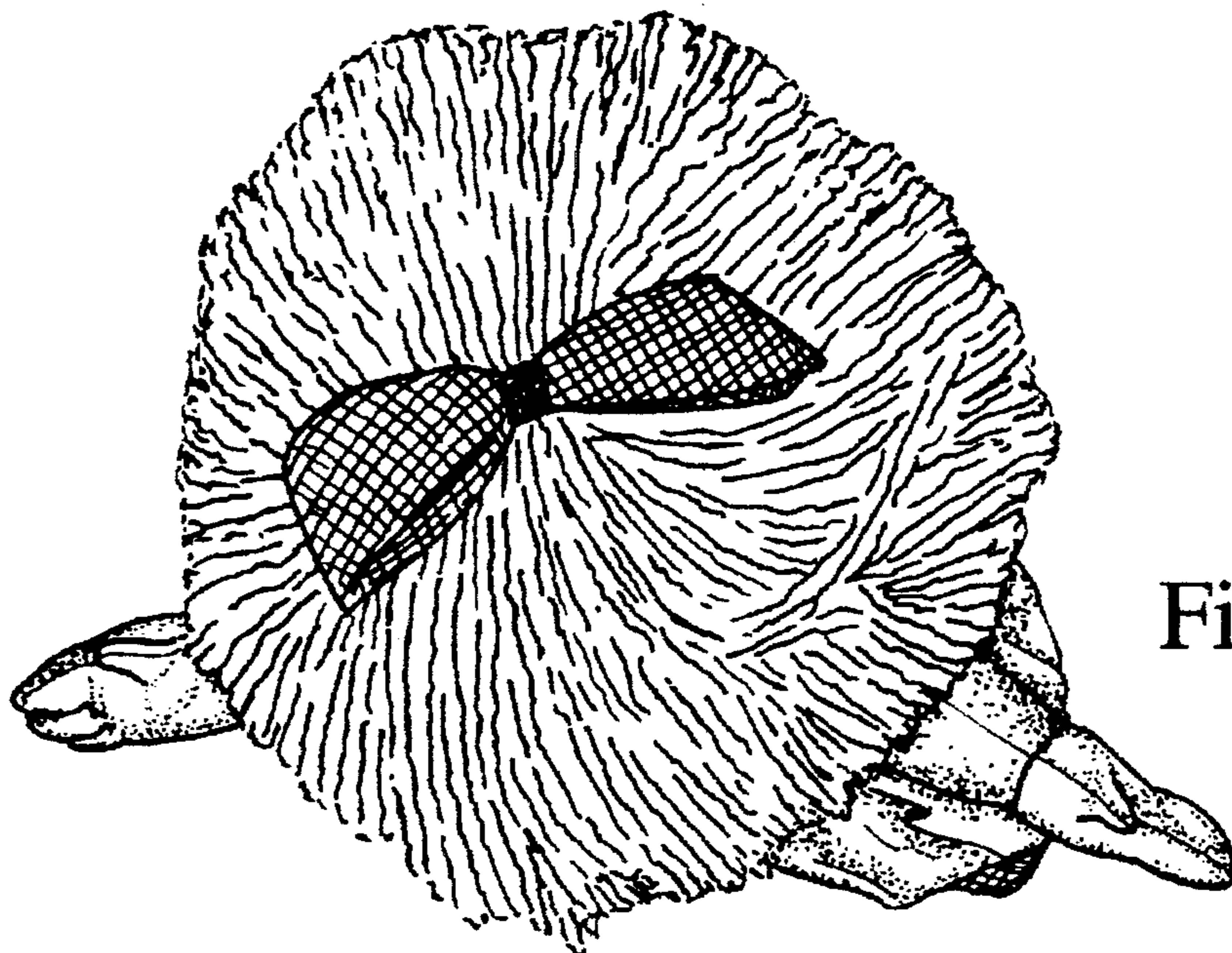

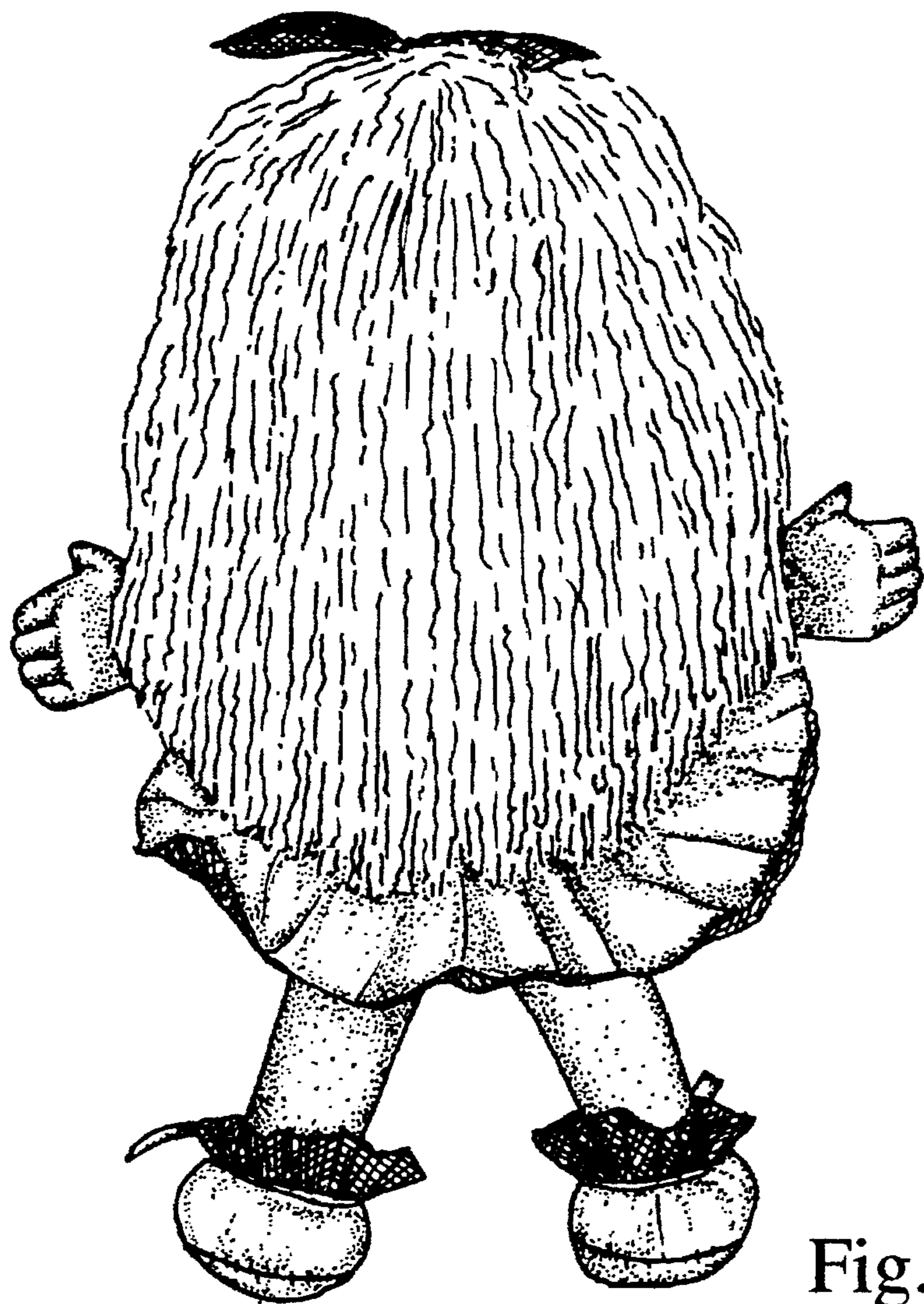

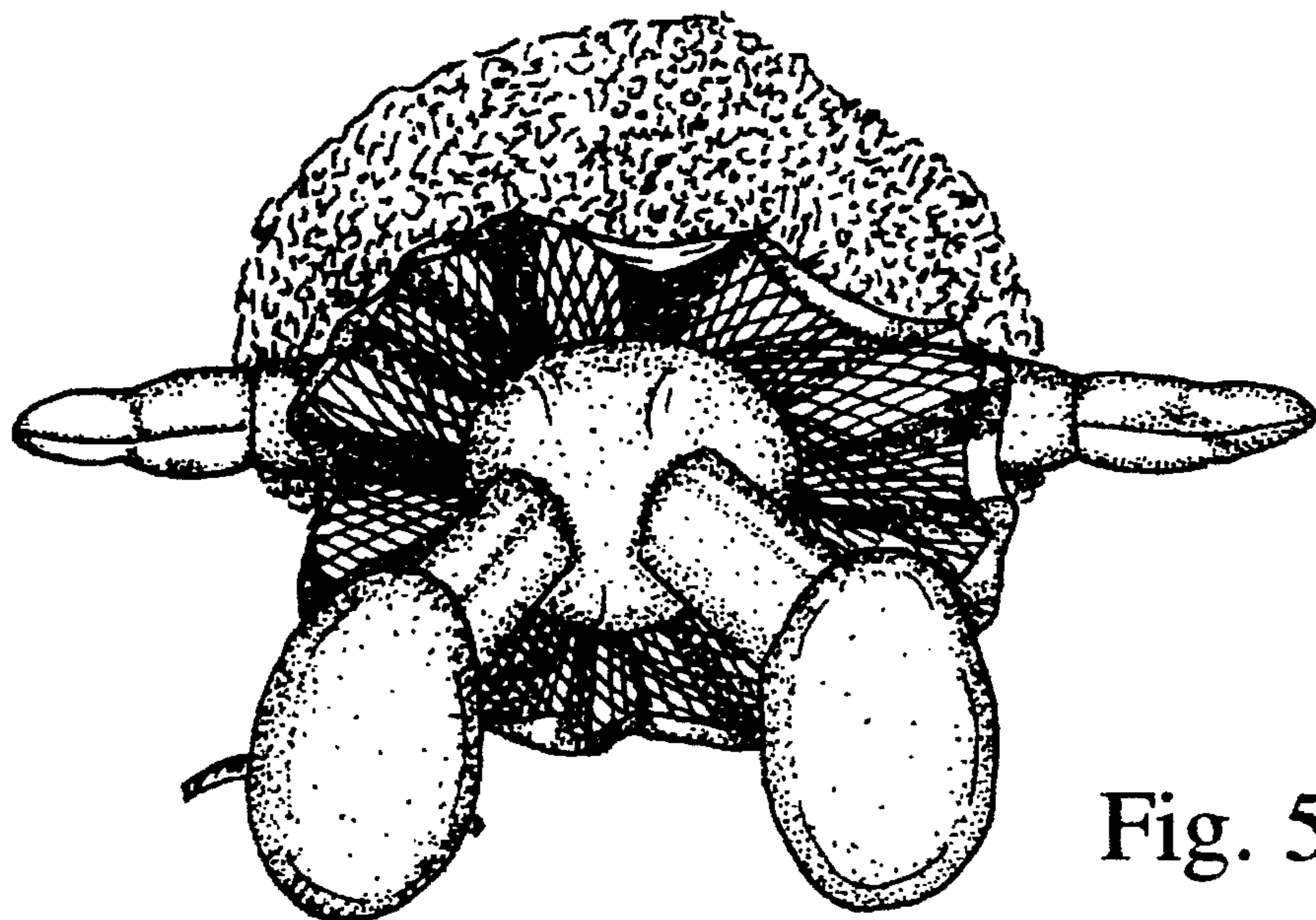
